# Dragonet roars to Cox Plate victory

Ozzie's European import provides milestone moment for Maher and Eustace

ox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) winner Sir Dragonet (Camelot) had been on the radar of Mathew Becker for more than 12 months before he was able to convince Coolmore to part with the well-bred and highly talented colt who provided the ultimate return to his new owners at Moonee Valley yesterday.

The five-year-old, a one-time Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m 4f) favourite who won the Chester Vase (Gr 3, 1m 4.5f) led home a European-bred first four in the 100th running of the prestigious

\$5 million race and cemented Ciaron Maher and David Eustace as a likely force in Australian training ranks in the years to come.

Becker is the agent for Sir Dragonet's principal owner Ozzie Kheir and the pair orchestrated a late Friday night deal with Coolmore's Tom Magnier to buy the entire from the international racing and breeding empire.

Speaking to ANZ Bloodstock Bloodstock News after the momentous occasion, Group 1 Bloodstock's Becker was well aware of the downfalls of buying Sir Dragonet for a significant seven-figure sum. *Continued on page 2>>*

<< Continued from page 1 "It's one of those things buying these horses from overseas is good in theory, but it is fraught with pitfalls and they don't always come off, but we've got a system in place that we have had for a little while and Ozzie and I worked pretty closely hand-and-glove on it," Becker said.

"I was confident that he was the right horse, but you are never too sure until you see them have their first run in Australia to see how they are going to adapt and all that sort of stuff, so it was just so good to see him find the line the way he did. It is quite amazing really."

Sir Dragonet defeated Armory (Galileo) by one and a quarter lengths, with Russian Camelot (Camelot) another three quarters of a length away in third. Mugatoo (Henrythenavigator) was fourth while Arcadia Queen (Pierro), the first Australian-bred, ran fifth.

Jockey Glen Boss won last year's Everest (1200m) for similar connections.

"It's unbelievable. I used to wear out my VCR watching the Kingston Town and Manikato video. It's ingrained in my psyche," Boss said.

Maher was also elated at the result of his new stable addition.

"It's something else. You dream of having a runner in it, let alone winning the race," Maher said.

"Ozzie bought him for the Melbourne Cup and he'll be even better in that race."

Becker praised the "ten out of ten" ride Sir Dragonet received from

Boss but also credited the recently retired hoop James Winks for his input in the success of the entire.

"One thing that Ozzie and John O'Neill did was engage James Winks to ride the horse and I think it was a masterstroke because, one, getting a quality rider like that with feedback directly every day was so important for us and, two, to be honest, we became confident when the horse got to Newmarket because the Maher-Eustace stable put him in work with David's brother Harry," he said.

"Harry remarked when he got the horse there that he was a really lovely horse with plenty more to give. He was thriving there with no problems and when he got to Werribee he just loved it.

"James (Winks) just said he felt so good and he had so much quality. He was also fit, which was another major thing, as we didn't have to worry about his fitness. We could just take time with him."

<< Continued from page 2 He added: "He had a couple of key gallops which was all he took. He had a gallop last Saturday and he went to Moonee Valley for breakfast with the stars but he's been going to the beach and he's thrived on that sort of training that Ciaron can offer them here as opposed to the style of training that he's been used to in Ireland. I think he is just brilliant with those horses and Ciaron was just so confident today. It was amazing, really."

A deal for Sir Dragonet to end up in Australia was only signed off three months ago after months of inquiries.

Caught up in the euphoria of a clutch goal by Carlton's Jack Newnes on August 15, which saw the Blues victorious over Fremantle in the Australian Football League, Kheir upped the ante in his negotiations to secure the subsequent Cox Plate winner.

"That was that night I said that he could be bought and there was a little bit of negotiation going on and Ozzie took control of that. He knows Tom Magnier. He was involved in Yes Yes Yes deal together, so he had a personal relationship," Becker recalled.

"They did the deal on the phone that night after Carlton won the footy. It was quite amazing how it all transpired and it's worked out in the end."

