## Gangemis' Magic touch with tried horses on show in Winterbottom

*Life left in veterans as trio line up in Perth's \$1 million feature*

Perth-based brothers Chris and Michael Gangemi have made an artform out of raiding eastern-state stables searching for relative diamonds in the rough in order to uncover horses capable of being rejuvenated in the west.

The exercise has been rather lucrative for the West Australia training partners who could have up to three runners, all of them

tried horses sourced from NSW or Victoria, in Saturday's Winterbottom Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Ascot.

Gangemi-trained veterans Rock Magic (Redoute's Choice), a former Arrowfield-owned gelding who has won 12 races and had multiple Group 1 placings since switching stables, and nine-year-old near \$1 million earner Durendal (Medaglia d'Oro) are guaranteed starts in the \$1 million feature sprint.

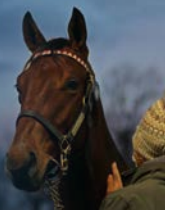

Relative stable newcomer Condor Heroes (Not A Single Doubt), a former Sun Stud-raced six-year-old gelding, is the emergency for the Winterbottom having already paid his new owners back "tenfold" since being purchased for just \$10,000 in October last year.

The Gangemis' trio all clashed last start in the Colonel Reeves Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) at Ascot last Saturday week when striking a heavy track.

Rock Magic, Durendal and Condor Heroes ran fifth, sixth and eighth respectively.

The wet track counted against Rock Magic, according to Michael Gangemi, and he is positive the 11-year-old can run another big race in the Winterbottom, having ran third in 2016 and again last year.

"Jarrad (Noske, jockey) said that he travelled into it but that he just couldn't hit that top gear that he's got, so we're really looking forward to getting him on top of the ground this week again," Gangemi told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday.

"It was only 12 months ago when he ran fourth in a Manikato behind Loving Gaby and behind Hey Doc in a Winterbottom, and he's only 12 months older than that, He's 11 but if he managed to do that at ten there's no reason why he can't do it again at 11."

In 2014, a deal was negotiated between the Gangemis and Arrowfield's John and Paul Messara, who was training Rock Magic at the time, and the new owners have enjoyed a tremendous ride ever since.

"He was a Redoute's Choice who had shown a really good form early, but then he dropped right off the boil at his last few and he'd had a few issues," Gangemi recalled.

"He was the sort of profile we look for - a horse who had shown a lot but gone off the boil. We were lucky enough to get him back and he has just been a Godsend to the family and all his owners for a long period of time.

"He's taken everyone on an amazing ride. He has run fourth in a Newmarket, fourth in a Manikato, a William Reid, a Lightning Stakes. Third in two Winterbottoms, second in a Schillaci, if anyone deserves to win a Winterbottom, it is probably him."

Durendal, a horse initially raced by prominent Victorian owner-breeder David Moodie and trained by Mathew Ellerton and Simon Zahra, has also been a good investment for the Gangemis.

"He always takes a few runs to come right and, now that he is older, he's taken even longer but he wanted to do it the other day," Gangemi continued.

"He showed he had that zest back for racing and we wanted to see that because his first two runs this preparation were pretty plain, but we were really happy with his run the other day and he doesn't really stretch out on the heavy, either. *Continued on page 4>>*

"He's only small and he's up in the ratings, so he always has to carry weight and he needs things to go his way in races. He is just shy of a million dollars in prize-money, so he's been a super horse."

As for Condor Heroes, a sprinter who spent time firstly with Gerald Ryan before a brief stint at Lindsay Park, has already put his new owners in front.

He led the Colonel Reeves field up before tiring late.

Gangemi said: "He has several issues and it's very hard to get runs into him and get him fit, which probably told on him last start, but he had also missed the Prince Of Wales and he had missed a few weeks' work as well.

"But now that he has got that 1100-metre run on a bog track under him, I expect him to improve dramatically from a fitness point of view Saturday."

While there is arguably now more competition from buyers seeking tried horses than there was previously, Gangemi says the digitisation of the marketplace has helped them find more horses to syndicate.

"To be honest, it was a lot harder previously because they were only (being sold) through a few bloodstock agents and it was really hard to find a nice one," he said.

"We have a good relationship with Arrowfield where we bought a few of their tried horses with a fair bit of success, and that is where Rocky (Rock Magic) came from.

"But just recently, with these online digital platforms with Inglis Digital, Gavelhouse and places like that, it makes these tried horses more available, but you've still got to sift through to find the diamonds amongst them."

The brothers rely on some trusted contacts to help them identify the right candidates they believe they can turn around and others who are unlikely to meet their criteria.

"We have a lot of mates over east, which comes in handy, so we ask them a lot of questions. We ask around and see what we can find out," he said.

"There's certain things we know that we can't fix and there are certain things that we might be able to patch up, so it comes down to horses for courses. There are certain things we try to avoid, particularly if they have had certain injuries.

"We don't win them all but we have managed to have a little bit of success."

At the other end of the scale, the Gangemis are also behind King's Troop (Redoute's Choice) - another tried horse purchase from Arrowfield Stud whose career did not reach the heights in Perth of his stablemates - but his pedigree demanded he find a home at stud.

Runner-up to subsequent Group 1 winner Japonisme (Choisir) at his first start as a two-year-old, he was also runner-up to the same horse at three in the San Domenico Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) before another seven runs for Sydney trainer Gerald Ryan before being sold to the Gangemis.

He ran three times, all at Listed level, in Perth before being retired to Oakland Park Stud in 2017 where he has covered small books of mares.

"We bought him off Arrowfield and he had a couple of runs over here in the west, but unfortunately he succumbed to an injury," says Gangemi.

"Being a three-quarter brother to Snitzel, there was definitely no blood like him over here in the west, so we thought we'd stand him.

"He's thrown some unbelievable types and his oldest are two-year-olds at the moment and there's massive raps on them already.

"He hasn't had any triallers or runners yet, but we've got a couple and we're taking our time as we've got a massive opinion of them."

