Mystic Journey creates history in Australian Guineas

Three-year-old becomes first Tasmanian-trained horse to win at Group 1 level

Connections of Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Mystic Journey (Needs Further) could be destined for another huge payday in the \$5 million All-Star Mile (1600m) after she became the first Tasmanian-trained filly to win a race at the highest level.

The star Adam Trinder-trained Mystic Journey, the first horse prepared in the Apple Isle to win at Group 1 level since the introduction of the Group system in the late 1970s, will take

on older horses in the Flemington feature on her next start on March 16.

But yesterday Trinder, a former jumps jockey who trains at Devonport's Spreyton Racecourse in Tasmania's north, was focusing on the enormity of his star filly's success.

"It's a Group 1 - they don't come any bigger," Trinder said.

"She's a fantastic filly, which makes our assignment a lot easier.

"The team at home do a fantastic job with these horses and it's good to be able to showcase it on the main stage. *Continued on page 2>>*

Winx does it again - her fourth Chipping Norton

What more can you say? Winx (Street Cry) has done it again. It was not unexpected, but she has now strung 31 wins together, while she has succeeded 23 times at Group 1 level.

Yesterday's victory in the Chipping Norton Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick, the fourth time in a row she has won the race, did not come without a challenge from her main Sydney foe of recent seasons, top-class gelding Happy Clapper (Teofilo).

Blake Shinn sent the Pat Webster-trained Happy Clapper to the lead, the first time he has done so in his career, and established a big mid-race advantage. << *Continued from page 1* "We didn't think she was a Group 1 filly in the spring but we trusted come the autumn, once she strengthened up, she would be. Thankfully we were right."

Mystic Journey defeated Hawkshot (Fiorente) (\$7) by two and a quarter lengths with a long-neck back to Amphitrite (Sebring) (\$4.20) in third.

She is expected to gain a wildcard entry into the inaugural running of the 14-horse All-Star Mile later this month.

Bred by Victoria's Ralph Zito, Mystic Journey was purchased from the 2017 Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale for \$11,000 from the Armidale Stud draft by Trinder for owner Wayne Rosser.

"We bought her and thought she was a lovely cheap little filly that would go out and do a job for us," Trinder said.

"Not in our wildest dreams did we think that job would be a Group 1." Mystic Journey, who had won two lead-up starts in her home state this preparation, was ridden by low-profile jockey Anthony Darmanin, who is based in Victoria but rides regularly in Tasmania.

For Darmanin, 36, the win was also his first at Group 1 level.

"It's just amazing," he said.

"I never thought I would ever ride in a Group 1 let alone win one.

"She was a bit timid in the field but once she went past the second horse she just found another gear and it was easy on the line."

Darmanin was later suspended for eight meetings for breaching the whip rules.

Mystic Journey (3 f Needs Further - White Gold by Colombia) took her record to nine wins from 13 starts and yesterday's first prize of \$600,000 took her earnings to \$1,012,600.

The first Group 1 winner for her Tasmania-based sire Needs Further (Encosta De Lago), who stands at Armidale Stud, Mystic Journey is one of three winners for White Gold, herself victorious on two occasions and a sister to the stakes-placed Oronero.

Mystic Journey is also a half-sister to Oh So Gold (Savoire Vivre), the dam of Listed winner Mystical Pursuit (Needs Further).

Needs Further, who stood for a 2018 fee of \$5500 (inc. GST), is the sire of three stakes winners and five stakes-performing horses.

Nakeeta Jane a star on the rise for So You Think

The emergence of lightly-raced filly Nakeeta Jane (So You Think), who was unraced at the start of last spring, continued yesterday when the talented three-year-old scored a narrow but brilliant win in the Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m).

Nakeeta Jane's victory, which followed on from her first-up win the Light Fingers Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) and that of her third placing in the Flight Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) on just her third start, also mirrors the progression of her Sydney-based trainer Mark Newnham.

A long-time Gai Waterhouse employee, Newnham trained another current three-year-old filly, Maid Of Heaven (Smart Missile), to win the Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) less than two years into his own training career.

Now he has two wins at the highest level, with the promise of more to come from Nakeeta Jane (\$3.60 favourite), who came from off the speed to defeat race leader Fundamentalist (Not A Single Doubt) (\$14) by half a head.

El Dorado Dreaming (Ilovethiscity) (\$19) was another head away in third place.

"She is very special. To do what she has done in that number of starts she is top class," Newnham said.

"They've been a really superior group of fillies right through their two-year-old year. The fillies had it over the colts in the Slipper, Sires' and Champagne last year. It really continued on with that trend.

