Newnham hoping for Oaks breakthrough with Bargain

Daughter of Ocean Park bids to end stable's streak of near misses after placing in the Australian Oaks earlier this season

In just five years of training, Mark Newnham has saddled six Oaks runners for four top-three placings and he is hoping that Bargain (Ocean Park) can finally win him one today.

A leading contender in today's Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2200m), Bargain races in the famed colours of one of New Zealand's leading thoroughbred nurseries Waikato Stud, where she was bred.

A daughter of in-form stallion Ocean Park (Thorn Park), who stands on the Waikato roster, she is the first horse Newnham has ever trained for the farm's owners, the Chittick family.

Newnham said the relationship came out of the blue when he received a phone call from Waikato principal Mark Chittick.

"I got a phone call saying 'would you like to train a horse for us' and then they sent her over. She's the first horse I've had for them and it's been a good result," said Newnham. *Continued on page 2>>*

"I have bought a horse from them and have since. They are very good breeders and good owners to get."

The Chitticks like to try and support trainers who invest in their stock by sending them horses and the decision to back Newnham just over 12 months ago has paid dividends.

Bargain emerged as a class act when she ran second in the Adrian Knox Stakes (Gr 3, 2200m) at Randwick in April and followed it up with a third placing in the Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m).

"She's always shown ability but needed a bit of time to mature," he added. "She's been at her best at 2000 metres and beyond so she's found the right trip now."

Last start Bargain ran second behind Only Words (Sweynesse) in The Roses (Gr 2, 2000m) at Doomben, and on the strength of that performance Newnham believes she is a genuine winning chance in today's Group 1 feature at Eagle Farm.

"I think she will run top three and she's a great chance of winning. She's trained on well, is up in distance on a bigger track, and has a good gate. I would be disappointed if she couldn't run top three," he said.

Like Newnham, the Chitticks are hoping for their first Queensland Oaks victory which would cap off what has been a stellar season for them. Last weekend, Kukuracha (Night Of Thunder), a graduate of Waikato Stud's 2019 New Zealand Bloodstock Karaka Yearling Sale draft, won the Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2400m).

"We have had 20 winners of 31 stakes races and five Group 1 winners have come off the farm, four of which we bred ourselves," said Chittick.

"It's a season we are incredibly proud of. There's a lot of hard work and investment and something is heading in the right direction. This year has been something special."

Bargain was born and raised on Waikato Stud and is out of Shopaholic (Pins), who herself was a sprinting mare winning several Group races including the Angus Armanasco Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Caulfield.

Bargain was passed in at the NZB Karaka Yearling Sale after failing to meet her reserve of \$200,000, so the Chitticks decided to try their luck racing her.

"She's been very consistent and the Ocean Parks are tough and consistent so it's very exciting," he said.

While she doesn't possess the movie star looks of her former stablemate Greysful Glamour (Stratum), who was recently sold at the Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale for \$1.5 million, Newnham is hoping Bargain will continue to establish herself as a suitable replacement.

"If you get a genuine Group horse and they retire or are sold, they are hard to replace. She (Bargain) is a bit plain to look at so she goes a little unnoticed, but that's not a bad thing," said Newnham.

Newnham, who currently has 70 horses in work at his Warwick Farm and Randwick stables, has bold plans for Bargain come the spring.

"She will spell for a few weeks up in Queensland and we will get her ready for a race like the Matriarch Stakes," he said. "That's a realistic target for a mare like her who needs a big trip and track."

Four for Cable Bay

Uncommon James (2 c ex Pickabee by Jet Spur) impressively landed the QTIS 2YO Maiden Handicap (1000m) at the Sunshine Coast yesterday to earn former Woodside Park shuttler Cable Bay (Invincible Spirit) his fourth Australian winner. The Steven O'Dea and Matt Hoystead-trained colt finished a narrow second on debut at the Gold Coast last month and was consequently sent off the \$1.75 favourite under Ben Thompson. Uncommon James rewarded favourite backers with a three and a quarter-length win over Dare To Share (Dream Ahead), with Nizhoni Lass (Nicconi) another two and a quarter lengths back in third. Uncommon James is the first runner out of stakes-placed mare Pickabee (Jet Spur), who is a sister to Listed winner Emmalene (Jet Spur). Cable Bay, who shuttled to Australia for three seasons between 2018 and 2020, has had plenty of early success in the northern hemisphere, siring four individual stakes winners.

