## Marquand and Addeybb set for Sydney return in 2021

*The pair are aiming to replicate their two  
Group 1 victories earlier this year*

Tom Marquand and Addeybb (Pivotal) will bid to repeat their Ranvet Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) and Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) double in 2021 with both the jockey and Addeybb's trainer William Haggas yesterday confirming to ANZ Bloodstock News they will return in the new year, despite Covid-19-related complications.

Marquand landed the first Group 1 of his career at Rosehill in March, which acted as a springboard for his most successful season yet, and is lining up a February return to Australian racetracks.

The former British champion apprentice has applied for a three-month visa and, if approved, he will have to endure a two-week hotel quarantine before again gracing Australian turf following his highly successful time earlier this year. *Continued on page 3 >>*

Marquand will ride in Australia until at least the Queen Elizabeth Stakes, which takes place at Randwick on Saturday, April 10.

"I've applied for my visa and exemptions and it's all looking positive, but I'm not sure on the exact timing. My guess would be February, simply because of the duration of my visa," Marquand told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"With Addeybb being a rough plan to go back, in theory my visa will have to last until the start of April. So obviously the three-month visa limits when I can go.

"I have to do two weeks quarantine in a hotel when I get there, so it's all a bit messy compared to a normal year, but as long as it happens then that's the main thing."

Marquand, who described his venture to Australia as "the trip of a lifetime" on his return to Britain earlier this year, will be unable to

replicate the two separate stints he did previously. One long trip is his preferred method this time around, which eradicates the need for a double dose of quarantine.

"If I did it in two trips, it would wipe out a month of my visa sat in a hotel which seems a bit pointless. So I will do it in one trip this year and see how I go."

Addeybb, who added another Group 1 win to his 2020 tally with victory in the Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 1m2f) at Ascot last month, will likely attack the same two Sydney races again, with Haggas reluctant to change the winning formula.

A trip to Hong Kong, where Marquand is due to ride in next month's International Jockeys Challenge at Happy Valley, was mooted for the 11-time winner as well as the Dubai World Cup Carnival in the new year, but Haggas is likely to keep the son of Pivotal (Polar Falcon) fresh for another shot at the Ranvet.

"I don't want to go to Dubai. Well, I'd love to go to Dubai, but he's shown a preference for cut in the ground and it doesn't usually rain in Dubai, and ditto with Saudi Arabia," Haggas told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"We've looked after him for the first six years of his life and we'll keep just trying to find the right spot for him.

"There's three or four months to go and lots of things can go wrong, but all things being equal then we'll aim him for the same two races he ran in last year. I don't see a reason to change that really."

Reflecting on Addeybb's achievements in March and April, Haggas added: "It was fantastic, absolutely great, but we were extremely fortunate, it very much went our way the whole time."

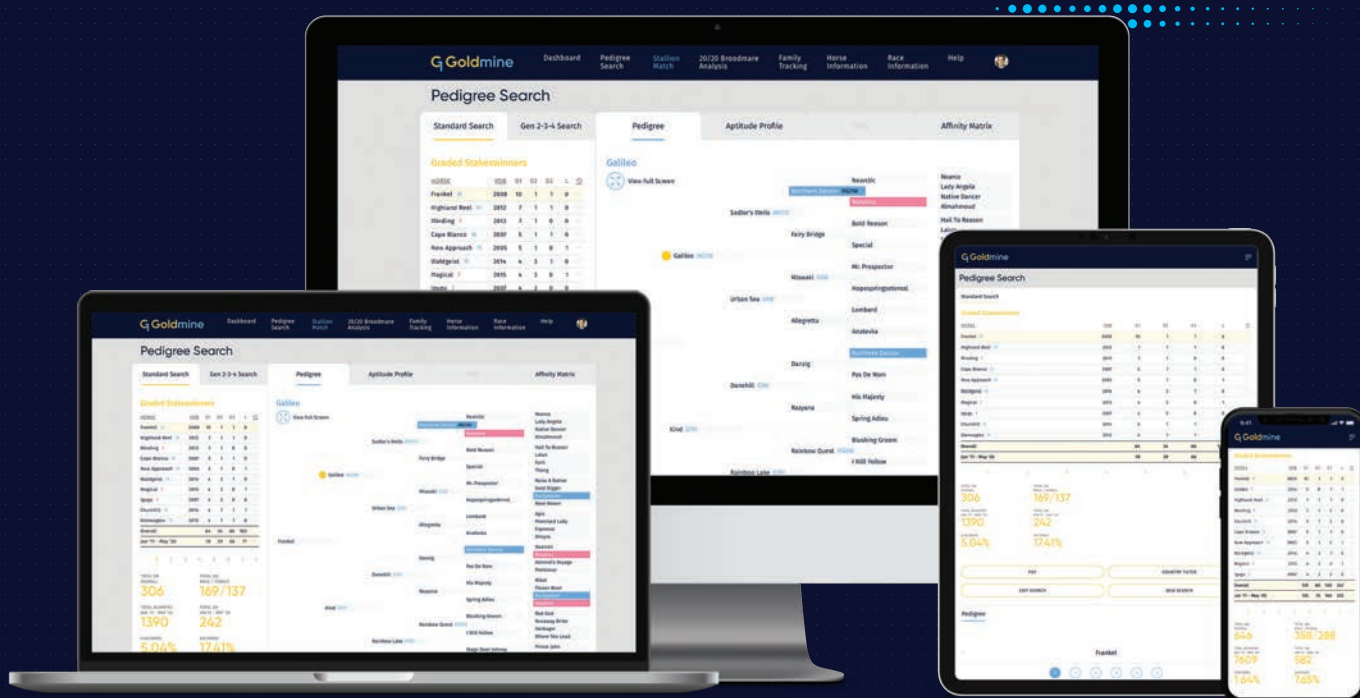

<< *Continued from page 3* “Everything that we wanted to happen, happened. I said to my assistant at the time, Harry Eustace, that it would never happen again like that and I don’t suspect it will, but we’ll be trying.”

