MAGIC MILLIONS

Arcadia Queen sells for \$3.2 million in crowning moment for Magic Millions broodmare auction

A \$3.2 million deal for champion Arcadia Queen (Pierro) reached two days after she was initially passed in has brought to a close a frenzied Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale; the culmination of a three-day \$142 million bloodstock spending spree, never before witnessed in Australasia.

Arrowfield Stud agreed to terms to buy

Western Australian owner-breeder Bob Peters' three-time Group 1 winner for the sale-topping figure, which was below the reserve of \$4 million, as the sun had gone down on the Gold Coast and the final lots were going through the ring.

Arcadia Queen, a supplementary entry in the race fillies and mares session and billed as Magic Millions' star attraction, surpassed Melody Belle (Commands), who made \$2.6 million on Tuesday morning.

It capped a frenetic week in which 25 mares sold for \$1 million or more, including five who went through the ring in yesterday's final session, with Volpe Veloce (Foxwedge) the highest-priced of those at \$1.9 million.

Arrowfield Stud's Paul Messara revealed he had shown interest in Arcadia Queen in conjunction with a partner when the mare was offered prior to the Shadwell Stud Australasia dispersal but the dynamic changed once she was passed in at \$3.4 million.

After 48 hours of considering their options, Arcadia Queen became theirs for the eye-watering figure.

"Looking at it after the event, we valued her around the mark and she's one of those foundation mares that you don't get the opportunity to buy too often," Messara said.

"They are great mares to have, hard to come by, and we are very happy to have her on the farm."

Arrowfield will consider stallions on its own roster as well as looking to other elite sires as a first-season mating option for Arcadia Queen.

"We have got Dundee who would be a perfect cross for her, but we will look outside our roster if need be," he said.

"Obviously, we want to have the best commercial outcome and produce the best horse. With those types of mares, you really have got to have a good look everywhere for the best possible options for her.

"Bob's done a great job breeding and racing, so to be able to get into a

family like that and also at the top-end of that family. She's the pinnacle of that family, so to have the top of it is fantastic."

Peters, who sold another Group 1-winning mare in Celebrity Queen (Redoute's Choice) at the Inglis Chairman's Sale for \$2.5 million earlier this month, said selling Arcadia Queen was "purely a business decision".

"As I said before, we've got lots of the family and lots coming on for us in the future, so one of them has now gone out of the family, and not a lot of them have come out of that over the years," Peters said from Perth last night.

"They are very competent people and I'm sure they will look after her really well. She's only just down the road from where she's been living.

"It's very rare that you get a big mare like her that is so athletic. Most of them aren't like that, but she has just got everything you could want."

If Arrowfield chose to send Arcadia Queen to Dundee (High Chaparral), they would have Peters' endorsement.

"She'd suit Dundee down to the ground, really. I've got a share in Dundee and we breed a couple of mares to him every year," he said.

"He would definitely be a really good mating for her. If she were to go that way. It's good that she stays here, but on the other hand, it would have been great to see her on the international stage as well.

"Either way, it is good to see she is going somewhere where she will be really well looked after."

Longwood's Christian's patience rewarded with Volpe Veloce purchase

Investors showed no signs of buyer fatigue on the third and final day of the mares' sale, instead stepping up the bidding competition with a number of high-profile mares who were offered yesterday, led by Group 1-winning sprinter Volpe Veloce, the equal fifth highest-priced mare of the sale.

Longwood Thoroughbred Farm's Michael Christian had to go to \$1.9 million for Volpe Veloce, his second high-priced addition this week to his growing Victorian-based broodmare band.

"We bought Rimraam from the Shadwell draft for \$1.5 million on Tuesday night and we thought she was the bees knees and we really wanted to get this mare as well, so we waited patiently all day yesterday and we're delighted to get her," Christian said.

"Again, like Rimraam, she will be on the farm for the next 12 years and hopefully produce some really nice foals and hopefully we will have a lot of fun over that time."

Volpe Veloce is in foal to I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) on a November 7 cover and Christian confirmed the mare was set for a return date with the Yarraman Park Stud stallion.

Christian confirmed Volpe Veloce would be mated with I Am Invincible again this year.

"I think he's a great match for her and, certainly for this year, she will be going straight back to Vinnie, so we're really excited about that."

Christian partnered with agent Sheamus Mills and Peter Morgan to buy Volpe Veloce, who was a big trading result for Newgate Farm's Henry Field who bought her for \$675,000 at last year's Inglis Chairman's Sale and put her in foal to I Am Invincible.

She was sold last year in absentia due to the Covid-19 restrictions.

"I was just talking to Michael Christian, who bought Volpe Veloce with Sheamus, and I remember a mare Response who we sold for a good price - \$1.5 million - but in her belly she was carrying a \$1.7 million yearling who won a Golden Slipper in Estijaab and she's probably a \$5 million mare now," Field said.

"We will be successful in selling these big-ticket mares as long as they keep doing the job for the people who buy them and in Volpe Veloce I couldn't be more certain about a mare going on to do that for everyone involved."

A New Zealand Railway Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner who was trained by Graham Richardson, Volpe Veloce is a half-sister to Black Opal Stakes (Listed, 1200m) winner Delago Bolt (Delago Brom) and a daughter of Blue Diamond Preview (F) Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) winner Bardego (Baratheia).

"She's freaky good looking, she was a really good racehorse, she's in foal to Vinnie and she's got a pedigree - she's a star," Field said.

"I am really glad Michael bought her as I've admired him all my life. I used to strap a (Group 2 winner) called Phoenix Park for him and I'm confident she's going to be a great mare for him."

Christian runs Longwood Thoroughbred Farm in North East Victoria and believes the state's breeding industry is on the way up.

"It's great with Widden coming down to Victoria and Yulong is stepping it up as well," he said. "There's some great farms with some great stallions as well.

"Rosemont has been really busy at this sale and we've bought two quality mares as well to come home to Victoria and we're really excited about what the future holds."

The Group 3 winner and Group 1-placed Rimraam (Commands), a half-sister to Group 3 winner and promising Novara Park-based sire Sweynesse (Lonhro), was bought in foal to Dundee (High Chaparral).

The four mares to surpass \$2 million, Arcadia Queen (\$3.2 million), Melody Belle (Commands) (\$2.6 million), Mizzy (Zoustar) (\$2.2 million) and Qafila (Not A Single Doubt), who was in foal to Dundee (High Chaparral) (\$2 million), were sent through the ring on Tuesday in the race fillies and mares and Shadwell Stud Australasia Dispersal session and, while the latter three all sold in the ring, Arcadia Queen's sale-topping purchase completed yesterday evening followed her passing in with a reserve of \$4 million on Tuesday.