Sir Dragonet (5 h Camelot - Sparrow by Oasis Dream) hails from a potent European family, being a son of the stakes-placed, juvenile winner Sparrow (Oasis Dream), who is a half-sister to Italian Listed winner Victory Song (Dansili), Cheshire Oaks (Listed, 1m3.5f) winner Wonder Of Wonders (Kingmambo), while his third dam is Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Urban Sea (Miswaki).

She, of course, is the dam of European champion Sea The Stars (Cape Cross) and phenomenal Coolmore Group 1-winning stallion Galileo (Sadler's Wells). The blue hen mare is also the dam of champion Italy three-year-old Black Sam Bellamy (Sadler's Wells), Urban Ocean (Bering), Born To Sea (Invincible Spirit) and Melikah (Lammtarra), among others.

Sparrow has a stakes-performed juvenile brother to Sir Dragonet in Sir Lucan and a yearling colt by Caravaggio (Scat Daddy).

Becker reiterated Maher's view that Sir Dragonet was a legitimate Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) contender on Tuesday week and that there was unlikely to be any thought of protecting his value as a potential stallion.

"The Melbourne Cup was the primary race and it was our belief at the time (of buying him) that he can stay," he said.

"He's got a stallion's pedigree, but these guys are here to win major races, and if he's sound and well I am sure they will be running him.

"I think it will be having a conversation about (his stallion value), but these guys are in it for the sport. They have got other horses that they race. Ozzie had Tagaloa, Brae (Sokolski) and Ozzie had Yes Yes, those sort of horses as stallion prospects, but these horses we buy are here to win the major races.

"I would be very surprised if they didn't want to run him (in the Cup) because he is here to do that job."

Danny O'Brien said **Russian Camelot** produced the best run of his career to finish third and that the entire was likely to press on to the Melbourne Cup..

"I was really proud of him. He went forward from a hot tempo and Damien Oliver gave him a superb ride," O'Brien said.

"He was left a sitting shot but kept on fighting."

Currently in lockdown, Becker chose to watch the race from his Melbourne office as he was too nervous to stay at home with the family.

"I had to get out of the house as I was driving the family crazy," he said.

"Ozzie and I were texting each other backwards and forwards still at 2am sitting in our lounge rooms looking out our windows waiting for the race.

"There wasn't much sleep last night and we felt a lot better when the rain came."

### Cherry Tortoni back on track after Vase win

Trainer Patrick Payne was cursing himself after a trip to Sydney for leading Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) contender Cherry Tortoni (Night Of Thunder) proved fruitless, but the promising three-year-old gelding confirmed he was back to his best with victory in the Moonee Valley Vase (Gr 2, 2040m) yesterday.

It was Payne's intention to use the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) as a lead-up run for the talented son of Darley's former shuttler Night Of Thunder (Dubawi) but the Victorian trainer instead sent the gelding north for the Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m). *Continued on page 4>>* 

<< Continued from page 3 He finished seventh and left Payne rueing his decision, but yesterday Cherry Tortoni firmed into \$6 second favourite behind Young Werther (Tavistock) (\$4.50).

"It's amazing how things can turn around, I was dirty on myself after the Sydney run but today was much better," Payne told Racing,com.

"From a trainer's point-of-view, I didn't think he had a hard run. We'll never know but I still think he had something left in the tank.

"He looked like he wanted to stargaze when he got to the front but, still, it was good to see him back winning like that."

Jockey Billy Egan was able to circle the field on Cherry Tortoni to defeat Khoekhoe (Turffontein) by a short neck with Johnny Get Angry (Tavistock) seven lengths away in third.

"Once we got down the side, I just gave him breathing room and let him build his momentum and swoop on them over the top," Egan said.

"I know he's won a couple of races, but he's got the on-and-off ability without knowing what he is doing.

"He's got a lot of learning to do. To see what he's doing now, all natural ability, is really nice."

