Yulong buys into Alabama Express

Moroney's Group 1-winning son of Redoute's Choice to stand in Victoria

ast-start C F Orr Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Alabama Express (Redoute's Choice) will stand at stud in Victoria once his racing career is over after Yulong struck a deal to buy into the talented three-year-old.

Alabama Express, who is trained by Mike

Moroney, will join Yulong's foundation stallion Grunt (O'Reilly), the most supported first season sire in Victoria last year, at owner Yuesheng Zhang's Nagambie farm upon his retirement.

Negotiations between Yulong Investments and connections of Alabama Express ramped up in the past few days before confirmation of a controlling interest in the colt was made on Tuesday.

Eccles enhances Oaks claims with impressive Lowlands success

Since finishing a strong and unlucky long-neck second in the New Zealand One Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Riccarton in November, Jennifer Eccles (Rip Van Winkle) has notched three Group 2 wins in four subsequent starts and she looks to have a stranglehold on next month's New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m). Like her classy Fillies Classic (Gr 2, 2000m) victory at Te Rapa earlier this month, Jennifer Eccles had her opponents in trouble in yesterday's Lowlands Stakes (Gr 2, 2100m) soon after starting the run for home at Hastings. Ridden by Jason Waddell, Jennifer Eccles

sat one out in sixth down the back straight and started her run from the 600-metre marker.

Yulong chief operating officer Sam Fairgray, speaking from the Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale yesterday, declared the acquisition as being "great for Yulong, great for Victoria and we are really pleased to be able to get a horse of this quality to stand at our farm".

"His win in the Orr had huge merit because he was trapped wide yet he was so strong to the line.



of an Encosta De Lago mare, so it is pretty exciting going forward to have a horse of his quality."

Alabama Express is raced by a syndicate that includes Arrowfield Stud, prominent New Zealand investor Lib Petagna and leviathan owner Rupert Legh, who also raced the dual Group 1-winning, Mick Pricetrained Grunt.

He has won four of his seven starts, including the Gothic Stakes (Listed, 1400m) last spring as well as both runs this campaign, most notably the Orr Stakes second-up against older horses.

Yearling Sale graduate from the Arrowfield Stud draft, Alabama Express
was selected by Moroney's brother, and renowned agent, Paul in 2018.

He is one of three winners for the raced mare Lago Ovation (Encosta De Lago), who is a half-sister to Rekindled Power (Redoute's Choice), who was Group 2-placed in Sydney, and the ATC Carbine Club Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m)-placed Shuffle Up (Redoute's Choice).

Paul Moroney said: "He had a lot of his dad, Redoute's Choice, about him (as a yearling). He was a great moving horse and to me, he was a

racehorse.

He's got all the hallmarks of making a great stallion prospect - he's a Group 1 winner, he's athletic, he's a standout on type and he's got a lot of his dad about him

standout on class.

"He's obviously taken that quality of his looks across to the racetrack and he's proven himself as a high-quality

- he's a Group 1 winner, he's athletic, he's a standout on type and he's got a lot of his dad about him.

"We've always thought that he was a miler, so I'm excited to see him step up to that distance this weekend. We thought that from the day we bought him as a yearling."

Alabama Express will arguably be the best-credentialed son of Redoute's Choice, who died in March 2019, to stand in Victoria in recent years.

Arrowfield Stud's decision to relinquish its share in Alabama Express

was crucial in ensuring the colt stayed in Victoria for stud duties, which Fairgray said could be delayed until 2021, depending on how the remainder of the colt's autumn campaign panned out.

"With the group of mares that we have got on the farm, with a lot by Zabeel and a lot of Street Cry mares, he will be very well supported in his early years at stud," he said.

"Arrowfield are selling out their share as they have got The Autumn Sun, so they have decided that they were happy for us to buy him, so that is another coup for us."

Redoute's Choice has 28 weanlings from his final crop born last year, comprising of 17 colts and 11 fillies.

Five for Needs Further

ARMIDALE STUD

Armidale Stud resident Needs Further (Encosta De Lago) sired his fifth individual stakes winner yesterday when Deroche (3 f ex Buzzing Along by Tough Speed) landed the Vamos Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at Launceston. Trained by Leanne Gaffney, Deroche made it five wins from her last six outings when pulling a length clear of Miss Mandito (Zacinto), with a further half-length back to Jentico (Written Tycoon) in third. Now the winner of nine of her 13 starts for prize-money of \$363,639, the progressive Deroche joins last year's Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and All-Star Mile (1600m) heroine Mystic Journey, Mystical Pursuit, Pateena Arena and Bold Star as stakes winners for Needs Further, who covered 103 mares at a fee of \$13,750 in 2019.