Marquand concurred with the dual British Classic-winning trainer, but joked his stay might not have been quite so rosey had Addeybb not recorded the two elite-level wins.

“It was huge because it came at a pretty weird time. I was over there when everyone at home was in lockdown and racing had stopped, but I was in lockdown there myself.

“I picked up quite a significant injury so I was sat by myself in a flat in the middle of Sydney for most of the time, riding twice a week.

“The two winners were major and it started off what ended up being an incredible year, but if Addeybb hadn’t have won it would’ve been a pretty miserable stay!”

While Australian supporters of Marquand can begin to get excited about his upcoming return, they will have to wait at least another year before his partner Hollie Doyle graces the turf down under, after Covid-19 restrictions put paid to the possibility of her making her Australian debut this summer.

Doyle has had a remarkable season in Britain, with her feats including a first Group 1 victory, breaking her own record for most wins by a female jockey in a calendar year and most recently being crowned the 2020 Sunday Times Sportswoman of the Year.

“This year it’s not going to happen,” Marquand said of Doyle riding in Australia. “On a normal year where there was no quarantine, it might have been something she would’ve considered.

“But because I’m very lucky and know what I’m going over to and for - obviously the trainers that supported me last year I hope they’re going to put me up again - whereas for Hollie it would be a bit of a fact-finding mission.

“No doubt she would fly over there, but to waste two weeks sat in a hotel to then only do a month or six weeks riding it’s probably not really worth it this year. But no doubt it will be something she’ll end up doing in the future.”

Despite the impact of Covid-19 on British racing, which was halted in March and did not resume until the beginning of June, Marquand managed to surpass his previous personal best for the number of British winners in a calendar year, with his 137th coming courtesy of the Queen's filly Companionship (Galileo) at Chelmsford on Friday night.

Companionship is the first foal out of the top-class Sweet Idea (Snitzel), who won The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m) and several Group 2 races for Gai Waterhouse, before being sold to the Queen's racing adviser John Warren five years ago.

Companionship is a two-year-old filly trained by Haggas, and Marquand believes she has a big future ahead of her.

"She obviously is a filly to really look forward to in the future. She ran massive on debut and finished off with great effect," he said.

"I was really looking forward to

riding her the other evening at Chelmsford and some people probably said she wasn't as impressive as she should've been, but Chelmsford is a track that is very sharp and it probably didn't play to her strengths.

"She improved for her first run nicely and no doubt she will take a big step forward for having the winter under her belt. It's always nice to find a good one for Her Majesty and hopefully this filly can fulfill that promise."

On riding for the Queen, Marquand added: "They are the most significant colours in British racing and it's always something that gives you extra pleasure riding winners for.

