Racing NSW inject a further \$20 million prize-money

New metropolitan Midway races and boost to Epsom Handicap part of increases across the board

Racing NSW yesterday announced increases in annual prize-money to the tune of \$20 million, in a show of further investment to the racing industry from the state's governing body.

Among the changes is the creation of a new tier of race staged on metropolitan Saturday racecards, to be named Midway races, while prize-money levels for several Group races, including the Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m), will see significant increases.

NSW trainer's three-year disqualification over horse deaths stood aside

Leading Southern NSW trainer Trevor Sutherland has had a three-year disqualification thrown out by the Racing NSW Appeal Panel relating to the euthanasia of two retired racehorses he had re-homed to a third party prior to their death. Wagga-based Sutherland was yesterday in the process of re-applying for his trainer's licence after the appeal victory following six months on the sidelines.

The Midway Races will feature as part of Saturday metropolitan racecards, taking the number of races on a standard card to ten. They will be open exclusively to horses from small to mid-sized NSW metropolitan and provincial stables, with races carrying a total purse of \$100,000, and eligibility determined on a point-scoring system with trainers assessed on the number and level of race winners trained by them in the previous year.

Increases to prize-money levels will be implemented across the spectrum of racing in New South Wales, with prize-money for Saturday metropolitan races increased by \$5,000 to \$130,000, while the metropolitan TAB Highway races for country-trained horses will be bolstered to \$100,000, from its current level of \$75,000.

Country racing will be the biggest recipient of the increases, with a total investment of \$5,200,000, as minimum prize-money for TAB country races will see increases of \$2,000, to \$24,000, while 20 country race meetings will be elevated to Showcase status, with races carrying prize-money of \$30,000.

Prize-money on the country racing circuit has increased \$58 million since 2012, with the total on offer now standing at more than \$91 million. The changes will take effect from July 1, 2021.

In announcing the new changes, Racing NSW chairman, Russell Balding, said: "We are pleased to be able to announce this significant increase in prize-money which will benefit country races as well as the Saturday metropolitan race meeting each week.

"These increases broaden the spread of prize-money and further improve the dividends back to our owners and participants. We also want to make sure that our traditional spring feature races continue to attract quality fields and maintain their prize-money relativity."

Racing NSW CEO, Peter V'landys, said the introduction of Midway races to metropolitan racedays will offer smaller trainers the opportunity to bolster their stables.

"The idea actually came from the trainers, it was Richard Freedman who put this to me some years ago," said V'landys.

"The country have their specialized races, the Highway race, but provincial and those metropolitan trainers that are in the smaller or mid-stream, they don't get that opportunity every week. So now they have their opportunity to procure owners, because there'll be a \$100,000 race each week for those stables.

"The objective of the Midway Races is to build the competitiveness of small to mid-sized stables, and further develop the field sizes and quality for metropolitan racing."

The time-honoured Epsom Handicap, won most recently by Probabeel (Savabeel) last year and which also includes Winx (Street Cry), Desert War (Desert King) and Super Impose (Imposing) on its roll of honour, will have prize-money boosted by \$500,000, to \$1.5 million, among several upgrades to the Everest carnival in the spring.

In addition, Racing NSW announced a bonus prize of \$1 million for any horse that wins the Craven Plate (Group 3, 2000m) and Rosehill Gold Cup (2000m) in the same year, with each race seeing an increase of \$250,000 to its prize fund, taking both to a purse of \$750,000.

The Villiers Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m), inaugurated in 1892, will see its prize-money treble, receiving an increase of \$500,000, while the Flight Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m), will receive an increase \$250,000, a move that V'landys says will bring prize-money for these traditional races in line with newly-created spectacles possessing lucrative prize pots.

"We have to have relativity on our prize-money and we need to make sure that our traditional and time-honoured races don't lose out," V'landys said.

"I think we've just rectified this to bring (prize-money levels) back and relative to these new races."

The newly-announced increases are a far cry from at this stage last year, when racing bodies across the country were forced into implementing reductions in prize-money levels due to the outbreak of Covid-19 and V'landys said that Racing NSW had emerged from the pandemic in a strong position, allowing for these prize-money increases to take place.

"We were in unknown territory last year when the pandemic hit, we didn't know how long it was going to last, and what effect it would have on our revenues, so we had to take a conservative approach," V'landys said. "We restructured prize-money until we saw what the pandemic was going to do to our revenue streams.

"It certainly didn't have as big an effect as we thought. It had an effect on the race clubs, but the betting turnover increased dramatically over that period. So we were able to generate more revenue than expected and, like any organisation, we turn those revenues back to our participants.

"If we were a public company, our dividends are prize-money and they can all compete to get that prize-money."

Six for Capitalist

Kalashnikov (2 c ex Rough Ride by Flying Spur) broke his maiden at the fourth attempt yesterday to provide first season sire Capitalist (Written Tycoon) with his sixth individual winner. Trained by Peter and Paul Snowden, Kalashnikov took out the CG&E Maiden Plate (1100m) at Gosford under Jason Collett, defeating Godolphin's Raoul (Kermadec) by a long neck. Double Ex (Exosphere), the \$2.70 favourite, was the same distance behind in third. Kalashnikov is the second foal out of Flying Spur (Danehill) mare Rough Ride, who has produced two winners from two runners. Newgate Farm's Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Capitalist already has a stakes winner to his name courtesy of Inglis Millennium (RL, 1200m) winner Profiteer. Capitalist covered 237 mares in 2020, his fourth season at stud, at a fee of \$44,000 (inc GST).

Inglis Digital reaches \$100 million milestone

A gross of \$2.17 million in the February (Late) Online Sale has seen the Inglis Digital platform reach the historical milestone of \$100 million in total turnover since its launch in May 2017. It also brings the overall 2021 figure to \$9.3 million, while the clearance rate was again strong at 78 per cent. Topping the sale was four-year-old gelding Heyington Station (Star Witness) (Lot 65), who was sold to Trent Needham for \$95,000. It was Needham and his father Mark's first outright purchase. "Dad and I have had shares in multiple horses but Heyington Station is our first horse that we will own outright and obviously it's our first ever buy with Inglis and

Inglis Digital," Needham said. "We look at every digital catalogue and this horse just jumped out at me and I convinced dad to jump on, the bidding war online was a bit intense but we're really excited to race this horse together. His form is so consistent, in 16 starts he's only finished further back than fourth once and that was a fifth effort at Caulfield. We're sending him to Will Clarken to train." Other highlights of the sale include the Lindsay Park Racing-consigned Triton Rising (Sebring) (Lot 19), who sold to Michael Hickmott Bloodstock for \$90,000, and a Capitalist yearling colt out of Hussonet (Mr. Prospector) mare Ropable (Lot 191), who was purchased by David Bayne for \$80,000.