Eleven Commands (Danahill) mares sold this week at an average of \$604,545 while Foxwedge (Fastnet Rock) had nine sell for an average of \$428,889.

Diddles a million dollar first for Boomer and Daandine

Newgate Farm also pulled off another big trade later in the day when it sold Diddles (Snitzel), an ATC Gimcrack Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) runner-up and half-sister to Barbaric (I Am Invincible), for \$1 million in foal to Deep Field (Northern Meteor).

Field bought Diddles, a daughter of Group 2 winner and Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) winner Mimi Lebrock (Show A Heart), for \$300,000 from last year's Inglis Chairman's Sale.

Yesterday, going through the Magic Millions sale, she made \$1 million after Boomer Bloodstock's Craig Rounsefell identified Diddles on behalf of client Jan Clark of Daandine Stud, the breeder of Written Tycoon (Iglesia) and his Golden Slipper Stakes- (Gr 1, 1200m) winning son Capitalist.

Diddles was a major milestone for Rounsefell, the president of the Federation of Bloodstock Agents Australia, becoming the first million-dollar horse he has bought.

"She's the type of mare we truly believe that the farm can produce another Golden Slipper winner out of," Rounsefell said.

"It's a real two-year-old family, the mare had unbelievable speed and talent early. She was a \$400,000 yearling and showed incredible talent before she got hurt.

"The farm's had a lot of luck with Deep Field, who she is in foal to, they produced Isotope and she's a mare that hopefully will produce another Golden Slipper winner.

"The pedigree's there, the mare herself as a type has unbelievable quality and is as intelligent a horse as you will see.

"She is one of the ones you never think you'll get and I'm delighted Jan's got her for the farm."

No decision on a mating for Diddles has been decided but Rounsefell will be recommending the Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) mare is sent to I Am Invincible.

Rounsefell, an agent who operates in both hemispheres, admitted to feeling nervous as the bids closed in on seven figures.

He said: "You are at these auctions all the time and horses, particularly now, are making a lot of money.

"It is very nerve-racking as it is a lot of money, so when you do pull the trigger you want to make sure that you have total confidence and with this mare, Jan and the team, had total confidence that she was the one to do it on."

Rounsefell commended Field for his conviction to invest in quality mares last year and he has certainly been rewarded for doing so.

"During Covid last year there was uncertainty, but the market's thriving right now and there's a lot of people out there who want to compete and produce top horses and you have got to buy quality to do that," he said.

Torryburn stump up for Jedastar

The third million-dollar mare for the day was former speedy juvenile Jedastar (I Am Invincible), who will find a new home at Torryburn Stud after John and Brett Cornish decided to make the most of their "last saloon" after drawing a blank earlier in the week.

Brett Cornish, who signed for Jedastar, had to go to an even \$1 million to get her and defeated Widden Stud in the process.

Another star lot offered by the Newgate Consignment, the former Lloyd Kennewell-trained Jedastar, a juvenile winner who was runner-up in the 2019 Blue Diamond Preview (F) (Gr 3, 1000m), was sold in foal to Zoustar (Northern Meteor).

Jedastar is a sister to the stakes-placed sprinter Rulership and a daughter of the Listed winner Devoirs (Dehere). Such was Jedastar's speed, Kennewell ran her in the Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) as a two-year-old.

"She was a very fast and forward two-year-old by one of our great sires, and she is in foal to one of our great sires. There's not much guesswork there. she was just an excellent type and we were just happy to get her," Cornish said.

"When the catalogue came out, we were hoping the physical would match up and it did. She was a very short-coupled, fast two-year-old type.

"It was a great mating, Henry (Field) put a Zoustar in her and it's just the perfect mating, to put some size and scope into the foal."

"We've been trying. We have been underbidder on a couple and been on the hunt for a few, including the Shadwell mares, but we didn't quite make it."

"That was the last chance saloon, right at the end of the sale. The amount of money that is floating around is amazing. A lot of it seems to be going to Victoria, and so the whole industry is strong, not just the Hunter, which is good to see."

Jedastar is likely to return to Widden's Zoustar this year.

Meanwhile, Newgate Farm sold 28 mares at the National sale for \$13.205 million at an average of \$471,607, to sit behind only the Shadwell Dispersal as leading vendor.

Regally-bred Taste Of Heaven sells for \$1.6 million

An intriguing and stoutly-bred supplementary addition to the Magic Millions National Broodmare sale was Taste Of Heaven (Encosta De Lago), whose pedigree spoke volumes in the ring, as the mare, out of Shantha's Choice (Canny Lad), making her a sister to Manhattan Rain and a half-sister to Redoute's Choice (Danehill), sold for \$1.6 million to Bill Mitchell.

Agent Will Johnson played a significant role in bringing her back to Australia, after US owner LNJ Foxwoods entered the ownership of the mare, who found her way to the US having been purchased for \$1.5 million by John Sikura and Craig Bernick, as part of the Teeley Assets dispersal in 2014.

At the Inglis Chairman's Sale two mares sold from the prolific-producing family, as Meuse (Snitzel) was knocked down in foal to Dundee (High Chaparral) for \$1.2 million, and Visenya (Fastnet Rock) sold in foal to Written Tycoon (Iglesia) for \$310,000.

"The plan was to get her in foal to I Am Invincible last year, which we successfully did on the early cover," said Johnson. "With the market so buoyant after the Chairman's Sale we thought it was a good opportunity to see how she fared on the open market.

"It was great to see fierce bidding on her and ultimately selling for \$1.6 million. On behalf of Craig and LNJ Foxwood, we'd like to wish the best of luck to her new connections.

"With all likelihood she'll go back to I Am Invincible and with a bit of luck they can get a couple of nice fillies and the legacy of this family can continue.

"In line with the I Am Invincible covers, the majority of which made seven figures, I think that was the starting point and we let the market find the level thereafter."

Mitchell Bloodstock's Bill Mitchell was delighted to take up the rare opportunity to buy into the black-type family.

"It's the best pedigree, isn't it," said Mitchell after securing the mare, catalogued as lot 1369, from the Yarraman Park Stud draft in foal to I Am Invincible on a September cover. "It just keeps getting better and better.

"We bought her for a syndicate and that's in the process of being sorted out."