## AUSTRALIA

### TRSA boosts prize-money levels

Thoroughbred Racing South Australia (TRSA) yesterday announced that as of December 1, prize-money levels in the state will return to their minimum level before the Covid-19 pandemic struck. The new arrangements also include an increase equal to the riding fee deduction. "We have watched as wagering revenue has stabilised since the first round of reductions in federal stimulus packages such as JobKeeper and JobSeeker and that has given us the confidence to increase prize-money levels back to pre-Covid-19 levels," TRSA chair Rob Rorrison said. "The board has also taken feedback from stakeholders into account regarding the riding fee deduction. While the riding fee deduction needs to remain, we are further increasing prize-money and

the unplaced subsidy by an amount equal to the riding fee at a cost of approximately \$2.6 million per year." The announcement was welcomed by Tony McEvoy of McEvoy Mitchell Racing. "Prize-money is the lifeblood of our industry; it pays the wages and helps drive confidence levels across the racing community," he said. "To have prize-money trending back upwards in South Australia is fantastic news and underlines the importance of the steps taken by TRSA and the relevant health authorities in keeping racing going through the pandemic. It's also great to see that TRSA has recognised the industry's feedback around the riding fee deduction."



### Rising star Pacific set for Winterbottom test

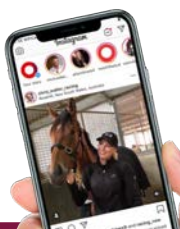
Neville Parnham believes Indian Pacific (Zoustar) is ready to tackle elite company for the first time as he prepares to saddle the six-time scorer in Saturday's Winterbottom Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Ascot. A neck winner of the Crawford Stakes (Listed, 1000m) on October 17, Indian Pacific was last seen running third in the Colonel Reeves Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) earlier in the month, beaten three-quarters of a length by Celebrity Queen (Redoute's Choice). "It's not going to be an easy race, it will be tough, but I think he will be up to it," Parnham told The Races WA. "It's certainly going to be his biggest test to date, but he will be up to the mark. His work has been really impeccable and I couldn't be any happier with him. He goes in in very good order and will be peaking for Saturday. He is a horse that is on the way up." Indian Pacific worked with blinkers in a strong Ascot gallop yesterday morning, with Parnham considering a gear change for the four-year-old at the weekend. "I've been tempted to try the blinkers for a while," Parnham added. "He probably went too hard in them, so we'll have a think about that before making a final decision. He was strong all the way up the line. It was probably the best he has worked this time in."

## Through The Cracks on Villiers path

Angela Davies plans to test the Villiers Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) credentials of Through The Cracks (Wanted) when he lines up in the Festival Stakes (Gr 3, 1500m) at Rosehill on Saturday. The six-year-old, winner of the Provincial Championship Final (1400m) at Randwick in April, was last seen racking up some crucial ratings points with a customary late-driving success over 1300 metres at Newcastle on November 14. "It was an important win at Newcastle," Davies said. I felt under a bit of pressure as he needed to measure up that day and I was thrilled that he did. He ran a good time and he continues to take that upward step." Looking ahead, Davies added of the seven-time winner: "If he runs a nice race on Saturday then he'd have to be a lightweight chance for the Villiers. We hope he can maintain his sprint now that he is getting over a bit more ground. But he's nice and strong, maintaining his weight and recovering well from his races. He's definitely gone to another level."

## Pride sends Royal Witness south

Joe Pride has secured the services of leading rider Craig Williams for Royal Witness (Star Witness) as the five-year-old is set to return in Moonee Valley's Carlyon Stakes (Listed, 1000m) on Saturday. Royal Witness, who ran five times for Toby and Trent Edmonds when stationed in Queensland throughout the autumn and winter, will be having his first outing since July 4, with Pride opting to head to Sydney for the short-course journey as opposed to running his charge closer to home in Rosehill's Starlight Stakes (Listed, 1100m). "That extra 100 metres for him is a whole new world of pain. He might get it later on but at this stage he is a 1000-metre horse," Pride said. "I chased him (Williams) early. I've always had a good association with Craig and he has the faith that if I'm taking one south it's going to be a good, live chance. He was more than happy to take the ride for me and that gives me confidence because no-one does more homework than Craig." Royal Witness has prepared for his resumption with two barrier trial wins and Pride believes he is a sharper horse this time around. "I've seen him trial moderately then come back

and race well so to see him trial like he has gives me good confidence he has gone up a cog, which he needs to do because we're in Listed grade here on Saturday," he added.

## Sadler flags weight concern for Splendor

John Sadler has issued an upbeat bulletin on his Carlyon Stakes hopeful Sartorial Splendor (Brazen Beau), despite the four-year-old being forced to concede weight to horses rated 20 points higher than him. The \$140,000 Carlyon is a set-weights-and-penalties race in which Sartorial Splendor has been allocated 58.5 kilograms, meaning he will carry more weight than the 104-rated Coruscate (Exceed And Excel) (58 kilograms) and the 103-rated Prezado (Denman) (57 kilograms) having incurred a 1.5 kilogram penalty for his victory in the Red Anchor Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) in October 2019. "He is going to carry 58.5 kilograms, he's an 80-rated horse and he is going to be giving weight to horses that are rated 100-plus. It just doesn't make sense," Sadler told Racing.com. "The horse is really good. The reason he is going to The Valley is that he's had three starts there for two wins and a third. He obviously likes the place. He's a short-course horse, even though he is not well suited at the weights in this race, we will go there and hope for the best." Reflecting on Sartorial Splendor's 955-metre Moonee Valley success on October 23, Sadler added: "It was a reasonable win first-up, although he did only just fall in. I think he is going really well. The rating he has got now, even though it's not up near the top, we've got to throw him in the deep end, I suppose, as we are doing this Saturday. Hopefully he can take the next step."

## Newnham senses Oaks with Harmony Rose

Mark Newnham is hoping Harmony Rose (Glass Harmonium) can take the next step towards becoming an Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) contender when she lines up in the Drinkwise Mile (1600m) at Warwick Farm today. Unbeaten in two starts having followed-up her debut success at Kembla Grange with a gutsy win at Gosford on November 10, Harmony Rose has drawn parallels to her former stable companion Scarlet Dream (Sebring), who finished second behind star mare

Verry Elleegant (Zed) in the 2019 running of the ATC Oaks. "I have a good opinion of her, I think she is a really good staying filly," Newnham told Racing NSW. "She'll have this run and a break and I'll get her back for the autumn. I thought she did a good job the other day (Gosford) off a really slow speed, it took a while for her to build her momentum but I thought her last 100 metres was really good. She's probably on a par with where Scarlet Dream was at the same time. It's fair to say she's unfashionably bred but the Darby (Racing, co-owners) guys have a knack at finding one out of the box. She was a little bit of a handful early days but lacked a bit of maturity more than anything."

