Moore to send lightly raced Petronius to Queensland

Fred Best Classic test for son of Redoute's Choice in possible Stradbroke audition

Gary Moore is looking forward to working with his elder brother John for the first time in more than three decades, but the Group 1-winning trainer wants to claim stakes success in his own right with promising three-year-old Petronius

(Redoute's Choice) before the partnership comes to fruition.

A last-start Sydney winner, Petronius was scratched from Randwick on Saturday because of a wet track and the Rosehill-based Moore will enact a back-up plan by sending the colt to Brisbane for this weekend's Fred Best Classic (Gr 3, 1350m) at Doomben.

Joe Lau Chasing a Fourth Derby Victory

Crown Of Gold (Duporth) cemented his Macau Derby (Listed, 1800m) berth with a dominant win in Saturday's Porto Alegre Handicap (1800m) on a heavy turf track.

Prepared by Joe Lau, Crown Of Gold was never in doubt after being fired out of the gates by regular rider Luis Corrales. Rated nicely in front, Crown Of Gold was let slide by Corrales from the six hundred where he extended his lead to a six lengths turning for home, running out an easy three lengths winner untouched over Fantastic Friends (Denman), with Golden Victory (Shamus Award) in third. *Macau News page 10 >>*

Connections have been forced to be patient with the \$1 million Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale graduate, but Moore is confident the colt is about to start repaying his owners who include Arrowfield Stud principal John Messara and Japan's Katsumi Yoshida.

"We didn't want to run him on Saturday at Randwick on a heavy 9," Moore said yesterday.

"He looks in great shape and the weather looks good up in Brisbane, so we thought we'd give him a chance at stakes level."

Petronius won his maiden on the Kensington track last September and returned from a summer spell with a second at Warwick Farm on April 29 before leading throughout over 1400 metres at the same course two weeks later.

"I have always loved the colt since I was given him to train. It was just quite unfortunate that he had the tieback (operation), which held him back a little, but my plans were always to be very patient with the colt as he's had a few issues along the way," Moore continued.

"The way he's looking at the moment and the way he's racing, I think we're going to get a good return on him."

Petronius is also nominated for Saturday week's Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) at Eagle Farm, but Moore wants to wait until after the Fred Best Classic before determining whether the colt will back-up, if indeed he makes the field.

"It was always on the cards to either go to Randwick on Saturday and then we'd go to the Fred Best. It wasn't an afterthought, put it that way," he said.

"It'd be a great result, but we'd have to back him up a week later if we did head to the Stradbroke. I've put in an acceptance for him, but we'll see how he goes on Saturday and then we'll speak to Mr Messara and the partners and go from there."

This season will also signal Moore's last as a solo trainer ahead of his partnership with his brother, who has been forced into retirement by the Hong Kong Jockey Club as he turns 70 this year.

The brothers will take on more boxes at Rosehill and increase the number of horses in work with the support of prominent Hong Kong owner Bon Ho, who races Southern Legend (Not A Single Doubt) with Caspar Fownes and the Les Bridge-trained Classique Legend (Not A Single Doubt) in Sydney.

"We haven't worked together since 1986 when I rode for brother John in

Hong Kong until I took up a contract to ride in France for the Head family, so we're all excited. We're starting to put things in place for how he likes to run things," Moore said.

"I'm sure we're going to learn a lot from him having him back here. To be in partnership, I am sure dad would be very proud."

Gary has nothing but admiration for his brother's training achievements and has no qualms about who will call the shots when the pair joins forces.

He said: "We've got a good umpire here with my son James, but brother John is always going to be my older brother and I always look upon him to give the orders."

Waterhouse and Bott colt favourite for Fred Best

In-form Sydney colt Dawn Passage (Dawn Approach) is the early favourite for the Fred Best Classic (Gr 3, 1350m) on Saturday, which features a number of three-year-olds who also hold entries for the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) the following week. The winner of the Fred Best will be exempt from ballot for the Stradbroke. A winner of the Hawkesbury Guineas (Gr 3, 1600m) and Inglis 3YO Guineas (1400m), the Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained Dawn Passage was installed as the \$3.50 favourite with the TAB yesterday. The colt is high up in Stradbroke betting at \$8 but down the ballot order at 37th. He will have to rely on attrition or winning the Fred Best to gain a place in the line-up. Jockey James Innes Jr will take the ride, having travelled to Queensland last week from Sydney to begin a 14-day quarantine period.

