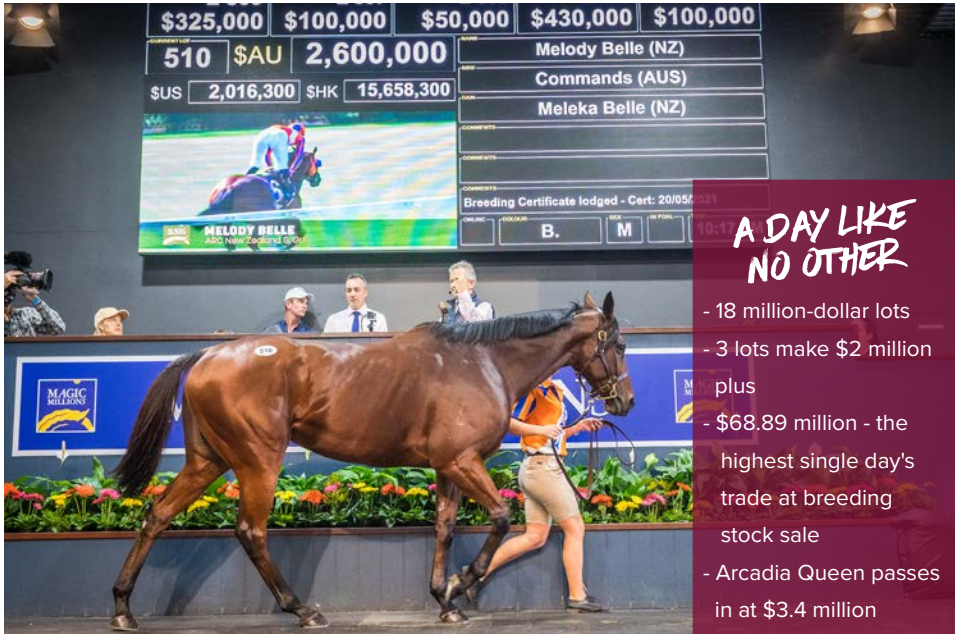

Belle shines on Magic day at the Gold Coast

Fourteen-time Group 1 winner tops day one of National Broodmare sale as records tumble after extraordinary session's trade

It promised to be a day like no other and it delivered, so much so it prompted industry figures to label yesterday's opening session of the Magic Millions Gold Coast National Broodmare Sale as the most extraordinary they had witnessed in decades.

Eighteen mares sold for \$1 million or more yesterday, 11 of them in the Shadwell Stud Australasia dispersal sale, and champion New

Zealand mare Melody Belle (Commands) could lay claim to being the head of the pack one more time when she topped the day at \$2.6 million.

There was \$68.888 million spent on 210 lots in the race fillies and mares session, the highest single day's trade in the southern hemisphere at a breeding stock sale, at an average of \$328,038, up 59 per cent year on year.

The median of \$145,000 was up 93 per cent on last year and up from \$70,000 achieved in 2019.

The clearance rate was set at 91 per cent as breeders looked to cash in on the booming market after record yearling and weanling sales.

"I am speechless. We'd hoped to achieve something extraordinary, but to do so is a remarkable result. It's a remarkable result for the team and it's a remarkable result for the industry here in Australia," an elated and clearly emotional Magic Millions managing director Barry Bowditch said.

"The industry's in great shape here, isn't it? It's buoyant, there were so many people trying to get in and bidding was healthy from start to finish.

"It just shows that if you bring a premium product to a horse sale, we'll ensure that the buyers are here to bid on these horses. Today reflected that like never before.

"I think we've had ten lots make over \$1.5 million and I'd hate to know how many made over seven figures. It's a huge number - 18 in one day.

"I don't think that's been done in the history of a mares sale and definitely not here."

The figures, even taking into account the once-off Shadwell dispersal sale, could have been greater had Arcadia Queen (Pierro) been sold.

Onlookers were left stunned when Arcadia Queen, arguably the sale's biggest drawcard, was passed in for \$3.4 million after her Western Australia owner-breeder Bob Peters was unwilling to part with his star homebred mare. Her reserve was listed at \$4 million.

Further underlining the dramatic day, the sale was halted for about 45 minutes after a car crash nearby cut power to about 370,000 residents from the Gold Coast to Caboolture and also brought the Magic Millions sales ring to silence.

A back-up generator was called upon to allow the sale to resume.

Belle rings at \$2.6 million for Fortuna's champion New Zealand mare

The first big-name mare through the ring on day one was star mare Melody Belle (Commands) and it was Yulong's Written Tycoon Syndicate which landed the brilliant six-year-old for \$2.6 million to liven up a remarkable day's trade.

She was the most expensive of 26 mares bought by the partnership on day one, which also included Greysful Glamour (Stratum) for \$1.5 million and another Stratum (Redoute's Choice) mare Positive Peace for \$800,000. The high-investing Victorian-based stud spent a total of \$12.2 million yesterday, the majority for their new high-profile stallion recruit, Written Tycoon (Iglesia).

With Kiwi Steve Davis ushered onto the rostrum to auctioneer New Zealand's champion 14-time Group 1 winner Melody Belle, the bidding opened at \$1 million before an investor bidding online went toe-to-toe with Yulong Investments, who is buying under the Written Tycoon Syndicate in support of their acquisition of the champion stallion.

"We are looking at mares of this quality now we have got Written Tycoon standing at the farm," Yulong's chief operating officer Sam Fairgray said.

"She was an obvious mare that we will look to put to him and we think she will suit him ideally."

Catalogued as Lot 510, the Marie Leicester-bred Melody Belle won 19 races and she is one of two winners for Meleka Belle (Iffraaj), a half-sister to four stakes-placed horses.

"We thought she would be around that (\$2.6 million) mark," Fairgray said.

"She is a Group 1 winning two-year-old and went on to win 14 Group 1 races, so a mare of that quality doesn't come on the market very often.

"She was bred by a very good breeder in New Zealand. She's been trained by New Zealand's best trainer.

"She came over and raced against the best in Australia as well."

Soon after the sale of Melody Belle, and on his way to enjoy a celebratory champagne next to Melody

Belle's box at the Blue Sky Premium Consignment area near the centre parade ring, Fortuna Thoroughbreds' John Galvin admitted to feeling a sense of relief.

"There's quite a bit of pressure leading into a sale like this, of course. There's all sorts of things to do, managing her campaign, managing the sale, managing shareholder expectations, etc, etc. It's happened, she's sold, and \$2.6 million is a lot of money," Galvin said.

"While there was talk, perhaps, of figures higher than that, we're very, very happy to have brought her here. Yulong will give her a great home, they've got some great stallions, so it's done and dusted."

Galvin was front and centre to the ring, on a table flanked by trainer Jamie Richards and Te Akau principal David Ellis, as other syndicate members sat nearby.

Ellis was one of those bidding on the mare, using the online platform to make a play for Melody Belle.

"The bidding was a little bit slow, to be honest, but with the inspections over the past few days we detected there was strong interest from a number of players and we were happy to go unreserved," Galvin said.

"I think that was the right way to sell this mare. It probably just needed another player or two to be in there bidding for her to reach a higher figure, but as I say, we're pretty happy to get \$2.6 million on the back of a \$57,500 purchase, not to mention \$4 million in race winnings."

Greysful Glamour heads to Victoria

Darby Racing was another beneficiary of the large investment by the Written Tycoon Syndicate with the Group 2 winner and VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) placegetter Greysful Glamour's looks and temperament not going unnoticed by those interested in the Widden Stud-consigned mare.

Catalogued as Lot 679, the former Mark Newnham-trained on-pacer is a half-sister to the stakes-placed mare Celestial Falls (Hinchinbrook) and is out of Dalakhani (Darshaan) mare Rippled.

"She started as a two-year-old and she's still racing at five. She's been in umpteen stakes races, she's pretty much raced in stakes races all her life," principal Scott Darby said.

"She's got a cult following and the owners are very emotional selling her, but to get a result like that for a Group 1-placed mare, a Group 2 winner, is phenomenal.

