

Exceed And Excel colt shows class with strong Sires' victory

Cummings and Bowman laud exploits of Group 1-winning colt Microphone

icrophone (Exceed And Excel) has all but assured himself of a place at stud on the roster of Darley stallions after the consistent colt scored an important Inglis Sires' (registered as ATC Sires' Produce Stakes) (Gr 1, 1400m) win at Randwick yesterday.

The victory by Microphone, who was runner-up to stablemate Kiamichi (Sidestep) in the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) last month, also continued Godolphin's dominance

of the two-year-old Group 1 races this season.

Sheikh Mohammed's Australian operation has won the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) with Lyre (Lonhro), the Golden Slipper and the Sires', but it is arguable that Microphone's Group 1 success holds the most significance given the dramatic jump in his value as a stallion prospect.

The James Cummings-trained Microphone (\$4.60), who was ridden by Hugh Bowman, defeated Loving Gaby (I Am Invincible) (\$4.20 favourite) by three quarters of a length, with a half-head back to Kiamichi (\$7.50) and Castelvecchio (Dundeel) (\$10), who deadheated for third. *Continued on page 2>>*



Written By joins Widden Stud

Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Written By (Written Tycoon), the winner of six of his 11 starts having amassed \$1,808,700 in prize-money, will stand at Widden Stud in 2019.

The Grahame Begg-trained Written By, who was bred and owned by his father Neville, came onto the radar of studmasters following his dominant Blue Diamond Stakes victory last year, with Widden Stud last night confirming it had secured standing rights for the six-time winner.

Written By won four of his five starts as a juvenile, with his only defeat coming when he was fourth - and the first colt home - in last year's Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m).

Widden Stud principal Antony Thompson was delighted to be able to add Written By to the historic farm's stallion roster this year.

The news comes only weeks after Widden Stud and owner Bert Vieira had agreed to terms for multiple Group 1 winner Trapeze Artist (Snitzel) to also stand at Widden Stud.

Continued from page 1 Godolphin's Australian head trainer Cummings has prepared two of the three Group 1 juvenile winners this season and was far from complaining, but he did lament the impact a Golden Slipper victory would have had on the stallion profile of 'star colt' Microphone.

"I think back to the Tuesday before the Slipper and he absolutely exploded for us in a gallop," Cummings said.

"We would have loved him to get up for the farm, but to present Sheikh Mohammed with a Golden Slipper meant more than that and for him to come here, with the effort of the guys to hold him together, we barely had to breathe on him for this race today.

"(We) just had to be confident in the horse. We didn't do too much with him and his class shone through."

The win by Microphone is also the 12th individual Group 1 winner for his champion Darley stallions-based reverse-shuttling sire Exceed And Excel (Danehill), himself the grandsire of Kiamichi.

Cummings would not be drawn on whether Microphone would press on to the ATC Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick on Saturday week.

He said: "He has gone to the line like a top-class colt. He's a star horse and I can't tell you how proud I am of him. He stormed to the line once again in another top-class two-year-old race.

"I think the longevity of his campaign, his strength, his class, all point to him being the best two-year-old in the country this season and think : would have given the winner an even bigger Continued on page 4>>

that's deserving for the horse."

Bowman was also full of praise for Microphone after yesterday's impressive win and has no doubt the colt would handle the step up in distance if he continued his autumn preparation.

"I will be surprised if he isn't the best horse out of the Golden Slipper," he said.

"I think he will improve on what we saw today. The track is racing beautifully but in my opinion it is heavy and, despite that, I think we will see him better on top of the ground.



James McDonald, who rode runner-up Loving Gaby, said the rain-affected surface had played against the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained filly.

"She is a beautiful filly who was unlucky not to win," he said.

Continued from page 2 scare. She just lost her footing from about the 600 metres to the 400 metres and that's where she lost the race."

Josh Parr rode the Richard Litt-trained Castelvecchio and the jockey said the colt tired late against race-fit horses having bypassed the Golden Slipper.

"It was a terrific effort. I chimed in like I was going to win, but a couple of those horses who have been up and racing just had the fitness edge on him," Parr said.

Microphone (2 c Exceed And Excel - Sung by Anabaa) has won four of his six starts and finished runner-up twice, in the Blue Diamond Preview (C&G) (Listed, 1000m) and the Slipper, for prize-money earnings of \$1,588,600.

The colt is one of three winners from four to race for the Listed winner Sung, who is a sister to three-time Group 1 winner Yell and a half-sister to Shouts (Strategic), herself the dam of Darley Group 1 winner and Victorian-based sire Holler (Commands).

Godolphin sold Sung, who was not in foal, for \$70,000 to Craig Rounsefell of Boomer Bloodstock at last year's Magic Millions Gold Coast National Broodmare Sale and was subsequently covered by Eureka Stud-based stallion Spirit Of Boom (Sequalo) last December. Rounsefell purchased Sung on behalf of Plaintree Farm's David and Heather Pascoe.