"For her to do what she did in the spring and be better - I'm speechless with it really."

Newnham is contemplating backing Nakeeta Jane up in the Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) on Saturday, which would see her clash with The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice). *Continued on page 6 >>*

<< *Continued from page 4* "Looking at the Australian Guineas today there wouldn't be many back up from that," he said.

"It won't be a full field there. It's not an easy assignment taking on The Autumn Sun, but it will be a good lead up for her into the Vinery at 2000 metres three weeks later."

Nakeeta Jane was ridden once again by Josh Parr, who has struck up a successful partnership with Newnham.

"We began a little bit awkwardly and as I thought there was a clump of horses that wanted the same spot - third, fourth, fifth, sixth - and it just forced me to get in behind them and get her to travel knowing that she's got a better turn of foot if she can travel up and dash at them," Parr said.

"The problem then was how slow they went. It was an absolute walkathon and we are out of our ground, covering ground. The leaders kicked from the top of the hill and she had it all ahead of her."

A winner of three of her five starts as well as a third in last spring's Flight Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m), Nakeeta Jane (3 f So You Think - Lustre Lady by Flying Spur) has earned \$495,050 in prize-money.

Nakeeta Jane is the fifth foal out of Group 2 placegetter Lustre Lady (Flying Spur), who has produced winners with all of her foals to date over distances ranging from 1200 metres to 1900 metres.

Lustre Lady herself is out of the winning mare Lucky Lady (Nashwan), making her a half-sister to Legaya (Shirley Heights), the dam of British Listed winner Legal Approach (Zafonic).

Her third and fourth dams, Jet Ski Lady (Vaguely Noble) and Bemissed

(Nijinsky), were both victorious at Group 1 level, including the former's emphatic 10-length victory in the Oaks (Gr 1, 1m4f) at Epsom.

In 2016, Lustre Lady slipped to Coolmore's young sire Adelaide (Galileo) before producing a filly, who died, by the same sire in 2017. She also has a colt foal by fellow Coolmore stallion Pierro (Lonhro) and was most recently covered by So You Think in late October.

Nakeeta Jane is the fifth Group 1 winner for Coolmore's So You Think (High Chaparral).



Trainer Chris Waller said rival jockey Blake Shinn almost rode the perfect race on Happy Clapper but had little doubt turning for home that Winx would make up the ground on the third-last start of her remarkable career.

"It was certainly no easy feat," Waller said. "I thought Winx would either beat him if they go too slow or they go too fast. I'd say they almost got it right. Under pressure she is very good.

"It was a good test for her and will bring her on nicely for the next couple of runs because they need stimulating. They need to do it under race conditions to get that. It's looking good for three weeks time then three weeks after that."

Winx's jockey Hugh Bowman called on his experience when Happy Clapper had kicked clear and did not panic.

"Blake really made it a test today, as Josh Parr did a few years ago on Red Excitement, but she can cover all bases this mare," Bowman said.

"She's just an amazing athlete, there are really no more words to describe her.

“When you watch the replay, at the 700 metres you would have thought well she’s out of business, and another jockey riding her may have thought that, but I knew when I balanced up there was no way that Happy Clapper could sustain that speed.

“I knew that when she balanced up, she’d have the energy required to reel him in.

“To be honest, although I was pushing her, she did it with relative ease.”

Winx won by one and three quarter lengths from Happy Clapper in a race-record time of 1:33.37, while her last 600 metres came in 34.96 seconds on a Good 4 surface. Unforgotten (Fastnet Rock) was another three and three-quarter lengths back in third place.

There was also some pre-race drama when Winx’s stablemate Libran (Lawman) had to be backed out and vetted before being allowed to start.

This was an episode Waller said could work out in the mare’s best interests.

“I thought it would do her the world of good to tell you the truth,” he continued. “She can be like that at the start of the prep and doesn’t take much for a horse to kick out.”

“It did her good to stand there afterwards. No cotton wool treatment - we wouldn’t expect any. To stand there and wait will help. An all-around perfect display.”

Shinn said: “What can I say about my horse? He put up a Group 1-winning performance but there are no superlatives you can say about

the winner. She just a freak and she had to put up a freakish performance to beat Happy Clapper.”

Bred by John Camilleri’s Fairway Thoroughbreds, Winx (7 m Street Cry - Vegas Showgirl by Al Akbar) was a \$230,000 purchase at the 2013 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale from the Coolmore Stud draft. She has had 41 starts for 35 wins with prize-money totalling \$23,429,674.