"We didn't pay big money for her at the Easter sale (\$90,000) but she's grown into a beautiful mare. You only have to take a look at her - she's amazing looking and she was sound.

"Mark Newnham said she never had an unsound day in her life, really, never been treated, and winning from 1400 metres and Group 1-placed over 2400 metres, it appealed to many buyers."

Darby has been lucky enough to race some high-class fillies such as Yankee Rose (All American) and Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner She Will Reign (Manhattan Rain) and he put yesterday's market into perspective.

"We had a reserve of \$600,000 on her, we thought she'd comfortably get to the \$800,000 and maybe a million in this crazy market," he said.

"I threw a few figures around this morning saying, 'in this market she can make \$1.2 to \$1.5 million' so we were on the money. I thought we had the product, but \$1.5 million is enormous.

"We sold Yankee Rose for \$2 million and She Will Reign for \$2.3 million (to Japan) and they had a much better race record than what she had. It's just a huge result in this market."

Like Melody Belle, Greysful Glamour will head to Written Tycoon this year.

"She was just a lovely mare when we saw her. She's another great racemare and physically she's a mare that we thought would suit Written Tycoon really well, being by Stratum, the pedigree works as well," Fairgray said.

"She's just a beautiful mare to have on our farm, and another white one. We've got Utzon, who's a white one and so she is now going to have a buddy, which is great."

Widden buys back speedster Humma Humma

Soon after selling Greysful Glamour, Widden Stud played vendor and buyer on Humma Humma (Denman), a mare they co-owned and raced to Group 3 success with trainer John McArdle in Victoria.

Widden Stud principal Antony Thompson paid \$1 million to buy out his partners in the rising six-year-old, who won six of her 32 starts and \$656,000 in prize-money.

Out of the four-time winner Humma Mumma (Bel Esprit), Humma Humma is a half-sister to this season's McArdle-trained Listed-winning two-year-old Tycoon Humma (Capitalist).

"We have been involved in the ownership and racing her with John McArdle. It's been a great ride and we know how good she is as we are very close to her," Thompson said.

"So it was an honour to be able to sell her on behalf of the owners and I am even more thrilled to be able to buy her."

Thompson suggested Zoustar (Northern Meteor) would be high on the list of stallion candidates this year, but he was also keeping his options open.

"She's a complete outcross. I love the fact she is in-bred to Vain, like Black Caviar, and of course Vain is very dear to us at Widden, having stood there.

"Honestly, when you look at her, she just suits so many stallions. Zoustar is front of mind but she can go to Trapeze Artist, or any of that line."

Mizzy heads to Coolmore

It was no surprise to see Coolmore playing a key role at the top-end of the market and it was Mizzy (Zoustar) who Tom Magnier had his eye on less than an hour into the sale, going to \$2.2 million to secure her.

Mizzy is the second high-priced daughter of Zoustar (Northern Meteor) bought by Magnier in as many years having gone to a Magic Millions record of \$4.2 million for the three-time Group 1 winner Sunlight last year.

The Anthony Cummings-trained Mizzy, a daughter of the Robert and Sylvie Crabtree-owned Listed winner Missy Cummings (Magnus), won four of her 25 starts, three of them at Group level, and she was also twice Group 1-placed to earn \$1.69 million in prize-money.

Offered through the Newgate Consignment as agent for her syndicate of owners, Mizzy finished well back in the Robert Sangster Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) in Adelaide on May 1 and will now join the Annabel Neasham stable as she's targeted towards next month's Tattersall's Tiara (Gr 1, 1400m) at Eagle Farm.

In 2019, Coolmore bought Eckstein (I Am Invincible) for \$750,000, transferred her to Chris Waller and was able to win a Winter Stakes (Listed, 1400m) and a valuable placing in the Tramway Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) before being retired.

The whole Shadwell Dispersal was an amazing draft, but this is one mare we really picked out, being by More than Ready. More than Ready with Not A Single Doubt is a phenomenal cross when it comes to stakes results, which looks great for Farnan.

She's in foal to I Am Invincible, and the foal last week was a lovely foal that made very good money as well. No mare today was cheap, but we think she's a mare we can really appreciate going forward and Farnan will love.

It's a beautiful family, she's a great type, and we were very happy to get her.

You have to support new stallions and we want quality over quantity. That's what we have always said. There have been mares today that we have had our eyes on, and we bid on some, but in fairness to Magic Millions it's been an amazing sale with amazing results and it's been hard to buy from. It's a great result for vendors.

Bidding on Mizzy opened at \$500,000, with the rising six-year-old commanding interest from local and international buyers while Crabtree, who was standing out the back of the sales ring, revealed he also bid on the mare in the hope of buying out his racing partners.

"It's extraordinarily hard to let her go, I'll be frank, I did have a bid, and was close to the mark, but not quite good enough," Crabtree said.

"Coolmore is a wonderful organisation and they will give her every chance she deserves.

"She's quite a beautiful horse. We just love to have lovely horses. The money is incidental, it's good when you get it, but it's the horse you produce which gives you the thrill."

"I just thought she was a pretty rare offering. How often do you get a mare with six starts for four wins who is a Group 1 winner and a Group 2 second at her last start and is a lightly raced three-year-old filly who is well looked after and is a really good type?"

"She has a really fast, good Aussie pedigree. Those horses just don't come on the market. I can't remember a horse who was so lightly raced and so well performed coming through a broodmare sale."

"The plan was to try and buy her, but probably not quite at that price. I have never sat here trying to buy the really good ones and thought to myself, 'wow, that was cheap.' You have the price you hope you buy them for, but the reality is, a very good judge said to me, 'if you fall in love with one and they're proper types, they're the ones that make you money. Pin your ears back and buy them.' That's what she was."

"She will race on. She has had six weeks off at Willow Park, so she's ready to go. The only problem of putting her in work now would be what you aim her for, so maybe we're better off giving her a little pre-training prep and look at the calendar and see what races we could aim her for and plan her program around that."

"If I say it (who she will be trained by), they're both going to ring me in the morning and say, 'C'mon mate' but the majority owner has all his horses with Mick Price or Tony Gollan, so she will either go north or south."

"I am busting her up, this will be a bit more syndicated. At the moment, there's at least three people in her and there's a bit of room to move there, so I need to find one more person."

He added: "There were people from America, England and Australia on her. She's an international mare and our little stud Dorrington is very proud to have bred her and raced her with our partners."

Magnier, who bought the mare for a new partnership, was in little doubt that Mizzy could have laid claim to being a Group 1 winner had she had a bit more luck. She was twice Group 1-placed and finished fourth in two other races at the highest level.

A mating for Mizzy has also not been confirmed but it would be fair to say Wootton Bassett (Iffraaj) will come in for strong consideration.

Her price tag, he says, is reflective of the prosperity of the Australian racing industry.

"It just shows the strength of the market at the moment in Australia. You have to put a zero behind your first valuation at the moment. It's a great indication for Magic Millions that they have one of the best sales going on in the world right now," he said.

"We've got a really exciting stallion roster this year. We're obviously bringing Justify back and we've got Wootton Bassett coming down this year and he's already fully booked."

"We've bought a lot of big mares over the past couple of years, so we'll be heavily supporting Wootton Bassett."

Recently, Magnier bought Celebrity Queen (Redoute's Choice) for \$2.5 million, El Dorado Dreaming (Ilovethiscity) (\$1.35 million) and Savanna Amour (Love Conquers All) (\$1.25 million) at the recent Inglis Chairman's Sale and last year he purchased Sunlight, Champagne Cuddles (Not A Single Doubt) (\$2 million), Invincibella (I Am Invincible) (\$1.3 million).

Coolmore also bought Global Glamour (Star Witness) (\$1.55 million), Invincible Star (I Am Invincible) (\$1.45 million) and Savvy Coup (Savabeel) (\$1 million) in 2019.

Bella Vella the queen of Rosemont's collection

Rosemont Stud's goal of becoming a leading player in the sales ring, as well as on the racetrack, took another big-spending turn yesterday with principal Anthony Mithen and his brother-in-law Nigel Austin spending almost \$10 million on ten mares to boost the quality of its broodmare band.

