Sun Stud excited about the prospects of freshman sire Palentino at Premier

First yearlings by dual Group 1-winning stallion set to make big impact at Oaklands Junction

ll eyes will be on Flemington when an eagerly anticipated renewal of the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) takes place tomorrow, just one day before the first yearlings by Palentino (Teofilo), winner of the stallion-making race in 2016, go through

the ring at Oaklands Junction as the Inglis Premier Yearling Sale gets underway in Melbourne.

Trained by Darren Weir, Palentino held off fellow freshman sire Tarzino (Tavistock), as well as eight other individual Group 1 winners, to win the autumn feature, prompting Sun Stud to secure a major share in the colt to stand at their farm at the end of his career.



Avilius a 'formidable opponent' in Chipping Norton

After a credible first-up performance in the CF Orr Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m), James Cummings believes Avilius (Pivotal) will shape up as a "formidable opponent" in tomorrow's Chipping Norton Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m). "He's bounced back in tip-top shape from his excellent return at Caulfield a few weeks ago," Cummings told Racing.com. "There's a brightness to his eye, he's swishing his tail and his coat has that sunburnt look that he gets at this time of year. We're looking at a balance between a swagger and a squeal as he goes onto the track in the morning."

Palentino was retired following his 2017 autumn campaign, which included victory in the Blamey Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) and fourth-place finishes in the Australia Stakes (Gr 2 1200m) and Doncaster Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m).

In three seasons at stud, the Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale graduate has received tremendous support by the breeding industry,

covering over 400 mares for a fee of \$17,600 (inc GST).

Sun Stud have been very impressed by their freshman sire's progeny and that opinion has been echoed by trainers and bloodstock agents during the first inspections at Oaklands.

"We're very happy with the progeny," Phillip Marshall of Sun Stud told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"He seems to be really stamping his stock. Not only are

most of them flashy chestnuts with plenty of white on them, but he's also got plenty of size, scope and bone into them that he has himself.

"He's a very strong horse and we're seeing that in his progeny. The other thing we're seeing is that Palentino was a very good work horse. He really enjoyed his work as a racehorse and we've found during the prep with the Palentinos that they're also really happy to keep working.

"The more work they can do the better and that's a great attribute to have going on into their racing careers.

"Overall, the fact he's stamping them and leaving what I call a commercial type, it's very pleasing to see."

Results from the sales season so far have shown buyers are not shying away from the new, unproven sires and early feedback has indicated that won't change at Premier with Palentino.

"The feedback has been very good," Marshall continued.

"It's still early days, we're only two and a half days into parading, but overall the trainers and bloodstock agents have been really impressed with what they see.

"They're echoing my sentiment in that he's leaving a type - that you can tell which ones are the Palentinos - because he's really stamping them to himself."

There are 25 yearlings by Palentino catalogued at Premier, the most of any first season sire. Sun Stud will offer five lots by their resident, but there are two colts the operation think have particularly caught the attention of buyers during early inspections.

Evasive (One Cool Cat), who herself is a half-sister to Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Zabrasive (Zabeel) and dual stakes placegetter Anzali (Zabeel).

The other colt is out of the unraced mare Tantalized (Octagonal) and he is a half-brother to VRC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) runner-up Lazumba (Sebring).

Tantalized is out of the seven-time stakes-winner, and three-time Group 1 runner-up, Excited Angel (Don't Say Halo), who has also produced Ballarat Cup (Listed, 2000m) winner Aquiver (Danehill) as well as Group 3 runner-up Provokes (Octagonal). He is catalogued as **Lot 480**.

"They're wonderful moving horses and very athletic but they've got plenty of strength and substance about them. They're the two buyers are most impressed with," Marshall said.

Sun Stud will present an 18-strong draft featuring yearlings by leading sires Snitzel (Redoute's Choice), Fastnet Rock (Danehill) and Not A Single Doubt (Redoute's Choice).

"We've got a really strong draft in terms of quality and quantity," Marshall said. "I think we've got something for all shapes and forms of buyers.

