'It's hard to imagine Arrowfield without him'

John Messara leads tributes to champion Redoute's Choice, who died yesterday aged 22



Redoute's Choice

ARROWFIELD

Redoute's Choice (Danehill), the champion Australian stallion whose legacy will last for generations, was the horse John Messara just had to have.

The Arrowfield Stud owner felt so strongly that the son of Danehill (Danzig) was an elite stallion in waiting - which he says "doesn't happen very often" - that he struck a multi-million dollar deal for the then three-year-old colt.

Almost two decades on, with three champion sire titles on his record and arguably Australia's greatest ever stallion, Messara was yesterday left remembering Redoute's Choice, a horse "who touched many people".

The rising 23-year-old died at Arrowfield Stud yesterday after suffering a traumatic loss of mobility which could not be restored. He was euthanised following intensive veterinary care.

"Redoute's Choice is such a big part of all our lives, and right now it's hard to imagine Arrowfield without him," Messara said.

Redoute's Choice at Haras de Bonneval

AGA KHAN STUDS

The shockwaves caused by the death of Redoute's Choice (Danehill) were felt internationally yesterday as tributes were paid to the son of Danehill (Danzig) by Georges Rimaud, manager of the Aga Khan's Haras de Bonneval in France.

Redoute's Choice shuttled to Bonneval for two northern-hemisphere breeding seasons, producing 71 foals from the book of mares he covered in 2013, for which he stood at a fee of €70,000, and 69 foals the following year having stood the 2014 season for €60,000.

"It was a great honour to have Redoute's Choice stand with us at the Aga Khan's studs for two seasons and he is definitely a horse that will mark the stud book for years to come," Rimaud told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"He has given us so much, Arrowfield has been built on his back and he's allowed all of us and many, many other people to fulfil our dreams and ambitions."

Messara's belief in Redoute's Choice was solidified after his "off the canvas" Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) victory in 1999, a win he listened to from a

hotel room in France, a story retold in part yesterday.

"When I inspected him and saw him at close quarters I knew he was the horse we had to have," he told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"I was reminded today by Byron Rogers, who was a staff member of Arrowfield at the time, that I had come home and said 'we have to have this horse'. We pushed on to buy a stake in him and the rest is history.

"He was a very imposing animal and a great athlete. He was tough and courageous - he had everything that you want and he had great bloodlines as well.

"You don't get that often, that they are everything and prove to be everything in the barn."

Redoute's Choice's temperament had also been a standout while at stud.

"He was a gentleman. He was so easy to handle for everyone at the farm and was just a great horse all round," Messara added.

"It is like losing a relative. He has been around for 20 years and we wake up (this) morning and he is not going to be there. It is a big shock."

Messara took comfort from the fact that Arrowfield Stud has invested heavily in sons of Redoute's Choice, headed by his champion sire son Snitzel, Not A Single Doubt, Pariah, Scissor Kick and perhaps his best-performed colt The Autumn Sun, who Arrowfield bought into last October, having sold him for \$700,000 at the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale in 2017.

"He leaves a legacy at Arrowfield because we had enormous faith in him and we invested in a number of his male progeny, so we have got a number of his sons now under our control and hopefully the story will live on for a lot longer," he said.

Just like Redoute's Choice almost 20 years earlier, Messara has a similar inclination about the Chris Waller-trained The Autumn Sun and after his last-to-first Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) win last spring he mounted a successful big-money play to secure a controlling 50 per cent share in the three-year-old colt.



The Autumn Sun won his fifth Group 1 race, the Rosehill Guineas (2000m), and his eighth race from nine starts on Saturday and his place on the Arrowfield Stud stallion roster is assured.

When that will be is yet to be decided but it was confirmed yesterday that the colt will be spelled and will not race again this season, if he does at all. *Continued on page 4>>*

"The Autumn Sun is owned jointly by another partner and I will be mindful of the partner's wishes, so [Redoute's Choice's death] shouldn't have an impact on that decision," Messara said.

"We will probably make up our mind over the next couple of weeks. He is going off for a spell now."

Bred by Muzaffar Yaseen of Teeley Assets, Redoute's Choice was born on August 15, 1996, as the first foal out of juvenile-winning mare Shantha's Choice (Canny Lad) and was from the sixth southern hemisphere crop of champion stallion Danehill.

He would be retained to race by Teeley Assets, winning five of his ten starts including four at Group 1 level before being retired to stud in 2000 at a fee of \$33,000 (all inc GST).

As Redoute's Choice's progeny began to become a force on the racecourse his fee rapidly increased, from \$40,000 in 2004, to \$220,000 in 2005 and a career high \$330,000 in 2007 and 2008. He covered 45 mares last year at an advertised fee of \$137,500.

Redoute's Choice was a champion sire on three occasions; 2005-06, 2009-10 and 2013-14, having been crowned leading first

season sire in 2003-04. In 2013-14, Snitzel was runner-up to his revered sire - the first time the feat has been achieved.

Fifteen years later, Redoute's Choice is currently lies fourth on this season's Australian general sires' table, one that is led by Snitzel, while his first crop son Not A Single Doubt is lying in 11th place.

Redoute's Choice's death also coincides with the stallion enjoying a revival in the sales ring and on the racecourse this season, no doubt boosted by the deeds of The Autumn Sun.

At last month's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Redoute's Choice had 15 yearlings sell for an aggregate of \$8,245,000 at an average of \$549,667, which saw him finish second in the leading sire by average with three or more lots sold. He was only bettered by Medaglia D'Oro (El Prado), who had four lots sell.

In Perth his daughter Galaxy Star, who was bred and is owned by one of Redoute's Choice's big supporters in Bob Peters, won the Railway Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) to become his 34th individual Group 1 winner.

In total, Redoute's Choice is the sire 163 individual stakes race-winners with progeny earnings in excess of \$157.2 million. *Continued on page 5>>*

<< *Continued from page 4* As a broodmare sire, he has also left a distinct mark, producing 86 stakes winners including Zoustar (Northern Meteor), Arcadia Queen (Pierro), Amphitrite (Sebring) and Kementari (Lonhro), and this season he is poised to win the title for the first time.

He currently leads Encosta De Lago (Fairy King) by earnings with \$15,297,257 in prize-money and is the broodmare sire of 15 stakes winners in 2018-19, headed by Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) winner Extra Brut (Domesday).

Messara said: "It is a great consolation to me that Redoute's Choice leaves us at the top of his game, having sustained his greatness as a sire from start to finish, across the full span of his career.

"His legacy to Australian breeding and racing is immense, through his sire sons, his broodmare daughters, his final crops still to come and all the people he touched over the past two decades."