Spicer buys at Arqana

Brad Spicer failed to buy an Almanzor (Wootton Bassett) yearling at the Australasian sales this year but he finally succeeded at the Arqana Breeze-up Sale last week when he went to £245,000 (approx. AU\$450,000) for a colt by the stallion, out of Schlague (Pulpit). "It wasn't part of the plan originally, but I've got a guy over there, Alex Elliot, who does a lot of work at the sales and he let me know there was a really nice Almanzor colt going through," Spicer told Racing.com. "I loved his breeze-up and the more I looked into his pedigree and realised he was a half to Dice Roll, who I love, the more I wanted to get this colt." Spicer confirmed

that the youngster will clear quarantine in early August and join trainer Lindsey Smith at Warrnambool. "I'd say his first preparation in Australia will be fairly light because he will have only just turned three, Australian time, but he's obviously six months behind the locals and his birthday isn't until April." He continued. "He's the sort of horse that you don't want to rush, he's going to be a nice staying horse so hopefully, at the back end of 2022, we're talking about him in spring."

Media Award faces further vet check

Queensland Racing Integrity Commission vets will assess Media Award (Shamus Award) at around 7am this morning before deciding whether or not she is fit to contest the Queensland Oaks (Gr 1, 2200m) at Eagle Farm later today. The Chris Calthorpe-trained Australasian Oaks (Gr 1, 2000m) winner has some degree of lameness in one of her legs and failed to satisfy vets in previous checks on Thursday and yesterday.

Black Caviar owner excited for daughter's debut

Pam Hawkes enjoyed 25 special days as part-owner of Black Caviar (Bel Esprit) and she is looking forward to seeing how the great mare's daughter Invincible Caviar (I Am Invincible) gets on when she debuts down the Flemington straight in the VRC Member Philip Jacobsen Sprint (1100m) today. The fact that the filly is the first of the champion's offspring to be trained by Peter Moody, the man who guided her career, makes it extra special for the part-owner. "Being back with Peter and having this girl who we've heard a lot about from the start, it does get you excited," Hawkes told Racing.

com. "We've had a good relationship with all of the trainers who've had her progeny, but of course it's special to be back with Peter. He's a great bloke and it's nice getting some familiar videos from him where he talks about how this filly also gets angry if she has to wait on her food like the big horse did." Hawkes will not be on course due to Covid restrictions but is hopeful of the filly putting her best foot forward. "As long as she acquits herself well, that's all we want to see," she added, "We'd love to see this one win a few races and prove the myth wrong that these good mares don't throw anything of worth."

Punters fancy Seonee over Invincible Caviar

While many are hoping for a fairy tale debut win for Invincible Caviar, punters have supported rival Seonee (Winning Rupert). Invincible Caviar is the fifth foal of unbeaten 25-time winner Black Caviar, who won her debut over the straight 1000-metre course at Flemington in April 2009, and rank-and-file fans are hoping for a romantic result. However, after opening as the TAB's \$3.50 favourite, Invincible Caviar has drifted in the face of support for her Patrick Payne-trained rival, a slow starter when fourth at her only start behind Moon Over Alice (Your Song) who reopposes. "She's normally first out in her jump-outs, but for some strange reason, whether it was more raceday pressure or commotion at the start, she was slow through no fault of the rider," Payne told RSN. "But her last 50 metres was fantastic and after the line she was fantastic. When you look at her in the mounting yard, don't be put off. She's quite skinny and on the light side, that's just her make-up." Payne said Seonee had trained on well since her debut performance and the distance should suit at this stage of her career.

