Gollan hoping to cause an upset in Doomben 10,000

Local trainer fields Outback Barbie and I'm A Rippa in 'open' renewal of the Group 1 sprint

ueensland trainer Tony Gollan will launch a two-pronged assault on tomorrow's Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 1200m) and is hopeful his duo can upset the market principals in what he believes to be an open renewal of the Group 1 sprint.

Gollan will saddle Outback Barbie (Spirit Of Boom) and I'm A Rippa (Love Conquers All) in tomorrow's \$800,000 contest, with the former bidding to become the first three-year-old filly in 86 years to land the lucrative prize.

Outback Barbie will also be out to emulate:

her father Spirit Of Boom (Sequalo), who led home a memorable 1-2 for Gollan in the 2014 renewal of the Doomben 10,000.

The talented filly comes into the race without a run since January having been scratched from last weekend's Silk Stocking (Listed, 1200m), though Gollan has no reservations about her fitness and expects a bold showing from the three-year-old.

"We scratched her last week due to the conditions of the track and we're very comfortable with that decision," Gollan told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday.

Bolt d'Oro spearheads sixstrong roster for Spendthrift Australia

Spendthrift Australia have announced the fees for their six-strong stallion roster for 2019, with the sextet spearheaded by dual Grade 1-winning juvenile Bolt d'Oro (Medaglia d'Oro), who is set stand his debut season in Australia at a fee of \$13,750 (inc GST)

The son of Medaglia d'Oro (El Prado) will shuttle to the Kerrie-based operation after covering a full book of mares in his first season at Spendthrift's Kentucky base, as reported in ANZ Bloodstock News on Saturday.

"She's in good shape heading into this week.

"She's certainly ready to go. She'll improve fitness wise as she gets out to 1400 (metres), but she has a great record fresh at 1200 metres and always races well on that fresher side.

"We've had blinkers on in her trials and she's been excellent in them, I think we'll see her race really well.

"She's unproven at weight-for-age but I do think she has Group 1 ability. Whether it's enough to win this race who knows, but I think she's a Group 1 filly in the wings and I guess we'll see how close she is to that prediction on Saturday."

Tomorrow's contest is also likely to provide pointers for the remainder of Outback Barbie's winter campaign, with the likes of the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) and the Tattersalls' Tiara (Gr 1, 1400m) mooted as potential targets should she acquit herself well at Doomben.

"There are options for her in a fortnight, it's just a case of which way do we go," Gollan said.

"Do we go through the three year old grade or back to fillies and mares, or do we stay in this weight-for-age racing? It all depends on how she goes in the 10,000.

"Obviously we were looking for a softer approach to the carnival with her, but that's not to be. We've gone straight for the deep end and if she happens to swim really well in this grade then we'll stick with it.

"That will give us an idea of whether she's up to getting in the

Stradbroke off a light handicap, or whether we just continue on that three year old or fillies and mares route and head towards the Tiara at the end of the carnival, which has always been her main aim if her form was good enough."

The trainer is also confident that I'm A Rippa can leave behind his disappointing comeback run at Eagle Farm last month, where Gollan feels his freshness accounted for his lacklustre sixth of seven in the Victory Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m).

"It was a funny day, they were racing well off the fence even though it was a Good 3," Gollan said of I'm A Rippa's last start.


"He didn't seem to settle at all, got pressured a little bit mid race and wanted to overdo things, so we'll probably let him run along a little quicker which might help him a touch.

"He should find the fence pretty comfortably early in this race and we'll be able to let him roll along and do his natural racing.

"He's a dry tracker and he needed another run at the 1200 (metres), hence why we've come to the 10,000. I just felt he ran too fresh first up to wait until next week and go to 1350 (metres).

"This run will bring him on for other assignments in the carnival. Whether they're Listed to minor Group racing or whether they're Group 1s or the Stradbroke, this run will certainly tell us where we're at. I think he's a handicapper and I'd love to get him in the Stradbroke with a light weight."

Continued from page 2 10,000 as a two horse race with last-start Galaxy Handicap (Gr 1, 1100m) winner Nature Strip (Nicconi) and serial Group 1 placegetter Osborne Bulls (Street Cry) well clear of the rest, but Gollan feels this year's renewal is much more open than the market suggests.

