Fierce Impact's potential Chipping Norton milestone for his sire Deep Impact

Norton Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) could create a new milestone for his champion Japanese sire Deep Impact (Sunday Silence) and enhance the import's stallion credentials both domestically and internationally.

No son of the late Deep Impact has won more than two races at the highest level, which

includes the likes of sire-sons Real Impact, Mikki Isle, Saxon Warrior and Tosen Stardom, but the Matthew Smith-trained entire gets the chance to eclipse that benchmark at Randwick on Saturday.

Prominent Victorian owner Ozzie Kheir has already been appointed to handle negotiations with studmasters from Australia and overseas on behalf of the Seymour Bloodstock-led syndicate who part-own the six-year-old Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) and Cantala Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) winner.

Stallion farms have already been circling Kheir about potentially buying into the Trent Busuttin and Natalie Youngtrained Tagaloa, who is likely to head to Sydney for the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) in an attempt to further enhance his value as a stud prospect which skyrocketed after his Blue Diamond victory.

Agent Mark Pilkington, who manages Darren Thomas' Seymour Bloodstock portfolio of racing and breeding stock, and also has a close association with Busuttin and Young, revealed yesterday that Kheir had fielded calls about Tagaloa and Fierce Impact.

"You can draw the analogy that Lord Kanaloa is the I Am Invincible on the way up and Deep Impact is the Redoute's Choice of Australia," he said.


"Fierce Impact, if he wins the Chipping Norton, becomes the first three-time Group 1-winning colt by the champion sire Deep Impact anywhere in the world, so it is pretty significant for him with that race on

"When you are talking about the burgeoning Japanese influence they are having on the industry, (Tagaloa and Fierce Impact) are two colts that are probably front and centre of all the studmasters from literally around the world now."

Lord Kanaloa is the sire of star Japanese mare Almond Eye, who is among his 15 stakes winners to date, and he is currently third on Japan's leading general sires table this year, trailing Deep Impact and Heart's Cry (Sunday Silence).

He was also crowned Japan's leading first season sire in 2017 with 32 individual juvenile winners, while Deep Impact, who died in July last year aged 17, is on track to win his ninth consecutive sire premiership this year.

"As a breed on the whole, the Japanese are internationally very well respected and you only have to see what happened at last year's spring carnival here in winning the Caulfield Cup and Cox Plate, they have winners everywhere and they are a bloodline that Australia is yearning for really," Pilkington said. << Continued from page 2 "Arrowfield Stud's Iohn Messara has been ahead of his time in getting all those breeds down here in consultation with (Shadai Stallion Station's) Katsumi Yoshida.

"I am sure we will be doffing our hats to them in years to come."

Fierce Impact was sourced from the 2017 Tattersalls Autumn Horses in Training Sale in Europe for 120,000gns by Smith and the now six-year-old returned from his stellar spring campaign with a first-up second in the C F Orr Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield on February 8 before returning to Smith's Sydney stable.

"Fierce Impact was tried as a stayer in Europe and the philosophy (for buying him) was that he had a pedigree to be a miler," Pilkington said.

"Funnily enough, not long after we bought him, there was a full-brother to him in Japan (Keiai Nautique) who won a two-year-old Group 1 mile.

"Once we worked out to keep Fierce Impact at a mile, he won those two miles during the spring and he has got a proper maternal pedigree.

"We can't put a two-year-old record alongside him now, but he could be the winningest (Group 1) colt by Deep Impact.

"There is international interest in him as well, so I would say it is exciting times for the Japanese breed and the integration of it down here."

Pilkington believes Tagaloa will hold a lot of currency at stud even if he does not add to his Group 1 record.

"There's a lot of appeal and he is by the young and up-and-coming sire in Japan and he is Danehill-free, which is great as well," he said.

Tagaloa was a \$300,000 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale purchase by Busuttin Racing from the Arrowfield Stud draft, with the "all Japan-bred" colt the first-named foal out of the winning Heart's Cry (Sunday Silence) mare Vasilissa, who in turn is a half-sister to Listed winner Tricolore Bleu (Stay Gold).