Still A Star back with a bang

Still A Star (4 m Toronado - Lita by Casino Prince) produced an impressive performance on her first run for 12 months to land the Vamos Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Launceston yesterday. The Bill Ryan-trained mare's last competitive outing was at this track in February last year, when she took out the Tasmanian Oaks (Listed, 2100m). Ridden by Brendon McCoull, Still A Star tracked the leader Deroche (Needs Further) into the straight before pulling clear comfortably in the closing stages to win by three-quarters of a length on her comeback. Runaway Girl (Sebring) finished a length behind Deroche in third. All roads lead to the All-Star Mile (1600m) now for Still A Star, who finished fourth on the leaderboard for next month's contest with 9,954 votes. Still A Star will bid to emulate the achievements of her fellow Tasmanian mare Mystic Journey (Needs Further), who won the inaugural All-Star Mile in 2019, and McCoull will maintain the ride in the \$5 million race at Moonee Valley on March 13.

Glass Warrior narrowly takes Launceston Cup

Glass Warrior (5 m Glass Harmonium - Hissy Miss by Golden Snake) landed a thrilling edition of the Launceston Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) by the barest of margins yesterday, with three horses crossing the line almost simultaneously. The John Blacker-trained mare came late down the outside under a perfectly-timed ride by Sigrid Carr to get the better of Sh'bourne Renegade (Wordsmith) by a nose, with the same margin back to White Hawk (Tough Speed) in third. It was the second stakes win for Glass Warrior, who landed the Launceston Guineas (Listed 2100m) in 2019, and she improved on her fourth-placed finish in the race last year.

Newhart takes Mowbray Stakes

Newhart (5 g Fighting Sun - Jesting by Commands) notched a hat-trick of wins when comfortably taking out the Mowbray Stakes (Listed, 1600m) at Launceston yesterday. The Leanne Gaffney-trained gelding tracked the leaders rounding the turn before breaking through a gap halfway down the straight. Once ahead, he cruised clear to score by a length over Mandela Effect (Turffontein). Swoop Dog (Husson) was a short head further behind in third. It was the third win of 2021 for Newhart, who took out the Devonport Cup (1880m) on January 6 before landing the Thomas Lyons Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Hobart earlier this month.

Group 1 winner Fenway has first winner

Zudin (Redoute's Choice) earned 2015 Vinery Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Fenway (High Chaparral) her first winner as a dam when taking out a 1600-metre maiden at Gosford yesterday. The Chris Waller-trained Zudin, a \$600,000 purchase from the 2019 Inglis Easter Yearling Sale, broke his maiden at the fifth attempt with a head victory over Apollate (I Am Invincible). Oceanic Flash (Sacred Falls) finished a length behind the winner in third. Three-year-old colt Zudin is Fenway's first foal and Arrowfield Stud will offer her yearling, a colt by Snitzel (Redoute's Choice), at Inglis Easter as **Lot 304**.

Starry Legend sensational on debut

The John Sadler-trained Starry Legend (Zoustar) produced a devastating performance on debut at Sandown yesterday under Michael Dee, running out a three and three-quarter-length winner of the IVE Print Plate (1000m). The colt, who

was purchased by Sadler for \$500,000 from last year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, finished ahead of De Long Star (Squamosa) in second, with Square Cut (Kuroshio) another one and three-quarter lengths back in third. "He's delivered, we've liked him for a long time but he's only gone as far as 800 metres in his training and you just wonder. But as happy as I am, it hasn't surprised me," Sadler told Racing.com. "It was amazing really, the gate speed, it was almost as if the others missed the start. You think to yourself through the race that you hope he isn't running through the bridle but to see him give that kick inside the 200 metres showed that he wasn't. He's a very promising horse."

Bellinger scores Sandown win

The Tom Dabernig and Ben Hayes-trained Bellinger (Zoustar) was another to impress at Sandown yesterday, breaking his maiden at the fifth attempt in the Ladbrokes Plate (1500m). Ridden by Damian Lane, Bellinger cruised to an

emphatic two and three-quarter length win over And She Was (Shamus Award). Old Fashioned (Dissident) was a further short-head behind in third. "It was certainly enjoyable to sit back and watch that, Damian was very composed on the horse and it was a very easy watch," Dabernig and Hayes' Flemington stable manager, Dara O'Meachair, told Racing.com. Bellinger finished unplaced in both his spring starts but arrived at Sandown yesterday on the back of two runner-up performances. "He'd really improved this preparation as his form suggested and the team just waited the month between runs to get him on a similarly large track to Pakenham," O'Meachair added.

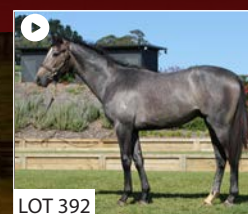

Montefilia ready for Surround

Dual Group 1 winner Montefilia (Kermadec) returns in the Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick on Saturday and, despite 1400 metres not being an ideal trip, her trainer David Payne would not rule her out of producing a big run. "Not on the way she has been working. She's been working really well," Payne said. "But in my heart, I feel it's a bit short for her." The three-year-old filly had a remarkable spring, taking out the Flight Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) and Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) on consecutive weekends before finishing third in the Kennedy Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) in November. The Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m) is her most likely second-up goal following Saturday, but if she happens to show she has more speed in her legs, a Coolmore Classic (Gr 1, 1500m) tilt is a possibility. "That's why I put her in everything, then we can decide where we want to go," Payne said. "But the Oaks is where she will finish off. I think she's good. I don't think we've seen the best of her. She is a big, strong filly and she will win a few decent races."

Away Game undergoes vet check

The Ciaran Maher and David Eustace-trained Away Game (Snitzel) has sustained an abrasion to her off-side hip after slipping when being unloaded from a horse float yesterday morning. The three-year-old filly has accepted for the Surround Stakes and her suitability to race will be assessed by Racing NSW's general manager veterinary services, Dr Toby Koenig, this morning. Away Game was last seen finishing third in the Light Fingers Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) earlier this month.

McDonald upbeat on Very Elleegant

James McDonald is looking forward to continuing his association with multiple Group 1 winner Verry Elleegant (Zed) in the Chipping Norton Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick on Saturday. The leading jockey missed her Victorian spring Group 1 double in the Turnbull Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) and Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m), but was reunited with the five-year-old mare in the Apollo Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Randwick earlier this month. Very Elleegant finished third behind the reopposing Colette (Hallowed Crown) and Kolding (Ocean Park) and McDonald was pleased with her first-up effort. "She was fantastic," he told Sky Sports Radio. "She got in an awkward spot and it wasn't her sort of race in terms of set-up - it was slow off the front and they sprinted home. She made very good ground late and I was impressed with the way she came back. She will be very hard to beat (on Saturday)."

Mugatoo's owners sweat on Mile wildcard

Connections of Mugatoo (Henrythenavigator) remain intent on gaining a start in the All-Star Mile and have decided to bypass the Chipping Norton Stakes to concentrate on the Melbourne feature. The Kris Lees-trained gelding narrowly missed out on securing his spot among the top ten gallopers in the public vote and now has to sweat on receiving a wildcard entry. Mugatoo was nominated for Saturday's Chipping Norton as a precaution but Lees said they have decided to roll the dice and wait for the All-Star Mile process to unfold. "We're still concentrating on getting to the All-Star Mile," he said. "It's a fortnight away so we will stick to the original plan of going into it second-up should we get in. You'd like to think you're in strong contention."