Stradbroke hope Tambo's Mate injured

Top Queensland sprinter Tambo's Mate (Mossman) has been injured and is set to miss the Stradbroke Handicap. Tambo's Mate had beaten the ballot for the Stradbroke when winning the BRC Sprint (Gr 3, 1350m) at Doomben three weeks ago. The gelding finished seventh in the Victory Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Eagle Farm last Saturday and Stuart Kendrick said jockey Matt McGillivray felt there was something wrong when he returned to scale after the race. "We let him cool down and had him scanned. He wrenched a joint," Kendrick said. "It's very swollen and he will need three months in the paddock. I thought he was going to be in the finish at the 250 metres

but he stopped. He must have done it around then. Hopefully we can get him back for the summer."

Pride assessing options with Stockman

Stockman (Tavistock) continued to progress at Randwick on Saturday when scoring a 2000-metre event - his third win this preparation from four starts at distances ranging from 1300 metres to 2000 metres. Trainer Joseph Pride now has his eye on some bigger targets. "They are promising signs when they're able to win a 1300-metre race first-up and three out of the first four runs of the preparation, you know they're headed in the right direction," Pride told NZ Racing Desk. "We will find out what his best distance is along the way but I wouldn't be surprised if he could run 2400 metres. He might even be able to run two miles. It is a pretty stout pedigree."

Trial to determine Bart's future

The futures of Group 1 winners Black Heart Bart (Blackfriars) and Humidor (Teofilo) will be put to the test this week in Western Australia. Black Heart Bart failed to beat a horse home in the Roma Cup (Gr 3, 1200m) and will trial today. "I didn't like what I saw when he raced last start," trainer Lindsey Smith told Racing.com yesterday. "He was meant to trial today but they've been moved to tomorrow due to our severe weather forecast. If he trials well then he'll take his place on the weekend, if not we'll let him enjoy the rest of his days in a paddock like he deserves." Humidor has had two trials in the west, impressing Smith. "He's trialled well and we're excited to see him step back out and hopefully return to his best," he added. "With his record there's no hiding him. He will race in the best races in WA and if he's not up

to that then it will be retirement for him as well. But if he goes well in this Belmont series then there's plenty of options for him in both states in the spring."

Three-year-old races on Resortman's radar

WA trainer Michael Lane is hopeful Resortman (Helmet) can continue his upward trajectory ahead of the upcoming feature three-year-old races. Lane is keen to test him in better company, with the Raconteur Stakes (Listed, 1500m) and Belmont Guineas (Listed, 1600m) as possible targets. "I haven't mapped anything out yet but that's a natural progression I suppose," Lane told The Races WA. "If he is right and good you go there and you test the waters, then you know where you are heading with him. I suppose you have to test them sometimes but it is a big jump in grade there is no doubting that."

Hey Doc back for another campaign

Hey Doc (Duporth) has returned to work after a spell and will be given a slow build-up before the three-time Group 1 winner is locked into spring targets. The six-year-old gelding has not started since finishing unplaced in the CF Orr Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) in February. "He only came back into work last week so he's just settling in," Calvin McEvoy said. "We're just going to take it very slowly with him and see how he comes up. He's a horse who puts on a lot of weight throughout a spell." Hey Doc spent more than a year off the scene but returned late last spring after joint surgery and in his second start back won the Winterbottom Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) in Perth. The Winterbottom was Hey Doc's third Group 1 following success in the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) in 2017.

One to Watch - Vancouver

Leading Western Australian owner breeder Bob Peters is a big fan of Golden Slipper winning sire Vancouver, who gave him an exciting debut two year-old winner on Wednesday. Trained by Grant and Alana Williams, Dunbar was a hot favourite for the 1200 metre juvenile maiden at Pinjarra and after stalking the leader did his best work late to score a determined neck victory with a good margin back to the third horse.

"He has always shown plenty of ability at home and has only ever had one gallop (where he won his trial by five lengths)" said Bob Peters. "He will improve out of sight with the run and hopefully there are bigger races in store for him in the future."

Vancouver stands at a fee of \$30,250 at Coolmore this spring, which might be outstanding value given the quality he has in his first large crop of rising three year-olds.



"I went to the sales this year to target the progeny of Vancouver as I have a very good opinion of the Vancouver two-year-olds in my stable and came away with two lovely fillies. The filly out of Miss Darcey is particularly exciting and will make her presence felt in the spring. I think he's a stallion to watch."

