November-born American Pharoah filly with mouth-watering pedigree is one of the star attractions at Magic Millions

Selling yearlings in June, as a rule, is not the first port of call for many breeders and pinhookers but as often happens with horses timing can be everything and if for various reasons they could not be sold at earlier sales it leads to opportunities for astute buyers.

As a result, this week's Magic Millions National

Yearling Sale of 616 lots, features some well-bred fillies and well-credentialed colts who will go under the hammer, bringing down the curtain on a massive three weeks of trade on the Gold Coast.

Yearlings by big-name stallions such as I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit), Dundee (High Chaparral), Exceed And Excel (Danahill), Capitalist (Written Tycoon), Deep Field (Northern Meteor) and Sebring (More Than Ready) will be on offer. *Continued on page 2>>*

Coolmore has an American Pharoah (Pioneerof The Nile)-Pretty Penny (Encosta De Lago) filly, a half-sister to four stakes winners and three stakes-placed horses, to be offered tomorrow as Lot 1502, while Widden Stud has a Zoustar (Northern Meteor) sister to this season's Reisling Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) winner Glistening, Lot 1688.

Widden also has a colt by Zoustar (Lot 1777), the first foal out of Group 2-winning mare French Emotion (Snitzel), who had to be withdrawn from the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale.

Coolmore's American Pharoah filly, a half-sister to Group winners Sertorius (Galileo), Pretty Brazen (Brazen Beau), Dollar For Dollar (High Chaparral) and Clifton Red (Sebring), was also withdrawn from the Easter sale.

"She is going to furnish and improve a lot over the next six months to a year. She is a late November foal, so it's all ahead of her and her pedigree keeps improving," Coolmore Australia's sales and nominations manager Colm Santry said yesterday.

"A lot of her siblings are very good older horses, Pretty Brazen, Dollar For Dollar, Sertorius, they're all horses who have trained on later in their careers and proven to be very high-class racehorses."

Santry did not put a value on the filly yesterday, but suggested the Dr Denis O'Brien-bred yearling held significant residual value.

"If she walked through the ring last week (at the National Broodmare Sale) God only knows what she would have made as an unraced four-year-old?" he asked.

"It is all ahead with American Pharoah, it's all going to happen with his three-year-olds over seven furlongs and a mile-plus."

Santry bought Pretty Penny, who was carrying Pretty Brazen at the time, for \$570,000 at the 2016 Magic Millions National Sale for his long-time client O'Brien of Clairden Racing.

O'Brien more than recouped his investment when the Tony and Calvin McEvoy-trained Pretty Brazen made \$700,000 at the 2018 Australian Easter Yearling Sale.

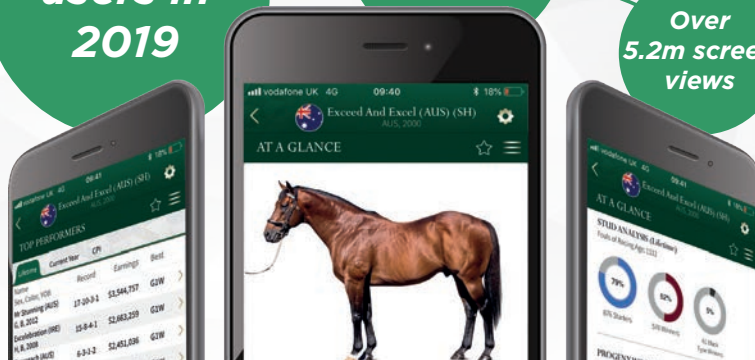

<< *Continued from page 2* The Gold Coast-based breeder retained Pretty Penny's unnamed two-year-old filly by American Pharoah who is in training with Chris Waller and Santry revealed feedback from the premier Sydney stable had been extremely positive so far.

Pretty Penny is in foal to Coolmore's first season sire Yes Yes Yes (Rubick).

"The mare's had seven foals, they're all black-type, she's had four Group 1 horses. She's gone to seven different stallions for seven results. She's an elite blue hen mare," he said.

"I can't think of any other mare in Australia like her."

American Pharoah is the sire of three southern hemisphere-bred first crop winners and Santry is confident that the US Triple Crown winner's progeny will excel in their three-year-old season.

"I have seen it all before with Zabeel, High Chaparral, Montjeu, So You Think and Pierro," Santry reasoned.

"They're written off in the spring of their three-year-old year and, all of a sudden, they get a couple of big horses. We've seen it with Pierro with his daughter Pinot winning the VRC Oaks in Melbourne.

"I think Pierro had three (first crop) stakes winners over the Melbourne carnival that year (2017) and he just took off from there."