Zou Dancer deserves Group 1 shot

Zou Dancer (Zoustar) will line up in the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Flemington on Saturday and co-trainer Troy Corstens believes the filly has earned her shot at Group 1 riches. Zou Dancer has three wins from five career starts and was last seen running out an emphatic winner of the The Vanity (Gr 3, 1400m) at Flemington on February 13. "If any trainer goes into a race like that telling you they're going to win by five lengths, they're kidding themselves, because you don't expect that," Corstens, who trains in partnership with his father Leon, told Racing.com. "It's not like we beat a bunch of hacks, we beat Personal, who is a Group 1 winner, so it was a surprise. We knew she was going good, but it was really a pleasant surprise. We could have taken the easy route and gone to the Kewney Stakes the following week, but we want to test her at the mile and we're not going to die wondering so we'll give her a crack at it."

Ole Kirk bound for Australian Guineas

The Hawkes Racing-trained Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) is set to back-up in the Australian Guineas after finishing well down the field in last weekend's Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m). The three-year-old colt broke from barrier one and struggled to handle the inside part of the track, finishing six and a half lengths behind winner Probabeel (Savabeel). He has been handed barrier 15 in Saturday's contest and will be ridden once again by Kerrin McEvoy.

Moroney keen on Poland's chances

Mike Moroney is confident Autumn Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) winner Poland (So You Think) can match up to Group 1 company in the Australian Guineas. Poland has started once before at the highest level when he finished eleventh in last year's Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m). Moroney is expecting Poland to perform better on Saturday after coming through his Caulfield win in good shape. "I don't run my horses in Group 1 races unless they are up to it," Moroney said. "We've got to take on better company and we've got to see whether he can measure up. He came through his last-start win really well."

Harrovian out to extend streak

The Toby and Trent Edmonds-trained The Harrovian (Fastnet Rock) will bid to extend his streak of 11 consecutive wins in the Shaftesbury Avenue Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) at Flemington on Saturday. The seven-year-old gelding, who secured his place in the All-Star Mile with over 7,000 votes, has not lost a race since June 2019 and was last seen in competitive action when landing the Bernborough Plate (Listed, 1600m) at Eagle Farm on Boxing Day. "He is there to win on Saturday, without a doubt we are full steam ahead," Trent Edmonds told Racing.com. "We are hoping he can go there and get the job done and give us some confidence heading into the All-Star Mile. He had a gallop on Saturday and had a big blow and again on Tuesday and was super. So he is spot on for the Flemington 1400 metres which I think will suit him."

Begg's familiar path with Butter Chicken

Grahame Begg is planning to follow the same path he used for Nonconformist (Rebel Raider) last year with exciting filly Butter Chicken (Savabeel), who finished runner-up in the Caulfield Autumn Classic (Gr 2, 1800m) on Saturday. "We are going to aim her at the Alister Clark Stakes and go from there before considering taking her up to Sydney," Begg told Racing.com. "It is three weeks between races and we know it worked with Nonconformist last year." Nonconformist also finished second in the Autumn Classic before going on to win the

Alister Clark Stakes (Gr 2, 2040m) at Moonee Valley and Begg was impressed with Butter Chicken's first effort in stakes company. "I was delighted with the way she went on Saturday and so was Jamie (Kah), even though she is a high-class filly that we expected to run well," the trainer said. "She is still in her first racing preparation so if she shows any signs of not coping she can go to the paddock but she has come through the run well so far."

Coomo bids for first city winner

Rockhampton trainer Adrian Coome is hoping Sunrise Dancer (Dawn Approach) can provide him with a first metropolitan winner as a trainer at Eagle Farm today. The five-year-old mare, who is bidding for a hat-trick following wins at Rockhampton and Mackay, is a dual acceptor in the 1200-metre Benchmark 70 and the 1400-metre Class 6 Plate. "The Benchmark race looks easier for her and she'll come in a few without the emergencies," Coome told Racing Queensland. "She's been racing well back at home, so her Sydney owners wanted to give her a go in Brisbane before she goes for a spell."

Lynch kicking goals on racetrack

Richmond footballer Tom Lynch, who co-owns European import Starcaster (Dansili), helped launch the Victoria Racing Club's Autumn Racing Carnival on Tuesday. The Anthony and Sam Freedman-trained Starcaster has won three times since arriving from Jedd O'Keeffe's UK stable in 2019, including the Torney Night Cup (Listed, 2500m) earlier this month. "I have always loved to follow the horses and have a small share in a runner at the moment, Starcaster, which has won its last two, which has been fun," Lynch said. "Lachie Hunter and a lot of the Western Bulldogs boys are in it and through my manager asked if I wanted to come in on it. It has been the first horse I have been involved with, so it has been good fun. All the luck has probably dried up for me now."

Laming case adjourned

Richard Laming's hearing into alleged race-day treatment was adjourned yesterday after Racing Victoria made an application to the Victorian

Racing Tribunal to postpone proceedings. Brendan Murphy QC, who was representing RV, put in his application after the hearing had reconvened following a break to permit Laming's barrister Damien Sheales to listen to an audio recording made by RV's manager of the compliance assurance team during surveillance of Laming's property in November 2019. Judge Bowman granted the adjournment, with the hearing due to resume at 9:30am (AEDT) today. As part of the application for the adjournment, RV agreed to pay the defendants' legal costs for the lost day, believed to be around \$10,000.

Randall disqualified for jigger possession

Former Casino-based trainer Kevin Randall has been banned until May 2023 after pleading guilty to a charge of being in possession of an "electronic or electric device" following a raid on his stable in August last year. Randall, who also pleaded guilty to two charges of employing unregistered staff, was additionally found guilty of sexual harassment by the Racing NSW stewards, despite entering a not guilty plea on that charge. He was banned for three years, reduced to two years and three months due to his guilty plea, over the device found in the stable and six month for his misconduct. The penalties are to be served concurrently.

Hyeronimus and Paine appeal decision handed down

Adam Hyeronimus has had his appeals dismissed against 23 of the 32 charges laid against him in breach of AR115(1)(C) relating to having an interest in a bet on any race and AR115(1)(E) pertaining to jockeys betting on a race they are riding in. The jockey's cousin, stablehand Blake Paine, has also had his appeals dismissed for facilitating the bets. The pair were handed a guilty verdict in August last year and on day two of the appeals process in September changed their plea to guilty for three of the 32 charges laid against them. Appeals against five of the charges relating to a breach of AR115(1)(C), were allowed with the charges set aside. Hyeronimus was banned for three years in September, while Paine was handed a ban of two years and four months.

Oaks path for Amarelinha

Rising star Amarelinha (Savabeel) will not be a late entrant for the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) after Te Akau principal David Ellis revealed the filly will be aimed at the New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) at Trentham on March 20, with the Sunline Vase (Gr 3, 2100m) at Ellerslie on March 6 as her final lead-up. "In general terms, I am a fan of running the fillies in the New Zealand Bloodstock Filly of the Year Series where possible," Ellis said. "I think that they are better placed and they have got the rest of their career to go on as four and five-year-olds and race against the colts and the geldings. Amarelinha might be a Caulfield Cup or Cox Plate mare in the spring and I want to win the Filly of the Year Series and turn her into a top broodmare in years to come."

