Tom Marquand making his mark in Australia

21-year-old British jockey talks about his time down under and landing his maiden Group 1 aboard Addeybb in the Ranvet Stakes

hen 21-year-old British
jockey Tom Marquand
arrived in Australia at
the beginning of the year,
little did he know he would become a Group
1-winning rider just three months later. And he
certainly wasn't expecting the elite level win to
come with an English-trained horse.

Seven days ago, 'Aussie Tom' partnered the William Haggas-trained Addeybb (Pivotal) to victory in the Ranvet Stakes ($\operatorname{Gr} 1, 2000 \operatorname{m}$), the first of what is likely to be many Group 1 wins across his career and the former English Champion Apprentice is still coming to terms with it.

"It's pretty mad considering the whole build up from riding ponies to pony racing, to apprenticeships to getting your licence, and that is the goal (to win a Group 1), the whole way through, so it's pretty mad," Marquand told ANZ Bloodstock News.

Marquand has built a strong partnership with Newmarket-based trainer Haggas over the last few seasons with 158 rides for 39 wins at a strike-rate of almost 25 percent, making the win all the more special.

"Last year I thought I might have found a couple of horses early in the year that might get me there and things didn't materialise," he continued

"I was thinking I was going to struggle in the early part of the year to be able to find those Group 1 horses but I certainly didn't expect it to be in Australia on an English horse. I did not think that would happen."

Despite coming from a family with no ties to racing, Marquand knew from a young age that being a jockey was what he wanted to do.

<< Continued from page 1 "I rode from the age of about four but I was probably on five or six when I decided I wanted to be a jockey," Marquand said. "It was a bit strange because I have no family in racing or connected to racing or with any interest in racing at all.

"I never had my own pony until I was like 13 but I ended up doing quite a bit of pony racing from that age on other people's ponies for about a year, and then when mum and dad realised I was serious about doing it, they let me get a racing pony.

"I did a couple of years with that and spent time at the racing school amid riding out for local trainers.

"I was riding out trying to get more involved to get through the school. In the summer I went down to Andrew Balding, I think I was 14 or 15, and then I went to Richard Hannon for a week and that's where I ended up going as an apprentice and staying all the way through."

It was in 2016 that the then-apprentice got his first taste of Australian racing when he was offered an opportunity to travel to Melbourne and ride for David Hayes and Tom Dabernig for a month on Sheikh Mansour's exchange program.

"Sheikh Mansour does the apprentice series around the world," Marquand continued. "So they started up a new thing where they were going to fund one apprentice from one country and then one apprectice in another country and they were basically going to switch, so basically a student exchange.

"After my first year of riding they asked if I wanted to do that so I took them up on it and I went down to Melbourne to ride for them (Hayes and Dabernig).

"I was lucky, I had like nine rides and they put me on an even money favourite for Sheikh Hamdan at Caulfield on a Saturday before I'd even arrived and he went and won and the same horse actually won again like two days before I left.

"So I had two metro winners from nine rides and I couldn't believe my luck. ${\it Continued\ on\ page\ 4}>>$

<< Continued from page 2 "I left with a very good taste in my mouth from Australia so I knew I always wanted to come back but the next couple of years, I rode out my claim and I wasn't able to get away from English racing for that amount of time for it to be worth coming down."</p>

Worried about losing momentum in England, it was during the British winter last year that Richard Hannon's former assistant trainer Tom Ward, who now trains in his own right, convinced Marquand to come back to Australia and base himself in Sydney.

"Tom Ward helped me out a lot," he continued. "I was talking to him about it and I was like, 'Oh, I'm going to go back to David and Tom in Melbourne I think, and have a winter down there.'

"I didn't want to ride another full all-weather winter, just because I wanted to go and learn something else, and he (Ward) was like, 'No, you're not going down there, you're going to Sydney' and I was like 'oh, right' and he was like 'you're going to John O'Shea' and I was like 'ah, alright," the jockey laughed.

After arriving in Sydney, things struggled to take off for Marquand as he wasn't getting as many rides as he would have liked. He began questioning his decision to base himself in New South Wales, but after landing a metro double at Randwick in late December, 2018, things began to fall into place.

