Maher and Eustace celebrate career best season

Sales investment pays dividends for powerful duo as business continues to grow

t has been a fruitful season for the ever powerful stable of Ciaron Maher and David Eustace, highlighted by the feats of star fillies Loving Gaby (I Am Invincible) and Away Game (Snitzel), but it certainly hasn't come by chance.

In the last two seasons, the pair's operation

has doubled in size with the acquisition of Darren Weir's Ballarat property, as well as opening a satellite stable at Warwick Farm in Sydney.

It took a little while for Maher and Eustace to figure out how to manage the rapid growth of the business, but now that they have, the pair have their sights set on their first Victoria Training Premiership title.

"We went through a lot of change, the stable grew a lot through the addition of the Ballarat stable and it's just been about consolidating.

"Our two-year-olds have been fantastic, Loving Gaby and the rest of our three-year-olds have been very good and our jumpers have been fantastic as well.

"So right across the board we're very happy with that consistency

and with the team across various locations all working really well together and getting the results."

In the last couple of seasons, the stable has put a lot of time and effort into targeting the rich juvenile races which started with spending big at the 2019 yearling sales.

At last year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sales alone, Ciaron Maher Bloodstock themselves signed for 19 lots and teamed up with operations

such as Aquis Farm and First Light Racing to purchase several other expensive yearlings.

Among those purchases were metropolitan winners Anders (Not A Single Doubt), who was bought for \$670,000 in conjunction with Aquis Farm, Grand Slam (Myboycharlie), who cost \$600,000 and is the brother to Maher's dual Group 1 winner Jameka, Unstoppabelle (I Am Invincible), a \$320,000 buy, and Amish Boy (Star Witness), a \$300,000 purchase who took out the Magic Millions Adelaide 2YO Classic (1200m). *Continued on page 4>>*

<< Continued from page 2 Throw in the feats of Away Game, Prague (Redoute's Choice), and the fact they managed to get six runners into the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) and four into the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), and the investment into precocious types at the yearling sales seems to have paid off.

"We're very happy with the two-year-olds," Maher said. "They've been fantastic.

"It has paid off (yearling sale purchases) with the year we've had with them (two-year-olds) and they're now going to progress into three-yearolds and they should have a good year.

"We've stocked up again, we've got a similar amount of yearlings coming in. We bought 72 this year.

"That was the reason we got a stable in Sydney. One, because we wanted to get access to the better bred colts and fillies and two, just to be able to place our horses where suitable, so we'll look to build on Sydney."

With bases at Caulfield, Ballarat and Sydney, plus the use of the beach in Balnarring and an expanding property at Pakenham, there's not much left for Maher and Eustace to add to their set up although that hasn't deterred their ambition to improve.

"We're pretty happy location-wise and facilities-wise, but you can always improve," Maher said. "You never stop improving in terms of

technology and the way you do things and all that, but we are very happy with what we've got and how we're going."

Looking ahead, Maher still has his sights set on winning that elusive Golden Slipper but his goals don't stop there.

"We've got a lot of good Europeans and hopefully we can win a Melbourne Cup," he said. "That would be a goal obviously.

"The Slipper, the last couple

of years we've been fourth (Loving Gaby) and second (Away Game) so that's still a big focus."

As we edge closer to the start of the new season, preparations for the spring have well and truly begun in the Maher and Eustace camp and they are set to be represented in a number of feature races.

Reigning Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) and William Reid Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Loving Gaby is, unsurprisingly, on a path to the \$14 million Everest (1200m), with a tilt at the \$7.5 million Golden Eagle (1500m) also on the cards.

Away Game is being set for the Coolmore Stud Stakes (registered as Ascot Vale Stakes) (Gr 1, 1200m) with the possibility of trying to emulate her stablemate in the Manikato, while Prague is heading towards the Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m).

Schweppervescence Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) winner Holyfield (I Am Invincible) is likely to head to the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m), and Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) scorer Etah James (Raise The Flag) is on track for the Metropolitan (Gr 1, 2400m) before hopefully gaining a berth in the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m).

With their investment in this year's yearling sales series just as high as what it was in 2019, Maher and Eustace will also surely be featuring in the early season juvenile events, and who knows what other untapped stock they've got up their sleeve for the rest of the spring?

Sansom set for WFA test in Bletchingly

Phillip Stokes believes today's Bletchingly Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Caulfield presents a late-season opportunity to test Sansom (Charm Spirit) with a view to the future in the gelding's final week as a three-year-old. "I feel like he's going really well, he's just been carrying big weights," Stokes said. "He's been consistent every time he has gone around this preparation without winning. He's on the back-up, he's very fit and he handles all conditions. This will probably give us a good guide on where he goes in the future. At the weights he's probably not that well suited taking on those seasoned horses, but I just thought I'd like to throw him in the deep end, which I haven't really done yet, and just see where he's at. He's a four-year-old soon, so this will tell us where he lies against the big boys."

