Moody makes play for \$500,000 Exceed And Excel filly

Savabeel colt also fetches six-figure sum as vibrant Book 1 sale at Karaka comes to a close



Lot 614: Exceed And Excel - Gallwitz filly

Two \$500,000 lots have brought the curtain down on what investors on both sides of the fence deemed to be a successful three-day Book 1 New Zealand Bloodstock Karaka Yearling Sale.

The Exceed And Excel (Danehill) filly and a Savabeel (Zabeel) colt rounded out the session, which followed on from a Pierro (Lonhro) colt

making \$900,000 and another son of Savabeel fetching \$875,000 earlier in the week to take top honours.

Melbourne-based Peter Moody, who has signalled his intent to reapply for his trainer's licence in the near future, was the one to sign for the first of the session-topping horses to go through the ring yesterday, securing the daughter of Exceed And Excel for Ron and Judy Wanless.

The prominent Queensland-based owners have been long-time supporters of Moody, providing him with 2001 Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Amalfi (Carnegie), the trainer's first of 56 victories at the highest level.

"She's a lovely filly who had great quality about her," Moody said.

"Trelawney Stud is an unbelievable nursery and a farm that I've had a lot of success with personally and with clients of mine as well.

"She is just a bloody nice filly with good quality.

"She's got to make her own pedigree as she is a little bit light in the first dam, but she looks like she has the quality to do it.

"You know the family is going to be bred up around her as Trelawney are such great breeders, but let's hope she can stamp her own authority without worrying about family members carrying the flag for her."

The filly is the second foal out of the unraced mare Gallwitz (Bernardini), who is a half-sister to joint top Australasian three-year-old of 2010-11, the dual Group 3 winner and Group 1-placed Retrieve (Rahy), as well as stakes winners Reparations (Exceed And Excel) and Abduction (Street Cry). Her second dam, Hold To Ransom (Red Ransom), was also successful in obtaining black-type, scoring in a Listed race at Royal Ascot. She was catalogued as **Lot 614**.

Moody confirmed on Saturday that he intends to reapply for his trainer's licence after a four-year absence from the Victorian ranks, but yesterday stopped short of saying whether he would prepare his latest acquisition.

"We'll have a chat about that later as there's no reason to rush into that as I'm not even a licensed racehorse trainer at the moment," he said.

"There wouldn't be a licensed trainer in the land that wouldn't like to see that filly walk through their gate."

The filly continued a stellar sale for vendor Trelawney Stud, who sold 11 yearlings at the Book 1 auction to be the leading consignor by average at \$314,545.

Gallwitz was purchased by agent Bruce Perry at the 2017 Magic Millions Gold Coast National Broodmare Sale for AU\$320,000.

"I bought the mare from Darley when she was in foal to Medaglia d'Oro," Trelawney Stud's Brent Taylor said.

"I loved the family but I had one or two doubts about Bernadini. However, I have since been 'put right' by a few people. His mares have produced something like ten Group winners.

"I planned the mating with Exceed And Excel and she is a truly beautiful filly. The mare has a filly foal at foot by Savabeel and is back in foal to him."

Taylor added: "Our staff have been fantastic and I am very proud of them because we have had an outstanding sale. I'm not sure if it is a record, but an outstanding sale."

New client to race Savabeel colt with Te Akau

Te Akau's David Ellis admitted on Monday that he was used to buying "everything on spec" and then on-selling the yearlings to current and new owners, but yesterday's \$500,000 equal session-topping Savabeel colt already has an owner lined up.

"I bought him for a brand new client of Te Akau's who wanted a really nice colt," Ellis said.

"We trained a full-sister to the colt that we won the Matamata Breeders' Stakes with, Gold Fever.

"She was a real two-year-old and I thought this colt was very precocious from a precocious family and he will race in the tangerine.