Cassidy lauds Redoute's Choice

Jockey Jimmy Cassidy, who rode Redoute's Choice in six of his ten starts including three wins, described the horse as a "machine".

Redoute's Choice won on five occasions including the famous Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) battle royale with arch-rival Testa Rossa (Perugino) in 1999 and in the Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) early in the 1999-2000 racing season.

Cassidy also rode the then two-year-old in his debut win on February 20, 1999, a week before the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m).

"I rode him his very first start when I won on him at Caulfield and I wanted to ride him in the Blue Diamond but I was already committed to one of Hayes' and he wouldn't let me off it," Cassidy told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"He gave me the feeling of being a machine because that day when he won first-up I was back on the fence, I had to shove one out of the way to get out, and I when I shoved it out of the way it nearly went through the outside fence and into the grandstand.

"He was that big and strong as a two-year-old and I am sure if he hadn't gone amiss he would have won the Golden Slipper."

Danny Nikolic won the Blue Diamond on Redoute's Choice and the colt was the short-priced favourite for the Golden Slipper on the back of his two-length victory over Testa Rossa.

He was, however, scratched on the eve of the race due to an elevated temperature and was spelled before returning as a three-year-old.

"I rode him in his three most important wins, his first one, the Caulfield Guineas and I won the Manikato on him first-up as a three-year-old," he said.

"They thought he was gone (in the Guineas), Testa Rossa got up inside me because he hung off the track but I didn't really panic.

"I just waited until he got balanced and I asked him for one

more crack and he was able to get off the canvas. It was a big effort."

Cassidy watched on as Redoute's Choice became one of the world's great stallions, but he said the early signs were always there that the son of Danehill could leave his mark in the breeding barn.

"He was an elite racehorse. Stallions are different to mares.

They can be champion mares and duds at stud, but you get a very good colt - and I have had a couple of them; him more so - so he didn't surprise me," he said.

"He just had the ability, he had a great nature and he was obviously like that at stud. He was certainly like that on the racecourse. He was just a freak."

The now retired Rick Hore-Lacy, who trained Redoute's Choice, also has fond memories of that famous Caulfield Guineas win.

"I was always broke and the (win) I remember the most was the one I had the biggest bet on (and) that was the Caulfield Guineas," Hore-Lacy told Sky Sports Radio.

"I tell you what, I nearly died because Testa pinched a break on him when he ran off a bit on the hometurn.

"Jimmy straightened him up again, he got up and won."

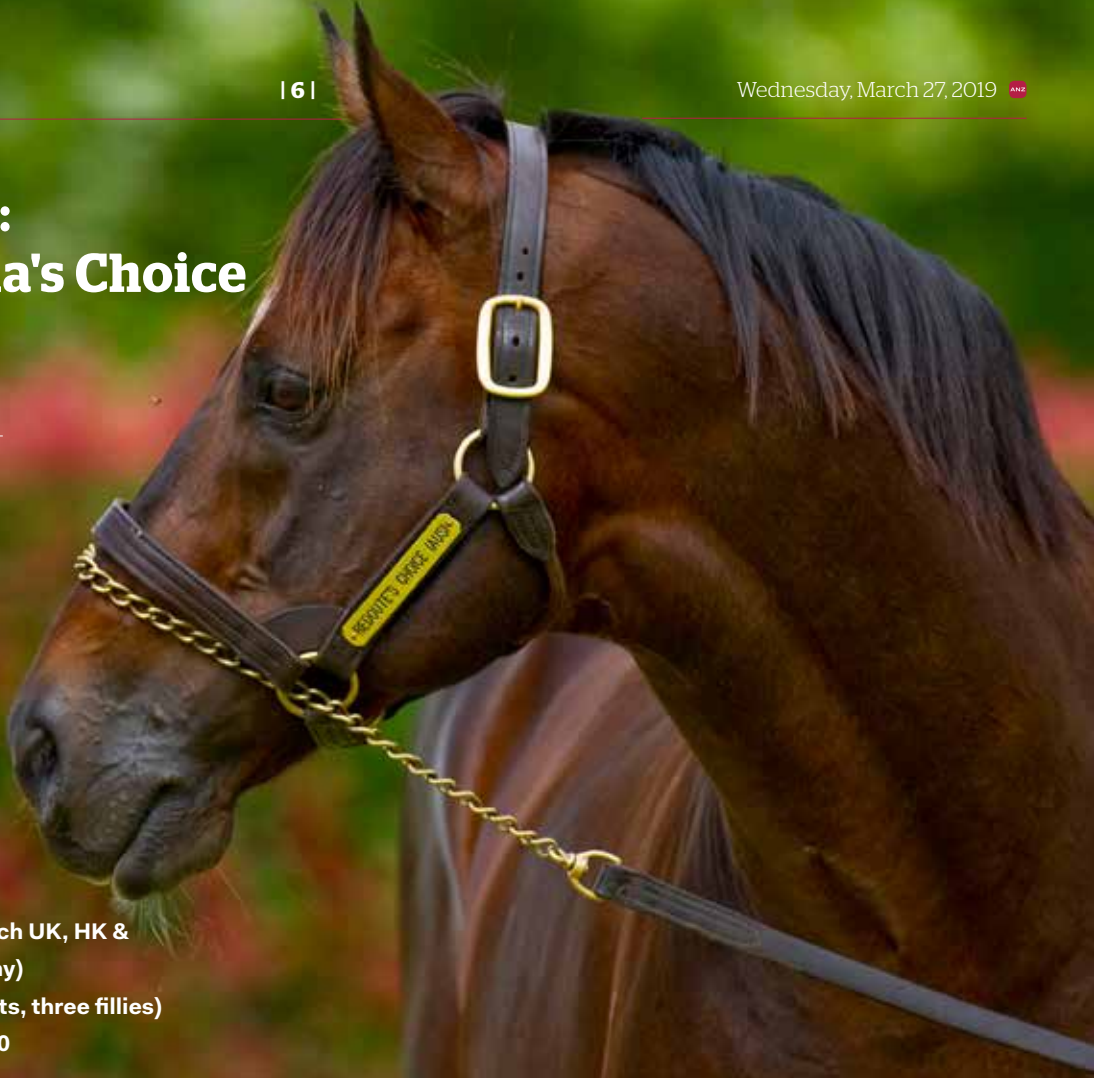

"It was a great honour to have Redoute's Choice stand with us at the Aga Khan's studs for two seasons and he is definitely a horse that will mark the stud book for years to come," Rimaud told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"He was a great horse to have around – he was trouble free and an amusing character. Everyone remembers the horse and the staff are sad at the news of his death."

