Breeders betting on demand continuing are well-placed to make big returns

Booming bloodstock sales underline increased interest in racehorse ownership, says economist

Do the extraordinary numbers paid for bloodstock in 2021 stack up? Or will there be blood on the floor if, and when, there is a correction of the Australian thoroughbred market in the years to come?

That is the question being pondered by many experienced industry figures after the Magic Millions National Weanling and Broodmare Sale, who say this week's "frenzied" activity was something never seen

at a thoroughbred auction anywhere else in the world.

Breeders betting on the driving forces behind the insatiable market demand for racehorses continuing at least in line with the prices for stock this year have the odds in their favour, a leading Australian economist says.

Managing director of Market Economics, Stephen Koukoulas, a former chief economist at Citibank, believes the stunning trend is here to stay for the foreseeable future after observing what has occurred at this year's sales series.

<< *Continued from page 1* “My answer is, yes, because once you’ve got a taste for it (racehorse ownership), you tend to keep going,” Koukoulas told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday.

“There’s an annual report that Racing Australia puts out. I had a look at it a few months ago and it shows the number of owners.

“OK, you’ve got the Gerry Harveys and the John Singletons and these guys who are extremely rich and can buy whatever horses they want, but if you look through the ownership numbers, there are people, like me, who have reached mid-life, a little bit beyond, they’ve got lucky in life who, I won’t say have a huge amount of cash, but occasionally they will buy a five per cent share here or there and the ownership numbers have gone up, so to me that suggests that there’s a bit more (demand) to come.”

The figures cited by Koukoulas show that 82,311 owners had a horse race last season in Australia, while another 40,804 were involved in ownership through a syndicate and he expects those numbers to increase year-on-year.

He shares the view expressed by many that racing has benefited from the closure of the international borders, leading to people finding other ways to spend their discretionary income.

“This is a very generic comment, but people who may have spent \$20-\$30 grand on an overseas holiday, business class to Europe and a month travelling around France, Spain and Italy and all the rest of it, all of a sudden have that money sitting in the bank now,” Koukoulas said.

“Their house prices have gone up in value, so they are feeling wealthy and the stock market’s recovered (to a record close yesterday), so the fear of the stock market falling away rapidly is no longer there and now they have the feeling of, ‘I’ve always wanted to buy a share in a racehorse.’

“The racing industry kept going through thick and thin during lockdowns a year ago and, of course, they are still going on, so I think it is all feeding into the market.

“They’re spending their money at home and keeping it at home and, as I said in the case of ownership rates of horses, it’s obviously spilling over to the breeders (who are reinvesting).”

At this month’s breeding stock sales conducted by Inglis in Sydney and the Magic Millions National Weanling and Broodmare Sale, a total of \$182,391,600 has been spent on mares and another \$40.39 million has been spent on foals.

The Inglis Great Southern Sale, featuring 408 weanlings and at least 125 broodmares, is still to be held in Melbourne on June 13 and 14.

Prior to the opening National Broodmare Sale session, Attunga Stud’s Brian Nutt told his clients they were “selling at the top of the market” while Cressfield Stud’s Bruce Neill, after paying \$1 million for Quilista (Scandal Keeper), said: “There’s a lot of reinvestment going on around the world with asset classes. Obviously, we are in that category with the horse industry and it’s very encouraging.”

Koukoulas, himself a racehorse owner and punter, says other industries are also experiencing a massive upswing in demand in a similar way the gambling sector and racing industry has in the past 15 months.

“The beauty industry has been booming during the downturn and recession, and it’s predominantly the women who buy the lipstick and things. It is booming because people want to feel good during these down times. It is an interesting phenomenon,” he said. *Continued on page 3>>*

"There's a link between those spending on cosmetics and perfume and those sorts of things, which is predominantly women, and predominantly males, I suppose, are buying shares in horses. A lot more women are buying into horses now, too, but it is still predominantly a male industry.

"I can afford to do it and I want to have a feel-good experience' and having a share in a horse who is running around is a very, very exciting thing."

He added: "Again, another funny link is the car sales. 'I am feeling OK with my money, so I am going to buy myself a fancy new car'. We've seen that with new car sales, where there was almost none of them being sold and now they're struggling to keep up with demand.

"Big-ticket items like cars are very expensive and a share in a racehorse is clearly very expensive for 'spare cash', but I think that momentum is continuing because the economy is still doing well, interest rates are low and people are feeling wealthy."

Magic Millions managing director Barry Bowditch, speaking on Thursday after the last lot was sold at the company's most successful National Broodmare Sale in which 611 lots sold for a total of more than \$142 million, does not expect a so-called correction any time soon.

"(The broodmare sale) mirrors what's happening on the racetrack here," Bowditch said.

"There's a lot of confidence here, our model is so strong and so robust,

our prize-money's fantastic and people want to get into the game at all levels, whether it be breeding, pinhooking or racing, so I've got a lot of confidence where we're at I think we can continue to go from strength to strength."

Koukoulas is clearly an industry convert but he firmly believes the long-term outlook for racing is a strong one in Australia.

"Having been under a lot of pressure with the welfare issues around the Melbourne Cup and horses being sent off to the knackery, there was some really bad PR there and there were some bad things that happened - I am not denying that for a second - but maybe people are thinking, 'OK, the industry's got its act together on these things and I want to be part of it,'" he said.