She is one of seven foals out of dual stakes winner Vegas Showgirl (Al Akbar), who is in foal to Japanese sire-sensation Deep Impact (Sunday Silence).

Vegas Showgirl is also the dam of 2016 Kindergarten Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) winner El Divino (Snitzel) and the unraced Boulder City (Snitzel), who stood his first season at Riverbank Farm in Victoria last year.

Vegas Showgirl is a half-sister to the Group 3-placed Black Magic Maggie (Westminster) out of two-time winner Vegas Magic (Voodoo Rhythm).

Camilleri has retained a two-year-old daughter of Vegas Showgirl named Courchevel (Snitzel), who is in training with Ciaron Maher and David Eustace at Caulfield, and he also has a yearling filly by Exceed And Excel (Danehill) named Covent Garden.

She missed to Exceed And Excel (Danehill) in 2017, which allowed Camilleri to send Vegas Showgirl to be sent to Japan to be covered by Deep Impact (Sunday Silence) to southern hemisphere last year. She is in foal and has since returned to her Hunter Valley base at Segenhoe Stud.

Marsh and Grylls score Derby upset with Crown Prosecutor

A surprise New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) victory by Crown Prosecutor (Medaglia d'Oro) has delivered prominent trainer Stephen Marsh with his first win in the race, a Group 1 that his well-known father also has on his record from nearly 20 years ago.

Starting at odds of more than 100-1, the Wellington Guineas (Gr 3, 1600m)-winning Crown Prosecutor also provided an important update for his younger half-sister on the eve of this week's Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale.

Jockey Craig Grylls, who has returned to New Zealand after a stint riding in Singapore, was emotional after the race and admitted Crown Prosecutor's two lead-in runs had been below expectations.

He had finished eighth in the Levin Classic (Gr 1, 1600m) before a last-start ninth in the Waikato Guineas (Gr 2, 2000m) at Te Rapa on February 9.

"He had won a stakes race before, but his form wasn't the best coming in," Grylls said.

"He's been a little off the boil, but Stephen and his team have done a great job and I couldn't believe it.

"The plan was to go forward but he was green down the straight the first time as he tried to duck out a couple of times.

"He was good when he got a bit of cover and they didn't go overly hard.

"Turning in he travelled up underneath me then he just kept grinding away and fought it out to the line."

Grylls took an inside run in the straight in a slowly run race to get up and score in the Group 1 over In A Twinkling (Fastnet Rock), who was a head behind the winner. Platinum Invador (Redwood) was another one and a half lengths away in third.

Marsh was also elated with Crown Prosecutor's victory.

"I know he was one of the roughies of the race and we know how hard it is to even have a horse in the Derby," Marsh said.

"I don't usually get given colts to train and we have, so this is the race you want to win as it's the best race on the calendar.

"I'm just rapt, I'm blown away."

Marsh was not completely shocked by the colt's long-odds win at Ellerslie.

"We had him hard-fit ready and I said to Craig to go forward as he can out-tough them," Marsh said.

"Nothing had gone right for us last start and he was a stakes winner.

"He [Grylls] rode him perfectly as they went hard and he sat in behind them, so it was a great win."

In A Twinkling's jockey Glen Boss said: "He was a bit slow out and there was a lot of action going into that first turn.

"I was three-wide with cover for most of the race and I started to edge forward at the half-mile as he's that type of horse.

"I felt like I had the winner beat the whole length of the straight, but he kept fighting back and pulling out a little more, so full credit to him."

Marsh's now Singapore-based trainer-father Bruce won the New Zealand Derby in 2000 with Hail (Stark South).

A \$50,000 purchase by Bruce Perry Bloodstock at the 2017 Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale, Crown Prosecutor (3 c Medaglia d'Oro - Riptide by Exceed And Excel) has now won twice, both of them at Group level, from seven starts for prize-money earnings of NZ\$644,625.

The colt is one of four winners for the juvenile winner Riptide, who was purchased by Belmont Bloodstock for \$150,000 at the 2017 Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale on behalf of Western Australian breeders Neville and Sue Duncan's Oakland Park Stud.

Riptide is a three-quarter sister to Group 2-winning juvenile and first-season sire Headwater, Kulgrinda and a half-sister to Listed winner Cross Current (Keltrice).

Blue Gum Farm will offer Crown Prosecutor's half-sister by Street Boss (Street Sense) on behalf of breeder Oakland Park Stud as **Lot 414** at the Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale on Tuesday.