Coolmore has five yearlings by American Pharoah, three by Caravaggio (Scat Daddy) and one by No Nay Never (Scat Daddy) to be offered this week.

"Caravaggio's doing an amazing job in the northern hemisphere," Santry said.

"He was a very fast horse and his stock are very fast over five and six furlongs. He's had six two-year-old winners as of today and is going really well.

"The breeze-up buyers should be looking at them as should the end users for these colts and fillies."

The National Yearling Sale starts at 10am tomorrow.

Conners sticks with Weir

NSW country based jockey Mikayla Weir will maintain her association with Rebel Rama (Dissident) in Saturday's Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2200m) at Eagle Farm. Warwick Farm trainer Marc Conners will remain loyal to Weir who rode Rebel Rama to victory in a benchmark race over 2000 metres at Rosehill on May 22. Rebel Rama, who broke her maiden at start nine at Newcastle on March 30, has won two of her 11 starts and is a \$15 chance in all-in Queensland Oaks markets behind the Edward Cummings-trained Duais (Shamus Award) (\$4.50).

Love Tap back in Sydney

Gloaming Stakes (Gr 3, 1800m) winner Love Tap (Tapit) will continue his campaign in Sydney due to lack of suitable races during the Brisbane winter carnival. The three-year-old, who won his first four starts before finishing fourth to Montefilia (Kermadec) in the Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) in October, was ruled out of the autumn in Sydney due to a hock injury. He resumed from a long layoff with a midfield effort over 1350 metres Doomben on May 15 before trainers Michael and Richard Freedman made the decision to pull the plug on his Queensland preparation and return to Sydney. "The only races to run him in were to go second-up in the Fred Best over 1400 and he's looking for a little bit further," Michael Freedman said. "We felt it would be better to have him back here, give him a run or two and freshen up for the spring. He's going to have a run, probably next weekend in a benchmark race here (at Rosehill)."

Trainers keeping open mind with Heart Of Puissance

The Ciaran Maher and David Eustace stable are keeping their options open with impressive last start Flemington winner Heart Of Puissance (Puissance De Lune). A soft three-and-a-quarter length winner over 2500 metres at his last start on May 22, Heart Of Puissance was expected to back-up at Flemington on Saturday in a heat of the Banjo Paterson Series (2500m) which carries a 2600-metre final at Flemington on July 3. However, Heart Of Puissance may be sent to Sydney on Saturday to run over 2400 metres instead, or even be held over an extra week and be Brisbane bound. "Heart Of Puissance will either run at Flemington or in Sydney in the (Listed) Winter Cup, but that will be weather dependent," Eustace said. "Or, he could be held back a week for the Brisbane Cup (3200m). It looks very fine and dry there."

Banjo Paterson for Grand Promenade

Heart Of Puissance's stablemates Grand Promenade (Champs Elysees), who split Realm Of Flowers (So You Think) and Miami Bound (Reliable Man) in the Andrew Ramsden Stakes (Listed, 2800m) at Flemington on May 15, and South Pacific (Galileo), fourth behind Le Don De Vie (Leroidesanimaux) in the Warrnambool Cup (Listed, 2350m) on May 6, are expected to line-up in the Banjo Paterson Series race. "Grand Promenade came through the Ramsden well," co-trainer David Eustace said. "He ran a great race. In a weight-for-age race he ran ahead of some horses rated 100-odd and he's rated 87, so on that he's run a big race. South Pacific is quite ground dependent. He would want to be on a Soft 5 or below, but he's in really good

form. It was a good run at Warrnambool but he just got knocked over by Heart Of Puissance, but he's in good nick."

Hawkes staffer tests negative to Covid

Michael, Wayne and John Hawkes' Flemington stable has been allowed to reopen after a staff member who was deemed to be a close contact of a Covid-19 case returned a negative test to the virus. Hawkes Racing's Flemington stable was placed into lockdown while test results were pending but yesterday's result means they will be allowed at Flemington trackwork this morning. Tonneofgrit (Winning Rupert) was scratched from Saturday's Caulfield meeting as a result of the drama.

Gytrash off to the paddock

Adelaide trainer Gordon Richards will spell Group 1-winning sprinter Gytrash (Lope De Vega) after a "forget" run in Saturday's Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) at Eagle Farm. The rising six-year-old gelding, who returned from a spell in which he underwent knee surgery to finish third in The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) earlier this month, ran 12th in the Kingsford-Smith Cup, two and three-quarter lengths behind winner Vega One (Lope De Vega). "It was just a forget from the barrier (15), he copped the interference but he wouldn't have found it from a better gate anyway," Richards told Racing.com. "He did work into it but then Savatoxl poleaxed him and he had nowhere to go after that anyway. I think with more luck he would've been in the money, but he kept trying and wasn't beaten far, so it was a brave run and he didn't disgrace himself. He was a bit sore this morning, nothing bad, just on that firmer track."