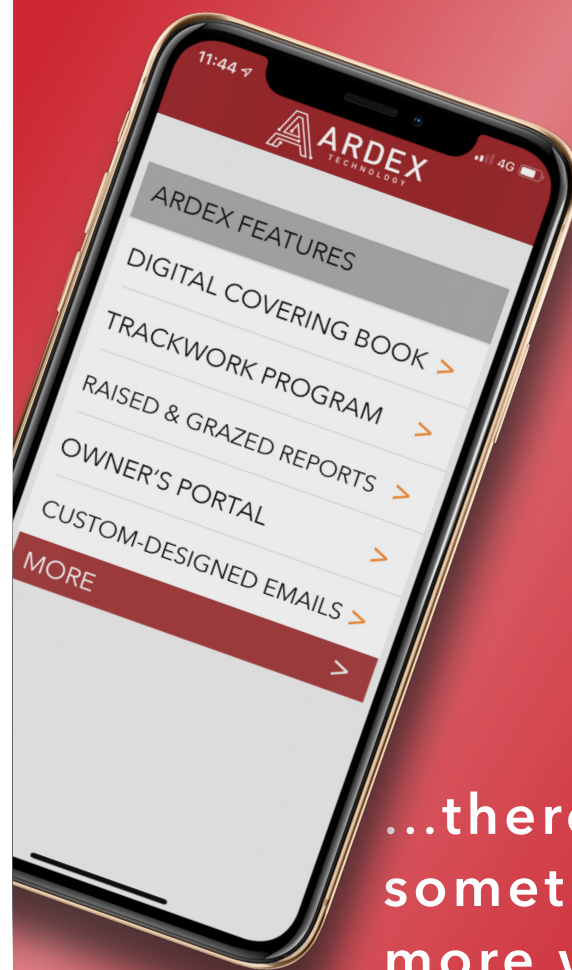
"It is a nick with Savabeel that has been really successful."

The Waikato Stud-consigned colt, who was catalogued as **Lot 626**, is a son of blue hen and Group 2 winner Gold Rocks (Oratorio), who has already produced three stakes winners from four foals to race.

They include Gold Fever (Savabeel), the Lance O'Sullivan-trained Gold Rush (So You Think) and ATC Gimcrack Stakes (Listed, 1000m) winner Calaverite (Lonhro).

The sale of the Savabeel colt capped a strong auction for Waikato Stud and owner Mark Chittick, whose operation claimed the leading vendor title (by aggregate) for the eighth year in succession.

Chittick paid tribute to his staff by leading the last Waikato Stud-consigned yearling through the ring, a Sacred Falls (O'Reilly) filly, who made \$32,500.

"It's all over for another year although the work starts again tomorrow," Chittick said.

"We've had a good, steady sale and I'm really proud of the homes these horses have found and they will get every opportunity from now on.

"At the end of the day, my leading that last lot through is a salute to my team who have worked so hard all the way through these horses lives, and especially in the last week or ten days."

Waikato Stud's draft has been underpinned by their champion stallion Savabeel, but Chittick also took satisfaction from the way the progeny of the farm's first season sire Tivaci (High Chaparral) was received by the market.

"We've known all along that we've had really good types (by Tivaci) but we weren't making too much noise about it," he said.

"These guys (buyers) are the ones looking at them and they are the experts. They've sold really well and once again, gone to very good homes and will get every chance.

"I'm delighted to see those who have supported Tivaci do so well as when you secure a stallion like this it's a pretty big job.

"Trelawney Stud, who sold one for \$500,000 and another for \$300,000, are amongst a bunch of really good supporters. For them to breed two such lovely horses and get those results is really satisfying."

Coolmore Australia's US Triple Crown-winning shuttler American Pharoah (Pioneerof The Nile) was the leading first season sire by average, with six lots selling at \$265,833 apiece.



New Zealand's Rich Hill Stud resident Vadamus (Monsun) was the leading local first season sire, with 21 yearlings selling at an average of \$125,714.

Blueblood Snitzel filly makes \$450,000

Earlier in the day, a filly from one of New Zealand's best families by Australia's champion sire Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) will remain in her home country after agent Phill Cataldo received an unexpected call to buy the valuable yearling on behalf of a new client.