A Kembla Grange winner in three starts, the rising 12-year-old mare is

the dam of Grade 3 winner Heavenly Curlin (Curlin) in the US, one of four named foals, with her Curlin (Smart Strike) two-year-old filly in training in France under the ownership of Haras D'Etreham.

"We know the mare well and she's produced a stakes winner and she's from the best family," Mitchell continued.

"I know they are expensive, but everything is expensive ... I don't think we had any more for her, just happy to have her."

Mitchell Bloodstock purchased eight lots outright for a combined outlay of \$2.91 million, while, in conjunction with Segenhoe Stud, Mitchell purchased Group 2 winner and Group 1 placegetter Oregon's Day (Domesday) in foal to Pierata (Pierro) for \$1 million.

A half-sister to two further stakes winners, Oregon's Day saw her first foal by Fastnet Rock (Danehill) sell for \$600,000 at the Magic Millions National Weanling Sale last week to Rosemont Stud and Bahen Bloodstock.

Widden make mark early

The strong start to yesterday's session saw Widden Stud win the battle for Group 2 winner Tsartisa (Dane Shadow), the dam of talented two-year-old Patton (American Pharoah), for \$950,000 in foal to I Am Invincible.

Offered by Attunga Stud as Lot 1100, Tsaritsa is a half-sister to Group 2 winner Ninth Legion (Fastnet Rock) and the stakes-placed Sing A Love Song (Your Song). Tsaritsa's weanling filly by The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice) sold last week to agent Justin Bahen for \$300,000.

"She's a lovely mare and the quality is obvious to see. The fact is that she has already produced a couple of good types of foals," Widden Stud's Antony Thompson said.

"The American Pharoah (Patton) was one of the better American Pharoahs we saw that year and her foal at this foal sale had great quality as well. It gives you great confidence that not only is she a lovely type of mare, but she throws that as well."

Champion stallion Zoustar (Northern Meteor), who stands at Widden, has been pencilled in for Tsaritsa this year.

Widden Stud bought six mares over the three days, led by Group 2-winning sprinter Humma Humma (Denman) who made \$1 million on Tuesday.

"Some of our new stallions, Russian Camelot and Doubtland in Victoria, and Anders in the Hunter, we've been targeting some mares that will really suit them," Thompson said.

"All three stallions are getting really good support so far, but we want to find the mares that really put the cherry on top and really help launch their careers.

"There's a bit of that going on and with the rest of our stallions there, we have plenty of options.

"We are just looking for nice mares all the time and if there is something we really like, we'll go a bit further on them (to buy them)."

Thompson added: "We have had a bit of luck with some mares out of this rung, with Bonny O'Reilly and Vezalay, mares of that ilk which have been bought in foal and we got good results with those foals.

"There have been some good returns and so hopefully we can do it again."

Eight mares in foal to I Am Invincible sold at this week's sale and averaged \$1,142,500.

Hell Or Highwater for busy Hedge

As the sun was beginning to go down, agent Suman Hedge capped a big broodmare sale with his 14th and final purchase, the Not A Single Doubt (Redoute's Choice) mare Hell Or Highwater who is in foal to Written Tycoon, for \$850,000.

The Melburnian, whose collection of mares cost a combined \$7.15 million and included Shadwell mares Futooh (Sebring) (\$1.2 million) and Hindaam (Savabeel) (\$1 million), rounded out his sales season with four lots purchased yesterday headed by the Woodside Park Stud-consigned Hell Or Highwater.

A Listed winner and multiple Group-placed mare, Hell Or Highwater, herself a daughter of US Listed winner Get Ready Bertie (More Than Ready), was bought by Woodside Park Stud and Iskander Racing for \$600,000 at the 2018 Magic Millions Broodmare Sale.

Her first foal, a colt by Written Tycoon, made \$250,000 at this year's Gold Coast Yearling Sale and his weanling brother was bought last week at auction by Rosemont Stud for \$510,000.

"She's a mare that we obviously knew a lot about as we owned her in partnership with Woodside," Hedge said.

"She's by a champion in Not A Single Doubt and was a well-performed racehorse herself, she was a stakes winner. Her first yearling made \$250,000 and her first foal sold particularly well last week as well and sold for \$510,000. With that in mind, we were pretty bullish in getting something done with her."

Zoustar is a probable mating for Hell Or Highwater this year.

Hedge also bought three mares in partnership with Ridgmont Farm and fellow agent Jim Clarke.

"We have had clients that really wanted to be active here, and we had the artillery to be involved," Hedge said.

"We had a clear edict to buy good physicals that we thought were elite and commercial and will mate those accordingly.

"It's been hard, but we certainly don't think we have got the upper hand anywhere, but if you wanted to be involved you had to be brave and put yourself up there and buy."

Mind-blowing results at mares sale

All the indicators were that there would be a hot market at the Magic Millions National Sale after a record yearling sale series and a strong weanling market but, even so, the auction house's managing director Barry Bowditch was still coming to terms by how much trade had taken place this week.

The sale closed with a spend of \$142.459 million on 611 mares at an

average of \$233,157 and a median of \$120,000. The clearance was 87 per cent, highlighting the intense demand for horses.

"We knew we had an unbelievable catalogue and we were very confident with where the market was at, but to achieve the results we have was blowing our minds, to be honest," Bowditch said.

"To have a gross of over \$142 million, a record average of \$233,000 considering we sold 611 lots at a clearance rate of 87 percent is just way above our expectations."

The Written Tycoon Syndicate was the leading buyer, taking home 39 mares at a cost of \$16.46 million while fellow Victorian operation Rosemont Stud bought 22 lots for \$12.735 million.

Bowditch credited the depth of the buying bench as one of the reasons for the results.

"To have 25 million-dollar mares and five of those today is better than we thought we'd go," he said.

"The Cornishs at Torryburn are great supporters of Magic Millions. They've had great success buying out of this sale, they have great success at our yearling sales, so it's great to see them chip up and spend plenty on a mare and Daandine, one of the champion breeders of Queensland who've had great luck buying mares here ... investing in quality bloodstock with their agent Craig Rounsefell is fantastic."

The three-day Magic Millions Gold Coast National Yearling Sale starts on Tuesday.

Perth Racing terminates contract of managing director Yovich

Perth Racing yesterday announced it has terminated the contract of managing director, Professor John Yovich, on the grounds of serious misconduct. The decision, which is effective immediately, was made following a board meeting yesterday afternoon. "The board applauds the brave member of staff who came forward with their credible account and evidence of what occurred," a statement read. "As a result of this evidence, the Perth Racing Board has been made aware of serious misconduct cultural issues within the organisation and will now work to appoint an independent agency to conduct a full organisational review." Perth Racing operations will continue as usual, with details of the review and its findings to be made public at "the appropriate time". Yovich, a qualified veterinarian, was appointed Perth Racing managing director in July 2016.