Morning line favourite Young Werther, who was runner-up in the Super Impose Stakes (Listed, 1800m), was scratched from the Vase by trainer Danny O'Brien after the track was downgraded to a Soft 7 earlier in the day. The Derby remains on the agenda.

Keeping in mind what Payne considers as an error of judgment by sending the horse to Sydney earlier this month, Payne was circumspect about not wanting to overtax Cherry Tortoni in Saturday's Derby.

"We're really mindful that, I think, he'll be a nice four, five and six-year-old," Payne said.

"It was a good tune-up for the Derby but if he shows us any signs that he doesn't want to go there then we won't."

From seven starts, which includes a victory in the Gibson Carmichael Stakes (Listed, 1600m) at Flemington in July, Cherry Tortoni has won four races and recouped \$392,125 in prize-money.

Cherry Tortoni (3 g Night Of Thunder - Tortoni by Strategic), a homebred for Sandy Tait, is a grandson of Group 1-winning mare Whisked (Whiskey Road) who, of course, is the dam of champion Tie The Knot (Nassipour), and stakes winners Hood (Shamardal) and Dream Ballad (Singspiel).

Tortoni, Cherry Tortoni's mother, won a Wagga maiden in 2013 shortly before being retired. She has a yearling filly by Coolmore shuttler Churchill (Galileo) and was covered by Mendelssohn (Scat Daddy) last year.

### **Tough Dissident filly lands Fillies Classic**

Troy Corstens has praised Yes Baby Yes' (Dissident) constitution after the three-year-old filly broke through for her first stakes victory in the Moonee Valley Fillies Classic (Gr 2, 1600m) at her ninth start in a preparation that started ten months ago.

Runner-up to Incredulous Dream (Press Statement) at her previous start at Caulfield on October 17, jockey Craig Williams was able to dictate the pace of the \$300,000 Group 2 three-year-old fillies race.

She had a margin of three and three-quarter lengths over Ecumenical (Zebedee), who ran fourth in the MRC Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m), with another two lengths back to Miss Inbetween (Fighting Sun).

"She's as tough as nails," trainer Corstens said. "You wouldn't believe it, but she's been up since January this girl.

Corstens acquired a farm near Benalla and he credited the property for being able to keep Yes Baby Yes in work for so long.

"She goes (to the farm) on a Monday morning and she'll go out in the paddock for three or four days - she still works while she's up there," said Corstens who trains in partnership with his father Leon.

"(It) just keeps them happy. Some like going to the beach, some like going to the paddock and she likes going to the paddock.

"I just love her. She's so tough. Things haven't always gone her way, but she puts herself out in front and she held on today."

It was a red-letter day for Hunter Valley operation Newgate Farm with resident stallions Dissident (Sebring) and Deep Field (Northern Meteor) siring winners and first season sire Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) providing two juvenile winners.

Yes Baby Yes (3 f Dissident - Exabelle by Exceed And Excel), a \$120,000 purchase by Flemington Bloodstock and Malua Racing from the 2019 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale from the Sledmere Stud draft, has now earned \$247,488 in prize-money after winning \$180,000 yesterday.

<< Continued from page 4 Bought by Sheamus Mills Bloodstock for NZ13,000 out of the 2014 NZB National Broodmare Sale, Exabeel is now the dam of three foals to race, all of whom have won, and the two-year-old half-sister No Baby No (Shooting To Win) is also in training with the Corstens at Flemington.

Exabeel also has a yearling filly by Spieth (Thorn Park) and was due to foal to Dissident this year.

Yes Baby Yes joins Pancho as a stakes winner for Dissident who stands at Newgate Farm for 11,000 (inc GST).

### Melbourne Cup next for Miami Bound

The Melbourne Cup dream is alive for VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Miami Bound (Reliable Man) after relishing a strong tempo and a wet track in the Moonee Valley Gold Cup (Gr 2, 2500m).

Trainer Danny O'Brien never lost faith in the four-year-old mare despite being unplaced in her first four starts this campaign, most recently when sixth in the Herbert Power Stakes (Gr 2, 2400m), at Caulfield on October 10.