Frontman to New Zealand Derby

The Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman-trained Frontman (Makfi) will contest the New Zealand Derby with leading jockey Danielle Johnson booked to ride. A full brother to multiple Group 1 winner Bonneval, Frontman finished a good second behind Tia D'Or (Tavistock) in a Rating 65 event over 2100 metres last Saturday. Connections had considered bypassing the New Zealand Derby in preference for the Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) at Randwick on April 3. Frontman is rated a \$21 chance in a market headed by Rocket Spade (Fastnet Rock) at \$3.20 and Montre Moi (Showcasing) at \$3.80.

Wexford eyeing Sydney with Force of Will

A Sydney autumn raid could still be on the cards for exciting filly Force Of Will (Power). The three-year-old was scratched from the Waikato Guineas (Gr 2, 2000m) earlier this month after trainers Lance O'Sullivan and Andrew Scott were not happy with the routine bloods taken from her a couple of days prior. They have however been happy with the way she has bounced back and a trip across the Tasman to contest the Vinery Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Rosehill on March 27 is now being favoured over the New Zealand Oaks. The Sir Owen Glenn-bred and raced filly has won three of her four starts to date, including a last start victory in the Desert Gold Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Trentham last month. "We are heading towards the (Auckland Cup) carnival with her. Whether it is the first day or second day we are a little unsure," Scott said. "She is back on her game and had her first training gallop yesterday, and she was back working with her normal high energy. We are really pleased with her. Safely through a run over the carnival, we will possibly consider running her in the Vinery in Australia."

Llanacord seeking ultimate Oaks tribute

Stephen Nickalls hopes to get Llanacord (Contributer) to the New Zealand Oaks as a tribute to her former trainer Glynn Brick. The filly broke her maiden in style in a 2040-metre contest at Whanganui last week, clearing out by over eight lengths and highlighting her stamina. She is owned by Nickalls, who trains at Rangiotu, near Foxton, along with his mother and stepfather, Dianne and Kevin Hopson. The latter bought her for \$15,000 at Book 2 of the New Zealand Bloodstock National Yearling Sale in 2019 and sent her to be prepared by Brick in Cambridge. However, all that came to a shocking end when Brick died in a car crash near Cambridge in March last year. "Glynn had trained Kevin's horses for ten years, and the intention was always that he would train this filly," Nickalls said. "When that happened my stepfather called and asked if I could take her and we were only too happy to. They were very tragic circumstances. To be able to do

something with her is something, and if she can even run in the Oaks it will have great sentimental value for all of us."

SGP: Woodworth takes up Mauritius contract

Benny Woodworth will be missing from the riding ranks in Singapore for a while after accepting a contract in Mauritius. The 47-year-old Singapore Permanent Resident, who has applied for leave to go and ride in Mauritius, departs on Friday and will serve a two-week quarantine in Mauritius before beginning racing on March 20, the day the new season kicks off at the Champ de Mars racecourse. The season lasts until December, but Woodworth, who was champion jockey in Mauritius in 2007, indicated it's an open-ended contract with trainer Simon Jones.

IRE: Goffs February Weanlings go online

The Goffs February Weanling Sale will now be held as a live online sale following the Irish government's decision to extend the current coronavirus restrictions. Vendors will be asked to upload films and veterinary information to the Goffs website, while every weanling will be presented with a veterinary certificate against which purchasers can re-examine within 48 hours of the fall of the hammer. Goffs has so far held three online sales including last November's Autumn Yearling Sale.

UK: July Cup hero Pastoral Pursuits dies aged 20

Pastoral Pursuits (Bahamian Bounty), the winner of the July Cup (Gr 1, 6f) and sire of the likes of Ventura Rebel, Pastoral Player and Rose Blossom, has died at the age of 20. The son of Bahamian Bounty (Cadeaux Genereux) was bred by Red House Stud and bought by his trainer Hughie Morrison as a yearling before a lucrative racing career. A three-time winner at two, including at Group 3 level, he took Listed honours the following season before winning Doncaster's Park Stakes (Gr 2, 7f). His career highlight came when defeating Avonbridge (Averti) in the July Cup in 2005. Pastoral Pursuits was subsequently retired to the National Stud, where he stood for 11 seasons before swapping to Ladyswood and Snailwell Stud and then Norton Grove Stud, where he has resided for four seasons. Pastoral Pursuits, who has been responsible for 13 stakes winners, was standing the 2021 stud season for a fee of £2,000.

US: Arlington Park could close as owners put track up for sale

Churchill Downs Incorporated (CDI) on Tuesday launched a process to sell the Arlington Park site in Illinois that has hosted racing since 1927 and welcomed some of the sport's biggest names, including legendary Triple Crown hero Secretariat (Bold Ruler). Citation (Bull Lea), Cigar (Palace Music) and John Henry (Ole Bob Bowers) are other equine superstars to have graced the course, which came under the control of CDI in 2000. The company is committed to staging racing at the track from April 30 to September 25, but its chief executive, Bill Carstanjen, said: "Arlington's ideal location in Chicago's north-west suburbs, together with direct access to

NSW trainer's three-year disqualification over horse deaths stood aside

Leading Southern NSW trainer Trevor Sutherland has had a three-year disqualification thrown out by the Racing NSW Appeal Panel relating to the euthanasia of two retired racehorses he had re-homed to a third party prior to their death.

Wagga-based Sutherland was yesterday in the process of re-applying for his trainer's licence after the appeal victory following six months on the sidelines.

The panel's judgment found that Sutherland was aware that the two horses, Rozzi (Shrapnel) and Redfu (Strada), could have been euthanised by Donnchadh Brown but ruled that the Wagga-based trainer's primary intent was for them to be used for "jumping and hunting" purposes.

"Certainly, the panel ... (thinks that the) appellant was aware that there was a prospect that these two horses could be killed by Mr Brown and used as dog food if they did not work out as jumpers and hunters. We do not consider, however, that this was the appellant's main intent," the panel wrote.

"We think his intent was for the horses to be taken by Mr Brown for the purpose of them being trialled, hopefully successfully, as hunters and jumpers. This carried with it the risk however, known to the appellant, that they might prove unsuitable horses for this, and could ultimately suffer the fate they did."

During the investigation, Sutherland told Racing NSW chief steward Marc Van Gestel: "I give these horses a home, a chance to be rehomed at Don Brown's. He is a world class rider, who assured me if I can ride them, he would ride them.

"So, I felt safe in letting Mr Brown have these horses because never - I never once ever had a conversation about slaughtering racehorses, never ever with Don Brown."

The two horses were picked up by Brown from Sutherland's stable on or about April 8 last year. The appeal heard Sutherland had

trimmed the pair's feet and groomed them the morning of their departure.

In interview transcripts provided to the appeal panel, when questioned by Racing NSW Southern District steward Jason Shultz, who recalled that Redfu was a horse "that could hang" during his races, Sutherland replied: "Yeah, and he could just do things wrong, so I certainly wouldn't give him to a kid or anyone to get hurt, you know, and that's where we're going to end up, sir, you know, so many are out there that are just dangerous, sir, so it's going to get people hurt, and I'm not a person that will, you know - we rehome them, we do a lot of work, a lot of work in rehoming, and if they're not suitable - as I said, Donny is a very capable rider, you know, you see pictures of him on Facebook jumping six-foot fences and that, so he can ride, and as I said both of them jump,

"I had no troubles riding them and I thought they'd both take to that pretty good."