The most expensive of the haul was Group 1 winner Bella Vella (Commands) who was knocked down to Rosemont Stud for \$1.9 million to provide her connections with their biggest return to date and Mithen was more than happy to play his role in the tried horse fairytale.

Rosemont Stud also paid \$1.8 million for Minhaaj (Exceed And Excel), \$1.35 million for Fiesta (I Am Invincible) and Bulabula (Shamardal), who is in foal to Epaulette (Commands), for \$1.35 million.

Austin and Mithen also paid \$800,000 for Bulabula's Group 3-winning filly Aryaaf (Epaulette) during the Shadwell dispersal session.

Top of the tree for Rosemont's haul, Bella Vella, was initially sold by Sir Owen Glenn through an Inglis Digital auction in April 2019 for just \$22,500 to a syndicate involving trainer Will Clarken, his racing manager Lachie Weekley, fellow South Australian trainer David Jolly and Rushton Park's David and Kayley Johnson.

She was on-traded as the winner of three restricted races after missing to Glenn's stallion Criterion (Sebring) in 2018.

"It's great when dreams like this can come true for great people and people who are having a crack. We are very lucky to be bestowed the honour of owning Bella Vella," Mithen said.

"I was nearly out of bullets, but those competitive juices kicked in. When the auction started I said to Nige (Austin), 'the heart rate is starting to go; and at about \$1.6 million, I said 'it's really going now'.

"It is a lot of money, but she is a quality product. She is by a quality broodmare influence in Commands.

"She has got a beautiful family and how they got her at that price online a couple of years ago, is beyond me.

"I expected her not to be as good a type as she is. I thought she might be a bit scrappy because they didn't pay much for her online. It just shows that if you do your homework, and you get around, you can find a nice horse at all levels in the market."

The Rosemont Stud team will consider a mating plan for Bella Vella "over a nice bottle of red".

"There are a few options and probably we have to consider all options, all stallions across the board and make sure we get that mating right, because there's a bit of money to bring back," he said.

"We are very keen as a racing farm as well as a selling farm, we might indulge ourselves and race out of Bella Vella, wouldn't that be nice to see her progeny run around in the Rosemont silks?"

Under Clarken Bella Vella won seven races, the 2020 Robert Sangster Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) and two other stakes races chief among them, during the two years under his care and sells as a rising seven-year-old.

"Obviously the money's fantastic, but it's the appreciation of how good a horse she was and also how good a physical she was," Clarken said.

"I love horses and she's as good a type as you will see and I am just so happy that people have respected that and respected how much ability she had."

Clarken credited an extended spell, which was enforced after not getting in foal, for Bella Vella's form turnaround.

"Sometimes maybe having a decent spell by accident can really help horses. She got better and bigger as I had her in my care," he said.

"She became a bigger and more robust mare, so maybe there's something in that having that long time off.

"She always had good ability and mentally she needed a bit of coaxing to teach her to win and once she got that confidence up, nothing stopped her."

Out of Forget The Weather (Stormy Atlantic), a half-sister to stakes winners Ever After (Kris S), Wedlock (Maria's Mori) and Extrovert (Wild Again). Bella Vella was consigned by Randwick Bloodstock's Brett and Rachel Howard, who also had a share in Bella Vella. She was catalogued as Lot 643.

"Myself and my racing manager Lachie Weekley and two of my oldest and best friends in Patrick and John Kelton and obviously my mentor David Jolly are all in her and so are the Rushton Park guys who have been with me from the start when I had five or ten horses in work," Clarken said.

"She was just an outstanding mare just in terms of her physical attributes. I don't think I've seen a better mare, so we were happy to go hard for the one we wanted and we were able to purchase.

<< *Continued from page 12* "I didn't feel nervous at all this morning, but the last ten minutes coming in, I started to get the shakes a bit and felt a knot in the pit of my stomach," Johnston said.

"I was just a bit overawed because it's the end of an amazing ride for us, to have her win a Group 1, from where she has come from, is just phenomenal.

"We haven't been lucky enough to sell a million-dollar horse and this is just amazing for us, It's an unbelievable experience. We had a massive range of prices on her. It's hard to know at that top end, where she would end up. To be here is just incredible.

"We were hoping for anything over \$1 million, so \$1.9 million is just amazing."

Minhaaj to stay in training

Mithen revealed that his \$1.8 million purchase Minhaaj, the first lot sold through the Shadwell draft, would remain in training next season rather than be retired to stud.

The VRC Thoroughbred Breeders Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) winner, who has raced just nine times for Lindsay Park, is out of Telaawa (Lonhro), a winning, city-placed half-sister to Group 3 winner Charmed Harmony (Hussonet) and South Africa Grade 3 winner and Grade 1-performed Suyoo (Magic Albert).

Bulbula's addition followed on from Rosemont's love of the family, having paid \$1.2 million for her Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) colt at the recent Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale and \$700,000 for her Zoustar (Northern Meteor) yearling colt at last week's Magic Millions National Weanling Sale.

"(Bulbula) was a Shadwell family and I'm hoping in time that it might be referred to as a Rosemont family," Mithen said.

"It's an amazing job that Shadwell has done with breeding these mares. The opportunity to buy Minhaaj, a fast three-year-old filly by Exceed And Excel, one of the best stallions in the country, what an amazing opportunity.

"We'll rub our chin and think about what we do with her and what we set her for. Those fast fillies are hard to get."

Earlier in the day, Rosemont Stud acquired the Star Thoroughbreds-raced mare Fiesta, a Silver Shadow Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) winner as a three-

year-old. During that spring campaign she then ran three consecutive seconds in the Furious Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m), Tea Rose Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) and the Flight Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m), a campaign which netted connections a free service to a Darley stallion.

"She was a high-class two-year-old and, for an I Am Invincible, she trained on as an older filly and mare," Rosemont Stud's general manager of bloodstock Ryan McEvoy said.

"She's a big, strong, roomy mare who will carry a good foal.

"I just love that race record that will go and produce those two and three-year-olds and that's, ultimately, what we're trying to do by getting a broodmare band that allows us to do that and have horses running in those big two-year-old races.

"Fiesta comes with a free nomination to a Darley stallion after winning the Princess Series, so maybe we'll look at sending her to Dubawi!"

In summary, Mithen said: "That was an extraordinary day really. To add a collection of mares, and we bought ten mares in all, to be able to add that sort of quality, the opportunity was there with the Shadwell dispersal, but there was some beautiful mares before the dispersal as well,

"We couldn't resist and we are very pleased. We have put a line in the sand about how serious we are about Rosemont."

Buyers make most of Shadwell dispersal

Expectations were high for the Shadwell Stud Australasia dispersal, but 11 million-dollar mares changing hands in not much longer than an hour still had many experienced participants in awe of what had just occurred.

Such was the appetite from buyers to take advantage of the rare event, brought on by the ill-health and then death of Shadwell founder Sheikh Hamdan Bin Rashid Al Maktoum, it led to major players joining forces in order to secure their chosen lots.

South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Qafila (Not A Single Doubt), who was offered in foal to Dundee (High Chaparral), garnered the most attention, with GSA Bloodstock's Jonathan Munz partnering with Coolmore to buy the talented mare.

"You've got to pay for these nice mares. It's been strong all day, hasn't it? Everyone seems to be partnering up, so it seems, and we've partnered with Coolmore," Munz's representative, agent Dean Hawthorne, said.

"Qafila was a hell of a racemare who we followed (on the racetrack). She is a good type and (\$2 million) is the market, really, and I can't really see it stopping.

"She is a good long-term investment."

Munz has a share in Coolmore's dual Group 1-winning two-year-old and first season sire King's Legacy (Redoute's Choice) and Hawthorne indicated the two parties are likely to do more business together in the future.

"We've also been trying to buy mares together for King's Legacy and we'll be involved with Coolmore from now on," he said.

"We will sit down with the (Coolmore) boys (about a mating for Qafila) but she will go to one of the Coolmore stallions, I'd imagine. There's all sorts of options on the table for her."