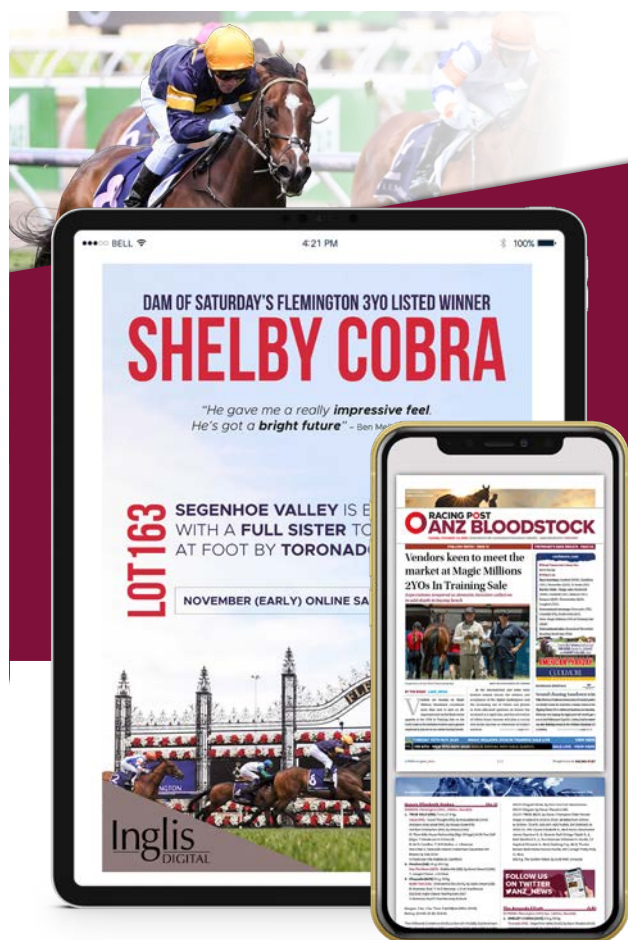

# MORNING BRIEFING

## Locals take Jericho Cup

Count Zero (Zed) outstayed his rivals to land Australia's longest Flat race and provide the local duo of Symon Wilde and Luke 'Stumpy' Williams a cherished win in yesterday's Jericho Cup (4600m). Sent off a \$26 chance, the six-year-old relished the test of the Warrnambool marathon as he registered a first win in 11 starts this year by beating the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained pair of Dambulla (Fastnet Rock) and Wil John (Reset) by a comfortable four and a half lengths. "In this race's short history it's been a bit of an aim of ours after we were fortunate enough to win the Grand Annual to also win this race," Wilde said. "It's not a pop-up race or money-grab like some of the other ones are, I think it's got real depth and meaning and it is a real honour to win the race." Williams was equally delighted with the victory. "It's a real thrill, I'm pretty sure that's the biggest race I've won," he told Racing.com. "I went into the race pretty confident. I walked the track this morning and I knew there was a couple of spots where I could seriously make up ground without doing anything, if I could get to them of course. When I went up the hill the second time he just rolled up there easily and was making ground beautifully. We stayed out on the better ground and made the ground we needed to and got the job done which was awesome."

## Another feature for Zed

Grangewilliam Stud stallion Zed (Zabeel) is having a spring to remember. The unheralded stallion is the sire of six-time Group 1 winner Verry Elleegant, in addition to Ballarat Cup (Listed, 2000m) hero Irish Flame, while the stallion's versatility extends to champion jumpers such as Zed Em and venerable Group

1 winner Survived. And now a Jericho winner can be added to the stallion's success stories. Count Zero was bred by Wanganui farmer Peter Smith and hails from a family that features 1936 Melbourne Cup winner Wotan (Siefried), who was raced by Smith's uncles Bob and Pat. It is also the family of Smith's Wellington Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Willy Smith (Volksraad), in addition to recent Group 2 winner Albarado (Savabeel). "My Governess, the granddam, was a very good race mare," Smith said of the 2003 Feilding Gold Cup (Listed, 2100m) winner. "We bred Count Zero's dam, My Duchess with John Boon, who trained My Governess. We have still got the dam of Count Zero and we didn't breed from her this season, but we have done up until now. If you want to breed good horses, you have got to go to good sires and Zed is certainly turning into that."

## Traralgon Cup to No Effort

Former jump jockey Gavin Bedgood trained his first country cup winner when No Effort (Reward For Effort) landed yesterday's Traralgon Cup (1900m). Ridden by Daniel Moor, the six-year-old mare was winning for the seventh time in 35 starts as she got the better of Nudge Bar (Bullbars) and Lord Bouzeron (Burgundy). Lord Bouzeron, who was ridden by apprentice Will Price, was second past the post before being relegated to third behind Nudge Bar on protest due to shifting ground in the home straight.

## Late Kingston Town entry for Sun

Railway Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) runner-up Too Close The Sun (Carlton House) is set to have a second foray into elite-level company in Saturday's Kingston Town Classic (Gr 1, 1800m)

at Ascot. Trainer Lindsey Smith yesterday said he intends to pay the late entry fee this morning to add his eight-time winner to the line-up for the weekend feature after the five-year-old came out of his recent second behind Inspirational Girl (Reliable Man) in good shape.

## Gailo Chop still bound for Kingston Town

Too Close The Sun is set to once again lock horns with Gailo Chop (Deportivo) on the weekend. The multiple Group 1 winner trailed in last of the 16 runners in the Railway Stakes with connections reporting him to have pulled up fine having been too far out of his ground that day. Matt Smith intends to give the nine-year-old a gallop at Lark Hill tomorrow morning ahead of Saturday's assignment where he will again be ridden by Brad Rawiller, fresh from his exploits aboard Elite Street (Street Boss) in the Winterbottom Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m).

## Elite Street possible for Melbourne

Dan Morton is eyeing a trip to Melbourne for Elite Street following the four-year-old's shock Winterbottom success. Although race plans are yet to be firmed up, Morton is considering a number of big race targets in the autumn for the now Group 1 winner who the trainer yesterday reported to have come out of his weekend heroics in fine shape.

## Rodd set for Queensland return on Friday

Michael Rodd will waste little time heading to Brisbane when the borders open tomorrow with the jockey planning to head straight to trackwork on Wednesday and Thursday with his first rides booked for Ipswich on Friday. Rodd is



set to ride Outback Barbie (Spirit Of Boom) for the first time when the five-year-old returns to action in Saturday's George Moore Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Doomben.

## Greysful Glamour a Villiers contender

Mark Newham was yesterday mapping out a plan for Greysful Glamour (Stratum) after the five-year-old bounced back to winning ways by taking out Saturday's ATC Cup (Listed, 2000m). Saturday week's Villiers Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) at Randwick and the Summer Cup on December 26 (Gr 3, 2000m) are races under consideration.

### NEW ZEALAND

## Camino Roco defends Cromwell Cup title

A huge crowd at Cromwell yesterday was treated to an extended glimpse of the silky skills of Chris Johnson as the rider they call the magic man guided enigmatic galloper Camino Roco (Shocking) to victory in the Loveracing. nz Cromwell Cup (2030m). The John and Karen Parsons-trained seven-year-old was up for the challenge of defending his hold on the race after streaking to a four-length victory last year and Johnson adopted similar free-wheeling tactics, opening up by as much as eight lengths mid-race. At the line, he had a three-length margin on his rivals. "He's a good horse but we've been having trouble getting him to settle after he got fired up a few starts ago," Karen Parsons said. "With Chris back on, he judged things nicely and that's what experience and skill like he has can do for you. To be honest he had a few lengths on the rest of the field but Chris got him into a beautiful rhythm and he did it fairly easily in the end."

