rainers are set to be given the goahead to step up their horses' work next week at Kranji Racecourse ahead of the likely return of Singapore racing from the start of July, in what has been a coronavirus-hit period that stakeholders hope is the catalyst for the revitalisation of the country's industry.

Racing in Singapore has withered over the past decade, with declining wagering revenues impacting prize-money levels and the axing of feature races in the once vibrant Asian jurisdiction, with the Covid-19 pandemic the latest setback.

Racing at Kranji was initially suspended until May 4 after the Singapore Turf Club's meeting on April 3, due to a spike in coronavirus infections. That suspension was subsequently extended until June 30 but trainers are expected to receive the green light to restart fast work.

"We're a small island country, so the government is doing everything to get (coronavirus) under control and it is probably stricter than most," leading trainer Stephen Gray said yesterday. Continued on page 2>>

<< Continued from page 1 "They were doing a good job until they had an issue with all the workers in the dormitories which they are solving now and they are on top of that.

"It was announced (on Thursday) that they are going to open things up pretty strongly at the end of June, or even before, so I think for us personally we have just to wait until then and it is looking like racing will restart in July.

"We've been allowed to start galloping our horses again from next week, so I think we're heading in that direction."

Fellow Singapore trainer Michael Clements was "hopeful" the July racing return will come to fruition but admitted the government was yet to confirm that was the case.

"It's still in play with all these government agencies who need to approve everything," Clements said.


"From the beginning when they stopped racing, we've been able to keep the horses ticking over by giving them slow conditioning work and then two weeks ago we were able to start giving them 14 to 15-second furlongs, so we are hoping that we can step it up to normal next week and then hoping for trials in the middle of June and racing at the beginning of July.

"We're 50 per cent there but we're not over the line yet."

Debbie Hawkins, the operations manager at the Singapore Association of Racehorse Trainers. said stable staffing levels had been maintained, with some Malaysians living on site for more than two months due to the closure of the border between the two countries.

"We do have Malaysian

workers who have been amazing because the Malaysia border got locked down on March 17, so those poor guys have been here since then without seeing their families," Hawkins said.

"The trainers have been great by setting up home for them at the stables and the government checks on them on a weekly basis, so it is very controlled and we are very grateful to the Malaysian staff."

The feature Singapore Derby (Listed, 1800m), the Kranji Mile (Listed, 1600m) (restricted to Singapore horses only this year) and Lion City Cup (Listed, 1200m) are all set to be rescheduled in July after becoming casualties of the lockdown.

The Singapore Turf Club has made a number of changes in recent years to shore up the sport, and Gray believes the Covid-19 pandemic may help lead to a further overhaul and government recognition to help turnaround the industry's fortunes.

"They've been going through the doldrums a bit and I think now hopefully management can get the government to change their mentality and thinking a bit and open it up a bit more. I hope it goes that way and then we can be a bit more positive about it," said Gray, who has trained in Singapore for the past 20 years.

"They can change betting structures and opportunities a bit more because if it doesn't, it might be a bit of a worry for the long-term situation and certainly in the short-term anyway."

The spotlight has been placed on many racing industries around the world during the health crisis and Clements hopes Singapore decision makers also take note.

"I think the worldwide racing industry has been exposed with all that is happening," he said.

"Certainly, all governments have had to take more of a focus on many industries in their country and racing being one of them. Obviously, we are hoping that the same ripple effect will happen here."

The economic impact of the coronavirus pandemic and the closure of racing for this period could also hinder the amount of reinvestment in new horses over the next few months, particularly being sourced from Australia and New Zealand.

Clements trains for prominent owners including Thai businessman Krit Chittaseni's Falcon Racing and King Power Stable, which is also managed by the large-scale Singapore racing investor. Continued on page 4>>

<< Continued from page 2 Zimbabwean Clements, who works closely with New Zealand agent Bevan Smith, is a regular attendee of Australian and New Zealand yearling and two-year-old sales, while he has also ventured further afield, including to South America.