AUSTRALIA

First for Exosphere

Group 1 winner Exosphere (Lonhro) sired his first winner yesterday when the Godolphin homebred Thermosphere (2 f ex Glows by Canny Lad) posted a breakthrough win after two promising efforts. Trained by James Cummings, Thermosphere took out a two-year-old maiden at Newcastle over 1300 metres by a short-head from the favourite Cultural Amnesia (Snitzel). Rock My Wand (Wandjina) was another length and a quarter away in third. Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Exosphere, who has had six runners to date, has four entries at the upcoming Inglis Premier Yearling Sale.

Shark circling Australian Group 1

Te Akau Shark (Rip Van Winkle) will again have to overcome a wide draw when he goes in pursuit of a first elite win on Australian soil in the Chipping Norton Stakes. The Jamie Richards-trained five-year-old will break from barrier 13 tomorrow and the trainer said:

"We're getting used to the bad draws. It's just part of it. I will leave it up to Opie (Bosson, jockey) a little bit, but he won't rush him and do much early. He's a horse that likes to find his feet, even if he ended up three-deep with a bit of cover. He's got very good form from the spring so if he can run up to that form he should be competitive."

Bowman backs Flit

Hugh Bowman has declared he would not swap his mount Flit (Medaglia D'Oro) for any of her rivals in tomorrow's Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick. "Funstar has to be respected. She stamped herself as clearly the

best filly that raced in Sydney in the spring," Bowman said. "I would have thought she might have had the wood on Flit in the spring but I'm not sure that will be the case this time. It is a good race but I wouldn't swap Flit for anything else, even though I do have a healthy respect for them all."

Snowdens looking to add to Slipper contingent

Peter and Paul Snowden will look to enhance their Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) hand at Randwick tomorrow when five stablemates of their leading fancy Dame Giselle (I Am Invincible) will attempt to book spots in the \$3.5 million contest at Rosehill on March 21. Aim (Star Witness) and debutant Argenteus (Written Tycoon) will contest the Skyline Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m), while Stellar Pauline (Not A Single Doubt), Tilia Rose (Written Tycoon) and possibly Close To Me (I Am Invincible) clash in the Sweet Embrace Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m). "Everyone is trying to get them to a grand final on the day and twoyear-olds are just so very hard to keep up for a length of time so it's all about timing," Peter Snowden said. "If they win on Saturday they're in the race, if they don't win they will need to be running well to think they're a live chance in a race like the Slipper."

Alligator after maiden Group 1

A Group 1 win is missing from Alligator Blood's (All Too Hard) growing list of achievements and his trainer David Vandyke hopes that will change when he lines up in a highly-anticipated Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Flemington tomorrow. "Group 1s are Group 1s," Vandyke said. "He's won a \$2 million Magic

Millions Guineas and that was fantastic. But to win a Group 1 is the top of the mountain. We get a great opportunity on Saturday. The owners and jockey Ryan Maloney and the horse, they haven't won a Group 1 as yet. So I'm wanting him to win on Saturday for them as much as myself."

Spring riches on Alligator's horizon

Vandyke, meanwhile, has tipped The Everest (1200m) and the Golden Eagle (1500m) as the main spring targets for Alligator Blood. "We haven't taken a slot at this stage and we're just having some negotiations behind closed doors, nothing confirmed," Vandyke said of The Everest. "It's mainly up to Allan Endresz, who is one of the syndicators involved in the horse. He has been negotiating and I'll leave it up to him to talk about slots and opportunities."

Chenier on song for Guineas

While all the talk from of the CS Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) has been about Alligator Blood and Catalyst (Darci Brahma), Anthony Freedman's Chenier (Medaglia d'Oro), who finished third in the race first-up after almost a year off, has very much flown under the radar. The trio will again face each other in tomorrow's Australian Guineas and assistant trainer Sam Freedman couldn't be happier with the progression of the Godolphin-owned colt. "He was by no means screwed down for his first-up run," Sam Freedman told Racing.com. "He worked with Damien Oliver on Tuesday morning and went extremely well. We'd probably be happier if they went a better speed in the Guineas than last time. He's bred to run a strong 1600 metres or even further."