Riptide also has a weanling colt by Frosted (Tapit) and is in foal to Western Australian stallion Demerit (Lonhro).

Crown Prosecutor is also one of 22 Group 1 winners for Darley sire Medaglia d'Oro (El Prado), who last shuttled from the US to Australia in 2017.

He is also the sire of Darley's young stallion, the Group 1 winner Astern, and Coolmore's Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Vancouver, whose oldest progeny are yearlings.

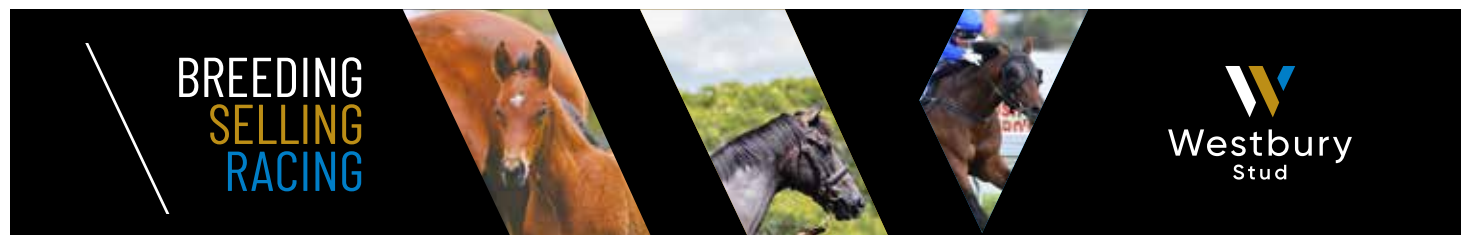

First for Needs Further

Mystic Journey (3 f ex White Gold by Colombia) gave a major boost to Tasmanian breeding when storming clear to win the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Flemington on Saturday, becoming the first top-flight scorer for her Armidale Stud-based sire Needs Further (Encosta De Lago). The three-year-old filly, bred by Ralph Zito, is bred on the Rasmussen factor and is inbred 4x4 to the 1995 Australian Broodmare of the Year Lady Giselle (Nureyev) and 4x5 to Klairessa (Klairon), dam of the esteemed blue hen Eight Carat (Pieces Of Eight). The filly was purchased by Adam Trinder for \$11,000 from Armidale at the 2017 Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale.

Five for So You Think

Nakeeta Jane (3 f ex Lustre Lady by Flying Spur) emerged on top in a photo finish to the Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick on Saturday, joining D'Argento, Inference, La Bella Diosa and Sopressa as the fifth top-flight winner for So You Think (High Chaparral). Trained by Mark Newnham and ridden by Josh Parr, the winner beat Fundamentalist (Not A Single Doubt) by a short head, with a head back to El Dorado Dreaming (Ilovethecity). Violate takes out Shaftesbury Avenue

Violate (5g Sebring - Shantha's Girl by Redoute's Choice) landed the Shaftesbury Avenue Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m), a week after his sire died of a heart attack at Widden Stud. Trained by Brent Stanley and ridden by Michael Walker, the winner beat Streets Of Avalon (Magnus) by a long neck, with Zebulon (All American) three quarters of a length back in third. Violate was having his first start this year having won the Sofitel Handicap (Listed, 1400m) in September during his last preparation. The five-year-old gelding has now won four of his 31 starts for prize-money of \$469,600.

Oregon's Day to chase Coolmore Classic win

Last year's Hollindale Stakes (Gr 2, 1800m) scorer Oregon's Day (5 m Domesday - Oregon Seal by

First-up win for She's So High

The Galaxy (Gr 1, 1100m) in Sydney is also in Mick Price's sights after She's So High (I Am Invincible) returned to racing with a convincing win in the Bob Hoysted Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at Flemington. Making her first appearance since claiming the Proud Miss Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) on a soft track last May, She's So High sprinted clear before being eased down late to beat Thermal Current (Exceed And Excel) by a length, with another three-quarters of a length to I Am Someone (Onemorenomore) in third. "She was never going to be a summer mare and she will be off to Sydney now," Price said. "She might be a nice horse to run in The Galaxy over 1100 metres if we kept her fresh. She's not a Group 1 mare at the moment, so you are always trying to improve them. If I can keep her fresh I think it would be a beautiful race for her if the track is chopping out a bit."

"You'd have to rate him right there at the moment," trainer James Cummings said. "This horse came up from Melbourne not long ago but we've barely breathed on him since. He's going to tighten up as clean-winded as he is. Come Slipper day he'll be like a young man with a new suit."