Four for Pride Of Dubai

Maha (2 f ex Makrooma by Fastnet Rock) scored on debut at Bendigo yesterday, continuing the momentum of her Coolmore first season sire Pride Of Dubai (Street Cry) so far this season. The fourth winner for Pride Of Dubai, the Tony and Calvin McEvoy-trained Maha is a homebred for Sheikh Mohammed Bin Khalifa Al Maktoum and she started her career in the perfect manner by defeating Awkward (Teofilo) by a neck in a 2YO Fillies Maiden Plate (1000m). D'Arbanville (All Too Hard) was another two and a quarter lengths away in third. Pride Of Dubai, who covered an increased 176 mares in 2019, is also the sire of the stakes winner Tanker and the stakes-placed fillies Bella Nipotina and Dubai Star. The pair are nominated for the Sweet Embrace Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Randwick on Saturday.

Sidestep to stay at Telemon

Sidestep (Exceed And Excel), the sire of first crop Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Kiamichi, will remain at Queensland's Telemon Thoroughbreds for at least a third season. Darley, who owns the rising ten-year-old stallion, yesterday confirmed that the Pago

Pago Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) winner would not return to NSW this season. "We think it's a pretty special time for this sire line," Telemon Thoroughbreds' Dan Fletcher said. "Sidestep went to stud as Exceed And Excel's only champion two-year-old colt and has emulated his great sire in achieving champion first season sire status. He's a horse that's had to 'build his own house' insofar as he's started at a modest fee with lesser opportunity. From that base, he's thrown five first crop stakes horses already across both hemispheres." After covering 112 mares last year at \$22,000 (inc GST), a service fee for 2020 has not yet been announced.

Alligator Blood a juggling act for Vandyke

David Vandkye believes Saturday's Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) favourite Alligator Blood (All Too Hard) is 'still peaking' ahead of his fifth run this preparation, although the trainer sounded a slight note of caution regarding the return to 1600 metres for his CS Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) winner. "Barriers will play a big part in how he goes, and we are a little bit nervous at the mile at Flemington," Vandyke told Racing.com. "His only defeat obviously he had excuses - but his only defeat has been stepping out to the mile. But he's bounced back well off the C S Hayes. He's been up a while, but I think he's still peaking. It's a bit of a juggling act because we don't want to work him too hard. He took a few days to get over that run, and I guess we're going to find out on Saturday how much the C S Hayes took out of him." Vandyke continued: "It's just a matter of trying to keep him up. He's had a bit of a long preparation. I wouldn't say he's come forward, but I think he's going to run as well as he did in the C S Hayes."

Probabeel on song for Surround

Jamie Richards believes Probabeel (Savabeel) is in better order than when she last raced in Sydney which resulted in a placing in the Flight Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m). The Brendan and Jo Lindsay-owned Probabeel returned to New Zealand where she scored back-to-back wins including in the Karaka 3YO Classic (RL, 1600m) on January 25, a performance that confirmed plans for a tilt at this weekend's Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick. "She is in good shape, she trialled well and worked nicely on Saturday and again this morning," Richards said yesterday. "She is a stronger filly than she was when she was here in the spring."

Shark on the improve ahead of Chipping Norton

Te Akau Shark (Rip Van Winkle) will also contest a Group 1 race at Randwick on Saturday for trainer Jamie Richards, with the exciting five-year-old out to avenge a narrow defeat in the Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) last spring. He is line line to run in the Chipping Norton Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) after returning from a spell with a dominant display in the BCD Group Sprint (Gr 1, 1400m) at Te Rapa on February 8. "We like to get him over a little bit earlier and get him settled because he is not a horse with a great appetite," Richards said. "He takes a little while to settle in. It worked in nicely with Probabeel trialling that they came

over together. He has tightened and looks a fitter horse, not that he wasn't a fit horse in New Zealand. He's in good shape."



Begood Toya Mother could bypass Flemington

The Daniel Bowman-trained Begood Toya Mother (Myboycharlie), who holds a nomination in the Shaftesbury Avenue Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Flemington on Saturday, could bypass the race in favour of the Canterbury Stakes (Gr 1, 1300m) at Randwick seven days later. "We're not sure if we are going to run," Bowman told Racing.com yesterday in respect of this weekend's engagement. "The weight spread is going to be a bit against us. We'll have a gallop tomorrow and have a look at how it comes up and if he's all good, we could go around and if not, we'll wait for Sydney next week. The 1300 metres (of the Canterbury) is probably the right distance. It's just been one of those races over the years that has small fields."