"It's the social thing of owning a share in a horse that is exhilarating. The fact that we are locked down and we want to spend our money on something.

"It's a mid-life crisis for a lot of us, so if you've always wanted a share in a racehorse, here's your opportunity.

13 for Star Turn

My Snow Queen (2 f ex Lionel Left Me by Casino Prince) gave Star Turn (Star Witness) his 13th individual winner when taking the Iron Horse Global Maiden Plate (1300m) at Goulburn yesterday. The John Sargent-trained \$1.45 favourite drew clear under Keagan Latham on a Soft 5 track to win by three and a quarter lengths from After Dinner (Choisir), with She's Justified (Vancouver) a further three and a half lengths behind in third. The filly was winning at the third attempt, having placed fourth on debut at Warwick Farm on April 28 and runner-up at Hawkesbury a week ago. J & J Thoroughbreds purchased My Snow Queen for \$5,000 as a weanling out of the 2019 Great Southern Sale, having been offered by Oakford Thoroughbred Farm, Maldon. She went unsold at \$2,000, after failing to hit her \$5,000 reserve, at the 2020 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale when offered by Tallarook, Chambers Flat, Qld (agent). Austin racing then bought her for \$15,000 at last year's Scone Yearling Sale, the vendor being Jazcom Thoroughbreds, The Oaks. My Snow Queen is out of a winning half-sister to Hawkesbury Gold Cup (Gr 3, 1600m) winner Amovatio (Al Maher). Her fourth dam is the multiple Group 1-winning champion Emancipation (Bletchingly). Star Turn stands at Vinery for a fee of \$16,500 (inc. GST).

Eight for Flying Artie

Flying Artie (Artie Schiller) sired his eighth individual winner when Flying Tyrol (2 f ex Burgeis by Catbird) landed the Hibernian Hotel Maiden Handicap (1000m) at Goulburn yesterday. Keagan Latham drove the John Thompson-trained filly to score by a neck from

Shocking Force (Air Force Blue) with Devine Miss (Headwater) another half-length behind in third. Flying Tyrol's dam is the speedy and talented Burgeis (Catbird), a Listed winner who placed third behind Reaan (Hussonet) in the 2008 Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m). Burgeis is out of a winning half-sister to Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) victor Stratum (Redoute's Choice) and Group 3 scorer Dystopia (Redoute's Choice). Flying Artie stands at Newgate Stud for a fee of \$33,000 (Inc. GST).

Five for Divine Prophet

Selling Sunset (2 f ex Rolling Stock by High Rolling) got off the mark Casino yesterday to give Divine Prophet (Choisir) his fifth individual winner. The Kacy Fogden-trained filly was racing for the third time when successful in the Parker/Kissane Solicitors Handicap (1200m) as the \$1.57 favourite. Selling Sunset made all and scored by two lengths under Matthew Bennett, ahead of runner-up Bean Foggy (Spill The Beans), with Waltz (Hinchinbrook) three lengths behind in third. The winner is a half-sister to three-time winner Jazari (Not A Single Doubt), out of the eight-time winner up to a mile, Rolling Stock (High Rolling). Her fourth dam is the Group 2-winning black type producer Fiancee (Baguette). Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Divine Prophet stands at Aquis Farm for a fee of \$16,500 (Inc. GST).

Siyouni available for southern hemisphere covers

French Champion Sire Siyouni (Pivotal) has been made available for southern hemisphere coverings in 2021 by The Aga Khan Studs for a fee of €100,000. Siyouni, himself a winner of the Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere (Gr 1, 1400m) in a two-

year-old season that yielded four wins from six starts, is the sire of European Champion Two-Year-Old and recent French 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner St Mark's Basilica. In Australia, Siyouni has delivered eye-catching success, with five winners from seven to race, notably through the Woodpark Stud-bred Aylmerton, winner of the Todman Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), as well as this year's Listed two-year-old winner See You In Spring, while his nine yearlings to sell in Australia this year sold for up to \$550,000 at an average of \$312,777. The sire of 46 individual stakes winners from eight crops of racing age, Siyouni has bloodlines familiar to Australian breeders, being out of Danehill (Danzig) mare Sichilla, a Listed winner in France and producer of four stakes winners, including Siyouni. Favourites all clear for Kingsford-Smith

Savatiano (Street Cry) and Gytrash (Lope De Vega) have been cleared to contest the Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) at Eagle Farm today. Doubts had hung over the market principals since Thursday after Savatiano was found to have mild lameness in the off-fore and Gytrash in the near-fore but both horses passed veterinary tests late yesterday afternoon. However, Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Savatolx (Kuroshio) must go through another check this morning after failing to satisfy the vet last night.