Back-to-back Group wins for Alassio

Alassio (5m Foxwedge - Cinque by Red Ransom) secured back-to-back Group wins in the Guy Walter Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at Randwick on Saturday. Trained by Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott, the winner beat Dixie Blossoms (Street Sense) by three quarters of a length, with Manicure (Exceed And Excel) a long-neck back in third. "Running the distance is very important," stable representative Neil Paine said. "She relaxed so well. Tim [Clark] just had her relaxed, bowling along and she kept giving and giving. She's a gutsy mare. She hit the lead at the 300 and kept going. They were chasing and she never gave in. She's done a tough 1400 metres today so why couldn't she run and win the Coolmore."

Three for Verrazano

Mockery (2 f ex Madoni by Lonhro) has delivered former Coolmore shuttler Verrazano (More Than Ready) with his third stakes winner and first in Australia after an all-the-way victory in the Very Special Kids Plate (Listed, 1000m) at Flemington. A homebred filly for Victorian owner Scott Williamson, the John McArdle-trained juvenile was having her third start when defeating Yulong Savings (Helmet) by the narrowest of margins, with the same distance back to Cheer Leader (Snitzel) in third. Mockery, who was runner-up first-up at Moonee Valley on February 16, joins US Listed winners Stirling Drive and Seek And Destroy as stakes winners for Verrazano who covered 71 mares in 2015, his only southern hemisphere season at Coolmore.

Job done' with Mockery

Trainer John McArdle had considered taking lightly-raced filly Mockery to Adelaide for the SAJC Cinderella Stakes (Listed, 1050m) but was pleased he made the decision to keep her in Victoria yesterday. Mockery, who had her first start in the MRC Debutant Stakes (Listed, 1000m) last October, scored an important stakes victory for her owner-breeder Scott Williamson, who oversees David Kobritz's Musk Creek Farm. "The thought was to go to the Cinderella Stakes ... but with the heat we didn't want to take her interstate because she would melt," McArdle said. "She can be a little bit of a hot-headed filly, so we kept her here to take the colts on and it has worked. I haven't really got a plan for her going forward. We'll have to work that out now. My job was to get a black-type race with her, so I've done that."

First for Pastorius

European import Schabau (4 h ex Staying Alive by Royal Dragon) kept his unbeaten Australian record intact at Flemington yesterday in the Roy Higgins Quality (Listed, 2600m) and provided his German sire Pastorius (Soldier Hollow) with his first stakes winner. Schabau, who is trained by Robert Hickmott, has progressed from a first-up win at Flemington on New Year's Day to a comfortable Listed win yesterday. Ridden by Craig Williams, Schabau, the \$1.50 favourite, defeated Naval Warfare (Born To Sea) by three and three-quarter lengths with Top Of The Range (Savabeel) three-quarters of a length away third. Schabau, who was purchased by Australian bloodstock agent Suman Hedge, is from the first crop of Pastorius, who relocated to Haras De La Hetraie in France in time for the 2018 northern hemisphere breeding season.

Spell for Schabau

Robert Hickmott indicated that Schabau would head for a spell on the back of yesterday's win. Hickmott plans to raise his sights with the emerging stayer and says the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) is a realistic target in the spring. The Caulfield trainer said Schabau would line-up the Bart Cummings (Gr 3, 2500m) at Flemington in October, which gives the winner automatic entry. "A Melbourne Cup would be fantastic and that's what we bought him for," Hickmott said. "We're very lucky to have a horse that's adaptable and has come through without any issues. He goes to the paddock now for four or five weeks and then prepare for the spring."

94 for Choisir

Coolmore Stud resident Choisir (Danehill Dancer) was handed his 94th stakes winner when Lady Naturaliste (2 f ex Calcatta by Tale Of The Cat) landed the Cinderella Stakes (Listed, 1050m) at Morphettville yesterday. Trained by Matt Cumani, the two-year-old finished half a length too strong for Li'L Kontra (Krupt), with the same margin back to Movie Role (Fastnet Rock) in third. "He will need another run before the Weetwood and it might as well be in the Goldmarket, which is also Listed and carries double QTIS bonus money, taking first prize-money to \$145,000 for eligible horses," Kemp said. "It's great to see him back in form and I am looking forward to the next few weeks."