"For the first couple of weeks when I came over I was like, 'Oh, what have I done?" Marquand said.

Melbourne right now riding nice horses for Lindsay Park' and then all of a sudden on my third or fourth Saturday here, I rode a double.

"One of them was actually on one of Lindsay Park's horses for Coolmore and then John (O'Shea) found me a winner on my first ride for him on Live And Free and then it just took off and I had a great time, so I came back." Continued on page 5>>

<< Continued from page 4 It's no secret that the English raider has become a popular member of the industry down under but he has formed a great relationship with the in-form stable of Ciaron Maher and David Eustace, one for which he cannot give reason.

"I have no idea (how they picked me up)," Marquand continued.

"Last year I think I rode the same horse for them twice in the provincials and I got beat on it twice.

"This time I was just riding as normal, I hadn't had a ride for them yet this year round, and all of a sudden they put me on Away Game and Prague in two Group 3s and I was like, 'Alright, thanks," he laughed.

"I don't know whether it had anything to do with it but obviously Harry Eustace (Haggas' assistant trainer) is David's brother and his father is James so I've had quite a lot to do with the family and have been working for Haggas a bit.

"Annabel Neasham (Maher and Eustace's assistant trainer) is obviously English as well, so I don't know whether it was just a few things combined but it's been a great link up so far. Obviously we've had quite a bit of success this year and they've had a phenomenal year."

The 21-year-old steered Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) winner Away Game (Snitzel) to victory in the Widden Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) and Prague (Redoute's Choice) to land the Canonbury Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) for the Maher and Eustace team, both on the same day at Randwick.

A week and a half later, he took out the \$2 million Inglis Millenium (RL, 1100m) aboard Prime Star (Starspangledbanner) for Richard and Michael Freedman and cemented himself as one of the world's most exciting up and coming jockeys.

While his stint in Australia was set to finish at the end of February and he was due to return to the UK, the prospect

of securing some exciting rides across the Sydney Autumn Carnival, particularly aboard the Haggas pair Addeybb and Young Rascal (Intello), lured Marquand back a month later.

On his first day back in the southern hemisphere, Marquand returned to Prague's back and won the Pago Pago Stakes (Gr 3, $1200 \mathrm{m}$) at Rosehill and all but sealed the ride on the classy colt in the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, $1200 \mathrm{m}$) the following week.

Though he didn't take out the richest juvenile race in the world, it was still a day the young rider will never forget, winning his maiden Group 1 on Addeybb and taking out the N E Manion Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) aboard compatriot Young Rascal.

Today, Marquand's book of rides at Rosehill is as classy as ever as he takes the reins on Zipping Classic (Gr 2, 2400m) winner Southern France (Galileo) in the Tancred Stakes (Gr 1, 2400m) as well as Fascino (Charm Spirit) in the Vinery Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m), Vegadaze (Lope

de Vega) in the Star Kingdom Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) and Mask Of Time (Holy Roman Emperor) in the Doncaster Prelude (Gr 3, 1500m). Just to name a few.

Beyond today, there is every chance he could be returning to England as a multiple Group 1-winning jockey with bookings for Young Rascal in the Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) and Addeybb in the Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m), both of whom are currently clear favourites.

It's easy to assume that, given the success he has had during his limited time here and the prizemoney on offer, the talented rider would consider basing himself in Australia but for him, home will always remain in England.

"With the success I've had down here in such a short amount of time, a lot of people have been asking (if I'm going to stay in Australia) but I think I personally, at the moment, see my home and career in England," Marquand said.

"I love coming down here and it's actually something that works very well with the English season. I can do three or four months at a time here and it doesn't affect what happens at home.

"If anything, it's probably a good thing for home because I go back and ride even better. It definitely helps my riding when I'm at home, so while I can't see myself here long term and living here, I don't think it matters that much"

On what he wants to achieve now that he's got that elusive Group 1 next to his name, Marquand said: "For me from childhood it was like, Group 1 winner, Champion Jockey. That was it. That was as good as it gets.

"I've ticked one box, hopefully one day I can tick the other because I think Champion Jockey in England is pretty much as good as it gets.