While his racecourse success in the southern hemisphere far exceeds the level of form his progeny have achieved on the track in Europe, Redoute's Choice has still been represented by a number of black-type performers, siring the winners of six stakes races in France, three in Britain and one in Germany.

They include Sevens Star, who won the Classic Trial (Gr 3, 1m2f) at Sandown for John Gosden last April, and the Freddie Head-trained Gold Luck, who won the Prix Vanteaux (Gr 3, 1800m) at Chantilly in 2017 prior to running a two and a half-length third behind subsequent Dubai World Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Thunder Snow (Helmet) in the Prix Jean Prat (Gr 1, 1600m) at Chantilly.

Rimaud reflected on the legacy of Redoute's Choice from his perspective as a broodmare sire, re-affirming the decision to stand the four-time Group 1 winner through the indelible mark he has imprinted on the Aga Khan's broodmare band.

"Although his progeny's success in Europe did not reach the same level as in Australia, this doesn't take anything away from his intrinsic quality," he continued.

"I think standing Redoute's will, in the end, have been a good move because we have some beautifully-bred fillies by him and they will surely show what they are capable of. Some of them are carrying foals this year and it will be very interesting to have that part of him staying with us for the years to come."

Rimaud also paid compliment

to Redoute's Choice through the legacy he has left courtesy of his heir-apparent, triple Guineas winner The Autumn Sun, who was bred by the Aga Khan in partnership with Arrowfield Stud.

While the future of The Autumn Sun's racing career remains as of yet unclear, Rimaud did not rule out the possibility of supporting him as a breeding prospect when he eventually commences stud duties at Arrowfield.

"We've had the great fortune to breed The Autumn Sun in partnership with John Messara and Arrowfield Stud," Rimaud said. *Continued on page 8 >>*

<< *Continued from page 7* "I wrote to John this morning and said The Autumn Sun will now rise to take charge of his sire's role. Whether he retires to stud this year or the following year, he is the horse who will take-up from Redoute's Choice. He will be an interesting stallion and he's simply been a great horse in Australia.

"We've been asking ourselves if we should send some mares to The Autumn Sun, despite some of the results we've had with Redoute's Choice here. It's definitely a very interesting pedigree for us, which we may be able to use at some stage – we're not sure. We could maybe send some mares to Australia, but we'll see."

The Autumn Sun is out of the unraced Galileo (Sadler's Wells) mare Azmiyna – bred on the same cross as Sevens Star and a fitting match-up

between the two preeminent sires of their respective hemispheres in recent times.

Azmiyna is a three-quarter sister to the stakes-placed Galileo's Star (Galileo) and a half-sister to four-time Group 1-winner Azamour (Night Shift), who died in 2014 having stood for nine seasons at the Aga Khan's Giltown Stud in Ireland. His progeny include Aga Khan

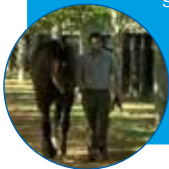
homebred Dolniya, winner of the Dubai Sheema Classic (Gr 1, 2400m) in 2015 who has thus far produced a two-year-old colt by Darley Lynchpin Dubawi (Dubai Millennium) and a yearling filly by Irish National Stud stalwart Invincible Spirit (Green Desert).

Azmiyna is also a half-sister to Group 2 winner Arazan (Anabaa), while The Autumn Sun's third dam is the stakes winner Anaza (Darshaan), who is also the dam of Group 1 winner Astarabad (Alleged) and the stakes-placed Astarak (Rainbow Quest), making this a deep Aga Khan family.

Azmiyna had a Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) colt born on October 29 last year but was not served last season. She was exported to Japan in January where she will be covered by Deep Impact (Sunday Silence) to northern-hemisphere time.

