Roll The Dice Racing expands into Sydney & aligns with Matt Smith

Dissident ex Excess Love and Rubick ex Lady Rah Rah fillies are the first set to join the Group 1-winning Warwick Farm trainer

Fresh off the back of two-year-old colt Profiteer's (Capitalist) stunning success in the \$2 million Inglis Millennium (RL, 1100m) earlier this month, Roll The Dice Racing has expanded into the tough Sydney market, aligning with Warwick Farm trainer Matt Smith.

The move is opportune for one of Australia's fastest growing syndication companies, with the expansion coinciding with yesterday's

announcement by Racing NSW of a \$20 million increase to its annual prize-money offering in the state from July 1.

"We are trying to crack the Sydney market and so it's very timely for us, we are really excited, it's perfect timing," said Roll The Dice Racing's operations manager Steve Travaglia.

Smith is the latest Group 1-winning trainer to join up with Roll The Dice Racing, who now have their horses well positioned in stables right along the Eastern Seaboard. *Continued page 2 >>*

Tony Gollan is their preferred trainer in Queensland, David Jolly in Adelaide and Mick Price, along with his training partner Michael Kent Jnr, in Melbourne.

"Sydney was the last market for us to set up in. It seems like more of a prestige market and a tough one to crack," said Travaglia.

"I didn't know a lot about Matt but I went through his resume and, crikey, he's got an incredible resume and record.

The introduction to Smith came about through their own regular dealings with highly respected bloodstock agents John Foote and Jeremy Rogers.

"John Foote has been buying for Matt for the past six to eight months. He advises us on bloodstock and other matters and he encouraged us to go with him," added Travaglia.

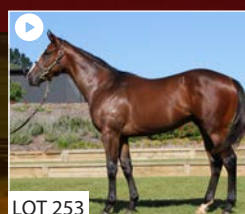

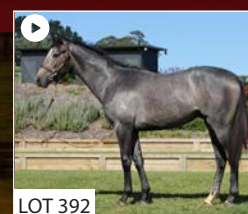

Roll The Dice Racing will send two of their recent yearling purchases to Smith, including a Dissident (Sebring) ex Excess Love (Exceed And Excel) filly from the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale and a Rubick (Encosta De Lago) x Lady Rah Rah (Choisir) filly they picked up at the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale.

"We are syndicating two with him at the moment and hoping to get up to five or six."

Roll The Dice Racing's banner horse, Profiteer, gave them just the nudge they needed to get a foothold in Sydney racing.

Travaglia reports the valuable Capitalist (Written Tycoon) colt has been ticking along quietly since his rousing performance in the Inglis Millennium at Randwick, while the likes of Home Affair (I Am Invincible) and Stay Inside (Extreme Choice) have burst onto the scene as his potential rivals in the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) on March 20 after impressive victories in the Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) and Pierro Plate (1100m) respectively.

"He galloped on Tuesday morning," said Travaglia. "Our ultimate goal is the Slipper and we will go to the Todman on the way. He won't be fully ready and at 95 per cent for that race and, if he comes out of that, win lose or draw, he will be 100 per cent ready for the Slipper."

"A lot of judges are saying it's going to be a strong year. Gee there's a lot of nice horses bobbing up and most of them are colts."

Roll The Dice Racing will be active at the upcoming Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale that begins on February 28.

"Hopefully we will walk away with three or four that meet our budget, but by all reports it's going to be a very strong sale," Travaglia added.

Inglis' general manager of bloodstock sales, Sebastian Hutch, applauded yesterday's Racing NSW prize-money announcement as inspections got underway for the Victorian sale.

"It's evident to any bloodstock professional that Australia is the most lucrative bloodstock market in the world," said Hutch.

"It's not just about the volume of million-dollar-plus races, it's prize-money across all levels. There's tremendous strength and a conscious effort on the part of administrators to grow the prize-money pool. It's a credit to the people responsible for that."

Hutch said he's "reasonably optimistic" of a good performing Premier sale and added that the impact of such bold prize-money lifts would inevitably stimulate the bloodstock market and the remainder of the yearling auction season in Australia.

"I think when prize-money in Sydney really started progressing there was always a feeling that once that flowed through to owners the knock-on effect would be very positive for us, coupled with fact it was demonstrated to be a very enjoyable and well-run sport during the Covid-19 pandemic."

Forbes to run at Canterbury

Talented two-year-old Forbes (Capitalist) is set to run at Canterbury tonight in a bid to start his Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) campaign, which has been disrupted by barrier issues. The Anthony and Sam Freedman-trained colt, runner-up in the Merson Cooper Stakes (Listed, 1000m) in Melbourne last spring, received his barrier certificate at Goulburn on Sunday after being declared a late scratching from two Sydney barrier trial heats within a matter of days. He is set to jump from barrier 11 of 12 (after the emergencies) in the 2YO Handicap (1100m). Forbes, who underwent some barrier reeducation with Goulburn trainer Mark Gee, could run in either the Todman Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) or the Black Opal Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) next weekend.