Kah to iron out Dalasan quirks

Dalasan (Dalakhani) will have his fourth rider in as many starts when Jamie Kah takes over the reins in the Australian Guineas. Kah travelled from Melbourne to ride Dalasan in trackwork at Morphettville on Tuesday, after which she recommended the quirky three-year-old should wear a tongue tie. "He's a bit of a tricky horse and Leon (MacDonald, co-trainer) wanted me to come over and have a sit on him," Kah said. "He did want to lay in a bit, more he wants to lean in, so Leon wanted me to get a feel for that before the race. I also suggested that they put a tongue tie on him. Because of his laying, it plays around with his tongue and his breathing, so hopefully it can only help."

Williams excited about Soul Patch

Craig Williams believes the removal of blinkers from Soul Patch (Shamus Award) will allow his mount to switch off and power home in the Australian Guineas. The colt is coming off a closing fourth in the C S Hayes and Williams said: "It's going to be quite tactical, which will be a disadvantage for my horse, but I like the fact they get out to the mile and it might pay dividends for him, especially with that run under the belt. He's come up with a favourable draw, so he's going to get every possible chance from there after his first-up run when he closed off nicely. I'm not saying I'm going to overhaul them, but going into the race I'm confident I will give it a shake."


Pohutukawa sizzles in gallop

A brilliant trackwork gallop has boosted the confidence of James Cummings that Pohutukawa (Medaglia D'Oro) can gain a first win in almost a year when she lines up in the Guy Walter Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Randwick tomorrow. The four-year-old finished third on her recent return in the Triscay Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) and Cummings said: "She was crying out for 1400 (metres) on her return. It's been

a while since she has won a race but we are confident that our patience will be rewarded. If her gallop this week was any better, it would have been a waste."

Stakes test for Blazejowski

Multiple city winner Blazejowski (Dash For Cash) will step up to stakes level for the first time when he runs in tomorrow's Shaftesbury Avenue Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) at Flemington. Blazejowski won an 1100-metre open handicap at Flemington in the first start of his current campaign last month, before finishing sixth over 1400 metres at the same track where his trainer Greg Eurell believed he had excuses. "I thought his run was good last start," Eurell said. "He was held in. He was looking for some daylight as they approached the straight. Finally he got out and hit the line pretty good. He needed to have a bit more time to wind up and get into the race. I was quite pleased with the way he did box on in the finish though and he never shirked the task."

Heathcote: Rothfire has improved

Rothfire (Rothesay) will start one of the shortest priced favourites at a Brisbane metropolitan meeting in years in The Jewel Prelude (C&G) (1110m) at Doomben tomorrow and his backers will be buoyed by the news that trainer Robert Heathcote believes the juvenile is getting better all the time. "I have been monitoring him daily through my staff and I have some bad news for anyone who was hoping he has gone backwards since Eagle Farm," Heathcote said of the easy last time out winner. "If anything he has taken another step up. His work on Tuesday morning was very strong. He has won two of his starts by big margins but in his other win he had to show a lot of courage to beat a pretty smart filly in Gotta Kiss. He had to climb off the canvas to beat her and that is the mark of a good horse."

Wet to aid Miss Cavallo

The prospect of a wet track at Doomben gives Miss Cavallo (Nicconi) the chance of an upset win in tomorrow's The Jewel Prelude (F) (1110m). The three-year-old is a noted wettrack horse and is unbeaten in two starts on soft tracks, including a Doomben win as a juvenile. "She likes the Doomben track and distance and she has won first-up," trainer Michael Nolan said. Doomben has been soaked in the past month and is in the soft range after showers this week. Further rain is predicted with up to 15 millimetres expected tomorrow.