The Odyssey tunes up for Aquis Jewel

The Kelly Schweida-trained The Odyssey (Better Than Ready) was propelled to favouritism for the \$500,000 Aquis Jewel after he landed the Emerald Jewel Prelude (1200m) at Doomben yesterday. The two-year-old bounced back from a disappointing run in the Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) to beat Ready To Roam (Better Than Ready) by two and a half lengths, with a further length and three quarters back to Xanthus (Better Than Ready) in third, securing a trifecta for first-season Lyndhurst Stud resident Better Than Ready (More Than Ready). "The way the lead-up races have fallen haven't suited The Odyssey and I was a bit worried about 1200 metres first up today," Schweida said. "You always worry when a horse is first up but hopefully he had an easy run which should help him in two weeks time."

Magic Night aim for Niedorp

The Magic Night Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m), run at Rosehill on March 16, appears the likely next target for Niedorp (Not A Single Doubt) following her neck success in the Jewel 2YO Prelude (1200m) at Doomben yesterday. Trained by Tony Gollan, Niedorp finished runner-up on her debut at Toowoomba in October, but she broke her maiden at the second time of asking when beating stablemate Perudo (Spirit Of Boom) by a long neck, with four lengths back to Raay Of Dreams (Dream Ahead) in third. Niedorp is not eligible to run in the Aquis Jewel, which is also run on March 16. "Niedorp is in the Golden Slipper but she would probably be just on the edge of a start after picking up \$72,500 today," Gollan said. "But before I commit her I obviously want to see how she pulls up."

Darmanin outed for Guineas-winning ride

Anthony Darmanin was suspended for eight days and issued with a \$500 fine following his winning ride on Mystic Journey. Chief steward Robert Cram adjudged Darmanin to have hit the filly 13 times prior to the final 100 metres, which is eight strikes over the permitted level, while he also hit the filly twice in consecutive strikes on the run to the line. Cram justified the penalty and fine as being appropriate given the misuse of the whip occurred in a Group 1 contest.

Bushfires endanger horses and homes

Victorian bushfires ravaging the state last night were threatening homes and horses in Gippsland including close to Pakenham racecourse at Nar Nar Goon. The major concern was a fire that was out of control in the Bunyip State Forest, 16 kilometres from Pakenham, as well as a blaze at Yinnar South, near Moe. Trainer Troy Corstens tweeted yesterday: "Huge effort from my bro @KevinCorstens and a couple of his staff. Have moved and possibly saved around 20 horses already, from the bushfires. No runners today so only too willing to help out. #veryproud." The fires were reportedly closing in on about 20 townships with emergency services personnel urging people to evacuate while they still could.

"I think that she's just a very, very good horse," Gerard said. "On her breeding I don't think that [the 2400m distance] is a problem as that is why Mike [Moroney] and Paul [Moroney] bought her."

Another stakes win for Emily Margaret

The Kevin and Pam Hughes-trained Emily Margaret (3 f Pins - Seven Schillings by O'Reilly) gained her second success at Listed level when posting an all-the-way victory in the New Zealand Bloodstock Insurance Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Wingatui yesterday. The three-year-old stayed on powerfully to beat Dreamtesta (Testa Rossa) by two and a half lengths, with a further long-neck back to Naval Fleet (Declaration Of War) in third. "We thought we could just grind them all into the ground and that is what she did," co-trainer Pam Hughes said. "She was very, very fit and was just too good on the day. She seems to have come through the race very well and we will have a look at the Wellington Guineas. The travel doesn't seem to worry her."

Waikuku impresses again as a Hong Kong Derby contender

Waikuku (Harbour Watch) fired a booming warning shot to his fellow Hong Kong Derby (Listed, 2000m) aspirants with an impressive victory in the Lion City Handicap (1800m) at Sha Tin yesterday.

"He has gone to another level," jockey Joao Moreira said. "I can't wait to ride him in the Derby."

John Size's charge has made big strides since going down by a nose on debut a couple of days before Christmas.

Yesterday's success was his fourth in a row and it was achieved in the style of a horse destined to be a major player in the final leg of the Four-Year-Old Classic Series in two weeks' time.

"He has quite surprised me and John Size, and people watching, with the rapid progress he has made," Moreira said after the Irish import had scored by a length and a half in a time of 1m 46.74s.

"He was very nice and relaxed on the back of the field and the race suited him because they went a bit fast up front. He had to go around them all and he just left them all flat-footed the last 200 metres."

Moreira eased Waikuku back from gate 12, settling second last as Easy Go Easy Win (Savabeel) set the tempo. The four-year-old shifted wide for progress on the turn but had the race in the bag long before he passed the leader approaching the 200-metre pole.