Away Game passed fit for Surround

Racing NSW's chief veterinarian Dr Toby Koenig yesterday passed Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) contender Away Game (Snitzel) fit to start in the Randwick feature race tomorrow. Trainers Ciaran Maher and David Eustace reported to stewards on Wednesday that the filly had suffered an abrasion to her offside hip when she slipped while being unloaded from the float. Koenig, Racing NSW's general manager of veterinary services, examined Away Game yesterday and determined she would be able to take her place in the race. Away Game finished third in the Light Fingers Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) having also filled that spot in the Magic Millions 3YO Guineas (RL, 1400m) in January. Glen Boss will take the ride.

Never Talk out to again exceed expectations

The runner-up in the Light Fingers, Never Talk (No Nay Never), will also contest the Surround and her trainer Kris Lees believes she will again be suited by a rain-affected track. "She has surprised me nearly every start to be honest. She just keeps improving," Lees said. "She is on trial at the trip but she's fit and well. She has been up for a little while so you're always a bit guarded about how many runs they've got in a prep but I'm seeing no signs to suggest she has come to the end of her preparation." Jason Collett will ride Never Talk from barrier seven.

Sam Freedman bids for second Group 1 success

Co-trainer Sam Freedman is hoping Surround Stakes contender La Mexicana (I Am Invincible) can provide him with a second Group 1 winner in as many weeks. Freedman and his father Anthony had their first elite-level winner as a partnership last weekend when Artorius (Flying Artie) landed the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) and connections of La Mexicana are praying for rainfall ahead of tomorrow's contest. "She's just thriving at the moment and I am hoping that they (Sydney) continue to get a lot of rain as she's probably more effective on rain-affected tracks," Freedman told Racing.com.

Dom can Shoot for gold in Guineas

The Sean Casey-trained Dom To Shoot (Shooting To Win) will aim to build on his last-start Victorian debut when lining up in the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Flemington tomorrow. Dom To Shoot finished

strongly to take fifth place in the CS Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) and Casey is confident he will improve from that performance. "We were very happy with his run. He bungled the start from a wide barrier and had to go back a long way," Casey said. "He had to make a long sweeping run and he probably peaked with 100 metres to go. He's since had a jump-out at Flemington and with the run under his belt he's ready to run well." Casey said they are hoping Dom To Shoot will run well enough to gain a wildcard into the All-Star Mile (1600m). "Hopefully he can run in the placings or do enough to catch the eye to get in," he said.

Hayes expecting improvement from Aysar

Ben Hayes is hoping Aysar (Deep Field) can break his runner-up streak in the Australian Guineas and is anticipating further improvement from the colt. Aysar has finished second on each of his last four starts, most recently behind the reopposing Tagaloa (Lord Kanaloa) in the CS Hayes Stakes on February 13. "He has been a little bit unlucky to run into the horses he has," Hayes, who trains in partnership with Tom Dabernig, told Racing.com "Three of the horses who beat him are Group 1 winners (Ole Kirk, Portland Sky and Tagaloa) and the other one we think is a very nice three-year-old (stablemate Crosshaven), so we still think he is a good horse. We thought his run in the CS Hayes was excellent and Damian Lane thought he just peaked on his run 50 metres from the line. Third-up I expect him to take improvement into the grand final, he naturally jumps well and should hold a spot from the barrier. All his gallops have been good and hopefully he can turn the tables on Tagaloa."

Young: draw not ideal for Tagaloa

Meanwhile, Natalie Young believes Tagaloa's barrier ten draw could prove to be a disadvantage as the stable chases back-to-back wins with the colt. "It's probably not really ideal," Young, who trains in partnership with Trent Busuttin, told Racing.com. "But the speed seems to be outside us so I think we should be okay. If he jumps as good as he did last time hopefully we can push up and just roll forward a little bit. It would be nice if we were drawn in the first six but let's hope they don't go too hard inside us and we can get across nicely. There's a long straight from the mile to the first corner so we've got a little bit of room." Young said they would again look to send Tagaloa to the front. "I think that's his best asset letting him bowl along and getting into a rhythm early," she added. "Luke Currie did mention after the CS Hayes that if he does need to ride him a pair back he thinks he can. He's got the top jock on him so I think he'll work it out from there."

Payne hopeful Cherry can contest Guineas

Patrick Payne is not heading into the Australian Guineas full of confidence that Cherry Tortoni (Night Of Thunder) can win, but he does believe the gelding is capable of running into a place. Cherry Tortoni finished fourth behind Tagaloa and Aysar in the CS Hayes Stakes first-up and Payne has seen improvement from him since that performance. "He's gone the right way since his first-up run," the trainer told Racing.com. "He sort of peaked a bit the last 100 metres or so, but I also think racing in tight quarters for much of the race didn't really suit him. From that barrier (17) we'll have to ride him conservatively but at least he should have a peaceful run. Realistically, he's probably a first four or first six chance but then he goes to the Alister Clark Stakes, which looks a really nice race for him."