Blinkers for Eric The Eel

Eric The Eel (Olympic Glory) will wear blinkers for the first time when he races at Doomben tomorrow as a final trial for a trip to Sydney where he could take in the likes of the Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m) and Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m). The gelding ran well in an unofficial trial when second to Alligator Blood before resuming with a sixth at Eagle Farm over 1200 metres last Saturday week. Trainer Stuart Kendrick was happy with the comeback run

but is looking for further improvement. "He had barrier 15 and he had no choice but to go back to near last at Eagle Farm. He finished well along the fence to be in a four-way photo finish for third," Kendrick said. "But he would need to take another step to head to Sydney. The blinkers at this stage of his career should switch him on."

Sunline target for Jenni

David Brideoake's Group 1-winning mare Princess Jenni (High Chaparral) will kick-off her campaign next Saturday before targeting the Sunline Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) second-up at Moonee Valley on March 20 with options open to press on to Sydney. "This has been our program all along, to step out Saturday week and then we will go to the Sunline, a Group 2 at The Valley and then weigh it up," Brideoake told Racing.com. "She has been very good at The Valley, she's had some good wins there. So, second-up is good, her second-up record is very good."

Glen Boss will ride Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) for the first time when the three-year-old colt lines up in the Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) at Flemington next Saturday. With Craig Williams choosing to stick with the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained filly Loving Gaby (I Am Invincible), James Cummings has snapped up the services of Boss. Loving Gaby is the \$4.50 favourite with the TAB, followed by Exceedance (Exceed And Excel) at \$5. Bivouac and Gytrash (Lope De Vega) are both on the \$6 line.

Harlech could head to Randwick Guineas

Mike Moroney has Harlech (Darci Brahma) in line for a start in next Saturday's Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) but a gallop in New Zealand tomorrow morning will help determine whether the colt makes the trip across the Tasman. "He's in the Randwick Guineas and he's booked to fly on Tuesday to run," Moroney said. "But we're going to do a bit with him on Saturday. He's had a bit of a break and he's got behind a little bit and if he doesn't work well enough we won't come over. He

Enood off the mark

Million dollar filly Enood (Deep Impact) got off the mark at the seventh time of asking when swooping late to take out an 1100-metre maiden at Kilmore yesterday. The Tony and Calvin McEvoy-trained three-year-old beat Bethpage (Reward For Effort) by half a head, with Groovy Kinda Love (Smart MIssile) a further length and a quarter away in third. Purchased out of the Arrowfield draft for \$1 million at the 2018 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale, Enood is a half-sister to the Listed winner Manhattan Street (Manhattan Rain), being out of the Redoute's Choice (Danehill) mare Charming Estelle.

Group 1 import to join Cummings stable

German Group 1 winner Nancho (Tai Chi) is set to join the stables of Anthony Cummings after being purchased by Tried and True Bloodstock for an undisclosed sum. "What he has done in Germany against the best horses available, plus English runners from Ralph Beckett's stable (Manuela De Vega and Antonia De Vega) and Ashrun, who had French Group-winning form, was just outstanding," Holger Faust of HFTB Racing, who brokered the deal, told Horse Racing Planet. "He has done all his winning over different tracks and different distances from firm ground, to very heavy, to all-weather, and from 1600 metres up to 2400 metres, so for me he is like a monster, an extraordinary horse. In my opinion he could be a Melbourne Cup horse. He was one of the best horses to run in Germany."

Gold Coast to host Stud & Stable Staff Awards

Diamond turnover down

Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) day turnover fell 10 per cent year-on-year to \$60 million, continuing a downward trend over the summer months. The Melbourne Racing Club reported a slight uplift in turnover (0.4 per cent) on CF Orr Stakes day, but that was largely attributed to Sydney racing being abandoned, with Saturday's Blue Diamond results being a sign of current wagering trends. The crowd on Blue Diamond day was 10,444, which was down five per cent on 2019. MRC CEO Josh Blanksby told Racing.com: "We had a bumper year in 2018/19 with turnover up 14 per cent and we're cycling through some big comparisons year-on-year. \$60 million on Blue Diamond is still a cracking day." The results come on the back of wagering turnover during last year's feature Caulfield Cup Carnival falling 17 per cent year-on-year. Blanksby confirmed that the dip in turnover isn't isolated: "The industry standard for turnover through this season is six to seven per cent down."