"That's what you're hoping for," Size said. "In the 1400-metre races he's been running time and the other day he ran a slow section mid-race, 24 [seconds] or something, so let's go up in distance and see if he's got the stamina to finish it off."

"He was always going [to the Derby] but that had to be part of his preparation otherwise he hadn't had any practice at the tempo."

Size also saddled Enrichment (Teofilo) – third behind runner-up Mongolian King (Sufficient) – and the trainer stated that the

Australian import will go on to the Derby where Ryan Moore will take the ride.

"Enrichment, he's run another dour race," Size continued. "He's obviously going to appreciate the 2000 metres and he can race handily so that will help him a lot. I think they've both got chances of getting prize-money."

Neil Callan was in the plate this time, though, and he said post-race: "The pace was nice and even. I had Enrichment out early enough in the straight and he just kept batting away."

"He just feels a little bit mentally immature; he's a really nice staying type going forward for next season. The Derby? It looks like the winner's going to be a tough one to beat but this horse has a future."

With a two-meeting suspension followed by a Happy Valley blank mid-week, the prolific Moreira had not been up to the winner's arch since February 17.

Perfect Pair (Darci Brahma) rectified that situation to kick off a double for the rider when landing Bukit Timah Handicap (1400m) by a neck for trainer Chris So.

So headed into yesterday's fixture with 16 wins on the board and seeking to ignite his season.

He left with a brace after Chad Schofield made all on Team Spirit (Strategic) to win the second of the afternoon's two trophy contests, the Singapore Turf Club Trophy Handicap (1200m).

Frankie Lor arrived on 98 career wins and left with the century in his pocket after book-ending the card.

Debutant Joyful Heart (Smart Missile) took the opener under Karis Teetan and Right Choice (Mastercraftsman) impressed with his fourth win from five starts in the finale.

That win gave jockey Silvestre de Sousa a brace, too, following his win on the Richard Gibson-trained Corre Rapido (Iffraaj) in race two.

E Star (Ferlax) ran well enough on debut to have started shorter than the \$69 odds he returned after winning the day's first silverware.

Manfred Man's charge kept on strongly to claim the Journalist Challenge Cup Handicap (1200m) by a neck under Umberto Rispoli.

Alexis Badel partnered the three-year-old to a career debut fifth last month but Rispoli was more than happy to step in with his weighing room colleague now back in France.

"I was just saying to Manfred, it was a very good run for the horse last time," Rispoli said.

"They slowed down on the corner that time and this horse's mouth is a bit soft so Alexis couldn't hold him up, he had to bring him out, he was three-wide on the bend and finished pretty well in the straight."

"He gave me a good feeling in the morning and I think once he goes 1400 metres, if he settles down in his mind, he'll be much better, for sure."

"He's got some gate speed but you can see then that he needs time to wind up. I wasn't worried around the corner because I had cover three wide and that brought me where I wanted to be in the straight. He kept going."

Prince Of Gems (I Am Invincible) started the \$2.7 favourite on the back of a winning debut ahead of E Star last time. However, Zac Purton's mount hit trouble at a vital juncture on this occasion, finishing sixth.

Dragon Dance (Bianconi) must rate highly in Jack Wong's affections these days as the rider notched his fifth win of the campaign when partnering the Me Tsui-trained gelding sweetly on the front end. That ended a losing streak for the rider that went back to November 7.

At 45, Eddie Lai is the old man of the jockeys' room following Douglas Whyte's retirement.

The senior rider has five wins on the board thanks to Phantom Falcon's (Swiss Ace) victory for trainer Peter Ho in race six, and that lifted the rider to a career Hong Kong total of 298.

Hong Kong racing continues at Happy Valley on Wednesday March 6.

Pinhook Bloodstock's Dave Mee was among a large group of Federation of Bloodstock Agents Australia (FBAA) members running the rule over yearlings at Oaklands this week.

Inglis has catalogued 786 lots over four sessions at the Melbourne Premier commencing on Sunday and Mee, a NZ-bred agent based on the NSW Central Coast, has always liked the Melbourne Sale.

"The general public has a greater awareness of the racing industry in Victoria and, although it's an old cliché, there really is a yearling for everyone at Oaklands," he said. "The Classic Sale is still bedding down but you know what you're getting at Premier. Yearlings by I Am Invincible and Zoustar will obviously make good money alongside other stallions that are more affordable."

Mee has been in tremendous form in Hong Kong with 8 individual winners sourced for his clients since the start of this season. Over half of them have saluted in the last month at Sha Tin and Happy Valley - Hinyuen Swiftness (Duke Of Marmalade), Otouto (Haradasun), Clear Choice (Rebel Raider), Chung Wah Spirit (Dash For Cash) and Splendour And Gold (Excelebration).