Colette can repeat Apollo win

James Cummings is confident Colette (Hallowed Crown) can repeat her last-start Apollo Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) win when she lines up in the Chipping Norton Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick tomorrow. Colette defeated the reopposing Kolding (Ocean Park) by two lengths in the Apollo and Cummings believed she will be suited by

tomorrow's conditions. "Track and weather forecasts suggest she will have similar conditions to those she enjoyed in her impressive first-up victory," he said. "She meets similar opposition on Saturday, she is fit and healthy, and steps up to the mile. We are hopeful of a repeat performance."

Berry delighted with Master Of Wine

Tommy Berry is looking forward to partnering Master Of Wine (Maxios) in the Chipping Norton Stakes, as the gelding aims to bounce back from a difficult spring campaign. His best efforts in the spring were a fourth-placed finish in the Makybe Diva Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) and a fifth in the Turnbull Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) and Berry admits he may have contributed to Master Of Wine's lacklustre preparation by riding him aggressively first-up in the Winx Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m). "I tried to ride him on the speed and I was caught wide. I rode him to win that race instead of riding him to run well, he is a stayer so he had bigger things in mind," Berry said. "Looking back, I probably gutted him a little bit. It took him a few runs to get over that tough, first-up run." Berry was impressed with Master Of Wine when partnering him in a recent trial and added: "I was very pleased with his trial. He went super and he has definitely come on well since then. I've ridden him in a few pieces of work and he has really pleased me."

Cummings confident better Days are ahead

Best Of Days (Azamour) broke a winless drought stretching back to November 2018 when taking out the Carlyon Cup (Gr 3, 1600m) earlier this month and James Cummings is confident the seven-year-old can build on that performance in the Blamey Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) at Flemington

tomorrow. "To see him get back to winning form last start was very satisfying," said Cummings. "It had been a long time, but it came as no surprise, his lead up form in Sydney had been terrific and he's continued to please the team at Flemington. We are confident he will handle the extra ground and the step-up in class."

Jamaea to fly juvenile flag for Prices

Robert Price has not trained a Sydney Saturday two-year-old winner for almost 24 years but he is hopeful that Jamaea (Headwater) can break the long drought in tomorrow's Sweet Embrace Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m). Jamaea heads to Randwick off the back of a Kembla Grange victory on debut followed by an unlucky second in the Lonhro Plate (Listed, 1000m) earlier this month. "The last two-year-old race I won on a Saturday in Sydney was Red Ivory (April 1997), she turned out to be a pretty good mare," Price, who trains in partnership with his son Luke, told Racing NSW. "That's a long time ago. We train no different to the rest of them and you just need a bit of luck. Numbers is how you find horses, we don't have enough young ones come through the stables. Heaven knows when we are going to get another two-year-old but she's certainly one out of the box, both Luke and I think so anyway."

McEvoy: Hey Doc is vulnerable

Calvin McEvoy believes multiple Group 1 winner Hey Doc (Duporth) will be vulnerable first-up in the Bob Hoysted Handicap (Listed, 1000m) at Flemington tomorrow. The seven-year-old, who won the Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) in October, finished his spring campaign with a fifth-placed effort in November's Darley Sprint Classic (Gr 1, 1200m) and McEvoy expects him to come on for the run. "He'll be vulnerable on Saturday having only had the one jump-out," McEvoy, who trains in partnership with his father Tony, told Racing.com. "We've done probably as much as we can do, albeit with him only having that one jump-out going into the race, but he'll derive much from getting typical race-day experience this weekend. He's a rising eight-year-old, he just takes a little bit more to get fit, but he's had no setbacks and everything has gone swimmingly."

Humma bids to remain unbeaten in Plate

The John McArde-trained Tycoon Humma (Capitalist) will bid to build on his impressive winning debut in the Festival Of Racing Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at Flemington tomorrow. The filly took out a 1000-metre Bendigo maiden by two and a quarter lengths, a result that McArde was expecting. "I wasn't overly surprised (of the debut win)," McArde told Racing.com. "She was visually impressive and on the clock she was impressive. She has come through it well and Jamie (Mott) was probably happier with her work on Tuesday than he was before her debut. The market has probably gravitated to her as she's the only horse to win a race but the Godolphin horse (Kallos) has probably ran in a stronger race."

Flemington straight to suit Kallos

James Cummings agrees with McArde's comments, noting how impressed he was with Kallos' (Medaglia D'Oro) performance in the Blue Diamond Prelude (Gr 3, 1100m) at Caulfield on February 6. Kallos was beaten just two and a half lengths in that contest and the first two home, General Beau (Brazen Beau) and Anamoe (Street Boss), went on to run with credit in the Blue Diamond Stakes. "He performed very well in a strong race last start behind General Beau and Anamoe," said Cummings. "At his only run before that he was beaten a long neck when fourth at Moonee Valley. The straight track at Flemington should suit his style of racing."