Shadow Hero HK-bound

The Sydney Morning Herald yesterday reported that dual Group 1 winner Shadow Hero (Pierro) has been sold to Hong Kong for upwards of \$3 million to be trained by David Hayes next season. The three-year-old gelding was vetted yesterday and only requires a final tick of approval for the sale to go through. Shadow Hero won last year's Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) and finished powerfully to win the Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) in March. His trainer Mark Newnham said he was disappointed to lose the gelding who was being aimed at the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) in October.

Gold Rush leading Rosemont Online Sale

At the time of going to press, So You Think mare (High Chaparral) Gold Rush, who is in foal to Savabeel (Zabeel), was at the top of bidding on the Magic Millions Rosemont Exclusive Online Sale at \$75,000. Catalogued as **Lot 40**, Gold Rush won the Matamata Breeders' Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) in 2016 while her half-sister Gold Fever (Savabeel) also won the Matamata Breeders' Stakes and was placed in the Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m). Bidding for the sale closes today at 11:58am.

Bidding for the Arrowfield Unreserved Weanling Sale on bloodstockauction.com will close today. The draft includes 21 colts and nine fillies by sires including Dundee (High Chaparral), Maurice (Screen Hero), Mikki Isle (Deep Impact), Scissor Kick (Redoute's Choice) and Real Impact (Deep Impact). Stewart could miss Stradbroke meeting

Queensland jockey Brad Stewart is the latest rider to need a stay on a suspension if he is to ride at the Stradbroke Handicap meeting at Eagle Farm next Saturday. There is an increasing shortage of top jockeys in Queensland which has been exacerbated by injury, suspensions and coronavirus restrictions imposed on

interstate riders. Stewards opened an inquiry after Galvarino (Sepoy) and Paris Crystal (Stratum) suffered interference at the 200 metres in race eight at Ipswich on Sunday. Stewart, who rode Open Road (Animal Kingdom), pled guilty to a charge of careless riding and was suspended for ten days, starting at midnight on Saturday and concluding at midnight on Tuesday, June 9. It means unless Stewart lodges an application for an internal review and gets a stay, he cannot ride on Stradbroke Handicap meeting on June 6.

Kissick rides first winner after layoff

New South Wales country jockey John Kissick made a successful return from injury yesterday, riding his first winner in more than three-and-a-half years at Albury. Kissick partnered the Norm Loy-trained Waiting For A Mate (Widden Valley) to victory in the \$20,000 Drake International Benchmark 66 Handicap (1400m) in what was just his sixth ride since fracturing his T-12 vertebrae when riding cattle in October 2016. He was dislodged and landed heavily on his back. The 28-year-old had his jockeys' reissued by Racing NSW last month. A three-time New South Wales southern district premiership winner, Kissick has ridden 375 winners since his first victory at Gungahlin on the first day of the 2010/11 season.

Prebble suspended

Brett Prebble was suspended for ten meetings at Sandown on Sunday after being charged

with careless riding. The jockey shifted inwards aboard runner-up Iscariot (Zebedee) when insufficiently clear of Obi (Excelebration) 300 metres after the start in the Ladbrokes Switch Handicap (1300m). Prebble is free to return to riding at Seymour on Thursday, June 4.

Ablaze to aim at Melbourne Cup

Ciaran Maher, who trains in partnership with David Eustace, has outlined a bold plan with Grand Annual Steeplechase (5500m) winner Ablaze (Raise The Flag), who also won the Jericho Cup (4600m) on the flat at Warrnambool last year. Maher intends to aim Ablaze at both the Grand National Hurdle (4200m) and Grand National Steeplechase (4500m) before targeting the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m). "We'll put an entry in the Melbourne Cup for Ablaze," he told the Warrnambool Standard. "He's just a tough, versatile horse. We would be silly not to enter Ablaze in the Melbourne Cup, considering his staying ability and his love of all conditions. No one is sure what the field will look like in this year's Melbourne Cup because of the coronavirus pandemic - it may be the year of the tough local stayer. Ablaze may not be the most brilliant horse that I've trained, but he rates as one of the toughest."

Heathcote calls for ramped up pre-race testing

Robert Heathcote believes that not enough pre-race testing is being done in Queensland after concerns were raised in a report on Racenet on Sunday that rules were being breached. "In these last two or three months there's been so many race meetings with zero pre-race testing, I mean zero and the word has got out," Heathcote told RSN927. "You have to understand the mechanics of cheating to a degree, particularly tubing a horse. Administering an alkalizing agent pre-race, once the horse has raced, the evidence is burnt off. At the end of the day we all know the fuel that drives the industry - it's wagering. Every effort must be made, in our opinion, to restore confidence to us in the industry that there's far more pre-race testing and I'm talking about the \$5000 maiden at Gatton right through to the Group race at Eagle Farm."