## Mistress Of Doom on MM Guineas trail

Co-trainer Peter Hulbert is hopeful Mistress Of Doom (Domesday) can take a small step towards qualifying for the \$2 million Magic Millions 3YO Guineas (RL, 1400m) in January when the filly makes her comeback at Ipswich today. Hulbert, training in partnership with son Will, has a big opinion of the three-year-old, who resumes in the 1200-metre QTIS Three-Year-Old Handicap. A \$50,000 buy at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Mistress Of Doom has been restricted to just two career starts to date, finishing fifth on debut at the Sunshine Coast in May before coming from last to down Tramonto (Wandjina) over 1050 metres at Doomben in June. "She's a very promising filly but she's only lightly-framed which has held her back a bit," Hulbert told Racing Queensland. "She's been slow to mature, that's why she's only had two starts because we haven't rushed her. We thought she could win, so we took her to Caloundra for her first start but she was a bit over-awed by the lights, then she came from behind at Doomben to beat Tramonto who looks to be a pretty smart horse." Looking ahead to the Magic Millions Guineas, Hulbert added: "If she's not ready we'll just wait as she's QTIS eligible but she'll need to pick up her prize-money levels to get into the Magic Millions Guineas."

## In Her Time's half-sister gets off the mark

Glowing Red, an Artie Schiller (El Prado) half-sister to dual Group 1 winner In Her Time (Time Thief), broke her maiden at the second

time of asking when she got up by half a length at Newcastle yesterday. Retained to race by her ownership syndicate having failed to meet her \$200,000 reserve at the 2019 Inglis Classic Yearling Sale, Glowing Red is under the care of Kris Lees, who also trained her twice-winning dam, Hell It's Hot (Zeditave), through the latter part of her career. Building on her half-length second at Gosford on November 10, Glowing Red showed a good turn of foot to win over 1200 metres yesterday and in doing so became the sixth victor from eight foals to race out of her dam, with Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) and The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m) heroine In Her Time the pick of those. In Her Time was sold for \$2 million at Inglis' The Chairman's Sale this year, knocked down to Newgate Bloodstock prior to being covered by I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) this spring. Hell It's Hot is a half-sister to Group 3 winner Hot As Hell (County) and stakes winners Flaming Hot (County) and Craig's Dragon (Catbird) alongside the dam of Everest (1200m) winner Yes Yes Yes (Rubick). The 18-year-old has a yearling colt by Impending (Lonhro) and a filly foal by Pariah (Redoute's Choice).

## Coolmore colt impresses in trial

Zarastro (I Am Invincible), the seventh most expensive youngster to pass through the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale in January when realising \$1.05 million, made a striking impression in a barrier trial at Randwick yesterday. The November-born colt, who was knocked down to Chris Waller and Guy Mulcaster having been consigned by Segenhoe Stud on behalf of Fairway Thoroughbreds, is out Light Fingers Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) winner Adrift (Zabeel), herself a three-quarter sister to Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m), Orr Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) and Yalumba Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Maldivian (Zabeel) and a half-sister to Karaka Million (RL, 1200m) scorer Imperial Win (Iffraaj). Having made his public debut when running second in a 900-metre trial at Randwick on November 12, Zarastro stepped out in heat two over 1045 metres yesterday, moving powerfully under James McDonald before scooting a length and a quarter clear of Villani (Not A Single Doubt).

## Qld border reopened

Queensland premier Annastacia Palaszczuk yesterday announced that, from next Tuesday, the state's border will reopen to residents of Greater Sydney to fall into line with the rest of NSW. There are also suggestions that the premier will also rule that residents of Victoria, which now has no active cases of Covid-19 in the state, will also be able to travel to Queensland. It means that owners, trainers, breeders and other racing industry participants, who had previously been unable to travel to Queensland without undertaking 14 days of hotel quarantine, will be able to travel north for the summer carnival and the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale in January. "Today I had a meeting with (chief health officer) Dr Young ... and Dr Young is now satisfied that they have reached the 28 days," Palaszczuk said yesterday. "So, can I say to NSW, we welcome you from December 1. Every single Queenslander has played their part for us to get to this stage. This is a great day, this is exciting news."

## 815 first acceptances for Blue Diamond

A mammoth 815 first acceptances have been taken for next year's Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m). They include 63 first acceptances from Ciaran Maher and David Eustace, with the duo having already saddled five two-year-old winners this season. Exciting prospects Enthaar (Written Tycoon), Fake Love (I Am Invincible) and Sneaky Five (Fastnet Rock) have all been accepted for the Caulfield Group 1, which is set to be run on February 20. Godolphin have accepted 54 two-year-olds, including Merson Cooper Stakes (Listed, 1000m) winner Anamoe (Street Boss). Second acceptances for the Blue Diamond close at noon on Tuesday, January 5, while third declarations have been pushed back by the MRC from Tuesday, January 26 to noon on Thursday, January 28 to avoid Australia Day.

## Caserta heads north

Chris Caserta is the latest jockey to relocate from Victoria to Queensland, with the 25-year-old set to depart Victoria yesterday and complete 14 days of quarantine in northern New South Wales before heading to Queensland next month. "I will be

based around the Gold Coast area,"

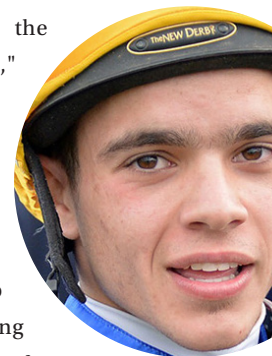
Caserta told Racing.com.

"I've spoken to Bryan Guy up there and he's happy to give me a helping hand and get my feet

off the ground, which is good to know. I'm approaching it as a fresh start and we'll see how things go." Caserta joins the exodus of previously Victoria-based riders who now call Queensland home, with Andrew Mallyon, Ryan Maloney, Dale Smith, Ben Thompson and Stephanie Thornton all having shifted within the past three years, while Queenslander Michael Rodd announced his decision to return home on Sunday. "Almost every jockey can do 56 kilograms and that's why you can see there's many jockeys at the races these days," Caserta added. "Riding those horses at 54 kilograms was my bread and butter and even though sometimes you wouldn't have good chances, you'd still make up a book of five or so rides, whereas these days you are going to country tracks like Terang and Tatura, like I did last week, for no more than three rides."

## Vale Jim Marconi

Jim Marconi, trainer of Marlboro Cup (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Rancho Ruler (Rancher) alongside Cossack Prince (Sir Tristram), King Marauding (Marauding) and Pride Of Rancho (Rancho Ruler), died on Monday. He was 87. Marconi's daughter Fiona posted a tribute on Facebook yesterday afternoon. "Last night our wonderful dad Jim Marconi passed away - he would have been 88 tomorrow," she wrote. "Dad lived an enormous life filled with an abundance of love, laughter, dedication and passion. He could be both fiery and tenacious and kind and loving. Whilst having many professional successes, his greatest achievement was his family, who truly adored him. We are so fortunate to have had so much time with him. He will be desperately missed."