Gunsynd next for Ayrton

Ayrton (Iffraaj) is set to press on to the Gunsynd Classic (Gr 3, 1600m) at Eagle Farm on June 12 after finishing runner-up in Saturday's Fred Best Classic (Gr 3, 1400m). "He's a gelding and he has got to learn to race," Roll The Dice Racing's Leigh Saville told Racing.com. "His first three starts he toyed with them and was never really let off the bit, so he needs to keep learning. He might be looking for a trip now, Jamie (Kah) has always said he never seems to sprint - he just has a massive stride and keeps building."

Bright future for Magnus' Magic Max

Gordon Richards, meanwhile, also has a high opinion of two-year-old Magic Max (Magnus), an impressive winner at Caulfield on Saturday. Magic Max, who ran third a fortnight earlier in the David Coles Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Morphettville, was ridden by Damian Lane. "(Lane) losing his googles meant he had to keep wide, he probably hit the front a bit early and wondered," Richards told Racing.com. "He is a very good horse and the best of my two-year-olds. He ran third in the Group 3 last start and was probably a bit green. We jumped him out with blinkers on Tuesday and decided to leave them off, but I think he might even go better with them. We will spell him and see where he measures up in the spring in Melbourne." Richards also had two-year-old Garrire (I'm All The Talk) win at Morphettville on Saturday. "Garrire was good having to go back from the draw which is often a death sentence on the inner track," Richards said. "He will go to the paddock as well, I don't think he's as good as Magic Max but you never know with a spell he could come back better. He was odds-on last

start so I was a bit surprised he wasn't shorter (than \$13)."

Kiwis' Queensland campaigns come to an end

New Zealand trainer Lance O'Sullivan yesterday reported that the Queensland campaigns for several stable members had come to an end with the individual horses each going in different directions. "We had three horses in Brisbane, but they have all been turned out now for various reasons," O'Sullivan said. "Dragon Leap was going to run at Doomben last weekend but after working nicely on the Tuesday he spiked a temperature on Thursday morning, so we had to scratch him. We've decided to bring him home and give him a spell before getting him ready for the spring. We didn't see the point in taking any risks, so he is having a fortnight in the Queensland sun before he heads back to us. Spring Heat has been retired and will now become part of the broodmare band for Hermitage Thoroughbreds, while Force Of Will has been turned out and will do her future racing in Sydney."

Coffey making most of Lindsay Park opportunity

The forced exit of a number of Victorian jockeys to Queensland may have opened the door for Harry Coffey with the Lindsay Park stable. Coffey has slipped under the radar in recent years however he is tracking towards a career-high this season, already approaching 70 winners and in sight of the 80 he rode during the 2015-16 season. Recently he has had support from Lindsay Park and with the likes of John Allen, Ben Allen, Craig Williams, Jye McNeil and Jamie Kah riding in Queensland and Mark Zahra not riding, Coffey made a rare visit to a Melbourne metropolitan meeting and it paid off with success on Biometric (Bated Breath) in the Enable Professional Services Handicap (1400m) at Caulfield, a day after posting a win aboard Tycoon Beau (Written Tycoon) for the stable at Ballarat. "Going forward hopefully we can put some more wins together," Coffey said. "They've (Lindsay Park) got a lot of horses and it's good to be involved with stables who have high quality horses and lots of them. It's

good to get a couple of wins and at this time of year, it gives fellas like myself a bit more of an opportunity in town and you have to grab it by the horns and make the most of it. That's what we did and thanks to Biometric, he put on a great display."

Bowditch: truck crash extremely upsetting

Barry Bowditch, managing director of Magic Millions, has expressed his sorrow over the truck crash that killed five mares purchased from the Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale at the Gold Coast last week. The horses, who are yet to be identified, were making their way to the Hunter from Queensland by float before the vehicle crashed. "It was extremely upsetting news yesterday morning (hearing that) the truck coming back from the sales had an accident, five mares lost their lives," he said. "The drivers are in a critical yet stable condition and our thoughts go out to the mare owners, the guys who sold those mares, the truck company and the truck drivers involved."