"Generally, the mood of owners putting their hands in their pockets again for new young stock is very subdued with the circumstances," he said.

"However, I am sure once we get back racing again, it won't take them long to get back into the swing of things. My last trip was to Argentina where I was fortunate enough to get a couple of yearlings before everything closed

"Obviously, travel restrictions will play a part. I really like to be there to see the horses (at the sales). Hopefully things start to come back online towards the end of year."

Gray indicated that he and his clients may look more closely at young horses emerging from barrier trials if travel restrictions remain in place, but he was also cognisant of the fact that his owners would want to see how Singapore racing responds after the current lockdown ends.

"I have a lot of young horses that my clients have bought, but they might miss the two-year-old series or the three-year-old series, so these owners who have invested a lot want to see what Singapore Turf Club is going to do for them and that all comes down to prize-money and the way they structure their racing from here on," he said.

"If it's not done properly and the owners and patrons aren't going to get looked after, they won't reinvest. They won't stay in the game.

"Australia has proven in the past ten years that it is all about prizemoney and looking after the owner.

"We have had a downturn over that time in Singapore, but it is still

OK and it's a lot better than New Zealand and it's still probably a lot better than Australia for the class of horse that we have."

But Gray warned if the regression continued, the appetite for owners to race horses in Singapore could further decline and threaten the viability of the local industry.

"I've got good owners, but I've noticed in the past two or three years the lack of interest and it's been harder to syndicate and sell horses. It's dropped off quite a bit," he said.

"With the coronavirus, is that going to be worse? Probably yes because everyone has businesses and that is going to be the same for

Australia, New Zealand and Hong Kong - everywhere in the world."

Hawkins, who represents the Singapore trainers, said the pandemic had demonstrated that the racing industry can adapt.

"I think it's been a huge learning curve for everybody. You show a little bit of initiative when times get hard and by doing things differently and approaching it from a different aspect," she said.

"You look at the Inglis sales and how successful they were and the broodmare sales and the online sales with Magic Millions. New Zealand Bloodstock have got the South Island Sale coming up online as well."

Two for Kermadec

Darley first season sire Kermadec (Teofilo) landed his second winner yesterday when Seduction Queen (2 f ex Seduction Line by Testa Rossa) took out a 1300-metre maiden for fillies and mares on debut. Trained by Richard and Michael Freedman, the filly defeated Petaluma (Pierro) by a length with Natanya (Pierro) coming home a further length and half away in third. Purchased by Heart Thoroughbreds for \$80,000 at Book 2 of the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Seduction Queen is one of seven foals to race out of Seduction Line (Testa Rossa), making her a half-sister to four-time stakes winner Snippets Land (Snippetson) as well as Listed-placed Canny Franco (Canny Lad). Group 1 winner Kermadec stands at Darley's Kelvinside property for a fee of \$13,750 (inc GST) in 2020.

Two for Scissor Kick

Former Arrowfield resident Scissor Kick (Redoute's Choice) sired his second winner vesterday as Dzsenifer (2 f ex Phaedra by Hussonet) took out the TAB QTIS 2YO Plate (1400m) at the Gold Coast. The Gary Duncantrained filly defeated See Marie (Sebring) by a length and a quarter with Corvo (Spirit Of Boom) a nose back in third. Dzsenifer was purchased by Duncan for \$32,000 from the Arrowfield draft at Book 2 of the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. She is one of three winners out of Phaedra (Hussonet) while her granddam Bella Cantata (Stravinsky) is a halfsister to Group 1 scorer Inaflury (Zabeel). Scissor Kick stood at Arrowfield Stud for four seasons and shuttled to Haras d'Etreham in France where he now permanently resides.