"It's a sign recognised worldwide of someone that's made it, whereas a Group 1 winner is incredible for yourself but anyone can ride a Group 1 winner on the right horse. Champion Jockey is just slogging it out for the whole summer and I quite enjoy that I think."

Quick back-up a test for Verry Elleegant

Verry Elleegant's (Zed) part-owner and former trainer Nick Bishara was delighted with his star mare's performance in last week's Ranvet Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Rosehill and hopes the four-yearold can go one better in today's Tancred Stakes (Gr 1, 2400m). The Group 1 winner, who is now prepared by Chris Waller in Sydney, was runner-up to European import Addeybb (Pivotal) last week. "It was a massive run. I was gutted to be beaten but so proud of her. While they're not in the same class as Bonecrusher and Our Waverley Star, it reminded me a bit of that as they drew away from the field. They ran the fastest last 600 metres of the day," New Zealander Bishara said. "I am hopeful she can backup. Chris is pretty mindful of that. He said everything looks really good and all systems are go. But the little query must be that she never has backed-up and it was a tough run last week."

Imported stablemates face Tancred clash

Kris Lees will send out a trio of European imports in today's Tancred Stakes as Mugatoo (Henrythenavigator), Mustajeer (Medicean) and Danceteria (Redoute's Choice) each chase their biggest Australian paydays in the \$1.5 million feature. "I think a seven-day turnaround will be good for Mugatoo," Lees said. "It will make him relax a little bit more I suspect, and that will give him his chance. He's been a touch aggressive. I'm really happy with Mustajeer. It's a race we always thought was a logical target race for him so he's going there in good order. And Danceteria, he certainly hasn't quite got to where his European form would suggest he'd be at and he's untried at 2400 metres. But all his runs would suggest he's going to appreciate it."

Carif's primary target still months away

A Tancred Stakes win for Carif (So You Think) would be celebrated by Peter and Paul Snowden, but the father-son training partnership has just one goal in mind: the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) in November. Peter Snowden said Carif's autumn campaign is all about preparing the stayer for his primary goal. "It's essential for him. He made big steps in the spring, if he can do something in this race on Saturday, a Group 1 race, it would cement his place in the Cup," Peter Snowden said. "Everything we do now is about the Cup for two reasons. One, to qualify and two, to make sure he is good enough. We don't want an also-ran. We want to make sure we have a legitimate chance in the race, which I think we have."

Snowdens hope to cause Vinery upset

Peter Snowden hopes that the step up in trip might allow Missile Mantra (Smart Missile) to turn the tables on top fillies Funstar (Adelaide) and Probabeel (Savabeel) in the Vinery Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m). She was beaten less than a length and a half when fifth behind Probabeel and Funstar in the Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) and co-trainer Snowden says that on that effort, she must be considered a chance. "In the Surround, they beat her a length and an unlucky length, she was held up all the way down the run and they were the best fillies around," Snowden said. "The 1400 was always going to be too short and getting up to 2000 metres now should be her level. Funstar does have the runs on the board and she is the one to beat. But my filly wasn't far away from them in the Surround and I think she is definitely a chance."

Baker flying father's flag at Rosehill

Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman have been forced to close their Cambridge operation in line with New Zealand's racing shutdown, but they will still be represented at Rosehill by Tulloch Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) aspirant Quick Thinker (So You Think) with Murray's Sydney-based son Bjorn at the helm. "He's only got two in work and they're both in my stable so they're sure to improve," Bjorn Baker quipped. The Bakers have been in contact via telephone and it is clear the suddenly time-rich Murray, who was already in isolation after returning from Australia, will be finding himself at a loose end sooner rather than later. "He is going to read a book, he's got some blueberries to eat and then he doesn't know," his son said.