Gear Change for Special Reward

Out-of-form sprinter Special Reward (Demerit) will be given a final throw at the stumps to earn a Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) start in the Moreton Cup (Gr 2, 1200m) at Eagle Farm today. Last year's Newcastle Newmarket (Gr 3, 1400m) winner hasn't fired in two runs this campaign, finishing unplaced in the Hawkesbury Gold Rush (Listed, 1100m) and again in the BRC Sprint (Gr 3, 1300m) at Doomben. He has been caught wide from awkward draws in both races but trainer Kris Lees is leaving nothing to chance, taking blinkers off the five-year-old and adding winkers for the first time. "I'm hoping putting winkers on him will keep him more focused," Lees said. "We'll be positive on him and he could easily turn his form around if he gets his own way in front. But he needs to be ultra-impressive to convince us to back him up in the Stradbroke." Hugh Bowman partners Special Reward in the 1200-metre sprint while Andrew Mallyon rides stablemate Zaniah (Zoustar).

Bring The Ransom set to grab the cash

Winter Cup (Listed, 2400m) favourite Parry Sound (Pierro) might be the headline act at Rosehill for trainer Bjorn Baker but two horses resuming at the track today could emerge as surprise packets for the stable. Baker has ten runners across nine races, including Matowatake (Dream Ahead), who returns in the Acy Securities Handicap (1200m) following an underwhelming three-start summer campaign. "Last time he was very disappointing. He had an ordinary prep after running well first-up," Baker said. "But I think he's come back in good order. He looks great and I'm confident he is ready to jump back to his best. He's not out of it on Saturday, he can run a race." Baker will saddle firm ground lover He's A Hotshot (Star Witness) in the same race. Stablemates Exotic Ruby (Snitzel) and Bring The Ransom (Sebring) will round out Baker's afternoon. Bring The Ransom is returning after bleeding in December but has twice won first-up. "She has come back in terrific order, she looks magnificent," Baker continued. "Even though she has only had the one trial, she has done plenty of work and been in work for a long time, so she's got a good base and from a good gate she's not out it."

Black Caviar's (Bel Esprit) two-year-old daughter Invincible Caviar (I Am Invincible) makes her much-anticipated debut at Flemington today.

The Peter Moody-trained filly sparked plenty of discussion among racing fans as to whether she can be the best of Black Caviar's progeny after bolting up in a Pakenham trial on May 25.

Black Caviar began her 25-start unbeaten career at Flemington in 2009 and Moody will be hoping Invincible Caviar can do the same, although he was quick to downplay her impressive-looking trial last week.

"If you take that into context, that morning when she put that big gap on them, they only went even time the first couple of furlongs, so I think that's a bit deceiving that jump-out," he said.

The fifth foal out of the 15-time Group 1 winner Black Caviar, connections will be hoping Invincible Caviar can fare slightly better than the champion mare's three runners to date.

Her first foal, Oscieta (Exceed And Excel), won two of her five starts before being retired to the breeding barn, while Prince Of Caviar (Sebring), her second foal, recorded one win from six starts. The next foal, Out Of Caviar (Snitzel) is unraced, while her three-year-old filly Ready For Caviar (More Than Ready) is winless from two starts.

Black Caviar has a yearling colt by I Am Invincible and was served by Written Tycoon (Iglesia) in December, having missed to I Am Invincible the previous breeding season.

Invincible Caviar will face 12 runners in the VRC Member Philip Jacobsen Sprint (1100m) and was the general third favourite at the time of publication, behind Seonee (Winning Rupert) and Commands The Field (Deep Field).

Fresh is best for Bottega

Gerald Ryan is hoping he has got the mix of fitness and freshness just right with Bottega (Snitzel). The talented entire has disappointed at his past two starts, over-racing when finishing down the track behind Rocha Clock (Pierro) at Randwick in April then turning in a perplexing performance when sixth to Laure Me In (Ad Valorem) in the Scone Cup (Listed, 1600m) last month. "The track was funny (at Scone), you couldn't be on the inside, you had to be winning out wide but in saying that, I still felt he was a little disappointing in the straight," Ryan said. The four-year-old has had three weeks since then into today's Precise Air Handicap (1800m) at Rosehill. "He's a horse who doesn't cop a lot of work, you can overcook him very easily," he continued. "But we've kept him fresh and kept him well and he seems good within himself."