NEW ZEALAND

James shoots for sixth Derby win

Co-trainer Roger James will launch a three-pronged assault on tomorrow's New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) as he tries to win Ellerslie's blue riband for the sixth time. Star filly Two Illicit (Jimmy Choux) heads the trio following her seven and a half-length Waikato Guineas (Gr 2, 2000m) success and she will be joined by stablemates Reggiewood (Redwood) and Monlula (He's Remarkable). "She's done everything right. She's a fit filly and I can't fault her," James, who trains

in partnership with Robert Wellwood, said of Two Illicit. "She relaxes beautifully in her races. Her first run over ground (in the Royal Stakes) really showed she could stay because she was asked the question when Vinnie (Colgan, jockey) went forward at the half-mile and she kicked again at the 200 (metres). She's by a horse (2011 Derby winner Jimmy Choux) that got 2400 metres no problem so everything says the trip shouldn't be a problem."

Superior victory for debutant

Six-year-old gelding Superiority (Snitzel) took a long time to see a racecourse, but the patience afforded to him by Cambridge trainer Trevor Da Cruz was rewarded yesterday when he won by six and a half lengths on debut at Pukekohe. Injury-plagued throughout his career having won barrier trials in New Zealand before being shipped to Hong Kong, Superiority returned to New Zealand 18 months ago and made the long wait worthwhile with a comfortable success under Craig Grylls. "He is one I have thought highly of ever since he was a baby when I bought him," Da Cruz said. "I was really sad to see him go to Hong Kong. He has taken a while for me to nurse him back to where he is. I am very happy with him today."

ASIA

Coronavirus forces fanless Japan meetings

The Japan Racing Association has banned racegoers from attending meetings from tomorrow in a bid to prevent the spread of coronavirus. Cards are scheduled for Nakayama, Chukyo and Hanshin, while the same venues are

In addition, there will be no sale of betting tickets and payout for winning tickets on racedays or payout on weekdays at all JRA racecourses and off-track betting facilities, including WINS, Park WINS and J-PLACE until further notice. During this time, the sale of betting tickets and payout for winning tickets will be held only via telephone or online betting."

Options open for Big Blue at Cheltenham

The Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained hurdler Big Blue (Galileo) has been nominated for four races at next month's famous Cheltenham Festival in England. Maher said he was favouring the Coral Cup (Gr 3, 2m 5f) on the second day of the Festival while the eight-year-old gelding has also been entered for a race on day three and two on the final day of the four-day meeting. "We didn't get any favours at the handicap and 140 is quite high I thought for what he has done," Maher said. "At least he's got one now and if you had a set of flippers and a canoe you'd be more likely to win a race. It's not quite the ideal preparation, but it's not ideal for a lot over there at the moment. It's a bit daunting. He's had a few little hiccups over there, but I think we've got them ironed out now and he's going the right way."

wo promising juveniles fought out the finish to the 1000-metre maiden at Gosford on Wednesday, with the Gerald Ryan-trained newcomer Kumasi (Snitzel) edging out fellow debutant Deniki (Not A Single Doubt) by the narrowest of margins.

Owned by Aquis Farm, whose enviable armoury of two-year-olds also includes Rathlin (Fastnet Rock), Global Quest (More Than Ready) and Prague (Redoute's Choice), Kumasi showed clear signs of inexperience first-up, sweating badly in the preliminaries.

However, those pre-race manners did

not preclude a top-drawer performance, with Kumasi tracking a quick tempo under Brenton Avdulla before moving up to challenge on the turn for home.

The Mark Newnham-trained Deniki, a halfsister to Menari (Snitzel), quickened nicely in the straight. But so too did Kumasi, with the latter getting up in the dying strides to stop the clock in a quick time of 57.16. In addition, the front two pulled four lengths clear of their remaining six rivals.

In winning, Kumasi became the ninth individual juvenile scorer this season for Arrowfield Stud's champion sire Snitzel. The son of Redoute's Choice (Danehill) is leading the two year-old sires list by earnings, with that mantle fuelled heavily by the exploits of Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) winner and

Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) fourth Away Game, who is part-owned by Loretta Fung, wife of Aquis chairman Tony Fung.