Wet track worry for Morgan's Ligulate

Cody Morgan will be keeping a close watch on the skies as much as Ligulate's (Domesday) opposition in tomorrow's Tattersall's Mile

(Listed, 1600m) at the Sunshine Coast. Corbould Park was rated a Heavy 8 yesterday after copping 41 millimetres of rain in a 24-hour period until 8am, taking the weekly total to 60 millimetres. Morgan is desperate for some drying weather because he is adamant Ligulate is an inferior performer on wet tracks. "As long as he's not on anything worse than a Soft 6 or Soft 7 then he's at his best," Morgan said. "In the Country Championship Final last year we ran him on really wet ground and because he's such a big, heavy horse he's not as good on those sort of surfaces."

Hickmott thrilled by Macedon return

Rob Hickmott will likely have his first runner since returning to train for Lloyd Williams tomorrow, with Saracen Knight (Camelot) set to line up in the Wangaratta Cup (2000m). It was announced earlier this month that Hickmott would return to Macedon Lodge, with Williams keen to bring all his horses back to the training base. "It's a great honour and thrill to come back and have your name beside some of Lloyd's horses. Lloyd is so passionate, loves his horses and loves his farm," Hickmott told Racing.com. "It's a pleasure to go back there. And the improvements he has done out there are amazing. It's a terrific role for me. I can still run my business as usual. Lloyd hasn't tied me down to any hours and I'm very lucky they don't start trackwork until 9am out there. I can still watch all my horses work at Caulfield and then three days a week watch them gallop work out there. I only live five minutes from Macedon, so in the afternoon I can pop in and check on the horses and the staff and oversee the operation that way. I'm very happy."

Moody to be patient with Oxley Road

Peter Moody is planning to take his time with unbeaten colt Oxley Road (Exceed And Excel), who impressively took out the Zeditave Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) last Saturday. Speaking on his Moody On The Mic podcast, the trainer said he was delighted with the performance but will bring Oxley Road back in class for the Moomba Plate (Listed, 1100m) at Flemington on March 6. "I love to build the profile of a horse and love to teach them to win and keep them in that winning

form, so we'll keep him in his grade and just let him progress through there and learn how to be a racehorse and be six-foot tall and bulletproof, instead of jumping classes," Moody said. "He did jump up a few grades the other day although, in all fairness, most of those had only won one or two races. He'll come from a Group 3 to a Listed for his next one and if he happens to dispose of the opposition, we then might look at a throw at the stumps on the big stage."

Dunn suffers setback

Dwayne Dunn will have an operation on Monday after suffering a minor setback in his return from a neck injury. Dunn had been sidelined for five months before returning to riding last week, but he has been suffering general soreness and headaches and visited doctors on Wednesday to seek advice. "(I will) have a small procedure on Monday and hopefully that helps," Dunn told Racing.com. "It will be approximately two weeks on the sidelines to see if it's successful."

Queensland reopens border to Victorians

Queensland yearling buyers will no longer have to risk being shut out of their home state in order to attend the Inglis Melbourne Premier Sale after premier Annastacia Palaszczuk yesterday announced she would reopen the border to Victorians. Following Victoria's five-day lockdown, which ended last week, after an outbreak of Covid-19, Queensland and a number of other states had shut the borders. However, the border closure will be lifted from 1am tomorrow. Some buyers were yesterday making arrangements to fly to Melbourne to ensure they were at Oaklands Junction in time to participate in the Premier sale, which starts on Sunday.

Australian Racing Hall of Fame jockey Jim Johnson has died at the age of 92. A three-time Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner, Johnson was a highly respected figure in Australian racing, firstly as a jockey and later as an ambassador. Johnson began his career in South Australia in 1945, riding over 1,000 winners and winning four Adelaide Jockeys' Premierships, before coming to Victoria, where he achieved his most famous wins. The first of these came in 1963, where he won his first Melbourne Cup aboard Gatum Gatum (Star Of Baroda), before riding Rain Lover (Latin Lover) in his back-to-back wins in 1968 and 1969. His 1968 victory by eight lengths equalled the winning margin of Archer (William Tell), the last horse to win the Cup in successive years, in a then-record time of 3 minutes and 19 seconds – a mark that stood for 22 years. Johnson was also

a dual Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) winner (1966 and 1967) and Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) winner (1967) on Tobin Bronze (Arctic Explorer). He won a Melbourne Jockeys' Premiership in 1967, the same year in which he won his first Caulfield Cup and second Cox Plate. Following a successful riding stint in Singapore between 1970 and 1973, he closed out his career in 1976 with 2,158 race winners. He rode 125 feature race wins, including 36 at Group 1 level. Flags at Flemington will fly at half-mast tomorrow as they did when the news was announced yesterday. Jockeys will wear black armbands fittingly in the Roy Higgins Quality (Listed, 2600m) as a dual mark of respect for two former great riders.