Midnight lands Launceston Cup

The Patrick Payne-trained Home By Midnight (7 g Domesday - Fastnet Lady by Fastnet Rock), who raced as Five To Midnight in New Zealand, produced a dominant performance when taking out yesterday's Launceston Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) by two and a quarter lengths. Taikomochi (Snitzel) ran second, while Dogmatic completed a 1-3 for

Aquis Farm resident Domesday (Red Ransom) when finishing a further two and a half lengths adrift in third. A last-start sixth behind Toorak Affair (Toorak Toff) in the Hobart Cup (Gr 3, 2400m), Home By Midnight comprehensively reversed form with that rival, who could only muster a seven and a quarter-length sixth having been sent off the \$3.20 favourite. Home By Midnight is now the winner of 10 of his 54 starts for prize-money of \$854,193.

Midnight caps team effort in Cup

Winning rider Billy Egan was quick to praise both Payne and jockey Tahlia Hope, travelling foreperson for Home By Midnight, having taken out yesterday's \$250,000 feature. "The shades went on today so he just positioned up a lot easier without much work needed," Egan told Racing.com. "Such a team effort and I'm really proud of Tahlia for what she's done with the horse." Representing connections, Prime Thoroughbreds Joe O'Neill concurred. "It was a fantastic win, all credit to Patrick, he had the horse in fantastic order," O'Neill also told Racing.com. "If the horse was going to be good enough he was going to win the race."

Three in a row for Mandela Effect

The Scott Brunton-trained Mandela Effect (5 g Turffontein-Morell by West Quest) completed a hattrick of Listed wins since the turn of the year when he landed the Mowbray Stakes (Listed, 1600m) earlier on the Launceston card. Supplementing his victories in the Tasmanian Stakes (Listed, 1600m) and the Thomas Lyons Stakes (Listed, 1400m), in which he fended off stable companion Hellova Street (Helike) on both occasions, Mandela Effect once again got the better of his old rival by a neck. Zatacla (Al Maher) was a further half a lengths

adrift in third as the front three pulled clear of their remaining four rivals. Well campaigned by Brunton, Mandela Effect has won 12 of his 23 starts for prizemoney of \$547,939.

Eight for Guineas

A high-class field of eight runners has been assembled for Saturday's Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Flemington, headed by CS Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) quinella Alligator Blood (All Too Hard) and Catalyst (Darci Brahma). Alligator Blood, the CS Hayes winner but the \$3.10 secondfavourite with TAB for this weekend's assignment, has drawn barrier two under Ryan Moloney. Bookmakers believe Catalyst will turn the tables on his rival at 1600 metres, making him the \$2.60 favourite having drawn barrier four under Damian Lane. Yulong's new recruit Alabama Express (Redoute's Choice) will break from stall six under Michael Dee, while CS Hayes third Chenier (Medaglia d'Oro) has been handed gate five under Damien Oliver. Dalasan (Dalakhani) (3), Soul Patch (Shamus Award) (1), Superstorm (Sebring) (7) and Commodus (Uncle Mo) (8) complete the line-up.

Catalyst earns Lane's tick of approval

Lane, who was booked to ride Catalyst in the CS Hayes before being ruled out with a suspension, will replace James McDonald aboard New Zealand's star three-year-old on Saturday, and the leading jockey was delighted with the colt having partnered him in his final gallop at Mornington yesterday. "He got a little bit keen early now that he knows where he's going but he settled good through the middle stages and finished it offwell," Lane said. "It's going to be a cracking edition of the race. The 1600 metres is going to suit, as will having that run under the belt."

Macdonald not doubting Dalasan

Co-trainer Leon Macdonald expects CS Hayes fifth Dalasan to produce a bold display in the Australian Guineas, despite having almost four lengths to find with the market principals. "His work on Saturday was really good, so we're looking forward to having another crack at the likes of Alligator Blood and Catalyst," Macdonald, who trains in partnership with Andrew Gluyas, told Racing.com. Dalasan will be ridden by Jamie Kah on Saturday, his fourth different jockey in as many starts, and Macdonald expects patient tactics to suit on the return to 1600 metres. "I'd like to see him ridden a bit more conservatively over further ground," he added. "His best wins have been when he's ridden colder and really let down late."