Snitzel has nine lots catalogued at the Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale, which gets underway on Sunday.

Kumasi is the fifth winner from six to race out of the winning Anabaa (Danzig) mare World Joy, who is herself a half-sister to the Group 2 winner Light Up The World (Rory's Jester). This is the same family as top-tier winners Bentley Biscuit (Peintre Celebre) and Thorn Park (Spinning World).

Meanwhile, World Joy produced a sister to Kumasi in 2018 and missed to Lonhro (Octagonal) last year. She was subsequently covered again by Snitzel, with a service date of September 17.

Turf-scorching Pippie posts brilliant times in Oakleigh Plate success

ightly-raced, but talented, mare Pippie (Written Tycoon) produced a stunning performance in taking out Saturday's Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m), only failing by the barest of margins to break the 10-year-old track record at Caulfield.

After beginning brilliantly from barrier 14, Pippie crossed to the front in a twinkling. She continued at a fast tempo before holding on to score in a time of 1:01.93, which was just 0.2 seconds outside of Here De Angels' (Dehere) record, set in winning the Rubiton Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) in 2010.

Pippie's time of 1:01.93 was achieved at a fast 11.26 200-metre rate, which is equivalent to 1200 metres in 1:07.56.

Having her first run since November and only her ninth race start, Pippie travelled particularly well, had a clear advantage at the 200 metres and then held on to score by half a length from Zoutori (Zoustar), with Crystal Dreamer (Stratum) three-quarters of a length further back in third.

Pippie's 200-metre breakdown really illustrated the merit of her performance, where she clocked (from the 1000m): 10.07, 10.19 (400m in 20.26), 10.71 (600m in 30.97), 11.71 (800m in 42.14) and 12.15 to give her a brilliant 54.29 for her last 1000 metres.

And while the aforementioned facts show what a marvellous performance Pippie staged, there was considerable comment about a perceived leaders' bias at Caulfield, and those subscribing to that line of thought would

therefore be reluctant to give her the credit she deserves.

So it should be highlighted that the runners that raced closest to the front-running Pippie finished near the tail of the field, with the best of those being **Bons Away** (Bon Hoffa), who was fourth at the home turn before finishing ninth.

While the runner-up Zoutori came from 13th at the home turn, third-placed Crystal Dreamer was eighth at that point, fourth-placed All Too Royal (All Too Hard) was ninth, fifth-placed Vainstream (Bel Esprit) was seventh, sixth-placed Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) was tenth, seventh-placed Halvorsen (Magnus) was 18th and eighth-placed Bold Star (Needs Further) was 14th.

Of those runners, some of the most interesting closing sectionals were:

- Zoutori (53.76 last 1000m, 43.58 last 800m, 33.33 last 600m and 22.48 last 400m).
- **Bivouac** (54.14 last 1000m, 43.89 last 800m, 33.65 last 600m and 22.86 last 400m).
- Halvorsen (53.68 last 1000m, 43.23 last 800m, 33.04 last 600m and 22.31 last 400m).
- **Bold Star** (54.14 last 1000m, 43.84 last 800m, 33.56 last 600m and 22.31 last 400m).

The Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) was also a strongly-run race and while he was a surprise winner at odds of \$26, Tagaloa (Lord Kanaloa) staged a very smart performance in winning in a time of 1:08.56, which was 0.82 outside of the track record.

Having his fourth start and his second run this preparation, Tagaloa was one of a trio of leaders as he raced three deep. The quick early tempo resulted in the first 600 metres being clocked in 34.06 (11.35 200m rate) and the strong pace continued with the final 600 metres in 34.50 (11.50 200m rate).

Despite working most of the way, **Tagaloa** went to the front on turning for home and then fought back courageously to hold off the favourite Hanseatic (Street Boss) and score by a head. Personal (Fastnet Rock) was a further three-quarters of a length away third.