Cummings keen on all three Kingsford-Cup runners

Godolphin trainer James Cummings is keen on the chances of all three of his runners in today's Kingsford-Smith Cup. The handler will saddle up Kementari (Lonhro), Savatiano (Street Cry) and Trekking (Street Cry). "You can't help but admire a mare as good and as honest as she is," Cummings said of Savatiano. "She's a fixture in open Group 1 company these days, she proved that again last start where she might have won the All-Aged but for rolling around a bit at the end. We've kept her fresh with a month between runs and she showed she'd maintained her form with a nice barrier trial effort two weeks ago. Trekking finished fifth in the Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 1200m) a fortnight ago. "He'll arrive at this race at a high point in his preparation after two very respectable runs," Cummings said. "I thought his effort to be beaten only three-quarters of a length behind Eduardo in the 10,000 indicated he was racing with the right level of enthusiasm. On Kementari, Cummings added: "The focus was probably on Savatiano and Cascadian in the All-Aged, but there wasn't a lot wrong with Kementari's performance. He responded to a change of scenery when we sent him to Perth last summer and I thought he got the line with sufficient desire last start to earn himself a trip to Queensland."

Sudoku brings a solid debut performance to Caulfield today after the Mick Price and Michael Kent Jnr-trained gelding opened his account at Ballarat with a two-and-a-half-length win over Ostracised (Divine Prophet) on May 9.

The son of Rubick (Encosta De Lago) made the perfect start in repaying his \$160,000 purchase by his trainers and DGR Thoroughbred Services at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale last year.

He is the first winner for his dam, the unraced Tiergarten (Street Cry), and his pedigree gets more interesting the deeper you delve.

His second dam, the winning Redoute's Choice (Danehill) mare Ringstrasse, has produced three winners from three foals to have hit the track, including five-time

winning former Godolphin galloper Wagner (Bernardini).

Go back one more dam and we have Wiener, a stakes placed mare by More Than Ready (Southern Halo) who has produced two-year-old stakes winner Rathlin (Fastnet Rock) and the stakes placed duo Redoutable Heart (Redoute's Choice) and Za Zi Ba (All Too Hard).

Wiener, herself, is out of the stakes winner Snippet's Lass (Snippets), making her a half-sister to perennial champion sire Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) and multiple Group 1-placegetter-turned-sire Hinchinbrook (Fastnet Rock).

The Duncan Ramage-raced juvenile faces seven rivals today in the opening race at Caulfield in a bid to keep his unbeaten record intact.

His dam's yearling colt by Maurice (Screen Hero) sold for \$110,000 at the Inglis Melbourne Premier Sale this year.

Dunn has faith in Derby longshot

Matt Dunn believes Sagacious (Foxwedge) can run a cheeky race today in the Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) at long odds, despite a pedigree that is all about speed. His sire's progeny are usually sprinters, while his dam, Vecchia Roma (Testa Rossa), couldn't win beyond 1200 metres. But Dunn believes the distance will be fine. "There is no way in the world he should be running these trips, but he does," the handler said. "His last prep, he beat some really nice horses. Last start is a blot on his page, but you take that out of the equation and he's got the action of a horse who will run a mile-and-a-half." Sagacious won three in a row in November and December from a mile to 1900 metres but has mixed his form in four runs this campaign, including a last-start flop in the Rough Habit Plate (Gr 3, 2000m). "He looked horribly disappointing last start but there were probably a few reasons for it," Dunn continued. "He went a bit quick in front and as the day went on, the part of the track he was on was no good at all. Maybe he didn't travel so well, he only arrived the Thursday before the race and maybe that was the issue. But he seems to have come through the run well and I don't want to condemn him on one poor performance." Sagacious is a \$101 chance behind \$2.60 favourite Explosive Jack (Jakkalberry).

Tiger ready to pounce from good draw

A change of fortune at the barrier draw sees Tiger Of Malay (Extreme Choice) set to break from gate seven of 17 in the BRC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Eagle Farm today. The Pago Pago Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) placegetter has had no luck with gates this preparation and Michael Freedman, who co-trains with brother Richard, saw merit in the colt's fifth-placing from barrier eight of ten in the Spirit Of Boom Classic (Gr 2, 1200m) at Doomben last time. "He sat three and four deep and it was no fault of Nash (Rawiller), it was just the way things panned out, but he never got on the track," Freedman said. "I thought he toughed it out pretty well under the circumstances. Saturday is probably

the best barrier he has drawn this entire preparation. He has just been plagued by bad barriers." Original booking Mark Zahra has remained in Victoria due to the Covid-19 situation and Craig Williams will partner for the first time. Like his Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m)-winning stablemate Stay Inside, the colt is by freshman sire Extreme Choice (Not A Single Doubt) and is a \$19 chance. Unbeaten Queensland youngster Prince Of Boom (Spirit Of Boom) holds market sway at \$4.20 and will be bidding to become the first local to capture the feature since Sizzling (Snitzel) in 2012.

Don't discount Overpass

Bjorn Baker has expressed faith in Overpass (Vancouver) ahead of the Sires' Produce Stakes at Eagle Farm today. The two-year-old is a \$9 chance in TAB markets behind the Rob Heathcote-trained favourite Prince Of Boom (Spirit Of Boom) at \$4.20. Overpass goes into the 1400-metre feature chasing his fourth consecutive win at only his fifth outing, following an impressive win at Gosford on May 8. "It was a big win as he had the outside gate and was never better than three wide," Baker told Racing Queensland. "He's got a good gate this time in barrier three and he's improving all the time. He's won his last three runs so you can't knock his form."