## Super Seth receives plenty of support

After a stellar 48 hours for Waikato Stud, principal Mark Chittick is pleased with how the nursery has fared during the 2020 breeding season. "It's a bit of a quieter morning than we've had for the past few months so it's good to be able to sit down and relax a little," Chittick said. "I think we have three mares to serve today and only one mare left to foal so that takes a

little pressure off compared to the level we have been operating at up until now. Our stallions have all gone really well this season and I think we will have served over 600 mares when we get finished. We've been supported really well across the board although I think the thing that stands out to me is the quality and depth of book that Super Seth has got in his first season. Off the top of my head he has served mares like Lucia Valentina, Bonneval, Daffodil and Chandelier and that quality just travels right through his book. We've supported him with our own mares and it is a big job when you take on a horse like him, but from day one when he won the Caulfield Guineas, we were extremely passionate about him. Now we are getting to the end of his first season I think I'm even more passionate about him as he is just a beautiful individual to work with, he has extremely good fertility and he has matured and developed while being extremely busy."

## Australian Group 2 winner to end career in New Zealand

One of Waikato Stud's mares that is safely in foal to Super Seth (Dundeel) is Thousand Guineas Prelude (Gr 2, 1400m) winner Acting (Savabeel), who has returned to New Zealand in search of an elusive Group 1 prize before she heads to the matron's paddock. Acting has only raced in Australia, but trialled at Matamata on November 5. "Acting was supposed to kick off at Otaki on Thursday but with all the rain we had we decided to hold off for a while longer," Mark Chittick said. "She's already a Group 2 winner in Australia so to improve her position we are trying to get a Group 1 with her. She's back and in foal so we have ticked that box and now we want to tick that final Group 1 box with her. She's nominated for both the Railway and the Telegraph so we are hoping she can do the job for us."

## Catalyst recovering well

Trainer Clayton Chipperfield says that stable star Catalyst (Darci Brahma) is thriving during his extended break away from the track following his early return from Australia in September due to some niggling leg issues. "I went out to The Oaks Stud the other day and he is looking a picture," he said. "He's put on

plenty of condition, is bright and shiny in his coat and he is thoroughly enjoying himself. At this stage we will take a look at him in January, where we will do all the testing to make sure he is 100 per cent, before we make any plans for him. He just needs time as he is worth waiting for and when he does come back, I'm sure he will be back to his best pretty quickly. That timing is good as he should be coming back when the jar is coming out of the tracks which will suit him perfectly."

### ASIA

## JPN: Inglis graduate takes Keihan Hai

Fiano Romano (6 h Fastnet Rock - Heart Ashley by Lion Heart), a \$250,000 purchase by Katsumi Yoshida from the Kia Ora Stud draft at the 2016 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale, yesterday scored a second stakes win by taking the Keihan Hai (Gr 3, 1200m) at Hanshin. Sent out as third favourite, the Tomokazu Takano-trained Fiano Romano made late ground to defeat favourite and sprinting blueblood Curren Moe (Lord Kanaloa) by a neck with Jo Arabica (Jo Cappuccino) a further neck away in third. It was the Australian-bred's first win since taking the Lord Derby Challenge Trophy (Gr 3, 1600m) last March, but he had proven his talent with a second at Group 2 level in December to Gran Alegria (Deep Impact), who has won three of her four starts at Group 1 level this season including a defeat of Almond Eye (Lord Kanaloa) in the Yasuda Kinen (Gr 1, 1600m). Heart Ashley (Lion Heart), an American Grade 3 winner, has an Exceed And Excel (Danehill) yearling filly, while she produced a colt by The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice) in August.

## KOR: Jockey on sidelines for military service

Seoul-based jockey Jo Jae-ro has been hauled off to do his military service after his enlistment papers were sent to his home in Daegu, which he hadn't visited for some time, so subsequently missed the deadline to apply for a deferment. Jae-ro got called up immediately so won't be returning to riding until August

2022. All Korean males must enlist for military service, which can last up to 21 months, by the time they are 28, so Jae-ro joins fellow Seoul jockeys Jeong Jeong-hee and Lee Dong-ha as well as Busan jockey Jeon Jin-gu among those currently enlisted.

## INTERNATIONAL

### Six for Jukebox Jury

Burgage Stud resident Jukebox Jury (Montjeu) sired his sixth individual stakes winner when his daughter Santa Rita (4 f ex Sister Act by Act One) took out the Premio Regione Toscana (Listed, 2200m) in Pisa yesterday. The four-year-old filly was winning for the fourth time in 16 starts as she defeated Deeper Dive (Red Rocks) and Blu Navy Seal (Blu Air Force). Jukebox Jury, a dual Group 1 winner when trained in Britain by Mark Johnston, stood for a fee of €6,000 (approx. AUD\$9,720) in 2020.

### 13 for Air Force Blue

First season sire Air Force Blue (War Front) recorded his 13th individual winner when Major Frontier (2 c ex Make Haste by Tiznow) made a successful debut at Gulfstream Park West on Saturday. Trained by Lester Barbarzon, the Hinkle Farms-bred juvenile beat King Uhtred (Declaration Of War) by a head, with Stand With Mo (Uncle Mo) two and a quarter lengths away in third. Air Force Blue, who has his first two-year-olds in Australia this season, will stand for a fee of US\$10,000 (approx. AUD\$13,500) at Coolmore America in 2021.