Cliff's Edge to stand at Rangal Park Stud

After being retired from racing last month, dual Group 2 winner Cliff's Edge (Canford Cliffs) will begin his stallion career at Victorian farm Rangal Park Stud this season. The son of Canford Cliffs (Tagula) had 30 starts for eight wins including the Crystal Mile (Gr 2, 1600m), Alister Clark Stakes (Gr 2, 2040m), Caulfield Classic (Gr 3, 2000m) and Manfred Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m). Cliff's Edge will stand alongside Soul Patch (Shamus Award), Boom Time (Flying Spur) and Danerich (Danehill) at Rangal Park for a fee of \$6,600 (inc GST).

Schweida poses Fred Best speed map query

Kelly Schweida admitted he is worried about the race pattern for today's Fred Best Classic (Gr 3, 1350m) at Doomben, after The Odyssey (Better Than Ready) drew an outside barrier of 13 in the 14 horse field. He said had the gelding drawn a soft barrier he would have been able to get an easy lead but that had changed with the wide gate. "The Odyssey is very quick out of the barrier but he has shown he doesn't have to lead. I don't think there is anything that can go with him but maybe a couple drawn inside him will want to kick up," Schweida said. "It would be lovely to think he could get across with cover but that might be wishful thinking."

Boomtown Lass chasing Hinkler success

Chris Anderson is hoping Boomtown Lass (Spirit Of Boom) can overcome another wide draw when she contests the Hinkler Handicap (Listed, 1110m) at Doomben today. The 1110 metre start at Doomben can be a real problem for horses drawn wide on the track, but Boomtown Lass is proof that isn't always the case as she is one of only a few horses to win from a barrier outside seven from the start this season. "Last time she went around at the 1110 metres she drew barrier 13," Anderson said. "The horses inside her went berserk and next thing we knew she was third on the fence. It would be too much to expect that to happen again but it did show she doesn't necessarily have to lead. The other unusual thing is a lot of other pace in Saturday's race is drawn wide as well. It will make things interesting."

Wide draw for Vanna Girl

The Toby and Trent Edmonds-trained Vanna Girl (Husson) faces a major test in today's Pam O'Neill Stakes (Listed, 1600m) at Doomben, as she starts from barrier 12 of 14 for her main leadup run before her target race in The Roses (Gr 2, 1800m) on June 13. "Under different circumstances you can ride her back and she will run on as well. So she is versatile," Trent Edmonds said. "The Roses is 1800 metres and that is her target. After that we can give her a break and think about the spring when dates are decided." Before the coronavirus restrictions, which decimated the winter schedule, the O'Neill was not on the radar for Vanna Girl who was headed to the Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m). "It is a pity she missed a Group 1 shot this season but there is plenty around later this year," Edmonds added.

Longer journey for Superium

The Joe Pride-trained Superium (Verrazano) will resume in today's Iron Jack Handicap at Rosehill over 1100 metres, a distance over which he is a three-time winner. While Pride believes sprinting is the horse's forte, his owner is adamant he will be better over further, and the trainer is happy to put that theory to the test this campaign. "We agree to disagree at this stage, me and the owner. I think he's a dead-set sprinter and the owner has always thought he could get over a bit of ground," Pride said. "We'll find out this preparation I think."

City test for Pride Of Dubai filly

Canberra trainer Nick Olive is hopeful his opinion of Proud Mia (Pride Of Dubai) will be proven correct when the two-year-old is tested at metropolitan level for the first time in the Darley 2YO Handicap (1100m) at Rosehill today. "I think she goes pretty well and I just want to see where she fits in," Olive said. "I'm not saying she's going to go there and win but I just want to see where she fits in with a better class of horse. It is exciting but I'm a little bit anxious about it too. She's got to handle a heavy track, she's got to handle the 1100 metres. But if she came out and won it would be very exciting, for sure. I have got an opinion of the horse but she needs to show us where she's at now and where we think she might be next preparation."