The star filly hails from the family of stallions Darci Brahma (Danehill) and Burgundy (Redoute's Choice) and she realised \$460,000.

"She will stay in New Zealand for a new client of mine," Cataldo said.

"They just rang out of the blue yesterday because they loved her pedigree.

"She is a lovely type and she vetted well and I would like to think we got her slightly under the odds, but I may have gone another bid or so as that is the beauty of the auction system."

Bred and consigned by Sir Peter Vela's Pencarrow Stud, the filly is the first foal out of the four-time winning, stakes-placed Encosta De Lago (Fairy King) mare Echezeaux, who is a half-sister to Darci Brahma and Burgundy and the stakes-placed Saperavi (Stravinsky).

Her second dam is the champion mare Grand Echezeaux (Zabeel), the 2000 Australasian Oaks (Gr 1, 2000m) winner who became a top-producing broodmare. She was catalogued as **Lot 565**.

Cataldo also revealed the new owner of the filly would take a long-term approach with her racing career.

"The plan would be to breed and race her, definitely. He has his own farm so she will go back there and give her a couple of months and then think about breaking her in," he said.

"She doesn't strike me as an early two-year-old. It sounded like he wanted to produce her as a late two-year-old, which is when the best racing is on, so I think we will just stick to that plan.

"It is so hard to buy into this family, especially being by Snitzel - that's a real bonus."

Pencarrow Stud's Leon Casey said the filly met her reserve and that Sir Peter was excited by what was to come from the immediate family.

"We bred and raced the mare and she had some ability. She is a good size and the filly was a good size when she was born," Casey said.

"Because Danehill and Redoute's Choice crossed well with the family we thought Snitzel would be a good way to continue.

"We sent Echezeaux to U S Navy Flag this year and she has a colt by Tavistock at foot."

Boys Get Paid...again

Little Avondale's Savabeel (Zabeel) colt appeared to be a syndicator's dream before he entered the sales ring mid-afternoon and so it proved, with Te Akau's David Ellis and Go Racing's Matt Allnutt going toe-to-toe at Karaka.

It was Go Racing who won the battle, securing **Lot 557** to deliver a pinhooking windfall for the ever-growing Boys Get Paid punters club, who expanded their betting syndicate to the weanling market last year.

Allnutt admitted that Ellis was a formidable foe but was pleased to come out on top.

"To buy that horse, we are thrilled with it. He's one we've had on our list right from the first time we looked at it and he was a bit of a must buy for us," he said.

"It's good to be supporting the vendors (Boys Get Paid) as they are fantastic for racing. What they did the other night at the Karaka Million was just outstanding.

"First and foremost, though, it was the horse we liked as we thought he

was a real great mover and hopefully we can have a runner in the Karaka Million next year."

A trainer for the colt is yet to be decided but Allnutt said expatriate Kiwi Chris Waller was a chance to handle the horse's career in Australia.

Little Avondale Stud's Sam Williams, who along with Michael Wallace bred the colt out of their mare Drappier (Pins), admitted his co-owners had led to him to "replenish the fridge a lot more frequently over the past week".

"He was a neat horse. It was fortunate that Michael Wallace and I actually owned the mare. We bought her as a yearling and these boys were able to buy in and it was a great result," Williams said.

"Also, well done to Micheal for having the foresight to put these boys into the Savabeel colt because 'Savs' are always going to sell.

"The colt having that publicity behind him is going to prove invaluable to any syndicator."

Catalogued as Lot 557, he is the first foal for the placed mare Drappier, who is a sister to the Group 3 winner Crepe De Chine and Listed winner Glam Slam as well as a half-sister to Singapore's 2006 champion older sprinter Arenti (O'Reilly).

Boys Get Paid ringleader Luke Kemeys, who orchestrated a \$250,000 punters club at the Karaka Million meeting at Ellerslie on Saturday, said "I think that is the hardest my heart has been going all weekend - a bit more nervous than the punting".