RV drops race-day treatment charges against Laming

Racing Victoria yesterday dropped all charges against Richard Laming for the alleged race-day stomach tubing of Jamaican Rain (Manhattan Rain) in 2019. RV gave no reason for the decision and released the following statement: "The Racing Victoria stewards today withdrew charges laid against licensed trainer Richard Laming, assistant trainer Marnu Potgieter and stable employee MD Zeyaur Rahman in relation to the alleged stomach tubing or attempted stomach tubing of Jamaican Rain, which was engaged to run in the Group 3 Jim Beam Stakes over 1400 metres at Flemington racecourse on November 5, 2019. Racing Victoria has no further comment at this time." Laming was relieved with the decision. "It was the right outcome and I can just go on and prepare horses," Laming told Racing.com. "It's not ideal when you are concentrating on training horses, so it's all in the past and I'm pleased it's been put to bed."

Gelagotis cleared over high bicarb reading

The Victorian Racing Tribunal has cleared trainer Peter Gelagotis of illegally stomach-tubing one of his horses in 2019. The VRT said it could not prove the charges based on the evidence at hand. Gelagotis, who pleaded not guilty to the charges, was pleased with the decision. "I'm grateful for being given a fair and proper hearing and I believe the right decision has been made," Gelagotis told Racing.com. "We put our faith in the system and the Victorian Racing Tribunal has arrived at this

conclusion by acknowledging the evidence and facts presented to them."

Greg Stephens fined \$5,500

NSW country trainer, the Sapphire Coast-based Greg Stephens, has been fined a total of \$5,500 for two offences after St Anton (Redoute's Choice) returned a positive post-race swab to the drug betamethasone after the gelding won at Moruya on December 20 last year. At a stewards inquiry, Stephens pleaded guilty to the offence for which he was fined \$5,000. He was fined another \$500 after stewards found the notation of a treatment relevant to the St Anton inquiry contained in his stable treatment records was found to be incomplete. St Anton was disqualified as the winner of the race. Betamethasone is a corticosteroid medication available in several forms available for veterinary and human medicine, available in topical formulations for the treatment of skin irritation and inflammation.

NEW ZEALAND

Germanicus wins star-studded trial

Group 3 winner Germanicus (Rip Van Winkle) showed he is in excellent order ahead of a return to racing, winning a 1000-metre trial restricted to stakes performers at Pukekohe yesterday. The Danica Guy-trained five-year-old narrowly edged out the Lance Noble-trained Bavella (Snitzel), with the Jamie Richards pair of Prise De Fer (Savabeel) and Entriviere (Tavistock) running home nicely for third and fourth respectively. After a disappointing spring campaign which went pear shaped after an incident in the Tarzino Trophy (Gr 1, 1400m), Guy was pleased to present a happy horse at Pukekohe. "It was nice to see the horse back and wanting to do it again. He has been through the mill a little bit and had some time off and got well again," she said. "He copped a really nasty check in the first race at Hastings and we didn't really realise just how much it affected him. He lost his confidence but he was also a very sore horse. We did try and patch him up and carry on but ultimately the best course of action was to back right off, get his confidence back and then go again."

The promising three-year-old had previously been first past the post at Te Rapa earlier in the month but was relegated from first to third after causing interference over the concluding stages. "It is quite satisfying to get the 100th win on my home track, particularly with a promising horse bred and raced by Matt Goodson and Di Perron who have been great supporters," Collett said. "He is learning and he has got a lot of ability. Things are starting to fall into place. He is going to be competing for black type at some stage but it is just a matter of when he is ready to do it. There is a race on the first day of the Auckland Carnival in nine days' time, but we will just see how he comes through this."

Callsign Mav ready to rumble at Otaki

Callsign Mav (Atlante) and Advantage (Fastnet

Rock) will go head-to-head for the third time this season when they clash in the Weight-For-Age Classic (Gr 1, 1600m) at Otaki tomorrow, with connections of the former going into the race full of confidence. Callsign Mav was an upset victor when taking out the Tarzino Trophy (Gr 1, 1400m) on the opening day of the Hawke's Bay Spring Carnival, while Advantage evened the score at Te Rapa earlier this month when winning the BCD Group Sprint (Gr 1, 1400m). Callsign Mav's trainer John Bary was pleased with his gelding's runner-up effort at Te Rapa, particularly with the sectional times he ran. "He ran the fastest 800, 600, 400, and 200 metres in the race. It was the fastest 200 metres of the day, quicker than Levante who missed the start," Bary said. "He (Callsign Mav) got the sweet trip on the first day of the carnival and beat her, she was three-wide. The other day she (Advantage) got the sweet trip and we were second. It's one all and let's go again."