## Trainer Clarke critically ill

Popular trainer Udyta Clarke is fighting for her life after she was found unresponsive at her Cranbourne stables on Monday night. The 72-year-old was rushed to the emergency department at the Monash Hospital where doctors detected a hypertensive brain bleed. She remains in a critical condition.

## O'Neill inducted into Hall Of Fame

Trailblazing jockey Pam O'Neill has been recognised as one of the state's all time-greats after being inducted into the Queensland Sport Hall of Fame. O'Neill is the first female jockey to be inducted, and only the sixth in total, following Mick Dittman, Darby McCarthy, George Moore, Mel Schumacher and Neville Sellwood. Having campaigned for more than a decade to ride alongside her male counterparts, O'Neill was granted a jockey licence in 1979 at the age of 34, riding a treble on debut at the Gold Coast as she became Australia's first female jockey. During her stellar riding career, O'Neill piloted more than 400 winners, including a month-long stint in Japan in 1980, which landed her three triumphs. "It's a real thrill to be honoured in this manner, in a state where we have so many great sportsmen - I felt extremely humble and proud," O'Neill told Racing Queensland. "To be put amongst this company is amazing. I got a thrill when I was inducted into the Queensland Racing Hall of Fame, but this is another fantastic recognition." ## Outside gate for unbeaten Basarwa

The Guy Lowry and Grant Cullen-trained Basarwa (Atlante), who made a big impression when winning by a length and a quarter on debut at Hastings earlier this month, will have to overcome the outside barrier if he is to remain undefeated in tomorrow's Wellington Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m)

at Otaki. The three-year-old has drawn gate 13 in the feature, which is being used as a stepping stone towards the Levin Classic (Gr 1, 1600m) at Trentham in January. "I thought it was a good run, which followed up his strong trial," Lowry said of the gelding's debut win. "He had the best sectionals of the day. He is a talented horse but just does a lot wrong. He is a work in progress." Looking to tomorrow, Lowry added: "I don't know how much rain they are going to get down there, but that's a bit of a concern for everyone." By Fastnet Rock (Daneshill) sire Atlante, Basarwa is out of a half-sister to Listed scorer Big River (General Nediym), from the family of Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) runner-up Star Worship (Star Way).

## Sharrock taking trio to Otaki

Allan Sharrock will launch a three-pronged assault on tomorrow's Otaki meeting, with Tavi Mac (Tavistock), Waisake (Zed) and Our Hail Mary (Ocean Park) set to represent the Taranaki trainer. Tavi Mac, runner up in the Foxbridge Plate (Gr 2, 1200m) prior to taking out the Matamata Cup (Listed, 1400m) by three and a quarter lengths on October 10, will chase more black-type in the Levin Stakes (Listed, 1400m), for which he has been allocated 60 kilograms. "He's only a little horse but he seems to carry the weight no problem," Sharrock said. "He's earned the weight I suppose, and we can't duck and dive, he's got to carry it." Looking to the future with the five-year-old, Sharrock continued: "I wouldn't rule out Brisbane in the winter, or we might look at the spring next year in Hawke's Bay. He's a serious racehorse and he'll be more competitive knowing a bit more next year. He's probably got to learn the racing game, but he's a tenacious little fella. He wants to win, that's the big thing with him, and he's still got plenty of improvement." Waisake, who contests a Rating 74 race over 2100 metres, won three starts ago at Hastings and has earned two third placings since then, while Our Hail Mary will make her second start of the season in a Rating 74 contest over 1400 metres. She has not been seen since running a fast-closing fifth at Hawera on October 10.

## New Cambridge track given tick

The Cambridge Jockey Club's new synthetic track received a tick of approval from leading jockey Samantha Collett after its first set of trials yesterday. Collett, who was riding on the surface for the second time having undertaken jump-outs earlier in the month, said: "I think it is really fantastic. The club can be really proud of what they have produced. I was fortunate enough to have a few rides around at the jump-outs prior to today's trial meeting and it really impressed me then. I feel like the track is really nice and forgiving. It is going to produce a really nice, even surface that we can look forward to using all year round, especially in the winter months when our turf tracks are deteriorating. It's going to be a great tool to have."

## Campbell has Karaka Million ambitions with duo

The Karaka Million 2YO (RL, 1200m) at Ellerslie on January 23 is the target for two of Andrew Campbell's juveniles who won their respective trials on the Cambridge Jockey Club's synthetic surface yesterday. Campbell saddled a Tivaci (High Chaparral) colt out of Salford Art (Sir Percy) and a Highly Recommended (Fastnet Rock) colt out of Borntobeirish (O'Reilly), both of whom were successful over 800 metres. "They did everything right today so we will head to a race in the near future providing they pull up well," Campbell said. "I like them both, but they are two different horses. The Tivaci didn't show a heap early on but he has just improved all the time and today he was pretty impressive. The other one ran a better time today and he's pretty tough, he never gives it away. Our main aim is trying to get them to the Karaka Million. If they are good enough they will go overseas at three." Reflecting on the new surface, Campbell added: "I am rapt with the track. It was pretty even and every horse got its chance. It is so even and consistent. Everyone was thinking it was going to be a front-runners bias, but they were coming from everywhere. Everyone that I have spoken to has been positive."

## ASIA

**JPN: Shadai Stallion Station announce Siskin fee**

This year's Irish 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) winner Siskin (First Defence) will stand at Shadai Stallion Station Hokkaido for a fee of ¥3,500,000 (approx. AUD\$45,615). Owned and bred by Khalid Abdullah, it was revealed in June that breeding rights in the son of First Defence (Unbridled's Song) had been sold to an undisclosed group, with rumours having circulated for a while following the colt's unbeaten juvenile career. Siskin, the second foal out of the winning Oasis Dream (Green Desert) mare Bird Flown, completed his two-year-old season with victory in the Phoenix Stakes (Gr 1, 6f) and took Classic honours this year when seeing off Vatican City (Galileo), among a host of Ballydoyle runners, at the Curragh. The colt is the headline name for former Juddmonte stallion First Defence, a top-level winner himself when landing the Forego Stakes (Gr 1, 7f) at Saratoga. He was sold to Saudi Arabia at the end of 2016.