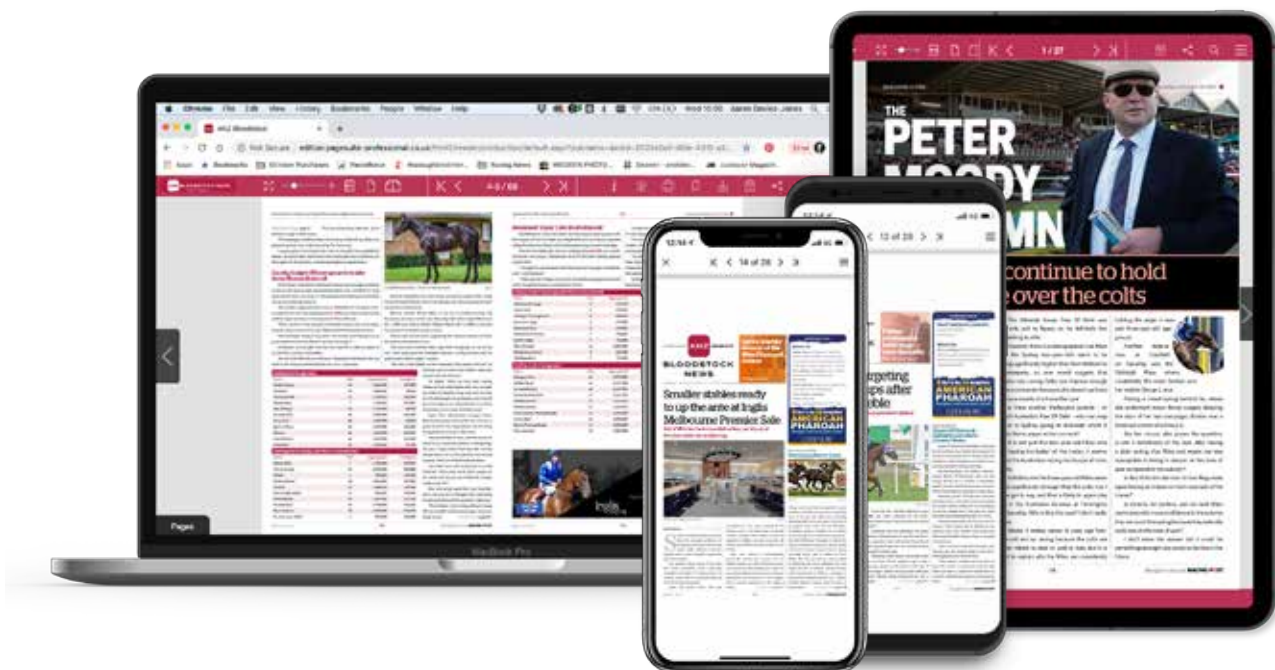

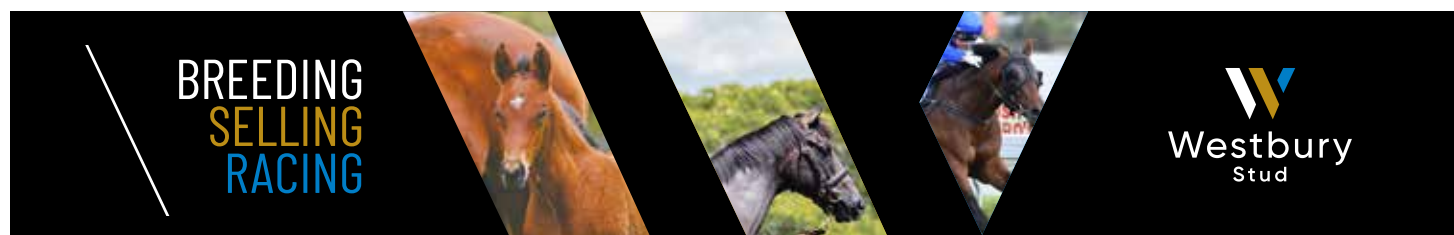

In-form Red Cardinal to run in Tancred

European import Red Cardinal (Montjeu), who is unbeaten this preparation having won the Parramatta Cup (Listed, 1900m) and the Sky High Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m), will return to Rosehill to contest the H E Tancred Stakes (Gr 1, 2400m) on Saturday. The six-year-old is one of three potential runners for Kris Lees, who is also considering running Big Duke (Raven's Pass) and Doukhan (Dansili) - second and fifth in the N E Manion Quality Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) respectively - and both of whom have next month's Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) at Randwick on their radar. "We'll monitor the track conditions for both," Lees said.

Yogi on track for Group 1

Co-trainer Ciaron Maher has issued a positive update on fellow Sydney Cup hopeful Yogi (Raise The Flag), who was last seen finishing eighth in the Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) and who will also contest the H E Tancred Stakes at Rosehill this weekend en route to his Randwick assignment. "He came through his Australian Cup run really well, the 2400 metres will be ideal and the bit of rain around will suit him also," Maher told Racing.com "He came here (from Darren Weir's stable) in super order and he hit the board really early and then we raised the bar to weight-for-age in the Australian Cup. I thought he handled it really well and this mile-and-a-half will have him spot on for the Sydney Cup."

Derby unlikely for Extra Brut

However, the prospect of a wet track could put a premature end to Extra Brut's (Domesday) preparation, with the Tulloch Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) nomination likely to be spelled until the spring. "He's in Sydney at the moment but he doesn't handle wet tracks," Maher also told Racing.com. "He had a gallop this morning and he's entered for the Tulloch, but if it's wet we may not accept. When Sydney gets wet it stays wet, so if this weekend is wet I'd say the Derby will be wet as well and that will probably put a line through the rest of his campaign. We could keep him up, but I'd say we'll probably target the Cup races in the spring."

Red Alto after rare Bendigo double

Last year's Bendigo Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) winner Red Alto (High Chaparral) will return to the scene of that triumph to contest the Golden Mile (Listed, 1600m) this weekend, one of two runners in the contest for Sutton Grange trainer Brent Stanley, who is also set to saddle Violate (Sebring). "He's got the ability to win so it wouldn't surprise me," Stanley said of Red Alto, who finished ninth in the March Stakes (Listed 1400m) on his reappearance earlier in March. "He's fit enough, but it all depends on how the race is run as to how he'll go." Violate won the Shaftesbury Avenue Handicap (Gr

3, 1400m) on his return at Flemington before running eighth in the Ajax Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m) last time out and he is being aimed at the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick on April 6.

Berry to ride Japanese Kluger

In other Doncaster Mile news, Tommy Berry has been booked to ride the Tomokazu Takano-trained Kluger (King Kamehameha) at Randwick and his trainer cut a delighted figure after the seven-year-old worked over 1400 metres on the course-proper at Canterbury on Tuesday morning. "He worked very well and we are very happy," Takano told Racenet.com. "He worked from seven furlongs out and he worked nicely. He had no problems travelling and he has no issues. He's a nice, relaxed big horse. We thought that the grass here would suit him better than in Japan - he doesn't mind the wet ground. He's very well handicapped and he has no problem travelling." Kluger has won five of his 19 starts, including the Yomiuri Milers Cup (Gr 2, 1600m) at Kyoto in April 2016.

The Autumn Sun spelled

The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice) will be sent for a spell with a decision still pending on his racing future. The valuable colt claimed his fifth Group 1 win in Saturday's Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m) in a tough slog on a heavy track. Trainer Chris Waller said he had advised the owners that the colt should be rested. "This decision was formed on the basis that he is still a young horse who is continuing to grow and develop and whilst it may not be seen in that light by racing enthusiasts and his growing fan base, it is my job as his trainer to look after these horses to ensure they can be followed and continue their careers with distinction," Waller said in a statement. "It is not my job to make a decision on when he retires, however it is my job to manage the horse to the best of my ability and I take great pride in what has been achieved thus far."

In Her Time a T J Smith doubt

Dual Group 1-winning mare In Her Time (Time Thief) is a doubt for the T J Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) after suffering a foot issue. The Kris Lees-trained six-year-old, who won the Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) first-up, was scratched from a Gosford barrier trial yesterday after returning from a two-start Melbourne campaign. In Her Time ran sixth last start in the Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m). "In Her Time has a foot issue, and we are treating it," Lees said. "She (did not) trial at Gosford ... and a T J Smith start is unlikely. She has been nominated for the Group 1 Chairman's Sprint Prize at Sha Tin at the end of April, and the Brisbane Winter Carnival is also approaching. But we'll just have to see how she progresses before determining any immediate plans."

Paddock likely for Graff

Kris Lees is also weighing up what to do with talented three-year-old Graff (Star Witness) who did not handle the heavy track in The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m) at Rosehill on Saturday. The Group 3 winner, who had finished fourth in the Black Caviar Lightning Stakes and the Newmarket Handicap, tired to finish last in The Galaxy. "Both he and Gem Song didn't handle the heavy track in their respective races," Lees said. "It was hard work out there on a very testing track, and Graff was pretty distressed after the race. That may be it in regard to his current campaign, but we are yet to make a final decision."

Lyre spelled

Lyre (Lonhro), the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner, will be spelled immediately following her third in Saturday's Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m). Trainer Anthony Freedman confirmed yesterday that the two-year-old filly, who is a Godolphin homebred, would not continue her campaign towards the Inglis Sires (registered as ATC Sires' Produce Stakes) (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick on Saturday week. Lyre raced five times in her first campaign for three wins and her Group 1 placing, earning \$1,381,400 in prize-money.