Bottega to take on older horses

A horse of Bottega's (Snitzel) quality would normally be spelling at this time of year in preparation for the spring, but his immaturity has prompted Gerald Ryan to keep the three-year-old in work to educate him in the off-season races and build his rating and prize-money to help him qualify for bigger races. Today, Bottega faces a test against the older horses in the Lord Mayors Cup (Listed, 2000m) at Rosehill. "He was still doing things wrong and he needed to get his rating up and a bit of stake money up so he could get a run (in better races)," Ryan said. "He's starting to get it all together. His last start was the first time he went to the races and did everything right." Ryan has pencilled in a summer preparation and hopes to target the Villiers Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) or Summer Cup (Gr 3, 2000m) before the horse joins in with the traditional autumn carnival timetable.

Translator chasing hat-trick

Since being gelding at the end of a winless spring campaign, the Nigel Blackiston-trained Translator (Helmet) is undefeated from two starts and will aim for a hat-trick in the Nick Johnstone Real Estate Handicap (1600m) at Caulfield today. "We gelded him after the spring carnival and gave him some extra time out and he's developed mentally as well as physically," Blackiston said. "The pleasing thing is there is still more improvement to come. He's had a bit over four weeks between runs now so he's still got freshness in his legs. Hopefully if the weather pattern is on our side we can take him to Flemington on June 20 for a 2000-metre race then."

Hang Man ready to bounce back

After disappointing Mike Moroney on a heavy track at his last start when fourth over 1600 metres, Hang Man (Windsor Knot) returns to Caulfield for a rise in distance in better going. Moroney sees a rise to 2000 metres in today's Neds Toolbox Handicap as ideal, along with firmer footing. "If you look at his form his win on a heavy track was in a maiden at Terang when he was too good for them and other than that his form has been on better ground, so we're hoping that is all it was," Moroney said. "He got the right run, travelled up nicely with the blinkers on, didn't over-race, put himself in the race, looked the winner, but was disappointing late."

JJ Atkins tilt for Tick Tock Boom

After taking out the QTIS 2YO Maiden (1200m) at the Sunshine Coast yesterday, David Vandyke confirmed that Tick Tock Boom (Spirit Of Boom) will back up in next Saturday's J J Atkins Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m). The two-year-old colt yesterday won by a comfortable margin of two lengths and has guaranteed himself a start in the juvenile feature at Eagle Farm.

Kinane spelled with Caulfield Cup aspirations

Chris Waller has declared the Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) as a spring target for Kinane (Reliable Man) after pulling the pin on his winter campaign. Waller said the Frank Packer Plate (Gr 3, 2000m) winner had been in work for a long time and the decision was made to give him a break after his defeat as a short-priced favourite in the Gunsynd Classic (Gr 3, 1800m) at Eagle Farm last week. "We are going to give him every opportunity to get to the Caulfield Cup, obviously qualify first and have him peaking for that race," Waller said. "I am looking forward to the spring with him. He is a very promising horse with a lot of upside."

Behemoth remains in training

After a runner-up performance in The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) last start, trainer David Jolly has kept Behemoth (All Too Hard) in light work with no future targets set in stone. "Ideally we would have loved to have gone to Brisbane and had a crack at the Stradbroke and my gut feeling is he is just starting to reach the peak of his powers," Jolly told Racing.com. "Anyway, he is just hanging around home for now, spending a lot of time in the paddock and coming in for some light treadmill work. Being such a big horse, we feel it will be in our best interest for when we start to crank him up again for the spring. With the uncertainty still of programming with the Covid-19 situation, we don't have anything set in stone for him, but we do think his main goals will be around the 1400-1600-metre trips."