Doyle to savour Tulloch moment

Emerging Newcastle trainer Nathan Doyle will have his first stakes runner when Pride Of Adelaide (Adelaide) lines up in today's Tulloch Stakes at Rosehill. It is a defining moment for the 31-year-old, who has been training for 18 months after previously handing in his licence to work with leading Sydney trainers including Peter and Paul Snowden and Mark Newnham. "We've had runners on a Saturday but he is our first stakes runner," Doyle said. "It's exciting for the stable." Pride Of Adelaide finished second on debut for former trainer Brett Cavanough before he was transferred to Doyle. He showed talent on the track at home but his first start for his new trainer was inglorious. "He got beaten at \$1.30 at Port Macquarie. He wanted to run off the track and do everything wrong," Doyle said. "From day dot he has shown us a bit. He always had that acceleration and turn of foot in his work but he just wasn't mentally there yet."

Postcode chasing breakthrough win

Adrian Bott is prepared to forgive talented colt Postcode (Vancouver) for his below-par fifth in the Pago Pago Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) a fortnight ago. The Randwick trainer, who along with Gai Waterhouse prepared Farnan (Not A Single Doubt) to win the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) last week, has Postcode in the Schweppervescence (Gr 3, 1400m) at Rosehill today. "It was an excellent run first-up when he was probably in need of the run," Bott said. "He knocked up at the furlong but I thought he stuck on well in a race of plenty of class. I thought he was a bit disappointing second-up, I was expecting him to show a bit more improvement but he didn't have the easiest of runs. He suffered a bit of interference which I think for a pretty inexperienced horse just got him a bit unbalanced and he lost a lot of confidence from that. I'm being a bit forgiving of the performance and 1400 metres is going to be more suitable for him."

Kementari set for comeback

Fertility issues cruelled Kementari's (Lonhro) short-lived stint at stud, but the 2018 Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner - now a gelding - gets his chance to add to his record when he returns to the racetrack in today's Star Kingdom Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m). Kementari was accepted for last week's The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m), but was scratched on race morning. "He drew wide over 1100 metres last week and we decided to delay his return for this event," James Cummings said. "A favourable draw and the 1200 metres is more appealing and more in his hitting zone. It's up to the horse to fulfil his destiny."

Cartier out to fill void left by Luvaluva

In a week where he has had to retire Group 1

placegetter Luvaluva (Mastercraftsman), John Sargent will look to another stakes-performed mare from his stable to make her mark at Rosehill. House Of Cartier (Alamosa) is a year younger than Luvaluva and was placed in last year's Australasian Oaks (Gr 1, 2000m) in Adelaide. She steps up to that trip again in the Neville Sellwood Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m) with Sam Clipperton to ride. "She's at her peak now," Sargent said. "This should be a perfect race for her. She's got no weight, it's 2000 metres and she's third-up. She won third-up last time in. I think she's a smart mare and she'll go on with it. She's a bit under-rated, I think. She was placed in an Oaks last season and then was going for the Derby a week later but she injured herself in the Oaks and couldn't run in the Derby. She's bigger and stronger so I'd expect her to go close on Saturday."

Sydney trip off for Debt Agent

Like everyone, trainer Jim Conlan has been forced to make adjustments to plans for his horses and has abandoned a Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) campaign for Debt Agent (Thorn Park). Against a backdrop of coronavirus protocols and conditions on border crossings, former Singapore champion Debt Agent formerly Debt Collector - will run in today's Golden Mile (Listed, 1600m) at Bendigo. "Originally before all this broke out I was going to give him a trial at Balnarring on Wednesday and then head up for the Doncaster," Conlan said. "But with what's going on it just seemed too hard. You've got to take whatever you can, whenever it's available. If you can have a crack at something, do it, and I thought who knows what the situation is going to be like in another week. You kind of say take it day by day, but now it's press release by press release." Debt Agent resumed with a closing fourth to Wild Planet (Animal Kingdom) over 1400 metres at Flemington on March 7.

Widdison to take Bendigo chance with Doll

Wodonga trainer Craig Widdison will be eagerly checking the Bendigo scratchings this morning to see whether his filly Toffee Doll (Toorak Toff) can gain a run in today's Bendigo Guineas (Listed, 1400m). Albury Guineas runner-up

Toffee Doll is first emergency for the \$150,000 event and will be Widdison's only runner at the meeting, while he has nine runners at his home track today as well. Widdison often takes runners to NSW but current logistics make that tough, meaning that most of his team is restricted to the north-east of Victoria. He is more than happy to take Toffee Doll further though. "There's probably a better race for her a week later for three-year-old fillies over 1400 metres at Caulfield, but if she gets a run at Bendigo, I won't be waiting," Widdison said "I think she's as good a horse as I've had. She is one that I won't mind travelling with."