### Three for Kingman

Juddmonte stallion Kingman (Invincible Spirit) brought up his third individual Group or Grade 1 winner on Saturday when Domestic Spending (3 g ex Urban Castle by Street Cry) took out the Hollywood Derby (Gr 1, 9f) at Del Mar. Ridden by Irad Ortiz Jr, the Chad Brown-

trained Domestic Spending charged home from second last to get up by a head on the wire over favourite Smooth Like Strait (Midnight Lute), with Belmont Derby (Gr 1, 10f) winner Gufo (Declaration Of War) a further neck away in third. Bred by Rabbah Bloodstock, Domestic Spending - a 300,000gns (approx. AUD\$567,750) purchase by Klaravich Stables at Book 1 of the 2018 Tattersalls October Yearling Sale - is the first foal out of English Listed winner Urban Castle (Street Cry). Kingman will stand for £150,000 (approx. AUD\$270,300) at Banstead Manor Stud in 2021.

### Two for Frosted

Darley shuttler Frosted (Tapit) brought up his second individual stakes winner, his first in the United States, when Travel Column (2 f ex Swingit by Victory Gallop) took out the Golden Rod Stakes (Gr 2, 8.5f) at Churchill Downs on Saturday. The Brad Cox-trained Travel Column swept home from last under Florent Geroux to score by a length over Clairiere (Curlin), with Coach (Commissioner) two and a half lengths away in third. Travel Column, sold for USD\$850,000 (approx. AUD\$1.15 million) at last year's Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Select Yearling Sale, has won two of her three starts, finishing third in the Alcibiades Stakes (Gr 1, 8.5f) at her only defeat. She is a half-sister to Neolithic (Harlan's Holiday), third in the Dubai World Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) and the Pegasus World Cup Invitational (Gr 1, 9f). Frosted, whose first stakes winner was Maribyrnong Trial Stakes (Listed, 1000m) winner Ingratiating, will return to Jonabell Farm in the coming weeks, having stood for \$22,000 (inc GST) at Darley's Northwood Park in 2020.

### Three for Laoban

First season sire Laoban (Uncle Mo) brought up his third individual stakes winner from his first crop on Saturday when Keepmeinmind

(2 c ex Inclination by Victory Gallop), third in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile (Gr 1, 8.5f) and the Breeders' Futurity (Gr 1, 8.5f) at his last two starts, broke his maiden in the Kentucky Jockey Club Stakes (Gr 2, 8.5f) on Saturday. Trained by Robertino Diodoro, Keepmeinmind chased down Smiley Sobotka (Brody's Cause) to win by three-quarters of a length under David Cohen; Arabian Prince (Mshawish) was a further length and three-quarters away in third. Keepmeinmind will now point towards the Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f) next May. "I told Robertino after his first start that he was going to be our Derby horse. It's nice when they don't prove you out to be a liar," Cohen said. "He was a horse that had the ability but mentally didn't grow up yet. But he's finally figured things out." Laoban will stand at WinStar Farm for USD\$25,000 (approx. AUD\$33,850) in 2021.

### 119 for Speightstown

WinStar Farm also tasted success at Aqueduct in New York when veteran Speightstown (Gone West) brought up stakes winner 119 with Discovery Stakes (Gr 3, 9f) victor Forza Di Oro (3 c ex Filare l'Oro by Hard Spun). In a field of five, the Bill Mott-trained, Junior Alvarado-ridden Forza Di Oro scored by almost four lengths over favourite Monday Morning Qb (Imagining) with Shared Sense (Street Sense) a length and a half away in third. Speightstown will stand for USD\$90,000 (approx. AUD\$121,850) in 2021.

# Epiphaneia beckons for Japan Cup heroine Almond Eye

It is remarkably rare that any pre-race hype matches the eventual product, but yesterday's Japan Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) not only delivered in spades - proving the leading race anywhere in the world in 2020 - it marked the coronation of a legend of Japanese racing as Almond Eye (5 m Lord Kanaloa - Fusaichi Pandora by Sunday Silence) capped her career with her ninth Group 1 win, a JRA record.

Labelled the "battle of the century" by the Japanese media, in the same way in which Australian fans laud the 1986 Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m), the 40th Japan Cup featured an unprecedented three Triple Crown winners - 2018 fillies' champion Almond Eye, her 2020 equivalent Daring Tact (Epiphaneia) and 2020 king of the colts Contrail (Deep Impact).

Tearaway leader Kiseki (Rulership), who held a 25-length margin at one point, was still clear by 15 lengths at the 500 metres and seven lengths at the 300 metres before being grabbed at the 150-metre mark, setting up a grandstand finish.

It was the Christophe Lemaire-ridden Almond Eye, who had settled marginally closer than Contrail and Daring Tact, who had first run on her rivals and that proved the decisive blow. The mare was the first to pass Kiseki and proved impossible to reel in as she became the second horse, after Gentildonna (Deep Impact), to win two Japan Cups.

At the line, the Sakae Kunieda-trained Almond Eye had a length and a quarter on the closing Contrail, who lost no admirers as the Yoshito Yahagi trainee suffered his first defeat under Yuichi Fukunaga. The Haruki Sugiyama-prepared Daring Tact filled third, a neck behind Contrail, with rider Kohei Matsuyama striking trouble on the filly at different times in the straight.

"The pace was ideal for Almond Eye and her response was totally different from that in the Tenno Sho (Autumn)," Kunieda said. "Since

expectations of an eighth Group 1 title were enormous at her last start, we did feel pressure but today, all we wanted was for her to come back safe and sound.

"The victory is such a bonus, we couldn't be happier. She has given us so much excitement and joy and it has been fulfilling to be a part of her career. It would be great if I could be involved in training her colt or filly someday."