Brown, a licensed owner, was disqualified for four years at a Racing NSW hearing on September 8 last year for "having disposed of the racehorses Rozzi and Redfu on or around April 2020" and another two horses "on or around July 2020".

Sutherland was initially found guilty by Racing NSW stewards of a breach of the equine

welfare rule, specifically relating to a "horse is not to be, directly or indirectly, sent to an abattoir, knackery or similarly disposed of".

"Turning back to the words used in LR114(5)(e), the facts as found by us mean that what has occurred here is not caught by the rule. For the appellant to be in breach of the rule, we consider that his intent must have been, in giving the horses to Mr Brown, that they would then be killed, and their meat used as food," they wrote.

"That was not the appellant's intention. While knowing there was a risk that the horses could be destroyed for food, his intent was that they be used by Mr Brown for jumping and hunting."

In closing, the panel said: "Based on our factual findings as to the appellant's intent when sending the horses to Mr Brown, he has not breached the (equine welfare rule). The appeal in relation to that finding of breach must be allowed, and the penalty imposed set aside."

The panel also granted Sutherland the right to appeal the severity of a six-month disqualification imposed last September by stewards relating to failing to lodge a relevant death notification form for Bless You Toby (Shamus Award) who had been found deceased at his Wagga stables on July 7 last year.

Sutherland had pleaded guilty to the charge and the six-month ban expired last Monday.

ANZ Bloodstock News spoke to Racing NSW chief steward Marc Van Gestel yesterday, but he could not comment on the matter as, at the time, the judgment had not been made public.

The enforced closure of Sutherland's business last August led to the redundancy of nine staff and it also cost local racing clubs hundreds of thousands of dollars in lost revenue generated through runners in the region's races and track fees.

He trained 47 winners last season, to be the fifth leading country trainer in NSW, with prize-money earnings of more than \$950,000.

Sutherland's solicitor Paul O'Sullivan told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday: "In 35 years of doing this, I have never met a more genuine or better bloke than Trevor Sutherland."

Grateful Heart wins lucrative Million series

Grateful Heart (Written Tycoon) has been crowned DBS x Manulife Million Challenge champion, leaving trainer Danny Shum to revel in a third victory in the lucrative Happy Valley series in six years.

Joining Shum's previous winners – Speedy Longwah (Perfectly Ready) (2016) and Charity Glory (Written Tycoon) (2018) – Grateful Heart was clearly the best-performed runner in the series, which stretched from Happy Valley meetings between September to its conclusion yesterday evening (24 February), with four wins, a second and a third at the city circuit.

A constant force in sprint contests at the Valley, Grateful Heart boosted his series record to 70 points by posting a third to Sky Field (Deep Field) in the Class 1 Blue Pool Handicap (1200m), collecting four points.

That left the Written Tycoon (Iglesia) gelding tenuously placed with a 13-point buffer over Scores Of Fun (Reward For Effort), who was in a position to claim overall honours by lifting the Class 3 Sing Woo Handicap (1200m) two races later under the 15-6-4-3 points format.

But John Size's charge endured an interrupted run for Vagner Borges and crossed the line in seventh place behind Dennis Yip's Racing Fighter (Mastercraftsman).

Flying Genius (All Too Hard), winner of the Class 3 King Kwong Handicap (1000m) for Tony Cruz and Zac Purton, finished in third place with 46 points.

Shum was elated with Grateful Heart's effort to secure the HK\$650,000 first prize, a figure boosted by prize-money of HK\$345,000 to add further lustre for the chestnut's connections.

"He deserved it because he had four wins, one second and one third," Shum said.

"The horse always tries his best - he deserved to get his reward. It's good, we're very happy."

Sky Field's triumph delighted trainer Caspar Fownes as the Deep Field (Northern Meteor) gelding collected a HK\$1,500,000 High Achievement Bonus for winning a Class 1 contest before reaching the age of five.

Fownes predicts a bright future for the four-year-old after he charged down the outside under Alexis Badel to deny Stronger (Not A Single Doubt) by a head in a time of 1m 8.84s.

"He's still learning, but he's a good horse. Once he starts to really chill with maturity, he'll be a lot of fun," Fownes said.

"I'm very happy to get that result for the owners, it's a massive win for them because they get the \$1.5 million bonus with it as well, so it's just magic.

"He's still got it ahead of him but it's exciting when you know he's got a massive engine.

"He's a triple-figure (rating) horse for sure. By the end of the season, he'll be into triple figures and we'll have something to look forward to in December."

Fownes regained the lead in the trainers' championship from John Size with a treble as Daily Beauty (All American) surged to win the Class 4 Wang Tak Handicap (1200m) for

Joao Moreira before the Brazilian successfully combined with Green Luck (Street Cry) in the Class 3 Tsui Man Handicap (1650m).

Fownes shades Size in the trainers' title 46-44, while Moreira maintained the jockeys' championship status quo – and a 93-64 margin – over Purton, who triumphed on Racing Fighter in the Class 3 Sing Woo Handicap (1200m).

Solar Wai Wai (Snitzel) proved his liking for the Valley's 1650-metre trip with a fourth victory over the distance for Frankie Lor and Matthew Poon, lifting the Class 1 Shan Kwong Handicap.

Posting his sixth win from 23 starts, Solar Wai Wai is likely to be given more opportunities at his favoured distance.

"There are a few more 1650-metre races here, I think he's got a chance to get another," Lor said.

Douglas Whyte and Vincent Ho combined with Harmony Fire, a son of Brazen Beau (I Am Invincible) having only his second start, to claim the Class 4 Village Handicap (1000m).

Hong Kong racing continues at Sha Tin this Sunday (28 February).

They say fortune favours the bold, but it can scarcely have smiled more outrageously than it has on Mel Copelin and Brett Cornish since a daring day out at the sales four years ago.

The Torryburn Stud duo had a white-knuckle ride in securing broodmare Miss Interiors at the Inglis Chairman's sale of 2017, beating off some heavyweight under-bidders to gain the prize.

They then faced a nervous drive home, with some explaining to do to associates with an eye on the books – most notably Torryburn's ultimate chief John Cornish - having gone well beyond budget to secure the then five-year-old, for \$625,000.

"Brett and I picked her out as the one we wanted, but she did cost a pretty penny," Copelin tells *It's In The Blood*. "We probably paid more than we wanted to. And yes, we probably did get in a bit of trouble when we got home."

Miss Interiors had a great exterior, but had not exactly shown much was on the inside in her racing days.

Big things may have been expected as the daughter of Flying Spur kicked her career off in stakes class. But having run last in the Group 1 ATC Sires Produce of 2014 at her third start for Anthony Cummings, she was retired two seasons later in the bush, three wins from 25 attempts, on the back of an eighth at Dubbo.

Still, she was a hot ticket at the broodmare sale back in the big smoke 11 months after that, fetching the auction's sixth-highest price.