Godolphin retains ownership of Sung's yearling colt by Teofilo (Galileo), who has been named Choir.

Exceed And Excel has 13 lots catalogued at this week's Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale.

Santa Ana Lane earns overseas trip after T J Smith win

An international campaign culminating in a tilt at Royal Ascot beckons for high-class sprinter Santa Ana Lane (Lope De Vega), who produced a brilliant performance against elite opposition in the T J Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) yesterday.

Santa Ana Lane confirmed his reputation as one of Australia's best sprinters with his emphatic come-from-behind win in the \$2.5 million race, his fifth at the highest level.

Trainer Anthony Freedman admitted he had worked out how best to train Santa Ana Lane, which has seen the *Continued on page 6>>*



Continued from page 4 gelding's dramatic turnaround in form over the past two seasons.

"I knew he was really good. I was worried about the (soft) track but I knew that the horse was as good as I have had him," Freedman said.

"When he is like that he can do that (blistering finish), so it's exciting going forward."

His confidence in Santa Ana Lane's ability prompted Freedman to outline an overseas preparation, starting with the Chairman's Sprint Prize (Gr 1, 1200m) in Hong Kong later this month before heading to the UK.

"We will obviously give Hong Kong serious thought and if things are still good we will head on to Europe," he said.

"He's clearly gone to a huge level now. I've sort of worked him out. I know how to train him and that is the key with horses.

"The trainer works out how to train them and you get the best out of them. (The key is to) keep him fresh, big gaps between runs, and he just keeps stepping up to the mark.

"That's number five so we just keep finding good races for him now and hope that he can keep doing it."

Yesterday, the Mark Zahra-ridden Santa Ana Lane ran his last 600 metres in 35.05 seconds to win by three and a half lengths over Osborne Bulls (Street Cry). Three-year-old filly Sunlight (Zoustar) was a nose away in third.

Zahra oozed confidence leading into the race and was not surprised by Santa Ana Lane's dominance.

"It was an amazing victory," Zahra said. "He was a bit cranky in the gates. I was a bit slow away but I got him on the back of Champagne Cuddles and just down the side I gave him a click to track up and just had to wait and wait and I got around the bend. I had them covered 300 metres out."

"I think he would have won like that no matter what (the track condition) was. He is just flying. Anthony and Sam and the team have him airborne."

On Sunlight's performance, jockey Luke Currie said: "She




was great, relaxed wide, but out in the better going, she was very good."

Santa Ana Lane's stablemate Shoals (Fastnet Rock) did not travel to jockey Tim Clark's expectations, with the mare finishing unplaced.

"She was out of business early on. She didn't travel that great - we'll see how she pulls up," he said.

The Gerald Ryan-trained Trapeze Artist (Snitzel) was retired to stand at Widden Stud this year after finishing seventh *Continued on page 8>>*

Continued from page 6 in the contest, ending any plans to have his farewell start at Royal Ascot.

Purchased by Justin Bahen and Troy Corstens under the Flemington Bloodstock banner for \$80,000 at the Inglis Premier Yearling Sale from the Rosemont Stud draft, Santa Ana Lane (6 g Lope de Vega - Fast Fleet by Fastnet Rock) has now won ten of his 33 career starts, including the VRC Sprint Classic (Gr 1, 1200m), the Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes (Gr 1,1400m), The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) and Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1350m), which has seen him amass \$5,069,711 in career prize-money.

"He's just a champion, we love him, he's given us so many great thrills and maybe the best is yet to come with him," Bahen said.

"The wet track probably cost him an Everest but that aside, he's won so many other big ones here that it's time to take him abroad and take on the world.

"As for The Everest this year, why not? But we might need to look at a few things to see if we can do everything."

Bred by Dyson Hore-Lacy, Santa Ana Lane is the only foal to race for winning Fastnet Rock (Danehill) mare Fast Fleet, who is a three-quarter sister to the Macau stakes-placed Strategy (Danehill) and a half-sister to Waikato Guineas (Gr 3, 2000m) winner Blimey O'Reilly (O'Reilly) and Listed winner Flag Officer (Excites).

Santa Ana Lane's third dam is Far Flying (Far North), a US Listed winner who is the dam of Grade Three winner Dalhart (Forty Niner) and Listed winner Rose Frances (Crafty Prospector).

Fast Fleet is the dam of the lightly raced three-year-old winning filly by Kuroshio (Exceed And Excel) named The Black Tide, who is owned by Proven Thoroughbreds and trained by Steve O'Dea in Brisbane.

She also has a two-year-old filly by Toorak Toff (Show A Heart) and a weanling filly by Frosted (Tapit). She is due to foal to Zoustar (Northern Meteor) this August.

Continued from page 8 contest like a very well handicapped horse indeed.