<< *Continued from page 14* Go Bloodstock's Sir Owen Glenn also combined with Coolmore to land a Shadwell mare, Minhaaj's dam, Telaawa (Lonhro), for \$1.7 million.

She was sold in foal with an early service date to Exceed And Excel (Danehill). Dean Hawthorne paid \$900,000 for Telaawa's Exceed And Excel yearling filly at the Inglis Australian Easter Sale last month.

"Sir Owen thought it was a great opportunity with the Shadwell Dispersal to add to the very top end of our band and she is a Lonhro mare," Go Bloodstock's Steve O'Connor said.

"We loved the yearling back at the Easter Sale that Dean Hawthorne bought, and of these Shadwell mares, she was our pick.

It was great to partner with Coolmore, who we own some great horses with, like Merchant Navy.

She's a lovely mare to have and she is an outcross to all these Danehill-line stallions that will be retiring for us."

Yarraman Park, where the Shadwell stock had been kept for many years, consigned the draft which grossed \$25.135 million.

Despite the startling figures, Yarraman Park's Arthur Mitchell was not completely shocked by what occurred in the sales ring yesterday.

"It's been the culmination of 25 years of growing a broodmare band and nurturing them and buying the best yearlings," Mitchell said.

"(Shadwell representative) Angus Gold has done an amazing job and this is the culmination. It is sad to see the end of Shadwell's investment

in Australia. Maybe there's a chance they may come back, but it was obviously a phenomenal sale tonight.

"The mares sold really well, and we are so proud of our staff, they have done an amazing job."

As for the overall race fillies and mares session, Mitchell backed up many opinions shared as the day progressed.

"I've been around the world for many years, and I've seen big markets in America, and this is as strong a sale as you'd see, all the way through," he said.

"It wasn't just the Shadwell dispersal ... and it's not just Australians buying, it's people from across the world and this seems a very buoyant market to play in at the moment.

"Australia is in a good place, racing is in a good place and breeding is in a good place. It's wonderful to see all these different people investing in these mares."

Magic Millions' Bowditch added: "Shadwell's stock selling was one of the most emotional things you'll see at a horse sale.

"It was truly special and we're extremely grateful to be given the opportunity to sell these horses and it is a big reflection on Yarraman, Angus Gold and Sheikh Hamdan's investment worldwide.

"These horses commanded respect and the buyers got behind them and gave them the respect."

Day two, featuring broodmares in foal, starts on the Gold Coast at 10am today.

"There's a lot of quality mares to come through. We won't be reaching the heights of what we have today, but it's going to continue to be healthy," Bowditch said last night.

"The depth of the catalogue provides breeders at all levels with opportunities that will be seen over the next two days.

"Buyers will continue to keep their lists long and, even though the market is great, vendors will continue to be realistic."

Two for Kiss And Make Up

Miss Mecca (2 f ex Miss Elvee by Elvstroem) got off the mark at Rockhampton yesterday to provide 2016 Todman Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) winner Kiss And Make Up (More Than Ready) with his second individual winner. The Garnett Taylor-trained filly improved on her third-placed effort behind Sequesay (Rothsay) on debut in February with a one and three-quarter-length win in the QTIS 2YO Maiden Handicap (1100m) yesterday. I'm Strolling (Better Than Ready) was second, with Jungle Beat (Drumbeats) three lengths behind the winner in third. Miss Mecca is the first winner out of dual Listed-placed mare Miss Elvee (Elvstroem), who is a half-sister to Group 3 winner Magnapal (Magnus) and the Group 1-placed Red For Lou (Testa Rossa). First season sire Kiss And Make Up, who was retired after finishing down the field in the Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) on his third start, will stand at Aquis Farm for \$8,800 in 2021.

Harron secures stake in Extreme Choice

Leading bloodstock agent James Harron secured three shares in Golden Slipper-winning sire Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) at yesterday's session of the Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale. The Newgate stallion, who sits second to Capitalist (Written Tycoon) in the leading first season sires by earnings table, has produced five winners from his first 13 runners, including Slipper winner Stay Inside and Woodlands Stakes (Listed, 1100m) scorer Xtremetime. Extreme Choice stood at Newgate for \$22,000

last year but will stand at a private fee in 2021. Harron purchased the shares, catalogued as lots 758, 766 and 767, for \$210,000, \$205,000 and \$215,000 respectively. "Delighted to round out a busy first day at the Magic Millions Broodmare Sale by securing three shares in boom young Newgate stallion Extreme Choice, sire of Golden Slipper winner Stay Inside in his first crop," Harron said yesterday evening on Twitter. Extreme Choice produced 48 live foals from his first crop, which also included Pago Pago Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) runner-up Tiger Of Malay.

Hezashocka ready to win again

The Mick Price and Michael Kent jr-trained Hezashocka (Shocking) impressed in trackwork yesterday ahead of his tilt at Saturday's Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m). The gelding, who was transferred to the Price and Kent jr stables after landing the Championship Stakes (Gr 2, 2100m) in New Zealand as a 75-1 chance, worked at Eagle Farm yesterday. "He worked super," Price told Racing.com. "I reckon he will show up. He's a big, long-striding horse. He's a bit green. He's still a bit off-and-on. He's still learning. He worked by himself and was ridden by (Price's former apprentice) Jordan Grob. Once he got into his rhythm, he carted Jordan into his work and he said he could have done another lap on him. He ran a mile home and improved the last 600 metres. He's a beautiful, clean-winded gelding. I am hoping he can step-up that horse. He's a nice horse. It's been a nice transition from his New Zealand pattern into here and I certainly haven't changed too much with him." The OTI Racing-owned three-year-old has drawn barrier 14 for the Derby.

Explosive Jack draws barrier six

Meanwhile, Queensland Derby favourite Explosive Jack (Jakkalberry) has been handed barrier six in his quest for a fourth Derby win this season, having already landed the Tasmanian Derby (Listed 2200m), Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m), and South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m). His Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained stablemates Let's Karaka Deel (Dundeel) and Toscanini (Fastnet Rock) also drew favourably in stall three and eight respectively. Senor Toba (Toronado), the second favourite as of last night, will start from the widest barrier after drawing stall 21.

McEvoy: Savatoxl barrier not ideal

The Tony and Calvin McEvoy-trained Savatoxl (Kuroshio) will jump from barrier 14 in Saturday's 16-runner Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m). Calvin McEvoy was hoping the last-start Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) winner would draw a single figure barrier and admits his task has been made harder from the wide gate. "It's not ideal, you would love to draw in and get forward, he loves to find the rail, so it makes it harder," McEvoy told Racing.com. "It's another tough field and we are not on our home deck this time, we've had to travel, but sometimes that can also be in your favour. I have full respect for the opposition and Barend (Vorster) has got good confidence in the horse." If the five-year-old performs well, he could be lined up in the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) on June 12. "He could possibly stay for the Stradbroke and there are a couple of other options as well," McEvoy continued. "We won't hesitate to just stop and look at the spring with him if he shows that as well."

"She is a really nice filly, there were no maidens over 1000 metres so we chose this race," McEvoy told Racing.com. "Her jump-outs have been super beating the older horses. If she does everything right, she should be winning."

Quickie impresses Stokes at Pakenham

Mr Quickie (Shamus Award) continued his preparation for the Stradbroke Handicap with a 1000-metre jump-out at his home track of Pakenham yesterday. The dual Group 1-winning five-year-old was ridden by Ben Allen and Phillip Stokes was pleased with what he saw. "He was sharp in his work this morning and we're really happy with how he's tracking into the Stradbroke," the trainer told Racing.com. "He led them out and definitely showed that he's fresh and ready to go. He'll have one more piece of work before hopefully flying up to Queensland on the Tuesday leading up to the Stradbroke, hopefully everything is worked out with the planes and he'll be able to fly up how he did before winning the Derby. He'll work the reverse way for that final piece of work, but we don't have any concerns with him going that way as he's already raced up in Queensland and Sydney before. We can't wait to get him up there."