**JPN: Regally-bred Frankel filly makes the perfect start**

Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Gr 1, 2400m) heroine Danedream's (Lomitas) two-year-old Frankel (Galileo) filly, Online Dream, made a winning debut in Japan on Monday when landing a Tokyo newcomers race over 1400 metres. The brilliant racemare, who has also produced the winning Dubawi (Dubai Millennium) gelding Faylaq - a 1,500,000gns purchase for Shadwell at Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale in 2017 - has thrown three other offspring by the dual world champion Frankel, but only Solid Dream had previously made it the track. Her first foal was Nothing But Dreams, who failed to race for Roger Varian and was subsequently shipped to Japan to start her broodmare career, while the two-year-old Dreaming Eyes suffered a fatal injury during exercise last year.

**HK: Callan gunning for IJC berth**

Neil Callan's fine run of form has fired him into contention for the coveted final spot in the International Jockeys' Championship

and at Happy Valley tonight he will attempt to seal his place from five rides in the eight races left to play out. The Irishman has bagged three doubles for six wins from his last four race meetings to leap-frog his rivals and occupy the coveted sixth spot designated to Hong Kong-based riders. He and Vagner Borges each have 11 wins for the term but Callan has the edge over the Brazilian on a countback with 12 seconds to Borges' six. "If we get through tomorrow night and we get some luck, or nobody else gets an advantage on me and the results stay the same, then hopefully I'll be happy. If it does happen, it does; if it doesn't, it doesn't," Callan said. This year, the Hong Kong Jockey Club elected for a half-and-half split of competitors in the 12-jockey competition on December 9. Six jockeys from overseas and six based in Hong Kong will vie for the most lucrative jockeys' challenge winner's cheque in the world and Callan, along with Alexis Badel, who sits fifth in the local premiership, could join Zac Purton, Joao Moreira, Karis Teetan and Vincent Ho as Hong Kong's representatives.

## INTERNATIONAL

**12 for Vados**

Rich Hill Stud shuttler Vados (Monsun) sired his 12th individual winner when Mammasaidknockout (2 f ex Open Verse by Black Minnaloushe) kept on well to get off the mark in a Lingfield nursery over six furlongs yesterday. Trained by Richard Hannon, the juvenile was having her fourth start when beating favourite Olivia May (Dark Angel) by a length. Decadent (Mehmas) was another three-quarters of a length away in third. A €50,000 purchase by Peter and Ross Doyle at Goffs last year, Mammasaidknockout is a half-sister to four winners, out of the Black Minnaloushe (Storm Cat) mare Open Verse, who herself is a half-sister Group 1 winner Polaris Flight (Northern Flagship). Vados, a Group 1 winner in France, is standing for NZ\$15,000 (plus GST).

**20 for Shalaa**

Arrowfield shuttler Shalaa (Invincible Spirit) continues to fire in the winners

with victory for his son Shershab (s c ex Gherdaiya by Shamarda) over 1500 metres at Marseille-Vivaux on Monday providing him with his 20th winner from his first crop. Trained by Frederic Rossi, the Al Shaqab-raced juvenile beat Sens Du Defi (Yumzain) by a length, with Roxy Music (Prince Gibraltar) back in third. Shershab is the first foal out of dual-winning Group 3-placed Gherdaiya (Shamardal). Shalaa's 2021 fee at Haras de Bouquetot has been set at €15,000 (approx. AUD\$24,260).

**146 for Dansili**

Newmarket trainer Roger Varian landed his fourth French stakes race of the year with a fourth different filly when Stylistique (3 f ex Sleek by Oasis Dream) took out of the Prix Petite Etoile (Listed, 1900m) on the all-weather at Deauville yesterday. In doing so, she became the 146th individual stakes winner for former Juddmonte Farms stallion Dansili (Danzig). A Carisbrooke Stud homebred for Yvonne Jacques, Stylistique joined stable companions Believe In Love (Make Believe), Angel Power (Lope De Vega) and Queen Daenerys (Frankel) as successful raiders to cross the Channel in 2020 for Varian, who landed this contest in 2016 with Dawn Of Hope (Mastercraftsman). Ridden by Olivier Peslier, 20-1 chance Stylistique came home a length and a quarter to the good of fellow Newmarket rival Perfect Inch (Dark Angel), who is trained by Charlie Fellowes. Vadsena (Makfi) was a further short-head back in third for Jean-Claude Rouget. Dansili was pensioned from stallion duties in 2018 and his progeny include the outstanding Harbinger and exceptional performers Flintshire, The Fugue and Zacinto.



## IRE: O'Brien snaps on Ebendi in historic sale

The Aga Khan's homebred Ebendi (Le Havre) created a little slice of sales history yesterday when bought by Joseph O'Brien for €165,000 (approx. AUD\$266,800) at Goffs' single-horse online auction. The sale, which opened for bidding at 10am and closed at midday, was the first of its kind. The gelded three-year-old, who shed his maiden tag when winning at Killarney in July, attracted 27 bids from prospective buyers across Europe, Australia and South Africa. Ebendi, who finished runner-up to subsequent Breeders' Cup Mile (Gr 1, 1m) winner Order Of Australia (Australia) on his most recent start for Dermot Weld, was due to be sold at the Goffs Autumn Horses in Training Sale but was withdrawn due to being cast in his stable.

## US: Into Mischief breaks earnings records

The well-named Life Is Good's (Into Mischief) debut victory at Del Mar on Sunday allowed

Spendthrift Farm's Into Mischief (Harlan's Holiday) to break the North American single-season progeny earnings record set by Gainesway's Tapit (Pulpit) in 2016. Into Mischief's progeny earnings from northern hemisphere racing now totals US\$19,994,720 (approx. AUD\$27.267 million), according to The Jockey's Club Information Systems' Equineline, meaning the 15-year-old son of Harlan's Holiday (Harlan) is \$11,547 (approx. AUD\$15,746) ahead of Tapit's record of \$19,983,173 with 38 days remaining for 2020. "Tapit is a wonderful sire, so to eclipse his record is something special," said Ned Toffey, general manager of Spendthrift Farm. "To have these kinds of numbers, you have to be consistent and you have to be brilliant. Into Mischief just gets one good runner after another." Trained by Bob Baffert and ridden by Mike Smith, Life Is Good won by nine and a half lengths, earning \$34,200 (approx. AUD\$46,640) in prize-money.