Guizot chasing All-Star berth

Saturday's Blamey Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) offers the winner a guaranteed slot in next month's All-Star Mile (1600m) and Aaron Purcell has set Guizot (Tertullian) for the contest with a view to securing a coveted place in the \$5 million contest. Guizot is yet to win in four runs this campaign, but was a last-start third in the Carlyon Cup (Gr 3, 1600m) having experienced trouble in running. "If he had got out a bit earlier he probably would have gone close," Purcell said. "It just didn't work out for him on the day." Looking ahead to the weekend, Purcell continued: "He's drawn the outside barrier (9) in the Blamey so we're going to have to go back and ride him quiet, but if the race is run to suit I'm sure he's going to be in the finish somewhere."

Heart Of Puissance unplaced first-up

In other All-Star Mile news, Heart Of Puissance (Puissance De Lune) will take his chance in the Caulfield showpiece despite only running fourth in a Sandown handicap on his return yesterday. The Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained three-year-old was last sighted running third in the Sandown Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m), while he was beaten three and a quarter lengths on this his first start since November 16. "He'll improve a lot off that as it was a bit leader-ish today," Maher said postrace. "Once he got out it took him a little bit of time to wind up, but he'll be much better suited out to the mile and will come on a lot for that. All things being well we'll see him second-up in the All-Star Mile."

Xilong given Surround shot

Twilight Glow Stakes (Listed, 1400m) winner Xilong (Deep Field), who was withdrawn from her intended engagement in the Inglis 3YO Sprint (1200m) earlier this month having played up in the barriers, will take her chance first-up in the Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick on Saturday. "We wanted to have her second-up into this at the 1400 metres but unfortunately her race day manners didn't allow us to do that," Calvin McEvoy, who trains in partnership with his father Tony, said. "She didn't miss any work but obviously we would have much preferred her to have had that race going into it." Xilong, who will be ridden by Glen Boss, has drawn barrier 12 in the 14-filly line-up at the weekend and McEvoy continued: "Glen

galloped her this morning at Randwick and he really liked her. She's a lovely filly. If she's on her best behaviour she'll run a really nice race. I believe."

Stellar Pauline needs to stand up

Also at Randwick, Stellar Pauline (Not A Single Doubt), who finished runner-up to Away Game (Snitzel) in the Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) at the Gold Coast, will try to secure a rematch with that rival in next month's Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) when she lines up in the Sweet Embrace Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m). Stellar Pauline currently sits 38th in the order of entry for the Slipper and she needs to win on Saturday to gain a start in the \$3.5 million contest. One of three Sweet Embrace entries for Peter and Paul Snowden, Stellar Pauline could be joined by stable companions Tilia Rose (Written Tycoon) and Close To Me (I Am Invincible), who is dual accepted at Canterbury tomorrow night. "I thought her trial the other day and her work on Tuesday morning was excellent so she is on track to run well," Peter Snowden told Racing NSW.





Gem Of Scotland to skip Doomben

Rex Lipp has decided to bypass Saturday's \$125,000 The Jewel Prelude (F) (1100m) at Doomben with Gem Of Scotland (Rothesay) and will instead trial the progressive three-year-old next week before her intended outing in The Jewel (1200m) at the Gold Coast on March 14. "There is nothing wrong with her and I will probably trial her on Tuesday," the trainer said. Gem Of Scotland has won six of her nine starts and was last seen winning an Eagle Farm handicap on October 12. Her performance in The Jewel will dictate her campaign moving forward, with Lipp set to decide between a programme in Sydney or saving his filly for the Brisbane winter.

Three-pronged Prelude assault for Ross

Les Ross is set to saddle four-length Caloundra winner Hancora Field (Deep Field) and Mishani Miss (Denman) in The Jewel Prelude (F), while their stable companion Mishani Fraudster (Jet Spur) will take his chance in the preceding The Jewel Prelude (C&G) (1100m). "Rothfire (Robert Heathcote-trained gelding) is the one to beat in the OTIS Jewel (C&G) and Hancora Field is my best hope of beating him in the final (on March 14)," Ross told Racing Queensland. "Hancora Field had three days out in the paddock following her Caloundra win and she's ready to rumble. I'm just hoping the drop back in distance from 1200 metres to 1110 metres won't be a problem. Mishani Miss also had a couple of days out and she'll be up to her ears in the finish against Hancora Field."

