Connections to hold studmasters at bay after Ole Kirk's Group 1 victory

Hawkes' indicate second elite level tilt is on the cards for the well-related three-year-old colt following his Golden Rose Stakes win

Studmasters are likely to have to wait at least another fortnight before negotiations for a stallion deal for Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) ramp up, with the highly sought after colt set

to embark on a Melbourne campaign after his breakthrough Group 1 victory.

The three-year-old's principal owner Neil Werrett confirmed yesterday that the syndicate would more closely consider their stud options for the son of Written Tycoon (Iglesia) after his next start which is set to be in Melbourne.

The Hawkes Racing-trained Ole Kirk is expected to be given his chance to emulate The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice) (2018) and In Top Swing (Beautiful Crown) (2003) in completing the Golden Rose-Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) double rather than be freshened up for a tilt at The Everest (1200m) or Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m).

Werrett on ...

Spring horses to look out for outside Ole Kirk ...

Neil Werrett is one of Australia's biggest owners and he is also a significant breeder. After Ole Kirk's Golden Rose success, he has high hopes for Jen Rules (Redoute's Choice) this spring.

Raced in partnership with Max Whitby, the Peter and Paul Snowden-trained Jen Rules ran third in Saturday's Golden Pendant (Gr 2, 1400m). Werrett has also bought into international Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) contender Nickajack Cave (Kendargent) who is to be trained by Peter Moody.

"I am hoping (Jen Rules) will pick up a really good race and we've got a horse coming out from overseas who I have an interest in called Nickajack Cave, so I am looking forward to him running in the Melbourne Cup," he said.

"It's a really strong lot (of internationals). I'm surprised how strong they are, but they don't run for too much money in the UK and if they can come out here and run for \$7 million, that will certainly get them on that plane."

Werrett, a shareholder in Max Whitby's Everest slot alongside Steve McCann and Ole Kirk's part-owner Colin Madden, admitted the proposition to freshen up Ole Kirk for the \$15 million race on October 17 had been floated but at this stage he had been ruled out as a candidate.

"I think it'd be great to go down there (to Melbourne) as the Guineas is a race that will suit him. He looks to be a top three chance at worst and I would have thought, on current form, you'd have to put him in the top three," Werrett told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday.

"We had discussed The Everest, but unless something dramatically happens between now and Wednesday and the Hawkes' have another rethink, from what they were talking about (on Saturday night) it would be Caulfield Guineas if the horse pulls up well."

Out of Naturale (Bel Esprit), an unraced sister to the Werrett-raced, unbeaten champion sprinter Black Caviar and a half-sister to Vinery Stud stallion All Too Hard (Casino Prince), Ole Kirk was a \$675,000 Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale graduate in 2019.

Written Tycoon, who also sired Friday night's A J Moir Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) winner Pippie, relocated from Woodside Park Stud in Victoria to the Hunter Valley's Arrowfield Stud this year and is developing a reputation as a sire of sires, which has helped fuel interest in Ole Kirk.

Werrett stressed his affiliation with Vinery Stud and Kitchwin Hills would not give the two Hunter farms a headstart on any potential interest they may have in standing Ole Kirk and that a number of factors will be considered once a deal is eventually struck for the colt.

"We've had some very nice inquiries but, to be honest, none of us have spoken much about it because I don't think you want to get too carried away

with stallion deals until after you have kept celebrating for a little bit, so we will probably have a chat later in the week," an elated Werrett explained.

"First of all, you have to be comfortable about where he's going and then the money comes second, to be honest, because you want the horse to be well supported.

"A lot of the studs have already called and asked that if we're going to do anything, can we speak to them first.

"I think we wait until after the Guineas."

Written Tycoon's son Rich Enuff has made a promising start at stud, while Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Capitalist and Group 2-winning sprinter Winning Rupert's first crop two-year-olds are racing this season.

Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Written By's first foals are also being born this year after attracting a quality book of mares at Widden Stud in 2019.

Brett Bradley, who bred last year's Everest winner Yes Yes Yes (Rubick), is also a part-owner of Ole Kirk and he backed up Werrett's comments that connections would not rush into a stud deal with the colt.

"The studs will have their own view on what they're prepared to do and all we can do is just manage the horse and make sure he is in the right races and look after him and whatever offers come, will come," Bradley said.

Werrett, meanwhile, indicated that the Whitby Everest slot would be vying with rivals for the remaining candidates for the race, with Saturday's Premiere Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Randwick and Gilgai Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Flemington to be crucial.

Santa Ana Lane (Lope De Vega), who ran sixth in the 2018 Everest and second last year, looms as a likely target for the remaining slot holders without a horse as does Libertini (I Am Invincible) who will resume in the Premiere.

He said: "We're talking to everyone we can. I think it's a bit up in the air after Saturday. Rothfire, unfortunately for the connections and miRunners went amiss, so they're out looking for another horse now as well.

"I suppose everyone's got about five or six horses in mind and two or three of them are running next Saturday, either in the Gilgai or the Premiere, so if anyone comes out and wins they will be snapped up within 30 seconds."

Werrett also has a share in the Mike Moroney-trained Tofane (Ocean Park) who last week was announced as running in the Yulong Investments slot.