Allen leaving nothing to chance in Derby bid

John Allen was not going to let the latest Covid outbreak in Melbourne prevent him from teaming up with the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained Explosive Jack (Jakkalberry) for a fourth Derby win. Allen left Victoria before Queensland shut its border so as he could ride the TAB's \$2.90 favourite in the Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) at Eagle Farm tomorrow. "Initially I didn't plan on coming up until Saturday and then I decided to come Wednesday after racing at Sandown," Allen told RSN. "But then I was

chatting to Ciaron and a few of the owners and I ended with only one ride at Sandown. It was in similar ownership to Explosive Jack and I think they were keen for me to get up here before they closed the border." Explosive Jack has won the Tasmanian Derby (Listed, 2200m), Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) and South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) and will be aiming to join Dayana (Oncidium), from the 1970s, as a four-time Derby winner. A dry track is expected, with Explosive Jack's three Derby wins coming on soft ground. "No doubt his best form has been on soft tracks but he's won on good tracks twice as well, so I don't see it as a real issue and we'll find out more after Saturday," Allen said. "Hopefully everything goes well on Saturday and we can add a fourth Derby to the mantlepiece."

Hulberts' Derby dream

Criminal Defence (Nicconi) will tomorrow attempt to become the eighth horse to follow-up a Rough Habit Plate (Gr 3, 2000m) win with a Queensland Derby victory. Father and son co-trainers Peter and Will Hulbert caused a shock when their three-year-old, a \$67 chance for the Rough Habit, stepped up to score at his first attempt in Group class. "I've been training just over 40-odd years now and that would have to be our biggest thrill, particularly the fact Will and I train together. That makes it all the more special," Peter Hulbert said. The handlers opted to go without blinkers last time and that combined with Michael Rodd's ride made the difference. "Michael Rodd suggested to Will we take the blinkers off and I know it would have been a slower tempo stepping up to the 2000 metres, but in saying that, that's the best he's ever begun. I would say now we know that formula

worked, we will go with it again," Hulbert continued. "To me physically, the horse has improved since the Rough Habit, even though he's well into his campaign." With Michael Rodd out for the carnival, Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winning jockey Jye McNeil has been called up for the ride.

So Si Bon in good shape for latest Group 1 bid

Connections of So Si Bon (So You Think) are hoping he can finally break through for an elite-level win in the Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) at Eagle Farm tomorrow. The Tom Dabernig and Ben Hayes-trained gelding has placed three times in Group 1 races at 1400 metres and 1600 metres during the past four years and again faces a strong field of rivals. "He's fallen just short of the mark when we've had him in Group 1s but he's run some very good races at Group 1 level, so I certainly wouldn't put it past him," Dabernig told Racing.com. The seven-year-old has won three of his last six starts, including the Vobis Gold Mile (1600m) at Caulfield last time. "He's the sort of horse that, even when he gets beat, often the margin isn't too great so, if the race happened to go his way, he's certainly the horse that will be finishing strong," Dabernig added.

Doubts over leading Kingsford-Smith fancies

Gytrash (Lope De Vega) and Savatiano (Street Cry), the font two in the betting for the Kingsford-Smith Cup, were last night reported to be showing signs of lameness. Gytrash was found to have some lameness in his near-fore during an examination while Savatiano was mildly lame in her off-fore. Another big-name runner found to have mild lameness ahead of the weekend feature was the recent Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Savatolx (Kuroshio), who had an issue with the near-fore. Vets will re-examine all three this morning.

Du Plessis hunts maiden Group 1 win

Mark du Plessis has won 19 Group 1 races in his career but the rider, now based in Queensland, is hoping his twentieth will be his first in Australia. The Zimbabwe-born former Kiwi, who has raced around the world, including in Hong Kong, will ride Victorem (I Am Invincible) in the Kingsford-Smith Cup and believes the six-year-old has the ability to win in the top grade. The Jenny Graham trained gelding is around a \$17 chance having drawn barrier two, and heads into the race off an eye-catching barrier trial in which he finished four and a half lengths ahead of the rest.

Converge sets focus on winter carnival

The Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott training partnership is hoping to notch its first win of this season's Queensland winter carnival when Converge (Frankel) tackles the BRC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Eagle Farm tomorrow. The two-year-old is set to drop down in trip after a smart effort when third behind Captivant (Capitalist) in the Champagne Stakes

(Gr 1, 1600m) at Caulfield on April 24. Converge has been freshened since then and the team believes the strongly-run mile last time might have meant the final 100 metres was a stretch too far at that stage of his development. The gelding has drawn barrier 15 of 17 and is around the \$10 mark up against local runner Prince Of Boom (Spirit Of Boom)

Holyfield aims at Ayrton knockout

Annabel Neasham will look to keep her momentum rolling with tough colt Holyfield (I Am Invincible) who will take on hype horse Ayrton (Ifraaj), trained by Mick Price and Michael Kent jr, in the Fred Best Classic (Gr 3, 1400m) at Eagle Farm tomorrow. "Obviously, Mick Price's horse has a big boom on it and I'm sure it will be hard to beat but the 1400 seems to be our fellow's go and he's rock-hard fit, so I'm looking forward to seeing him lineup there," Neasham said. Holyfield was placed in Group 3 company as a juvenile and again as a spring three-year-old when under the care of Neasham's old bosses, Ciaran Maher and David Eustace. In three starts for Neasham, he needed the hitout when resuming with an unplaced run behind Ellsberg (Spill The Beans) in the South Pacific Classic (Listed, 1400m) and improved from fifth in the Queensland Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m) to runner-up behind Glitter Strip (Street Boss) in the ANZ Bloodstock News Plate (1350m) at Doomben last start. "He looks super and he has tightened up," Neasham said of the colt who will be ridden by Josh Parr. "He was good the other day. It was a good ride by 'J Mac' (James McDonald) and I thought he was going to cling on and while he didn't quite, he's hardened up again from that run." Holyfield is at \$31 in early TAB fixed odds markets which have Ayrton a \$1.55 chance to take his undefeated record to four.