Yargi puts faith in I'm Telling Ya

Despite being the outsider of the field, co-trainer Amy Yargi believes I'm Telling Ya (Reward For Effort) can put up a bold showing in today's Bletchingly Stakes. "I think he'll run a cheeky race this weekend, you'd be mad to leave him out of your first four," Yargi told Racing.com. "There's genuine pace in Saturday's race with the likes of Jungle Edge and I think a few of the backmarkers, including us and Widgee Turf, shouldn't be underestimated. I know our guy will do his best work late and will put in the honest effort he always does and I think he'll be right there in the finish strong to the line as he's consistently shown. He's ready to go, he likes the back-up and he'll fly home and apart from last week he's been very consistent and has a high placing strike-rate, I'd be watching for him late."

Mystery Shot set for five in row

Lindsey Smith believes there is still more to come from the unbeaten Mystery Shot (Shooting To Win) who will attempt to make it five wins in a row when he lines up in the Super Vobis 3YO Handicap (1400m) at Caulfield. The gelding won his latest race by an eased down two and a half lengths and Smith had an ominous warning for today's rivals. "My gut tells me that he may have gone up a notch to be honest," the trainer told Racing.com. "He's going to the races in a good frame of mind, he's super fit, he's drawn a great gate, he's got a better track, which I think will help him (and) he's well weighted."

Maher and Eustace pair to clash at Caulfield

Also looking to extend a winning run on the Caulfield card is the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained Persan (Pierro) who will make it four on the bounce if he can get the better of his nine rivals in the Mark Needham Handicap

(2394m). Persan rises from 59.5 kilograms to 62 kilograms and Eustace said: "I think Persan will be fine carrying the weight. He's in really good order and has trained on beautifully. The three weeks between runs with the busy schedule is ideal for him." Maher and Eustace also have another inform runner in the field in the shape of the hat-trick seeking High Emocean (Ocean Park) who Eustace rates as the main danger to her stablemate. "High Emocean I think will actually give him a run for his money. She's getting eight kilos off him and a bit of time between runs definitely suits her. I think she will run very well too."

Prince confident in outsider

The Mick Price and Michael Kent Jr team will be doubly represented in another race on the Caulfield card when stablemates Sensationalisation (Written Tycoon) and Write The Score (Written Tycoon) contest the VOBIS Gold Ingot (1400m). Although the bookmakers favour the chances of the first named, it is the latter Price is leaning towards. "She (Write The Score) possibly should have won at Moe last start," he told Racing.com. "She's a bit more robust, while Sensationalisation is a bit of an immature sort of filly. They had a nice gallop together on Tuesday and last Saturday, they're both ready to go, I could be wrong, but I think Write The Score might finish a bit harder."

Weight relief the key to Folly

A three kilogram drop in the weights should counter the rise in the class for Lake's Folly (Pierro) when he takes his chance in the \$108,000 Neds Money Back Handicap (1400m) at Caulfield, according to assistant trainer Sam Freedman. "He's a nice horse that appreciates give in the track. He's probably a horse that has had to carry a bit of weight in his previous starts, so he should drop down in the weights," Freedman, assistant to his father Anthony Freedman, told Racing.com. "It's a step-up in class, but down in the weights he could run a cheeky race for sure. He seems to love a really heavy track, so it's the right time of year to test him in Saturday grade."

Denero eyeing more city success

Pakenham trainer Mick Huglin will attempt to build on his impressive metropolitan strikerate when Denero (Pierro) runs in the opening Benchmark 78 handicap (1600m) at Caulfield. Huglin has struck with two of his three city runners this year but he admits the lightly raced five-year-old faces a tough task if he is to build on that stat. "It's a hard race - he's going up in class, up in weight and he's drawn a bad gate for him," Huglin told Racing.com. "He's got Craig Williams on and he's going to need some luck from the draw - he could be buried back on the fence - but he's definitely going well enough to figure for sure."

Prince on song for Winter Challenge

If Invictus Prince (Dansili) was any other horse, Matthew Smith might dare to be bullish about his chances in the Winter Challenge (Listed, 1500m) at Rosehill today. But like

punters, Smith has been burned too many times. Invictus Prince showed enormous promise to be Group 1 placed behind Winx (Street Cry) at just his third Australian start in 2018. But his subsequent journey has been stop-start and the seven-year-old is yet to win outside Europe, with his enigmatic ways a source of frustration for connections and punters alike. "I'm really happy with him but punters don't want to hear it, they're sick of the horse, the owners are probably sick of the horse," Smith said. "But I reckon he is cherry-ripe for Saturday. His trial was brilliant, he looks great, his work has been good and he gets the right draw, finally."