No Blamey for Bart

Lindsey Smith has opted out of running Black Heart Bart (Blackfriars) in the Blamey Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) at Flemington on Saturday, which subsequently rules the nine-year-old out of next month's All-Star Mile (1600m), with the Blamey winner guaranteed a place in the \$5 million contest. "He's not running this Saturday," Smith told Racing.com. "It's a bit hard for him at his age and I just want him to win another race this prep." Black Heart Bart has won 17 of his 59 starts, amassing \$4,732,950 in prize-money. In addition, Smith also confirmed Adelaide Ace (Savabeel) will miss Saturday's Australian Guineas and instead be targeted at Moonee Valley's Alister Clark Stakes (Gr 2, 2040m), run on March 13, with the Autumn Classic (Gr 2, 1800m) winner being set for the WATC Derby (Gr 2, 2400m) further down the line.

Patient approach for promising Shepard

Progressive stayer Shepard (Sea The Moon) will try to make it four wins from five starts when he returns from a spell in the Thoroughbred Club Handicap (1800m) at Sandown today. The David Brideoake-trained three-year-old, who is owned by Peter Moody, is nominated for the Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m), but he might instead try to gain ballot exemption for the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) by taking in the Andrew Ramsden Stakes (Listed, 2800m) later in the campaign should he continue to improve. "He could potentially have a pretty nice future but there won't be a lot of rush to go on in the autumn," Brideoake said. "I think after autumn, come spring, there might be a horse that might be in the better quality races." Regarding today's race, the trainer continued: "I expect him to go well on Wednesday. He's worked well, he's trained well. We have to kick off somewhere and he might run out of puff towards the end, but he'll be improved and we'll add a bit of distance to him after this race. He's a lovely horse and I would say he has come in better this time."

Standout impresses at Rosehill

Expressway Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) winner Standout (Excel And Excel) remains firmly on course for next month's Canterbury Stakes having impressed trainer Gerald Ryan with a barrier trial success over 1130 metres at Rosehill yesterday. The three-year-old, whose only defeat in five starts came when running second to Cosmic Force (Deep Field) in last October's Roman Consul Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m), coasted to a short-neck victory over the Chris Waller-trained Imaging (Oasis Dream) in a time of 1:02.89 (last 600 metres in 34.40). "I thought he was good and it is about what you expect from him," Ryan said. "He is a genuine Group horse and with the run under the belt now he will go straight to the Canterbury Stakes. He has had an easy time since he won. We gave him a gallop last Tuesday and he has a nice blow. He has pulled up from his trial super."

Booker also performs well

Standout's new stable companion, last year's Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) winner Booker (Written Tycoon), also impressed when pulling five and a quarter-lengths clear of five-time Group 1 winner Santa Ana Lane (Lope De Vega) in a Rosehill trial yesterday. Formerly trained by Mathew Ellerton and Simon Zahra, Booker won

her 900-metre heat in 53.70 (last 600 metres in 33.40). "I thought she was good and they ran a good time," Ryan said. "She came into work in early December and we have just been fiddling around with some gear on her. We haven't made up our mind what we want to do with her but there are races like the Challenge Stakes or Wenona Girl first-up we could look at." The Wenona Girl Quality (Gr 3, 1200m) and the Challenge Stakes (Gr 2, 1000m) are both staged at Randwick on March 7. A date with The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m) a fortnight later could follow should Booker return to her best first-up.

Zoustyle wins trial

At the Doomben session yesterday, the Tony Gollan-trained Zoustyle (Zoustar) also stepped out publicly for the first time this preparation, winning his heat comfortably in the fastest of the 840-metre barrier trials of the morning. Ridden by Baylee Nothdurft, Zoustyle showed his customary speed to lead heat 16, before kicking clear to win by three and three-quarter lengths in 48.37 seconds. In the previous heat, trainer Rob Heathcote unearthed a potential classy two-year-old when Better Get Ready (Better Than Ready) showed superior speed and a strong final sectional to win his trial by seven lengths.

Fierce Impact an All-Star emergency

Dual Group 1 winner Fierce Impact (Deep Impact) heads the list of provisional emergency runners for the All-Star Mile (1600m) at Caulfield, although the Chipping Norton Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m)-bound entire could still be granted a wildcard entry. Fierce Impact heads the emergencies having amassed the highest eligible prize-money through his wins in the Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) and Cantala Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m), coming clear of the James Cummings-trained trio of Alizee (Sepoy), Avilius (Pivotal) and Flit (Medaglia d'Oro).