Nothin' Leica High overdue for win

Nothin' Leica High (High Chaparral) has been placed in four of his eight starts this preparation, while he has finished fourth in a further three of those, and trainer Robbie Griffiths is hopeful the four-year-old can gain compensation in the Yulong Handicap (2400m) at Sandown today. "He's been good without winning so hopefully he can get the job done on Wednesday," Griffiths said. "He's been knocking on the door - surely it's going to open soon. He goes around every couple of weeks and earns money. I said to the owners after his last run, I know it's frustrating not winning, but most owners would give their back teeth to have a horse run in the metropolitan area every run and collect a cheque every time he runs."

Stephenson unable to avoid clash

Trainer Richie Stephenson will allow stablemates Bernie's Tiger (Bernardini) and Skylight (Red Dazzler) to clash at Toowoomba today, albeit reluctantly. The pair will do battle in the Class 3 Plate (1640m),

with Josh Oliver booked to ride Bernie's Tiger while Kenji Yoshida stays aboard Skylight. "I tried to find different races for them but unfortunately this was the best race for both," Stephenson told Racing Queensland. "They both should run very well but it's a hard race. "If the speed is on Skylight will finish over the top of them. She had to lead last time at Toowoomba when she prefers to chase. She should have won her previous start when she suffered bad interference at Caloundra."

Ef Troop wins trial

Talented three-year-old Ef Troop (Spirit Of Boom) has shown his well-being with a decisive barrier-trial victory at Doomben yesterday. The gelding was having his first serious test since October and, after being caught three-deep early, had far too much pace over the 840-metre trip to beat Masterati (Master Of Design) by three and a quarter lengths. Trainer Tony Gollan said Ef Troop would have another trial before going to the Mick Dittman Plate (Listed, 1200m) at Eagle Farm on April 20. "He did what we wanted and that trial should bring him along nicely," Gollan said.

Balfour charged over alleged raceday treatment

Racing Victoria stewards have charged trainer Clive Balfour with alleged raceday treatment of a runner at Moe in November last year. Stewards charged Balfour with breaching the raceday treatment rule when he allegedly administered or caused to be administered "Racing Oil" orally to Alsimon (Bushranger) before the horse competed in a Benchmark 58 Handicap. Ranvet's Racing Oil product sheet says the substance "spares glycogen use, reducing the formation of lactic acid" in horses when racing. The product statement also declares Racing Oil "provides sufficient energy for performance, particularly for endurance work". The Racing Appeals and Disciplinary Board will hear the case on a date to be fixed.

New Zealand

Wet track to help Qiji Spirit

Pukekohe trainer Nigel Tiley will travel south to Awapuni on Saturday with promising juvenile Qiji Spirit (Charm Spirit) set to tackle the Manawatu Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m), where the forecast wet conditions are expected to suit the three-start maiden. "He worked really well this morning," Tiley said. "The weather forecast is for a bit of rain down that way, which I think would really help him, and the 1400 metres will be right up his alley. There are only 12 left in the race, so I would be silly not to go down. I am confident that he will run a good race. He has got three-year-old written all over him." While Tiley believes Qiji Spirit will develop into a better three-year-old, he is eyeing a tilt at the Champagne Stakes (Listed, 1600m) should he pull up well after Saturday.

Tiptronic to continue campaign

Tiptronic (O'Reilly) will head towards the Easter Handicap (Gr 2, 1600m) at Ellerslie next month following a disappointing effort in the Japan-New Zealand International

Trophy (Gr 2, 1600m) on Saturday. The Group 1-placegetter finished a well-beaten 12th, with co-trainer Graham Richardson reporting the gelding to be none the worse for his exertions after some initial post-race concern. "He had a very hard run," Richardson said. "I was a bit worried about the horse - I went running down to see if he was okay. His action up the straight didn't look that good, but he's as good as gold. I'm going to save him for the Easter. He's better right-handed. Most of his best achievements have been right-handed and he loves Ellerslie."

Grant Cooksley to train

Jockey Grant Cooksley is to enter a training partnership with Bruce Wallace while continuing to ride. As well as his native New Zealand, Cooksley has ridden with success in Sydney and Asia. Known as 'The Iceman' for his cool demeanour, Cooksley has combined with Wallace over the years for multiple Group 1 successes. "I've thought about training for a while now," Cooksley said. "I had a couple of options in Sydney, but it was too early at that stage. I just wanted to concentrate on riding at the time. Now this opportunity has come up to train in partnership with Bruce and it's too good to turn down. If I started on my own I'd have to do it from scratch, but I've been given the opportunity to start with an established stable."

Zimmerman joins Tiley

In other news for the Tiley stable, multiple Group 1-winning trainer Karren Zimmerman will take up the position of stable foreman. Zimmerman won four Group 1 races in her training career,

with Barinka (Shinko King) recording the last of them in the NZ Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Te Aroha in 2011. Tiley said he is delighted to have someone of Zimmerman's experience join the stable. "She is going to join us in about three weeks," he said. "We advertised for a foreman/assistant trainer and Karen was very keen to take it on and we would have been stupid if we hadn't taken her straight away. She's a horsewoman, too - her horses always look immaculate on race day. I'll be able to travel a few more horses and be very comfortable that I have got somebody at home that's more than capable of doing the job for us."

Asia

Charisma in line to charm Happy Valley for a second time

John Moore believes that being trained at Conghua has helped unlock the potential of Helene Charisma (Air Chief Marshal) and he is hoping that the six-year-old can record back-to-back wins in the Mount Collinson Handicap (2200m) at Happy Valley today. The one-time Hong Kong Derby (Listed, 2000m) prospect hasn't lived up to expectations since he finished fifth behind Rapper Dragon (Street Boss) in the 2017 edition of the race. "He's been a total disappointment, but finally we got Zac on board (last start) and he was able to work a miracle," Moore said. "He did win very well - I was pleased with the effort. He's a different horse since he's been at Conghua for a couple of months. That's done the job for him - he's enjoyed being over there."

The six-year-old was beaten a neck by former stablemate Beat The Clock (Hinchinbrook) in the Centenary Sprint Cup (Gr 1, 1200m) in January and Lor, speaking after Mr Stunning eased home first under Purton in a 1050-metre dirt trial yesterday, said: "Mr Stunning was strong, but different, today. You can see Zac has got soft hands, so he gets the horse more relaxed. The owner talked to me about Mr Stunning being six already and next year he will be turned seven. He still wonders if the horse can keep top form or not. Zac maybe gives the horse a chance to still have two big races for him, so that's why we changed the jockeys."