"There's been very good support for Nature Strip and rightfully so, he's a Group 1 winner on his last outing, but he's yet to win at this level over 1200 metres," he said.

"Osborne Bulls is obviously very hard to beat, but at the moment he's forever the bridesmaid and never the bride. I think it's a really open 10.000.

"I think they'll be a lot of speed on in this race, it will be a true run 1200 (metres) and I think luck will play its part.

"I really do think there are question marks on a lot of these horses and it's a very intriguing rendition of our great sprint."

Elsewhere at Doomben on Saturday, Gollan has a whole host of chances across the nine-race card, with the trainer optimistic that a drop to Class Six company can help Ef Troop (Spirit Of Boom) recover the form that saw him finish a close second in the Todman Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) as a juvenile.

"I think we have a lot of hopes, particularly in the restricted races early in the meeting," he said.

"I'd love to see Ef Troop bounce back to his best in that class six. He's had a bit of a stop start prep as far as the weather has gone and I'd like to

see him resume, back on good ground and down in grade.

"A Man To Match is on a Derby path and I think I have some pretty nice chances in the Champagne as well. It's going to be a great day's racing and hopefully we get a nice, good track."

Baker hoping for a change in fortune for ultra-consistent Champagne Cuddles

Tony Gollan is not the only trainer seeking to land tomorrow's Doomben 10,000 with a filly. Warwick Farm-based trainer Bjorn Baker is hoping to take out the lucrative sprint with the ultra-consistent Champagne Cuddles (Not A Single Doubt), who will be bidding to seal a deserved Group 1 success at her tenth attempt.

The rising five-year-old has recorded placings at the highest level on four occasions, as well as finishing a gallant fourth in both the TJ Smith Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) and All Aged Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) on her previous two outings.

Blake Shinn, who rode the daughter of Not A Single Doubt (Redoute's Choice) to victory in the ATC Breeders' Classic (Gr 2, 1200m) earlier this year, takes over the reins for tomorrow's assignment - one of many positives her trainer outlined to ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday.

"She's in great order and I couldn't be happier with her. She's really relaxed and her work has been very good," Baker said.

"It's a bit of an awkward gate on Saturday, but Continued on page 5>>

Continued from page 3 I think she's going as well as she ever has and Blake Shinn knows her well.

"She's travelling up tonight (yesterday) and she knows Brisbane, she went to the sales there and was up there last winter where she ran well, so I'm confident she'll run a really good race.

"She just hasn't had the best of luck in her last two runs. Her run in the TJ (Smith) was great, so close to running second, and then the All Aged Stakes I thought she ran super as well."

Having failed to register a podium finish on just six of her 20 outings, Baker is confident that Champagne Cuddles possesses the requisite ability to record the all-important Group 1 win that has eluded her thus far.

"The top two in the market will be hard to beat, but if we can have luck in running I think she's up to it. She's coming out of similar formlines to Osborne Bulls anyway so she's not out of it," he added.

"They don't give these Group 1s away, they're always tough races, but I think the way she is and how she's working I'm confident she's going to run a really good race. You never get carried away, but I think she's going well.

"We'll take it one run at a time. She has been up for a wee while and we're mindful of that."

The trio of fillies in the field for the Group 1 contest is completed by Group 2 winner White Moss (Mossman), who will jump from barrier 1 with Kathy O'Hara booked to take the ride.

Elsewhere at Doomben tomorrow, Baker also has a live chance of securing stakes race glory in the shape of Music Magnate (Written

Tycoon), who will bid to repeat the heroics of his Doomben 10,000 victory on this card three years ago should he take his chance in the Members' Handicap (Listed, 1600m).

"It was a really good run last week (second at the Gold Coast) but I'm sort of debating whether we save him for a week," Baker said.

"Up to a mile is a big question mark but he's going well, looks well and being back at Doomben is where he's had his best runs.

"He has to overcome his big weight but you have to have some confidence as he's the class horse on the day."