Connections of 21 of the original nominations who missed selection in last week's public vote have confirmed they want their horses to remain in contention for a spot as one of four emergencies when the final field is declared on March 10. The four emergencies will not be given a barrier and take the starting position of a scratching, if there is one.

Nature Strip topweight for Newmarket

Nature Strip (Nicconi) will join an elite group of horses if he wins the Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) after being given the topweight of 58 kilograms. The Chris Waller-trained gelding will become only the fourth horse in the past 50 years to carry 58 kilograms or more to win the Group 1 sprint at Flemington should he emerge victorious on March 7. A total of 30 horses remain in contention for the Newmarket Handicap after yesterday's release of weights. Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) winner Gytrash (Lope De Vega) is second topweight with 56 kilograms with Zoutori (Zoustar) and Deprive (Denman) next in line with 54 kilograms. Loving Gaby (I Am Invincible), the winner of the Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Moonee Valley last October and a first-up third in the Lightning Stakes has 51.5 kilograms and is one of 11 three-year-olds remaining in the entries, which also includes Exceedance (Exceed And Excel) (53 kilograms), Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) (53 kilograms) and Libertini (I Am Invincible) (50 kilograms).

Gaby flying ahead of Group 1

Loving Gaby was promoted to TAB's \$4.50 favourite for the Newmarket following the publication of yesterday's weights and Craig Williams, who has ridden the three-year-old in her last three starts, is brimming with excitement ahead of next month's assignment. "I galloped her before she resumed in the Lightning and she galloped solidly and I loved her attitude as she was a lot more settled," Williams told Racing. com. "Then she ran and I believe if we were in the same race (she was on the opposite side of the track to quinella horses Gytrash and Redzel), we would have won the Lightning. Then, working her yesterday morning, I couldn't be more impressed

how much she's come on from her first-up run and I'm really excited going into the Newmarket now."

Happy Clapper, Avilius head Doncaster weights

Veteran Happy Clapper (Teofilo) shares top weight with Godolphin's Avilius for the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) after the pair were both given 58 kilograms for the \$3 million handicap. However, the popular gelding, who won the race two years ago carrying 57 kilograms, is unlikely to run at Randwick with the Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) on April 11, a week after the Doncaster, his probable target. The Mark Newnham-trained Quackerjack (Not A Single Doubt) is guaranteed a start in the Doncaster courtesy of his win in the Villiers Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) in December and will carry 51 kilograms with Rachel King to ride. Quackerjack, who is a \$26 chance for the Doncaster, will make his return in Saturday's Liverpool City Cup (Gr 3, 1300m).

Mozu Ascot aimed at Sydney carnival

The new \$8 favourite for the Doncaster is Japanese horse Mozu Ascot (Frankel) who is entering quarantine ahead of his trip to Australia following his win in the February Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) on the dirt at Tokyo on Sunday. Prepared by Yoshito Yahagi, trainer of Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) winner Lys Gracieux (Heart's Cry), Mozu Ascot has been given 57 kilograms in the Doncaster. "He is a great horse who has now won both a turf Grade One and a dirt Grade One," Yahagi said. "His condition was better than the previous race, so I expected the result, although I was nervous. I will take him to Australia to contest the Doncaster Mile, and the main target this year would be the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile."

Sydney Cup weights released

Meanwhile, Avilius has also been allotted topweight (58 kilograms) for the Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) at Randwick on April 11 with Saturday's Rosehill winner Master Of Wine (Maxios) the \$6 favourite with the TAB after being given 52.5 kilograms. A total of 104 nominations were weighted for this year's

Sydney Cup, which is staged on day two of The Championships. Eight runners from last year's Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) remain among the nominations, including placegetters Prince Of Arran (Shirocco) (57 kilograms) and Il Paradiso (Galileo) (54.5 Kilograms). Japanese entry Kiseki (Rulership) has 57.5 kilograms in the Cup, while British horses Young Rascal (Intello), trained by William Haggas, and the Ed Dunlop-trained Red Verdon (Lemon Drop KId) both have 54 kilograms.

WA's Bennett to represent state

Kristy Bennett will form part of an all-female team who will represent Western Australia in the National Apprentice series which kicks off in Tasmania next week. Bennett will take part in the final leg of the series in Adelaide on April 1 where she will do battle against some of the best apprentice riders in Australia. "It's a great opportunity to be racing against different riders in a different state and environment," Bennett told The Races WA. "It will be good to test yourself against riders from around Australia, some of the best apprentices going around. I'm involved in the final leg of the series where the winning result may come down to me, so the pressure might be on." Bennett, who has ridden 28 winners this season, joins team mates Jade McNaught, Chloe Azzopardi and Beaux Banovic Edwards.