A mare of impressive size, she'd presented as an older half-sister - from the Stravinsky

dam Ballet D'Amour - to outstanding sprinter Russian Revolution. That three-year-old son of Snitzel, never seen at Dubbo, had won his first five Sydney starts. The latest - three weeks before this broodmare sale - was his first of two Group 1s in The Galaxy, at Rosehill.

Ballet D'Amour, a younger half-sister to triple US stakes-winner Tale To Be Told, had a brief racing career in the US before being brought to Australia. She had also thrown Turbo Miss (Sebring), winner of the Group 3 Frances Tressady Stakes at Flemington, two weeks before Russian Revolution's Galaxy.

As a bonus, Miss Interiors was in foal to Newgate Farm's ever-ready sire Deep Field. After a colt was born, Copelin decided on a no-brainer mating with I Am Invincible, standing back then for a mere \$110,000, and a second male foal ensued.

The first colt fetched \$260,000 at the Magic Millions Gold Coast sale, sold to Shadwell Stud, and was named Aysar. He's won two from eight

for the Hayes-Dabernig yard, came a long neck second in the Caulfield Guineas before Group 3 seconds at his past three starts, and is among the favourites for this Saturday's Group 1 Australian Guineas.

The second colt reaped Torryburn \$875,000 when knocked down to Coolmore's Tom Magnier (and syndicate) after a spirited bidding duel at last year's Sydney Easter online sale.

A massive colt who went to Chris Waller, he's known as Home Affairs. A narrow second on debut at Group 3 level last month at Rosehill was followed last Saturday by a classy long-neck win in the Group 2 Silver Slipper Stakes, which has pushed him high into markets for the coveted Golden version later this autumn.

"Miss Interiors is just a machine," Copelin says. "She didn't do much on the racetrack, but just looking at the mare in front of us at the sale - she was big, really physically impressive, and exactly the type of speed mare we wanted."

"We searched the whole catalogue and nothing compared to her physically. Plus, we

already had foals on the ground by Deep Field, and we liked the look of them.

"We did take a bit of a risk in paying that much for her, but you'd have to say she's going pretty well. Her first foal is a winner who's placed at Group 1, and her second foal's a stakes-winner at two, so you can't do much better than that."

Considering Russian Revolution had long since retired, the leap in yearling price between his half-sister's two sons - from \$260,000 to in 2019 for Aysar to \$875,000 a year later for Home Affairs - speaks volumes.

"Home Affairs was just this awesome looking horse from day one," Copelin says. "At the sales everyone just snapped their heads back at him when he walked past."

"He's huge. He weighed about 560 kilograms in his yearling prep, and he's just so powerful all over. He's a horse who really takes your breath away."

In fact, hinting at his temperament and durability, there was more than one yearling prep involved. The colt was en route to last year's Magic Millions sale on the Gold Coast when he injured himself on the truck, sustaining a gash to his hock. He was rested, then given another prep for the Easter sale.

"Probably a good thing he hurt himself in January rather than on the way to a late sale like Easter," Copelin says with a smile she can now well afford.

"We were happy with the price, given it was an online sale. In a live sale we might have got a million for him, because he's so impressive to look at, but we're certainly not complaining."

Not now.

Copelin explains she chose I Am Invincible because "I like to give our young mares the best chance to get up and running." As it happens, of all the stats collected by the great and prolific sire, Flying Spur mares represent his most successful nick, with a striking 26 winners from 29 runners all time, including two other stakes winners besides Home Affairs in Parlophone and Vinicunca.

Given the huge size of Home Affairs, and likewise Aysar, she opted for the smaller Capitalist for Miss Interiors' third foal, a "brilliant, strong colt" who'll be offered this Easter.

The similarly compact Dundee is the sire of Miss Interiors' fourth colt now on the ground.

She's in foal to that \$66,000 sire again, but it's likely the blend with I Am Invincible - now \$209,000 a go - will be tried again.

"The physicality was the idea in going to Capitalist and Dundee, but I imagine after this Dundee she can go to I Am Invincible for the rest of her life!" Copelin says.

"He is a bigger stallion, but it doesn't matter because now we know the offspring can run."

"And with his service fee, we couldn't have kept going to I Am Invincible until the mare had proved herself, but she's certainly done that now."

Woodside Park REFINES ITS Direction in Victoria

JO MCKINNON SPEAKS TO WOODSIDE PARK PRINCIPAL MARK ROWSTHORN

Earlier this month it was announced that James Price would be leaving his role as CEO of Woodside Park Stud at the end of the financial year as part of a major restructure at the leading Victorian farm that will see them vacate their traditional base at Tylden which is home to stallions Tosen Stardom (Deep Impact), Foxwedge (Fastnet Rock), Rich Enuff (Written Tycoon) and Cable Bay (Invincible Spirit). Jo Mckinnon spoke with Woodside Park's owner Mark Rowsthorn about his vision for the future, and posed the burning question, will champion stallion Written Tycoon (Iglesia), who once stood at Woodside Park, remain at Arrowfield Stud in the Hunter Valley next season or make a return to Victoria >>

In the wake of the recent announcement can you explain a bit more about your plans for Woodside Park moving forward?

Essentially, when I took over from my father five years ago we had four properties and it was always an immediate term objective to get down to one. Critical to that was the purchase of Morningside at Nagambie from Bill Burns which is now one one and a half years ago.

It's a wonderful property and historically has grown some great yearlings. It makes sense given it's the only freehold property we have that we would end up there.

In relation to the racing facility, Eddie Hirsch has done some really impressive improvements to the track and infrastructure and the breeding operation down the road at

Central Road we sold the freehold to Fulton Hogan, our neighbour with the quarry, and we lease it back. Part of that arrangement was that we could give notice and depart with six months notice.

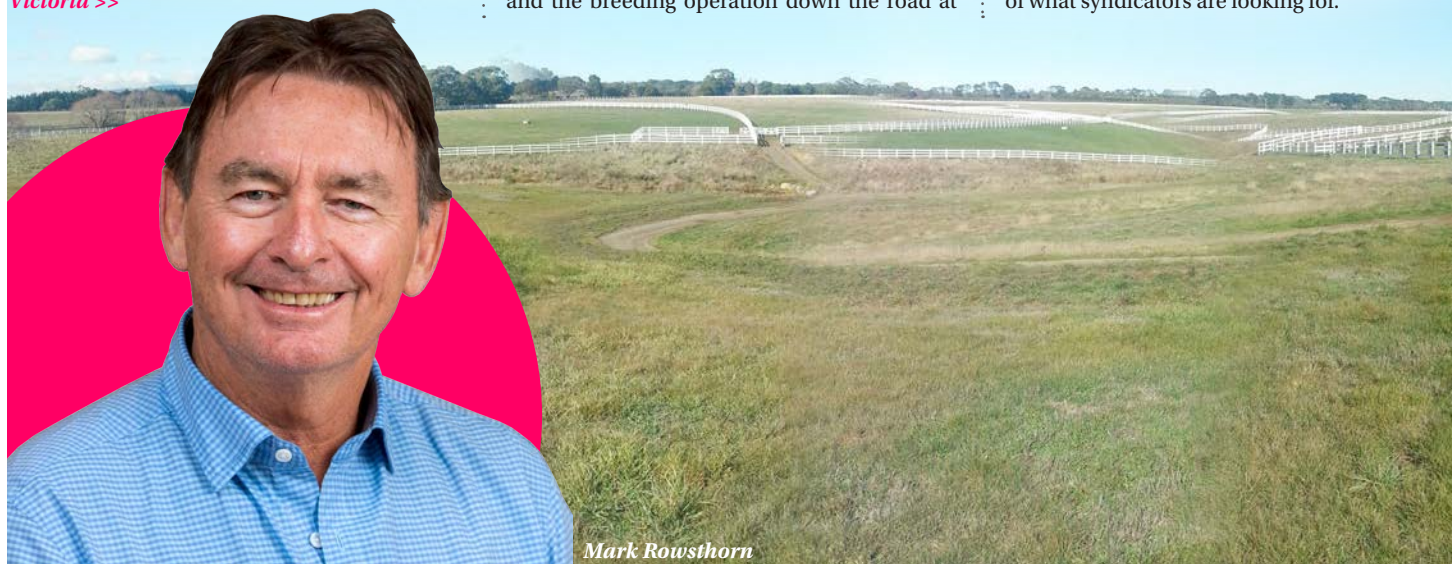
Our plan is to relocate the activities there such as the stallions standing at the barn, while mares and foals when they are weaned off will go up to Morningside to be grown out for weanling and primarily yearling sales.