Southern stable a successful venture for Marsh

Stephen Marsh has four runners at today's

Riccarton meeting, including Call Me Coquette (Burgundy), an impressive placegetter on debut, and the stakes winner Exuberant (Savabeel). Call Me Coquette kicks off the Marsh runners in the NZB Insurance Pearl Series Race (1200m), sticking to the shorter trip in her first run since her debut third at Ashburton in December. "We really like her. It was a good run on debut but down the chute they might just be a bit sharp for her," the trainer said. Exuberant will be joined by Acting Up (Showcasing) in tackling the JL Barr Memorial (1200m), with the first named dropping in grade and getting a prime opportunity to return to the winner's stall for the first time since he won the Wellesley Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at Trentham on debut as a two-year-old. "He did look like a very progressive colt when he won the Wellesley. He went a good race in the (Karaka) Million and then ran second to Catalyst but he hasn't fulfilled his potential," Marsh continued. "He's got the side winkers on and back in Rating 65 grade and he's been working well so he's got to be a chance."

New process to license trackworkers

Working in conjunction with the NZ Trainers' Association, it has been agreed that a two-step process of accreditation and licensing will be introduced for aspiring trackwork riders seeking a conditional licence. Under the new guidelines, riding duties will not be permitted until evidence of completion of a practical assessment is provided to NZTR. The two-step process will apply to new applicants of both the trackwork rider licence and stablehand (riding) licence. Anyone who has held a NZTR riding licence, or who is verified as holding a race riding licence overseas, will be exempt from the accreditation process. For further information

Night Of Thunder's Love Sensation out to cause Group 1 upset in Surround

Love Sensation (Night Of Thunder) will not be called up for a fashion shoot any time soon, but Kevin Corstens has not given up on his diminutive three-year-old filly being in the subject of the winner's photo in tomorrow's Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) in Sydney.

The Victorian filly, owned by Byron Bay-based breeder Peter Raftopoulos, is \$41 for the three-year-old Group 1 race after as much as \$101 was available after acceptances on Wednesday, and trainer Corstens believes his charge can cause a boilover at Randwick.

Love Sensation also started long odds in the Light Fingers Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) on February 13, her first start in Sydney, but she closed strongly to finish fifth under Rachel King, one and three-quarter lengths behind the winner, Every Rose (Choisir).

“If we had gone left instead of right, we probably would have finished third, but apart from that, I thought it was a super run,” Corstens told ANZ Bloodstock News.

“I am not discrediting Rachel's ride or anything, I think if she was in the better part of the track, she might have finished a little bit closer.”

Love Sensation returned to Corstens' Cranbourne stables after her last start and arrived back at the Rosehill stables of David Payne on Wednesday night ahead of tomorrow's race.

“Because I work from the farm, they are out in day yards all day whereas they don't get the opportunity to do that in Sydney,” he said.

“I work her down at the beach all the time, so she is used to her environment and I always bring her back to her (normal) environment if I have a bit of time between races.”

While there were three-year-old fillies Group races on the calendar in Melbourne for Love Sensation, Corstens said the likelihood of striking wet tracks in Sydney led him to sending the filly north.

If she runs well in the Surround Stakes, she could again return to NSW for the Coolmore Classic (Gr 1, 1500m) next month.

“Her owner Peter is based in Byron Bay and he loves going to Sydney to the races and the majority of the time ... in Sydney the tracks are wet, and she does like the sting out of the ground,” he said.

“It is a bit of a bonus as Peter loves going to the races in Sydney and fortunately we've had the Covid restrictions lifted (to a degree) and we can get her up there to race.”

A Geelong maiden winner last September, Love Sensation was deemed talented enough to run in the Thousand Guineas Prelude (Gr 2, 1400m), beaten less than a length and a half when finishing fifth and, ultimately, the Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) last spring, a race in which she failed to shine.

“In the Thousand Guineas Prelude she ran a super race over the 1400 metres and she was stiff not to have won it - she was blocked for a run,” Corstens said.

“She had four starts (that preparation) going into the Thousand Guineas and she was just that little bit over the top and that's why she didn't finish it off as well as she could.

“We tipped her out, gave her a spell and she's definitely blossomed into a nicer filly this time around.”

Sam Clipperton will ride Love Sensation from barrier one in a race which has multiple Group 2 winner Dame Giselle ((Am Invincible) as the early favourite at \$4.80, ahead of the Anthony and Sam Freedman-trained La Mexicana (I Am Invincible) (\$7), a last-start Kevin Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) winner at Caulfield on February 6.

“The idea will be to give her a little bit of a chance and, with her style of racing, she is usually in the first four or five. Hopefully, she can position up on the rail, fourth, fifth, sixth, that would be perfect for her,” Corstens said.

“She is a pretty straight-forward filly. She enjoys the beach environment and she's one of those really quiet, unassuming fillies and you wouldn't pick her out of a crowd. She's bay and she's plain but she has got a big heart.”