Werrett also remains optimistic that the 2021 Australian yearling sales will remain vibrant despite the wider economic outlook caused by Covid-19.

"We're so lucky that we've got racing continuing through (Covid-19) and that prize-money has had a very little effect and it's a credit to racing administrators that they've been able to keep it going with the governments' support," he said.

On next year's yearling market outlook, he added: "It would only crash if the returns come down. If they decided to halve prize-money or something like that, then it would have to come off. You look at yesterday's prize-money (for the Golden Rose), it's really good.

"It was a million dollars, for a race like that - it's a lot of money. People invest in horses to make money and there's a lot of people who do it very well.

"While prize-money is holding up, I think horse prices will hold up, too."

Rothfire suffers
sesamoid injury

Queensland three-year-old Rothfire (Rothesay) will be sidelined indefinitely after fracturing a sesamoid bone during the running of the Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m). The gelding started as the odds-on favourite in Saturday's Group 1 race but tired quickly over the final stages to finish fourth to Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon). Jockey Jim Byrne dismounted on pulling up, fearing something was amiss, and Rothfire was unsaddled and walked back to the enclosure. A post-race veterinary examination ruled him to be lame but the news was even worse a day later. Trainer Robert Heathcote had him vetted again yesterday and Rothfire was found to have suffered the devastating sesamoid injury. He is out of next month's \$15 million The Everest and will need to spend at least a year on the sidelines to recuperate. Rothfire had been secured for the Everest slot held by miRunners but they will now have to go back to the drawing board. The three-year-old's withdrawal from The Everest means six positions in the race are now vacant.

Nature Strip set for trial

Nature Strip (Nicconi) will attempt to get his Everest (1200m) campaign back on track in a barrier trial at

Rosehill this morning. The ruling favourite for the \$15 million race, Nature Strip reared in the barriers in a Kensington barrier trial last Monday and dislodging jockey James McDonald in the process. As a result, Racing NSW stewards ordered the six-year-old gelding to re-trial before being allowed to race. Runner-up to Gytrash (Lope De Vega) in the Concorde Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) first-up, Nature Strip is expected to line-up in Saturday's Premiere Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) as his final public hit-out before the October 17 Everest at Randwick. Nature Strip is down to trial in heat one (900m) at 8.15am this morning. Gytrash will also trial this morning in heat three over 1030 metres. Ten for Ocean Park

New Zealand stallion Ocean Park (Thorn Park) sired his tenth individual stakes winner when the improving mare High Emocian (4 m ex High Joy by High Chaparral) took out yesterday's R M Ansett Classic (Listed, 2415m) at Mornington. The Ciaran Maher and David Eustace-trained High Emocian won the \$140,000 Listed race by four and a half lengths over Tavirun (Tavistock) while Eureka Street (Street Cry) was a neck away in third. A winner of four of her past five starts, High Emocian was an NZ\$80,000 purchase from the Wentwood Grange draft by Darren Weir and agent John Foote. "That was fantastic, she's an amazing little filly, she's very brave," Eustace said post-race. "It was the plan to come here and win a stakes race with her being a mare. She's a genuine stayer, so a Sandown Cup would have to be a consideration for her, or a staying race over the carnival at Flemington." Ocean Park stands at Waikato Stud for a fee of NZ\$20,000 (plus GST).

Boss booked for Funstar

Glen Boss will be attempting to win his second

Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) in as many years after being booked to ride the Chris Waller-trained Funstar (Adelaide) in Saturday's Randwick mile. Boss also combined with Waller to land last year's Epsom on Kolding (Ocean Park) and he will replace James McDonald on Funstar, who has been handicapped with 52.5 kilograms. Boss galloped Funstar at Rosehill on Saturday morning.

Zahra on Verry Elleegant

Mark Zahra will ride Verry Elleegant (Zed) when the leading cups contender returns to Melbourne for Saturday's Turnbull Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Flemington. The five-year-old mare has not raced in Victoria since finishing unplaced in last year's Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) and is reportedly being set for the Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) and Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) this year. Trained by Chris Waller, Verry Elleegant won the Winx Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) first-up before finishing fourth in the George Main Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) on September 19. Zahra replaces James McDonald who rides at Randwick on Saturday.

Bowman to make
Melbourne home

Hugh Bowman will maintain his association with Group 1 winner King's Legacy (Redoute's Choice) when the colt heads to Melbourne, leading the Sydney jockey to forgo the lucrative Everest carnival. Bowman intends to arrive in Melbourne in time to complete five days of quarantine prior to the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) on Saturday week. The Peter and Paul Snowden-trained King's Legacy, a winner of the Inglis Sires (registered as ATC Sires' Produce Stakes) (Gr 1, 1400m) and the ATC Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m), ran third in the Golden Rose at the weekend. Bowman will also ride Aidan O'Brien's Anthony Van Dyck (Galileo) in the Caulfield Cup.