Hocking's incredible comeback

Kyle Hocking will get the leg up for his 1000th race ride at Bendigo today, aboard the Vin Malady-trained The Mood I'm In (O'Lonhro). But just making it back to the saddle is a remarkable triumph for the rider whose life took a tumultuous turn after a serious paddock accident at Terang in 2014 left him with little feeling in his hand. Hocking ended up homeless and as recently as last year was living in a van behind an old dentist surgery in Geelong, which was used as a squatter refuge. "There were a couple of times where people came running through with axes and poles and that sort of thing," he said. "I think we had the armed robbery squad come through once or twice with 30 or 40 police in riot shields. But you've just got to deal with it, I suppose." Hocking's turn-around came thanks to his 'mentor' Ian Fletcher, the father of a friend, the late Kerry Fletcher. "He had been trying to find me for a while, while I was homeless. But I didn't have money for a phone or anything, really. So it took him a while to find me." Hocking, a former apprentice to Terry O'Sullivan and Ross McDonald, made his way back to the sport and had his first ride in seven years at Geelong on May 14. "I'm a natural lightweight. I'm walking around at about 52 kilograms. Hopefully this is just the start," he added.

Europeans to clash in Bendigo maiden

Irish and British form will come together at Bendigo today when Hosier (Camelot) and Aquileon (Gleneagles) clash in a 1500-metre maiden. Hosier raced twice in Ireland for Joseph O'Brien and placed sixth behind subsequent Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) second Tiger Moth (Galileo) on debut. Aquileon raced as Aquileo for the Roger Varian stable pre-import and competed twice as a juvenile before placing second on both his starts at three last summer, latterly over 2300 metres at Windsor. Hosier will race without a jumpout but Aquileon has had two at Caulfield. "(Aquileon) is a lightly-raced horse, he didn't acclimatise that well, but we have gelded him and that certainly seems to have helped," Australian Bloodstock's Jamie Lovett told Racing.com. "I wouldn't be expecting lots from him, it's well short of his best, so if he is finding the line and having a good experience, we will be pleased. I would expect him to only have one or two runs this preparation and it would be nice to win a maiden with him this time in. We thought he was worth the punt after reviewing his tapes and if he can turn into a Saturday horse, for what we paid for him, that will be a good result."

Racing in Victoria to continue without spectators

Racing Victoria announced yesterday that spectators will not be allowed access to Victorian race tracks until June 10 at the earliest. "Due to the limited number of spectators and a focus on limiting, to the extent possible, the movement of racing industry participants, RV has determined that racing will be spectator free across all Victorian race tracks until at least next Thursday," the statement said. "This decision has been taken in consultation with Country Racing Victoria (CRV) and the relevant clubs, to ensure thoroughbred racing is able to continue safely." The Swan Hill Jockey Club will host its three-day Swan Hill Cup meeting from Friday, June 11 but took the decision yesterday to refund current bookings, while a decision will be made next week as to whether or not a small number of patrons might be able to attend. "When we can safely welcome spectators back to the racetrack in larger

numbers with sufficient notice for clubs then we will make owners and club members the immediate priority," Racing Victoria CEO Giles Thompson said. "We'll continue to liaise with the State Government over the coming days regarding requirements for venues and will provide a further update to our industry in the days ahead."

20 years between Flemington wins for Cahill

Shayne Cahill's last win at Flemington came when he steered Shorblue (Bluebird) to victory back in 2001 but today he hopes to end that long barren spell when he sends out his stable's Dexter You Devil (Ambidexter) in the VRC Member Otto Kohn Trophy (2000m). "It would be massive, it would be a good achievement," he said. "It's great racing in Victoria and it'd be a buzz for sure." Cahill holds a dual licence but will not be in the saddle due to Covid restrictions. "We've won probably eight races, nine races with him I think, and obviously (as a) dual licence holder, I won most of those on him, so he's been a great asset to us for sure," the trainer said. "He's got 61.5 kilograms, it's probably a big ask to come over there in reasonable company and carry that sort of weight." The six-year-old was unplaced last time in the RA Lee Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Morphettville and is rated a \$91 chance. "He's an honest horse, I don't think he should be a 90-1 shot," he continued. "I believe now that he's up to this sort of company, he probably wants the 2000, they might be just a little bit sharp for him over the mile now he's up in this sort of grade."