"We knew we had a good horse. It was just how well he matured and if the buyers were here, so happy days," he said.

"The \$270,000 is not bad. I think it is dearer than any house I have had."

Kemeys detailed how the BGP syndicate created a successful pinhooking venture.

"We wanted to put together a syndicate to document the weanling to yearling process," he said.

"I asked Michael Wallace if he could give us a hand to find something because I didn't know what I was looking for.

"We were lucky enough to get the 50 per cent share of the Savabeel from Michael Wallace.

"I put the call out to the community to see who wanted to be involved and we had about 100 people say they would be interested in seeing how it all works.

"I think the best story was one of the lads saying 'what the hell is a weanling?' They wanted it explained to them what a weanling was and (once they understood) they ended up buying two shares."

Strong Book 1 encouraging for New Zealand breeders

NZB managing director Andrew Seabrook said it was encouraging to see the 2020 sale finish slightly up on last year, despite a local racing industry that continues to be impeded by low and stagnant prize-money levels.

The Book 1 average of \$138,698 was up marginally on 2019, while the median of \$107,500 was up 7.5 per cent year on year. The clearance rate was at a healthy 79 per cent with Books 2 and 3 to go over the next three days.

"It was very encouraging to see the number of international and domestic buyers present over the past few days," Seabrook said.

"The aggregate spend is on par with last year's sale, with 21 less horses catalogued.

"We had a strong middle market generated by the Australians. We put a lot of effort into getting them here, so it's great to see the vendors rewarded so well."

Leading buyer Ellis, a title he has held for 15 consecutive years, was pleased that a significant number of Australian owners and trainers had embraced the NZB market.

"I think it has been a very good sale," he said.

"There has been a lot of first season sires. We are desperate for new sires in New Zealand, so I am thrilled that the studs are giving it their best crack, and I thought the standard this year was very high and the sales series has been a huge success.

"I take my hat off to New Zealand Bloodstock, it is a company New Zealand should be very proud of."

Ellis finished Book 1 with 28 new yearlings set to race under the Te Akau banner for a spend of \$6.5 million.

"We bought yearlings from \$15,000 through to \$875,000, so we have horses at all price levels for all of our owners," he said.

"The horses we are trying to buy are horses who can race at two. We like to see them out in the autumn, but the one proviso that we do have is they have to be able to train on at three, four, and five.

"Remarkably, all our Karaka Million horses all get better as they get older and last year Melody Belle, for example, won more Group 1 races than any other horse in the sale."

Meanwhile, Black Caviar's (Bel Esprit) trainer Peter Moody, who was the second leading buyer for the week having purchased nine yearlings, was pleased that many local vendors had been well rewarded in the sales ring.

"It is an unbelievably resilient industry where you can see fire, flood or famine in this part of the world and the industry has continued to grow," he said.

"You have to respect that the breeders are a significant part of this industry and they race a lot of horses, so you can't begrudge them getting their money in the sales ring.

"I've said it publicly that I think this (Karaka) is the best sales complex in the world and the New Zealand product has been consistently good for my entire career, so that's why you continue to come back.

"Sadly, New Zealand needs to get their racing rejuvenated and part of their bloodstock, but the farms who breed winners continue to do it and that's why I come back here."

Local agent Phill Cataldo also commended the auction house and vendors for the stock brought to the sale.

"I think the sale is going really well and that's really important for the vendors. We all know the hard times the industry is going through and the last thing we need is for the vendors to start hurting so I'm thrilled for them," Cataldo said.

"New Zealand Bloodstock have done a fantastic job getting the buying bench they have and there are a lot of big-hitters here, including a lot of Australians, who are obviously the backbone of the sale and our industry to a point.

"I think there is a horse for everyone and every horse is finding it's fair value."

The Book 2 sale starts at 11am local time today.