Good draw for Savvy Oak

Co-trainers Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young believe the tough task Savvy Oak (Savabeel) has of winning a South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) at Morphettville tomorrow has been made slightly easier, given that he has been handed barrier one. "We've finally got a draw in a Derby, it's brilliant," Young said. "We've got the ace draw. I think Michael (Walker, jockey) will give him every chance, put him to sleep on the rail, cuddle him up so he can run the 2500 metres out and hopefully it's not too wet in Adelaide. He worked nicely on Tuesday. He'll travel over on Thursday night and chase another Derby and hopefully get our first Group 1 since we moved here."

Smart hoping Manzala can surprise in Derby

Trainer Nick Smart is hoping Manzala (Poet's Voice) can spring a surprise in tomorrow's SA Derby at Morphettville. The gelding has drawn barrier three for the \$500,000 feature and the Ballarat-based trainer is eager to utilise the inside draw."He's got nice gate speed and he'll relish the trip," Smart told Racing.com "From that barrier he should be able to put himself around six/seven and get a good run from there. I'm feeling pretty confident and think his price is a lot higher than it should be, especially as he's one of the runners who will really enjoy the wet."

Morton hoping to break Group 1 duck in Queensland

Dan Morton is hoping Man Booker (Discorsi)
can break his drought in Queensland Group
1s when the gelding takes his chance in the

Doomben 10,000 (Gr 1, 1200m) tomorrow. The six-year-old gelding has not been seen since his fifth place finish in the Racing Railway Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) in November, in a preparation which saw him string consecutive stakes races together in the Farnley Stakes (Listed, 1400m) and the Northerly Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m). "I was happy with his trial before we brought him across here and he worked strongly at Doomben this week," Morton said. "He has early pace but there looks to be a lot of speed in the 10,000 so I wouldn't expect him to be in a battle for the lead. He is here for the 10,000, Kingsford Smith Cup and Stradbroke."

Our Libretto seeking first stakes win

Grahame Begg believes that if Our Libretto (O'Reilly) handles the tight-track configuration of Doomben then she has a good chance of making the breakthrough at stakes level in the Kirin Chairman's Handicap (Gr 3, 2000m). "Doomben is probably not a track that's going to suit her, she'll be much better suited once she gets to Eagle Farm, which is more spacious but it's a nice stepping stone going towards the Brisbane Cup," Begg told Racing.com. Our Libretto's next two starts will be at Eagle Farm Premier's Cup (Gr 3, 2200m) on May 25 followed by the Lexus Brisbane Cup (Gr 2, 2400m) on June 8.

Anderson and Heathcote rely on Ballistic Boy

Ballistic Boy (Smart Missile) will be out to hand new training partnership Robert Heathcote and Chris Anderson their first stakes winner when he lines up in the BRC Champagne Classic (Gr 2, 1200m) at Doomben tomorrow. It is apt that the gelding could provide the co-trainers with their first black type winner since Ballistic Boy was one of five well-bred yearlings the late Dato Tan Chin Nam's Think Big Stud bought for Anderson to train. "I had trained some tried horses for them and they decided to give me a chance with some younger horses," Anderson said. "Naturally he came with me when I joined up with Rob who has also trained plenty of winners for Think Big Stud. We obviously would love to win any stakes races for them but again it would obviously be good if it was our first as a partnership."

Kendrick hoping to learn more about Jagged Edge

Stuart Kendrick is hoping to gage whether Jagged Edge (Better Than Ready) can mix it in Group 1 company when he runs in the BRC Champagne Classic at Doomben tomorrow. The two-year-old gelding is unbeaten in his two career starts, having been most recently seen winning the Dalrello Stakes (Listed, 1000m) last month and he could progress to the BRC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) and JJ Atkins (Gr 1, 1600m) at Eagle Farm should he perform well this weekend. "If he wins or runs a good race and hits the line well, he'll go on to the Sires' Produce and that race will decide if he runs in the J.J. Atkins," Kendrick said. "If he doesn't show he's ready to run further then he'll spell and come back and chase QTIS prize-money next campaign."