The trainer is hopeful Overpass can book a start in the J J Atkins (Gr 1, 1600 metres) at Eagle Farm in two weeks and beyond that he has a \$1 million race in his sights next spring. "I'll see how he goes in Group company in his next two starts before looking too far ahead but if he handles the step up then I'll be looking at the Golden Rose in the spring," he added.

Converge continues to improve

Fernhill Handicap (Listed, 1600m) winner Converge (Frankel) has been improving all the time, according to co-trainers Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott, as both bid to win their first BRC Sires' Produce Stakes. Bott was on hand to watch Converge work at Eagle Farm on Tuesday, and was impressed with what he saw. "It was nice sharp work, exactly what we wanted to see coming up here with him," Bott

said. He stretched out beautifully. Really happy with the way he found the line. He's had a good week to settle in since the nice trial at Wyong. He's had a little freshen up since his run in the Champagne. He's only lightly raced, but I thought he continued to improve throughout that last campaign. The good strong run over the mile seasoned him up nicely," Bott said. The stable also runs Maranoa (Snitzel) in the Queensland Derby, backing up from a second at Rosehill seven days ago. "It's a little bit of an ask for him, raising the bar, (but) I thought the run was full of merit over 2000 metres for the first time. He bowled along, set a strong tempo and stuck on gamely," Bott said. "He came through the run really well and came through the trip well. He's a horse with plenty of talent, plenty of upside and the extra trip should be a benefit to him."

King and Fling at Randwick

Gary Portelli has been on a jockey merry-go-round this week but his decision to wait it out has led to the booking of top rider Rachel King for his Inglis Guineas (RL, 1400m) placegetter Nicci's Fling (Nicconi) in the BenchMark 78 at Randwick today. The stable initially sought out an apprentice but the filly was left without a rider when both Samantha Clenton and Louise Day became belatedly unavailable. "It was just a comedy of errors and we ended up with no-one, so we thought we'd just sit on the fence and see what happened and if there was a scratching, we'd just take the best jockey available," Portelli said. "Then bang, Ms Rachel King, up you go. The old playing cards. If you haven't got the right hand you wait for the ace." King became available when her original booking, Fashchanel (I Am Invincible), was scratched after acceptances. The filly has been up for some time but continues to thrive and Portelli hopes she can deliver after eight top-four finishes from her last ten runs, without a victory. "If you throw enough darts at the target you eventually hit the bullseye and she just comes back looking for more," Portelli added. "The most dangerous place for a horse is in the paddock so if she's well, we will keep her racing. Particularly at this time of year, it's nice and warm in the stable and I think they appreciate being there."

Biometric expected to find winning form

Connections of English import Biometric (Bated Breath) are hoping he can shake the label of being a "frustrating" horse when he lines up in a Benchmark 84 today at Caulfield. "He has been a little bit frustrating. There was a couple of runs where he's just been a little bit unlucky through not getting the run at the right time and then, in his most recent run, he presented and wasn't beaten far," Tom Dabernig, who co-trains with Ben Hayes, told Racing.com. Biometric, winner of the Britannia Stakes (1600m) at Royal Ascot two years ago, stepped back to 1400 metres for his two most recent runs and displayed improvement. The five-year-old was less than two lengths behind dual Group 1 winner Mr Quickie (Shamus Award) in a Group 3 at Caulfield and then placed less than a length third behind Dice Roll (Showcasing) at Sandown-Hillside. "His actual Caulfield form is not bad, 1400 metres is his actual preferred distance, he's very fit so, if the track is in reasonable shape, he'll have a good chance and hopefully he'll get the right run," Dabernig continued. The stable will also send out Think 'N' Fly (So You Think) in the contest.

Spring Carnival extended and reworked

The spring racing carnival will run to the end of November with the Zipping Classic (Gr 2, 2400m) meeting to be run a fortnight later than its traditional date. The Zipping Classic, along with the Sandown Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m) and Sandown Cup (Listed, 3200m), will move to Caulfield on November 27. The Underwood Stakes (Gr 1, 1800m) program on September 26 will be transferred from Caulfield to Sandown, giving Sandown its first Group 1 race since 1996. This follows an earlier announcement that the Thousand Guineas (Group 1, 1600m) is moving back to the middle day of the Caulfield Cup carnival. Another provincial standalone meeting has been added with Cranbourne taking over the former Zipping Classic date, allowing the Cranbourne Cup (Listed, 1600m) to move from October to November 13 with prize-money increased to \$500,000 and the distance shortened from 2025 metres. "The major change is a revamped end to the

spring racing carnival which will provide an enhanced program of feature racing through until the end of November and we expect it will prove attractive to both our customers and participants," said Greg Carpenter, Racing Victoria executive general manager, racing.

Nugent back in five weeks

Teo Nugent expects to be back riding in five weeks from the broken fibula he sustained when he was dislodged on the way to post at Cranbourne last Friday. "We got into a canter and I stuck to the outside rail, I lost my right iron and kept my left one out and tried to hang on to the reins, but it went over the top of me," Nugent told Racing.com. "The doctor on-course said 'I think you've done your fibula' and when I went to Dandenong hospital that's what I was told so he was spot on. I'm able to walk around on it in no pain: in all of the spots to break it it's probably the best spot." The apprentice, 22, is wearing a moon boot and is due to have scans today but is looking forward to returning to the saddle to pick up again on his good recent form and chase down the 12 wins he needs to ride out his city claim. "Things had been going great, I'd had one month off but the last four weeks I'd ridden a city winner at each of the Saturday meetings since I'd been back," he continued. "It all comes to a halt now but when I come back I've got 12 winners to lose my 1.5-kilogram claim in the city so I'll be hoping to smash that out."