Melbourne Cup-winning rider Lemaire, who has been a constant visitor to Japan throughout his career but who made the move to the country full-time in 2015, has ridden Almond Eye in all but one of her 15 starts. The Frenchman's success yesterday gave him a third Japan Cup, having also ridden Vodka (Tanino Gimlet) to victory in 2009.

"Since this was Almond Eye's final start, it was very special for me and I'm thrilled we were able to win," Lemaire said. "She was tuned up beautifully. She was relaxed in the gate, broke smoothly and was able to sit in a good position. The pace was just right for her and she responded well in the stretch. The others closing in on us didn't worry me at all.

"Almond Eye is a perfect mare, she doesn't have any weaknesses, and she has been so very special to me. I love her dearly. Her career as a racehorse may have ended today but I look forward to riding her children."

With the curtain coming down on Almond Eye's career, she retires having won nine Group 1 races - two Japan Cups, the Tenno Sho (Autumn) (Gr 1, 2000m) twice, the Japanese Fillies' Triple Crown of the Oka Sho (Gr 1, 1600m), the Yushun Himba (Gr 1, 2400m) and the Shuka Sho (Gr 1, 2000m), the Victoria Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) and her sole effort on the world stage in the Dubai Turf (Gr 1, 1800m) at Meydan.

While 2014 Japan Cup winner Epiphaneia (Symboli Kris S) could not sire this year's winner with Daring Tact third, he may be one of the big winners out of the race with Almond Eye set to pay him a visit at Shadai Stallion Station in 2021.

Northern Farm principal Katsumi Yoshida told local media that there were a number of factors to consider, with King Kamehameha-line stallions naturally ruled out.



With Deep Impact yet to produce a stallion son, Yoshida is leaning towards either Epiphaneia - whose oldest crop are three-year-olds - or Arrowfield shuttler Maurice (Screen Hero), who is set to be crowned Japan's leading first season sire in 2020.

"I think it will be Epiphaneia or Maurice, although there are also overseas stallions to be considered," Yoshida said in Japanese. "As with most of our horses, we don't always know for sure until the day we cover them. In reality, I think it's going to Epiphaneia, that's the most likely option."

However, there is every chance that Contrail, who shapes as the great Deep Impact's best chance to produce an heir apparent as a stallion, could one day meet Almond Eye again in the breeding barn. First, though, he will

return as a four-year-old, with the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Gr 1, 2400m) a potential target.

Almond Eye retires as the winner of 11 of her 15 starts with earnings of 1,915,263,900 yen (approx. AUD\$24.9 million).

# Sioux Nation colt repays inspired purchase by breeder Rebecca Matthews

A budding breeding syndicate received the sort of result any small player would barely dare to dream of when their Sioux Nation (Scat Daddy) colt sat on top of the standings at the final session of the Tattersalls December Foal Sale.

Rebecca Matthews bought Autumn Snow (Invincible Spirit), a once-raced maiden for Godolphin whose full sister is the twice Group-placed juvenile Figure Of Speech, for just 1,500gns at the 2018 February Sale.

Breeding under The Brigadier Partnership, the mare's second foal was sent to be prepped and consigned by Barton Stud, whose manager Tom Blain was delighted when agent Alex Elliott's successful 88,000gns (approx. AUD\$166,450) bid brought the whole plan together.

He was the most expensive of eight members of Sioux Nation's first crop to change hands, the Phoenix Stakes (Gr 1, 6f) and Norfolk Stakes (Gr 2, 5f) winner having entered Coolmore Stud at a €12,500 (approx. AUD\$20,250) fee.

"This was an investment by the breeders to get going, they've put a lot into breeding and taken a few risks to get here, so it's going to help them a lot," Blain said. "He was a standout foal today, we deliberately came for Saturday to try to stand out."

Matthews was not at Park Paddocks but Blain continued: "They're lovely people and this has got them going. Autumn Snow has a Highland Reel yearling and she's in foal to Le Brivido."

Considering the sale overall, Blain said: "I think we've sold every single one we brought, and I'm delighted. You've got to bring stock that people want to buy, we always do that, and the usual people are here; buying foals is what these guys do."

"The clearance rate has been great and considering the current economic climate, it's incredible. I just hope that next year the horses

come back and make some of these people a few quid."

Another operation to exit the auction with measured optimism was the Pocock family of Stringston Farm, whose Australia (Galileo) colt topped their draft when bought by Howson & Houldsworth Bloodstock for 62,000gns (approx. AUD\$117,265) with Aughamore Stud.

Stringston's brilliant mare Sitara (Salse) famously bred them Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Rekindling and high-class pair Golden Sword (High Chaparral) and Sydney Opera House (Australia). Bitoo (Diktat), is another of her daughters and one that they were inspired to bring back into the Devon fold.

"We bred her, sold her and actually bought her back after Rekindling won the Melbourne Cup," said Nick Pocock. "She'll probably go back to Ireland and visit Australia again, as the family has done very well."

Asked for his verdict on the sale overall, Pocock added: "Tough but reasonable, I'd say. We brought eight here and sold seven."

"For next year, I think we're going to have to have a lot of conversations with stallion handlers. We haven't made any nominations yet, and we'll probably breed a few less but there is a trade and you've still got to be positive."

Matt Houldsworth, of the buyers, said: "We've bought him for resale, hopefully for Book 1 or 2. It's a smashing family, one which has been with the Pococks for a long time."