Toorak option for Buffalo River

Buffalo River (Noble Mission) could target the Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) after finishing second to Windstorm (Redoute's Choice) in the 1400-metre handicap at Caulfield on Saturday. The five-year-old was made the \$2.70 favourite for his first-up run and finished half a length behind the winner, but trainer Mike Moroney was pleased with what he saw. "We were really happy with him, he obviously had to be used up the hill from the wide draw once he was slow away, and Morrissy softened him up quite early around the home bend, so he was brave," Moroney told Racing.com. "We'll reassess what we do with him now, he's certainly a chance of heading to the Group 1 Toorak Handicap in two weeks."

Prague suffers thumps

Dual Group 3 winner Prague (Redoute's Choice) appears to have excuses for his disappointing run in the Caulfield Guineas Prelude (Gr 3, 1400m) on Saturday after vets reported the three-year-old was showing signs of colic after finishing a below-par eighth at Caulfield, according to co-trainer David Eustace. "We had our vets look at him back at the stables and maybe not so much colicky, but he was definitely slow to recover," Eustace told Racing.com. "He had the thumps and his heart rate was quite high and it took some time to get back to normal. So there were certainly vet excuses there."

Night Raid to press on to Thousand Guineas

Night Raid (Vancouver) will still be heading to the Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) after finishing fourth in the race's Prelude (Gr 2, 1400m) at Caulfield on Saturday, her co-trainer Mick Price confirmed. Night Raid, who won the Atlantic Jewel Stakes (Listed, 1200m) last time out, was the \$3.70 second-favourite and finished one and a quarter lengths behind the well-fancied Instant Celebrity (Not A Single Doubt). "I think the mid-race sectionals were just too strong for her leading, we'll be persevering to the Group 1 Thousand Guineas and riding a more conservative race with the idea it will help her get the trip," Price told Racing.com. "She's been set to peak there this preparation and if we get a softer run, she's capable."

Oliver compares Russian Camelot to Schillaci

On Saturday, Danny O'Brien claimed Underwood Stakes (Gr 1, 1800m) winner Russian Camelot (Camelot) was the best horse he had trained and yesterday the four-year-old entire's regular jockey Damien Oliver compared the horse to star sprinter Schillaci (Salieri). Oliver rode Schillaci at just his third start when winning a three-year-old race at Sandown in November 1991 and the Lee Freedman-trained sprinter would go on to win eight races at Group 1 level. "I haven't ridden a horse other than Schillaci that's gone to such a high level so early in his career," Oliver told Racing.com. "I rode this horse for the first time in a jumpout at Flemington about a little over 12 months ago. He did give me the feel that this horse could be something above average. I went to Ballarat on a Friday to ride him in a maiden and he did something that horses don't usually do in their first start."

Fabergino to stay in Melbourne

Fabergino (Maschino) will remain in Victoria following Friday night's below-par effort in the Moir Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m), according to trainer Tiarnna Robertson. Fabergino was made the \$5.50 favourite following her Northam Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) victory in May but never threatened the leaders, with a slow start ruining her chances of getting involved. "The moment she stepped slow, her race was over," Robertson told Racing.com. "It was obviously disappointing, but we'll move on from that and look towards the next race. She's really bright in herself and it's like she just had a track gallop. We'll hope the sun shines in Melbourne moving forward and aim to start her in the Group 2 Caulfield Sprint (1000m) on October 17." With Peter Knuckey seeking exemption to get back into Western Australia, a jockey change is likely to take place for her next outing. Jordan Childs, who won on Fabergino in the Bob Hoysted Handicap (Listed, 1000m) in February, could be set to regain the mount.

Sin Sin Sin heading to Snitzel

The dam of 2019 Everest (1200m) winner Yes Yes Yes (Rubick), Fantastic Light (Rahy) mare Sin Sin Sin, will be covered by champion stallion Snitzel

(Redoute's Choice) this year. Breeder Brett Bradley, who enjoyed success in the Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) with Ole Kirk (Written Tycoon) on Saturday, confirmed the 15-year-old mare would head to Arrowfield Stud to be served in the next week. She had a colt by Zoustar (Northern Meteor) on September 9. Bradley's Arlington Park Racing is also sending two mares to Yes Yes Yes in his first season at Coolmore this year.

Lucas Cranach dies in freak accident

Leneva Park's new stallion Lucas Cranach (Mamool) died after a freak accident on Saturday. Mick Sharkie, a part-owner of the Australian Bloodstock-raced dual Group 2 winner, orchestrated Lucas Cranach's relocation to the Euroa property earlier this year and reported the 14-year-old's death yesterday. Lucas Cranach raced just three times in Australia, finishing third in the 2011 Melbourne Cup and taking out the 2012 Peter Young Stakes (Gr 2, 1800m). He started his stud career at Bullarook Park Stud in 2013 at Avenel and has sired 44 winners to date.

Thoroughbreds Are Go back on Sky

Tonight sees the return of Australia's only thoroughbred rehoming and retraining program, Thoroughbreds Are Go, at 7.30pm on Sky Thoroughbred Central. The series aims to assist racing's owners and breeders know the best ways to find a new home for their thoroughbred away from racing. It also encourages the equestrian world to take on this fabulous, athletic breed and gives advice on the best care to give them in their new homes. The first episode of series two includes a beautiful and inspiring story on the Riding For Disabled organisation at Richmond on the outskirts of Sydney and how the thoroughbred's sensitivity makes it the perfect horse for the job. The other feature focuses on Godolphin's Lifetime Care and how the early handling of thoroughbred foals, bred to be racehorses, gives them the best chance of being a productive and willing horse in a variety of disciplines for the whole of their lives. A new segment The Thoroughbred Guru contains training tips for off track thoroughbreds from one of Australia's leading thoroughbred retrainers, Scott Brodie.