## UK: Crowds to return to English tracks

In a move welcomed with surprise and delight by racing and bookmakers, UK prime minister Boris Johnson announced English racecourses will be allowed to start welcoming back limited crowds from next Wednesday, while betting shops can re-open too. Up to 4,000 people will be admitted to outdoor sporting venues in the areas of England least affected by Covid-19 in Tier 1, a number which would drop to 2,000 in Tier 2. And in a further boost to the sport, betting shops across England will open their doors again when the England-wide coronavirus lockdown comes to an end. Racing's stakeholders welcomed the somewhat unexpected development, with British Horseracing Authority chief executive Nick Rust describing the UK government's announcement as "more welcome news" following last week's offer of financial assistance in the form of £40 million in loans. Racecourse Association chief executive David Armstrong hailed the move as a "welcome development".

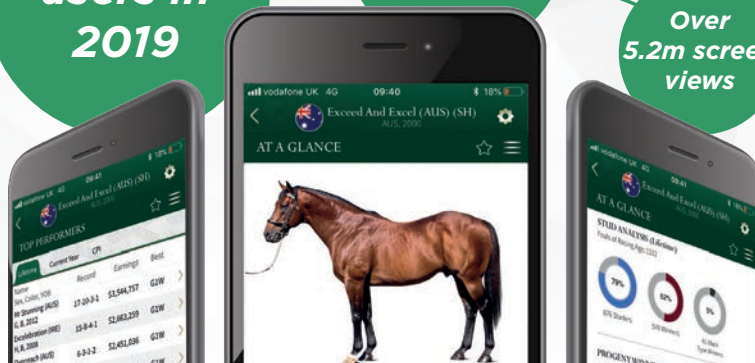

## Kah leads the pack in race to complete extraordinary achievement

Jockey Jamie Kah's success is likely to prove the racing story of the current season.

That will be especially so if she were to go on to claim the Victorian metropolitan jockeys' premiership in which she currently has a seven win lead over Damien Oliver and a winning strike rate of 20 per cent which is about 25 per cent better than any other jockey to have had more than 100 city rides.

A Melbourne premiership win would be momentous, history making and perhaps the ultimate denouement in the story of the advance of female riders around the world and particularly in Australia.

It would surely bring an end to the archaic differentiation between male and female riders in the form guide.

The very fact that she threatens to win the title is probably enough to hail a landmark point in the evolution of this remarkable sport where men and women, young and old, compete on equal terms.

Kah rode her third Group 1 winner in mid-October; then claimed four winners on Cox Plate day and rebounded from unfounded criticism of her Melbourne Cup ride on Prince Of Arran (Shirocco) to land a treble on Sandown Classic day.

For all the undoubted talent and success of her predecessors - who certainly trod a rockier path - and even that of some of her fine contemporaries; Kah's day in and day out competitiveness in one of the strongest racing

jurisdictions in the world has taken it all to a new level in this country.

Taken it well beyond the outstanding achievements of a trailblazing Bev Buckingham who was champion in Tasmania or the talented Clare Lindop who was a three-time premiership winner in South Australia.

Taken it beyond, in terms of the general perception of racing fans, even Michelle Payne and her historic Melbourne Cup.

And taken it a long way from 1979 when the first two Australian riding licences went to Pam O'Neil and Linda Jones and from the early to mid 1900s when some intrepid women rode disguised as men.

Kah is not an extremely good female jockey. She's an extremely good jockey.

Her 2020 success coincides with Rachel King continuing to excel in Sydney; Jessica

Eaton challenging for the South Australian metropolitan title and, perhaps, more significantly Hollie Doyle - in Britain - winning at Royal Ascot, riding five in a day at Windsor, becoming the first woman to ride a winner on Champions Day, securing a retainer and finishing fourth in the Jockeys' Championship.

What a change there's been to the landscape since Jones and O'Neil fought to be licensed and New Zealander Jones became the first registered female rider to win a race in Australia against male professionals - in Brisbane on 7 May 1979.

New Zealand has led the way in fostering female riding talent.

Ten months before Jones' breakthrough win - four women - Vivienne Kaye, Joanne Hale, Joanne Lamond and Sue Day became the first New Zealand female jockeys to ride against



their male counterparts on 15 July 1978 with Day, a week later, being the first to win a race.

In July 1982, fellow New Zealander Dianne Moseley became the first female jockey to win a Group 1 race (Doomben Cup) in Australia.

Yet another, Maree Lyndon became the first female to ride in the Melbourne Cup in 1987 and she won the Adelaide Cup that year.

Lisa Cropp, Lisa Allpress and Sam Collett have all been New Zealand premierships winners.

Julie Krone led the way in the United States. Newsworthy enough to once feature on the cover of Sports Illustrated, she became the first and only female jockey to win a Triple Crown race when she captured the Belmont Stakes aboard Colonial Affair in 1993.

Her trail was, in part, blazed by Diane Crump who on 7 February, 1969, became the first woman to ride in a professional race in the United States.

She recalled that day in a 2012 interview. "The crowd was just swarming all over me. They were crazy, up in arms...the hecklers

were yelling: 'go back to the kitchen and cook dinner.' That was the mentality at the time. They thought I was going to be the downfall of the whole sport, which is such a medieval thought. I was like: 'come on people, this is the 1960s!'"

Rosie Napravnik has twice won the Kentucky Oaks this decade during which time Hayley Turner and Josephine Gordon have excelled in England.

In the past two decades, no fewer than nine women have ridden Group 1 winners in Australia with Kah, Payne, Lindop and King joined by Kathy O'Hara, Linda Meech, Nikita Beriman, Katelyn Mallyon and Lauren Stojakovic.

None (with due respect to all), however, I would argue have quite had the impact of Jamie Kah.

The 24 year-old, from the Adelaide Hills, won the first of three Adelaide Jockeys' premierships in her first full season (2012-13) and is now poised to claim the title in the much, much tougher jurisdiction of Melbourne.

A Melbourne premierships would be an extraordinary achievement - perhaps the most extraordinary achievement by a female rider.

It is such a competitive environment that multiple Group 1 winning jockeys Michael Rodd and Michael Walker have struggled to secure rides at the metropolitan fixtures.

Thus, Rodd is heading back to his native Queensland. While reuniting with family was also a consideration, Rodd told Racing.com how difficult it was to regain a foothold in Melbourne. "The Melbourne jockeys' room is so competitive from top to bottom," he said.

Walker, a Group 1 winner as recently as October when he took the 1000 Guineas on Odeum (Written Tycoon), makes a similar observation about his competition and deserves great credit for refusing to complain about his diminishing opportunities.