Mickley Stud concluded the event with 24 lots sold for turnover of 638,000gns (approx. AUD\$1.2 million) and an average of 26,583gns (approx. AUD\$50,280). The operation's Saturday draft was capped by the 50,000gns (approx. AUD\$94,570) sale of a Rajasinghe (Choisir) colt to Phil Cunningham.

Mickley's Richard Kent, who was also encouraged by the enthusiasm for the first crop of his stallion Massaah, said: "I bought his dam Bakoura for just €3,500 - I had a lad at the sales in Ireland who needed to get back to Shropshire, the only way was on a truck with a horse - so I had to buy a mare to get him home!"

## Chairman's statement

The hosts were entitled to feel satisfied at overall trade and Tattersalls chairman Edmond Mahony said: "We felt that the relative strength of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sales would provide a solid platform for the December Foals and this has been borne out by another 2020 sale at Park Paddocks which has held up remarkably well under the current



circumstances, and particularly considering the continued widespread travel restrictions.

"Despite having the smallest catalogue since 2001, with 191 fewer foals catalogued than last year, the sale has achieved turnover just over 10 per cent below last year's lofty returns and single digit declines in average and median.

"Not for the first time this year we can reflect on a market which has displayed extraordinary

and commendable resilience, most graphically illustrated by a clearance rate which compares favourably not only with 2019, but also with the majority of recent renewals of Europe's premier foal sale.

"Trade has been competitive throughout the week, starting with sustained demand for the yearlings and flowing consistently through four days of the cream of the British and Irish foal crop. As ever the sale has been dominated by pinhookers and we applaud them for their huge contribution, but even more so in this strangest of years.

"The sale has been conducted under the strictest of health protocols and the compliance and awareness of all the rules and regulations has been admirable, as has the acceptance that we have not been able to provide the full Tattersalls sales experience in the current environment.

"Nevertheless, we have sold 64 foals for 100,000gns or more this week, including Airlie Stud's outstanding sale-topping Dubawi colt

whose 700,000gns price tag is the second highest for a colt foal at this fixture.

"In addition to the individual highlights, we have had widespread participation, some of it online, from buyers from throughout Europe, Japan, North America and the Gulf region, all of which gives encouragement as we turn our attention to the annual showcase of Europe's finest breeding stock at the Tattersalls December Mares Sale."

# Four-year-olds to the fore as Sky Darci takes the Cup and Enrich Delight impresses on debut

Gaspar Fownes could have the strongest hand of any trainer in January's Hong Kong Classic Mile (Listed, 1600m) as smart four-year-olds Sky Darci (Darci Brahma) and Enrich Delight (Medalgia d'Oro) came to the fore at Sha Tin yesterday.

Sky Darci made a big statement with victory in the Class 1 Chevalier Cup Handicap (1600m), the day's feature, and he did so at his first try in the grade following two Class 3 successes over 1200 metres at the city circuit.

"He was held up at a crucial stage of the race when everyone else had momentum, it's tough to do what he did today - it's gutsy," Fownes said. "He did it because he wants to do it, he's got a bit of spunk about him."

The gelding successfully made his first attempt at the mile a winning one and he did it in style, with a gritty triumph to maintain his unbeaten sequence this term as the HK\$12 million (approx. AUD\$2.1 million) first leg of the three-race age restricted series beckons on January 24.

"He'll have a bit of a freshen up now, he's done very well - I'll look at the program, whether he has one run before the Classic Mile or not I'll decide later but right now he's done a great job for us and I'm very happy for the owners," Fownes said.

The talented four-year-old has gone from strength-to-strength this term and yesterday handled an 11-point rating rise to win and now could find himself stamped with a triple figure rating.

"I felt the horse has got it well within his compass to go to the mile and even further, because what he was doing at Happy Valley he was just doing on his raw ability," Fownes said.

"It's pretty tough to go straight from a Class 3 to a Class 1 but I just felt we had the right horse to give us the chance to do it - up in class

but down in weight and a horse that is in really top form so you have to take a chance.

"Especially considering it is his four-year-old year and you hope that they're good enough to mix it with those type of horses and now he's proven that he can, so he's certainly earned his way in the Four-Year-Old Classic Series now," Fownes said.

Joao Moreira settled the New Zealand-bred on the rail close to the speed, a hapless run in the straight followed, before he knuckled down under the Brazilian's urgings for a narrow score ahead of fellow Classic Series prospect, Lucky Express (Toronado).

"He gave me the feel that he could do it when he won last start at Happy Valley - he has a high enough rating to go into the Four-Year-Old Classic Series with the reputation of being a nice horse, he's no doubt going to go there with a good winning chance," Moreira said.

Fownes drew comparisons to Green Birdie (Catbird), who won the Hong Kong Derby Trial (Listed, 1800m) in 2008, the race now known as the Hong Kong Classic Cup and is the second-leg of the series.

"We've had a great season so far with him (Sky Darci) it looked to be quite strong through the line - I won the Classic Cup over 1800 metres with a sprinter in Green Birdie and this guy has much better staying ability than him," Fownes said.

"When you're at your four-year-old year you can get away with certain things because you're up against the same age group," he added.

## Enrich Delight impresses on debut

Fownes' day would only get better as the ex-Godolphin owned Enrich Delight, known as Chenier prior to export, notched a dazzling win in the finale, the Class 2 Chevalier Property Investment Handicap (1400m) to seal a treble for Moreira, but it was no revelation to the handler.