Beautifully prepared by Team Hawkes, Brutal has run four times this preparation - stepping up in distance on each occasion - and he supplemented his fine second to Winx (Street Cry) in last month's George Ryder Stakes (Gr 1, 1500m) with a one-length success at Randwick yesterday, returning the \$6.50 second-favourite having mastered the enterprisingly-ridden Dreamforce (\$21) (Fastnet Rock) inside the final 100 metres, with a further two and a half lengths back to Godolphin stalwart Hartnell (\$7.50) (Authorized) in third.

A dual Listed winner last year having proved unbeaten in his first three starts, three-year-old Brutal was allocated 49 kilograms by the handicapper and despite Boss putting up half a kilogram overweight, the excess made no difference to a result that was shrouded in inevitability some way from home.

"I'm in awe of the colt," said the Hong Kong-based Boss, who last rode at 49.5 kilograms when steering So You Think (High Chaparral) to the first of his two Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) wins in 2009. "I know they've got light weights and he got himself in a spot but he just cantered to the 1000 metres.

"He just felt confident underneath me. There was never a point in the race when I thought I was going to lose."

Adopting a prominent pitch despite his wide draw in barrier 18, Brutal sat on the heels of Dreamforce for much of the journey before being asked to quicken by Boss entering the straight.

Hartnell made his move three-deep under Hugh Bowman as nothing threatened to get into contention from off the speed and while Dreamforce kept finding for the urgings of Damian Lane, Hartnell could not go with the front two under his welter burden of 58 kilograms.

However, Brutal always had the leader in his sights and Boss - who has now ridden six three-year-olds to victory in this race from seven rides - did not have to get overly serious to land the spoils. *Continued on page 12>>*

The win was also a second in the contest for Team Hawkes patriarch John,

who saddled Over (Dr Grace) to success in the 2000 renewal under Darren Gauci.

"These owners have been fantastic for us," co-trainer Michael Hawkes said.
"They've let us do what we wanted to do. He's a super colt - an absolute star."

"He (Boss) just coasted there and let him do what he had to do."

A winner of four of his seven starts, Brutal (3 c O'Reilly - Alberton Princess by Golan) has amassed \$2,289,650 in prize-money.

One of 14 Group 1 winners for the late O'Reilly (Written Tycoon), who was bred and raced by Waikato Stud and who died in 2015, Brutal was purchased by Hawkes Racing for NZ\$220,000 from the Mapperley Stud draft at the New Zealand Bloodstock National Yearling Sale in 2017.

Brutal is one of five foals, all of whom have raced and four of whom have won, out of the Group 3-placed Golan (Spectrum) mare Alberton Princess, making him a brother to the Listed winner Talaria.

Alberton Princess is herself a three-quarter sister to Group 3 winner Lady Alberton (Golan) and a half-sister to Te Akau Rose (Thorn Park), who numbers amongst her three wins a victory in the 2009 running of the Matamata Breeders' Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m).

Brutal's second dam, Straussbridge (Straussbrook), was twice a winner at Listed level, while this is the family of Sir Alberton (Red Tempo), who landed the Wellington Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m) in 1990 before subsequently finishing second in the Bayer Classic (Gr 1, 1600m).

Alberton Princess was served by Darley shuttler Iffraaj (Zafonic) last

year having produced a colt foal by Waikato Stud resident Ocean Park (Thorn Park) in 2017.

Continued from page 12 1, 2400m) at Randwick into a procession under a tactically astute front-running ride from Corey Brown.

In a carbon copy of last Saturday's impressive Tulloch Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) victory, the Gwenda Markwell-trained gelding was immediately sent to the head of affairs by Brown and seemingly allowed a soft time on the front end.

The chasing pack loomed up to challenge rounding the home turn and again it was Tulloch Stakes runner-up Madison County (Pins) who looked set to mount the strongest challenge, but Angel Of Truth had plenty in reserve and drew away once more inside the final 200 metres to record a commanding three and a quarter-length success at the line.

Yesterday's victory saw Angel Of Truth become the third horse in succession to land the Tulloch Stakes - Australian Derby double on a seven day back-up, with Jon Snow (Iffraaj) (2017) and Levendi (Pierro) (2018) having achieved the feat in the previous two seasons.

The win also ensured Angel Of Truth continued his rapid ascension up the staying ranks, providing former Arrowfield Stud shuttler Animal Kingdom (Leroidesanimaux) with his first Group 1 winner only a week after providing the stallion with his tenth stakes winner.

Brown said he was confident the progressive three-year-old had the necessary qualities to win the Australian Derby immediately after crossing the line at Rosehill last weekend.

"It's easy after the event but I did think he could do it," he said.

"They thought about heading to Brisbane at the tier below but he was

as strong after the line last week as he was on it.

"Once he got to the front, he did what he liked. Six hundred metres from home he was travelling and once he gets to his top he sustains it.

"He gave some cheek and I looked over my shoulder after getting the front. Full credit to Gwenda and the team for the win."