Mystic Journey back in work

Group 1-winning Tasmanian mare Mystic Journey (Needs Further) is back in work at Adam Trinder's stables as the trainer begins planning her spring campaign. "She's in really good order. I hope and trust she is going to be the beneficiary of a really light autumn preparation moving into the spring," Trinder told Racing.com. "Our plan is to kick off in the Bletchingly (Stakes). That was the plan last year, but we avoided the first run due to wet ground and went straight to the (P.B.) Lawrence (Stakes) over 1400 metres. The mindset is potentially the Bletchingly if the ground is all right, failing that, she will kick off in the Lawrence a couple of weeks later ... if it's a couple of weeks later. It remains to be seen."

Classique Legend wins heat

Talented sprinter Classique Legend (Not A Single Doubt) made his first public appearance since November, taking out a 910-metre trial at Canterbury yesterday. Ridden by Kerrin McEvoy, the four-year-old gelding cruised home to a two and a quarter length victory ahead of the Bjorn Baker-trained Tony's Reward (Reward For Effort). Classique Legend is now likely to head towards the Bob Charley AO Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Randwick next Saturday.

Not An Option wins trial

Former New Zealand-trained colt Not An Option (Not A Single Doubt) had his second trial for his new trainers Richard and Michael Freedman yesterday, taking out the 1100-metre two-year-old heat by a length and a half. The son of Not A Single Doubt (Redoute's Choice) is now likely to head to Queensland for the J J Atkins Stakes.

Master Montaro remains unbeaten

Master Montaro (Toronado) will do his future racing in Hong Kong, after winning his second start in a BM70 Handicap over 1140 metres at Geelong yesterday. The three-year-old was purchased for \$1.5 million following his debut win for Richard Laming at Pakenham in March. Unfortunately for his new connections Master Montaro did not receive a high enough rating in that victory to go straight to Hong Kong, but yesterday's three-length win against older horses will be enough for the gelding to race in Hong Kong. Now in the hands of the Lindsay Park stable of David and Ben Hayes and Tom Dabernig, Master Montaro will race for David Haves when the trainer makes the move to Hong Kong next month.

Perryman to take up Twin Hills role

Andrew Perryman is set to join Twin Hills Stud at Cootamundra as Stud Manager. He will be replacing Steve Brien who is retiring at the end of July after 33 years at Twin Hills. "We are thrilled that Andrew will be joining us at Twin Hills as our Stud Manager," Twin Hills owner Olly Tait said. "I know Andrew well and I am

excited that the leadership and horsemanship skills he has developed internationally and at some of Australia's best thoroughbred farms will be at the centre of our ongoing development. We are really looking forward to welcoming Andrew, Jodi and their children to Twin Hills. It is difficult to express how grateful we are to Steve Brien for all he has done in his time at Twin Hills. He is a terrific fellow. Hopefully we can continue to draw on his experience, abilities and enthusiasm but Steve certainly deserves a long and happy retirement."

Tosen Stardom weanlings to hit the market

Tosen Stardom's (Deep Impact) first crop weanlings are set to go through the sales ring in the upcoming Inglis and Magic Millions weanling sales. A selection of weanlings by the dual Group 1 winner will head to the Inglis Great Southern Sale including a Woodside Park Stud filly out of Balsamico (Redoute's Choice) and Noorilm Park's colt out of Awaayed (Hard Spun). "I've found the Tosen Stardom's foals very straightforward during the initial weaning process," Noorilm Park's Sherah Sullivan said. "They're all very correct have good bone and plenty of substance. Being naturally athletic, I would be very surprised if he doesn't leave some talented gallopers."

Arrowfield to offer broodmares unreserved

TRSA to meet with clubs over restrictions

Thoroughbred Racing South Australia are set to meet with key South Australian racing figures to begin planning for spectators to return to the racetrack. "We are having initial

discussions with our clubs next week as to what it might look like and just to get a feel for what the numbers are," TRSA boss boss Nick Redid said. "Obviously to conduct a race meeting you've got a core group of people that have to be on course just to put the show on, so to say. It's going to take a significant uplift with the current restrictions we have here for us to get people back on course. Then you've got to balance out the clubs which are all membership-based organisations wanting to get back to their clubs, against owners who have continued to pay and race their horses through this period. So we've got to find a balance and we will work with our clubs on that next week."