Oliver outed for careless riding

Damien Oliver was found guilty of careless riding on Thursday and suspended for eight meetings after he pleaded guilty to the low-range charge following his ride on Falls (Niagara) in race six at Sale. He was found to have shifted in when not sufficiently clear of Brilliant Venture (Zacinto) near the 1200-metre point. Brilliant Venture was, as a result, tightened up between Oliver's mount and Elvaric (Street Boss), and had to be restrained to avoid clipping heels with Falls. Oliver's suspension begins from midnight on June 5 and will finish at midnight on June 13.

Hope given go ahead for dual meetings

A shortage of apprentice riders prompted

Racing Victoria to grant Tahlia Hope permission to break usual health and safety protocols regarding apprentice workload yesterday. The decision meant Hope was able to ride Hit Reset (Reset) for trainer Brent Stanley in last night's apprentices-only race, finishing 10th in the Travis Harrison Cup (1200m), at Cranbourne after she was also booked for a ride during the day's meeting at Ballarat. Under normal circumstances, an apprentice can only ride at one meeting per day. The lack of apprentice availability for the Travis Harrison Cup was the culmination of various factors, including a couple on the sidelines through injury, six booked for Ballarat, others riding interstate and two thought to have been in isolation awaiting results of Covid-19 tests.

BetMakers move for Tabcorp

Matt Tripp yesterday made the move to acquire Tabcorp that the market has been expecting for the past few months. Tripp and Australian Stock Exchange-listed company BetMakers have tabled a \$4 billion bid. Tripp, who has had success already with Sportsbet and BetEasy, bought a stake in Australian-based BetMakers back in February and a statement to the ASX revealed that the company has submitted a non-binding, indicative proposal to acquire Tabcorp "for an enterprise value of \$4 billion". Entain and Apollo have tabled previous bids of \$3.5 billion but whereas both of those were cash bids, BetMakers' offer consists of \$1 billion in cash and \$3 billion in BetMakers shares priced at a 15 per cent premium prior to signing before being distributed to Tabcorp shareholders on a prorated basis. That means Tabcorp shareholders would get "an approximate 65 per cent interest in the combined BetMakers and Tabcorp Wagering and Media business". Tabcorp has struggled to retain its market share as customers have shifted to digital and this has brought pressure to split its wagering and media arm from its thriving lotteries business. Tripp said he was "excited by the potential to reinvigorate the Tabcorp wagering and media business". He added: "I have been impressed with the world-class team BetMakers has put together and the enormous growth opportunities they have created globally."

NEW ZEALAND

Hezashocka Derby dream

Hezashocka will bid to land the Queensland Derby for the Mick Price and Michael Kent jr stable at Eagle Farm today but the gelding's former registered handler and part-owner Emma Clotworthy is maintaining hands-on involvement. The gelding left the Clotworthys' New Zealand stable when OTI Racing purchased a majority stake following his victory in the Championship Stakes (Gr 2, 2100m) at Ellerslie last month. Clotworthy has retained a share and it was decided that Hezashocka would remain in her care in the lead-up to the big-race, under the direction of Price and Kent. "We have kept ten percent of him, just enough to have a bit of interest," Clotworthy said. "It would be nice to have a bit more, but it is too hard in New Zealand, so this is where he is destined to be anyway. Mick has been here the last week, but we have pretty much just carried on the same type of prep as what we would have done at home." Clotworthy is happy with her charge but expects him to furnish into a better four-year-old. "We had a gallop on the course proper the other day and he seemed to handle the track," she continued. "I think he will be a nice Cup horse, that is potentially his go. But he has done everything right and I think he is in with a bit of a show (in the Derby)."

No slowing Mustang

Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman are making a dual-pronged attack on the Mainland Auckland Futurity Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Ellerslie today with juveniles Mustang Valley (Vanbrugh) and Samarkand (Mongolian Khan). Mustang Valley has been supported from \$3.80 into \$3.40 since TAB markets opened and co-trainer Forsman believes the filly will be suited by the step up in distance after charging home late for second at Matamata over 1200 metres on debut. "She will need just a little bit of time to find her feet and if she can balance up and hit the line like she did at Matamata, she should be competitive," he said. "It's not an overly big field so if she is giving them a bit of a start, I don't think it'll be too much of a drama, but she has drawn better than what she did on debut, so I think midfield or thereabouts would be

ideal." Forsman believes Samarkand is better than his \$23 price after running a bold race for fourth on debut in the Champagne Stakes (Listed, 1600m) behind Lady Maroal (Power) and Atullibigeal (Street Boss). "He was first up in a mile on a testing track and I thought he acquitted himself really well. It brought him on," Forsman continued. "He's probably the forgotten horse in the race and I think he's a big improver from that first start."

Sharrock cleared of positive

A New Zealand Racing Integrity Unit investigation has exonerated Taranaki trainer Alan Sharrock from any fault in the two drug positives for methamphetamine returned by his horses, Alhambra Lad (Proisir) and Reliable Miss (Reliable Man), who won at Awapuni on ANZAC day. The cause of the positives has been identified as contamination of the race day accommodation the horses occupied on the day. An investigation into the cause of this contamination is ongoing.