Angel Of Truth provided a delighted Markwell with her first Group 1 win since Grand Zulu (Grand Lodge) won the Tancred Stakes (Gr 1, 2400m) as a three-year-old in 2004, when beating the likes of Elvstroem (Danehill), Mummify (Jeune) and the legendary Makybe Diva (Desert King) in the process.

"He's a good horse. When I saw him leading with his ears pricked around the 1000-metre mark I thought he is going to take a lot of running down here. It was great," Markwell said.

Angel Of Truth is the only foal to race out of the three-time winner Scarletini (Bernardini), who posted a career-best fourth in the Western Australian Oaks (Gr 3, 2400m) before being sold for \$80,000 at the 2015 Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale.

Scarletini is a daughter of the unraced Red Ransom (Roberto) mare Red Light, herself a half-sister to the stakes-winning mare Franjelica (Snippets).

Angel Of Truth is a direct descendant of the blue hen Margarethen (Tulyar), with the likes of dual-Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Gr 1, 2400m) heroine Treve (Motivator), British Classic-winning siblings Generous (Caerleon) and Imagine (Sadler's Wells) Continued on page 16>>

Nicoletta claims deserved Group 1 success

After a couple of near misses at Group 1 level, Nicoletta (Savabeel) finally added an elite-level victory to her CV in the New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Te Aroha yesterday.

The Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman-trained five-year-old was a Group 3 winner earlier in her career, but her previous best results at the highest level had been a third-place finish in the Herbie Dyke Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Te Rapa prior to occupying the same placing in last year's renewal of this Group 1.

Racing in the colours of owner Lib Petagna, Nicoletta had disappointed somewhat in her first three runs this campaign, although she put in a better performance on her last start when finishing a close-up seventh in the Japan NZ International Trophy (Gr 2, 1600m) at Tauranga last month.

After being ushered to the front by Jake Bayliss, Nicoletta established a break on her rivals turning for home before staving off the fast-closing Supera (Savabeel), beating her by a head, with Australian raider Luvaluva (Mastercraftsman) finishing another three quarters of a length away in third.

"He (Bayliss) rode her a treat," Forsman said. "She's twice Group 1-placed and is deserving of a Group 1 win so I'm glad she's got it.

"He timed it to perfection as I said just out-stay them as she won't beat them in a sprint home.

"He took it to them and she was just the toughest, fittest horse. They were coming at her late, but he got it right."

Forsman was pleased the mare had finally picked up some racing luck after things had not gone to plan in recent starts.

"She just hasn't had anything go right," he said. "She hasn't been going poorly and looked outstanding today.

"I said to Jake that she was hard-fit and ready to go so put her in the

race and give her her chance.

"She is good enough to beat these types of horses and she showed that today."

For Bayliss the victory was his third at Group 1 level and a nice farewell present as he prepares to head home to Queensland for a three-month stint before returning to New Zealand later in the year.

"I gave her a little bit of a chance just because of the way she was going to be ridden although there were some quality horses in the field," he said.

"When you lead like that you set it up for the back-markers but she stuck to her guns - it was just a brave brave run.

"It's my third Group 1 and Mum was here to watch it, so it's something special. "I'm off to Brisbane again in two weeks' time for the carnival and then some family time but you will see me back here again in August."

A NZ\$90,000 purchase from the New Zealand Bloodstock Karaka Yearling Sale, Nicoletta (5 m ex Savabeel - Celtic Crown by Doneraile Court) has now won five of her 30 starts and \$384,350 in career prize-money.

The five-year-old is one of three winners for Listed-winning mare Celtic Crown (Doneraile Court).

Further back, her fourth dam produced Group 3 winner and Group 1-placed Worth Avenue (Worth A Buck).

The victory provided Waikato Stud-based sire Savabeel (Zabeel) with his 13th Group 1 winner. He has four lots catalogued at the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale next week.

Having run second in the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) two weeks ago, Microphone (2 c ex Sung by Anabaa) went one better to win the Inglis Sires' (registered as ATC Sires' Produce Stakes) (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick, providing the everpopular Exceed And Excel (Danehill) with his 12th Group 1 winner. In winning the race, Microphone becomes the first colt to land a Group 1 this season, with the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) going to Lyre (Lonhro) and stablemate Kiamichi (Sidestep), who dead-heated for third in Inglis Sires', winning the Golden Slipper. Exceed And Excel, who shuttles to Kildangan Stud in Ireland, will be represented by 13 lots at the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale.

14 for O'Reilly

The Team Hawkes-trained Brutal (3 c ex Alberton Princess by Golan) ran out an impressive winner of the Doncaster Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick yesterday and in the process provided the late stallion O'Reilly (Last Tycoon) with his 14th Group 1 winner. The three-year-old colt was purchased by his trainers for NZ\$220,000 from the Mapperley Stud draft at the New Zealand Bloodstock National Yearling Sale. O'Reilly, who was bred and raced by Waikato Stud, died in 2015.