With Ben Currie's nominations being refused by Racing Queensland as he faces several inquiries, Mishani Hustler (Exceedingly Good) will have his first start for new trainer Les Ross in the Queensland Day Stakes (Listed, 1350m) at Doomben tomorrow. The gelding is one of Queensland's most exciting three-year-olds, having performed well in his juvenile year, winning the Dalrello Stakes (Listed, 1200m), before running second behind Zousain (Zoustar) in the Champagne Classic on his next start. The gelding will be on the hunt for his first stakes victory at three, having been narrowly denied on his last start, when finishing third in the Weetwood Handicap (Listed, 1200m).

Bartley launches twopronged attack on Scone Guineas

Lady (Walking Or Dancing) and McCormack (Eurozone) in tomorrow's \$250,000 race. "The horses have both been set for it," Bartley said. "It's good to get the two three-year-olds there. We own part of Bare Naked Lady so we're very excited for her and she's been good to us so far already." While of McCormack, Bartley commented: "We freshened him up and he had some time at home here. He races really good fresh, that's why we've gone that way with him."

Libertini heads to Scone

The Anthony Cummings-trained Libertini (I Am Invincible) will shoot for her first win at stakes level when she takes her chance in the Woodlands Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Scone tomorrow. The Gerry Harvey-owned two-year-old filly did not make her debut until last month after suffering with shin soreness, but made an instant impression, finishing second in the Kindergarten Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m), before

shedding her maiden tag on her next start in the Armistice Maiden 2YO Plate (1200m). "She went through the stable a couple of times before she went to the races. She was just a bit shinny in the preparation prior," Cummings said. "That slowed us up a little but nevertheless, she was there for a nice race over the carnival and did well, and she'll do well again on Saturday." Libertini is out of Group 1-winning mare Aloha (Encosta De Lago).

Grand Scholar set for another stakes test

Things did not go to plan for two-year-old Grand Scholar (Wandjina) first-up in Adelaide but trainer Tony McEvoy is convinced that result is not a true reflection of the filly's ability and he will be hoping she can live up to expectation when she runs in the Vale Redoute's Choice Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Caulfield on Saturday. Grand Scholar was third in the Maribyrnong Trial Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at Flemington last October on debut. She then made her return in the SAJC Breeders Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) in Adelaide last month but faded in the final 200 metres to finish fifth. "She will be ridden patiently and look for her to be finishing the race off strongly," said McEvoy. "I like to run my horses where I think they can be really competitive and I wouldn't be running her just to make up the numbers, I'd be going to a maiden. I've got a lot of time for her and that's why I've decided to stay aggressive and run her in this race."

More Queensland country meetings get TAB

Racing Queensland has negotiated TAB coverage for country race meetings linked to iconic regional tourist events such as the Barcaldine Tree of Knowledge Festival and the Mt Isa Rodeo. In a media statement RQ announced it would provide TAB opportunities to a further seven regional thoroughbred clubs, including national television coverage on Sky Racing. The Birdsville Cup (1600m) retains its status on the TAB circuit in September with the concept expanded across the state to include Barcaldine, Dalby, Emerald, Innisfail, Mount Isa, Warwick and Yeppoon. "Racing plays an important role in regional communities right across Queensland and


Wagering up on All-Star Mile day

The inaugural All-Star Mile meeting came close to matching established Autumn Carnival blockbusters Super Saturday and Blue Diamond Day in terms of total turnover according to Racing Victoria. Figures released by RV on Thursday show that All-Star Mile Day had domestic turnover of \$65.8 million, which was just short of Blue Diamond Day (\$67.1 million) and Super Saturday (\$67.8m). The All-Star Mile (1600m) replaced the Blamey Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m)and the new feature increased turnover by 53 per cent year on year. "The All-Star Mile was developed as a focal point within the Festival of Racing and the results indicate that it has achieved that in its first year, while fostering engagement with our racing in a unique and exciting way," said RV chief executive Giles Thompson.