Bowman back to begin carnival build up

Refreshed from a break, top jockey Hugh Bowman returns to Sydney racing at Rosehill with a strong book of rides, highlighted by Winter Challenge favourite Mugatoo (Henrythenavigator). Today's meeting will be Bowman's first since mid-June as he begins his build up towards the upcoming season's carnival races. Bowman had been riding in fine form prior to taking time out to recharge his batteries, notching a winning double at his last appearance at Randwick on June 20. He sits fourth on the Sydney jockeys' premiership with 69 victories and gets a prime opportunity to add to that haul at Rosehill where seven of his eight rides are at single-figure odds.

Forster and Marshall chasing juvenile double

Desleigh Forster and Taylor Marshall will be out to build on their punter-friendly partnership at Doomben this afternoon. Marshall has ridden 12 winners for Forster at a 20 per cent success rate, with the duo showing a staggering \$198 profit on a \$1 the win unit on each of their runners. Today, they combine with Boom Spender (Spirit Of Boom) in the 2YO Colts & Geldings Handicap (1200m) and Eelloh (Better Than Ready) in the 2YO Fillies Handicap (1200m). Forster spelled Eelloh straight after a win at the Sunshine Coast in April, a move which has given the filly time to mature. "She improved

out of sight in a short time last preparation, she has had a good spell and trialled OK," the trainer said. "She just has a tricky barrier (10) on Saturday." Boom Spender, meanwhile, has drawn barrier five for his second run back from a spell. "He was good when second first-up and I said before that run he was wanting the run," Forster added.

Schweida hoping for Doomben treble

Also on the hunt for more winners at Doomben is Kelly Schweida who will rely on two rising stars and a stable stalwart. Schweida will saddle promising two-year-olds Acrobatic (Snitzel) in the Welcome Back to BRC QTIS Colts & Geldings Handicap (1200m) and Fleet Dove (Not A Single Doubt) in the Quincy QTIS 2YO Handicap (1200m), while rising nine-year-old Outraged (Choisir) will be out to build on his recent fifth in the Glasshouse Handicap (Listed, 1400m), when he contests the TAB Long May We Play Open Handicap (1600m). "He swept around them and loomed up but eventually they were a bit slick for him at 1400," Schweida said of the 11-time winner's latest effort. At the other end of the spectrum, Acrobatic and Fleet Dove are both looking to add to their sole successes to date. "Acrobatic is a Snitzel horse and he was an impressive winner at the midweeks," Schweida continued. "I don't see why he wouldn't be up to a Saturday two-yearold race. Fleet Dove also has breeding on her side being by Not A Single Doubt."

Dream Master out for record booster

The consistent Dream Master (Dream Ahead) will be out to add to his tally of three wins and nine placings in his last 13 starts when he takes his chance in today's Benchmark 90 handicap (1050m) at Doomben. While acknowledging the six-year-old's consistency, co-trainer Toby Edmonds said Dream Master should have won more races in his 28 starts. "He could do a few things wrong which cost him wins," Edmonds, who trains in partnership with his son Trent, said. "He has had two trials this time and been beaten under a length in both. But he has a bad barrier (12) and will need a bit of luck."

The Spring Carnival may be edging ever closer, but Tony McEvoy is happy to remain in South Australia and leave his staff in charge of affairs at his Flemington base - at least for the time being. Although McEvoy could cross the border into Victoria, current restrictions would prevent him from returning to South Australia, unless he seeks government approval and completes a 14-day self-isolation period. "I'm desperate to get back to Melbourne but I'm certainly not going back while Victoria is in the state that it is at the moment," the trainer told Racing.com. "I can steer the ship from here for a bit longer. I've got very good staff, I trust them. I still do the trackwork schedules each day and those guys over there put it in place to the letter and whilst it's not ideal - you'd love to be seeing it for yourself in person - it's the next best thing with the videos and feedback we're getting."

Apprentice Lloyd out of hospital

Apprentice Jaden Lloyd is facing six weeks on the sidelines following his release from hospital after being injured in an incident during trackwork at Ballarat last Saturday. The 18-yearold sustained two fractures to his pelvis, a cracked rib and bruising on his spleen in the incident involving a filly trained by Matt Cumani. "I feel really lucky because, from the sounds of it, it could have been a lot worse," Lloyd told Racing.com. "I've never had surgery before, so it's a relief to not have had to have it this time around. Obviously it's a bit uncomfortable with a fractured pelvis, but it's the rib and spleen that have been more painful actually. It's mostly just frustrating not being able to be out there and ride, but I'll do everything I can to heal properly and concentrate on physio and getting back out there soon hopefully."