"She's a much better horse when she gets out in distance, a mile and a half at least, and she grows another leg on the Soft (tracks)," he said.

"There were a few things in our favour, but we are thrilled to see her win today.

"She gave us a great thrill last spring in the Oaks and it's still a big effort to come back here and beat the boys in the Moonee Valley Cup."

Miami Bound (\$26) defeated Shared Ambition (Born To Sea) (\$4.20 fav) by two and a half lengths with Oceanex (Ocean Park) (\$10) a half-length away third.

"We have been very happy with her all spring but she has been running on firm tracks and probably unsuitable distances. She was OK the other day in the Herbert Power, but that was on a Good 3," O'Brien said.

"It was a Soft 7 today and she grew another leg. She was never going to get beaten."  $\,$ 

Jamie Kah, who rode four winners on the ten-race Moonee Valley card, said of Miami Bound: "She always travelled like the winner. Danny gets his horses so fit and Daniel Moor told me how well she had been working."

Miami Bound will now head to the Melbourne Cup at Flemington on November 3 where she will carry 51 kilograms.

"She will definitely be an acceptor (for the Melbourne Cup) now," O'Brien said.


"She has won that impressively and when you are that close to her it is pretty hard not to run.

"It has been difficult for those fillies who have won an Oaks to come back and win a Melbourne Cup, I don't think it has happened for 30 or 40 years, but we will be there on the first Tuesday (of November) and giving it a crack"

Miami Bound (4 m Reliable Man - Arapaho Miss by Danehill Dancer) is a half-sister to O'Brien's Listed winner De Little Engine (Encosta De Lago) and three other winners. A NZ\$120,000 purchase from the New Zealand Bloodstock Karaka Yearling Sale, Miami Bound has had 14 starts for five wins and the prize-money earnings of \$1.228 million.

She is the daughter of VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Arapaho Miss, who is a half-sister to the Group 1-placed Heartsareforlove (Hussonet) and Cardiac (Encosta De Lago), the dam of Group 3 winner Declarationofheart (Declaration Of War).

Arapaho Miss has a two-year-old named Gabriellagrace (Swiss Ace) and a yearling brother to Miami Bound by Reliable Man.

### Six for Camelot

Coolmore's Camelot (Montjeu) sired his sixth individual elite level winner when Sir Dragonet (5 h ex Sparrow by Oasis Dream) triumphed in the 100th running of the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) at Moonee Valley yesterday. Formerly trained in Ireland by Aidan O'Brien, he was last seen running second to Magical (Galileo) in the Tattersalls Gold Cup (Gr 1, 1m2f) and was winning for the third time in ten starts as he made a successful debut for the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace team. He took the honours by a length and a quarter from the O'Brien runner Armory (Galileo) whilst Russian Camelot (Camelot) was third. Sir Dragonet hails from a potent European family, being a son of the stakes-placed, juvenile winner Sparrow (Oasis Dream), who is a half-sister to Cheshire Oaks (Listed, 1m 3.5f) winner Wonder Of Wonders (Kingmambo), while his third dam is Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Urban Sea (Miswaki), who is the dam champions Sea The Stars (Cape Cross) and Galileo (Sadler's Wells). Former shuttler Camelot now resides permanently at Coolmore in Ireland where his fee in 2020 was €40,000 (approx. AUD\$66,500).

### Homesman Mackinnonbound after Crystal Mile win

A step back up into Group 1 company is on the cards for Homesman (War Front) after he led throughout to land the Crystal Mile (Gr 2, 1600m) at Moonee Valley vesterday. The Anthony and Sam Freedman-trained six-yearold left the form of his Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) defeat firmly in the past as he beat Age Of Chivalry (He's Remarkable) by two lengths, with Kings Will Dream (Casamento) another length and a quarter away in third and in the process put himself into contention for next month's Mackinnon Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m). "It's great to get him into winning form and it's great to get a winner for Lloyd (Williams)," Brad Taylor, representing the Freedmans, told Racing.com. "We were excited to get this horse when they changed trainers and getting him back to winning form at his favourite track and distance. He's a bit of a lazy track worker but he was fit and had done a hell of a lot of work at Macedon. He's been with us over the last eight weeks. Ben (Melham, jockey) has done his last few gallops and was happy with him earlier in the week. It's great to see."