ASIA

JPN: Derby clash of the sexes

Unbeaten colt Efforia (Epiphaneia) and top-class filly Satono Reinas (Deep Impact) are vying for favouritism ahead of the Tokyo Yushun, the Japanese Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) at Tokyo tomorrow. The Yuichi Shikato-trained Efforia is aiming to emulate Contrail (Deep Impact) last year and keep the triple crown dream alive following his Satsuki Sho (Gr 1, 2000m) success last time out. "He hasn't dropped his condition since the Satsuki Sho (Japanese 2000 Guineas) and he's in good shape," said jockey Takeshi Yokoyama. "He seems to have become stronger. In his last work, he finished off very well and kept things going until after the winning post, demonstrating his ability." Christophe Lemaire's mount Satona Reinas is aiming to become only the fourth filly to win the Derby and first since Vodka (Tanino Gimlet) in 2007. She placed second first-up on the Oka Sho (Gr 1, 1600m) last time and is trained by Almond Eye's (Lord Kanaloa) handler Sakae Kunieda. "She's a horse that hasn't reached her full potential, and while she might not have quite enough speed over a mile, 2400 metres will be good," Lemaire

said. "She has a lot of ability, and she gets the two kilogram allowance here." A field of 17 will go to post for the Classic.

HK: Callan returns at Sha Tin

Neil Callan returns from nearly two months out through suspension with six rides at Sha Tin tomorrow. A Hong Kong Jockey Club show cause hearing on April 7, made up of a three-person panel that included the vocally anti-democracy Pro-Beijing politician Martin Liao, initially suspended the Irishman's licence until the end of the Hong Kong season, based on Rule 14(2) relating to his behaviour at a race night stewards' inquiry at Happy Valley. That verdict was softened when the appeal panel on April 29 adjusted the suspension to conclude on May 27 rather than July 15. Callan only received HKJC clearance two weeks ago to resume riding trackwork.

HK: Derby winner in Lion Rock

Caspar Fownes is confident Hong Kong Derby (Listed, 2000m) winner Sky Darci (Darci Brahma) can capitalise on favourable weight conditions when he returns to action in the Lion Rock Trophy Handicap (Gr 3, 1600m) at Sha Tin tomorrow. The four-year-old will likely carry 115lb, 1lb over his allotted weight. "I'm extremely pleased, he's had a couple of nice trials, he's ready to go to the races," Fownes said. "He's come back nice and well, dropping back in trip now, he's got a fresh pair of legs, nice small field, he's going to be competitive. We still respect our opposition in those types of races." Sky Darci faces last year's winner Ka Ying Star (Cityscape) and Champions Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) runner-up More Than This (Dutch Art) at his first race since the Derby in March. "We just had a nice freshen up with him, he's got the miles in his legs to come back at this trip. More than anything, he's ready to go to the races now and I'm very happy with him," Fownes continued. "He might have one more race after this just depending on how he runs and how he pulls up. If he gives us a big effort, there's no reason why I wouldn't give him one more race on the 20th of June." That would be in the Premier Cup Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) or the Premier Plate Handicap (Gr 3, 1800m).

MAC: Derby Trial for Bolt

Beauty Bolt (Redoute's Choice) will attempt to enhance her Macau Derby (Listed, 1800m) credentials when she returns from a three-month spell in the Derby Trial (1500m) at Taipa today. The Simon Kwok-owned four-year-old placed fourth in the VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) in November 2019 and has raced four times in Macau for trainer Stanley Chin, winning her penultimate start before placing fifth last time, both over the 1500-metre trip. Beauty Bolt is set to face nine rivals.

INTERNATIONAL

Medaglia D'Oro colt tops Arqana Breeze Up Sale

A Medaglia D'Oro (El Prado) colt out of Shelbysmile (Smart Strike) topped the Arqana Breeze-Up Sale held at Goffs UK's Doncaster saleroom yesterday. Anthony Stroud sealed the clinching bid at €783,000 on behalf of Godolphin for the two-year-old, catalogued as lot 90. Elsewhere, Stuart Boman purchased a filly by Night Of Thunder (Dubawi) for €580,000 and a Ribchester (Iffraaj) filly was purchased for €684,400. €15,219,820 was traded yesterday, at an average of €98,600.

First for Galileo Gold

Galileo Gold (Paco Boy) sired his first stakes winner when Ebro River (2 c ex Soft Power by Balmont) won the National Stakes (Listed, 5f) at Sandown on Thursday evening. The Hugo Palmer-trained juvenile took the lead approaching the furlong pole in the straight dash, drifted left under James Doyle once

clear but drew away to win by three and a quarter lengths from Little Earl (Havana Gold) with Navello (Ivawood) a further three-quarters of a length behind in third. It was Ebro River's second win at his third start, having followed a sixth on debut at Newmarket with a win at Doncaster, also over five furlongs on soft going. Bred in Ireland by Tally-Ho Stud, the Al Shaqab Racing-owned youngster is out of Soft Power (Balmont), a winning half-sister to Girl Power (Key Of Luck), the dam of champion sprinter Slade Power (Dutch Art). Charlie Gordon Watson Bloodstock and Al Shaqab purchased Ebro River for 75,000 guineas out of Tattersalls Book 2 last October. Galileo Gold stands at Tally-Ho Stud for a fee of €5,000.