Kah to ride Snickerdoodledandy

Jamie Kah wasn't the first name on the list to ride Snickerdoodledandy (Snitzel) in the 1400-metre Benchmark 84 handicap at Flemington today but trainer Peter Moody is delighted to have snagged the leading hoop. "We had an apprentice booked who had a dual booking and I think Jamie Kah was one of the few who didn't have a ride in the race," Moody said on his Moody On The Mic podcast. Brian Higgins was next in line but couldn't make the 56.5 kilogram weight. Snickerdoodledandy, a Listed winner at Ascot in December, is making her third start since transferring across the country from the Daniel Morton stable, having placed fourth and second so far under Moody's watch. "She's taking on the older mares here, but she's come on nicely and a little gear change with the tongue tie on will aid her nicely," Moody added. "I think she'll sit back and swoop home."

Verbek thriving ahead of The Phoenix

Verbek (Turn Me Loose) will head into The Phoenix (Listed, 1500m) at Eagle Farm today a maiden, but his trainers Luke and Robert Price believe he will not be one for long. The juvenile has finished runner-up twice in his three career starts, including a relegated second placing at Hawkesbury last start following a judicial review. "I don't believe he should be a maiden, but that was the stewards decision the other day," Luke Price said. "He showed great fight and I just think he is getting better and better every time we do something with him." Verbek has continued to show natural improvement with each outing and Price believes he has a bright future over further ground. "He is a horse we have earmarked since day dot that he wants a mile-plus before we see him at his best, so what he has done so far has just been a bonus for the owners. I can't wait to get him to ten furlongs in the spring, that could just be ideal for him," he continued. "There is a Group 1 race at Randwick we are half eyeing off, but we will get through Saturday first and then come up with a plan for the rest of the year. He has certainly shown great promise." Verbek will jump from barrier eight.

Mugatoo out for a year

The tendon injury that All Star Mile (1600m) winner Mugatoo (Henrythenavigator) was found to have suffered after being pulled-up in Doomben Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) will keep him on the sidelines for around 12 months. "My experience with tendon injuries is it will be the best part of a year," part-owner Australian Bloodstock's Jamie Lovett told Racing.com. The Kris Lees-trained six-year-old has won seven times since being imported from Britain. "The autumn next year is probably even a bit ambitious, I'd be thinking next winter and maybe the following spring," Lovett continued. "We will just cross our fingers we can get him back. There will be plenty of treadmill work, it's all about getting the fibres to realign. Whatever happens, he's been such a great horse."

Breeders seminar open for registration

Thoroughbred Breeders NSW and Charles Sturt University will bring together Australia's leading equine veterinarians and industry professionals, covering breeding topics for the upcoming season, at a breeders seminar to be held at Charles Sturt University Convention Centre at Wagga Wagga on July 29. Iffshecan defying early assessment

Iffshecan (Iffraaj) surprised trainer Cody Cole with a three and a quarter-length score on debut to earn a tilt at the John Turkington Forestry Castletown Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Wanganui today. "I would have said she was six months away and if we got her to the races it was a bonus, let alone winning a race. She has just improved out of sight," Cole said. "I thought it looked like quite a competitive field on paper. I was a little bit surprised when she kicked away by four lengths." Iffshecan has drawn barrier four

of ten for her Listed test and Cole said they won't be deviating from their front-running tactics. "She will be putting herself on speed somewhere thereabouts, she has got plenty of gate speed and when you can go to the front and kick away it takes a lot of bad luck out of the equation," he continued. "She will need to have made a bit of improvement from her maiden win, it is stakes company and there are other horses that have performed at stakes level and have won races there. I couldn't see why she wouldn't measure up." A short freshen-up will follow her weekend hit-out before she gets ready for her Classic season. "We will give her a short break and get her going and look for some of those spring races if she comes up well enough," Cole added.