AUSTRALIA

Kolding added to Expressway entries

Group 1 winner Kolding (Ocean Park) was yesterday one of four late entries for Saturday's Expressway Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Rosehill, increasing the number of nominations to 11. The winner of the Epsom Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) and the inaugural \$7.5 million Golden Eagle (1500m), the Chris Waller-trained four-year-old was joined by 2019 Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Kiamichi (Sidestep), veteran Sir Bacchus (Sebring) and Vegadaze (Lope de Vega) as additional entries taken for the 1200-metre sprint. Godolphin's Kiamichi led all the way to win a Group and Listed barrier trial at Rosehill yesterday morning before being added to the nominations. Her stablemate, triple Group 1 winner Alizee (Sepoy), is the early favourite for the race she won last year. Kolding has had two recent trials and Waller is keen to get him to the All-Star Mile (1600m) at Caulfield in March.

Free Of Debt set for Manfred

Last seen in the 2019 Golden Slipper, Adelaide colt Free Of Debt (Unencumbered) is primed to make his return in the Manfred Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Caulfield on Saturday. The Chris Bieg-trained three-year-old was sent to Melbourne on Sunday to take advantage of a gallop on the Caulfield course proper with race jockey Jye McNeil aboard. "Jye's quietly confident that fitness-wise we've got him where we want him," Bieg said. "Behaviour-wise he was spot-on, nice and keen and fresh, so it's good heading into Saturday. We'll see how he goes second-up in the C S Hayes and then push through to the All-Star Mile if we're looking like getting the votes to get in. If he comes out on

Saturday ultra keen and Jye gets off him and says we might be a year early for the All-Star Mile and let's keep him sprinting, then the Newmarket. It's a Group 1 that he'll get in with no weight and being a three-year-old it could be a genuine option."

Pride eyes Muscle return

Joe Pride knows Ball Of Muscle (Dubawi) is coming to the end of his career but believes the nine-year-old still has something to give. From a family dear to the trainer's heart, Ball Of Muscle is a brother to Tiger Tees and a half brother to Terravista (Captain Rio), both Group 1-winning sprinters. He is running out of time to get a Group 1 win of his own, but Pride hopes to give him a shot at next month's Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) at Caulfield, a track and distance he enjoys. "He has been back in the stable for a few weeks," Pride said. "I'm mindful he is now a nine-year-old and we have to pick his races. The Oakleigh Plate is ambitious, but it is not always the strongest of the sprints. I really want to dodge the good three-year-olds, but we will have to see what the handicap is."

Bivouac, Kiamichi win trials

Godolphin Group 1 winners Bivouac (Exceed and Excel) and Kiamichi showed they are ready for their autumn campaigns with barrier trial wins at Rosehill yesterday. Golden Rose (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Bivouac won the first of two course-proper heats over 900 metres, edging Hush Writer (Rulership) on the line, while Kiamichi led all the way to beat stablemate Deprive (Denman) by two and three-quarter lengths in the second 900-metre trial. James Cummings flagged the Oakleigh Plate on February 22 as a starting point for Bivouac. The colt has not raced since his close second to Exceedance (Exceed And Excel) in

the Coolmore Stud Stakes (registered as Ascot Vale Stakes) (Gr 1, 1200m) at Flemington on November 2.

Castelvecchio pleases in trial

Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) runner-up Castelvecchio (Dundeel) finished back in the field in Bivouac's heat at Rosehill, but trainer Richard Litt was pleased with his performance. The top-rated three-year-old colt is expected to have one more trial before returning to the races, with the Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) on March 7 and Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m) on March 21 his prime targets. His campaign is expected to culminate at Randwick during The Championships in either the Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) on April 4 or Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) on April 11 against older rivals at weight-for-age conditions.