42 for Zoffany

The late Zoffany (Dansili) sired his 42nd individual stakes winner when Lismore (4 f ex Tecla by Whipper) powered up the Sandown hill to win the Henry II Stakes (Gr 3, 2m 50y) on Thursday under Jamie Spencer. The four-year-old led with half a mile to go and galloped on resolutely to finish four and a half lengths ahead of runner-up Ranch Hand (Dunaden) with Ocean Wind (Teofilo) another 11 lengths behind in third. The Irish raider was having her third start for trainer Henry de Bromhead, having worked her way up the ranks with four wins from 12 starts for her previous handler Sir Mark Prescott. Lismore was a 60,000 guineas buy-back at Tattersalls last December, with her owner-breeders Sonia and Anthony Rogers of Airlie Stud having purchased her dam Tecla (Whipper) for 190,000 guineas from the Ecurie

Christiane Head consignment at the same auction back in 2013. Tecla has also produced the Listed scorer Testa (Acclamation) and is herself a half-sister to the Group 3 winners Johnny Barnes (Acclamation) and Albisola (Montjeu).

UK: Glen takes Brigadier Gerard

Euchen Glen (Authorized) returned to form in style with a four-and-a-quarter-length success in the Brigadier Gerard Stakes (Gr 3, 1m 1f 209y) at Sandown on Thursday evening. The eight-year-old took the spoils ahead of Sangarius (Kingman), with Fox Tal (Sea The Stars) another length behind in third. Euchen Glen progressed through the handicap ranks last year, having been off the track for two years, and had his first tilt at Pattern company when fifth in the Goodwood Cup (Gr 1, 2m). He followed up with a pair of Group 3 wins at a mile and half but was then well down the field in three subsequent starts. The Jim Goldie-trained gelding showed the spark is still there when swooping from the back of the four-runner field under Paul Mulrennan. Euchen Glen was bred by his owner William Johnstone and is out of the winning mare Jabbara (Kingmambo), a daughter of Group 3 winner and Group 1-placed Isle De France (Nureyev). She is a half-sister to the dams of Japanese Grade 1 winners Mikki Isle (Deep Impact) and Aerolithe (Kurofune). Euchen Glen's third dam is the triple US Grade 1 winner Stella Madrid (Alydar). Johnstone purchased Jabbara out of the Darley consignment at the 2011 Goffs February Mixed Sale for €25,000.

Star hope to add Classic sparkle to Fiesta sale

Queensland has provided a memorable setting for Denise Martin's Star Thoroughbreds, both on the racetrack and in the sales ring and, after the million-dollar sale of multiple Group winner Fiesta (I Am Invincible) at this week's explosive Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale, the prominent syndicator is looking to add a pair of Classic contests to her enviable trophy haul in the state across consecutive weekends.

Tasmanian Martin has overseen the racing career and sale of two of the country's most prized breeding prospects in the last two years, with Invincibella (I Am Invincible), a Group 1 winner in Queensland of the Tattersall's Tiara (Gr 1, 1400m) and twice a winner at the lucrative Magic Millions raceday, fetching \$1.3 million at last year's Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale when knocked down to Coolmore, and Fiesta, a Group winner at two, three and five years of age, going one bid better, selling for \$1.35 million on the Gold Coast on Tuesday to heavy investors Rosemont Stud.

"We thought about it over the summer period that we might keep her (Fiesta) going for another year," revealed Martin, with Fiesta having claimed a pair of Group 3 victories in the Melbourne spring, her fourth and fifth at

stakes level and two triumphs which took the evergreen mare past the \$1.5 million mark in prize-money.

"But fairly recently, Chris (Waller, trainer) decided that the broodmare barn was

beckoning and that the right thing to do would be to retire her now.

"We hoped she could at least achieve the result of last year's broodmare sale when Invincibella made \$1.3 million, and she did."

Martin's star fillies cost just \$150,000 (Fiesta) and \$185,000 (Invincibella) at their respective yearling sales, with combined prize-money earnings and sales results marking an astounding return of \$7.1 million.

"We bought her (Fiesta) in Sydney at the Inglis Classic Sale for \$150,000 and she was a very good two-year-old. Joao Moreira rode her in the Gimcrack Stakes that year and said to the group that this will be the best filly to come out of this field today. And he wasn't too far from the mark," recalled Martin.

That third placing in the Gimcrack Stakes (Listed, 1000m) set the tone for what was to become unquestionably a glittering racetrack career for Fiesta, who won the Widden Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) at two and the Silver Shadow (Gr 2, 1200m) and Inglis Sprint (RL, 1200m) at three, however Martin recalls plenty of heartache in a career that yielded five seconds at Group level, including in all three races that make up the three-year-old Darley Princess

Series, culminating in the Flight Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick.

"We've got mixed emotions that we said goodbye to her, she's been a fantastic performer," continued Martin.