The timing of that move is still up in the air and it depends on planning and so forth in terms of getting the facilities up and running by August this year. We have flexibility that we stay at Tylden for another stallion season and transfer over if there is too much stress involved in getting ready on time. I'd rather get things right.

Obviously, this is a period of serious refinement?

I think that's a good way of describing it. It's about getting more focussed and pitching ourselves at the pointy end. That's where we need to be. You look at the sales results at that elite end and you need to breed to the highly commercial stallions, the successful stallions that have a propensity to breed stakes winners and black-type horses.

You should support first season sires, but if you don't get that right and you don't have the right mare with the right page and the right type you are really punished. It's just a waste of time in terms of profitability on a per unit basis. You have to get every bit of it right. The right pedigrees, the right types and be mindful of what syndicators are looking for.

So how will things now work on the management side of things at Woodside Park?

Will, my eldest son, will take over at Morningside. He's been ready for a while and with James bringing some skills on the sales side and presentation and communication and marketing, he's learned a lot about the other side of the trade and the things that breeders think about and the challenges they have.

It's been terrific for James and us. Going forward Will, and my other son Tom, will be involved. Will will run more of the cattle and cropping on the farm. We have 1,000 acres at Morningside and equine takes a quarter of the preparation.

There are other interests that we are growing there. We have Ben Gunn who is a fantastic stallion guy and Matt Upton will continue to rear our young horses.

They are great young people. James taught them some stuff and I will now get more involved in this transition period. They are young, enthusiastic and skilled.

It's a smaller team than what we had. The staff piece is challenging for the industry. With younger people more mobile they are harder to keep. You have to keep training them and keep them interested and that includes the stable hands and even maintenance people and the handlers. It's really hard to keep those roles in place in smaller businesses. I think that is one of the bigger challenges and

frustrations in the breeding industry is that it's hard to find and retain good people.

In summary, it's a more family focussed and boutique operation. We have had a history of partners in mares and now we are less inclined to do that and do our own things.

We want to keep it simple and push for the highest quality we can and we have got the people to do that and continue to improve our mare band and continue to stand stallions on the basis they continue to be profitable.

It's not a complete pivot but a refinement of what we want to do; to make it more sustainable and fun and do a bit more racing like Rick (Jamieson) at Gilgai and Robert Crabtree down the road. They tend to have 50 or so mares, race a few and buy fillies.

I have developed friendships with those guys in the area and Gerry Ryan too.

It's not going to be as big and complicated with the burden of partnerships in horses. We are keeping it simple.

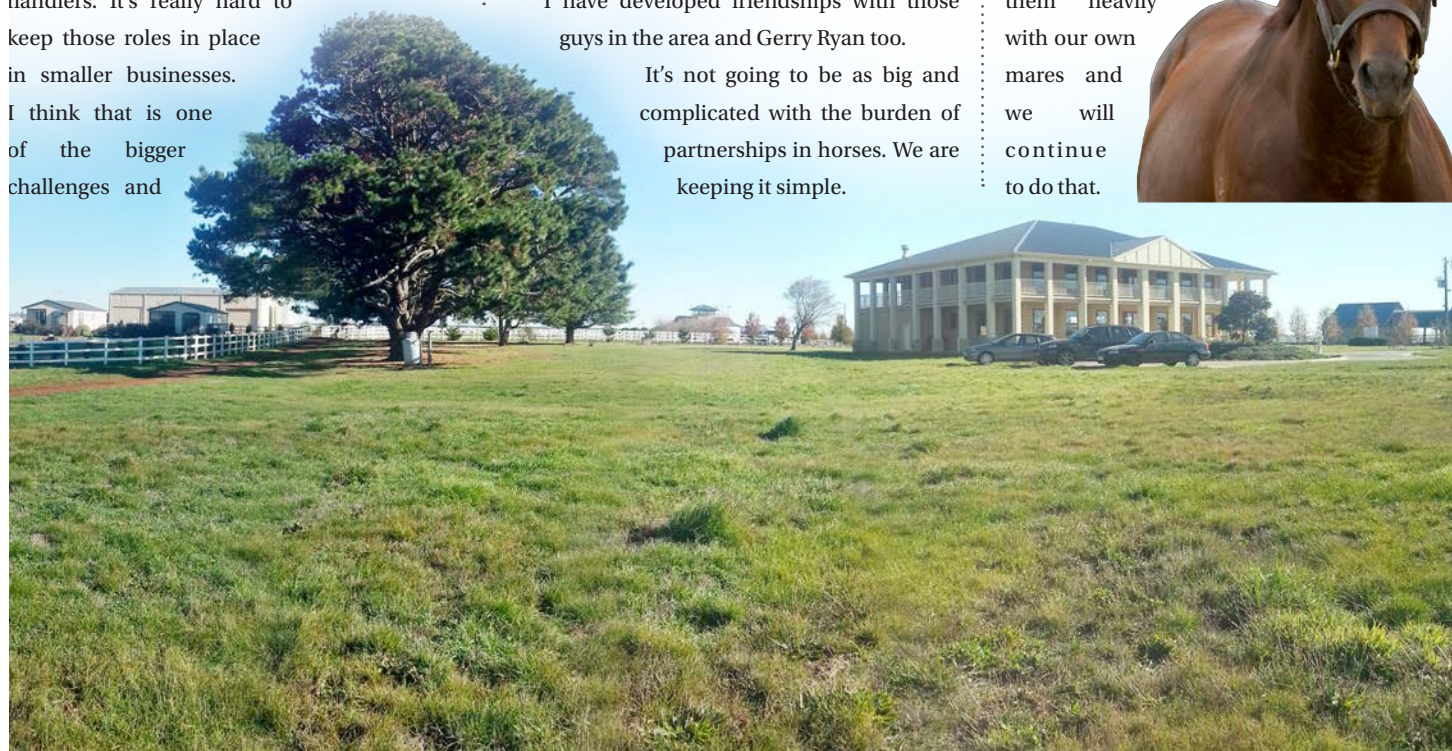
How committed are you to standing stallions in the future?