Nature Strip sizzles in trial

Nature Strip (Nicconi) has downed fellow Group 1 winners Santa Ana Lane (Lope De Vega) and Redzel (Snitzel) in a Randwick barrier trial in an entree to the T J Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) next month. The Chris Waller-trained sprinter, who was ridden by regular pilot James McDonald, held a one and a quarter length margin over Santa Ana Lane with Redzel another half a length back in third in heat two of the morning over 1050 metres. Nature Strip ran a time of 1:01.12 seconds and his last 600 metres in 34.40 seconds under a tight grip from his rider. Santa Ana Lane, who was ridden by Tim Clark, made up ground on the onpacers late in a pleasing effort. Nature Strip and Santa Ana Lane share the second line of betting with star three-year-old filly Loving Gaby (I Am Invincible) at \$6 for the T J Smith with Newmarket Handicap-winning colt Bivouac (Exceed And Excel) \$5 favourite and Redzel at \$15.

Trekking also impresses

Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Trekking (Street Cry) also caught the eye with a barrier trial win at Randwick yesterday at his second trial back from a spell. Trekking was held together by Josh Parr, ambling up to the lead and just holding off the late surge of Lanciato (Per Incanto) to score by a short neck with Reelem In Ruby (Pierro) a long neck away in third. Trekking is likely to head to the T J Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) first-up, for which he is a \$15 chance. Lanciato, who caller Darren Flindell noted went "the best he's gone in ages", holds no entries over The Championships but looks well for wherever he heads next.

New plans for Vanna Girl

Co-trainer Toby Edmonds is resigned to talented filly Vanna Girl (Husson) missing her chance at black-type this winter but he is still planning to continue her campaign. Racing in Queensland will be divided into regions from Tuesday because of the coronavirus pandemic and the Toby and Trent Edmonds team is based on the Gold Coast. It means the stable's runners will be restricted to weekday meetings at the Gold Coast, Ipswich and Toowoomba, and potentially the Northern Rivers region of NSW. "It will take us a good while to work out where our horses are going. It is a lot to digest," Toby Edmonds said. "We are resigned to Vanna Girl missing a chance at black-type as a threeyear-old but hopefully she can get it later in her career."

Heathcote hoping for Doomben double

Eagle Farm trainer Robert Heathcote is busy rescheduling his runners' campaigns but beforehand he is hoping for a Doomben double today. Racing Queensland will introduce five racing regions on Tuesday to help stop the spread of coronavirus and Heathcote is in the Brisbane-Sunshine Coast section. He will saddle top chances Minjee (Not A Single Doubt) and Guntantes (Rothesay) at Doomben but future plans for the pair are blurred. "I am like everyone else and I have to digest the new programs. But plans for black-type for that pair and several others are gone," he said. "I can understand zoning because it will keep us going. But it is disappointing to lose the winter carnival and a chance to get black-type. On the other hand it has to be recognised that it is a chance to keep racing."

RV ups Covid-19 protocols

Horses travelling to Victoria will be subject to the same stringent conditions as NSW with enhanced cross-border protocols to come into effect. Racing Victoria has strengthened biosecurity conditions in response to the Covid-19 pandemic from midnight last night as racing continues around Australia. While horses are not affected by coronavirus, the protocols relate to their handlers and drivers. They need to travel with a company approved by RV and drivers must not leave the cabins. The equipment used such as head collars and leads must be the property of the stable and not the float company and must be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected before and after transportation. Before and after the journey, the vehicle needs to be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected to minimise risks. "Whilst the Covid-19 coronavirus does not affect horses, we need to ensure that the appropriate protocols are in place to manage the people handling them," RV chief executive Giles Thompson said.