South Africa provides updates for Mill Park

Camelot's (Montjeu) newest stakes winner Crown Towers, who took out the Jet Master Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Kenilworth in South Africa at the weekend, provided another important pedigree update for South Australian farm Mill Park. The success of Australian-bred Crown Towers, who is out of Miss With Attitude (Galileo), in South Africa follows on from fellow Mill Park graduate Run Fox Run (Foxwedge) who won her first five starts on the trot highlighted by Grade 2 win, before running fourth in the Cape Flying Championship (Gr 1, 1000m) on February 1. Not only will Mill Park offer Crown Towers' half-brother by American Pharoah (Pioneerof The Nile) at the Inglis Australian Easter Sale as Lot 80, Run Fox Run's Astern (Medaglia d'Oro) half-brother will also form part of the nursery's draft as Lot 111.

NEW ZEALAND

Sherwood Forest to stay Derby trip

Cambridge trainer Tony Pike is hoping to add another New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) to his CV when Sherwood Forest (Fastnet Rock) lines up at Ellerslie on Saturday. Pike, who landed the blue riband event in 2016 with Rangipo (Stryker), has no concerns about the step up in trip for Sherwood Forest, who kept on gamely to finish third in the Avondale Guineas (Gr 2, 2100m), but admits he will have to be at the top of his game to beat Dragon Leap (Pierro) and Two Illicit (Jimmy Choux). "I couldn't be happier with him, he's improved off that last run," Pike said. "I think he's going to be right on song for the Derby. We've just got to find a length or two to beat the two favourites but as long as it's a truly run race then he's definitely going to out-stay most of them. It was a bit of a sit-and-sprint affair in the Avondale Guineas and he just hasn't got the dash to go home in sub 34 (seconds), so we'll make it a dour staying

race and he'll prove pretty
hard to beat. If there's a
small chink in their
armour (Dragon
Leap and Two
Illicit), then we've
got every chance of
knocking them off."

Loire on track for Oaks

Pike also has hopes of Classic glory with Loire (Redoute's Choice), who contests today's Little Avondale Lowland Stakes (Gr 2, 2100m) at Hawke's Bay before potentially lining up in next month's New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m). The Group 1-winning filly finished third in the in Fillies Classic (Gr 2, 2000m) at Te Rapa on her most recent start, and her trainer is expecting her to come on for that outing. "She'll improve a lot off her Te Rapa run," he said. "She got caught back and had to come wide in a slowly-run race. Just bearing in mind what we hopefully have coming up, I may have left her a bit short as well at Te Rapa. She's worked really well since and has definitely improved off that run. She'll get a good trip from gate three and I don't think we'll have to get as far back from the draw as she has been in past starts and two of the other favoured runners have drawn a touch wide, so it wouldn't surprise me to see her turn the tables. It's not the grand final with the Oaks two and half weeks later."

Tusk out of Saudi assignment

Four horses who contested last year's Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) will line up in the US\$2.5 million (\$3.6m) Longines Turf Handicap (3000m) at this weekend's inaugural Saudi Cup meeting after a last minute setback ruled out European stayer Raymond Tusk (High Chaparral). Trained by Richard Hannon in England, the five-year-old was found to be lame on his front left leg the day before he was due to fly to Riyadh. "It's annoying as we were all geared up to go," Tom Palin, manager for ownership group Middleham Park Racing, told Racing.com. The son of High Chaparral, who finished fourth in last year's Ebor Handicap (1m 6f) at York behind Mustajeer (Medicean) and 16th in the Melbourne Cup, is likely to take a similar route again this year. His absence means a field of 13 are set to go to post in Saturday's race, including 2018 Melbourne Cup winner Cross Counter (Teofilo) and last year's Cup runner-up Prince Of Arran (Shirocco). Benbatl (Dubawi), winner of the 2018 Caulfield Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) and Magic Wand (Galileo), last year's Mackinnon Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) winner, are set to line up in the feature US\$20m (\$29m) Saudi Cup (1800m), while last year's Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 3, 2600m) winner True Self (Oscar) will contest the US\$1m (A\$1.46m) Mohamed Yousuf Naghi Motors Cup (2100m).