Century up for Pike

Leading Perth jockey William Pike has notched up 100 metropolitan winners in a season for the fourth time in his career, riding a double at Belmont on Wednesday. "I was aware going into the meeting that I only needed the two winners, so it was nice to bring it up early," Pike told Racing.com. "With the calibre of horses that I get to ride every week, it's a goal that I look to achieve each year and I'm glad I've done it again. I'm not going to reach the 148 metro winners I rode last year, but I've ridden in Melbourne more this year and obviously Covid-19 has changed a few things as well."

McGillivrary to wear neck brace

Jockey Matt McGillivray will be in a neck brace for a fortnight after falling from Bel Strider (Unusual Suspect) at the 150-metre mark at the Sunshine Coast on Wednesday night. He was knocked unconscious and suffered facial and neck injuries. Queensland Jockeys Association boss Glen Prentice said McGillivray remained in hospital yesterday but was expected to be discharged at the weekend. "He is walking around and hopeful of being allowed home shortly," Prentice said. "When he may be able to return to the saddle is unknown, he is still awaiting a full diagnosis. He will have to wear a neck brace for a week or two for head and neck stability."

Vale Shane Yates

Tamanian race caller Shane Yates sadly lost his battle with cancer on Thursday. Yates became a full-time race caller in 2012 after making his way into commentary at 17 when he started with TNT9 in Launceston which saw him call races and present the sports segment on the nightly news.

Cherry Tortoni (Night Of Thunder) is owned by Sandy Tait and his sister Jill Nivison, and not Olly Tait, as was reported in yesterday's ANZ. The gelding, who won impressively at Sale on his first start, was also bred by Sandy Tait, and was raised at Olly Tait's Twin Hills Stud.

NEW ZEALAND

Talented Blaze Seven to join O'Shea stable

New Plymouth trainer Warren Bolton has been a successful producer of horses over the 25 or so years he has had a licence, and his latest promising filly Blaze Seven (Sacred Falls) will join Sydney trainer John O'Shea after owner-trainer Bolton decided to sell the majority of the two-year-old. "I bought her at the Ready to Run in November from New Zealand Bloodstock after seeing her run up," Bolton said. "She's always shown outstanding ability right from day one. She went massive in her first start against older horses after walking out of the gates. Then I got a call from Danny Rolston from New Zealand Bloodstock on behalf of trainer John O'Shea in Sydney. We initially said no to the offers but what sealed the deal after a couple of weeks was that he let Claire and I and the kids stay in for ten percent."

Clotworthys bring team back up to speed

Training partners Shaun and Emma Clotworthy are hoping they can pick up where they left off after the coronavirus pandemic halted their career-best season. The couple have trained 22 winners from 164 runners so far in 2019-20, placing them among the top 15 on the national trainers' premiership. "The season was going really well for us - it's been the best one we've

ever had," Shaun Clotworthy said. "So it was a shame that it was interrupted by the lockdown but there's not a lot you can do about it." The couple have around 30 horses in work and have sent out an impressive strike rate throughout this season.

Unchartered territory for South Island Sale

New Zealand thoroughbred auctions have moved into uncharted territory with the launch of New Zealand Bloodstock's South Island Sale on Gavelhouse Plus. The southern yearling session was originally due to take place in Christchurch in April but was cancelled due to the coronavirus pandemic. It will now be held online on the enhanced Gavelhouse Plus platform from May 28 to June 7, consisting of 65 lots. All unbroken yearlings offered through the 2020 South Island Sale on Gavelhouse Plus will be eligible for the Karaka Million Series featuring two NZ\$1 million races - the Karaka Million 2YO (RL, 1200m) and the Karaka Million 3YO Classic (RL, 1600m), in addition to the NZ\$100,000 Karaka Cup (2200m), which graduates can contest in for the duration of their career.