Zahra always confident of negative test

Mark Zahra says he has never received so many congratulatory text messages as he did after receiving the news of a negative test for coronavirus. "The phone blew up," Zahra said. "I've been inundated with text messages after winning Group 1 races, but I think this takes the cake." The jockey was alerted on Wednesday he may have been exposed to coronavirus after taking a commercial flight from Sydney to Melbourne on March 12 with a passenger on board testing positive. Racing in Australia on Wednesday was suspended with all meetings called off on Thursday apart from Narromine in NSW. The news from Gary Zimmerman, Racing Victoria's doctor, arrived around 9pm on Thursday night that the test for Covid-19 was negative paving the way for racing to resume. "I had one of the emergency seats and I don't think there was anyone next to me," Zahra said. "It was just wrong place, wrong time."

Holland into isolation

Victorian jockey Dean Holland will embark on 14 days of self-isolation with his partner and two children after they returned from an extended period in the UK. Holland rode a winner at Warrnambool yesterday but will not be seen on a racecourse again for at least a fortnight. "Dean hasn't seen the family for quite a while and he had to make a call as to what he'd do, ride or spend time with the family," Holland's manager Pete Newcombe told Racing.com. "He chose to be with his partner and children and that will force him into a 14-day lockdown. It was extremely difficult for him in that he'd made obligations to ride this weekend, Dean's never been one to not fulfil an obligation, but essentially the family side of things got the better of him, which is understandable."

SA prize-money slashed

Thoroughbred Racing South Australia is the latest governing body of the sport to slash prize-money and make programming changes during the coronavirus pandemic. The Oakbank jumping carnival and Clare's Easter Saturday card have also been abandoned while overall prize-money from April 1 until June 30 has been cut by 15 per cent and stakes races, including The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m), will have their purses slashed. Adelaide Group 1s will now be worth \$400,000, Group 2 races will be cut to \$175,000, Group 3 races will have a purse of \$120,000 and Listed races will be run for \$100,000. "Our aim is to keep racing going, just as it has been able to in Hong Kong and Japan during the pandemic. It is vitally important that we keep going to ensure there is not a significant equine welfare that will arise should all thoroughbred horse activities be stopped," TRSA chief executive Nick Redin said. "The prize-money reductions are necessary to try to ensure the industry's ongoing viability."

Sunshine Coast abandoned

Tomorrow's Sunshine Coast meeting has been abandoned by Racing Queensland after the organisation moved to "regionalised" zones for the sport to continue during the coronavirus outbreak. The state has been broken into five regions, with trainers and jockeys only allowed to participate in one zone. That includes three zones being implemented in south east Queensland, prompting the cancellation of the Sunshine Coast meeting due to an overlap of participants from neighbouring regions.

Button to split team

Caloundra trainer Tom Button hopes to relocate some of his team to Rockhampton this weekend with Queensland separated into racing regions from next week. Racing Queensland has announced plans for the state to be divided into five areas in an effort to limit horse and people movement during the coronavirus pandemic. Button is located in a region which restricts trainers to racing in Brisbane and the Sunshine Coast. A multiple central Queensland premiership winner, Button relocated to Caloundra last year but he wants to have runners at the Capricornia Classic day at Rockhampton on Saturday week. "I can send a staff member or I can relocate myself while this runs its course," Button said. "I have Gypsy Toff in at Doomben on Saturday and after that I will decide who is going with how many horses. I will keep a team at Caloundra of those horses up to Brisbane class."

Trots back on

Harness racing in NSW will resume today after a steward's coronavirus test came back negative. The steward was tested after having close contact at the Penrith meeting on March 19 with another participant subsequently diagnosed with Covid-19. "The test result on the Harness Racing NSW steward came back negative so we will be racing again from tomorrow," HRNSW chief John Dumesny told Sky Sports Radio. "We all must be cognisant and careful of the community we live in based on the infectious nature of this disease but as far as anybody that was at Penrith last week,

this connection we had to this meeting, it was a negative test." Bathurst hosts the feature Gold Crown meeting tonight.