Black Caviar's daughter wins jump-out

The sixth foal out of unbeaten champion Black Caviar (Bel Esprit), Invincible Caviar (I Am Invincible), impressively won an 800-metre trial at Pakenham yesterday as she edges closer to her racecourse debut. The Peter Moody-trained filly will bid to become the best of Black Caviar's progeny, with the 25-time winner so far producing two winners from three runners and no performers at stakes level. "It was nice to see her lengthen like that. She's at a stage

now where you can confidently say she's not no good," Moody told RSN. "What ability or where she lies in the food chain will be guided by how she improves off the back of that trial firstly then off the back of a few gallops. She's a metropolitan class filly. Is she going to be a black type filly? Look, she needs to improve more. She has done everything right. She has won a trial in good order. Let's hope we can find a nice two-year-old fillies race for her in a couple of weeks' time." Jockey Bryan Higgins added: "She gave me a beautiful feel, as you would expect from a well-bred filly like her. I've only sat on her a couple of times. It was a good trial. Without getting carried away, I think she goes okay and she will win a few races."

Busuttin ponders Group 1 tilt with Tycoon

Trent Busuttin, who trains in partnership with Natalie Young, will be keeping a close eye on Saturday's BRC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Eagle Farm before deciding whether to send promising juvenile Blushing Tycoon (Written Tycoon) to Queensland for the JJ Atkins (Gr 1, 1600m). The colt finished runner-up in the SA Sires' Produce (Gr 3, 1400m) earlier this month before getting off the mark at Flemington on Saturday. "I'll be paying close attention to the Sires' on Saturday as those that run well there will go for the Atkins and it looks a pretty hot field there on Saturday," Busuttin told Racing.com. "Blushing Tycoon was solid there on Saturday and so no doubt has to improve to get to that level, but I think the horse certainly has improvement in him and he'll get the 1600 metres. It's a Group 1 race and he's by Written Tycoon, so you have to have a look at it."

King partners Ayrton in work

Unbeaten colt Ayrton (Ifraaj) was partnered by Rachel King in a trackwork session at Eagle Farm yesterday as he prepares for Saturday's Fred Best Classic (Gr 3, 1400m). The Mick Price and Michael Kent jr-trained three-year-old will be ridden by Jamie Kah on Saturday, but Kah will be unable to ride Ayrton if he lines up in the Stradbroke Handicap a fortnight later due to weight. "The work was good, the horse good

and all is well," Price told Racing.com. "Rachel King had a sit and seemed to get on well with the horse and understand it. Her feedback was very accurate. I thought it was typical of those good professional jockeys. They understand their horses. They worked on the course proper with Odeum, who was ridden by Jordan Grob, who is my ex-apprentice and he knows every blade of grass here. They ran 1000 metres home improving 600 metres and the time was good and the work was good." Ayrton will gain a ballot-free exemption into the Stradbroke if he wins on Saturday but Price is yet to commit to a start in the Group 1. "We need a reality check after the Fred Best, whatever the result," he said. "I think I need to get a few opinions after the Fred Best on how he is situated in regards to the potential opposition in the Stradbroke. I just want to do the right thing by the horse."

Eagle the spring goal for Ayrton

Kent jr has earmarked the \$7.5 million The Golden Eagle (1500m) at Rosehill in October as the spring target for Ayrton, in preference to the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) at Moonee Valley. "I know the ratings guys respect Ayrton a lot but he's still a baby and I just think it's an obvious decision, why overexpose him early, as The Golden Eagle is for four-year-olds only," Kent jr told RSN. "The Golden Eagle is also over 1500 metres and we don't actually know if he gets 2000 metres yet let alone a tough 2000 metres against the best horses in Australia, if not the world."

Rock Prophet rested for Flemington final

Last-start Flemington winner Rock Prophet (Moshe) is set to make two further starts up the straight this season as he builds towards his final goal of the Victorian Sprint Series Final (Listed, 1200m) on July 3. The Ray Besanko-trained gelding landed the Breeders' Handicap (1000m), the opening heat of the All Victorian Sprint Series, on May 15 and will likely have one more run before the final. "He races best with his runs spaced, we found out that if you race him with his starts too close together, he doesn't race as well," Besanko told Racing.com.

True Self set for another international campaign

Irish globetrotter True Self (Oscar) will return to Australia for the spring after having a run in the United States. Trained by Willie Mullins and raced by Three Mile House and OTI Partnership, the eight-year-old mare, who was narrowly beaten in the Tattersalls Gold Cup (Gr 1, 1m 2.5f) at the curragh on the weekend, landed the Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 3, 2600m) at Flemington in 2019 and 2020. OTI's Terry Henderson confirmed her plans for the coming months. "She's a remarkable mare," Henderson told RSN. "She'll arrive back over here in Australia as a nine-year-old and she just seems to be getting better with age. We'll most likely take her to a race in America like the Arlington Million and then we will come across here for the spring, where she may be more aimed at the Cox Plate. So, hopefully, those lovely people at Moonee Valley might send her an invitation."

Wilde plans to win another Grand Annual with Gold Medals

Symon Wilde will spell his Warrnambool Grand Annual Steeplechase (5500m) winner Gold Medals (Elvstroem) and has a long-range plan to try and win a third Grand Annual next year with him. Wilde said there was not a lot to be gained, other than money and more weight, if he pressed ahead with the rising 12-year-old further into the current jumps season. "He's that well and we were thinking of continuing on and running him in the Australian Steeple, but after thinking about it there was not a lot to be gained, other than the monetary side of it. And he would only get extra weight for next year's Annual," the trainer said. "He's such a Warrnambool specialist, especially around that course, so why risk injury when we can have one last crack at the Annual next year and that can be his swansong? If he didn't come up, or we weren't happy with him, we wouldn't run him as he's run in four Grand Annuals, and he's never been further back than second, which is pretty incredible."

Beer looks to NZ for bargain buys

Mitch Beer boasts a number of tried purchases from New Zealand, including the improving Swagger (Postponed) who will line up in the TAB Highway (1400m) this Saturday, and has

explained why he often shops across the Tasman. "When you don't have a huge amount of money to spend you've got to shop around, you've got to keep your eyes open and you've got to look for deals," the trainer said. "The Inglis Digital and tried horse market in Australia is insane, absolutely insane. I think that the market over there [New Zealand] is massive and to buy a horse and bring it over here to compete at Wednesday to Saturday level is very hard. But, there's so many races to be won in the bush here. The whole thing of six or seven grand to fly them over here, it's only a couple of clicks online and you can spend an extra five or six (thousand) very easily. The Kiwi's want to get their horses over here and they're happy to do it because their prize-money isn't anywhere near as good."

In-form team hoping for more joy at Sandown

Having scored an Albury treble on Monday, Mitch Beer is hoping his form can continue at Sandown today where he lines up Bezos (Written Tycoon) and Power Me Up (Pins) in the Ladbrokes Switch Handicap (1500m). "We've got a higher-rated horse that is claiming and a more lowly-rated horse that is in form," Beer said. "They both race up on the speed, they're rock hard fit. Bezos should have won his last two but he's had no luck while Power Me Up has really found form."

Eclair Sunrise chases city win at Caulfield

Dan O'Sullivan is hoping last-start Ballarat winner Eclair Sunrise (Fastnet Rock) can benefit from a rain-soaked track when lining up in a two-year-old contest over 1200 metres at Caulfield on Saturday. Eclair Sunrise, who cost \$480,000 as a yearling, comfortably won at Ballarat on Heavy 9 ground. "It's all dependant on the weather, but it looks like she will be going," O'Sullivan said. "She's certainly effective on a wet track but it doesn't need to be heavy. She excelled on a wet track up here (Ballarat) and it seems a suitable sort of race for her to have a crack at this stage. She galloped here this morning on the grass with a mate and worked up as well as you would hope she would do."