Seymour meetings transferred

Following the safe resumption of racing at Seymour last Thursday, Racing Victoria and the Seymour Racing Club have agreed on a program of meetings throughout winter that will assist in the track's ongoing development after major works. The nine-race meeting was Seymour's first since November, 2019 when it underwent track renovations which involved full resurfacing with kikuyu grass and a recent oversow of rye grass to provide year-round performance and stability. Following the satisfactory performance of the track and in the knowledge that it will only continue to improve, it has been determined that the track will benefit most from conducting one meeting per month throughout winter. As a result, the race meetings scheduled for Seymour on Thursday, June 4 and Sunday, July 26 have been transferred to Wangaratta and Echuca respectively. The Seymour meetings scheduled for Thursday, June 18 and Tuesday, July 14 will be conducted as programmed.

Birdsville abandoned

The iconic outback Queensland two-day Birdsville carnival will not be held this year. Organisers yesterday confirmed the decision had been made to abandon the 2020 meetings, scheduled for September 4 and 5. The last time the meeting was called off was in 2007 due to equine influenza. "It is with heavy hearts that we have made the difficult decision not to stage the Birdsville Races this year. As much as we were holding onto the hope that we could run them, we're at a point where we've had to concede defeat. The health of our patrons, and those who live in outback Queensland, is of paramount importance to us - and it is impossible to know what the status with Covid-19 will be come September," Birdsville Race Club vice-president Gary Brook said. The

2021 dates have already been set for September 3 and 4 next year.

Sky to cover today's Qld trials

Racing Queensland have confirmed that Sky Racing will provide live footage of the Beaudesert Racing Club trials this morning on its Thoroughbred Central platform. Replays of the trials will also be available on the RQ website following the conclusion of the meeting. The Deagon trials, also this morning, will be recorded 'as live' and replays will be available on the RQ website following the conclusion of the meeting.

NEW ZEALAND

Beauden a highlight for Elliot

Although jockey Ryan Elliot was a little disappointed about the season being curtailed as a result of Covid-19, he is looking forward to getting back in the saddle. Elliot has ridden 59 winners this season, just one shy of last year's tally and he is hopeful he can surpass that number in the last month of the season. "It was my best season so far, it's just a bit of a shame it was cut short like that," Elliot told NZ Racing Desk. Elliot singled out two recovery rides on Beauden (Bullbars) and Mascarpone (Shooting To Win) at Awapuni in December as his highlights of the season. "Beauden when he hit the deck and I was able to stay on (and win) was a highlight," Elliot said of the gelding, who stumbled out of the gates and nearly fell prior to winning. "We need to just break that Group 1 for Mum with Rock On Wood and for me it would be a huge thrill."

Early bird Pearl Series nominations closing soon

The NZB Insurance Pearl Series has become an important part of the New Zealand racing

calendar and the New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Association (NZTBA) that administers the series eagerly awaits the continuation of the Series in the new 2020-21 season. "After fielding calls from owners who have Pearl fillies eligible for bonuses in the new season, I have been in discussion with New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing who have assured me that once funding and the new programme for the season is approved they will be looking to programme Pearl races," NZTBA chief executive Justine Sclater said. In March, the NZTBA announced that they were extending the Early Bird nominations for all Southern hemisphere fillies born in 2018 until 31 May 2020, due to the Covid-19 Lockdown. Officials confident about UK racing return

Brant Dunshea, chief regulatory officer at the British Horseracing Authority, has expressed confidence that racing will be able to resume on June 1. Racing was last staged in Britain on March 17 and the government announced earlier this month that no professional sport, even behind closed doors, would take place before June 1 at the earliest. The BHA on Saturday published its protocols for resuming behind closed doors at Newcastle on June 1. Dunshea told Racing TV's Luck On Sunday programme: "I think what we have got to understand is that all the way through this process in our engagement with government it has been recognised that we are different to the other sports that are being referred to. We are largely a rural-based sport, we are an outdoor environment - both our training and racing environments are outdoor and pose a lower level of risk and position us as a very different sport to football and rugby, for example."

Joe Lau Chasing a Fourth Derby Victory

Crown Of Gold (Duporth) cemented his Macau Derby (Listed, 1800m) berth with a dominant win in Saturday's Porto Alegre Handicap (1800m) on a heavy turf track.