"It's very satisfying getting runs on the board in Hong Kong. Obviously, it's a different environment...they're cooped up and selecting horses with the right temperament is very important. But you never know for sure whether they will acclimatise.

"We've had a mixture of seasoned campaigners and up-and-coming horses this season. Chung Wah Spirit always had the talent but took a while to develop and get going while Splendour And Gold was straight out of the blocks winning second-up for Dennis Yip in February."

Splendour And Gold was

trained by Mick Kent to win a Cranbourne trial last year when he was registered as Maximum Plaid. "Having them prepped by someone like Mick is a big advantage. He's had plenty of experience in Asia and knows what's required."

With the Asian trade in mind, Mee is generally drawn to proven sires and shuttlers. "First-season sires can be over-inflated at times," he reasoned. "I'm usually happy to let someone else gamble on the new sires."

Of first-crop sires in 2019, Mee has been impressed by Darley's Group 1 miler Kermadec (Teofilo). He had a colt sell to \$280,000 at the Inglis Classic and a filly for \$240,000 at the Gold Coast Magic Millions. They were also reasonably priced for buyers mining the middle-market averaging \$147,000 (Magic Millions) and \$89,364 (Inglis Classic).

Mee and Flying Start Syndicate manager Cameron Bennett bought a Kermadec half-sister to Sydney stakes winner Western Beau at the Inglis Classic and there's another five colts and four fillies by him at Melbourne Premier. "The Kermadecs are athletic and have lots of scope with a relaxed temperament," Mee said while evaluating yearlings outside Stable B on Thursday. "They will probably need time and won't be peaking until three."

Among his Melbourne colts are the half-brother to Singapore stakes winner Holy Empire (Kornong Station), the close relation to South African Group 3 winner Queen's Command (Millford Thoroughbreds) and the Redoute's Choice family descendant (Gilgai Farm).

Mee can see Widden Stud's Outreach (Exceed And Excel) siring early-comers next season. He was beaten by Vancouver on debut in the LR Canonbury Stakes but was injured in running and retired without another start.

"There was a slight dip at the 2018 Melbourne Premier but personally, I don't read too much into that," Mee declared. "At the end of the day as an agent, I have orders to buy the best horse I can for the budget I'm provided with by the client. If I'm beaten on a horse by someone with more money, then so be it. To me, acceptable value is paramount."

Analysis: The seemingly unbeatable champion **Winx** was brilliant yet again in recording her 31st successive win and a world record 23rd Group 1 victory in scoring here. She began well, settled in fourth place before improving to third at the 800m, chasing a strong pace. She was conceding the leader (Happy Clapper) five lengths rounding the home turn before eating into that margin and hitting the front at the 100m. She then drew away to score brilliantly and in the fast time of 1:33.27. Three-time Group 1 winner **Happy Clapper**, who had not led in 38 prior starts, was taken to the lead by Blake Shinn, who obviously realised there could be a lack of pace in this field. He let the gelding run along at a strong pace in the mid-stages and still held a clear advantage nearing the home turn. He was only overhauled at the 100m and then fought gamely for second after running a bold race. The 2018 ATC Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) winner **Unforgotten** raced back in third place, was fourth rounding the home turn and then battled gamely for third in a promising effort on her second run back. Dual Group 1-winning mare **Egg Tart** chased the free-

running leader until nearing the home turn and did well in battling on for (8.4 lengths) fourth, also on her second run back.

Neck and neck, he refused to give in, got the upper hand just short of the post and held on tenaciously by a head when it mattered. Into the straight four wide he was one four leaders at the 300m, co-led with the winner soon after and fought hard with every stride all the way to the line. This was a super run from **Platinum Invador**, who was last at the 600m, had a wall of runners in front of him at the top of the straight then weaved in and out, found a gap and rattled home for a top third. **Arrogant** was one of four leaders at the 300m then kept on doggedly to the line for a close fourth from **Surely Sacred**, who was widest but one turning in then kept on solidly the length of the straight but peaking just before the line for fifth.

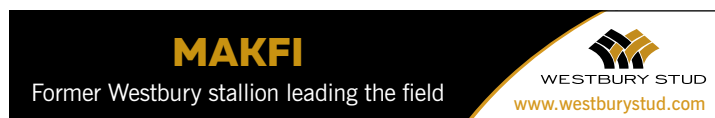