Spectroscope out to continue McCall's streak

Natalie McCall has saddled four winners from her last five runners and French import Spectroscope (Medaglia d'Oro) will try to continue the rich vein of form and make it eighth-time lucky for the Caloundra trainer when he lines up in the Tattersall's Members Cup (Listed, 1600m) at Doomben on Saturday. Formerly trained by Andre Fabre, John O'Shea and James Cummings, Spectroscope has won four of his 32 starts, and while he has yet to

score since arriving with McCall early last year, he finished a neck second at Eagle Farm last Saturday. "He gets back in his races and his high rating means he gets big weights, which is no help to a small horse," McCall said. "But he never runs a bad race and his time is coming. We were originally looking for a Rockhampton Cup-type horse when we went to the dispersal sale but came away with him. His rating is too high for the provincials but he is paying his way here."

Challenge Stakes for Nature Strip

Chris Waller has ruled multiple Group 1 winner Nature Strip (Nicconi) out of Saturday week's Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) at Flemington, with the five-year-old instead set to contest Randwick's Challenge Stakes (Gr 2, 1000m) on the same afternoon. Nature Strip had been allocated the welter burden of 58 kilograms in the Newmarket, the weights for which will now rise one kilogram following his defection, and Waller said the Challenge provided a better stepping stone for his star sprinter, who is being targeted at the TJ Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) in April prior to embarking on a Royal Ascot campaign. "It has not been an easy decision but we have now made a final call to bring him back to Sydney and prepare him for the Challenge Stakes," Waller said.

Toowoomba double for Tregea

Steve Tregea secured a double at Toowoomba after Command'n'conquer yesterday (Warhead) strode two and a quarter lengths clear of his nine rivals to make a taking debut in the Maiden Handicap (1100m) shortly before his relation, Prioritise (Rothesay), maintained his unbeaten record at the track with victory in the Open Handicap (1300m). Command'n'conquer was bred by Tregea and the trainer said after the win: "Commanding Queen (dam of Command'n'conquer) is a halfsister to my handy horse Prioritise and she has got a handy filly in Conquering Lass, who won five races. I sent Commanding Queen to Warhead because he traces to some of the sire Snippets' bloodlines and a few good judges rap Warhead." Reflecting on the subsequent victory of Prioritise, Tregea added: "He has run some good races against good horses and he has won 11 races, so he has been good to us."

NEW ZEALAND

Derby could be Dragon Leap's NZ swansong

Saturday's New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) could be the last domestic outing for the Lance O'Sullivan and Andrew Scott-trained Dragon Leap (Pierro), who is destined to join the Hong Kong stable of O'Sullivan's brother, Paul, in the near future. "The brief when we went to the sales was to get a horse for the Hong Kong Derby so that's where he will be headed," O'Sullivan said. "If he runs well on Saturday there is a chance we could take him to Sydney for the Australian Derby. It will all depend on how well he goes on Saturday." Purchased at the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale in 2018, realising \$1,050,000 from the draft of Coolmore Stud having been bought by Hermitage Thoroughbreds in partnership with Wexford Stables and Andrew Williams Bloodstock, Dragon Leap is a dual Group 2 winner having taken out the Auckland Guineas (1600m) and Avondale Guineas (2100m) at his last two starts.

Gingernuts to make Ellerslie appearance

Triple Group 1 winner Gingernuts (Iffraaj) will return to the scene of his New Zealand Derby success when he leads out the parade of runners at Ellerslie on Saturday. Having also won the Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m) and Windsor Park Plate (Gr 1, 1600m), Gingernuts was retired from racing having suffered a fractured pastern when cantering to post in the 2017 renewal of the Emirates Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m). The six-yearold now resides at Te Akau Stud. "Gingernuts is part of the Ellis and Te Akau family. He's a true character, has a ton of personality, as well as the most beautiful nature, and he thinks he runs the farm," Te Akau's Karyn Fenton-Ellis (MNZM) said. "We really believe that he can be a wonderful ambassador for racing and would love to see him enjoy more activities that benefit racing and in particular deserving equine and youth charities."

Live Drama after stakes success

Live Drama (Ghibellines) will be out to secure her first black-type success when she contests the NZB Airfreight Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Wingatui on Saturday. Trained by Lance Robinson, the three-year-old was beaten by the narrowest of margins in the Gore Guineas (Listed, 1335m) on January 18 and she has since won in handicap company at Riccarton. "Her run in the Gore Guineas was excellent," Robinson said. "She had every chance, but I don't think she saw the winner coming. He came from way out wide and she was on the fence." Live Drama will jump from barrier 12 on

Saturday, but that holds no concerns for Robinson.