Freedmans chasing Farm glory

Seasoned campaigner Paths Of Glory (Mastercraftsman) and progressive import Alakahan (Motivator) will attempt to give co-trainers Michael and Anthony Freedman success in the Premier's Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) at Eagle Farm tomorrow. Paths Of Glory won the JRA Cup (Gr 3, 2000m) two starts ago, defeating subsequent runaway Doomben Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) winner

Zaaki (Leroidesanimaux). Paths Of Glory went on to finish fourth in the Wagga Cup (Listed, 2000m), beaten just over a length. "He went to Wagga and was probably a little bit stiff there. It took him a while to wind up into it and then he got crowded up the straight," Michael Freedman said. "We sent him up (Wednesday) night to line him up there Saturday. He always gives his all so if he gets the right run, it's a race he can run well in." Former Irish galloper Alakahan has started to blossom in his second preparation and has notched back-to-back 2400-metre wins at his past two starts, on the Randwick Kensington track and at the Gold Coast. "Saturday is a bit of a step up from his win the previous start at the Gold Coast but he's doing well up there, his work has been good so, while it will be interesting to see how he handles that step up in grade, he is a progressive stayer," Freedman added.

Racing to continue in Victoria but with no crowds or owners

Race meetings in Victoria will continue during the seven-day lockdown period imposed by the state government due to a Covid-19 outbreak, with only competing participants, essential staff and officials permitted to attend. All spectators, including owners, members and the general public, non-broadcast media and non-essential staff are prohibited from attending the races, while all owners, media and non-essential persons are prohibited from attending Victorian public and private training facilities and licensed racing premises at any time. Face masks are compulsory on licensed premises at all times and riders are permitted to remove their mask only when on horseback and when they have exited the mounting yard on race day. "Throughout the pandemic Victorian racing's clear objectives have been to protect the health and wellbeing of industry staff, participants and the wider community; maintain 25,000 full-time equivalent jobs across the state; and ensure essential daily care and exercise can be afforded to our horses," said Racing Victoria chief executive, Giles Thompson. "Racing and training can continue in Victoria at this time under the strict biosecurity protocols that saw our sport safely continue throughout previous periods of lockdown and restrictions."

Wetter the better for Great Again

Winter is the time for smart sprinter Great Again (Viscount) to strike and his trainer Lindsey Smith is hoping for plenty of cushion in the track at Caulfield tomorrow for the Catanach's Jewellers Handicap (1100m). The eight-year-old is rated a \$9 chance in latest TAB markets, which have Bless Her (Street Boss), having her first start for the Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young stable, the \$4.20 favourite. "He's certainly looking for a bit of a soft track," Smith said. "We can only get a few runs into him each campaign, but he excels on the wet tracks and he's ready to run a bold race, as he always does." Seven of Great Again's ten wins from his 27 starts have come on rain-affected ground, including a first-up win in May last year in the Straight Six (1200m) at Flemington on heavy ground. The gelding went on to place in the All Victorian Sprint Final (Listed, 1200m) and a pair of Group 3 contests, and stepped out of a nine-month spell to run fourth in the Wangoom Handicap (Listed, 1200m) at Warrnambool on May 5. "He just ran out of steam a bit first-up," Smith added. "It's just about judging it right for him and getting the right conditions."

Pateman's Belmont Sprint confidence

A positive endorsement from Darren McAuliffe has boosted the confidence of Mitchell Pateman ahead of his ride on The Velvet King (Universal Ruler) in the Iron Jack Belmont Sprint (1400m) at Belmont tomorrow. The five-year-old campaigned in Melbourne last spring under the care of Peter Moody but was limited to just two starts after being hampered with feet problems.

He ran seventh in the Village Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Caulfield and last of 16 at his previous start in the Cantala Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Flemington in October. "He's a high-quality horse on his day," Pateman told Tabradio. "Darren (McAuliffe) messaged me the other day and said he flew. That was Tuesday morning and that's as good a lead as any. He's been at the top level for a good two or three years and it's hard to keep coming back and competing at that level. But Darren instils me with a lot of confidence. He knows the horse better than

anyone. He thinks he has him where he needs to be. That gives me as much confidence as anything," Pateman added. Winner of the Northerly Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) in 2019, The Velvet King has three wins and two seconds from six first-up attempts and is rated a \$10 hope with Tabtouch in the 15-runner field.

Nick Ryan team in great form

Victorian trainer Nick Ryan is enjoying a great run of form with his horses at the moment having trained six winners from his past 13 starters. The former jockey recently moved his stable from Caulfield to Flemington and into the complex where Freedman Racing used to be based. "The 'Freemies' used to be in here and they loved this barn," he told Racing.com. "They had some good horses win some good races out of this barn, so it does have a very, very good vibe to it. The horses that came from Caulfield, if anything, it did spark them up a bit. They're all very happy, they're eating well. Bloods have been good since they got here. We have been working on placing them right. We don't like to run them when they're not in the right race. We're a little bit picky like that. Being a boutique stable we like to go to the races and we like to be competitive."

Neasham confirms Zaaki for Q22

The impressive Doomben Cup winner Zaaki is set for the Q22 (Gr 2, 2200m) at Eagle Farm on Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) day, June 12. Trainer Annabel Neasham confirmed the \$1.2 million contest as the next target after assessing the six-year-old's wellbeing following his seven-length victory in last weekend's Doomben feature, which saw him emerge as the ante-post favourite for the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) at Moonee Valley in the spring. The gelding was trained by Sir Michael Stoute in Britain before having his initial start for Neasham at the beginning of April.

Mugatoo to miss the spring

All-Star Mile (1600m) winner Mugatoo (Henrythenavigator) has sustained a tendon

injury which will rule him out of the spring carnival. The horse was one of the top fancies for last Saturday's Doomben Cup but he struggled to quicken when the race heated up on the corner and was eased down by Hugh Bowman in the straight. Subsequent tests have revealed a tendon injury which will require rest and rehabilitation. "He's got a little issue with his tendon so he's going to be out for the spring, unfortunately," trainer Kris Lees confirmed. Lees said it was too early to tell how long Mugatoo would be sidelined with further tests scheduled for next month expected to reveal the severity of the problem. The Australian Bloodstock import was an outstanding fourth from a wide gate in the Cox Plate last spring and after returning to win the All-Star Mile, he performed gallantly in the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600) and Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m).