NEW ZEALAND

James happy with Concert Hall and London Banker

Cambridge trainer Roger James got what he was looking for at Ellerslie on Saturday when progressive stayers Concert Hall (Savabeel) and London Banker (Tavistock) performed with distinction in their first-up assignments. Manawatu Cup (Gr 3, 2300m) winner Concert Hall stormed home late to push eventual winner Dawn Patrol (Dawn Approach) close in an open 1400-metre event while lightly raced five-year-old London Banker finished close up in third behind longshot winner Lord Sibford (Darci Brahma) over 1600 metres. James, who prepares the pair with training partner Robert Wellwood, was keen to see how both runners would measure up as he looks toward the staying features later this year. London Banker burst on the scene last summer with three consecutive victories to close out his first full campaign and had looked ready to return off the back of a runner-up finish over 1200 metres at the Te Teko trials in August. "It was no real surprise that he ran a good race as he is very capable at a mile," James said. "It was very pleasing as he has a big preparation ahead of him. I've always thought he would make into this sort of horse as I've felt he is typical of the classic, old fashioned kiwi-bred stayer that takes a bit of time. He reminds me so much of the type of horse that trainers like Jim Gibbs and Dave O'Sullivan did so well with."

High hopes for Super Strike

Progressive four-year-old Super Strike (Super Easy) reminded racing pundits of his undoubted ability when he produced a powerful finish to score first up over 1200 metres at Ellerslie on Saturday. The gelding had been off the scene

since sustaining a muscle injury when running second at the venue back in December last year. Trainer Richard Collett took a patient approach with the Janet Hepi-bred-and-owned four-year-old who has taken time to grow into his imposing frame. Two handy trial outings at Ruakaka sharpened him up for his race day reappearance and he looked every inch a galloper going places as he easily lumped topweight of 59.5 kilograms to victory in the hands of Collett's son-in-law Andrew Calder. "Andrew was very complimentary of the run and the way the track played as he is a horse that needs good ground," Collett said. "(Super Strike) did a good job and I actually didn't realise that they ran 1.09.44 until I got home and watched the replay so I thought geez it's been a big effort to come from where he did to win. He just took a while to find clear air and had to come between a couple to make his run but he was very strong to the line."

McKay fractures collarbone

Jockey Shaun McKay will undergo further tests at Waikato Hospital to determine whether he needs a plate inserted in his shoulder to assist the healing process for the collarbone he broke in a nasty fall at Ellerslie on Saturday. McKay was riding the well-favoured Blood Warrior (Makfi) in the last race of the day when his charge crashed heavily to the turf on the home bend after clipping the heels of Manrico (Shocking), who was being angled into the clear by rider Jasmine Fawcett when insufficiently clear of McKay's mount. Thankfully, McKay was thrown clear of Blood Warrior but knew instantly something was wrong as he tried to make his way to his feet. "It happened pretty quickly but I knew something was wrong with my shoulder the minute I hit the ground," McKay said. "Watching the replay, it looks like the horse that interfered with us has swept his feet out from underneath him (Blood Warrior) and luckily I got thrown to the side away from him. I knew it was that serious and I did manage to sit up to let people know I was OK, which is something we get taught."

ASIA

160 for Deep Impact

Tomokazu Takano-trained five-year-old Centelleo (5 h ex Admire Kirameki by End Sweep)

landed the Sankei Sho All Comers (Gr 2, 2200m) at Nakayama yesterday and became the 160th individual stakes winner for his late sire Deep Impact (Sunday Silence). The entire got up by a nose from Curren Bouquetd'or (Deep Impact) while there was a further length and a quarter back to Stay Foolish (Stay Gold) in third. Centelleo was recording his fifth win from 16 starts, while he also ran fourth in the Queen Elizabeth II Cup (Gr 1, 2200m) at Kyoto last November and ran second in the Mermaid Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) at Hanshin on his last outing.

Contrail remains unbeaten at Chukyo

Three-time Group 1 winner Contrail remained unbeaten in the Kobe Shimbun Hai (Gr 2, 2200m) at Chukyo yesterday and provided Deep Impact a Group race double on the day. The Yoshito Yahagi-trained colt is now six from six, inducing victories in the Hopeful Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m), Satsuki Sho (Gr 1, 2000m) and Tokyo Yushun (Gr 1, 2400m), as well as a maiden win and success in the Hai Nisai Stakes (Gr 3, 1800m). Sent off as favourite he was an easy two length winner over Weltreisende (Dream Journey), while Robertson Quay (Rulership) a neck away in third.