ASIA

JPN: Gran Alegria aims to go back-to-back

Gran Alegria (Deep Impact) will attempt to secure a sixth Grade 1 win and become the first horse since the crack mare Vodka (Tanino Gimlet) in 2007 and 2008 to win the Yasuda Kinen (Gr 1, 1600m) back-to-back when she lines up amongst a hot field at Tokyo tomorrow. The five-year-old heads in off an easy victory in the Victoria Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) two weeks ago. "I was very happy about the Victoria Mile win. Due to the lack of time between races, we've just focused on getting her recovered and tuned up. She hasn't had that many races overall but has come along well nonetheless," said trainer Kazuo Fujisawa. Her rivals include 2019 victor Indy Champ (Stay Gold), as well as last year's Derby runner-up Salios (Heart's Cry) who failed to handle the wet track in the Osaka Hai (Gr 1, 2000m) last time. Also in the line-up is Schnell Meister (Kingman) who took his tally to three from four last time in the NHK Mile Cup (Gr 1, 1600m) and is looking to become the first three-year-old to succeed since Real Impact (Deep Impact) in 2011. "The Yasuda Kinen is a big challenge and though 3-year-olds have won before, it's often a tough race. But he has potential. I'm hoping he can make the best of the lighter weight he'll be racing under," said trainer Takahisa Tezuka.

HK: Moreira puts faith in God

Joao Moreira leads Zac Purton by 136 wins to 115 wins in the jockeys' premiership and he will climb aboard another exciting youngster from the John Size stable at Sha Tin tomorrow when Drops Of God (Mossman) lines up in the Class 3 Lai On Handicap (1200m). An emphatic two and a quarter-length winner on debut, Drops Of God is aiming to emulate stablemates Courier Wonder (Sacred Falls) and Fantastic Way (Swiss Ace) and put together a winning sequence. "He's done it in a good way at his first run and I could not ask for more than what he did, he's such a professional horse," the Brazilian said. "We wonder why John Size backs him up in two weeks: that means he felt the horse did what he needed to do without overdoing it at his first attempt. He's another horse I have no doubt people should keep an eye on because he's quite promising." Drops Of God showed smart pace on debut clocking 1m 08.89s while hefting 127lb. On Sunday, rising in class, he will jump from gate ten with a 117lb impost. "It is a strong race, he's up in class but I think with light weight on his back, he's going to appreciate that and we're about to find out if he's up to the class," Moreira added.

HK: Diamond looks to add sparkle to Classic form

While four-time champion Zac Purton's hopes of retaining the title are fading rapidly with only 11 meetings left, the Australian is upbeat about Tourbillon Diamond's (Olympic Glory) prospects of giving the Hong Kong Derby form another boost in the Class 2 Chung On Handicap (1600m). The four-year-old was seventh behind Sky Darci (Darci Brahma) in the blue riband back in March and was beaten a neck last time over the course and distance. "He doesn't necessarily have to lead, he's shown he's versatile. He's come from different positions in the field in a number of races and run equally well. In that respect, he's easy to ride," Purton said of the import, who raced as Eric The Eel in Australia. "I think a mile is a good distance for him, that's not to say he can't run 1800 (metres) or 2000 (metres). I think his run in the Hong Kong Derby was very good from a bad gate. If he had drawn well there, he could have possibly been winning that race."

INTERNATIONAL

Second for Harbour Watch

Pyledriver (4 c ex La Pyle by Le Havre) outbattled Al Aasy (Sea The Stars) to win the Coronation Cup (Gr 1, 1m 4f) at Epsom yesterday, becoming the second elite-level winner for Harbour Watch (Acclamation). His rider Martin Dwyer took control of the race at the top of the hill and kicked for home early in the straight. When the runner-up loomed threateningly to deliver a challenge, the William Muir and Chris Grassick-trained four-year-old dug in along the inside rail and repelled his rival to win by a neck. Third-placed Japan (Galileo) was a further seven lengths behind. It was a first Group 1 win for the horse and his co-trainers, Pyledriver having landed a pair of Group 2 wins last season before placing third in the St Leger (Gr 1, 1m 6f). The colt is out of the two-time winner La Pyle (Le Havre), a half-sister to Grand Prix de Paris (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Mont Ormel (Air Chief Marshal), a multiple winner in Hong Kong as Helene Charisma, from the family of Group 1 winner Linnigari (Indian Ridge). Harbour Watch (Acclamation) retired from stud duties in 2017 after just five seasons due to arthritis. The stallion stood at Tweenhills Stud in England and shuttled to Aquis Farm in the Hunter Valley for two seasons.