Standalone meeting a win for Cranbourne

The decision by Racing Victoria to grant Cranbourne Turf Club a standalone Saturday meeting during the spring to host its cup meeting has been welcomed by the organisation. As part of a spring calendar shake-up announced by RV last week, Cranbourne will host a November 13 meeting, the Saturday after Melbourne Cup week at Flemington, and as a result the Listed Cranbourne Cup will be run over 1600 metres, a change from the traditional 2025 metres. It will be worth \$500,000. "It is a great opportunity for our club being offered the opportunity to run a standalone Saturday meeting during the Spring Racing Carnival this year," Cranbourne Turf Club chief executive Neil Bainbridge told Racing.com. "In consultation with RV it was deemed that 1600 metres would be the best distance for the Cranbourne Cup going forward, we are very confident as a club that will provide us with an outstanding race. When you consider the mile start at Cranbourne, it's a one turn start and will give every horse an opportunity to win."

NEW ZEALAND

Atullibigeal thrusts Henderson into the spotlight

For someone who steadfastly maintains he likes to keep a low profile with his training activity, you can imagine that Carl Henderson has a good deal of trepidation about describing his work with exciting two-year-old Atullibigeal (Street Boss). Henderson produced the juvenile to run away from his opposition in Saturday's Auckland Futurity Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Ellerslie, prompting plenty of media attention for the personable 48-year-old. Henderson is taking it all in his stride as a by-product of working with a potential topline but does admit he finds it hard for someone who maintains a boutique operation that is mainly focused on preparing young horses for clients in the Asian market, along with working with a small team of local runners. "I pretty much like to keep out of the limelight and just go about the business we have established here in Te Awamutu," Henderson said. "We generally work with clients who buy horses to take up to Hong Kong and Macau. We break them in and get them going and then send them up there to race. I also have a few here for friends and clients and that is how we came about Atullibigeal. My wife and part-owner Ross Mackay's wife are very good friends as they were bridesmaids at each other's weddings, so when Ross became involved with the horse, he got me involved as the trainer."

Career-best for McNab

A perfect ride aboard promising horse Dawn Parade (Dawn Approach) at Ellerslie on Saturday continued a purple patch of form for Cambridge-based jockey Michael McNab. With 60 wins for the season already, his best since he commenced his career in the saddle just on 20 years ago, McNab has taken his riding to another level, one which he is keen to maintain as he eyes some loftier goals in the next twelve months. "Things have gone really well for me this season, particularly in the last few weeks where I have ridden a lot of winners," he said. "The success I have had this year has made all the hard work I put in to get my career back on track worth it and I'm loving where I am in my life at the moment, both on and off the track. I'm pretty much riding the same horses and for the

same people as I have in the past, but something has clicked, and the wins have kept coming." He added: "Dawn Parade is a really promising type who I think is a Group 1 winner in waiting, so to get that win on him on Saturday was fantastic as he showed just what he is capable of."

Princess Rihanna's connections rewarded

Consistent performer Princess Rihanna (Showcasing) got a just reward on Saturday when she stormed to victory in an open 1100-metre contest at Ellerslie. The rising seven-year-old mare had finished an unlucky third at the venue in a similar event last month but snared the thick end of the prize this time, courtesy of a well-judged ride by apprentice Taiki Yanagida. Co-trainer Lance O'Sullivan was pleased to see the mare pick up another victory as she comes towards the end of her racing career, while he also praised the ride by his young apprentice. "She deserved that win as she has been running good races without a lot of luck," O'Sullivan said. "She had bad luck there last time and it looked like she might find trouble again on Saturday, but Taiki was patient and got her momentum up nicely when he found the gap in the straight. It was a good race for her and when she can get a run like that, she can be hard to beat. I was also thrilled for her owners who have been very patient with her all the way through."

Quiet time for O'Sullivan and Scott

Lance O'Sullivan and training partner Andrew Scott will maintain a low profile over the next few months with just one or two winter horses in work, however they will remain busy getting their younger members of the racing team ready for the spring. "We've lost quite a few out of the stable with retirements and the like but

we have a nice bunch of younger horses coming through," O'Sullivan said. "It's sometimes hard to know where your next good horse will come from, but it only takes one to get you going and I think with the talent we have on our hands it is going to be exciting to see which of them can step up to the mantle."