First for Animal Kingdom

Former Arrowfield shuttler Animal Kingdom (Leroidesanimaux) was provided with his first Group 1 winner yesterday, courtesy of Angel Of Truth's (3 g ex Scarletini by Bernardini) victory in the Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m). The Gwenda Markwell-trained three-year-old stamped himself as a contender for the Group 1 when winning the Tulloch Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) at Rosehill last Saturday. Animal Kingdom is standing at Darley's Jonabell Farm in Kentucky for a fee of US\$15,000 and he shuttled to Australia for four seasons.

17 for Hinchinbrook

The late Yarraman Park Stud sire Hinchinbrook (Fastnet Rock) was provided with his 17th stakes winner courtesy of Aliferous' (3 f ex Willow by Woodman) win in the Adrian Knox Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m) at Randwick. The three-year-old filly snuck up the rail to come home a neck in front of Amangiri (All Too Hard) with the same distance back to Maracaibo (Redoute's Choice) in third. Aliferous was purchased by Australian Bloodstock for \$130,000 at the Inglis Premier Yearling Sale from the Yarraman draft. Hinchinbrook died last year and he has ten lots catalogued at the upcoming Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale, which gets underway on Tuesday.

Oaks a possibility for Aliferous

Kris Lees said after Aliferous' victory in the Adrian Knox Stakes that she could be heading back to the Randwick to contest the Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m). "You don't know where they come from this time of year," Lees said. "She was really good at Kembla off the track. It was a good conditioning run for a testing track today. She got through the ground. So there are a lot of positives. Brenton [Avdulla] did the right thing early getting her to relax. She was a little keen mid-race but she was always going to be strong late. When the runs appeared he really let down on this type of ground." On the Oaks next week, he added: "It would be hard not to run. We'll give her every chance anyway."

126 for Medaglia d'Oro

P J Bell Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) winner Multaja (3 f ex Shelters by Lonhro) has delivered former Darley shuttler Medaglia d'Oro (El Prado) with his 126th individual stakes winner. Capping off a successful day for Godolphin and James Cummings, the homebred filly ran home strongly out wide to score by a head over Into The Abyss (Foxwedge) with another one and a quarter lengths back to So Taken (Street Boss) in third. Medagalia d'Oro, who

did not return to Australia after the 2017 breeding season, is the sire of 22 Group 1/Grade 1 winners including Astern and Vancouver.

Hearty Lass was purchased by his trainer and Cameron Cooke Bloodstock for \$40,000 at the Inglis Classic Yearling Sale from the Middlebrook draft. Wandjina has two lots catalogued at the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale, which begins its two-day run on Tuesday.

Trapeze Artist retired

Four-time Group 1 winner Trapeze Artist (Snitzel) has been retired after suffering a shoulder injury in his attempted defence of the T J Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Randwick. The four-year-old came out of the race with a large haematoma after finishing seventh and trainer Gerald Ryan said owner Bert Vieira had immediately decided the entire should be retired. "That's it," Ryan said. "Bert said, 'enough is enough'. "I'd say he's torn a muscle and it's haemorrhaged. He's been such a wonderful horse to all of us and I look forward to his first son or daughter to walk into my stables." Trapeze Artist will stand at Widden Stud with his 2019 fee yet to be announced.

Gallic Chieftain books his Sydney Cup ticket

The Archie Alexander-trained and OTI Racing-owned Gallic Chieftain (6 h Tamayuz - Katerini by Cacique) booked his ticket to next Saturday's Sydney Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) with a convincing victory in the Chairman's Quality (Gr 2, 2600m) at Randwick yesterday. The six-year-old entire had not scored since his victory in the Warrnambool Cup (Listed, 2350m) last May when trained by Darren Weir, and he won his first race since being moved to Archie Alexander's Ballarat base when beating Shraaoh (Sea The Stars) by half a length with Semari (Sebring) just over a length further away in third.

Chieftain pleases Alexander

Archie Alexander expressed his delight after Gallic Chieftain's victory in the Chairman's Quality. "OTI are a big help to me and always have been and this horse is terrific," Alexander said. "Coming up here I was really confident. We've brought horses up here before and it's hard travelling them. Some horses just don't settle but this horse has done really well. We came up here just for this race but with the Sydney Cup in the back of our mind obviously. We probably can't go back home now so we will keep him here, keep him nice and fresh for a week, and tackle the big one. It's been a real mission of mine to come up and beat you guys in Sydney and I'm really happy to do it."

Bivouac wins Kindergarten

Bivouac (2 c ex Exceed And Excel - Dazzler by More Than Ready) continued Godolphin's domination of the juvenile division with an impressive victory in the Kindergarten Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) at Randwick yesterday. The James Cummings-trained two-year-old colt was given a beautiful run by Blake Shinn, surging to the front halfway up the straight to score comfortably by two lengths over debutante Libertini (I Am Invincible), who was trained by James's father Anthony, with the winner's stablemate, Athiri (Lonhro), another half-neck away third. The win was something of a consolation with Bivouac given the juvenile was a first emergency for the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), although he did not get a start.