50 for Deep Impact

Snowfall's (3 f ex Best In The World by Galileo) stunning victory in the Epsom Oaks (Gr 1, 1m 4f) yesterday provided the late Deep Impact (Sunday Silence) with a half-century of individual elite-level winners. The Aidan O'Brien-trained three-year-old defeated Mystery Angel (Kodi Bear) by 16 lengths, with Divinely (Galileo) one and three-quarter lengths further behind in third.

FR: St Mark's bids for Classic follow-up

St Mark's Basilica (Siyouni) will attempt to become the fourth horse this century to add victory in the Prix du Jockey Club (Gr 1, 2000m) to success in the Poule d'Essai des Poulains (Gr 1, 1600m) when he takes his place among 19 declared runners at Chantilly tomorrow. Jockey

Ioritz Mendizabal has retained the ride on the Aidan O'Brien-trained colt, who secured stall two at yesterday's barrier draw, while Colin Keane will partner the other Ballydoyle runner, Van Gogh (American Pharoah), from stall 12. John and Thady Gosden will send out Derab (Sea The Stars) and Megallan (Kingman) from barriers 14 and 15 with the stable attempting to seal a second Prix du Jockey Club on the bounce after Mishriff (Make Believe) last year. Jean-Claude Rouget, three of whose four wins have come in the last five years, will rely on Saiyadabad (Blame) from stall 11 and Makaloun (Bated Breath) and Cheshire Academy (Flintshire) from wide berths in gates 18 and 19.

IRE: Kavanagh to take Curragh role

Brian Kavanagh will return to the Curragh racecourse and training grounds as CEO in November after 20 years as the CEO of Horse Racing Ireland (HRI). Kavanagh's latest five-year contract as CEO of HRI will conclude in September, bringing an end to his third term in the role. He will succeed Pat Keogh at the Curragh, who was brought in from Leopardstown racecourse to steady the ship in 2019 following the abrupt departure of Derek McGrath. Kavanagh left the CEO role at the Curragh in 1999 to become chief executive of the Irish Turf Club before then filling the same role at the newly-formed HRI in 2001.

Deep Impact's Snowfall in stunning Oaks win

Snowfall (3 f Deep Impact - Best In The World by Galileo) blitzed her rivals to win the Cazoo Oaks (Gr 1, 1m 4f) by a record 16 lengths and provide Aidan O'Brien with his ninth success in the Epsom Classic.

Frankie Dettori weaved through the field aboard the daughter of Deep Impact (Sunday Silence), who powered clear of 50-1 shot Mystery Angel (Kodi Bear). Divinely (Galileo) was one and three-quarter lengths further behind in third, while her better-fancied stablemate Santa Barbara (Camelot) finished fifth of 14 runners.

"We thought she was very good last year and ran her in all the big races," said O'Brien, who celebrated his 40th success in a British Classic. "She's got stronger over the winter.

"We've been over the moon with her at home since her impressive victory at York. We knew she had a lot of class coming here and Frankie gave her a very good ride. She looks special."

Snowfall was cut to 5-1 (from 20) for the Coral-Eclipse (Gr 1, 1m 2f) at Sandown and shortened to 5-1 favourite for the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Gr 1, 2400m) at Longchamp in October.

"They were going too quick up front and she went through the field like a hot knife through

butter," Dettori told ITV Racing after winning his sixth Oaks. "I was afraid of Santa Barbara coming from behind but when I saw some daylight she kicked on."

Snowfall is the first foal out of Group 3 winner Best In The World (Galileo), who is a sister to 2016 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner Found.

Huge pinhooking profit as Dark Angel colt brings £410,000 at the Tattersalls Ireland Goresbridge Breeze-Up Sale

All bets are off for the title of most successful pinhook of the year after a Dark Angel (Acclamation) colt picked up for a mere €6,000 topped the Tattersalls Ireland Goresbridge Breeze-Up Sale at a record-breaking £410,000 (approx. AU\$755,560).

Connections of the youngster, including owners Jerry Horan and Katharina Irmer and consignors Justin Timmons and Danny O'Donovan of Dolmen Bloodstock, looked on in stunned silence as the bid board rattled through six-figure sums at a rate of knots.