ASIA

49 for Deep Impact

Shahryar (3 c ex Dubai Majesty by Essence Of Dubai) took out the Tokyo Yushun (Japanese Derby) (Gr 1, 2400m) yesterday to earn the late Deep Impact (Sunday Silence) his 49th individual elite-level winner and also provide him with a record-breaking seventh Japan Derby winner. The Hideaki Fujiwara-trained colt demonstrated an impressive late turn of foot to defeat odds-on favourite Efforia (Epiphaneia) by a nose, while Stella Veloce (Bago) was one and a quarter lengths back in third. "It's so great to have won the Derby which I had made it my target with this colt ever since his debut," said winning jockey Yuichi Fukunaga. "We were keeping an eye on the race favourite but the race didn't go as smoothly as planned and we were in a tight spot so we were forced to make our charge late, but this colt really gave a terrific effort." A brother to 2017 Satsuki Sho (Japanese 2000 Guineas) (Gr 1, 2000m) victor Al Ain, Shahryar is one of five winners out of Grade 1 winner Dubai Majesty (Essence Of Dubai).

Four for Gold Ship

Win Kiitos (4 f ex Excuse by Boston Harbor) became Gold Ship's (Stay Gold) fourth individual stakes winner after landing the The Meguro Kinen (Gr 2, 2500m) at Tokyo yesterday. Having finished last of 15 in Grade 2 company on her last start in March, Win Kiitos showed considerable improvement yesterday to score by a comfortable two lengths over Heat On Beat (King Kamehameha), with outsider Admire Alba (Heart's Cry) another one and three-quarter lengths back in third. Win Kiitos is one of six winners out of dual Listed scorer Excuse (Boston Harbor), who is also the dam of the Grade 2-placed Win Exceed (Manhattan Cafe). Gold Ship, the sire of last weekend's Yushun Himba (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Uberleben, stands at Big Red Farm in Japan.

12 for Screen Hero

Kurino Gaudi (5 h ex Kurino Billionaire by Diablo) finally got off the mark in stakes company when taking out the Azuchijo Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Chukyo yesterday, earning Screen Hero (Grass Wonder) his 12th individual stakes winner. The five-year-old has narrowly missed out in stakes company on multiple occasions, including a second-placed effort in the 2018 Asahi Hai Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m), but managed to get the better of Shivaji (First Samurai) by a length yesterday. Meisho Titan (Lord Kanaloa) was a further length back in third. Screen Hero, the sire of six-time elite-level scorer Maurice, stands at Lex Stud in Japan.

14 for Kizuna

Sefer Rasiel (3 c ex Dark Sapphire by Out Of Place) eased to a comfortable victory in yesterday's Shirayuri Stakes (Listed, 2000m) at Chukyo to become the 14th individual stakes winner for Kizuna (Deep Impact). A winner of just one of his previous seven starts, the Daisuke Takayanagi-trained colt stepped up on his second try at Listed level to romp to a four-length win over Anagosan (Mikki Isle). Short-priced favourite Machaon d'Or (Gold Ship) was another length away in third. One of ten winners from as many to race out of Dark Sapphire (Out Of Place), Sefer Rasiel is a half-brother to Listed scorer Logan Sapphire (Daiwa Major) and the Graded-placed pair of Sappheiros (Kinshasa No Kiseki) and Cordierite (Daiwa Major). Kizuna, winner of the 2013 Japanese Derby, stands at Shadai Stallion Station.

JPN: Contrail out of Takarazuka Kinen

2020 Japanese Triple Crown winner Contrail (Deep Impact) has been ruled out of the Takarazuka Kinen (Gr 1, 2200m) on June 27. Trainer Yoshito Yahagi is unhappy with the four-year-old's condition after finishing third to Lei Papale (Deep Impact) in the Osaka Hai (Gr 1, 2000m) last month, which is his only run since losing his unbeaten status in November's Japan Cup (Gr 1, 2400m).

INTERNATIONAL

First for Kendargent

Skalleti (6 g ex Skallet by Muhaymin) got up late to get the better of Tilsit (First Defence) after a

photo-finish to yesterday's Prix d'Ispahan (Gr 1, 1850m) at Longchamp, earning Haras de Colleville resident Kendargent (Kendor) his first elite-level winner. Sent off the odds-on favourite under Gerald Mosse, Skalleti lunged in the dying strides to deny the Charlie Hills-trained Tilsit by a head, with My Oberon (Dubawi) a short neck further away in third. Despite never winning a Group 1, Skalleti has proved himself at the top level on numerous occasions, most recently when second to Addeybb (Pivotal) in the Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 1m2f) at Ascot last October. Skalleti lost his off-hind shoe during the race, and winning trainer Jerome Reynier said: "It's great that he's been able to show he is a top horse on more than just soft ground. We never got hung up on winning a Group 1, but I've been really concentrating on building a career for this horse. Now he's shown he's one of the best older horses in Europe. We'll let him down now and the main aim is to take our revenge in the Champion Stakes." Out of stakes winner Skallet (Muhaymin), Skalleti is a brother to Group 2 winner Skazino and the Listed-placed Skalleto. Kendargent, the sire of 33 individual stakes winners, stands for a service fee of €10,000 (approx. AU\$15,800).