International

First for Alhebayeb

Tara Stud stallion Alhebayeb (Dark Angel) was

provided with his first stakes winner yesterday courtesy of Talk Or Listen's (3 c ex Sodashy by Noverre) tenacious victory in the Prix Francois Mathet (Listed, 2100m) at Saint-Cloud. Trained by Frederic Rossi and ridden by Stephane Pasquier, the colt got up in the shadows of the post to beat Surrey Thunder (Le Havre) by a nose, with three lengths back to Argyron (Ifraaj) in third. Alhebayeb's first-crop of racing age yielded 17 winners, while he is currently standing at Tara Stud in Ireland for a fee of €5,000.

Eight for Intello

Cheveley Park stallion Intello (Galileo) was handed an eighth stakes winner yesterday after Folamour lunged late to land the Prix de la Porte de Madrid (Listed, 2400m) at Saint-Cloud. The Andre Fabre-trained colt got up in the nick of time to collar Ziyad (Rock Of Gibraltar) by a head, with a length and a quarter back to Good Question (Manduro) in third. Intello, whose progeny is spearheaded by Prix Jean Prat (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Intellogent, is currently

standing at Cheveley Park Stud in Newmarket for a fee of £20,000.

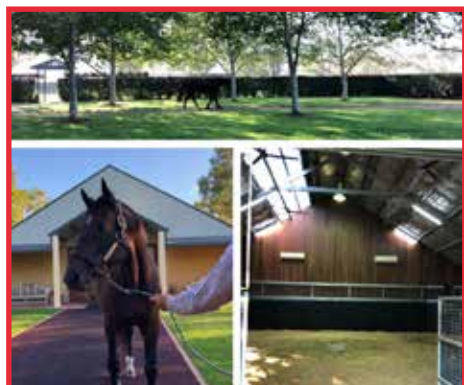
Catcher In The Rye dies

Catcher In The Rye (Danehill), who stood under the Coolmore banner for six seasons having finished runner-up behind Rathasker Stud stallion Clodovil (Danehill) in the 2003 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (Gr 1, 1600m), died at Haras la Leyenda in Argentina on Monday at the age of 19. Catcher In The Rye stood for five seasons at Castle Hyde Stud and an extra year at Coolmore Stud, before taking up permanent residence in Argentina, where he was crowned leading first-season sire and champion sire twice. He first took up residence at Estacion de Montas la Mission in 2006, started shuttling to Haras de la Pomme in 2013 and eventually arrived at Alberto Stein's Haras la Leyenda in 2018. His southern hemisphere offspring includes champion two- and three-year-old filly Catch The Mad and other multiple-Group 1 winners in Argentina, including Anaerobio, Flowing Rye and Rabid In The Rye.

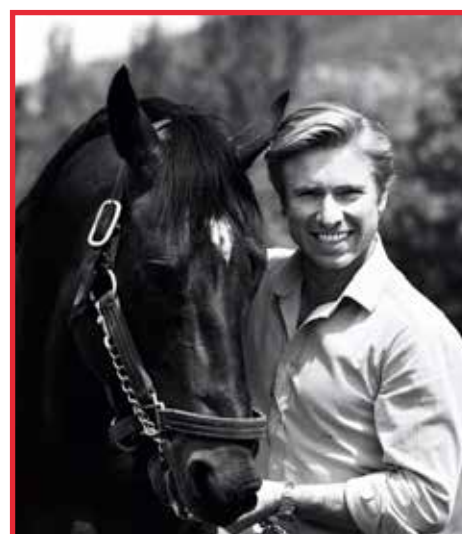

The legacy shaped by Redoute's Choice (Danehill) can be measured by many metrics, not least the level of form achieved by his progeny on the racecourse. The accolade of his greatest act at stud, at least according to Timeform ratings, is awarded to Lankan Rupee, who was allocated the lofty figure of 132 following his two-length victory in the 2014 renewal of the TJ Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) – one of five top-tier successes for the explosive sprinter.

It is not uncommon for the elite stallions to produce at least one horse who exceeds their own level of form on the track. In the northern hemisphere, longstanding Coolmore Stud breed-shaper Galileo (Sadler's Wells) was awarded a Timeform rating of 134 following his two-length success in the King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 1m4f) at Ascot in 2001, a figure his great masterpiece - the Juddmonte Stud champion Frankel - would eclipse nine times during his unbeaten 14-race career, including a record-high of 147 following his 11-length demolition in the Queen Anne Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) at Royal Ascot in 2012.

However, the subsequent achievements of a stallion in the covering shed can sometimes overshadow their very own brilliance as a racehorse and now seems a pertinent time to revisit the career of Redoute's Choice the athlete who, despite only running ten times, amassed \$1,600,350 in prize-money having won five of those outings and been placed on a further three occasions.

126: CF Orr Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m), 2000 - Won

In the vernacular of Redoute's Choice, this was not his career-defining performance. Yet in quantitative terms, it very much was. In what would prove his penultimate outing and

his final success, Redoute's Choice saved the best until last so far as the figure-compilers are concerned, prevailing by a head over Miss Pennymoney (Brocco) following a stirring dual up the Caulfield straight in which the runner-up eyeballed her rival but was run out of proceedings by the paint-scraping champion. In pure handicapping terms, this was not a performance the eye would deduce as the crest of the wave, with a blanket finish separating the first three home, but in beating a pair of rivals who had already notched seven top-tier

successes between them, Redoute's Choice clocked the figure of 126 - the very peak of his achievements.

Testa Rossa (Perugino) shot a length and a half clear inside the 200 metres, accelerating with a venom that was surely race-sealing, but Redoute's Choice had far different ideas, knuckling down well and producing a powerful late surge to get up on the line, so eloquently described in a dramatic

commentary by Greg Miles as 'Redoute's digs, he lunges, and wins!' Awarded a Timeform rating of 125 for the win, Redoute's Choice was adjudged to have run to the same figure when finishing a length and a half behind Testa Rossa in the Vic Health Cup just under three weeks beforehand. However, with both colts tackling 1600 metres for the first time, Redoute's Choice saw the trip out stronger to turn the tables on his old foe. Redoute's Choice and Testa Rossa would clash six times overall, with the final tally standing at two victories apiece, while Testa Rossa held the verdict over Redoute's Choice in the two other contests where neither horse won, finishing runner-up in the Ascot Vale Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) as Redoute's Choice was fourth, and fourth in the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) as Redoute's Choice ran fifth, with neither horse best-suited by the step up to middle-distances.

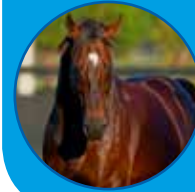
124: Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), 1999 - Won

Spring the gates, adopt a prominent pitch, quicken clear and maintain the unbeaten run. Four simple steps, beautifully executed by a colt who elevated his record to three-from-three and expertly guided by a wasting Jim Cassidy, who stripped down to 51 kilograms for the ride. The first start of his three-year-old preparation, Redoute's Choice was simply imperious on his return, quickening up on the turn for home to power a length and a half clear of Marstic (Rustic Amber), while the commentary was once again majestic, describing the 'big colt' as one who 'could be anything' as he hit the line. Simply anything he wasn't, but something very special he was.