Forsman on the hunt for milestone win

Co-trainer Andrew Forsman will be hoping he can bring up a century of winners in a season and with five runners at New Plymouth and ten at Rotorua the prospects of making it to three figures look bright. Among the runners are Highlad (High Chaparral) and Tomelilla (Tavistock) who return to defend their crowns in the Rotorua Cup (Gr 3, 2200m) and Rotorua Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) respectively. "It's always nice to get to three figures. I did it a couple of times playing cricket when I was younger but I wasn't much of batsman," Forsman said. "It would be nice if we could get there this weekend." Of Highlad's chances Forsman added: "We'd have liked to have had one more run leading in but there was nothing suitable. He's got a big weight (59kg) to carry again and with just one run in, that's got to be the guery with him. But he's working well."

Stable apprentice Holly Andrew kept her composure aboard the daughter of Tartan Bearer, biding her time before unleashing her charge down the straight where she was able to run home late to get the better of Lincoln Hanover (Showcasing) by a neck. "I am very pleased for (owners) Paul McGlade and the Taumaranui Racing Club and the syndicate up there," said Gray. "I think she is a speed horse and a bit of cut out of the ground you will see a lot more of her."

Te Akau Shark back in work

Group 2 winner Te Akau Shark (Rip Van Winkle) has returned to work after a lengthy spell after pulling up with a few soreness issues after his win in the Coupland's Bakeries Mile (Gr 2, 1600m) and will now be set for some major spring targets, with a likely trip across the Tasman on the cards. "He has always been plagued a little bit by immaturity issues that have taken a fair while to settle down. He seems to be fine for three or four runs and then he needs a spell," Jamie Richards said. "He has had a good long break, he has got a heap of weight on and hopefully now that he is fully matured we could see him hopefully get to some of those good races in Australia."

Morando lands Ormonde Stakes at Chester

Owner King Power, trainer Andrew Balding and jockey Silvestre De Sousa continued their fine start to the season with Morando (5 g Kendargent - Moranda by Indian Rocket) running out an easy winner of the Ormonde Stakes (Gr 3, 1m5½f) at Chester yesterday. The five-year-old gelding scooted clear in the home straight, eventually beating last year's St Leger Stakes (Gr 1, 1m6½f) winner Kew Gardens (Galileo) by an impressive eight lengths, with another half length back to Magic Circle (Makfi) in third. Morando is one of 25 stakes winners for Kendargent (Kendor).

191 for Galileo

Coolmore's supersire Galileo (Sadler's Wells) was handed a 191st stakes winner when Circus Maximus (3 c ex Duntle by Danehill Dancer) landed the Dee Stakes (Listed, 1m2½f) at Chester yesterday. Having won once as a two-year-old, the Aidan O'Brien-trained colt was having his first start this season and he exerted his class, pulling a length and a quarter clear of his fast-finishing stablemate Mohawk (Galileo). Fox Chairman (Kingman), who had no luck in running, finished another two lengths away in third. Circus Maximus is the first foal out of Group 2 winner Duntle, while Galileo stands at Coolmore Stud in Ireland for a private fee.

"He's a relaxed horse and he just needed to learn a little bit, it was lovely to come here. He got a lovely handy break, he gets lazy in his races and he dropped back. When Ryan moved him up he came back on the bridle. The great thing about here is that they have to have quick feet, they have to learn to jump and they have to travel then they have to keep

going as well. The ground was slow so they had to work a little bit harder but it was all perfect really."

First for Penny's Picnic

Ilanga (3 f ex Molly Mara by Big Shuffle) landed a huge shock in the Prix Texanita (Gr 3, 1200m) at Maisons-Laffitte yesterday and in the process provided Penny's Picnic (Kheleyf) with his first stakes winner. The three-year-old filly beat Milord's Song (Siyouni) by three quarters of a length with another three lengths back to Cigalera (Elusive City) in third. Penny's Picnic stands at Haras Du Hoguenet for a fee of €6,500.

True Self stretches unbeaten run to five

Talented mare True Self (6 m Oscar - Good Thought by Mukaddamah) stretched her unbeaten to five when getting the better of her rivals in the Vintage Tipple Stakes (Listed 1m6f) at Gowran Park on Wednesday. The Willie Mullins-trained mare beat Jaega (Fastnet Rock) by three quarters of a length with the same distance back to Bongiorno (High Chaparral) in third, bringing her total tally of stakes wins to three. True Self is Oscar's (Sadler's Wells) only stakes winner on the flat, with the stallion being more commonly known for his exploits as a National Hunt stallion.