The win continued a great run for the sire who was recording his fourth new stakes winner this month. The Peter Schiergen-trained three-year-old made all and romped to a seven and a half-length victory from the Godolphin runner Sky Angel

(Dark Angel) and Belcarra (Estidhkaar), who were split by a neck for second and third respectively. Novemba won her maiden on her second start at Hannover and has since run second in the Preis der Winterkonigin (Gr 3, 1600m), while yesterday's victory takes her tally to two wins from six starts. The Gestut Brummerhof homebred is out of Listed winner Nevada (Dubai Destination), who is a half-sister to Champion German Three-Year-Old Miler Nordico (Medicean) and Classic-placed Nordic Flight (Adlerflug). Dual 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) winner Gleneagles stands at Coolmore in Ireland for a fee of €25,000 (approx. AUS\$39,528).

Eight for Kallisto

Aff Un Zo (3 c ex Andarta by Platini), who broke his maiden at start six last time, stepped forward to take the Grafenberger Derby Trial (Listed, 2200m) at Dusseldorf yesterday and became the eighth individual stakes winner for the late Gestut Rottgen stallion Kallisto (Sternkonig), who died last year. The Markus Klug-trained three-year-old flew late down the centre of the track to win comfortably by a length and a quarter from Sisfahan (Isfahan), with Elegant Maximus (Maxios) a further length and a half away in third. A €13,000 BBAG yearling purchase by his trainer, Aff Un Zo is out of a winning sister to Champion German middle distance filly Antara (Platini) and Group 3 scorer Andolini, who is also by Kallisto.

Jin Jin keeps perfect record in Badener Meile

Jin Jin (Canford Cliffs) remained unbeaten in the Badener Meile (Gr 2, 1600m) at Dusseldorf yesterday and took her tally to seven from seven, including four stakes successes. The former Bohumil Nedorostek-trained mare was making her first start for Andreas Suborics and the five-year-old justified favouritism when taking the contest by two and a half lengths from French raiders Alpen Rose (Sea The Stars) and Galova (Galiway), who were separated by three-quarters of a length for second and third. Jin Jin was unraced at two, unbeaten in three starts at three and she returned to take two Listed contests and the Prix Perth (Gr 3, 1600m) last year.

84 for Ghostzapper

Award Winner (5 g ex Devine Actress by Theatrical) became Ghostzapper's (Awesome Again) 84th individual stakes winner when causing an upset in the Charles Whittingham Stakes (Gr 2, 10f) at Santa Anita. The David Hofmans-trained gelding narrowly edged out Acclimate (Acclamation) in the closing stages to score by a head after a fierce battle up the straight. Red King (English Channel) was another two and a half lengths back in third, while short-priced favourite United (Giant's Causeway), who landed this contest last year, finished last of the four-runner field. Out of Listed winner Devine Actress (Theatrical), Award Winner is a half-brother to four-time Grade 1 scorer and sire Oscar Performance (Kitten's Joy) and Grade 3 winner Oscar Nominated (Kitten's Joy). Ghostzapper stands at Hill 'N Dale Farms in Kentucky for US\$85,000 (approx. AUD\$110,227).

144 for Tapit

Magic On Tap (5 h ex Aubby K by Street Sense) took out the Triple Bend Stakes (Gr 2, 7f) at Santa Anita to earn Tapit (Pulpit) his 144th individual stakes winner. The lightly-raced five-year-old was making his second start in Grade 2 company after finishing fourth in the Californian Stakes (Gr 2, 9f) last time out and looked to appreciate the drop down in trip when defeating Shooters Shoot (Competitive Edge) by two lengths. Exalted (Twirling Candy) was one and three-quarter further lengths behind in third. Magic On Tap improved his overall mark to three wins and two seconds from six starts. He was bred in Kentucky out of the late

Grade 1-winning mare Aubby K (Street Sense), who died in 2019. Her last foal was a Tapit filly, now a two-year-old named Definitive. Tapit stands at Gainesway in Kentucky for a service fee of US\$185,000 (approx. AU\$240,000).