Options open for Gaby

Star filly Loving Gaby (I Am Invincible) returned for her first jump-out this preparation yesterday and while her first-up assignment is yet to be locked in, next month's Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) at Flemington appears likely, with the Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) her ultimate target. "It was her first jump-out back and she was drawn widest. Teo (Nugent) rode her and he knows her well, she closed off really nicely late," co-trainer David Eustace told Racing.com. "She always looks ready to go, she's not one that lets down significantly in the paddock. I'm sure if we ran her now she'd be ready to go, but we'll have another strong hit-out before she either goes to the Oakleigh Plate or the Lightning. Ultimately, the Newmarket is the target in the first half of the preparation, so the Lightning obviously gives you another sighter down the straight, which is an advantage."

Setback for Heart Of Puissance

Meanwhile, Loving Gaby's Ciaran Maher and David Eustace-trained stable companion Heart Of Puissance (Puissance De Lune) has suffered a setback in his preparation for the autumn. "He just had a little bit of muscle soreness and has been at the beach for ten days, so time will be a little bit tight for those early season targets," Eustace told Racing.com. "They are certainly not off the table, but we just need everything to go right from now on. He still needs to furnish and he is still trying to work everything out. There is a lot of natural ability there and we still think whatever we can achieve in the prep, there's a lot more to come."

England on the cards for Russian Camelot

An ambitious tilt at the Epsom Derby (Gr 1, 1m4f) could be on the cards for the Danny O' Brien-trained Russian Camelot (Camelot). Listed placed at Flemington in November, the northern-hemisphere bred three-year-old is likely to be targeted at the South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) on May 9 or the Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) on June 6, but the option of travelling to England for the most famous Derby of all remains a possibility. "It's very audacious. But we've prepped this horse like he has been in England the whole time," assistant trainer Ben Gleeson told Racing.com. "If he was in England right now he would be the type of horse that trainers would be aiming at an Epsom Derby. It's a big ask of a three-year-old to go back over there, but he's done the travel before. He'd want to come out here at Flemington and his South Australian starts and put pay to them very impressively. If he was to do so we would certainly consider it."

Zahra to ride Rulership

Leading riding Mark Zahra has been booked to ride impressive debut winner Rulership (I Am Invincible) when he heads to Melbourne to prepare for the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Caulfield. Nash Rawiller rode the Peter and Paul Snowden-trained two-year-old to win on Saturday but has already been told he has lost the mount. "I've already found out that I've been overlooked for Melbourne," Rawiller told RSN927. "I was already booking my plane ticket but Zahra is going to ride him. I don't think I ride too bad at Caulfield, it's one of my favourite tracks." Rulership is scheduled to start in the Blue Diamond Prelude (C&G) (Gr 3, 1100m) at Caulfield on Saturday week ahead of the Blue Diamond Stakes on February 22.

Heathcote recovers from heart surgery

Eagle Farm trainer Robert Heathcote has put a health scare behind him and is ready to continue his recent momentum on the track. Heathcote was back at trackwork yesterday after undergoing heart surgery on Saturday. "Medicine these days is amazing. I had a stent put in four days ago, but here I am and I feel terrific," Heathcote said. "I was short of breath at Doomben last Thursday and went to see my doctor who sent me for some tests. Before I knew it I was on the operating table. It is a case for all people to note - listen to your body. I felt something was wrong and did something about it. The good news is everything else is fine and working properly. But I have avoided a possible heart attack or stroke."

Scales Of Justice tops big weekend for Inglis graduates

Inspections for Inglis' first yearling sale of the year - the Classic Sale - begin next week and recent graduates of Inglis-run auctions enjoyed a fruitful weekend on the track. They were spearheaded by Boomer Bloodstock's Scales Of Justice (Not A Single Doubt), a \$180,000 Premier Yearling Sale purchase from Millford Thoroughbreds, who led home three further Inglis graduates when winning the Australia Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Moonee Valley on Friday night. Cradle Mountain (West Quest) took out the Carrington Stakes (Listed, 1400m), Morvada (Mossman) the John Dillon Stakes (Listed, 1400m) and Taikomochi

(Snitzel) the Australia Day Cup (Listed, 2400m) to add further Australian stakes success over the long weekend, while New Zealand's Kiwi Ida (Squamosa) secured the Westbury Classic (Gr 2, 1400m) and Singapore star Bold Thruster (Turffontein), who landed the Listed Fortune Bowl (Listed, 1400m), were successful internationally.