Nestor duo ready for Saturday

Dubbo-based trainer Kody Nestor will send two live chances to Sydney on Saturday,

with Jailbreak (Rubick) and Golden Gorge (Mossman) set to line up at Randwick. Jailbreak will line up in the Benchmark 78 (1100m), while Golden Gorge will be looking for back-to-back wins in the Tab Highway. On Jailbreak, Nestor said: "He's at the point now where he's benchmarked a little bit high for a country-level race, he gets out weighted in them," he said. "He's going to have to step up to the mark and be competitive there on Saturday. I'm sure he puts his hand up there to get a run in the Kosciuszko for sure." Golden Gorge won at Hawkesbury earlier this month and Nestor said: "He's come through his run really well. We've kept him on fresh legs. It was a good win with a big weight and he's going to have to carry it again there on Saturday."

Connections bullish about 'gorgeous colt' Mangani

Michael Kent jr has labelled Mangani (Tarzino) as one to watch in the spring after the two-year-old's eighth-placed debut over 1400 metres at Flemington last Saturday. "If you were to script the worst scenario for a nice horse debuting it would be staying in barrier one for three minutes, miss the start, and a moderate tempo," Kent, who trains in partnership with Mick Price, told RSN927. "They quickened down and he couldn't go with them, but through the line he was perfect. We would have preferred for him to have drawn a bit out and build momentum at the right time. He is a gorgeous colt and I would be very surprised if he wasn't in some of those Derby lead-ups in the spring," he said.

New jockey for Rothfire

Last year's JJ Atkins winner Rothfire (Rothsay) is nearing his return to action after successfully completing a trackwork session at Eagle Farm yesterday under Ben Thompson, and the three-year-old will have a new jockey during the spring. Rothfire, whose main target is The Everest (1200m), has been out of competitive action since injuring himself when finishing fourth in the Golden Rose (Gr 1, 1400m) under Jim Byrne last September and trainer Rob Heathcote is likely to opt for a Sydney jockey in the spring. Heathcote was unhappy with Byrne's ride aboard Rothfire in the Golden Rose, for which he was sent off a \$1.55 favourite.

RV announce additional Covid measures

Racing Victoria yesterday issued an update to the regulations in place following the announcement by the state government that additional COVIDSafe measures will be put in place. Effective from 6pm last night, face masks must be worn indoors at stables and training centres in the Greater Melbourne area, as well as indoors at all Victorian race meetings. Additionally, any person who has attended a Covid exposure site, or reasonably suspects that a close contact has done so, is not permitted to attend a Victorian racecourse or licensed premises until further notice.

Night finish times to be brought forward

Night racing times are set to be brought forward with 9:45pm between September and March to be the latest Victorian racing will be conducted throughout the 2021-22 season, RV announced yesterday. All night racing times will be brought forward 15 minutes, with Friday night meetings in April and May, which are held exclusively at Cranbourne, set to finish at 9:15pm in April and 8:45pm in May. Thursday night meetings at Pakenham will now finish at 9:15pm from October to April with an 8:45pm finish to come into effect from the start of May.

Trainers back early finishes

The Australian Trainers' Association yesterday welcomed the announcement of the earlier finish times for night racing. ATA chief executive Andrew Nicholl told Racing.com: "It is tremendous. We've got the balance there between what the clubs need and what the participants need. It's something that we have been debating at racing ops level for probably two years. With the continuation of seven-day-a-week racing, we really had to look at where a compromise could be (found). But now coming up with that 9:45 (finish) for those marquee meetings and a 9:15 close outside of that, is a real balance that gives clubs the ability to market and manage their business. The earlier finish is great for the participants."

Inquiry launched into alleged treatment of Anacheeva Lad

Queensland stewards have launched an inquiry into the alleged treatment of the Peter Kings-trained Anacheeva Lad (Anacheeva) who was due to race at Toowoomba last Saturday before being scratched after swab samples were taken. Kings, who is due to appear at an inquiry when the results of analysis of the samples are known, was found to be in possession of modified spurs at his registered stables. He was fined \$1000 and also handed an additional fine of \$200 for employing an unlicensed stablehand.

Stawell meeting abandoned

Yesterday's meeting at Stawell was abandoned after one race due to the state of the track. Having been rated a Good 4 on race-day morning, the condition of the track deteriorated as rain fell from 10:30am onwards. The track was downgraded to a Soft 7 at 11:30am and Heavy 8 at 12:25pm ahead of the opening race at 1pm, an 1100-metre maiden won by the Mathew Ellerton and Simon Zahra-trained Sotirio (Lonhro). Racing Victoria stewards abandoned the meeting at approximately 1:15pm, with seven races remaining on the card. The Bureau of Meteorology's rain gauge located at the Stawell Aerodrome, approximately 2.5 kilometres west of the racecourse, received 13.8 millimetres of rain between 10:30am and 1pm.

Vale Brian Russell

Racing and breeding journalist, bloodstock agent, historian and renowned pedigree authority, Brian Russell, died peacefully in his family home at North Richmond on Saturday, aged 90. A memorial gathering is being planned for early next month in the Hunter Valley. ANZ Bloodstock News passes on our condolences to his family and friends.

Paewai welcomes wet tracks

Marilyn Paewai is relishing the opportunity to run her mare Rosewood (Redwood) on a testing

surface on the weekend. The wet track specialist has recorded nine of her ten wins on heavy tracks, and Paewai is hoping to add another when she lines-up in the King of Comedy at Novara Park North Island Challenge Stakes (1400m) at Trentham on Saturday. The track was rated a Heavy 11 yesterday morning and the Taranaki trainer is hoping it will remain so ahead of the weekend. "That Heavy 11 is like telling me I have won a bar of chocolate," said Paewai, who owns and trains the seven-year-old. Rosewood was runner-up first-up over 1400 metres at New Plymouth earlier this month and Paewai admitted to feeling a sense of relief following the race. "She is a rising eight-year-old and you can't help but hold your breath a little bit when they are first asked a question and that they are going to come back," she said. "But I have been really pleased with her."

Bosson farewells Melody Belle

Opie Bosson yesterday paid his own tribute to Melody Belle (Commands) on the day the 14-time Group 1-winning mare sold for \$2.6 million at the Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale. Bosson rode Melody Belle in 16 of her 40 starts, scoring nine wins and three minor placings and he was on board at the weekend when she ended her racing career with a fifth-placed finish in the Doomben Cup (Gr 1, 2000m). "I think the timing was right to retire her now, and she's gone out safe and sound," Bosson said. "She's meant a lot to myself and my family. She's given us a lot of thrills and you knew every time you go out on her, she was going to give you everything. It was quite emotional actually, riding her for the last time." Bosson said the two races that stuck out most in Melody Belle's glittering career were her 2017 Karaka Million 2YO (RL, 1200m) and her Empire Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) victory in Melbourne two years ago. "The Karaka Million was my first ride on her and I'd only just become stable rider for Te Akau, and I really wasted hard to ride 54.5 kilograms on her, so for it all to pay off was quite a buzz," he said. "And in the Empire Rose she showed them that she was up to the top fillies and mares at weight-for-age level in Australia."

ASIA

HK: Shinn aiming to build on Sha Tin double

Blake Shinn is hopeful Harmony N Blessed (Magnus) can rediscover his winning groove when he contests the Class 3 Java Handicap (1000m) at Happy Valley this evening. After bursting onto the scene with a pair of rousing wins at his first two starts, the lightly-raced four-year-old has been unsuccessful in four subsequent runs, but Shinn is optimistic of his ability to not only bounce back but to carry on with his advance up the handicap. "His form has been fairly consistent but as he's gone up in class when he's got a racing pattern where he has to do it at both ends - it's hard for him, especially when he has to absorb so much pressure," the rider said. "But I believe he's going to make his way up the ratings, quite high in the ratings actually, so we certainly haven't reached the bottom of this horse and hopefully tomorrow night he can show his true form."