Prepared by Joe Lau, Crown Of Gold was never in doubt after being fired out of the gates by regular rider Luis Corrales. Rated nicely in front, Crown Of Gold was let slide by Corrales from the six hundred where he extended his lead to a six lengths turning for home, running out an easy three lengths winner untouched over Fantastic Friends (Denman), with Golden Victory (Shamus Award) in third.

Saturday's race was for four-year-olds only with the winner guaranteed a Derby start. However, trainer Joe Lau is not getting too carried away with the win at the moment.

"Yes it was a good win and he did it easily, but let's be honest the class was not that flash, from a Derby point of view he still has a long way to go," the usually conservative Lau said.

Whilst Lau's comments are valid it took nothing away from the dominance of Crown Of Gold's win over the Derby distance and on a very heavy testing track. Add to that two nice wins prior at 1500 metres on good tracks both in the good time of 1.27.9, Crown Of Gold is shaping up as a very worthy contender. The Derby is run on July 19 right in the middle of the monsoon

season, as we've seen in the past there is always a chance of a wet track.

"I'm not sure if I'll run him in the Macau Guineas. I'll see how he pulls up; I'll let the horse tell me. He's got his Derby start already so it's not like I have to chase it."

Joe Lau's main Derby contender is no doubt Sacred Magnate, a son of Foxwedge (Fastnet Rock) who was originally a \$155,000 purchase at the 2017 Gold Coast Yearling Sale. Racing in Victoria as Expansion, the gelding won a 1000-metre maiden at Yarra Valley when prepared by Leon and Troy Corstens.

Three starts later, Expansion ran a creditable fifth in the Colin Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Flemington only beaten two and a quarter lengths.

At his only Macau start, Sacred Magnate had a tough time caught three deep in the run and received a solid knock at the eight hundred corner. Spotting the leaders a big start, the gelding ran home well under Peter Ho to wind up in fifth spot beaten six and a quarter lengths.

"Sacred Magnate is a nice horse and yes not

much went right from barrier (12) at this first start," Lau said.

"I might run him this weekend over 1200 metres and then the Macau Guineas. It's going to be very wet again this weekend so still a bit undecided."

Lau has long been considered the doyen of Macau's conditioners and only operates with a small team nowadays. Sacred Capital (O'Reilly) gave Lau his third Macau Derby last year following on the heels of The Alfonso (Magnus) and Sacred Man (Fastnet Rock).

It's been a long hard road for former top flight Macau jockey Peter Lao as he tries to regain his place as one of the enclave's top riders.

In a career marred by race falls and a complete loss of confidence, Lau hung up his boots for a number of years before returning to race riding last December for one last throw of the dice.

Racegoers got a glimpse of the old Peter Lao on Saturday as he gave a perfect display on the Victor Chan-prepared Take The Cake (Reward For Effort) in the Class 4 (1200m).

Sent to the front out of the gates, Lao rated the son of Reward For Effort (Exceed And Excel) to perfection in the run before cuddling the horse until the 200 where he cut loose. Take The Cake extended his lead and ran out an easy two and half length winner over Mulan Go (Wandjina), with Premier Choice (Hidden Dragon) in third.

Lao was a former three-time Champion Apprentice in Macau when apprenticed to Darby Armstrong before making the move to Singapore for a number of years

His feature wins in the Lion City include The Queen Elizabeth II Cup (Listed, 2000m) and

Raffles Cup (Listed, 1600m) on Emerald Isles (Shaadi), along with a Kranji Mile (1600m) on Pacific Prince (Sky Filou) and the Patron's Bowl (Listed, 1400m) on Bon Amie (Fairy King).

The old confidence that made him a fearless competitor is back and Lao is looking superb on his runners with his short stirrup, great balance and vigorous style.

There were some impressive wins on Saturday but without doubt the easiest win was by the New Zealand import Qian Gua (Cape Blanco) ridden by Breinell Yamzon.

Prepared by KH Leong, Qian Gua made it two wins at the 1800 metres when he led throughout to simply destroy his rivals in the Class 2 Handicap scoring by eight and a quarter lengths.

Qian Gua translated means "to worry about" and he certainly gave his rivals plenty of that in Saturday's race and at his previous 1800 metres start.

At his second run in Macau, Qian Gua surprised all when he led throughout to romp in at odds of \$530.00 for the win. No such luxury

Qian Gua had 16 runs in New Zealand for a two wins at Matamata when prepared by Stephen Autridge and Jamie Richards when racing under the same name.

The five-year-old obviously relishes a wet track and ploughed through Saturday's testing conditions and would not be out of place in the Macau Gold Cup (Listed, 1800m) in August that more often than not has been run on a soft or heavy track due to the typhoon season.