Jockeys welcome Moody return

Luke Nolen and Linda Meech, both of whom enjoyed significant success when teaming up with Peter Moody, have welcomed the news that the Group 1-winning trainer will reapply for his license this year. Nolen partnered 32 Group 1 winners for Moody, with 14 of those achieved on champion mare Black Caviar (Bel Esprit), and he told Racing.com: "He was a great loss to the industry. I felt it when he walked away, so I don't think there'd be any one person, whether it be an owner, a participant or a punter, that wouldn't welcome him back." Meech and Moody enjoyed a 25 per cent strike-rate together and she also told Racing.com: "It's great for Pete - he's too good a horseman not to be training. It'll be interesting to see how it all unfolds and what the set-up is like if and when he eventually moves to Pakenham."

Eagle Farm meets benchmarks

Eagle Farm has met all benchmarks after its first full year of racing as the track prepares to host four consecutive Saturday meetings next month. The Brisbane Racing Club confirmed Eagle Farm was achieving the goals set in the Monteith Report, which was released ahead of the renovation of the track in 2018. The Monteith Report was conducted by former Victoria Racing Club chief executive Dale Monteith, who outlined recommendations for the maintenance of the track across several years. The Monteith Report recommended no more than 25 meetings be held at Eagle Farm in its first year, increasing for the next two years. The report also recommended annual renovation time and avoiding instances of three meetings in fewer than two weeks. Eagle Farm hosted 25 meetings in the first year. "Based on what we're seeing at Eagle Farm and, speaking with the experts who are working with the track, Eagle Farm is performing to the expectations that we set before the track was rebuilt," Monteith said.

Cornerstone donate stallion nominations

Cornerstone Stud will once again provide breeders two stallion service opportunities - World Of Trouble (Kantharos) and Sir Prancealot (Tamayuz) - which will be auctioned off at the South Australian Thoroughbred Breeders Awards and Horse of the Year Awards on Saturday evening. The auction, which aims to raise funds for the SATB, will be conducted by Adrian Hancock and a phone bidding service will be in operation for those who cannot attend. Thorndon Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) third Yearn (Savabeel) is being prepared for the inaugural running of the Lisa Chittick Plate (1400m), a fillies and mares set weights and penalties event at Matamata on February 22, prior to a tilt at the New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Te Aroha on April 4. "The Matamata race should be a good lead-up for her towards the Group 1 at Te Aroha," trainer Karen Fursdon said. "She'll have one more run in between, but we'll decide on where that will be after she gets through her Matamata race. If she does great she may have a Brisbane campaign after Te Aroha. Mark (Lupton, co-owner) has been looking at the Queensland programmes and the Prime Ministers Cup at the Gold Coast could be a good race for her."

Australia on cards for Harlech

Consistent three-year-old Harlech (Darci Brahma) has been sent for a small break after his fourth-placing in the Karaka Million 3YO Classic (RL, 1600m) at Ellerslie on Saturday. It was the first time the consistent colt finished

outside the top three this season, having won the Sarten Memorial Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) and placed in the New Zealand 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m), Levin Classic (Gr 1, 1600m), and Uncle Remus Stakes (Listed, 1400m). Co-trainer Mike Moroney said Harlech's lengthy campaign began to show in Saturday's contest. "He got a bit further back from the draw (barrier five). He was following the two that beat him, they got a run through and he had to come out and got shoved off the track," he said. "From halfway down the straight to the winning post he lacked a little bit of zip that he normally has. He did pull up looking pretty tired, so he has gone to the paddock briefly and we will work out if we can get him back in time for Sydney or whether we wait until Queensland."