Son of Snitzel to stand in New Zealand

The Hawke's Bay breeding industry has been boosted by the announcement that Sneaking To Win, a well-bred son of Snitzel (Redoute's Choice), will begin stud duties for local breeders Steve Brougham and Jenni Tomlins this season. The four-year-old raced three times for Peter and Paul Snowden, placing second behind subsequent Up & Coming Stakes (Gr 3, 1300m) winner Master Ash (Sebring). A \$450,000 yearling, Sneaking To Win's career was curtailed by a cyst and subsequent complications following an operation. He is out of three-time winner Disguise (Grand Lodge) and is a half-brother to four-time Group 1 scorer Appearance (Commands) and stakes winner Mascareri (Commands). Sneaking To Win will stand his first season in Hawke's Bay for a fee of NZ\$1,000 (plus GST) including a non refundable \$100 usage fee and Live Foal Guarantee. A small number of lifetime breeding rights are available.

Horses tested after Theileria equi infection

The ongoing testing by the Ministry for Primary Industries (MPI) is providing optimism that the discovery of Theileria equi infection is a single, isolated case. The horse concerned was imported to New Zealand by Cambridge Stud for breeding in February 2019 and returned positive for Theileria equi as part of standard export certification prior to shipment to Australia. Further MPI blood tests have confirmed the horse was positive, despite displaying no signs of illness during its time in New Zealand. At the time of the import, the horse met all New Zealand's requirements including testing negative for Theileria equi within the required 21 days before its shipment. Other horses at Cambridge Stud have undergone testing by ministry scientists. The testing is to give confidence that the operation is free of the Theileria equi and that there has been no transmission within the farm.

Keeneland officials yesterday announced the launch of the Keeneland Digital Sales Ring, a stand-alone online auction platform accessible to buyers and sellers around the world at Keenelanddigital.com. Kicking off the new digital platform will be a Select Horses of Racing Age Sale scheduled for June 23. "The Keeneland Digital Sales Ring marks a significant milestone in our rich sales history and expands the realm of high-quality sales options Keeneland can deliver," Keeneland president and CEO Bill Thomason said. "This tool does not replace Keeneland's traditional live sales format but rather provides us the flexibility to host small, select auctions throughout the year." Keeneland developed the Digital Sales Ring platform together with Kentucky-based technology company Horseco and it is similar to the successful Magic Millions Online technology.

Kentucky Derby hope retired

Nadal (Blame), one of the leading fancies for the Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f) has been retired after fracturing his left front lateral condylar. The injury was diagnosed after the colt worked at Santa Anita for trainer Bob Baffert. He went into surgery at the equine hospital at the Southern California track, owner George Bolton said. "It requires two screws," Bolton told Bloodhorse. "He is now going to become a stallion. It's very sad, obviously. I just got the call this morning. It's a call you never want to get in horse racing. He retires undefeated. He retires, thank God, on a soon-to-be-recovery. He gave us four great races." Nadal was the leader on the Road to the Kentucky Derby with 150 points. After a maiden win on January 19, he then won two Grade 2 races before winning the Arkansas Derby (Gr 1, 9f) on his last start.

TBA announce **Great British Bonus**

The Thoroughbred Breeders Association have announced a new prize scheme to safeguard the future of British racing and breeding through the Great British Bonus (GBB). The GBB will offer multiple bonuses of up to £20,000 per eligible race for British-bred fillies and mares. The aim of the bonus is to ensure that more British-bred fillies and mares are in demand as racing prospects, encouraging breeders and owners to race fillies. The number of eligible races this year will be dependent on the racing programme, rising to approximately 3,000 in 2022. Breeders, owners, trainers, jockeys, stable-staff and pinhookers will all benefit from the bonus. There will be six opportunities to win the bonus next week, upon the resumption of British racing.

Goffs UK Doncaster **Premier Yearling Sale Moved to September**