Stokes hoping for bright spring

Phillip Stokes is hoping for more big race glory to cap a successful season in which he has registered a win strike-rate above 20 per cent, but the trainer is already looking at spring targets for his stable stars. While Mr Quickie (Shamus Award) heads to the Stradbroke Handicap, fellow stable Group 1 winner Instant Celebrity (Not A Single Doubt) is enjoying a break after placing in the Goodwood. "She came through really well from the Goodwood after a tough run from the wide draw and having to put in a big sustained run and has come back to the Pakenham farm for the winter," Stokes told Racing.com. "The plan is probably to keep her around the 1200-metre to 1400-metre mark." Melbourne Cup hope Amade (Casamento) will be kept in light winter work following his win at Flemington last time. "He's got a big set of lungs and is better the more you do with him, we definitely don't want him putting on too much weight out in the paddock," Stokes continued. "We'll look to take a traditional path to the Melbourne Cup with him through the Bart Cummings or the Geelong Cup, just need to ensure he's qualified. He doesn't need too much racing. We're certainly not getting too ahead of ourselves going into the spring but it's fantastic to have some great options looking ahead."

McDonald to ride Mr Quickie

James McDonald has been booked to ride Mr Quickie in the Stradbroke Handicap next weekend after Jamie Kah was unable to commit in time. Kah has ridden the five-year-old in four of his last seven races, including to victory in the Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) in October. "Her (Kah's) manager I think wanted to see the state of play after this weekend for the Stradbroke so couldn't give us a firm commitment," part-owner Anthony Mithen told the Moody On The Mic podcast. "She's riding Vega One I think this weekend who's a chance to go into the Stradbroke. I understand all those things, but you've got to make the right decision for your horse." McDonald will be the 11th jockey to partner Mr Quickie. "We had a chat to Wiley (managing owner Wiley Dalziel) and Stokesy (trainer Phil Stokes) and the crew and said JMac is a pretty good option so let's go that way, so he's locked in," Mithen added.

NEW ZEALAND

Lady Maroal heads to Ellerslie

A trainer-owner combination in its infancy will look to continue a roaring start when Lady Maroal (Power) contests the Mainland Auckland Futurity Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Ellerslie tomorrow. Lady Maroal is the first horse 61-year-old Nigel Tiley has prepared for nonagenarian owner Ron Saunders and already the two-year-old has won the Champagne Stakes (Listed, 1600m) at Ellerslie and finished fifth in the Manawatu Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m). "Ron's 94 and he's

an amazing bloke. He loves his racing and he'll be there on Saturday with bells on," Tiley said. "She is the first horse I've had for Ron. She's worked really well on wet tracks so I don't think there's any issue there. It was a little tough on her at Palmerston North with a really heavy track but the forecast isn't too bad for the weekend. I'm really happy with her. She's spot on and she'll run a good race." Saunders bred Lady Maroal in partnership with Sir Patrick and Lady Hogan then bought them out when she sold for \$40,000 at last year's Karaka yearling sales through the Woburn Farm draft.

Blackadder goes north

An enhanced stake and a favourable heavy track have convinced North Canterbury trainer John Blackadder to trek north with impressive last-start winner Tellyawhat (Dalghar) for the US Navy Flag Autumn Sprint Championship Final (1200m) at Trentham tomorrow. The gelding won in the same 74-rating grade at Riccarton earlier this month. "He's notably a wet tracker but he came home (his last 600metres) in 32 seconds and went 1:09 for the 1200 metres last time which was quite impressive for him," Blackadder said. "He's won at Trentham on a Heavy 11 track before and though that was a while ago, I can't see why he won't handle those conditions again. And I've booked Bailey Rogerson for her four kilo claim. We wanted to take as much weight off his back as we could." Formerly trained by Allan Sharrock, Tellyawhat joined Blackadder's stable in December last year. "We've worked out he doesn't take a lot of work. Since Riccarton, I gave him a run along Woodend Beach and he's only done light pacework since," Blackadder continued. "He's

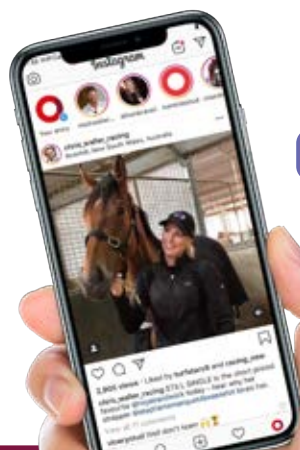

very well and I couldn't be happier with him. He's come through that win as good as gold. We won't change anything for Saturday. He comes from the back. He's better taking a sit."

ASIA

JPN: Gran Alegria gets green light

Star mare Gran Alegria (Deep Impact) looks set to defend her Yasuda Kinen (Gr 1, 1600m) crown at Tokyo in two weeks' time. The five-year-old notched her fifth elite-level win with an impressive score in the Victoria Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) at the same venue on May 16 but was found to be tender in the near fore hoof last Friday. Trainer Kazuo Fujisawa was said to be pleased with her work yesterday morning and the Yasuda Kinen on June 6 remains the target. Meanwhile, last season's fillies' triple crown heroine Daring Tact (Epiphaneia) will be sidelined for around nine months after injuring her off fore and being found to have sustained ligamentitis following her return to Japan after running third in the QEII Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) at Sha Tin last month.

HK: Lor hopeful of Happy success

Hong Kong Classic Cup (Listed, 1800m) winner Healthy Happy (Zoustar) will attempt to maintain a positive trend for light-weighted runners in the Lion Rock Trophy Handicap (Gr 3, 1600m) at Sha Tin on Sunday under a 114lb impost. Four out of the five winners since the race's inception in 2016 have carried 118lb or less. "The light weight should be better, it should be much easier for him," trainer Frankie Lor said. Stepping out off the back of a last-start fourth to Golden Sixty (Medaglia D'Oro) in the Champions Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) at the end of April, Healthy Happy lines up as one of two four-year-olds in the race alongside Hong Kong Derby (Listed, 2000m) winner Sky Darci (Darci Brahma), who may carry one pound over his allotted weight. "(Healthy Happy) ran well last start but we need to race him because his rating is at 106, we need to race him in Group races so I'm trying again. I hope he gets close but perhaps next season as he gets older he will be better," Lor said. The Australian import is

three from seven in Hong Kong and will break from gate seven under Alexis Badel "His form is good," Lor added. "I think he's now looking for 1400 to 1600 metres, I think they are his distances."

HK: Time called on Big Party

Connections have called time on Big Party's (Exceed And Excel) Hong Kong career. Frankie Lor's charge won five of his 22 starts across three seasons. The grey emerged as a burgeoning talent with those five wins coming in his first nine races. After landing the December 2019 Bauhinia Sprint Trophy (Gr 3, 1000m) in some style, the gelding struggled with physical issues but did still manage to earn a top level placing when third behind Hot King Prawn (Denman) in this year's Centenary Sprint Cup (Gr 1, 1200m). "He's done really good for me, unfortunately he has had too many problems with his back and his knees, so I think it's best for him to retire and be sent back to Australia to enjoy his life," Lor said.