INTERNATIONAL

Allen and McEvoy booked for Coolmore cup rides

Aidan O'Brien has secured the services of John Allen to ride Santiago (Authorized) in the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) and Kerrin McEvoy for Tiger Moth (Galileo). Irish Derby winner (Gr 1, 1m4f) winner Santiago is \$15 in Sportsbet's early markets. Tiger Moth, who earned a 2.5kg penalty for his recent win in the Kilternan Stakes (Gr 3, 1m4f) is currently \$11. Other key bookings include Ben Melham on Armory (Galileo) and Mark Zahra on Magic Wand (Galileo) for the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m). Hugh Bowman will be on King's Legacy (Redoute's Choice) in the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and Anthony Van Dyck (Galileo) for the Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m), while Damien Oliver has been booked for Personal (Fastnet Rock) in the Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m).

329 for Galileo

Stepping up to two miles for the first time, the Aidan O'Brien-trained Dawn Patrol (3 c ex Gwynn by Darshaan) claimed a first stakes victory in the Loughbrown Stakes (Gr 3, 2m) at the Curragh yesterday and became the 329th individual stakes winner for his sire Galileo (Sadler's Wells). He ran second to Tiger Moth in a Leopardstown maiden on his second start and was third to Santiago in the Irish Derby (Gr 1, 1m4f) before breaking his maiden at Naas in July. He then finished third in the Vinnie Roe (Listed, 1m6f) stakes and ran down the field in the St Leger (Gr 1, 1m6.5f) on his last start. He was held up yesterday by Seamie Heffernan, got a gap down the rail entering the final furlong and broke through to lead before seeing off Barrington Court (Mastercraftsman) by three quarters of a length.

Two for Belardo

Elysium (2 f ex Sonning Rose by Hawk Wing) sprung a surprise in the Weld Park Stakes (Gr 3, 7f) at the Curragh yesterday when the Noel Meade-trained juvenile ran out an impressive winner at 12/1 and became the second individual stakes winner for Darley first season sire Belardo (Lope De Vega). Held up at the rear by Billy Lee, she was switched left two furlongs out and came home strongly to win by a length and a half from Jim Bolger's Aunty Bridy (Camacho) while the Joseph O'Brien-trained Thinking Of You (American Pharoah) was three-quarters of a length third and the favourite No Speak Alexander (Shalaa) was a close fourth. Elysium broke her maiden over five and a half furlongs on her second start at Navan in June and has been placed twice since. She is out of the Chesham Stakes (Listed, 7f) runner-up Sonning Rose (Hawk Wing) and was purchased by her trainer as a yearling for €15,000. Haunui Farm shuttler Belardo is also responsible for dual Group winner Isabella Giles and stands this season for \$10,000 (+GST).

Stakes success for Lady Of Harrods' son

Bargain buy Omaha City (Temple City), who was purchased for US\$5,500 at Keeneland last September, has rewarded owner/trainer Mohamed Jehaludi with a stakes success in Saturday's Hollywood Beach Stakes (Listed, 5f)

at Gulfstream Park. He is a son of dual Group 3 winner Lady Of Harrods (Dubawi), whom Spendthrift Farm dished out \$400,000 for at the Magic Millions Broodmare Sale in 2016. Although they did not get a return for Omaha City in the ring there looks to be better days to come. The colt beat Big Daddy Dave (Khozan) by one and a quarter lengths with Hall Rich Legacy (Field Commission) three-quarters of a length back in third.

13 for Shalaa

Cutie (2 f ex Sky Colours by Galileo) was a debut winner at Jagersro in Sweden yesterday for Bodil Hallencreutz and she became the 13th individual winner from the first crop of Al Shaqab shuttler Shalaa (Invincible Spirit). Cutie won by a length from Chatarina (Lawman) while Whitestrip (Outstrip) was third. Shalaa is responsible for No Speak Alexander and Legal Attack who have both been stakes placed in Europe and he stands at Arrowfield Stud this season for a fee of \$33,000 (inc GST).

First for Joshua Tree

Top Max (Joshua Tree) justified favoritism and gained a first stakes success in yesterday's Grand Prix de la Region (Listed, 2100m) at Strasbourg. The Henri-Alex Pantall-trained four-year-old had been knocking on the door with placings in stakes races on his last three starts and became the first stakes winner for his sire Joshua Tree (Montjeu). Top Max took the honours by two and a half lengths from Gourmet (Dunkerque) while there was half a length back to Dato (Mount Nelson) in third. Royal Lodge (Gr 2, 1m) and three-time Canadian International (Gr 1, 1m4f) winner Joshua Tree started his stud career in 2015 at Haras du Grand Courgeon and has stood at Kilbarry Lodge Stud in Ireland since 2019 where his fee this year was €3,000.

18 for Lord Of England

Placed in all previous starts, Peaches (2 f ex Peace Of Glory by Sholokov) broke her maiden on her fourth start in the Winterkonigin Trial (Listed, 1500m) at Cologne yesterday, when stepping up to stakes company for the first time, and became the 18th individual black type winner for her sire Lord Of England (Dashing Blade). The Andreas Suborics-trained

two-year-old charged up the rail in the closing stages to beat Amazing Grace (Protectionist) while Kaliyah (Charm Spirit) stayed on for third. Lord Of England stands at Gestut Etzean where his 2020 fee was €6,500.