Home Affairs, a son of Yarraman Park Stud's I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit), announced himself a stakes-winner-in-waiting when narrowly beaten by Zethus (Exceed And Excel) in the Canonbury Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) on debut and was always in control of the Silver Slipper, making use of his inside barrier to race on the speed before going on to defeat Rocket Tiger (Cluster) by a neck.

"We have always known he was a talented horse, looking at him, he certainly looks the part, he has got a great attitude and is doing everything right," said winning trainer Chris Waller in the aftermath of the race.

Miss Interiors has a Dundee (High Chaparral) colt on the ground and has been put in foal to the Arrowfield sire once again, while at this year's Inglis Easter Yearling Sale she has a yearling by leading first season sire Capitalist (Written Tycoon) listed to sell as **Lot 428**.

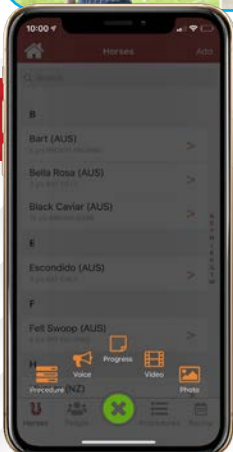

A NEW DAWN AT LENEVA PARK

Victorian-based pre-training and breeding organisation Leneva Park marked their intentions to venture into the stallion business earlier this month with the announcement they will stand three-time Group 1 winner Fierce Impact (Deep Impact) upon his retirement from racing.

The Japanese-bred seven-year-old – winner of the Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m), Cantala Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) and Makybe Diva Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) – will join incumbent stallions Royal Meeting (Invincible Spirit) and Lean Mean Machine (Zoustar) on Leneva's newly-acquired Seymour Park property, where Aquis Farm were previously based.

It is a move that has incrementally evolved for Leneva Park, who have made gradual inroads into the stallion business since owner Luke Vandersluys purchased the 260-acre property formerly owned by Rockmount Stud in July 2019 and created Leneva Park.

The operation purchased shares in Rosemont stallion Strasbourg (I Am Invincible) and Swettenham's I Am Immortal (I Am Invincible) after their retirement to stud, while in 2020, Leneva Park announced they would stand dual Group 2 winner Lucas Cranach (Mamool), however the former Australian Bloodstock-raced stallion died merely a month after acquiring him following a freak accident.

Undeterred, this venture is a firm statement of intent from Leneva Park, with Sharkie describing the opportunity as too appealing to pass up.

MOVING INTO THE STALLION SIDE OF THE INDUSTRY IS SOMETHING THAT'S BEEN ON THE RADAR AS PART OF OUR LONG-TERM PLAN AND THE OPPORTUNITY TO COME IN AND PICK UP THE LEASE AT SEYMOUR PARK WHERE AQUIS WERE PREVIOUSLY BASED, CHANCES LIKE THAT JUST DON'T COME ALONG TOO OFTEN - MICK SHARKIE

"It's a massive thrill for us," says Leneva Park bloodstock adviser Mick Sharkie. "Moving into the stallion side of the industry is something that's been on the radar as part of our long-term plan and the opportunity to come in and pick up the lease at Seymour Park where Aquis were previously based, chances like that just don't come along too often.

"Albeit it's a little bit ahead of our planning and schedule, it's an opportunity we had to take.

"It's really good to be able to work with Aquis and stand Lean Mean Machine and Royal Meeting, two young stallions that I think are going to do the job.

"Fierce Impact really was that headline horse we were after. His three Group 1 wins to date have all been in Victoria, he's a really well-known and well-respected product in Victoria.

"I reckon once breeders get a look at him later in the year, once he's come off the track and settled in to things at Leneva Seymour, I think they're going to be really impressed by what they see.

"We're very hopeful that he's the sort of quality mile-type stallion that Victorians have been searching for and waiting for."

The Victorian thoroughbred industry will be eagerly anticipating the arrival of the first crop of Fierce Impact foals, but for now Leneva Park have an eight-strong draft of yearlings, with one withdrawal, heading to the 2021 Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale.

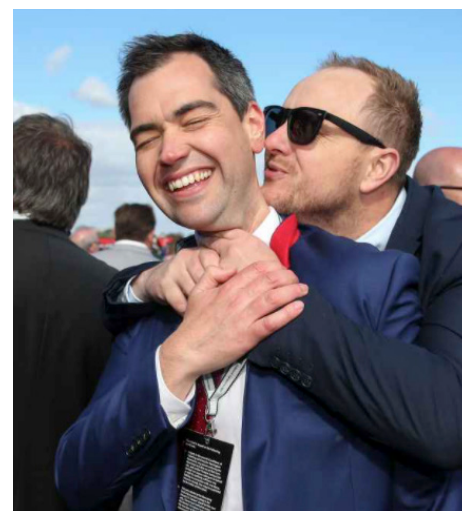
Sharkie describes their offering as "a changing of the guard draft", with horses they have bred themselves or bought as foals likely to appear next to their name in 12 months' time.