Having made a successful debut in Listed company only one-week beforehand, Redoute's Choice lined-up in the Blue Diamond light on experience but bristling with promise having defied a troubled passage to win first-up. And he confirmed the twinkle glimpsed on that occasion with a performance belying his lack of racecourse nous in Victoria's most prestigious juvenile prize, quickening up takingly to collar Testa Rossa inside the final 100 metres and win going away by two lengths. That success would signal the start of a great rivalry between the winner and the runner-up, while the manner of victory in the context of such an embryonic career at that stage was an early indicator of just how robust both Redoute's Choice and his progeny would subsequently prove.

Redoute's Choice: a force to be reckoned with for years to come

Not since the days of Danehill (Danzig), his own breed-shaping sire, has a stallion exerted quite the influence over the Australian thoroughbred that Redoute's Choice has.

In the immediate aftermath of his passing, it is worth reflecting on the sheer magnitude of his immense stallion career.

Redoute's Choice has sired 34 Group 1 winners, with his first coming when first-crop daughter Lotteria landed the 2004 Flight Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) and his most recent when Galaxy Star claimed last year's Railway Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m).

His roll of honour boasts some genuine modern greats, think Miss Finland and Lankan Rupee, and also includes current stars such as The Autumn Sun, who notched his fifth elite win in Saturday's Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m).

At the time of writing, although it is a tally unlikely to remain static for long, he is responsible for 163 stakes winners – including 106 at Group level – who have landed 329 black-type races. Those headline runners have contributed the lion's share of \$157.2 million in lifetime progeny earnings.

Significantly, these achievements make it something of an inevitability that Redoute's Choice's name will reverberate throughout pedigrees for generations to come.

Snitzel heads a lengthy list of sire sons, and has long since looked the heir apparent to his former Arrowfield neighbour.

At a price of \$220,000, Snitzel boasts the highest stud fee in a booming Australian stallion market, and with good reason, having supplied 13 Group 1 winners from nine full crops of racing age.

He has broken all manner of records at stud, and is on course to claim his third consecutive champion sire title at the end of the current season.

Snitzel is, however, not alone when it comes to Redoute's Choice's sire sons. A total of 38 horses who have struck at the highest level boast Redoute's Choice as grandsire, with Snitzel joined by other multiple Group 1 winner-siring sons Beneteau (2 Group 1 winners); Fast 'N' Famous (3); Not A Single Doubt (8); and Stratum (7).

Meanwhile, Bradbury's Luck, Duelled, Lucky Unicorn, Nadeem and Time Thief have all sired one Group 1 winner each.

At present, 26 of Redoute's Choice's sire sons are responsible for a total of 286 stakes winners. With young and well-credentialed colts still on the up, it is unthinkable that these figures will not rise sharply in the coming years.

While Australia is very much the epicentre of Redoute's Choice's influence, he also has a handful of sire sons scattered around the globe, including: Elzaam, who has gained a solid

fanbase at Ballyhane Stud in Ireland; France is home to Haras d'Etreham's shuttler Scissor Kick; Counterattack resides at Gestut Karlshof in Germany; while the South African-based pair Rafeef and Wylie Hall stand at Ridgemont Highlands and Cheveley Stud respectively.

Moreover, Redoute's Choice can already be found in the third generation of pedigrees, with Snitzel's own sire sons proving hot property in Australia, notably the likes of Russian Revolution, Invader and Spill The Beans.

And as is the case with all genuine breed-shapers, it is not only through the paternal line that Redoute's Choice is exerting his influence, as he is on the verge of claiming a maiden victory in the champion broodmare sire standings in Australia, too.

His daughters' progeny have accumulated in excess of A\$15.3m in earnings during the current campaign, with Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Extra Brut, who is by Domesday (Red Ransom) and out of Dom Perion, having contributed over A\$1.6m alone.

Redoute's Choice has been represented as the broodmare sire of 13 Group 1 winners throughout his career, most notably Zoustar (Northern Meteor), who was successful in the Golden Rose (Gr 1, 1400m) and Coolmore Stud Stakes (registered as Ascot Vale Stakes) (Gr 1, 1200m) and is now making his own mark at stud, having supplied three-time top-level winner Sunlight and elite performers Lean Mean Machine and Zousain.

With the son of Northern Meteor (Encosta De Lago) standing his first season at Tweenhills Stud in Gloucestershire, Zoustar looks set to further Redoute's Choice's global impact.

Moreover, there are some eye-catching stallion prospects among his daughters' 13 Group 1 winners, including Aquis Farm's The Mission (Choisir), Waikato Stud's Sacred Falls (O'Reilly) and Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Kementari (Lonhro), who will join Darley's Kelvinside roster later this year.

All told his broodmare daughters have produced 86 stakes winners and counting, and he has plenty of well-bred crops still to retire to the paddocks.

With a record of such uncommon excellence, and not to mention the ammunition still in the pipeline, the progeny of Redoute's Choice will ensure he remains a force to be reckoned with in pedigrees for years to come.

Japanese venture promises to pay dividends for Waterhouse and Bott

The Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained Hokkaido Miss is certainly the most intriguing runner at Sandown Lakeside today.

The four-year-old northern hemisphere-bred mare is by a Japanese stallion from a German mare, by an Irish stallion; she was bought as a foal in Japan, raised in France and originally prepared by the now retired Crique Head before transferring to Francis-Henri Graffard to win two of her five starts from Chantilly before her export to Australia.

Hokkaido Miss, by Orfevre, was one of five horses knocked down to Gai Waterhouse and Satomi Oka Bloodstock at the 2015 JRA Select Sale (Foals) at Hokkaido. Purchased for c. \$400,000, she will be the third of the purchases to race in Australia for Waterhouse-Bott, following the promising stayer Hush Writer and the unbeaten Wolfe.

Waterhouse also bought the now gelded Kushiro (Novellist) who is also in Australia but not yet raced and has taken more time to acclimatise according to Bott, along with Tuna Ocean (Workforce) who remained in Japan and has not yet won.

On balance, you'd say the unusual venture has been successful with the promise of better to come.

Bott, like Graffard a graduate of the Godolphin Flying Start programme, takes up the story: "We weren't in the same intake and, in fact, I've never met him but obviously there is the Flying Start connection and Francis came highly recommended to us after Crique

Head retired. He speaks English which is helpful and he's done an excellent job with both Hush Writer and this mare Hokkaido Miss," he said.