Bivouac impresses Cummings

Following Bivouac's victory in the Kindergarten Stakes, James Cummings could not hide his delight at the result. "Great credit to the guys at Crown Lodge," said Cummings. "I was getting frustrated with them - it's been two weeks without a two-year-old winner and it seems like too long! I haven't trained a trifecta yet, but we've had a Cummings trifecta there and that will have to do. "Blake Shinn was very keen for me to give it more and more thought about running him in the Sires' and we talked about it with the boys but the Kindergarten was his right race. He's a good colt and I think he is capable of improving into something even better in time. He showed brilliant acceleration on that going there at the top of the straight to put this race away comfortably."

Overdue win for Ringerdingding

Talented colt Ringerdingding (3 c Sebring -Maybe I by Red Ransom) yesterday ended a frustrating run of outs at his fifth start for trainer Chris Waller by winning the Carbine Club Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Randwick. Under his former trainer Darren Weir, Ringerdingding won three races including the Sandown Guineas (Gr 2, 1600m) in November but has had little luck in his previous four starts for Waller. "Unfortunately he didn't get to the Doncaster," Waller said of the three-year-old, who was an emergency for the Doncaster Mile. "It's been the story of this preparation. In Melbourne he was very unlucky with barrier draws but things have just gone wrong and today they went right." Ridden by James McDonald, Ringerdingding (\$3.10) edged clear from barrier one to win by a neck over Shuffle Up (Redoute's Choice) (\$61) with favourite Dealmaker (Dundeel) (\$2.80) another half length away in third.

25 for Rip Van Winkle

The Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained Naantali (4 f ex Zaloot by Zabeel) became the 25th stakes winner for Windsor Park Stud resident Rip Van Winkle (Galileo) when winning the Anniversary Vase (Listed, 1400m) at Caulfield yesterday. Now the winner of six races from 18 starts, Naantali finished a length and

three quarters to the good of Manolo Blahniq (Jimmy Choux), with a further short-head back to Kemono (Kinshasa) in third.

Meuse makes it two wins from two starts

Anthony Freedman's stellar season rolled on yesterday, with Meuse (Snitzel) bringing up his second win in as many starts yesterday in the Thomas North 2YO Handicap (1100m) at Caulfield. The two-year-old finished strongly to beat Flostar (Zoustar) by a short-head with another three quarters of a length back to Memphis Rock (Fastnet Rock) in third. The filly was purchased by Hilldene and Gelagotis Racing for \$500,000 at the Inglis Easter Yearling Sale from the Newgate Farm draft.

Adelaide beckons for Meuse

Following Meuse's victory at Caulfield, Freedman's racing manager Brad Taylor revealed the filly would now be aimed at a Group 3 in Adelaide. "It was a good effort," Taylor said. "She still wanted to do a few things wrong and needed every inch of the 1100 metres to get there. She is a filly who will progress on and we'll have a crack at black type now. There's a nice Group 3 race in Adelaide coming up for her in three weeks. She's a pretty talented filly and deserves her opportunity now. And she will be better when she gets out to the 1200 metres."

Nugent lands first Caulfield winner

Apprentice Teo Nugent's first race ride on his home track has been successful in the Polytrack Handicap (1600m) aboard the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained Think Bleue (So You Think) at Caulfield. "I'm out of bed at 3.30 in the morning, at the track here (Caulfield) at four, ride a couple and then head off to finish off the morning at Ballarat," Nugent said. "Luckily I didn't have to do that this morning, but the past week has been flat out and then there's racing on top of that. You look forward to your bed when you get home." Yesterday's victory was Nugent's third in the metropolitan area and comes after outriding his country claim. It's lovely to get one at home especially as I do so much trackwork here and it's great to ride one for the boss."

Grinzinger Star causes a Caulfield upset

The Danny O'Brien-trained Grinzinger Star (Reliable Man) caused an upset in the Tile Importer Handicap (1600m) at Caulfield yesterday, bringing an end to Mr Quickie's (Shamus Award) winning streak. Grinzinger Star prevailed in a close finish to beat Mr Quickie by a nose with Star Missile (Smart Missile) coming home length and a half away in third. "We've still got question marks over whether he ran the trip strongly," O'Brien's assistant trainer Ben Gleeson said. "His distance is looking ideally around the 2000-metre mark. He has come on a lot since his first-up run and Linda (Meech) rode him beautifully today. She followed Mr Quickie beautifully, presented him at the right time and he has been strong to the line."

Meech salutes on Bandipur for Godolphin

Linda Meech made her first ride for Godolphin a winning one when partnering Bandipur (Commands) to success in the Ladbrokes Handicap (1200m) at Caulfield yesterday. "The little fella he stuck his head out - he was tough," Meech told Racing.com. "I just got a brilliant run - I thought I might have got the split late, those other horses had the momentum outside of me, he was tough and he really dug in. He got a couple of little bumps on the outside and he just tried his guts out."