The colt was due to tackle the turf for the first time, having won on his second start at Fair Grounds on a fast dirt track in February and his other run coming when he was a length second in the Jeff Ruby Steaks Stakes (Gr 3, 9f) on the synthetic surface at Turfway Park. The victory provided former shuttler Mshawish (Medaglia D'Oro) his first stakes winner, with Arabian Prince, Igloo and Taylor Avenue also hitting the crossbar in stakes company to date for the Taylor Made stallion, who stands for US\$7,500 (AUD\$9,726) this year. Ridden by Joel Rosario, Sainthood was sent off as favourite and prevailed by a length from The Reds (Ash Zee) while Shawdyshawdyshawdy (Summer Front) was five lengths adrift in third. Future plans for Sainthood include the Belmont Derby (Gr 1, 10f). Sky Darci snares Lion Rock Trophy Handicap in a thriller as Fownes claims a treble

Gaspar Fownes regained the trainers' championship lead and celebrated the successful race-track return of BMW Hong Kong Derby (2000m) winner Sky Darci (Darci Brahma) in one fell swoop with a pivotal treble, crowned by Lion Rock Trophy Handicap glory (Gr 3, 1600m), at Sha Tin yesterday.

Trailing John Size by two winners entering the meeting, Fownes climbed back to the front - 66-65 - with a three-timer to leave the 2020/21 championship balanced on a knife's edge with 12 meetings left in the season.

Vincent Ho ended a relatively barren month in style with a four-timer, closing the meeting in style on David Hayes' newcomer Naboo Attack (War Head), who made light of his 1360lb frame to claim a HK\$1 million High Achievement Bonus on debut.

The highlight for Fownes was Sky Darci's resumption after a ten-week break, culminating in a short head victory over fellow four-year-old Healthy Happy (Zoustar). Not Usual Talent (Zacinto) was third, one and three-quarter lengths further back.

"On paper it looked a nice comeback race for him, 115 (pounds) on his back and a nice soft draw (barrier three). He landed in the spot we thought he would be, just relaxed and came out and you can see what he's got," Fownes said after Sky Darci withstood a fierce challenge from Healthy Happy, who lifted bravely after being headed by the winner.

"Obviously the second horse (Healthy Happy) is a horse we respected coming into the race because we didn't think there was much pace and obviously, he gave us quite a scare the last 100m.

"He's a nice horse, the second horse. He's probably one that's going to go on with it.

"At the end of the day, we're very happy to bring him back from the Derby. There's always pressure on you to get these horses to come back and perform."

Sky Darci's latest triumph leaves Fownes with a host of long-range options beyond a possible start in the Premier Cup Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) - including a potential tilt at the LONGINES Hong Kong Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m) in December.

"It looks like we've got something to work with going forward to December. He's a good horse and he's probably still got another length and a half to two lengths in him over the next 12 months. If he can do that, all of sudden he's a serious and proper horse," Fownes said, hinting at taking a path which avoids clashing with Golden Sixty (Medaglia D'Oro) over a mile.

"He's a sprinter-miler in my mind and he's showing us that, so we'll just try to pick the best possible options and avoid the champions.

"He'll come back to have a 1200 metre run early in the (2021/22) season, so we'll just see what he does there. He's versatile and he should be a bigger and better horse with a couple of months of the summer break under his belt."

Fownes said the Premier Cup could involve Sky Darci clashing with stablemate Sky Field (Deep Field).

"There's a good chance (he will run), it just depends on how he pulls up. Sky Field will

go there as well, so it will be nice to see them taking on each other if I go that route.

"We'll just see how he pulls up, the weather is getting quite warm now, but if he's well and he's eating up well and he's got a spring in his step there's no reason he can't have one more race," Fownes said.

With further wins through Green Envy (Shamexpress) and Tailor Made (Archipenko), Fownes overtook Size.

"It's alive (hopes of winning the championship), there's a long way to go but I'm just going to do my best. I'm sure John will keep churning winners out and I'm going to keep doing the same. All I can give is 100 per cent and I'm giving that," Fownes said.

Franking the BMW Hong Kong Derby form a week after Panfield's (Loooin At Lucky) triumph in the Standard Chartered Champions & Chater Cup (Gr 1, 2400m), Sky Darci impressed Moreira with his sheer grit on posting a seventh win from only 13 attempts.

"He won on his heart. He knows what his job is out there," the Brazilian said.

"The other horse gave him a challenge and wouldn't give up. Healthy Happy was coming back at him and I could feel he was giving everything he has got. He is a good horse.

"It was just what we wanted and it's no surprise to me that he didn't win by a bigger margin because we have a high opinion of the other horse."

Ho moved to fourth in the jockeys' championship after a stellar day, improving his tally to 54 to trail Joao Moreira (135), Zac Purton (113) and Karis Teetan (67).

Ho prevailed on Tailor Made for Fownes before delivering a stable double aboard Light Of Wanshi (Ocean Park) and Copartner Ambition (Starspangledbanner) for Chris So and finally Naboo Attack in the Class 2 Amah Rock Handicap (1200m).