Tagaloa's sectional times were impressive, clocking (from the 1000m): 10.39, 10.72 (400m in 21.11), 11.12 (600m in 32.23), 11.14 (800m in 43.37) and 12.63 for his last 200 metres to give him a fast final 1000-metre time of 56.00.

Hanseatic, who was beaten for the first time in three starts, was seventh on the rails early on, looked the winner when he eased into clear running at the 200 metres and clocked 55.72 for his last 1000 metres in chasing the fast tempo.

Personal raced just behind Hanseatic and ran on well, clocking 55.59 for her last 1000 metres in a smart effort at only her third race start.

In addition, On The Watch was taken by the effort of the Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) winner **Away Game** (Snitzel), who had a difficult wide trip close to the fast pace, making her (1.3 lengths) fourth a smart performance indeed.

Away Game's 200-metre breakdown (from the 1000m) was: 10.39, 10.69 (400m in 20.78), 11.23 (600m in 32.01), 11.25 (800m in 43.26) and 12.55 to give her a fast 55.81 for her final 1000 metres.

The Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) went to the consistent gelding **Streets Of Avalon** (Magnus), who broke through at the highest level in another solidly-run race, albeit not at the hectic tempo of the previous two Group 1 features.

Supported from odds of \$16 to start at \$9.50, Streets Of Avalon showed his customary pace to lead and then maintained quite a good tempo before fighting back gamely to defeat the favourite Super Seth (Dundeel) by a long-head.

The time for the 1400 metres was 1:21.90, which was 0.70 outside of the track record, with the first 800 metres in 47.78 (11.94 200m rate) and the last 600 metres in 34.12 (11.37 200m rate).

Streets Of Avalon got away with a moderate first 200 metres of 13.91, but the tempo was good from there on in, with the 200-metre breakdown (from the 1200m): 11.25, 11.23 (400m in 22.48), 11.28 (600m in 33.76), 11.40 (800m in 45.16), 11.23 (1000m in 56.39) and 11.60 for a final 1200 metres of 1:07.99.

The runner-up, Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Super Seth, possibly disappointed some of his supporters visually,

but he certainly staged a smart effort from a time perspective, with closing sectionals of 1:07.70 (last 1200m), 56.45 (last 1000m), 45.22 (last 800m), 33.57 (last 600m) and 22.57 for his last 400 metres.

In addition to those fast times, jockey Mark Zahra conceded after the race that **Super Seth** is probably better suited when held up behind runners rather than working outside the leader, a position he found himself in due to the circumstances of the race.

Multiple Group 1-winning mare **Melody Belle** (Commands) was third, just over two
lengths behind Super Seth. She raced a bit
below her brilliant best at her first run since
November, but connections said there was
improvement to come.

Melody Belle clocked 1:08.08 (last 1200m), 56.56 (last 1000m), 45.34 (last 800m), 34.02 (last 600m), and 22.65 for her last 400 metres.

Shining Ace takes Million Challenge

The DBS x Manulife Million Challenge came to a close at Happy Valley on Wednesday when Shining Ace (Testa Rossa) safely held top spot to secure the HK\$650,000 (A\$126,851) first prize.

The points-based challenge is for horses competing in races rated Class 3 and above at the city circuit, and this season's contest ran from September 11 and covered 88 eligible races

Points were awarded to the first four across the line with 15 points to each winner and six points to the runner-up, with third getting four points and the fourth placegetter receiving three points.

Going into the night, three horses were in contention to win the series outright, headed by the eventual winner, Shining Ace, who entered on 53.5 points and finished with a winning tally of 59.5 points after taking second in the night's final race. Gentle Breeze (Foxwedge) held on for second place overall with 45 points after finishing unplaced while Flying Quest (Alamosa) held third with 43 points.

Including Wednesday night's runner-up effort in the Class 3 King Kwong Handicap (1200m), Shining Ace has only finished outside of the top three twice from 11 attempts at Happy Valley, including two wins, with trainer John Size attributing the gelding's Million Challenge success to his admirable consistency.

"He did a good job - he's been consistent this season and he's run very well every time he's raced, including quite a few placings and a few wins," Size said.