"She goes forward anyway, so I don't think it will be a problem," he added. "She should be able to

go forward and slot in with a little bit of cover. Her work was excellent yesterday (Tuesday) morning and she has really thrived since her Riccarton win. We are really happy with where we are at. She should run really well."

Auckland Cup for in-form Big Mike

The Craig and Shaun Phelan-trained Big Mike (Don Eduardo), who won twice in the space of three days at Wairoa last week, will try to complete the hat-trick in the Auckland Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) on March 7. Big Mike will carry 55 kilograms under the set weights and penalties conditions of the Auckland Cup where he is likely to be one of the pace influences. "He has a high cruising speed so it is no use trying to change the pattern," Craig Phelan said. "That is how he has been ridden in most of his races. He is back from Wairoa now and will spend a couple of days out in the paddock and let down a little bit. In saying that, we are not going to back off him because we took the Dummy

Myers approach of training him like a jumper and I think he followed a similar path a few years back with his Auckland Cup winner, Titch"

Belle's sibling remains unbeaten

The Jamie Richards-trained Exaltation (Not A Single Doubt), the three-year-old half-sister of her champion stable companion Melody Belle (Commands), maintained her unbeaten record when getting up in the final strides to win at Hastings yesterday. Purchased by David Ellis for \$900,000 from Book 1 of the 2018 NZB Karaka Yearling Sale, Exaltation supplemented her debut success at Riccarton in November with a neck win in yesterday's Benchmark 65 contest. Exaltation is the second winner from her dam, Meleka Belle (Iffraaj), who has since foaled a filly by Tavistock (Montjeu) in 2017, a colt by the same sire in 2018 and a sister to Exaltation in 2019 prior to visiting Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) last spring.

ince finishing a strong and unlucky long-neck second in the New Zealand One Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Riccarton in November, Jennifer Eccles (Rip Van Winkle) has notched three Group 2 wins in four subsequent starts and she looks to have a stranglehold on next month's New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m).

Like her classy Fillies Classic (Gr 2, 2000m) victory at Te Rapa earlier this month, Jennifer Eccles had her opponents in trouble in yesterday's Lowlands Stakes (Gr 2, 2100m) soon after starting the run for home at Hastings.

Ridden by Jason Waddell, Jennifer Eccles sat one out in sixth down the back straight and started her run from the 600-metre marker.

Into the home straight she gobbled up the leader, sped clear by three lengths at the 200 metres and cruised along. Indeed, Waddell had the opportunity to look over his shoulder three times while she raced further clear.

At the line, Jennifer Eccles drew away from Loire (Redoute's Choice) by four lengths, while Showbeel (Savabeel) finished a further length and a half adrift in third.

"She's aggressive, she's a racehorse. She's so competitive, is probably the words I'm looking for," Waddell said in the post-race debrief.

"The race was slowly-run, but I couldn't hold her any longer coming to the 600 metres. We thought she had a short turn of foot, but I don't know that I've ridden too many fillies that can quicken like she did.

"She's an incredible filly, I didn't touch her

and it was a pretty soft win. I can't wait for the Oaks."

Trainer Shaune Ritchie agreed. He said: "She was dominant today. I was worried leading up to the mile and a half of the Oaks. You've always got that little concern, but she continues to hold her condition and is certainly not getting any slower."

Purchased as a weanling from New Zealand Bloodstock's 2017 May Weanling Sale for NZ\$5,000, being knocked down to Adrian Clark Bloodstock from the draft of Westend Partnership, Jennifer Eccles (3 f Rip Van Winkle - Platinum Elle by Elnadim) is the fourth foal to race, and the second winner, out of Platinum Elle (Elnadim).

She has now won three of her 10 starts, placing on a further six occasions, for prizemoney of NZ\$268,400.

Platinum Elle won four times, including at Ellerslie and Riccarton, where she was also stakes-placed in the Canterbury Breeders' Stakes (Listed, 1400m).

Her Group 3-placed grand-dam, Lady Tee (Zabeel), is a daughter of dual New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) winner Waikiki (Crested Wave), who herself is a half sister to the grand-dam of Hong Kong Horse of the Year Sacred Kingdom (Encosta De Lago).