HK: Moreira expecting improvement from Majestic Star

Later on the Happy Valley card, Majestic Star (I Am Invincible), who overhauled Harmony N Blessed last start, will feature in the Class 3 Marble Handicap (1200m) under three-time champion jockey Joao Moreira. Stepping away from gate four against 11 rivals, the gelding will look for back-to-back wins after his length and half success earlier this month over the course and distance. "He had the perfect run through - he had the best gate on the day, a clear run in the straight, everything was perfect for him and he definitely needs the

same to go his way again, if he gets a smooth run then no doubt he's a good enough horse to win again," Moreira said. Trained by Anthony and Sam Freedman prior to export from Australia, Majestic Star was a two-time winner from four starts Down Under. "Having had only three starts (in Hong Kong) that indicates to me that the more often we go to the races the more he's going to improve - I'm quite confident that he's going to improve further and win more races in Hong Kong," Moreira added.

GER: Australian Bloodstock's German hope

Australian Bloodstock's latest purchase Lambo (Protectionist) is set to bid for Classic honours after pleasing connections in his most-recent outing. Trained in Germany by Miroslav Rulec, the colt showed his well being with a third-

placed finish when heading to France to contest Longchamp's Prix Hocquart (Gr 2, 2200m) on Monday, beaten just a length by the winner Bubble Gift (Nathaniel). Lambo is now likely to take his chance in the Deutsches Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) at Hamburg on July 4.

The impressive upset resume of jockey turned builder Paul Jarman

Paul Jarman was no stranger to causing an upset. He won his second Victoria Derby on Big Print, a 20-1 chance who - in 1979 - defied two champions in Kingston Town and Roy Higgins.

Big Print, appropriately by a stallion named My Friend Paul (Pretendre), won by a short head from the famed son of Bletchingly (Biscay) on whom the great Higgins hadn't found the clearest path. Many claimed the champ was unlucky. Jarman claimed the spoils.

Jarman's first Victoria Derby win came 12 years earlier, while still an apprentice, aboard 9-1 chance Savoy (Latin Lover).

He won the 1970 Cox Plate on 33-1 pop Abdul (Sovereign Edition).

He won the 1986 Ascot Vale Stakes (now the Group 1 Coolmore Stud Stakes) on Zephyr Cross (Zephyr Zing) whose official starting price was a whopping 140-1 after 200-1 had been bet. Again he upstaged a champion with Bounding Away (Biscay) a half head astern.

And for good measure, he claimed an international Group 1 success in the 1973 Irish St Leger on Conor Pass (Tiepolo) who was no longshot but did tip over the favourite Sunyboy (Mourne). That came just two years after his Melbourne colleague Alan Simpson had won the race.

Jarman, 73 and living on the Gold Coast, says the memories of his riding exploits are not that vivid. "It was a long time ago," he

said. However, his recollections proved to be unerringly accurate.

The 1979 Victoria Derby on Big Print, trained by Andy White, is arguably his best remembered win. "Not sure I was lucky to win but I do know that Kingston Town never won at Flemington and I'm glad he didn't. Higgins rode Kingston Town after Malcolm Johnston chose Mighty Kingdom who'd won the Caulfield Cup. He was favourite, not Kingston Town. Kingston Town charged late but we held on," he said.

Kingston Town won 30 races including three Cox Plates but was unsuccessful in four starts at Flemington.

Jarman was champion apprentice in Victoria in 1965, 1966 and 1967 and, at just 19, he won the Derby on the Ken Hilton-trained Savoy in the last of those three title-winning years. "Yes, I was still an apprentice when I won that Derby but I wasn't the first," he said.

That distinction, according to research from Danny Power and Malcolm McLaren, likely sits with Phar Lap's jockey Jim Pike who won on Beverage (Maltster) - a horse who was blind in one eye - in 1910. Pike was 18 - as was Lester Piggott when he won his first Epsom Derby on 33-1 chance Never Say Die (Nasrullah) in 1954.

Then, in 1970, not long after coming out of his time he “pinched” the 1970 Cox Plate on the longshot Abdul who was trained by Geoff Murphy and won by three lengths. “I took off just past the school and he kept running,” Jarman said.

“Ridden a heady race by Paul Jarman, Abdul was taken to the front 500 metres from home and shot clear while other jockeys were waiting for breaks which were not forthcoming,” Rhett Kirkwood and Brian Meldrum wrote in the “Valley of Kings - a history of the W.S. Cox Plate”.

In 1973, he took the chance to venture to Ireland to ride for Australian-born Irish trainer Kevin Prendergast who favoured antipodean jockeys. “Laurie Johnson had been riding for Kevin but he decided to stay in Singapore in 1973 and apparently I was recommended. I jumped at it. I’d just been married and thought this would be a good honeymoon and I’d get paid for it.

“It was great. I rode 50 or 60 winners in each of my two seasons there and I loved the extended daylight. I’d go fly-fishing after the races,” said Jarman, who remains keen on fishing and crabbing.

As was the case with Abdul, he made an early and decisive move on Conor Pass to win the St Leger in his first year with Prendergast, who trained the three-year-old. “We kicked away at the three furlongs (600 metres) and held on. He probably wasn’t a real stayer but like many three-year-olds he could do it against his own age,” he said.

An ambitious trek to America for the Washington International was undertaken with Conor Pass later that year. “I headed over there but the horse didn’t travel well, picked up an infection and couldn’t run. As it turned out, another Aussie Billy Pyers won the race that year on the great mare Dahlia.

“I remember all the international visitors were out for dinner that night and, at one stage,

Billy comes bursting through the restaurant sitting on a tricycle and singing “if you ever go across the sea to Ireland...,” he said.

Jarman relished his time abroad but was equally pleased to head home after two years. “It was a great experience to ride in Ireland and England although I didn’t have much luck in England. Some of the tracks were amazing but, after a while, I was happy to get home to ride on some nice, flat tracks.

“Over there, if I was heading to track I didn’t know I’d look for the side of a mountain and think to myself ‘that’s where the track will be,” he said.

Jarman was perhaps not your stereotypical jockey and happily retired early, at just 39, to emulate his father Jim in taking out a builders’ licence - but not before that memorable win on 140-1 chance Zephyr Cross at Flemington in 1986.

Zephyr Cross was trained by Alan Yeomans who was left a paraplegic after an infamous fall at Pakenham in January 1960. Yeomans, who’d won the 1958 Caulfield Cup on Sir Blink (Blue Coral), would turn to swimming (and wheelchair sports) and won three medals in swimming at the 1962 Commonwealth Paraplegic Games in Perth. In 1967, he became the first licensed paraplegic horse trainer in Australia.

Simpson, Jarman’s Irish St Leger winning predecessor, escaped serious injury in that three-horse fall. Simpson had served his apprenticeship at Mentone while Jarman had done likewise at neighbouring Epsom, indentured to Jack Besanko and it was one of Besanko’s owners, Lee McKeen, who’d organised Simpson’s employment in Ireland.

What price that two jockeys from adjoining southern Melbourne training centres would each win the St Leger, in Ireland, two years apart?

Jarman estimates he rode 1500 winners. Alas, the Melbourne Cup was not among them but his resume was pretty darn good for a man who walked away from the profession sooner than most with his record and profile.

“Had 13 rides in the Cup with a fourth and a fifth the best I did,” he said.

He was beaten just two lengths into fourth place in the 1972 Cup won by Piping Lane (Lanesborough). “I rode Double Irish who’d won the Moonee Valley Cup, beating Piping Lane who finished third but he was too good at Flemington. Double Irish was just pipped for third by the great Gunsynd,” he said.

Jarman is married to Lyn, daughter of trainer Bill Warke and the girl he took on that Irish honeymoon almost 50 years ago. They have two children; Ben and Tammy and six grandchildren; Emily, Mackenzie, Stephanie, Tyrell, Zayden and Mariah.

He stays in touch with former riding colleagues including Stan Aitken and Pat Trotter and continues to follow the races. “I still try to back a winner but I’m not much good at it. I like to catch a fish or a crab, that’s still with me, but I’m not much playing as much golf as I used to because I keep getting worse at it,” he said.