"He's been good - he came back nice and in good shape, he holds himself well and he spent most of his time at Conghua but recently he's been at Sha Tin and even with the travelling down from there he seems to handle it and he always runs a good race - he's been amazing so he's a deserved winner.

"It's an extra bonus for the owners and it's

an incentive for them to bring their horse here so it's a good competition."

Shining Ace broke cleanly from gate 11 to settle near the rear of the field before closing strongly for Chad Schofield to finish second to Invincible Missile (Smart Missile), who was ridden by Hong Kong's champion jockey Zac Purton. The success sealed a treble for the champion jockey.

Earlier, Purton partnered Ares (Zacinto) to scoot along the rail and grab the Class 4 Wing Tak Handicap (1200m). He also snared the Class 3 Sing Woo Handicap (1650m) aboard Dances With Dragon (Savabeel), a win that sealed a double for trainer Caspar Fownes after Matthew Chadwick drove Winning Delight (Sebring) home in the Class 3 Tsui Man Handicap (2200m).

The DBS x Manulife Million Challenge presentation ceremony will be held later this season at a date to be announced.

Au revoir Tony Piccone

Tony Piccone closed out his 2019/20 shortterm contract with a thrilling win aboard Sunny Power (Tavistock) in the Class 4 Yik Yam Handicap (1650m).

The six-year-old gelding struggled for space in the straight but when Piccone found the gap, his mount accelerated to a narrow half-length score, with only that margin separating the first five horses across the line.

"He travelled well, I sat just behind the speed and he was just very strong in the finish,"

The win marked the Frenchman's eighth success from 91 rides since his licence commenced on New Year's Day, a short but sweet stint that has proved fruitful for the 32-year-old.

"I'm very happy - I've really enjoyed Hong Kong and hopefully I can come back again soon," Piccone said.

Karis Teetan rolled off the back of a Sunday treble at Sha Tin with a barnstorming score aboard Waldorf (Highly Recommended) in the Class 1 Blue Pool Handicap (1200m).

"He's one of my favourite horses in Tony's (Cruz) stable, he's so quiet and last season I won three races on him as well as so many places – he always tries and it's very nice to ride horses like that, so thanks to Tony and the owners," Teetan said.

The five-year-old is now a five-time winner over 1200 metres at Happy Valley, his last two scores displaying a trademark fast-finish from the tail of the field.


"I knew they went a bit quick and I knew he was going to finish off, especially from where I got him as he was in his comfort zone and I knew he was going to let down and he let down very well," Teetan said.

"He's done his best racing here on the little track, so maybe it's his favourite but of course if we run out of options and we have to take him to Sha Tin then we can, but at the moment we can keep him here."

Harmony Victory (Public Purse) has been knocking on the door all season having twice finished runner-up but tonight he rewarded connections with an electrifying rail-run under Alexis Badel in the Class 1 Shan Kwong Handicap (1650m).

"Forget his last run, he missed the start so he had to pass a barrier trial which he did nicely and I thought the sections would be slow tonight to help him," trainer Danny Shum said, before adding: "He's a nice horse – he's already earned over HK\$6 million in prize-money."

Apprentice Alfred Chan tallied his 20th

Hong Kong win and reduced his claim from 10lb (4.5kg) to 7lb (3kg) thanks to a brilliant front-running score aboard Very Sweet Orange (Exceed And Excel) in the Class 4 Village Handicap (1000m).

"It's a very special milestone for me, it's very hard here in Hong Kong and it's great to have ridden 20 winners, although it took me a little bit longer than I expected," Chan said.

The 25-year-old brought up his 11th win this term and second in succession aboard the Me Tsui-trained gelding.

"I'm claiming seven pounds now so it will be harder, but it's a challenge I am ready to take on."

The night kicked off with Chad Schofield

and Tony Millard registering their second win together this season as Gold Velvet (Savabeel) staved off a wall of challengers to secure the Class 5 Yuk Sau Handicap (1800m).

Hong Kong racing continues on Sunday, March 1.