### Six for Deep Field

A late decision to let Portland Sky (3 c ex Sky Rumba by Shrewd Rhythm) take his chance on a wet track paid dividends as the Matt Laurietrained colt won for the second time in four starts when landing vesterday's Red Anchor Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Moonee Valley. Winning jockey Ben Melham revealed after the three quarters of a length success over Bella Nipotina (Pride Of Dubai) that it was only an intervention on his behalf which led to the winner lining up. "I actually had to talk him into running this horse because he texted me at 9:30am and said he might scratch and I said 'don't you dare', so thankfully he didn't," Melham told racing. com. "He's a lovely colt. He did a good job to win actually, he's got good gate speed and his runs have been good in his first preparation, I just felt he's really been looking for the 1200 metres," Melham continued. Portland Sky became the sixth individual stakes winner for Deep Field (Northern Meteor) with yesterday's victory. Deep Field stands at Newgate for a fee of \$55,000 (inc GST) in 2020.

### Coolmore outing still option for Red Anchor winner

Matt Laurie could choose to backup Portland Sky in next week's \$1.5 million Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) he revealed after yesterday's win. "We're not nominated, obviously just see how he pulls up," Laurie said. "It's his first preparation and we want to be looking after him. It may not be the right thing, but if he was jumping out of his skin, you never know."

### **Second for Dissident**

Yes Baby Yes (3 f ex Exabelle by Exceed And Excel) proved to be a cut above her rivals when leading throughout to bag yesterday's Fillies' Classic (Gr 2, 1600m) at Moonee Valley. Trained by Leon and Troy Corstens, Yes Baby Yes registered her second win in nine starts when beating Ecumenical (Zebedee) by three and three quarter lengths with another two lengths back to Miss Inbetween (Fighting Sun) in a spaced out field. Yes Baby Yes became the second stakes winner for Newgate resident Dissident (Sebring) who stands for a fee of \$11,000 (inc GST) in 2020.

### Three in a row for Sovereign Award

Sovereign Award (Shamus Award) kept his winning run going when registering a third successive victory by taking out the Tesio Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m), one of four victories on the Cox Plate card for Jamie Kah. The Danny O'Brien-trained mare beat I Am Eloquent (I Am Invincible) by three quarters of a length, that one getting the better of Paradee (Epaulette) in their tussle for second.

### 59 for I Am Invincible

I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) sired his 59th individual stakes winner when his daughter La Mexicana (3 f ex Cailin Miss by Domesday) took out yesterday's Crockett Stakes (Listed, 1200m) under in form Jamie Kah. The Anthony and Sam Freedman-trained three-year-old was winning for the third time in four starts when narrowly edging out Twain's Express (Helmet), while Highly Discreet (Street Boss) was two and a half lengths away in third. I Am Invincible stands for a fee of \$209,000 (inc GST) in 2020.

### 161 for Fastnet Rock

Sneaky Five (2 f ex Small Minds by Canny Lad) has repaid Rosemont Stud for its investment in the Fastnet Rock (Danehill) filly with a debut win in yesterday's \$500,000 Inglis Banner (RL, 1000m) at Moonee Valley. The Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained filly, who was purchased for \$305,000 from the Goldin Farms at the Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale, is the 161st stakes winner for Coolmore's champion stallion Fastnet Rock who stands for a fee of \$165,000 (inc GST) this year. Ridden by Jamie Kah, Sneaky Five defeated stablemate The Art Of Flying (Flying Artie) by one and a quarter lengths, with the Robbie Griffiths and Mathew de Kock-trained Tempest Charm (Trust In A Gust) a neck away in third.