"We have the most amazing jockeys here in Melbourne, whether it's the old guys or the young kids coming through. They're amazing," Walker said.

And that amazing group is currently headed by Jamie Kah.

# Pagan dips into December Yearling Sale as Sea The Stars steals the show with 300,000gns top lot at Tattersalls

**D**enis Pagan, who caused an upset in last month's Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) when saddling six-race maiden Johnny Get Angry (Tavistock) to victory, was active at Tattersalls on Monday, going to 85,000 guineas (approx. AUD\$162,250) to secure a son of Australia (Galileo) from the December Yearling Sale.

The colt, who is out of an unraced half-sister to Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) hero Rekindling (High Chaparral), was bought in sombre circumstances after Pagan lost an unraced Preferment (Zabeel) filly in a trackwork accident at Flemington last week.

"When my filly went down, which was terribly, terribly disappointing because she was just showing so much, I just decided that you only live once and I don't want to die with my bank book in my back pocket, so I decided to have a crack," Pagan told Racing.com yesterday morning.

"I just wanted to get one. I didn't want to buy a tried horse, I wanted to buy a yearling and I got one. I went to bed last night hoping and I woke up this morning and I've got one.

"Once again, Troy Corstens (who also sourced Johnny Get Angry from New Zealand) helped me out finding and purchasing this horse. He's been terrific to me."

Catalogued as Lot 143 and offered by Norris Bloodstock, the colt is a half-brother to Saratoga Listed winner Julie's Love (Ad Valorem), who was also placed in Group 2 company at Hoppegarten and Woodbine, and the stakes-performed dam of Group 3 winner Julio (Exceed And Excel).

Alongside Rekindling under the second dam is Irish Derby (Gr 1, 1m4f) runner-up Golden Sword (High Chaparral), while this is the further family of 2019 Mackinnon Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Magic Wand (Galileo).

## Stroud digs deep for Sea The Stars top lot

Bloodlines do not come much better than being by an English Derby (Gr 1, 1m4f) winner and out of an English Oaks (Gr 1, 1m4f) heroine, and that is precisely the breeding boasted by the 300,000gns (approx. AUD\$572,325) top lot at Monday's sale.

The colt in question is by Sea The Stars (Cape Cross) and out of Talent (New Approach), and it was Anthony Stroud who struck the winning bid for the Ashbrittle Stud-consigned youngster. The colt, who was bred in partnership by Ashbrittle and Mark Dixon, is the fourth foal out of Talent, whose first offspring is the Prix Corrida (Gr 2, 2200m) winner Ambition (Dubawi).

The youngster, who is inbred 2x4 to the brilliant blue hen Urban Sea (Miswaki), was making a belated first appearance at public auction having been withdrawn from Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale earlier this year.

"He's a nice horse who needs a bit of time," said Stroud, who has spent much of the sales season sourcing future stars for Godolphin. "But he's by a Derby winner and out of an Oaks winner and Ambition has done very well. He

had a haematoma on his off hind, that's why he didn't make Book 1.

"I'd seen him as a foal and had seen how he'd been progressing but he's always been a very nice horse. He's going to be trained by John Gosden."

Talent landed the 2013 Oaks while in training with Ralph Beckett and went on to finish runner-up to Leading Light (Montjeu) in that year's St Leger (Gr 1, 1m6.5f). The daughter of New Approach (Galileo) visited Ballylinch Stud's rising star sire Lope De Vega (Shamardal) earlier this year.

Trade proved solid throughout the session, and although 25 fewer offered lots saw turnover dip by four per cent to 3,986,300gns (approx. AUD\$7,605,220), the clearance rate was a healthy 86 per cent as 122 yearlings found a new home. In turn, the average rose by three per cent to 32,675gns (approx. AUD\$62,330), while the median dropped by 20 per cent to 20,000gns (approx. AUD\$38,150).

Buyers have a final opportunity to purchase yearlings this year at the Tattersalls Ireland November Flat Foal and Breeding Stock Sale, which takes place on December 16 and has 116 yearlings catalogued.



## Sea The Stars show continues

It took all of five lots for the six-figure barrier to be broken as Harry McCalmont of Norelands Stud, stationed outside by the parade ring, landed the Sea The Stars filly out of Alla Speranza (Sir Percy) with a bid of 260,000gns (approx. AUD\$495,850). Bred by Kirsten Rausing and the Tsui family's Sunderland Holdings, the filly hails from one of Lanwades' most prolific families.

Alla Speranza, a Group 3-winning daughter of Sir Percy (Mark Of Esteem), is the dam of City of York Stakes (Gr 2, 7f) scorer Shine So Bright (Oasis Dream) and is out of the Listed winner Alvarita (Selkirk), who in turn produced the Noblesse Stakes (Listed, 1m4f) victress Altesse (Hernando).

Alvarita is a daughter of Rausing's brilliant Alborada (Alzao), winner of successive renewals of the Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 1m2f), while Alborada is, of course, a sister to Albanova (Alzao), a champion in Germany after three Group 1 victories and now the dam of major talents such as Algometer (Archipenko), Alignak (Sea The Moon) and All At Sea (Sea The Stars).

Such a page would not have looked out of place at Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale and that was where the filly had been due to be auctioned prior to being withdrawn. She was sold on Monday through The Castlebridge Consignment.

"She's been bought by a partnership between Norelands and Craig Bernick of Glen Hill Farm," said McCalmont after getting off the phone to Hubie de Burgh. "We both had a good yearling sale season and we're trying to bring in some new blood to the farm.

"She's a very nice filly and comes from a very good farm. There's a huge number of fillies breeding on the page and they're all being bred to the best stallions. Hopefully she can race and we can add her to the broodmare band in time."

McCalmont was on the opposite side of the docket on this occasion having seen Norelands sell three lots for 2,530,000gns during Book 1, including the 2,000,000gns Frankel (Galileo) half-brother to Golden Horn (Cape Cross) bought by Godolphin.

The County Kilkenny-based operation also

sold eight lots for 1,375,000gns during Book 2, a list topped by the Frankel filly out of Love Is Blindness (Sir Percy) who, coincidentally, went the way of Bernick's Glen Hill Farm for 460,000gns.

McCalmont added of the Sea The Stars filly: "Members of this family don't come up that often and it's been very well managed by Kirsten and her team.

"Coolmore have a branch and Juddmonte have a branch, and now we have a branch of it too! She's by a sire that we love and use a lot so we're pleased to have her. I've spoken to Mr Gosden and I'll speak to him again but hopefully she'll go to him."