Alex Elliott, standing with Amo Racing's Kia Joorabchian, pushed the price to £400,000 but the final say came from Richard Brown of Blandford Bloodstock, with a £10,000 increase enough to bring the gavel down.

Timmons said: "It's magic, it's life-changing stuff. Jerry and Katharina took a punt with him so it's a great story all round. He could have easily been a horse who had problems but everything went well and he matured all through the winter.

"He's never put a foot wrong and everything aligned. He's got a big, floating action and he did a very professional breeze, he's just been a dream to prep."

The colt, who was bred by the Wildensteins' Dayton Investments, was picked up by Horan's Paragon Bloodstock from the Ecurie des Monceaux draft at the Arqana October Yearling Sale. He is the fourth foal out of the Listed-placed Venturous Spirit, a daughter of Arch (Kris S) who shares her page with Group/Grade 1 performers such as Volga (Caerleon), Vallee Enchantee (Peintre Celebre) and Maids Causeway (Giant's Causeway).

Expanding on how the ownership group was formed, Horan said: "I know Katharina from the sales and we were in France trying to buy yearlings to breeze when she was there working for Grove Stud.

"She said if you get something let me in on it, and this was the horse I bought - she must have taken me for dinner that evening! In fairness we can't take much credit because the horse was broken in by Clare Manning and then went to the lads at Dolmen, so they're the ones who have done all the hard work. We're just lucky enough to own him."

Thursday's result may be the biggest touch Dolmen Bloodstock have pulled off, but it is not the first as they also sold a €10,000 Make Believe colt to Blandford Bloodstock for 105,000gns at last year's Guineas Sale.

Timmons added: "You can never expect figures like that, you just try your best to get them to the sale and then through all the other hoops they've got to jump through. We've been prepping breezers for the last six or seven years and we're trying to do better each year, so it's onwards and upwards."

Plans call for the colt to remain in Newmarket, as Brown revealed his purchase will head into training with William Haggas. After signing the docket, the agent said: "Well it was significantly more than I had expected or hoped to pay!

"I thought he did an outstanding breeze and obviously the sire is one of the best in

Europe. He's a gorgeous big horse and when I spoke to my client last night we highlighted him as the one - as obviously my underbidder did! I was on the phone to my client through the sale and I would say that was our last bid."

The intensity of demand for the top lot was mirrored elsewhere in the market, and by the close of trade 176 of the 193 two-year-olds on offer had changed hands for a clearance rate of 91 per cent.

Turnover hit £5,689,300 (approx. AU\$10,484,450), up 64 per cent year-on-year from an offering that had increased by 31 per cent. The average was up 16 per cent at £32,325 (approx. AU\$59,570) and the median remained static at £20,000 (approx. AU\$36,856).

Elliott atones

Alex Elliott may have missed out on the session-topper but he had better fortune earlier in the day when he secured the Bated Breath (Dansili) filly out of Polar Circle (Royal Academy) offered by Grove Stud at £240,000 (approx. AU\$442,280).

"When we come to these sales we like to try and buy the best horses and I thought she was the best filly here," said Elliott. "As the price would suggest, there were a few other people

who thought the same. She did a very good breeze, she's got a pedigree and she's by a sire that I love.

"I can definitely picture her in the parade ring before a good race. She's been bought for a partnership, I don't know who's going to train her but she'll stay in Britain."

Persistence pays off with Jet Setting colt

A strong wildcard offering was led by the Dark Angel colt out of Irish 1,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) heroine Jet Setting (Fast Company), who was making a quick return to action having been bought back by his vendor Star Bloodstock at £150,000 at the Arqana Breeze-Up Sale.

The well-bred youngster put in a much more promising breeze at Newmarket and duly had a much more successful spin through the ring as Adam Driver of Global Equine Consultant Services struck a winning bid of £185,000 (approx. AU\$340,865).

"We knew he was a nice horse so we brought him back so he could prove what he could do," said Star's Matt Eves. "Diego [jockey] got him to do a three-and-a-half furlong breeze

rather than a get-up-and effort and he galloped right through the line. I'm pretty convinced Adam's got a bargain but it's a good result and everyone's happy."