Four for Planteur

Road To Arc (3 c ex First Choice by Exit to Nowhere) won the Premio Conte Felice Scheibler (Listed, 2000m) at Rome yesterday and became the fourth individual stakes winner for his sire Planteur (Danehill Dancer). Aldrodovar (Lord Chaparral) finished second with Presidential Sweet (Golden Horn) in third. Planteur, who scored his Group 1 in the Prix Ganay (Gr 1, 2100m), stands at Haras du Grand Courgeon for a fee of €2,500 (approx. AUD\$4,000).

First for Dialed In

Get Her Number (2 c ex Fancier by Bernstein) provided his sire Dialed In (Mineshaft) with a first Grade 1 winner after claiming the American Pharoah Stakes (Gr 1, 8.5f) at Santa Anita yesterday. The switch to dirt proved key after two efforts on turf, with Get Her Number now given an automatic berth into the Breeders' Cup Juvenile (Gr 1, 8.5f) in November. Get Her Number defeated Rombauer by three-quarters of a length, with favourite Spielberg four and three-quarter lengths adrift in third. Dialed In, the sire of Breeders Cup Classic runner-up Gunnevera, stands at Darby Dan Farm in Kentucky, where he stood for a fee of US\$20,000 (approx. AUD\$28,500).

Two for Mucho Macho Man

After twice placing in Grade 1 company, Mucho Unusual (4 m ex Not Unusual by Unusual Heat) struck at the elite level for the first time after victory in the Rodeo Drive Stakes (Gr 1, 10f) at Santa Anita on Saturday evening, providing her sire Mucho Macho Man (Macho Uno) with a second Group/Grade 1 winner. Mucho Unusual defeated Maxim Rate (Exchange Rate) by one and a quarter lengths with Lady Prancelot (Sir Prancelot) third. With victory, the George Krikorian homebred secured her place in the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare in November. Mucho Macho Man, also the sire of three-time Grade 1 winner Mucho Gusto, stands at Adena Springs for US\$10,000 (approx. AU\$14,250).

18 for Distorted Humor

Painting (4 m ex Hand Painted by AP Indy) became the 18th individual Group/Graded winner for her sire Distorted Humor (Forty Niner), after winning the Ontario Fashion Stakes (Gr 3, 6f) at Woodbine on Saturday evening. Painting defeated by a neck the former Lindsay Park-trained mare Victory Kingdom (Animal Kingdom), who was second in the Kewney Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Flemington in 2019, while Sav (Big Screen) was a distant third. Now a 27-year-old, Distorted Humor stands for US\$50,000 (approx. AUD\$70,000) at WinStar Farm.

US: Princess Noor dominant in Chandelier

Zedan Racing Stables' Princess Noor (Not This Time) soared to an eight-and-a-quarter-length romp in the Chandelier Stakes (Gr 2, 8.5f) at Santa Anita on Saturday evening. Already a winner at Grade 1 level in the Del Mar Debutante Stakes (Gr 1, 7f), the two-year-old filly cemented her position at the top of the market for the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies with a commanding victory. The daughter of Not This Time (Giant's Causeway) remained unbeaten, with jockey Victor Espinoza commenting after the race: "She reminds me of other great horses I used to ride like American Pharoah and California Chrome."

US: Improbable downs Maximum Security

Victory for Improbable (City Zip) was anything but, as the four-year-old crushed hot favourite Maximum Security (New Year's Day) by four and a half lengths to win the Awesome Again Stakes (Gr 1, 9f) at Santa Anita yesterday. The win marked a fourth win at the highest level for the son of City Zip (Carson City), and third in succession, elevating the China Horse Club and WinStar Farm-owned Improbable to favouritism for the Breeders' Cup Classic (Gr 1, 10f) in November.

US: United runs them ragged

United (Giant's Causeway) led from start to finish to claim the John Henry Turf Championship Stakes (Gr 2, 10f) at Santa Anita yesterday. The five-year-old warmed up for a tilt at the Breeders' Cup Turf (Gr 1, 12f) with a one-and-a-half-length victory over Originaire (Zoffany), leading trainer Richard Mandella to comment that they'll 'blow their tyres off' in the showpiece event at Keeneland in November. This was a fourth win at Grade 2 level for the gelding, who finished second in last year's Breeders' Cup Turf at Santa Anita.