The plan is to transfer all the stallions across to Morningside and we will stay in that business while it is profitable and sustainable.

With stallions, it's intensely competitive. We have been incredibly lucky with Written Tycoon, who is going from strength to strength. And we have Zoustar in an arrangement with Widden Stud which is now finalised.

Rich Enuff is showing some early success which we are really pleased about, Cable Bay is starting to get two-year-olds on the track while Tosen Stardom is still to do that but there's still time for those guys.

We have supported them heavily with our own mares and we will continue to do that.



The decision to move Written Tycoon to Arrowfield Stud in the Hunter Valley certainly polarised the Victorian breeding industry last year. He's having an enormous season on the racetrack so far and been supported with some high quality mares since the big move. Will he remain in the Hunter Valley or return to Victoria?

I only contemplated the move because John Messara reached out and showed some interest with the pensioning of Not A Single Doubt and he was keen to get an outcross into his ranks.

Written Tycoon, the year before had been quite quiet on the track and I just felt from ours and the shareholders perspective that we would have been better off giving the stallion a new lease on life. John committed 35 of his elite mares to him so it was just a shot in the arm the horse needed for a year.

The dam is one from one with her progeny on the track, with the Mathew Ellerton and Mark Zahra-trained Part Time Lover (Zoustar), a \$130,000 buy from this sale in 2017, becoming a recent city winner.

The decision on where he will stand isn't finalised yet and there will be an announcement obviously because it's pretty newsworthy. There's been lots of rumours, is he going or staying.

John would like to get the horse. He had a fantastic breeding year and John said he thinks it's a world record for an 18-year-old stallion that he got 171 mares in foal. Hopefully they all stick but historically that's an extraordinary result. He's a terrific old campaigner and he's still got a twinkle in his eye.

At the end of the day, he will end up standing where it makes the most sense for all the shareholders. Sheriff Iskander owns 40 per cent, I have 20 per cent and rest is made up by other shareholders.

It's a critical decision because, off the back of Ole Kirk and others, his fee will

obviously go up and we will have to limit the number of mares he takes on.

You would think he's in the top two or three stallions in the country. It's tough in Victoria because most of his customer base, historically since his fee rose to \$50,000 plus, has come from the Hunter Valley.

There's the elite end of the Victorian market that have supported him but most of the support base comes from NSW.

What are your views about the state of play with racing in Victoria?

It's been amazing. I think it's critical for the breeding industry that racing is successful and continues to be.

That push and shove with Victoria and NSW has improved the offering and that's terrific. Now we are more inclined to stay in horses or, if we breed a fantastic filly, we will stay in it and race it.

We haven't done that so much in the past and it's been more a case of clearing the decks but now we want to align ourselves with

our buyers more than we have in the past, which is something we need to do, especially with the leading trainers return support and commitment to them and hopefully it's something we can do and have success with and enjoy.



Has the COVID-19 pandemic impacted on business at Woodside Park in any way?

In the stallion business we rely on seasonal people. There are a lot of Kiwi, French and English people who have a dual hemisphere career and they are missed and that's made it hard for getting those roles in, which are critical.

We have had to rely on our own people being trained up and doing different things. It's been difficult for

everyone, not so much on the farm but I'm talking in general.

I feel like there's such a gloom over Melbourne and it's become the new normal. I love getting up to the farm and being relieved of all that restriction.

I think the racing industry has done a great job in maintaining the races and it's kept a lot of the avid supporters sane through the whole thing. It's been therapeutic watching the racing, it's a shame there are no crowds there but I'm sure that will emerge shortly.

Our latest Flying Start blog comes from Lowri Allen, 25, from Bristol, England. Lowri graduated from Cardiff University in 2016 with a BSc in Chemistry. Alongside her university studies, she was also an exercise rider for trainer Robert Stephens. She completed the British Horse Racing Graduate Development Programme in 2016, undertaking her work placement at the BHA.

Prior to commencing Godolphin Flying Start, she spent three years working at the BHA, where she was first based in the Communications and Corporate Affairs department, as Plus 10 Executive, and later as a Project Officer working across the Equine Health and Welfare, Anti-doping and Integrity and Regulation departments.

The Godolphin Flying Start Programme offers a unique opportunity to spend time working in and learning about the thoroughbred industry in five major racing jurisdictions: Ireland, Britain, America, Australia and Dubai. The 2019-2021 cohort are currently based in Australia and are mid-way through completing externships at trainers, sales houses, bloodstock agents and industry organisations.

The Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale - one of Australia's premier yearling sales - kicked off 2021. We spent what was an incredible two weeks at the Queensland sale and its associated events.

I spent my time shadowing bloodstock agent Will Johnson, who I had previously joined for his pre-sale inspections in the Hunter Valley.

Will was mainly buying for Australia's leading syndicator, Darby Racing Syndicates, and bought a number of exciting prospects who have proven popular among their members

and are currently in pre-training.

My time with Will and the Darby team was both educational and enjoyable. During the course of the inspections, I learnt a great deal from Will about purchasing horses for syndication, assessing pedigrees and physical, as well as how to produce high quality marketing materials which best promote horses to clients.

Each Godolphin Flying Start trainee also spent a day with the Magic Millions team, where we assisted with yearling inspections, bid-spotting and sales day paperwork. The bid-spotting was a real thrill and highly entertaining.

As a group, we had the privilege of meeting Katie Page-Harvey, the owner of Magic Millions. A highly successful businesswoman, Katie has been instrumental in developing ideas which highlight and promote the important roles played by women in the racing and breeding industries.

We also attended the Magic Millions raceday which was headlined by the 2YO Classic for Magic Millions graduates. The Classic features a Racing Women's Bonus of \$500,000 which is on offer to the first four all-female owned or leased horses in finishing order in the Magic Millions Classic and is in addition to the prize-money of \$2,000,000.

This has been a popular incentive and has resulted in women's interest in racehorse ownership growing since its inception.

Following on from the Magic Millions sale, I started a seven-week externship with Ciaron Maher Racing's Warwick Farm Stables, which is led by Godolphin Flying Start graduate, Jack Bruce, in his role as assistant trainer.

My mornings were spent watching trackwork with Jack and racing manager, Johann Gerard-Dubord. It is a busy and exciting time of year with many of the horses gearing up for the Sydney Autumn Carnival.

I also enjoyed working with Ciaron's bloodstock team - Will Bourne, Sam White and Gabrielle Nutt - who I joined for Inglis Classic Yearling Sale's pre-sale inspections in the Southern Highlands and Hunter Valley and then at the sale at the beginning of February. Through my time with the team, I learnt about Ciaron Maher Racing's client communication, marketing and sales-day processes.

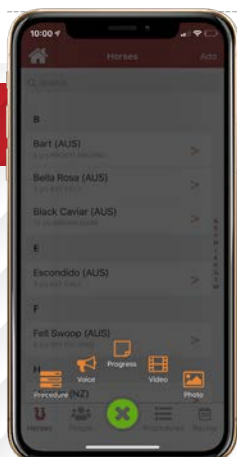