Second stakes win for Sexy Eyes

Sexy Eyes (5 m Written Tycoon - Hidden Savings by Secret Savings) secured her second success at Listed level when supplementing December's Belle Of The Turf Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) win at Gosford with victory in the Weetwood Handicap (Listed, 1200m) at Toowoomba yesterday, providing Chris Waller with the second leg of a double as the winter carnival got underway. "She does go well fresh and she did have a trial. But she got into a bit of trouble early before really running home," Waller's Queensland manager Paul Shailer said. "She only arrived up here late last week so she is still really to settle in. Chris will probably map out a plan now to get her more black-type during the winter."

The Lord Mayor claims Toowoomba Cup

Earlier on the card, The Lord Mayor (Rock 'N' Pop) kicked-off the Waller double with victory in the Toowoomba Cup (2000m). Kubis (Love Conquers All) finished a long-neck away in second, while there was a further length and a quarter back to Mishani Vaidra (Show A Heart) in third. The Lord Mayor was winning for the fifth time in 17 starts, while his Iffraaj (Zafonic) halfsister will be offered as **Lot 86** at next month's New Zealand Bloodstock Karaka May Sale.

Two for Deep Field

Dig Deep (2 g ex Lucky Ana by Lucky Unicorn) became the second stakes winner for Newgate Farm-based first-season sire Deep Field (Northern Meteor) when he landed the Karrakatta Plate (Gr 2, 1200m) at Ascot yesterday. Tinsnip (Snippetson) finished a longneck away in second, while Miss West Coast (Safeguard) was a further three-quarters of a length back in third. Dig Deep joins Pago Pago Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) winner Cosmic Force as stakes scorers for Deep Field, who stood for a fee of \$22,500 (inc GST) last year.

Mizlecki lands fourth Listed prize

The Fred Kersley-trained Mizlecki (4 f Lope de Vega - Miss Strezelecki, by Al Maher) secured the fourth Listed success of her career when winning the Old Comrade Stakes (Listed, 1600m) earlier on the Ascot card. Properantes (Danehill Express) finished four and a quarter lengths away in second, while there was a shorthead back to Variation (War Chant) in third. Mizlecki has won six of her 17 starts, amassing \$461,800 in prize-money having been passed in for \$28,000 (\$30,000 reserve) at the Magic Millions Perth Yearling Sale in 2016.

Winx gallops at Randwick

Winx (Street Cry) prepared for her final start in Saturday's Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) at Randwick, with an exhibition gallop on the course-proper yesterday. Chris Waller, as has been customary in recent seasons, elected to give Winx the public hit out over 1000 metres with Hugh Bowman in the saddle. She ran her last 600 metres in 34.67 seconds. Waller described the workout as "perfect" and

said the race day experience was beneficial for the whole team. "This morning is a good piece of work for her and an important piece," Waller said. "It will even help us. Three weeks between runs, you have a week to come down, a week to build up a little bit and the last week gets quite intense. She looks pretty good to me. We're just making sure the horse is staying the same and staying safe, not letting her get away on us with three weeks between runs."

Beriman hit with suspension

Nikita Beriman, who won the Anniversary Vase (Listed, 1400m) on Naantali (Rip Van Winkle) earlier on the Caulfield card, was hit by a 15-meeting suspension after pleading guilty to high-range careless riding in race seven. Beriman was riding Spirit Of Aquada (Bel Esprit) when she caused interference to Inn Keeper (Host) and Streets Of Avalon (Magnus). Her suspension will begin following the conclusion of Caulfield's meeting next Saturday, with Beriman free to return on April 27.

The Waikato Stud-based Savabeel (Zabeel) sired his 18th Group 1 winner after Nicoletta's (5 m ex Savabeel - Celtic Crown by Doneraile Court) victory in the Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Te Aroha, leading home a quinella for the stallion. The five-year-old mare lead all the way to beat Supera (Savabeel) by a head with Australian raider Luvaluva (Mastercraftsman) a further three quarters of a length back in third. Savabeel has four lots catalogued at the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale.

66 for Iffraaj

Who Dares Wins (6 g ex Wee Tipple by Centaine) upset the favourites when he produced a bold finishing burst to capture his first win at stakes level when scoring in the Easter Cup (Listed, 1600m), becoming Haunui Farm shuttler Iffraaj's (Zafonic) 66th stakes winner. Having his 47th career start, the Tony and Lyn Prendergasttrained Who Dares Wins beat Residential (Pins) by a length and a half with another long-neck back to Contessa Vanessa (Bullbars) in third. The stallion has one lot catalogued at the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale.

Prendergast happy with Who Dares Wins

Who Dares Wins had not been since December and Prendergast admitted he was not overly confident heading into the Listed race. "It hasn't been easy," Tony Prendergast said. "It's four months since he raced and although he's had a couple of trials it wasn't against much opposition. It all worked out good in the finish though. We weren't overly confident although we knew he was well. We were just worried about not being quite as seasoned as the others with the wet track."