### Sneaky Five overcomes inexperience

Ciaron Maher gave credit for the win to the horse's owner, Rosemont Stud's Anthony Mithen, who suggested he run Sneaky Five in the 1000-metre Inglis Banner instead of giving her another jump out. "She was the most inexperienced of all of ours and to give 'Mitho' some credit, we had a conversation after she'd trialled very well the first time," Maher said. "Mitho said 'what about going to the races with her' and I said I'd take her to The Valley for a gallop and she was very impressive and progressed the right way, so we rolled the dice. What a nice second jump out for \$500,000."

### A sneaky five grand pays off

Rosemont Stud principal Anthony Mithen recounted the story of buying Sneaky Five at Oaklands Junction earlier this year. "We had a limit of \$300,000 but got on the wrong leg and were \$290,000 and Brae Sokolski and Matt Scown beat us to the \$300,000 bid but I stood there with Nige (Austin) and I said to him 'if you were going to be \$300,000, you could be \$305,000 couldn't you? And he said 'yeah, go on, let's be brave' so we put in a little \$5000 bid...we broke our rule and went \$5k over and the auctioneer [Chris Russell] bought the gavel down and said 'well done Mitho, the sneaky five wins.' We had a laugh after and said, 'well, we've got her name anyway."

### **Hat-trick for Ancestry**

In-form sprinter Ancestry (The Brothers War) made it three wins in as many starts this preparation after convincingly taking out the Strathmore Community Bendigo Bank Handicap (955m), the opening race at Moonee Valley yesterday. Trained by Phillip Stokes, the four-year-old Wylie Dalziel Roy Higgins Racing-syndicated Ancestry crossed straight to the lead and was never in danger of being run down. Jungle Edge (Dubawi) was two and a quarter lengths away in second, with Holbien (Pierro) another two lengths away in third place. Stokes was weighing up whether to spell Ancestry with a view of targeting the Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) in February at Caulfield.

### **Two for Extreme Choice**

Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) and A J Moir Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) winner Extreme Choice, who is also the sire of the MRC Debutant Stakes (Listed, 1000m) placegetter Extreme Warrior, also sired Palamos who won in New Zealand vesterday. Extreme Choice stands for a fee of \$22,000 (inc GST) at Newgate Farm.

## Golden Gift possible for Tiger Of Malay

A tilt at the \$1 million Golden Gift (1100m) at Rosehill on November 7 is now on the radar for Tiger Of Malay after yesterday's winning debut. A win in that race would give him enough prize- money to be assured of a start in the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) and Michael Freedman confirmed that is the route connections are now looking at taking. "He is a lovely colt. We've been fortunate enough to be given a few of these by Newgate and their bloodstock partnerships," Freedman said. "He will learn a lot from today. There is improvement to come."

### Positive Peace ploughs through Randwick mud

Positive Peace (Stratum) continued trainer Bjorn Baker's successful Sydney carnival by taking out yesterday's Nivison (Gr 3, 1200m) at Randwick. The five-year-old mare started at \$16 but proved too classy for her rivals, beating Wandabaa (Wandjina) by a neck with Athiri (Lonhro) a further length and a quarter away. "Super result, she's a class mare," Baker said. "She'd won eight of 20, she's won a Group 2 on a wet track. I couldn't believe the price today, not that I worry about that. I don't know what happened last time but the team have changed a few things back from the mile and it's been a super job." Baker said he will now aim Positive Peace towards the Hot Danish Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Rosehill on November 7.

### 20 for Nicconi

The Bopper (3 g ex Chicago by Artie Schiller) moved his career tally to three wins from four starts as he made a successful debut in stakes company with victory in yesterday's Brian Crowley Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Randwick. Trained by Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott, the six-year-old was winning for the fifth time in his 11th start when beating Rondinella (Ocean Park) by half a length. So You Think stands at Coolmore for a fee of \$38,500 this year.