"I'm not surprised at all - I told Joao (Moreira) a while back - I said 'I think this horse could be pretty special,' Fownes said "I'm not riding them but I can get a good feel for horses from training good horses for years and I said to him, 'This one you want to be riding - he's pretty smart.'"

The youngster placed at Group 3 level in Australia and finished fourth in the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Flemington when under the care of Anthony Freedman.

"He's done it very professionally in a good style - he got into trouble in the home straight and horses were dropping quickly back into his face," Moreira said.

"I went for a run and the gaps started closing and he got interrupted and didn't have a smooth run, but when he saw daylight he really dashed home and showed he has a lot of ability and as Caspar described: he is the real deal."

Class 2 on debut is no easy feat, especially against a quality field which also saw the high-profile debuts of Tourbillon Diamond (Olympic Glory), who was Group 1-placed in Australia as Eric The Eel and finished third, while two-time Australian Group 1 winner Shadow Hero (Pierro), who was slow out - finished a luckless seventh.

"First-up to do that - if he had got clear at the 200-metre mark he would have (won) in a canter, there's not many that excite me, but he's exciting," Fownes said.

Fownes, with a strong grip on the Classic Mile, is hopeful of the gelding's ability to see out the strong 2000 metres of the Hong Kong Derby (Listed, 2000m) in March.

"If he can run 2000 metres its going to be really exciting, but to do that over 1400 metres first-up, obviously the second run in a couple of weeks' time will be good then he can sort of take a chill pill and go to the 24th of January for the start of the Classic Series," Fownes said.

Fownes also confirmed that fellow talented four-year-old Sky Field (Deep Field) and The Everest (1200m) winner Classique Legend (Not A Single Doubt) will both trial on Tuesday over 1000 metres on the turf at Sha Tin.

"He (Sky Field) is going to trial down the 1000 metres with Classique Legend on Tuesday and if he trials well and is strong through

the line then he'll go to the 1200 metres on December 13," Fownes said.

Moreira also drove Chevalier Prince (Rock 'n' Pop) to a thrilling victory in the Class 3 Chevalier Property Development & Operations Handicap (1600m).

## Super Axiom impresses on debut

The David Hayes-trained Super Axiom (Exceed And Excel) raced clear to a comfortable two-length win on debut in the Class 4 Chevalier Aluminium Engineering Handicap (1000m) to justify favouritism after a trio of strong trials leading up.

The talented gelding broke cleanly under Chad Schofield, who rolled across from gate three to find the stands' side rail and an uncontested lead.

"He goes well - he's shown a lot of ability since he came and I'm lucky enough that David (Hayes) gave him to me to ride, I've ridden him nearly every morning," Schofield said.

The Australian-bred three-year-old was purchased out of the 2018 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, his second dam Goodwood March (Foxhound) produced two-time Hong Kong Group 1 winner Gold-Fun (Le Vie Dei Colori).

"We thought he had a very good chance today and it was nice to see him do it - he's got a lot to learn but he's an exciting horse going forward," Schofield said.

Hayes' young stable has been on show of late as his most recent winner Harmony N Blessed (Magnus) was also a debutant who signaled a bright future with an easy two-length debut win a week earlier.

## Piccone gets off the mark

Frenchman Tony Piccone landed the first win of his second Hong Kong stint as Team Spirit (Strategic) toughed it out in front for an all-the-way win in the Class 3 Chevalier Lifts & Escalators Handicap (1200m).

"It took a little bit long but I am very happy, the horse was very good - I won on him last season and I'm very happy," Piccone said.

The 33-year-old got off the mark at his 59th ride of season 2020/21, but he had gone close with three runner-up efforts prior, and takes his overall total to nine in Hong Kong.

Apprentice Jerry Chau claimed a double, firstly as Adonis (Exceed And Excel) landed a close-up victory in the Class 5 Chevalier Car Dealership Handicap (1400m) for Douglas Whyte, before Kasi Farasi (Reward For Effort) secured the Class 4 Chevalier Healthcare Investment Handicap for trainer Dennis Yip.

Hong Kong's champion jockey Zac Purton drove the Ricky Yiu-trained Czarson (Stratum) to a first win, claiming the Class 3 Chevalier E & M Engineering Handicap (1200m) by five and a quarter lengths.

Neil Callan continued his fine run of form as Super Alliances (Zacinto) scooted clear for back-to-back wins on the Sha Tin dirt by landing the Class 4 Chevalier Construction Handicap (1200m).

All For St Paul's (Magnus) went all-the-way for Derek Leung and Frankie Lor in the Class 4 Chevalier Environmental Engineering Handicap (1600m).

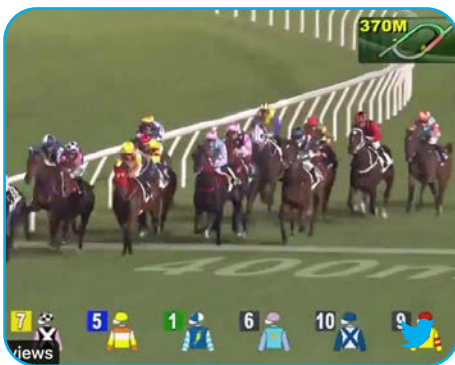

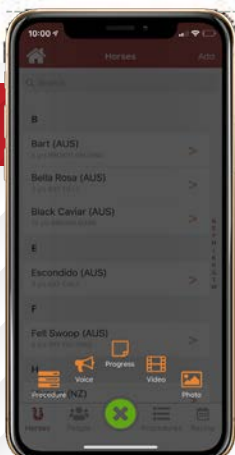