Hokkaido Miss resumes at 1600 metres tomorrow after winning over 2700 metres on the synthetic track at Chantilly in December. She finished second to Amralah in a 1550 metres trial at Cranbourne on 18 March.

"This race is likely to be a bit short for her

first-up," Bott said. "She probably doesn't have the tactical speed but she will stay all day and we'll have a better gauge when she steps up in trip. But she has certainly thrived and done very well ever since she's been here."

Hush Writer, by Rulership, had four runs in Australia last spring which included a second to Jaameh at 2500 metres at Flemington and a third to Haripour in the Listed Harry White (Ansett) Classic, over 2400 metres, at Mornington.

"There's some upside with this horse," Bott said. "His spring prep was a bit rushed and he wasn't quite there mentally but he still managed to run a couple of very good races. He's been gelded since that campaign and is coming along well. He'll have a light campaign with a view to being back for the spring."

The plan is similar, as are the expectations, with Wolfe, who won at Kembla Grange and Hawkesbury late last year after also coming from France where he was unraced.

"He's back in work and going well. We'd hope that he could go further through his

grades this winter and then pop up in the spring," Bott said.

The recent Moonee Valley placegetter Crimson Tears, a filly by Heart's Cry, was also bought from that 2015 foal sale - by Melbourne agent Rob Roulston.

The highest priced lot at c. \$2.4 million, incidentally, at that 2015 foal sale was a Deep Impact filly named Danon Cherry who boasts one three-year-old maiden win in Japan. Ditto for the highest priced colt who races as Tosen Brave (King Kamehameha).

Japan's champion filly Almond Eye, who will start a short priced favourite in Saturday's Dubai Turf at Meydan, was also a 2015 foal but she didn't go through the sales ring.

She was sent to Silk Racing Club straight from the farm. She was syndicated as a yearling. She was priced at 30,000,000 yen (about the same as was paid for Hokkaido Miss) in total and that was divided into 500 shares for 60,000 yen a share. She's won about 680,000,000 yen (about \$8.6 million).

Godolphin dominate the Golden Slipper

Godolphin's results in Australian racing this season have been uniformly outstanding but the performances of its two-year-olds have been nothing less than spectacular, winning both the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), last Saturday's Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) plus a number of other juvenile features along the way.

Having a huge stable of well-bred horses is obviously a big start for Sheikh Mohammed's international operation, with it's dedicated team of people behind the scenes making Godolphin very tough competition for rivals in racing, particularly when backed up by the Darley breeding operation standing a number of the best stallions in Australia, Europe and the United States.

But having said that, in Australia, great credit should also go to Godolphin's young, principal trainer James Cummings, who got five of his charges into the 2019 Golden Slipper and was able to quinella the race with underestimated filly Kiamichi (Sidestep) and the colt Microphone (Exceed and Excel), leaving Godolphin's Anthony Freedman-trained Blue Diamond winner Lyre (Lonhro) to finish strongly into third place to provide Godolphin with an unprecedented trifecta in Australia's premier juvenile event.

The Golden Slipper placegetters are all Godolphin homebreds by Darley-owned sires with Kiamichi's homebred father Sidestep (Exceed and Excel) a paternal half-brother to second placed Microphone.

Like most recent renewals of the Golden Slipper, this year's race was contested on a heavy track making it a real test of toughness, particularly for 25/1 shot Kiamichi who was backing up from her Magic Night Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) victory a week earlier to jump brilliantly from her outside barrier, work cross the field to lead then defy her rivals to score by a length, with a half-length separating Microphone and Lyre at the line.

Kiamichi's sire Sidestep exhibited similar qualities of toughness during his juvenile career, winning the Pago Pago Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) on the previous Saturday before backing up a week later to be second to Overreach (Exceed and Excel) in the 2013 Golden Slipper. Sidestep's juvenile performances resulted in him being ranked as Australia's champion two-year-old colt of his generation.

At three, Sidestep went on to win the ATC Royal Sovereign Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) and the ATC Darby Munro Stakes (Listed, 1200m) before retiring to Darley's Hunter Valley farm in 2015 where he covered 134 mares, leaving 86 living first crop foals now headed by a Golden Slipper winner.

Sidestep then shuttled to Haras du Logis in France for three seasons, returning to NSW to cover 86 mares in the 2016 season but only 36 in 2017. Interestingly, Sidestep's mare numbers in France suffered an even steeper decline, going from 105 in his first season to just 23 in his third season there.

At that point, Dan Fletcher, owner of the newly established Telemon Thoroughbreds in south eastern Queensland, approached Darley with a successful proposal to lease Sidestep to stand there for the next two seasons and in

2018 he served 57 mares at an advertised fee of \$7,700. Sire of his third individual winner, Longbottom, on Sunday, Sidestep will no doubt stand for a higher fee this spring.

From the family of champion Emancipation (Bletchingly), Sidestep has only limited Golden Slipper connections compared to those of Kiamichi's unraced dam Ouachita (Canny Lad), producer of five other winners headed by the 2019 Tasmanian Derby (Listed, 2200m) victor Cossetot (Epaulette). To come for Ouachita is a 2018 filly by Animal Kingdom (Leroidesanimaux) but the mare was not served last season.

A sister to Group 1-winning two-year-old Preserve (Canny Lad) and to stakes-winning producer Rio Osa (Canny Lad), Ouachita is closely related to promising Western Australia-based stallion Safeguard (Exceed and Excel) and is also a half-sister to Group 1 winner and successful sire Denman (Lonhro). Ouachita was bred by Woodlands Stud so is yet another wonderful dividend resulting from Sheikh Mohammed's 2008 purchase of the Ingham bloodstock empire.

Kiamichi's dam, second dam Peach (Vain) and third dam Market Maid (Marscay) are all daughters of notable winners of the Golden Slipper, while Market Maid is out of Marjoram (Major General) and is a half-sister to Dark Eclipse (Baguette), a winner, like Kiamichi, of the Magic Night/Golden Slipper double in 1980.

Marjoram, in turn, is a half-sister to a near champion in Taj Rossi (Matrice), from Dark Queen (Coronation Boy) which provides several links to the late Bart Cummings, grandfather of Kiamichi's trainer, and to his outstanding 1966 Golden Slipper winner Storm Queen (Coronation Boy), a close relative of Dark Queen from the same South Australian family.

Taj Rossi won six feature races, among them four now recognised as Group 1s including the Ascot Vale (Coolmore Stud) Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) and the Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m). He became a successful sire with three Group 1 winners among his progeny.

Kiamichi is an outcross to five generations but her pedigree carries three crosses of the legendary Star Kingdom (Stardust), sire of the first five winners of the Golden Slipper.