### 29 for Dream Ahead

Magical Dream (3 f ex Mystic Hour by Redoute's Choice) stretched her unbeaten run to three with victory in yesterday's Belgravia Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Ascot. Trained in partnership by Grant and Alana Williams, the filly maintained her perfect record when beating Mystical View (Canford Cliffs) and Watch Me Dance (I'm All The Talk) by just over a length and a quarter. Yesterday's victory provided former shuttler Dream Ahead (Diktat) with his 29th individual stakes winner. Dream Ahead stood at Haras de Grandcamp for a fee of €12,000 (approx. AUD\$19,950) in 2020.

Racing Victoria stewards charged Prebble with improper riding after he partnered Lunar Fox (Foxwedge) to finish seventh of eight in the Moonee Valley Vase (Gr 2, 2040m). The stewards said Prebble rode "unnecessarily tight with his mount's head turned in" at the 1500-metre mark which led to him receiving the 20-meeting penalty for improper riding. He was additionally suspended for careless riding when permitting his mount to shift inwards at the 1300-metre mark. His 12-meeting suspension will be served concurrently with his improper riding ban. Prebble, who has the right to appeal, will be sidelined until November 12.

### Boss hit with fine for celebrations

Glen Boss was given fines totalling \$2000 for his celebrations following Sir Dragonet's victory in the Cox Plate. Boss was fined \$1000 by the stewards for his celebration when he rose high in the stirrups before crossing the line, and also then hit with a penalty for the same amount for breaching Covid 19 protocols by hugging stable staff after dismounting.

### Giant win signals December intent, Courier Wonder dazzles on debut

ighty Giant (Power) sealed a fifth consecutive win with an impressive performance in the Class 2 Argyle Handicap (1400m) at Sha Tin yesterday, which had trainer Ricky Yiu eyeing Group 1 targets.

"There's every possible chance he'll run on International Day because there could be no overseas runners," Yiu said, referring to December's HK\$95 million LONGINES Hong Kong International Races.

The smart chestnut broke evenly from gate ten under Zac Purton, who mustered his mount forward to settle close to the speed. Mighty Giant hit the front at the 200m mark and kept smart rivals at bay for a neck winning margin.

"He's an honest horse, he gets up there and makes his own luck and he's a fighter – he's a winner," Purton said of the five-year-old.

The win sealed a treble for Purton, who earlier in the afternoon had ended a 33-ride winless streak stretching back to October 11.

The win was Mighty Giant's classiest to date as he defeated a field featuring leading Four-Year-Old Classic Series prospects, Sky Field (Deep Field) and Lucky Express (Toronado). That duo ran with credit to finish third and fourth respectively.

"The pace early on absolutely suited my horse according to Zac Purton, and he travelled as a lovely horse," Yiu said. "He was so relaxed and he was always waiting for the signal and once he asked him to kick he really accelerated – a lovely horse."

The Power (Oasis Dream) gelding takes his record to six wins from nine starts and Yiu is eyeing a pair of Class 1 contests as his next start before a potential tilt toward the HK\$25 million Hong Kong Mile (Gr 1, 1600m).

"I spoke to Zac right after the race, there's a few feature races we have to think about but I'm not sure which one we'll go for: there's the Panasonic Cup over 1400m and the Chevalier

Cup over the mile next month, there's a lot of time to make a decision," Yiu said.

Purton kicked off his treble with victory aboard Hong Kong International Sale graduate Beauty Angel (Dark Angel) in the Class 4 Waterloo Handicap (1800m).

Immediately before Mighty Giant's success in the finale, Purton drove the Danny Shumtrained Lockheed (Exceed And Excel) to his long overdue first Hong Kong win at his 24th Hong Kong start, in the Class 3 Dundas Handicap (1200m).

"He's always had problems, so I'm very thankful to the owner who has been patient and has given me a lot time," Shum said.

The grey was a Group 1 placegetter preimport, having finished third in the National Stakes (Gr 1, 7f) at the Curragh as a two-yearold when under the care of trainer William Haggas.