US: British import Viadara lands first Graded success

Juddmonte-owned mare Viadara (Bated Breath) scored a first Group/Graded success

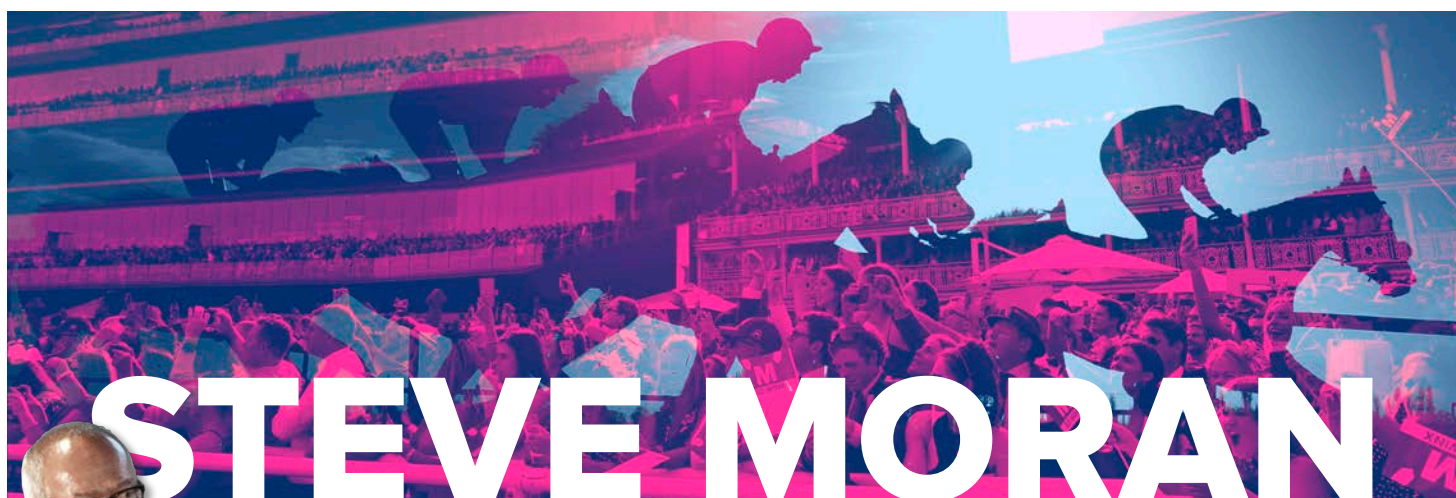
of her career, and a first success at stakes level in North America after she claimed the Noble Damsel Stakes (Gr 3, 8f) at Belmont on Saturday evening. Viadara beat Blowout (Dansili) by a neck, with Sweet Bye And Bye (Sky Mesa) in third. A Listed winner in Ireland, Viadara is a half-sister to Listed winner Crossed Baton.

US: Firenze Fire secures fourth Breeders Cup berth

Firenze Fire (Poseidon's Warrior) secured a fourth start at the Breeders' Cup meeting with victory in the Vosburgh Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) at Belmont on Saturday evening. Twice a runner up at Grade 1 level, Firenze Fire will contest the Breeders' Cup Sprint (Gr 1, 6f) next month, having finished fifth in the race last year and fourth in the Breeders' Cup Mile (Gr 1, 8f) in 2018. Firenze Fire defeated Funny Guy (Big Brown) by two and three-quarter lengths with Share The Ride (Candy Ride) in third.

US: Mr Money back to form

The Ack Ack Stakes (Gr 3, 8f) at Churchill Downs saw a return to form for Mr Money (Goldencents) who defeated Bourbon Calling (Dialed In) by one and a quarter lengths. A Grade 1 runner up in September last year after landing the West Virginia Derby (Gr 3, 9f), Mr Money finished down the track in the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile (Gr 1, 8f) at Santa Anita in November.

December bound Golden Sixty takes the Group 3 Celebration Cup

Golden Sixty (Medgalia d'Oro) took the first step on his path toward the 2020 Longines Hong Kong International Races with an impressive win in the Celebration Cup Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) at Sha Tin yesterday, thwarting Beauty Generation's (Road To Rock) tilt at a fourth straight triumph in the race.

Hong Kong's first Pattern race this season was billed as the clash between Beauty Generation and Golden Sixty and it did not disappoint, with the latter reigning supreme for trainer Francis Lui and jockey Vincent Ho.

"I think at the moment he is the best horse that I have trained – he'll step up in distance to 1600 metres now and then of course the target is the Hong Kong International Races," Lui said.

The Medaglia d'Oro (El Prado) gelding made the most of the 17 pounds he received off the two-time Horse of the Year, Beauty Generation (133lb), who finished a dead-heat second alongside Champion's Way (Hinchinbrook) by one and three quarter lengths.

"It's very exciting to be back on him (Golden Sixty), he felt great and fresh today – once I got a clear run I knew he'd run them down," Ho said. "I think he is one of the best horses in Hong Kong at the moment."

With his devastating turn-of-foot on display once again, the newly turned five-year-old made it eight wins in a row, following on from his Four-Year-Old Classic Series clean sweep which culminated with Derby glory.

After breaking cleanly Golden Sixty was snagged back to settle worse than midfield while Beauty Generation, under the guidance of Zac Purton, would stalk the leading duo on the rail.

As the field turned for home; Golden Sixty quickened when asked, while Beauty Generation hit traffic and had to bullock his way clear to share second prize.

"He pulled up well, it was a good blow for

him – he needed that, I think he was around 70 to 75 percent fit before this run and after this he should go up even more, of course with the aim of December," Ho said.

Trainer David Hayes spoke of Beauty Generation's performance post-race: "We knew it was always going to be a big ask to give a young champion like Golden Sixty so much weight but I thought Beauty Generation would have finished a clear second with a better run and I'm very happy with the way he went," he said.