"On the day that Fiesta finished second in the Flight Stakes, it was an extraordinary day, because we had two outstanding chances in the Flight Stakes and the Epsom, and Fiesta was beaten just the bob of the head by Oohood and forty minutes later D'Argento was beaten by the same margin by Hartnell.

"I said to both owners at the end of the day 'the phone will be out of reach tomorrow, I need to get over just missing out on winning two Group 1s at Randwick, so phone me on Monday!'

"Fiesta was a terrific character and a terrific mare. Breeders crave high-class two-year-olds when they're available and to still be winning Group races at five, it was a great result.

"She's gone to a wonderful progressive farm and we very much look forward to following her progress in the years to come."

Yet the party may not just end with Fiesta for Star's loyal owners, with Martin, who famously won the Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1200m) with Sebring in 2008, in the unprecedented position of having two live contenders for Classic success at a carnival.

Recent Roshill winner Achiever (Pride Of Dubai) will bid to upset the all-conquering Luigi Muollo-owned Explosive Jack (Jakkalberry) in the Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) today, while Martin teams up with Muollo to race

Kiwi import Only Words (Sweynesse) in the Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2200m) at Eagle Farm a week later, a horse Martin purchased from the Novara Park studmaster as a tried horse after she won a Listed contest in her native New Zealand.

"I think, more importantly, it shows the brilliance of Chris Waller," said Martin. "Three months ago, if I had mentioned a Derby and an Oaks to the owners of Achiever and Only Words they would think it was a bit of a fanciful notion.

"The fact that Achiever has progressed really well this preparation to a more confident and more determined three-year-old, is testament to Chris's training style, and with Only Words, it's testament to what is needed to have a legitimate candidate for an Oaks in acquiring the filly last year."

Martin had her eyes set on Achiever after the strapping colt initially passed in at the Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale, negotiating a deal to purchase him for \$80,000.

"Achiever was a lovely yearling in Melbourne at the Premier sale," said Martin. "I saw the colt in Melbourne and he was a pass in, I just remember at the time thinking how much I wanted to buy him. The breeder was Bert Vieira, and I remember saying to Brett Howard, 'please could we just check that this horse is in fact available, because I think he's a very inexpensive horse.'"

Achiever is out of Lady Circles (Ascot Knight), a daughter of Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Circles Of Gold (Marscaj) and a half-sister to multiple Group 1 winners Haradasun (Fusaichi Pegasus) and Elvstroem (Daneshill) as well as the stakes-placed Hveger (Daneshill), dam of Highland Reel (Galileo), Cape Of Good Hope (Galileo) and Idaho (Galileo).

Nash Rawiller, who famously rode both Elvstroem and Haradasun in their careers, is on board the three-year-old today.

"He's just gone from strength to strength. When he led in the Frank Packer Plate and he gave a kick at the 150-metre mark, I was thinking 'this can't be possible!' and he ran very well (to finish third).

"Then when he ran last start at Rosehill he was very determined in holding off the Godolphin runner and I remember thinking at the time that this horse has just come of age.

"It's great to get Nash for the Derby because he has such an association with the family. He rides horses that like to sit on the pace really well. I understand that the top horse (Explosive Jack) deserves to be favourite. He's had a fantastic preparation and won everywhere."

Explosive Jack's breeder and owner Muollo goes from rival to partner for the Oaks a week later, as The Roses (Gr 2, 2000m) winner Only Words looks to back up in the Classic.

The filly is a product of a subtle dabble into the tried horse market for Martin, with Only Words, a filly who passed in for NZ\$2,000 as a weanling, acquired after claiming a Listed win at Wanganui.

"Over recent years we've addressed the issue of tried horses with Chris, and suddenly we've had some success, not at the elite level yet, but with horses like Humbolt Current and a tried horse that we bought through Dermot Weld called Masaff, who won last week.

"Over the last few years we've put a small toe in the water, as it were. It will never be a major part of our business, but we are very much interested in acquiring large shares in

tried horses from Europe, maybe three or four."

Martin has been surprised by the progress of the filly, a daughter of Muollo's young Champion First Season stallion Sweynesse (Lonhro), whose win in The Roses arrived after a stakes placing in the Gold Coast Bracelet (Listed, 1800m) and a victory at Canterbury in April.

"When Only Words was available, Chris sought to try and acquire the horse, knowing the owner and trainer in New Zealand with whom he'd had associations in the past. So he approached both to ask if Only Words could be bought and our Star owners bought a sizable percentage of the filly," said Martin.

"When she won at Canterbury three starts back, I felt she was developing into a talented filly. But I don't think that any of us, six months ago, would have thought she'd be winning a Group 2 at Doomben through this carnival.

"Craig Williams was very happy with her and Chris was delighted. Clearly barriers that day, in a big field, didn't go the way of some of the favoured horses that day, but she was very strong and you would think she'd be one of the major chances next week.

"I'll get through the Derby first but the Oaks we can be very much involved with."

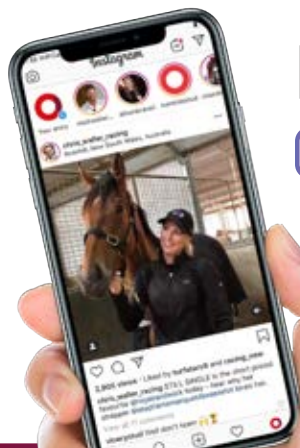