Secret Allure back in winning groove

Consistent filly Secret Allure (3 c ex Zacinto - Secret Scent by O'Reilly) made a successful return to Riccarton on Saturday when she stormed home to capture the NZB Airfreight Stakes (Listed, 1600m). The Lisa Latta-trained three-year-old finished strongly to beat Emily Margaret (Pins) by a length and three quarters with another two and a half lengths back to Our Hail Mary (Ocean Park) in third. "All I was thinking at the 800 metres was how are we going to get into it from against the fence and so far back," part-owner and syndicate manager Andy Rennie said. "It really turned out to be a lovely ride by Lisa as she had only ridden her for the first time in the Foxton trial last month. The key to the filly is to get her relaxed and travelling and Lisa did that a treat. That's why you get the best to ride for you in these races and that showed today."

Trainer Nigel Tiley is eyeing a trip to Queesland with Riding The Wave (Malibu Moon) after the gelding brought up his second win in as many starts in the Pyramid Trucking Handicap (1400m) at Riccarton yesterday. The three-year-old beat Anything But (Savabeel) by a length with another length and three quarters back to Peaceful (Savabeel) back in third. "He's a serious horse," Tiley said. "He just did a few things wrong with his first couple of starts so we gave him a break and started again with him. We changed a bit of gear with him as well and he's the real deal I think. We discussed that (the Queensland Winter Carnival) and I said if he wins today, we are going to have to consider it."

The three-year-old prevailed by a length and a half over Stone Tornado (Toronado) with the same margin back to Lamaire (Casamento) in third. Zoffany is currently standing for a fee of €25,000.

Mission Boy remains unbeaten

Mission Boy (3 c ex Paco Boy - Miss Mission by Second Empire) made a successful seasonal reappearance and stretched his unbeaten record to five when winning the Premio Gardone (Listed, 1600m) at Milan yesterday. Zoman (Rajsaman) finished three and a quarter lengths away in second, while there was a further five lengths back to Siculi (Kuroshio) in third. Mission Boy won all four starts as a juvenile, culminating with victory in the Gran Criterium (Gr 2, 1500m) at the same venue in October.

lue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Written By (Written Tycoon), the winner of six of his 11 starts having amassed \$1,808,700 in prize-money, will stand at Widden Stud in 2019.

The Grahame Begg-trained Written By, who was bred and owned by his father Neville, came onto the radar of studmasters following his dominant Blue Diamond Stakes victory last year, with Widden Stud last night confirming it had secured standing rights for the six-time winner.

Written By won four of his five starts as a juvenile, with his only defeat coming when he was fourth - and the first colt home - in last year's Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m).

Widden Stud principal Antony Thompson was delighted to be able to add Written By to the historic farm's stallion roster this year.

The news comes only weeks after Widden Stud and owner Bert Vieira had agreed to terms for multiple Group 1 winner Trapeze Artist (Snitzel) to also stand at Widden Stud.

"Widden have enjoyed unrivalled success in recent years, launching the careers of successful stallions such as Sebring, Northern Meteor, Stratum, Nicconi, Star Witness and Zoustar, and they have all been wonderfully successful sires," Antony Thompson said.

"Physically, Written By is an awesome individual. He is strong, imposing and perfectly built for the Australian conditions and our commercial market.

"We firmly believe this horse has all the attributes to add to our current sires' success and we thank Neville and the Begg family for entrusting us to fulfil his next career as a stallion. They have been an absolute pleasure to deal with."

Thompson added: "Not since Pierro in 2013 has an Australian Group 1-winning two-year-old retired to stud that is completely free of Danehill blood. We feel Written By presents a beautiful outcross to the many Danehill/Danzig-line mares in this country."

Written By, who won two of his six starts as a three-year-old and also finished fourth in the Coolmore Stud Stakes (registered as Ascot Vale Stakes) (Gr 1, 1200m) at Flemington last spring, will not race again after the deal was sealed between Begg and Widden Stud.

Passed in at the 2017 Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale with a reserve of \$200,000, such was the opinion Begg had of Written By, the colt is one of five winners out of the winning mare Yau Chin (Tobougg).

Neville Begg believes Widden Stud offers Written By the best chance to be a success as a stallion.

"Champion two-year-old colts have an incredible record at stud. From Luskin Star to Canny Lad and more recently Sebring and Pierro," Begg said.

"In fact, Written By's pedigree even features champion two-year-old colts and successful sires Rory's Jester, Marscay and Vain."

Written By will stand for an introductory fee of \$24,750 (inc GST) with Widden Stud and Begg also offering 40 lifetime breeding rights in the horse.

He will join Trapeze Artist at Widden Stud in the coming weeks after the Gerald Ryantrained four-year-old was retired following his seventh-placed run in yesterday's T J Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m).