The winner of five races in Australia as Command 'N' Conquer, massively-built Naboo Attack earned a HK\$1 million High Achievement Bonus for winning a Class 2 race or higher before turning five.

Manfred Man's Enzemble (Zoffany) caused a boilover at 57/1 in the Class 3 Piper's Hill Handicap (2000m) under Matthew Poon before Frankie Lor's Speedy Mouse (Slade Power) surged

to soft victory in the second section of the Class 3 Eagle's Nest Handicap (1200m) for Zac Purton.

Man posted a double when Dublin Star (Savabeel) lowered E Star's (Ferlax) Class 3 1200 metre record with a 1m 8.29s gallop to claim the first section of the Eagle's Nest Handicap under Karis Teetan.

Keith Yeung ended a 187-ride run of outs to post his eighth win for the season when Team Power (Excelebration) saluted for Ricky Yiu in the Class 3 Hung Mui Kuk Handicap (1400m).

Hong Kong racing continues at Happy Valley on Wednesday (2 June).

WA sire I'm All The Talk can complete a ground-breaking season when Billy Ain't Silly and The Spruiker line up in the Listed Belmont Guineas (1600m) later this month.

The Darling View Thoroughbreds resident has been an embedded Top 10 stallion on the Australian second-season premierships since Watch Me Dance completed the G3 Champion Fillies - G2 WA Guineas double at Ascot in November.

I'm All The Talk (Stratum) has also been represented interstate by Caulfield Stakes winner All Banter (Listed WJ Adams Stakes) and Garrire, who broke through in a Morphettville nursery on Saturday.

Gary Portelli trained I'm All The Talk to win a G3 Skyline Stakes and he's bought a couple back from the west to Warwick Farm. Speedy chestnut Walkin'talkin' will be winning races for the stable on the back of an impressive fourth on debut at Scone on Cup day.

A week later, on the opening day of the winter season in Perth, Billy Ain't Silly and The Spruiker both staked winning claims for the Belmont Guineas on June 19.

Billy Ain't Silly will be peaking for trainer Colin Webster. “He's thriving and loves going to track,” Webster said following that last-start victory in Crown Perth Stakes (1600m). “He

worked to get to the front today and then held together before Laqdar (Ramoly) let him sprint clear.

“He's a free-flowing galloper and I knew last year he would develop into a real racehorse. He comes through his runs enormously and is definitely not silly.”

Billy Ain't Silly will have a final lead-up in the LR Raconteur Stakes (1400m) this Saturday. He's a homebred for Bill and Patricia Robinson and his dam Tiara Mak (Medaglia D'Oro) continues the successful line of Mungrup Stud's star matron Kalatiara (Metal Storm).

The Robinsons also race I'm All The Talk's Belmont juvenile winner Dad's Bigheaded with Webster. They founded SESCO Security Systems at Guildford in 1971 and board Tiara Mak at Alwyn Park in Serpentine where she has a filly foal by Maschino.

The Spruiker is also in good hands being a stablemate of Watch Me Dance with Steve Wolfe in Albany. He was racing first-up since Boxing Day and firmed from \$41 into \$31 to win the Amelia Park Hcp (1300m).

“He's been flying at home and I was confident even though it was a hot field,” Wolfe admitted. “He's was fit enough and I told ‘Shooter’ (McGruddy) not to worry about 1300 metres fresh.”

McGruddy settled The Spruiker behind Timely Outburst before giving ground at the top of the straight when the Sessions filly sprinted to a clear margin. But once balanced, the Great Southern visitor ranged up to score by a half-length.

The Spruiker was bred by Wolfe and is the first foal from his Belmont-winning NZ-bred mare Pins Perhaps (Pins). Her final foal is a two-year-old son of Playing God. Wolfe has been a strong supporter of I'm All The Talk and he also polishes recent Ascot winner Bragwell.

I'm All The Talk covered 92 mares at a \$6,600 service fee in 2020 and Darling View has kept him at the same price this year. His book was topped up in November when Playing God (Blackfriars) was sidelined with colic. Playing God will cover a reduced book at \$16,500.

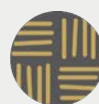

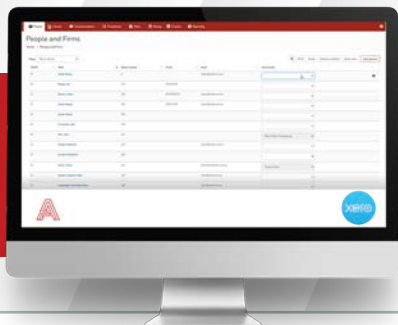