Uberleben victory gives Mirco Demuro a boost ahead of the Tokyo Yushun

Mirco Demuro's timely Yushun Himba (Gr 1, 2400m) victory on Uberleben (Gold Ship) at Tokyo on Sunday not only gave a welcome fillip to his campaign, ahead of another big-race assault against an unbeaten favourite in this weekend's Tokyo Yushun (Gr 1, 2400m), but also initiated a day of high elation and deep emotions for his family.

Nine hours after the Italian rider's second success in the race known more widely as the Japanese Oaks – following Loves Only You (Deep Impact) in 2019 – his brother Cristian Demuro landed his fifth Derby Italiano (Gr 2, 2400m) at the Capannelle in Rome, fittingly aboard the Satoshi Kobayashi-trained Tokyo Gold (Kendargent) in the colours of Teruya Yoshida.

"It was an amazing weekend for us," Demuro told Asia Bloodstock News, as he noted the poignancy wrapped up in those results: Uberleben's owner-breeder Shigeyuki Okada passed away in March, while the Demuro brothers lost a friend last week when Palio di Siena champion Andrea Mari was killed in a car accident at age 43.

"The owner was a nice person and when he had a Group 1 horse, he always thought of me as a jockey; our friend, he risked his life every moment on the horse and then he died in a car accident. This was all passing in my head in the moment when I won," he continued.

"Then, on the night, I supported my brother and it was emotional because my father passed away last year and he loved to go to the races. Yesterday my mother was there, and my brother was emotional and I was crying too, watching



online, and my daughter was there onstage at the presentation. It was a beautiful moment."

In Tokyo, Uberleben triumphed in the silks of K Thoroughbred Club Ruffian, having been bred by Okada's Big Red Farm, and is the first Group 1 winner for her talented but temperamental sire Gold Ship (Stay Gold). Demuro partnered the Takahisa Tezuka-trained filly to finish a close third behind the 'white wonder' Sodashi (Kurofune) in the Hanshin Juvenile Fillies (Gr 1, 1600m) in December, but things did not go quite to plan thereafter with a bout of colic stalling her progress, resulting in two more third-place returns. The first of those meant she did not have enough prize-money in the bank to take on Sodashi in the first Classic, the Oka Sho (Gr 1, 1600m), the Japanese 1,000 Guineas.

Demuro saw that as a blessing-in-disguise and a subsequent third behind Cool Cat (Screen Hero) in the Flora Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) earned enough money to book her place in the Oaks. But the jockey takes the view that he and Uberleben were able to see off Sodashi and co in the Oaks despite "not one of the best rides

I've had". Near the tail down the back, Demuro took the decision to advance very wide when the pace slackened and, upon finding cover again into the home turn, the filly galloped on to lead with 300 metres remaining.

"I was able to make her change legs: she's not easy to change legs and likes to fight with other horses and doesn't like to be stuck inside," he said. "I hit the front too soon for her, because she is still a baby, she was looking around and wasn't concentrating to the end, she was shifting in and out, but she always had the margin to win the race and she was waiting for the horses behind her. When Christophe (Lemaire on runner-up Akaitorino Musume) came at the end, I still had something to spend."

The Classic days in Japan are epic experiences, at least in non-Covid times, and that includes the Yushun Himba, but the biggest of all is the Tokyo Yushun, Japan's Derby, when 100,000 fans will turn out to roar on their heroes.

"The atmosphere in normal times is electric because of the breeding and the prospects in Japan for the stallions of the future and

the stars of the future who come out of the Derby,” said broadcaster and JRA race caller Murray Johnson. “The colts will go on to be the superstars at stud so I guess that’s the way the Japanese fans look at the Derby in terms of the stars of the future on the track and in the breeding barn.”

Last week’s Chiba Two-Year-Old Sale saw owner Susumu Fujita pay the highest price for a two-year-old at auction in Japan when he went to ¥517,110,000 for a colt from the penultimate crop of the late, great Deep Impact (Sunday Silence). Fujita likely has next year’s Japanese Derby in mind for the youngster, who is out of the Grade 3-placed mare Premier Steps (Footstepsinthesand), from the family of Group 1 winner Giofra (Danehill), who was runner-up in the 2012 Hong Kong Cup (Gr 1, 2000m). The vendor was Yoshida’s Shadai Farm and the Yoshida family has investment or involvement across a great majority of the runners in any given Derby.

This year’s winner of the Satsuki Sho, Japan’s 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m), and likely Derby favourite Efforia (Epiphaneia), will attempt to take his perfect streak to five wins and keep alive the Triple Crown dream. The bay was bred by Katsumi Yoshida’s Northern Farm and runs in the U Carrot Farm silks carried by his sire to second place in the 2013 Derby.

“The crosses with Epiphaneia seem to be working very well in the breeding and there seem to be some future stars from him,” Johnson noted. “And with some of the mares he’s been crossed with, former Group 1 winners as well, he looks like the potential star of the future in the breeding barn.”

Demuro, meanwhile, has won the blue riband twice before, with Neo Universe (Sunday Silence) and Duramente (King Kamehameha), and on Sunday he will partner Satsuki Sho fourth Admire Hadar (Lord Kanaloa) in a bid to emulate Lemaire’s 2017 feat of winning both 2400-metre classics in the same season; no other rider has accomplished that since before 1990.

“I rode Admire Hadar last week in training and he’s not bad,” Demuro said. “He has stamina and he was fourth last time on heavy ground, so if it is wet, I’m not worried. He has a chance but it’s the Derby so you can never

say you’re going to win or that you’re going to lose. He’s getting more mature, he has good condition, so he took his last race well, he’s good in his mind and I think he’ll handle the left turn and the distance.”

As well as the array of top colts, this year’s Derby features the classy filly Satono Reinas (Deep Impact), runner-up to Sodashi in the Hanshin Juvenile Fillies and the Oka Sho at her last two starts. Vodka (Tanino Gimlet) in 2007 became the first filly in 64 years to land the premier Classic and no other has done it since.

“It’s a very good, solid field and the filly, Satono Reinas, she hadn’t run for a long time and she still ran well in the 1,000 Guineas,” Demuro observed. “She’s in good form and she’s going to give the colts a hard race but, from my point of view, the colts are better this year than last year and the Satsuki Sho winner is a really good horse. I think it’s going to be hard to beat him.”

Demuro knows better than anyone that the past year has not met his expectations. After finishing 2019 with 91 wins and eighth in the jockeys’ list, 2020 saw him drop to 65 wins and 13th. Right now, he sits in 19th place with 26 wins.

“This year is still not out of fifth gear and I can feel it. I’m struggling to get rides and struggling to get a winner but, for me, it’s going better than last year. I’m confident in myself, I

try hard and I keep fit and that’s all I can do. I hope this win puts me back on the stage and helps me find other winners,” he said.

With fan attendance limited, the atmosphere for Yushun Himba day was not as it was two years ago when he guided Loves Only You to victory and the normal supercharged crowd noise will be lacking for Sunday’s Tokyo Yushun, too.

“When you have the full crowd in, it’s the same feeling you get winning at Royal Ascot,” he said. “It’s unbelievable, so many people and so many screams: people scream your name and for us it’s like a soccer player entering the stadium of Barcelona, or you play NBA and you enter into the arena in Los Angeles, it’s the same feeling. You are a champion and there is no better feeling.”

That champion’s desire has kept Demuro in the Group 1 zone despite days this past year when he has turned up for only a paltry handful of rides and, after the much-needed boost of Uberleben’s Oaks victory, he is hungry for that quick follow-up in the Derby.

“No one wants to be a jockey because they want to win at Catterick,” he added. “They become a jockey because they want to be a champion, they want to win the Breeders’ Cup or the Arc, or Japan Cup, that’s why we are born, that’s why we decided to do this sport.”

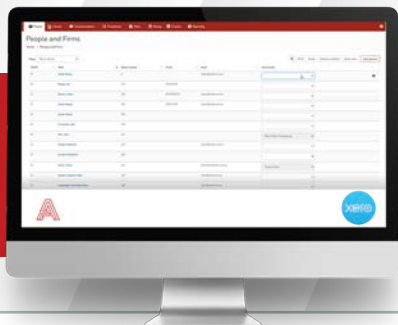