NEW ZEALAND

Cambridge training track closed

The largest training centre in Australasia, the Cambridge Jockey Club (CJC), has closed for business. With up to 1,000 thoroughbreds trained on the premises at its peak, it is the largest facility of its kind in Australia or New Zealand. However, the Cambridge committee has adhered to updated industry protocols and has reacted swiftly to cease training. "The Cambridge track is officially closed," CJC chief Mark Fraser-Campin said. "There were some key rules that came through on Thursday from the New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing Directive that impacted on even the limited training options. Everyone in New Zealand is trying to do the right thing and I think we will get through the virus outbreak more swiftly than some other nations."

Bishara coping with isolation

Trainer Nick Bishara credits Verry Elleegant (Zed) with stopping him from "going to the wall" as the New Zealand racing industry, and wider country, goes into lockdown over the coronavirus crisis. Bishara has been overseeing his Ardmore Lodge horses during the lockdown. "It was crazy on Wednesday before the lockdown," he said. "I went to the feed shop and there wasn't a bag of feed left. People

were queued out the door and they were just grabbing food, throwing money on the counter and leaving. But thankfully they're deemed an essential service and will still be open. I have got a few paddocks, but we're still in the middle of a drought up here where we have no grass. I am having to come down and feed out a couple of bales of haylage. This is a serious virus. I spent the last three months getting my winter team ready to go, so it is devastating for me, just like many others."

Pearl Series registrations delayed

The New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Association yesterday announced it had extended early bird registration for the NZB Insurance Pearl Series until May 31. Early registration for the Pearl Series, which includes 200 individual races for fillies and mares over three seasons of racing, was to close on March 31 for yearling fillies but has now been pushed back two months. "People have more important things to worry about at the moment, than registering their fillies for the Pearl Series," NZTBA chief executive Justine Sclater said. "This will enable the yearlings catalogued at the now postponed South Island Sale and those earmarked for the cancelled May Sale to still be eligible if they are able to be sold elsewhere or retained by their vendors. Registration is currently underway for all fillies born in the southern hemisphere in 2018. It is a very popular scheme and when we are racing again next season and into the future it would be a shame if a whole bunch of fillies and mares have missed out."

Japanese contingent to depart Dubai tonight

The 20 Japanese horses stranded at Meydan after the cancellation of the Dubai World Cup meeting will depart Dubai tonight for Tokyo, quashing fears that they may not get out of the United Arab Emirates for weeks or months to come. These concerns were raised by Sakae Kunieda, trainer of Almond Eye (Lord Kanaloa), earlier this week. However, it was confirmed yesterday that all 20 horses would leave tonight and arrive tomorrow afternoon at Narita Airport. All horses will be required to do a mandatory period of quarantine, but should be able to race from late April on.

Transcendent aims to keep on rising

French import Transcendent (Dabirsim) will attempt to maintain a perfect start to his Hong Kong career when he lines up in the Class 2 Chak On Handicap (1200m) at Sha Tin tomorrow. The Tony Cruz-trained four-year-old notched a smart win on his Hong Kong debut under Zac Purton, but with the champion jockey prebooked for Perfect Match (Not A Single Doubt), Chad Schofield will take the reins. "This race is a tougher race," Cruz said. "He's gone up in class, he's up five points to a rating of 85, and I haven't got Zac this time, but still, he's got a good draw and he's fitter than last time. I believe he's in great shape." Transcendent raced 10 times as Pizzicato for Fabrice Chappet in France and bagged five wins, including a 1300 metre Listed contest at Chantilly and the

All-Weather Championships Conditions Stakes (6f) at Lingfield, both on Polytrack.

Purton and Moreira set for long tussle but Champions Day first

Joao Moreira relinquished his lead in the Hong Kong jockeys' title race to reigning champion Zac Purton at Happy Valley midweek and both riders are psyched for an unrelenting fight for the crown through the season's final four months. Purton has sparkled in March with 18 wins, 11 in the last four meetings, while Moreira has secured only eight during the month. "I've come from a few winners behind Joao and now we're at about the same mark so it appears as if the momentum is probably with me, but I've always got to be wary of the support that he's going to get," Purton said, while Moreira added: "My thought is that it's good for the sport and everyone watching will enjoy seeing

The jockey, who was scheduled to ride Candy Tycoon (Twirling Candy) in today's Florida Derby (Gr 1, 9f), had not ridden since March 15, when he had two rides at Gulfstream Park. In the meantime, he returned to New York, which has quickly become the latest coronavirus

epicentre, to visit his family, but returned to Gulfstream early for a mandatory physical. "I was asymptomatic all along," he said. "Unfortunately the test came back last night as positive. I am otherwise healthy but will follow the doctor's orders to quarantine for the next two weeks. I have had no known contact with anyone that has tested positive. I appreciate the support from everyone including Gulfstream Park. Stay safe everyone and we will all get through this God willing."