The win secured a double for Shum, who claimed the race prior with Baltic Success (Exceed And Excel) in the Class 3 Bedford Handicap (1000m) under Jerry Chau, who also took two winners on the card. The apprentice earlier claimed the Class 4 Pitt Handicap (1400m) aboard the Francis Lui-trained Sunny Star (Flatter).

### Courier Wonder dazzles towards a bright future

Courier Wonder (Sacred Falls) was the talk of Sha Tin with a dazzling debut success that had trainer John Size brimming with anticipation for what his talented youngster has in store

"I'm very excited to have a horse like that, I haven't had one for a while and I was wondering at the beginning of this season where the good horse was going to come from and I think we've found one already," Size said.

The 11-time champion trainer is no stranger to unveiling a good one on debut, with the likes of recent Group 1 winners Beat The Clock (Hinchinbrook), Mr Stunning (Exceed And Excel) and Ivictory (Mossman) all winning at their first try, but this one managed to mug his rivals by five and a quarter lengths. The gelding turned heads as he drew clear ahead of another of the season's well-regarded young guns, the 1.4 race-favourite Everyone's Delight (El Roca).

"In Hong Kong, if a three-year-old first starter wins by a margin, then normally they're going to go all-the-way," Size said.

Jockey Joao Moreira mustered the New Zealand-bred to the front from barrier three and from there he was never headed.

"When we were about to cross the line I just could not believe he was winning that easily – he's one of a kind," Moreira said.

The Sacred Falls (O'Reilly) youngster crossed the line first in a recent trial at Conghua and was a NZ\$150,000 (approx. HK\$775,516) purchase out of the 2019 Karaka National Yearling Sale in New Zealand.

"I was very impressed with his trial at Conghua a couple of weeks ago, so when John (Size) said he was going to run soon I was quite excited about it," Moreira said.

"I couldn't have foreseen him winning as he did. Of course, the handicapper is going to stop him eventually but it's going to take him a while to get there because he won so impressively. It looks like as a young horse, he is immature but he has everything within himself to improve even more. I'm very impressed."

The win was the first of a double for the Brazilian ace who also claimed the Class 3 Fife Handicap (1600m) aboard the Me Tsui-trained Great Treasure (Husson).

### **Money for Hayes**

David Hayes snapped a two-month run of outs thanks to Moneymore's (Reward For Effort) sweeping victory in section two of the Class 5 Wylie Handicap (1400m) under Keith Yeung.

"It was a little bit frustrating but it's nice to get the monkey off the back. Every time I got a bit flat I would walk through my stables and look at all my new horses – I have 50 of them," Hayes said.

"I have to be patient as I know I have some very nice young horses coming."

Hayes' third win of the campaign came with Moneymore, who gave the handler his first success since he bagged a double at the season-opening fixture.

"I think going to Conghua provided a little change of environment that helped him. I think the addition of the winkers certainly helped him because he wobbled last start and Keith Yeung gave him a 12 out of ten ride.

"Keith (Yeung) does a lot of work for me, so it's great to see Keith win on him," Hayes said.

Dennis Yip bagged a race-to-race double as Goko (O'Reilly) landed the Class 4 Hamilton Handicap (1000m) under Antoine Hamelin before Matthew Poon drove stable stalwart The Full Bloom (Zebedee) to victory in section one of the Class 5 Wylie Handicap (1400m).

Hong Kong racing continues on Wednesday (28 October) at Happy Valley.

He moved up (three wide) from the 600m, challenged at the turn and then kept fighting on well for third. Mugatoo settled beyond midfield and deep. He moved up (wide) from the 800m, challenged (widest of all) at the turn and then battled strongly for (3.5 lengths) fourth, staging a very good effort. Arcadia Queen settled near the tail of the field, tracked up (wide with cover) from the 700m and then fought really well for (3.8 lengths) fifth in a sound effort especially considering the affected track where she has had no prior success. Fierce Impact settled near last, improved between runners coming to the turn and then strongly for (4.3 lengths) sixth, while Probabeel was handily placed, challenged at the home turn before holding on quite well to finish (4.5 lengths) seventh.