A bid of 260,000gns comfortably surpassed the high mark at last year's December Yearling Sale, which was set by Sun Bloodstock, who went to 200,000gns for the Dubawi (Dubai Millennium) colt out of Voleuse De Coeurs (Teofilo).

## Alcohol Free sibling lives up to star billing

Arguably no lot boasted a more current page than Knockatrina House Stud's Starspangledbanner (Choisir) half-sister to this year's Cheveley Park Stakes (Gr 1, 6f) heroine Alcohol Free (No Nay Never), and the filly lived up to expectations when knocked down to Daniel Creighton of Creighton Schwartz Bloodstock at 130,000gns (approx AUD\$248,000).

Creighton could not reveal the identity of the filly's new owner, but said she would likely head into training in Britain.

"The sister has done really well this year and she's by a stallion who's done very well as well," he said. "Hopefully it all adds up to her being a very good filly on the track and eventually being a nice broodmare as well. She's a lovely big filly and has a lot of quality.

"I'd say she'll be a midsummer or backend sort of filly. She's been bought for a new client but I don't know who'll train her yet. She'll go into pre-training with my brother and we'll see after, though I'd imagine she'll remain in Britain."

The six-figure filly was bred by Jossestown Farm and is out of Plying (Hard Spun), who was acquired for €21,000 at the 2018 Goffs November Breeding Stock Sale when offloaded by Churchtown House Stud. As well as Alcohol Free, the daughter of Hard Spun (Danzig) has produced the Listed-winning Alexander James (Camelot).

The filly was pinhooked by Canice Farrell through Pegasus Bloodstock when picked up for €40,000 at the Goffs February Sale earlier this year.

"We were lucky enough that Alcohol Free came along," said Farrell. "This filly was entered in an earlier sale but had an over-reach. It stood to her as she needed the time. She has a phenomenal temperament - and appetite!"

## Lope De Vega fan club in action

Hillwood Stud recorded a huge result at Book 1 when the Lope De Vega colt out of Moi Meme (Teofilo) was knocked down to Godolphin at 900,000gns, and the stallion did the Vigors' operation another good turn on Monday when Andrew Balding went to 130,000gns (approx. AUD\$247,000) for the colt out of Stone Roses (Rip Van Winkle).

"The stallion has done tremendous things and he's an exciting horse to get," said Balding. "He's been bought for some existing clients who have had a bit of luck with Lope De Vega. He's been good to us and hopefully we have some really nice ones coming through. There was lots to like about this colt."

Stone Roses, a Listed-winning daughter of Rip Van Winkle (Galileo), joined the Hillwood broodmare band at a cost of €280,000 at Arqana in 2016, and could well be set to repay that investment as the eight-year-old has more progeny of Lope De Vega in the pipeline.

"We've had a good year with Lope De Vega, although I think he's been good to most people who have been lucky enough to be involved with him," said Charlie Vigors.

"We've been big supporters of his and it's paying off. The mare has been producing some nice stock too, now they have to go and prove it on the racecourse. She's got a Lope De Vega filly foal and is in foal to him too, she's another of ours who's been on the Lope De Vega programme!"

## Gordon-Watson sticks with familiar family

Another lot by Sea The Stars brought a six-figure sum when Charlie Gordon-Watson went to 125,000gns (approx. AUD\$238,500) for the colt out of Crysdal (Dalakhani) offered by New England Stud.

The March foal is out of a daughter of Fillies' Mile (Gr 1, 1m) heroine Crystal Music (Nureyev), meaning the dam is a sibling to four black-type performers and the dam of Ocovango (Monsun).

The page traces back to Crystal Spray (Beldale Flutter), herself the dam of high-class talents such as Solar Crystal (Alzao) and State Crystal (High Estate), who is also the grandam

of Prix Jean Prat (Gr 1, 1600m) scorer Zelzal (Sea The Stars).

"It's a family I know well, going back to the days when I bought Crystal Spray," said Gordon-Watson. "Obviously I like the stallion, Sea The Stars is a very good sire, and he looks good value for a nice horse."

## Demi keeps it Dark

Also going beyond the six-figure mark was Croom House Stud's Dark Angel (Acclamation) filly who was knocked down to Demi O'Byrne, who signed as O'Byrne and Grassick/Dan Hayden at 115,000gns (approx. AUD\$220,000).

"She's a lovely filly, we really liked her, and she goes into training in Ireland," said Sean Grassick.

The filly was another lot to boast a recently enhanced page as she is out of Loreto, a Holy Roman Emperor (Danehill) half-sister to Cabaret (Galileo), dam of 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) hero Magna Grecia (Invincible Spirit) and his Dewhurst Stakes (Gr 1, 7f) -winning half-brother St Mark's Basilica (Siyouni).

## Cooper collects

Patrick Cooper snapped up another of the session's more eye-catching lots when the BBA Ireland man went to 105,000gns (approx. AUD\$200,000) for the New Approach (Galileo) colt out of La Superba (Medicean) offered by Mount Coote Stud.

"He's been bought for Alpha Racing and goes to Jessica Harrington," said Cooper. "He's

a lovely horse and we were looking for a three-year-old type so hopefully he'll turn out to be a nice mile and a half horse.

"He'll need a bit of time but he's a lovely horse. Alpha Racing have had Cadillac this year, which has cheered everyone up a bit, and hopefully Mrs Harrington can work her magic again."

Bred and raced by Mark Dixon and Mount Coote's Luke Lillingston, La Superba, a Medicean (Machiavellian) half-sister to Doncaster Cup (Gr 2, 2m2f) winner Thomas Hobson (Halling), won three races during her time in training and hails from the same family as Oaks heroine Talent, who supplied the top lot.

Lillingston went on to explain how Monday's sale proved to be a change in fortunes for the colt.

"He's a horse we've always loved," he said. "It was a very deliberate mating to replicate the cross with Talent. He came here for Book 2 and was showing really well for the first day but then spiked a temperature and we had to withdraw him. Damian Flynn and Emma Foley [Redgate Bloodstock] have had him for the last five or six weeks and have done a super job. Emma was an old Mount Coote girl once upon a time and they do a great job."

"When the horse was sick on the grounds our team were up almost all night with him, particularly Paul Carey. Book 2 was so strong that we were disappointed not to be part of it with this horse, but thankfully the market has valued him today. He's going to go to Jessie's, which is the cherry on the icing on the cake!"