"It's an even group of horses," says Sharkie. "We've tried to take horses to the market that we think trainers will really like and will go and do a job on the track for people, ultimately that's why we're all buying on the market to try and get a good racehorse.

"So we've tried to find clients that have had that sort of stock to show and offer."

Headlining their draft is Lot 88, a Rubick (Encosta de Lago) colt out of Starcraft (Soviet Star) mare I'm A Flying Star.

Coolmore's Rubick is the sire of three stakes winners to date – Everest (1200m) winner Yes Yes Yes, Rubisaki and Condo's Express – and he



has made a strong impression in his early days as a stallion, comfortably taking the honour of Champion Second Season Sire in 2020, with over \$10 million earned in prize money.

The colt is the second foal out of three-time winner I'm A Flying Star, whose first foal is yet to race.

"He's a really nice Rubick colt that is bred by a good client of the farm," says Sharkie.

"He's from a pretty precocious two-year-old family. When you go back and have a look it's through that Singles Bar family, the same family as Not A Single Doubt, Come Hither, Zizou, King's Legacy – proper two-year-olds.

"It's a very popular, proven-early family and this guy looks of that same sort of mould.

"He's a good, sweet-moving colt with a good attitude and good natural muscle. He looks the sort that should be ready at two but should train on into his three-year-old season, like most of the Rubick's do."

Speaking to ANZ Bloodstock News shortly after inspections took place at their Longwood Property, Sharkie picked out another on their draft, a Headwater (Exceed And Excel) colt out of Ellepin Gal (Pins) (Lot 593), who was turning a few heads among the trainers and agents.

"The mare's done a decent job to date but there's been a bit of an uptick in type here with the mating to Headwater," says Sharkie.

"When I went and saw this colt on the owner's property, I thought 'wow, there's some work to be done here', but all he has done is improve. He's just gone ahead in leaps and bounds in the last two months.

"I think, having had inspections this morning with Inglis and a group of trainers and

agents, a few of them did have good second looks at him. I think he could sell quite well and be a bit of a dark horse for us in this draft."

The final horse Sharkie is keen to highlight is one of three fillies they have going through the ring, a Russian Revolution (Snitzel) yearling out of American Listed winner Shakeira (Freud) (Lot 701).

"The dam is an American stakes winner and Russian Revolution was popular through Magics and also at Classic, so that gives us confidence a few of his could sell well," he says.

"She's an early going sort, mid-size, strong enough, good top-line on her and again she had a couple of heads looking twice at her this morning. So they'd be the three that I'd be confident would sell quite well."



The future of Leneva Park

Leneva Park's foundations have been built by the strong spelling and pre-training arm of their operation based at Longwood in North East Victoria and Sharkie believes the acquisition of their new 500-acre Seymour property will complement that side of the business, allowing it to maintain its standing while they delve into the stallion game.

Over the last 12 months they have had the likes of Inglis 2YO Millenium (RL, 1100m) winner Profiteer (Capitalist) and exciting prospect Ayrton (Iffraaj) come through their pre-training system and it is hoped that the additional stallion operation at the business will put Leneva in a unique position in the Victorian thoroughbred market.

"The addition of Seymour gives our Longwood property the chance to again focus on pre-training, which is what it was built for and designed to do," says Sharkie.

"Longwood's a great property and we're getting some fantastic results through the pre-training system on the property.

"To have a dedicated farm for breeding and stallions and another for pre-training puts us in a pretty unique spot.

"There's not too many businesses in Australia where you can breed a horse and go through all the stages up until going to the racetrack within the one business, so we're

pretty privileged to be in that position."

Despite only recently entering the stallions ranks, Sharkie is keen to expand their offering beyond Fierce Impact, Royal Meeting and Lean Mean Machine and is in search of an additional speed stallion to complement their roster.

"I'd probably like to add another one before the 2021 season, I'd be keen to add a speed influence into what we've got at the moment," says Sharkie.

"The market loves speed and if we can find a proven speed sire and somehow get him into the ranks, I'm working hard on that at the moment.

"Longer term, we're really inspired by what groups like Rosemont, Swettenham, and also in The Hunter what Newgate have been able to do by identifying young horses that could potentially have a future after the track as a stallion and staking a claim in them.

"I think that's an area that you'll see Leneva Park move into over the next two, three, four years."

A successful sale beckons

Turning his attention to the more immediate prospect of the 2021 Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale, Sharkie is confident that the positive results seen in southern hemisphere sales so far this year will roll over to Premier and he is expecting a strong three days at Oaklands Junction.

"I think everyone is pretty buoyed by the market on the back of the Gold Coast sale and also Inglis Classic.

"Both sales showed that the market is very healthy and there's a real appetite to buy.

"So the confidence is there rolling into Premier that it could be on that upward tick again and all indications from inspections to this point around the place suggest that the draft is very strong across the board, across all farms.

"So I think it bodes well for a pretty strong sale."