Stud farms rally together after Arrowfield Stud's Easter defection

ome agents and buyers are attempting to take advantage of a potential divide among Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale vendors after Arrowfield Stud on Thursday broke away from the online auction, but prominent breeders say they remain committed to supporting the company.

Inglis was forced to move its Easter sale, a 514-lot catalogue comprising some of the best-bred and credentialled yearlings to go to market this year, across to its digital portal after the federal government clamped down on certain business sectors in order to try and slow the rate of Covid-19 infection across the nation.

After confirmation on Wednesday that a live auction would not be permitted, even with an invite-only buying bench and an onsite attendance of fewer than 500 people, due to the government banning auction houses from conducting live sales, leading vendor Arrowfield Stud withdrew 60 yearlings and will instead sell them by private treaty.

Interstate vendors Gilgai Farm, Woodside Park Stud and Element Hill quickly followed suit.

But Scone breeder Glenn Burrows, who runs Willow Park Stud, yesterday said vendors had vowed to back Inglis and the April 5 to 8 online sale to the hilt.

"We are going to stay united and support the online concept. The phone is running hot with people wanting to buy privately but we breeders feel we must be solid and support each other rather than breaking ranks and selling beforehand in a panic mode," Burrows said.

"Inspections are coming thick and fast and while the sale will be tough, the top, say, 50 per cent of the catalogue might go a little better than I anticipated several days ago."

Willow Park Stud has a draft of seven yearlings set to be offered at the Easter sale including an Exceed And Excel (Danehill) colt out of stakeswinning mare Serious Satire (More Than Ready) and the Not A Single Doubt (Redoute's Choice)

brother to the Group 2-winning, multiple Group 1-placed Fell Swoop.

Coolmore, who have 35 yearlings catalogued for the Easter sale, was one of the major stud farms to remain supportive of the Easter sale even when it became increasingly likely that it would not be conducted at Riverside Stables.

"In what are incredibly tough and unprecedented times, Coolmore are committed to offering our Inglis Easter yearling draft to the market," Coolmore Australia principal Tom Magnier told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday.

"Our yearling crew have worked tirelessly to present them in impeccable order and we want to give all our clients equal opportunity to acquire them through the online auction.

"A significant number of trainers and agents have inspected our exceptional draft of 35 yearlings and we believe that this sale represents a great opportunity for investors to identify value, in what is the cream of the crop."

Aushorse, the marketing arm for Australian thoroughbred breeders, last night also weighed in, running an advertising campaign in today's ANZ Bloodstock News that is labelled as "United We Stand".

The advertisement said: "The vendors at the upcoming Easter Sale are committed to working together in these challenging times. The vast majority of the catalogue will be available when bidding begins on April 5 with a few horses being held back for Easter Round 2.

"To our buyers, you can have confidence that horses included in the online sale will not be sold beforehand. We are committed to creating a genuine marketplace, rather than holding negotiations behind closed-doors.

"This means you have the chance to buy the best stock from the best breeders."

Inglis has implemented an Easter Round 2 to be conducted as a live auction on July 5, if government restrictions have been lifted, to help vendors sell yearlings who are either passed in during the online auction or that the owners believe would be better suited being held back for the possible live sale.

Soon after Arrowfield Stud made its decision public on Thursday, Messara reasoned to ANZ Bloodstock News that the organisation had too much at stake during the uncertainty caused by the coronavirus crisis to risk selling at the digital sale.

"It was a terribly hard decision to make but we didn't bargain for having these horses in an online sale," Messara said.

"I know there was no other option and Inglis tried really hard to find a way through ... and when they went online it was an agonising decision that we just had to make for our own protection."