INTERNATIONAL

Magic Wand set for Saudi Cup

After finishing second in the Pegasus World Cup Turf (Gr 1, 9.5f) for the second consecutive year at Gulfstream Park on Saturday, globetrotting mare Magic Wand's (Galileo) next start is likely to be in the inaugural US\$20 million (AU\$29 million) Saudi Cup (1800m) at King Abdulaziz Racetrack in Riyadh on February 29. "It's very possible that she'll be heading to Saudi Arabia next month," said trainer Aidan O'Brien. "We're thinking about running her on the dirt. It'd be something new for her so we'll see how she comes out of her last run between now and then." The Mackinnon Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) winner has raced at Group / Grade 1 level 18 times for one win, eight seconds and a third.

Entertaining and crowd-pulling: why the picnics remain one of racing's best days out

Big crowd, a buzz in the betting ring, carnival atmosphere and a very good racing surface. No, not Flemington, but the Australia Day picnic races at Balnarring.

The formula is simple, of course. Twenty bucks to get in - kids go free - and then please yourself. That is, you may bring in your own food and beverages and thus cap your on-course spend, which was enough to motivate an estimated 5,000 people to attend last Sunday.

There is no surprise that the picnics are popular, but perhaps they are underestimated in their value as racing's shop front, especially as racing becomes more and more a television sport. The trouble is this: racing is a very good television sport, but only once you're already engaged.

Thus we still need people to go to the races, any races. We still need kids and teenagers to be exposed to it live. You can touch the horses at the picnics. You can have an affordably good time.

You can spare me the propaganda that

Racing.com, or any similar outlet, engages a new audience. Nobody channel flicking will suddenly become absorbed by horse racing, but a trip to the picnics just might do it for some.

I wouldn't be the first to muse that there might be a lesson here for metropolitan clubs - at the very least a BYO race-day might strike a chord with families.

I'd no sooner go to a routine city race meeting these days than go bungee jumping. I value my own cocoon when it comes to backing a winner and keeping my spleen right where it is.

But the picnics are a different story. You might have a bet (and I did), but just for fun. More importantly, you'll have a pleasant afternoon in an environment where - as one picnic regular told me - you'll never see a "blue". That is to say there's nobody telling you you can't take that drink there or that ice cream up those steps.

It's a refreshing and reassuring day out, watching a raft of people care for horses who are not, and never were, very fast. Watching amateur jockeys wasting as hard as their professional counterparts without ever having the compensation of a big prize-money win.

The picnics are now playing an ever more important role in sustaining the careers of horses who would otherwise have been banished from the racing scene much earlier.

You might argue their worth was acknowledged just last month when Minister for Racing Martin Pakula announced that the Labor Government would invest \$100,000 from its Victorian Racing Industry Fund into picnic horse racing venues.

But I'd argue that's a party sum given that it was allocated to eight venues and supplemented by just \$50,000 from Racing Victoria and Country Racing Victoria.

The picnics are worth more than that and I'd very strongly argue that any governing body spend could be happily absorbed within marketing and public relations budgets, rather

than operational, because no racing provides better advertising and goodwill than the picnics.

The Balnarring Picnic Race Club has a history dating back to 1863, still races on the same site in Coolart Road and continues to

serve the wider industry as the host of barrier trials, which have been graced by many a high-class horse.

Incidentally, the 2020 Balnarring Cup was won by I'm Peter, who is trained by Monica Cid and was ridden by apprentice Tracey Johnson. It was Johnson's second winner for the season, with the first coming just 24 hours earlier at Yea on the Mark Pegus-trained Veraj, and that being her first since 2006.

The picnic racing circuit moves to Healesville this Saturday (February 1) and then to Woolamai, near Phillip Island, on February 8 before the much anticipated meeting at Buchan on February 15.

Buchan Racecourse was scorched in the recent Gippsland bushfires and the photo of its burned winning post has become a significant image of the crisis. The Buchan and Gelantipy Race Club will be able to stage its 133rd cup meeting after approval from Country Racing Victoria.

This meeting will be worthy of your support. Any picnic meeting, and the season continues until March 12, is worthy of attending.