"The big handicap at a mile is obviously an option but, as I said before the race today, he's going to be at his very best when the big set weights races come around in November and December," Hayes said in reference to a possible next run in Oriental Watch Sha Tin Trophy Handicap (Gr 2, 1600m) on October 18.

But it was not altogether smooth sailing for the winning camp, as Lui spoke of his concerns pre-race as his stable star danced and buzzed around the parade ring before the race.

"I was worried about him before the race in the parade ring because he was so excited but in the race he was under control," Lui said.

The December riches on offer for Golden Sixty are the HK\$25 million Hong Kong Mile or the HK\$28 million Hong Kong Cup, should Lui opt to step up to the Derby distance of 2000 metres again.

"He looks like he is more mature – at the moment his best is between 1600 metres and 2000 metres," Lui said.

Before his end-of-year aspirations, the Australian-bred could next target the Oriental Watch Sha Tin Trophy Handicap (Gr 2, 1600m) which may see a rematch with Beauty Generation, who has won two of the past three editions of the HK\$4.5 million contest.

Earlier on the fixture, Ho also won on the Jimmy Ting-trained Go Goal Toby (Pins) who scored a maiden success in the Class 4 Swallow Handicap (1400m), surprising at odds of 37/1.

Teetan takes three

Karis Teetan continued his strong start to the 2020/21 racing season with a winning treble which was completed with victory aboard impressive juvenile, Lucky Express (Toronado) in the Class 2 Hwamei Handicap (1200m).

Although winless at the two previous meetings, Teetan had already bagged eight wins and yesterday added three more to skip into second on the jockeys' premiership table.

"You never know coming into the day – I thought I had ok rides but it's nice after two meetings blank to bounce back with a treble – especially on some nice horses," Teetan said.

Teetan wrapped up his three-timer with a barnstorming victory aboard Lucky Express, the gelding rattling over the top to score by three quarters of a length but Teetan did not expect to have a ride in the race, let alone partner the winner.

"I had no ride in the race so when Mr Size sent me a message, I confirmed it straight away," Teetan said, "the way he was running last season he looked like he was going to get better and I appreciate Mr Size's support – it's nice to sit on a horse like that."

The Australian-bred arrived in Hong Kong with two wins from three starts in Australia, amassing an eye-catching AU\$681,250 in the process (approx. HK\$3.8 million), when previously known as Prince Of Sussex.

Teetan kicked off his treble with victory aboard California Concord (Fastnet Rock) in the Class 3 Magpie Handicap (1200m, dirt).

"I thought from the wide gate we had to work all-the-way because the way the track was playing; any other horse caught four-wide would have thrown the towel in but he kept on fighting nicely," Teetan said of the Tony Cruz-trained galloper.

Teetan grabbed his second win of the day aboard Big Fortune (Moshe) in the Class 3 Lark Handicap (1200m) for trainer Douglas Whyte.

Trainer Tony Millard further improved his already excellent record with acquisitions from other stables when Galactic (Deep Field) took the Class 4 Shrike Handicap (1200m) under Antoine Hamelin.

"He's a very nice horse, he just lacked a bit of confidence and he just needed a bit of time," Millard said.

The handler and jockey combined for the second time this season following the success of Prince Of Gems (I Am Invincible) at the season-opening fixture, also a stable transfer.

"He's a big lanky type of horse and with those type of horses you have to be careful you don't get them too fat but as long as their muscle to weight ratio is good then you have a chance," Millard said.

Earlier on the program, apprentice Matthew Poon got off the mark for the new season with victory for his master, David Hall aboard Charge On (Rios) in the Class 4 Swallow Handicap (1400m).

"It was close, I think he isn't 100 per cent fit – he got tired at the end but he finished off really well and managed to hold on," Poon said, "the good draw helped him a lot – he's still young so he can keep improving. I believe he has plenty of ability."

Bella Baby (Havana Gold) grabbed the opener for Neil Callan and Chris So, the Class 5 Tailorbird Handicap; while Hong Kong's champion jockey Zac Purton took the second of the Class 5 contests, the Woodpecker Handicap (1400m), aboard Super Winner (Guillotine) for Dennis Yip.

Trainer Richard Gibson notched his third win this season as he took the first dirt race on the card, the Class 4 Sunbird Handicap (1200m) thanks to a well-judged front-running ride from apprentice Jerry Chau aboard Blotting Paper (Uncle Mo), who sports silks made famous by 2012 W.S Cox Plate winner Ocean Park (Thorn Park).

Hong Kong racing continues at Sha Tin on Thursday (October 1) and features the National Day Cup (Gr 3, 1000m).

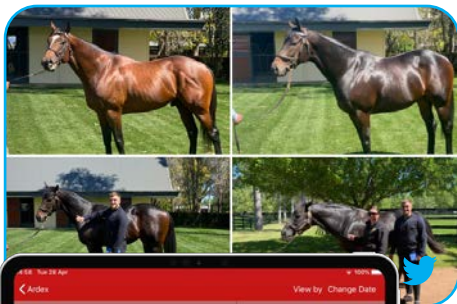