INTERNATIONAL

SAF: Greyville Group 1s

Greyville will host a pair of Group 1 features tomorrow with the Daily News 2000 (Gr 1, 2000m) and the Woolavington 2000 (Gr 1, 1900m). The Daily News 2000 is being seen as something of a head-to-head between a pair of Western Cape gallopers, Linebacker (Captain Of All) and Kommetdieding (Elusive Fort). The former, trained by Vaughan Marshall, won the Cape Derby (Gr 1, 2000m) in February and had the Harold Crawford and Michelle Rix-trained Kommetdieding behind in third when winning an incident-packed KZN Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m) earlier this month. Kommetdieding won three in a row before suffering a setback in January and was returning for the first time when caught up in interference last time. Meanwhile, the Woolavington 2000 looks to be an opportunity for South African triple tiara winner War Of Athena (Act Of War) to improve her impressive record, which stands at seven wins from nine starts. The Paul Matchett-trained star landed the SA Fillies' Classic (Gr 1, 1900m) two starts ago.

Group 2 winner Graff to stand at Kitchwin Hills

Group 2-winning and Group 1-placed sprinter Graff (Star Witness)

will stand at Kitchwin Hills in the Hunter Valley this year after connections made the call to officially retire the talented entire.

Graff, who joins Sooboog (Snitzel) on the Kitchwin Hills roster, will stand for an introductory fee of \$13,200 (inc GST) this year.

"He is a lovely horse and at one point in his career everyone would have thought he was a \$20 to \$25 million stallion and when you think about his race career, he was such a good horse," Kitchwin Hills' Mick Malone said yesterday.

"He was an undefeated two-year-old by Star Witness ... and as a three-year-old he comes out and wins the San Domenico and in three starts he's run in a Run To The Rose, a Golden Rose and an Everest, which just shows the opinion of him as a young horse."

Bought by renowned yearling judge Alan Bell for \$200,000 at the 2017 Magic Millions Gold Coast Sale from the Widden Stud draft, Graff was a dual winner at two and a San Domenico Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) winner a three, a victory which saw him start favourite in the 2018 Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m).

He ran third in the Golden Rose before running fifth in The Everest (1200m) later that year and the following autumn he ran fourth in both the Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) and Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) at Flemington.

He won the Caulfield Sprint (Gr 2, 1000m) last year when trained by Danny O'Brien and connections were attempting a Queensland campaign with Tony Gollan, but they pulled the pin on the rising six-year-old after the Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 1200m) a fortnight ago.

Graff is a brother to the stakes-placed filly Steel Diamond and a son of Group 3 winner Dinkum Diamond (Keep The Faith), herself a half-sister to dual Group 3 winner Dawn Passage (Dawn Approach). His second dam Raja Lane (Devaraja) was also a Group 3 winner.

"Any horse who can sprint here like he could is on any stud farm's radar," Malone said.

"Another string in his bow is you can breed him to any mare. Everyone walks around and wondering why we haven't seen these sons of Snitzel, or a really good son of Fastnet or a really good son of Exceed And Excel, and it's because they just don't get the chance to breed to the most prolific line of mares that work here which is Danehill.

"They're trying to inject their own line of Danehill into all these mares and often it doesn't come off. Often when you do get that out-cross stallion it's often from Europe and they're really hard to find the right ones that work here."

Australian Bloodstock's Jamie Lovett, who bought into Graff after his 2019 spring campaign, was delighted to find a home at stud

for the sprinter who was trained by Kris Lees for the majority of his career.

"There's a good pool of breeders who have bought into the horse because they want to use him and they will obviously do that," Lovett said.

"The fact that he's standing at Kitchwin Hills. To get them into the Hunter Valley, you know you're a live hope, and you only have to look at Star Turn and that line, it's certainly working."

Lifetime breeding rights at a cost of \$26,400 (inc GST) are being offered in the stallion, which provides breeders with two nominations each in years one and two and a lifetime nomination thereafter,

If a breeding right holder sends a mare in year one by Fastnet Rock (Danehill), Snitzel (Redoute's Choice), Exceed And Excel (Danehill) or Not A Single Doubt (Redoute's Choice), they will receive an extra nomination to be used at their discretion.

Kitchwin Hills is also committed to buying mares to support Graff who is available for inspection today at the Magic Millions sales complex on the Gold Coast.

half-length winner Hurtle (Capitalist) for the ANZ Bloodstock News Maiden of the Week.

In what was yet another winner for high-flying first season sire Capitalist (Written Tycoon), his 16th in fact, the Tony and Calvin McEvoy-trained Hurtle backed up a Morphettville trial win with this procession over the 1100 metres of the Ballarat synthetic, defeating fellow debutant Rock Melody (All Too Hard) and Ostracised, who at \$375,000 is the most expensive yearling for his first season sire Divine Prophet (Choisir).

Hurtle, himself a \$120,000 graduate of the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale for McEvoy Mitchell Racing and Belmont Bloodstock, was bred by Matthew Sandblom's Kingstar Farm.

His dam, Murtle Turtle (Murtajill), twice

a runner up at Group 3 level as a juvenile, has passed through broodmare sales' rings twice in the past two years. In 2020 she sold for \$40,000 in foal to Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) to Gainsborough Lodge and, having sold her Deep Field (Northern Meteor) yearling and resulting Extreme Choice weanling for \$380,000 and \$220,000 respectively this year, she went through the sales ring again on Wednesday at the Magic Millions, this time knocked down to Merricks Station and Group 1 Bloodstock for \$180,000 in foal to Shalaa (Invincible Spirit).

By Murtajill (Rock Of Gibraltar), a two-year-old winner of the Breeders' Plate (Listed, 1000m) and Skyline Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) in 2007, Hurtle is one of 22 runners out of mares by the son of Rock Of Gibraltar (Danahill), with 13 of them winners.

The syndicate, which features Mark Milano and Cornerstone Stud, who sold him as a yearling, was formed by Jack Cripps, who oversees sales and syndicates at McEvoy Mitchell Racing and was winner of the Newcomer Award at Wednesday evening's Godolphin Stud And Stable Staff Awards.

"We had 15 people or so there (at Ballarat in the ownership of Hurtle) who own a really small portion," said Cripps after collecting his award at the Gold Coast.