RV announce handicap updates

Racing Victoria yesterday announced updates to its handicapping policy due to ongoing impacts of the Covid-19 pandemic. RV has made changes to its policy regarding the minimum top weight at acceptance time, in light of the extension of the two kilogram weight allowance for riders beyond August 1, with the current minimum weight for Victorian races raised two kilograms to 56 kilograms until at least August 19. From the start of the new season until the Covid-19 weight allowance is removed, the top weight will be declared with a minimum of 60 kilograms upon release of the final field. Should the top-weighted acceptor have less than 60 kilograms, weights will be adjusted across the field.

NEW ZEALAND

Group 1 performer to make return

Group 1 performer Blue Breeze (Bullbars) will make his raceday return when he contests the Haunui Farm 1400 at Avondale today. The rising seven-year-old hasn't been the same since his Australian campaign last year, however, trainer Allan Morley believes he is on top of the gelding's issues now. "Since he came back from Australia it's almost like he said 'this is a cool place here, I would rather be here than Aussie," Morley said. "He has done very well, but he got galloped on in his last start and he injured a fetlock. This will be his first run since then and I am just a little bit worried about that."

Wigley turns to Matchmaker at Riccarton

Matchmaker (Makfi) is attracting plenty of interest ahead of her debut in the Barry Knudsen Dash (1000m) at Riccarton today. North Canterbury trainers Nick Wigley and Kayla Milnes produced Matchmaker for an impressive two-year-old 850-metre trial win at Rangiora earlier this month in easily the quickest time of the day. "She was a filly who we had entered for Karaka but she didn't pass the X-ray and we ended up keeping her," Wigley

said. "She had a cyst on her hind leg but that doesn't seem to be worrying her. She did it pretty easily in the trial. She just cruised up to those horses and won nicely. She'll have one run now then have a wee let up. We think she's a Guineas filly so we'll give her a break and then head her in that direction."

Savabeel 3YOs deliver double for McCullum

Former Black Caps captain Brendon McCullum is set to head off on his travels as a globetrotting Twenty20 coach buoyed by the recent success of a pair of winning three-year-olds he is involved in. McCullum was at Te Rapa last Saturday to see a stylish come-frombehind victory by Tabata (Savabeel), while two days later, Blesk (Savabeel), who he owns a part-share in, won at Goulburn. "She was outstanding," McCullum said of Tabata. "I really thought she was gone about halfway down the straight. Hopefully there might be a bit more to come from her on the track, and then she could make a nice broodmare later on as well. We don't want to get too carried away, but when you've got a nice Savabeel filly from Waikato Stud, you know you're off to a good start."

INTERNATIONAL

First for Muhaarar

Shadwell Stud's Muhaarar (Oasis Dream) sired his first ever stakes winner when Paix (3 f ex Pacifique by Montjeu) proved too strong for her rivals in the Prix Frederic de Lagrange (Listed, 2400m) at Vichy yesterday. Now the winner of two of her four starts, the Francis Graffard-trained filly beat Mykiss (Makfi) by two and a half lengths, with another five lengths back to Control Tower (Youmzain) in third. A €250,000 purchase as a yearling, Paix is the fourth foal of the Group 3-winning Montjeu (Sadler's Wells) mare Pacifique, who herself is a half-sister to Prudenzia (Zafonic), the dam of Mackinnon Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Magic Wand (Galileo) and Irish Oaks (Gr 1, 1m 4f) winner Chicquita (Montjeu). Four-time Group 1 winning sprinter Muhaarar, whose first crop included the Group-placed pair Unforgetable and Albaflora, stood at Shadwell's Nunnery Stud for a fee of £20,000 in 2020.

Graffard and jockey Pierre-Charles Boudot went on to complete a Listed race double on the Vichy card when success for Les Vertus (4 f ex Loshad by Lomitas) in the Prix Jacques de Bremond (Listed, 1600m) provided Shakespearean (Shamardal) with his first stakes winner. Now the winner of five of her 11 starts, Les Vertus beat Alfieri (Naaqoos) by a length and a quarter, with Manjeer (Footstepsinthesand) another nose away in third. Hungerford Stakes (Gr 2, 7f) winner Shakespearean formerly stood at Haras de la Barbottiere in France.

Four for Bungle Inthejungle

Rathasker Stud resident Bungle Inthejungle (Exceed And Excel) landed his fourth stakes winner when Acapulco Gold (2 f ex Velvet Revolver by Mujahid) took out the Prix des Reves d'Or (Listed, 1000m) at Vichy on Thursday evening. The two-year-old filly defeated Night Hunting (Amarillo) by two and a half lengths with Pietra Giallo (Evasive) coming home a