"Talking to them, for a lot of them it was their first runner ever as an owner, and their first winner and it realigns the values that you have in doing your job."

Co-trainer Calvin McEvoy believes the gelding has a bright future.

"It was fantastic to see Hurtle do that," McEvoy said after his impressive victory. "He's been pretty sharp in all of his gallops, but obviously, you want to see him come to the races and do it.

"It is just fantastic for the ownership group,

"Hurtle was very strong at the end of the 1100 metres so he has scope to get further. He's a hardy little horse that will handle that well.

"It was a good result, and he looks to have a very bright future.

"We'll see how he comes through it, he's pretty hardy, I think he will handle it really well, I expect him to go home and eat up and we can maybe find something in town in a few weeks."

Why British racing needs to take a lead from Australia

Our latest Flying Start blog comes from George Broughton, 23, from Suffolk, UK. In 2019, George completed his MA (Hons) degree in Politics at the University of Edinburgh, graduating with First Class Honours.

Since finishing university, George has spent time working for Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott, and at New Zealand Bloodstock. His interests outside of racing include politics and cricket, as well as cycling, having previously cycled 4,300 miles across the USA for charity.

The last two weeks have seen the return of spectators to British racecourses in what is hopefully the gradual return to normality for the racing industry. With that in mind, now is the perfect time to reflect on the lessons learnt from the past 15 months and what changes can be made going forward.

The first lesson is that the British racing industry's current business model is flawed and that fundamental reform is required to secure the long-term health and prosperity of the sport.

The other key lesson shown over the last year is that owners are the lifeblood of the sport,

contributing more than £30 million a month to the rural economy.

Not only are owners an intrinsic linchpin of the industry but, furthermore, the model upon which they are based is rapidly changing, with there being an inevitable move toward shared ownership.

This can be seen in there being a 7.8 per cent decline in sole ownership since 2015 - meanwhile, more than 60 per cent of racehorses trained in Britain are owned in some form of partnership.

With this inevitable change in ownership in mind, the British racing industry must learn from others to prepare for what is not only the future but already a core aspect of the country's racing model.

Australia, as expected, is the first port of call when evaluating successful syndicate models, with one in 244 Australians owning a share in a racehorse. This difference with the UK is furthered by the incredible prize-money on offer due to a strong pari-mutuel system in a nation with an amazing capacity to bet, with on average \$862 bet per capita each year.

However, while this strong prize-money is an aspiration that we in Europe can strive towards and probably only achieve through

fundamental reform, there is a lot that can be learnt from down under. These lessons, whilst not providing an entire solution, can bring what esteemed British cycling coach Sir Dave Brailsford would call 'marginal gains'.

What is key within the Australian model of ownership is not only great prize-money but the sense of ownership and the emphasis on making owners feeling valued.

With regards to this first issue, it is understandable owners take great pride in their horses, and an area where this is guaranteed - win, lose or draw - is seeing their name in the racecard. Australia hits the nail on the head by allowing up to 20 owners' names to be present on the racecard. In this way, owners have physical proof of their involvement in the horse.

Meanwhile, in the UK, our system has stuck with an outdated understanding of ownership, with racecards being limited to 40 characters for owners' names (including spaces and punctuations). Not only is this not enough to allow the names of syndicate holders, but it is often not enough for partnerships of people holding as much as a leg in a horse, with partners often having to decide whose name(s) must be omitted.

In the past, the argument against allowing more space for owners' names in the racecard was due to limited printing capabilities, but ultimately because it was deemed unnecessary. It is clear that this argument has long expired on both fronts, and therefore if ownership is to be encouraged in the UK we must also encourage a sense of ownership. Allowing more owners' names into the racecard is an easy place to start.

Not only is encouraging a sense of ownership key in this updated ownership model, but raceday experience is also of paramount importance. Here, the UK falls behind the times with the general rule of thumb for UK racecourses being for only six free entry badges per horse.

If over 60 per cent of UK-trained horses are owned in partnerships or by syndicates, then the standard of six badges must often prove limiting for owners.

There are two potential solutions. First, the minimum number of tickets for owners should be increased and, second, unclaimed owners' tickets should be reallocated to the owners

who need them. This second suggestion could prove particularly successful in the UK, which benefits hugely from overseas investment and, as a result, has a large number of owners not present on racedays.

How and when these actions are taken up

is ultimately up to the Racecourse Association and its members. However, there must be a recognition that syndication is the future of British racing. Australia again provides a valuable lesson, with syndicates being able to access up to 40 tickets per horse.

Another tool to further the lot of owners is ensuring they have as enjoyable an experience as possible on course. Here many courses excel, with York, Chester and Musselburgh all being officially recognised in recent years for their work in this department.

However, these courses are not primus inter pares and there is inevitably more that courses should be doing to look after owners. A greater emphasis could be placed upon the Racehorse Owners Association's Ownership Quality Mark, as well as their Gold Standard Awards, to truly incentivise improvements in racecourse hospitality for owners.

The traditional model of ownership in the UK has perhaps created this complacency, with many 'super owners' having their own boxes

or hospitality arranged. In light of a deeply changing structure to ownership, racecourses must adapt if they are not to drive away the sport's single most important stakeholder.

If the sport is to capitalise on the lessons learnt over the last year, there must be an increased emphasis on owners. While doing this does not solve the ongoing issues of prize-money and industry reform, it can certainly go a long way.

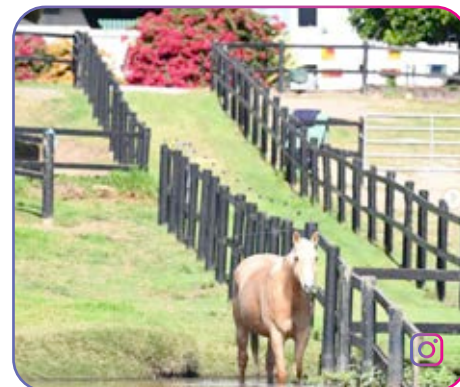

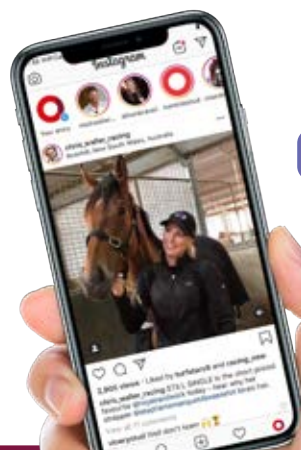