Bolt d'Oro spearheads six-strong roster for Spendthrift Australia

pendthrift Australia have announced the fees for their six-strong stallion roster for 2019, with the sextet spearheaded by dual Grade 1-winning juvenile Bolt d'Oro (Medaglia d'Oro), who is set stand his debut season in Australia at a fee of \$13,750 (inc GST)

The son of Medaglia d'Oro (El Prado) will shuttle to the Kerrie-based operation after covering a full book of mares in his first season at Spendthrift's Kentucky base, as reported in ANZ Bloodstock News on Saturday.

Overshare, the Group-winning son of leading sire I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit), is

set to stand his second season at Spendthrift Australia for a fee of \$11,000 (inc GST) - the same figure his illustrious father stood for in his first four seasons at stud prior to becoming Australia's most expensive advertised stallion this year.

Fresh from covering 79 mares in his debut season, Overshare will participate for the first time in Spendthrift's 'Breed Secure' program, which allows breeders to pay service fees from sale proceeds after recouping agreed expenses.

Also set to stand his second season at the Victorian farm is Group 2 winner Gold Standard

(Sebring), whose fee remains unchanged at \$5,500 (inc GST). The Stan Fox Stakes (Gr 2, 1500m) winner will also participate in Spendthrift's Breed Secure program.

Meanwhile, Spendthrift's two sons of the late Redoute's Choice (Danehill) in Swear and Hampton Court will both stand for unchanged fees of \$5,500 (inc GST) in 2019. The roster is completed by Jimmy Creed (Distorted Humor) whose fee also remains the same at \$8,800 (inc GST).

Swear, Hampton Court and Jimmy Creed will also participate in the Breed Secure program in 2019.

"We are very excited about the upcoming breeding season and our vision for the future of Spendthrift Australia," said general manager Garry Cuddy.

"We encourage breeders to visit to inspect our quality stallion roster and view the exciting farm developments that have taken place in the last four years.

"We are dedicated to the development of Spendthrift Australia and committed to helping breeders reach their goals."

The arrival of Bolt d'Oro to Australian shores sees an attempt to continue the legacy left in the southern hemisphere by his sire Medaglia d'Oro, who shuttled to Darley's Kelvinside base in New South Wales for eight seasons and produced the likes of Astern, Vancouver and Crown Prosecutor - all of whom recorded victories at the highest level.

alifornia Zimbol (I Am Invincible) staged a really smart debut effort in winning at Canterbury on Wednesday for trainers Peter and Paul Snowden.

The two-year-old broke cleanly and showed good early pace under Glyn Schofield, who settled the filly outside the leader. She then kicked off the bend to dash clear after the 200 metre mark before going on to score easily in a winning time of 1:10.33.

Bred by co-owner of Yarraman Park Stud Harry Mitchell, the filly is out of the placed Anabaa (Danzig) Zimaretto making her a half-sister Listed winning-pair From Within (Not A Single Doubt) and Cruden Bay (Not A Single Doubt) and a further two winners.

Zimaretto herself is out of German winner Borely (Reprimand), who is a half-sister to Group 3 winner Premiere Cuvee (Formidable) - the dam of six winners, including Group 3 scorer She Bat (Batshoof). She Bat is herself the dam of Listed winners She Is Great (Dalakhani), She Breeze (Selkirk) and She Spirit Di Su (Invincible Spirit). Meanwhile, Listed winner Fizzed (Efisio) also features among Borely's half-siblings.

Bloodstock for \$36,000 at the Inglis Sydney Summer Thoroughbred Sale in 2012

California Zimbol's brother was purchased by Edmonds Racing, Blue Sky Bloodstock and Raffles Racing for \$360,000 from the Yarraman Park draft at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale earlier this year, with Julian Blaxland's Blue Sky Bloodstock buying into the family for the second time having purchased From Within for the same price during the 2016 edition of the sale.

In 2018 Zimaretto produced a colt by Darley's exciting young sire Astern (Medaglia d'Oro) and was reported to have missed to I Am Invincible last season.


I Am Invincible has sired 18 two-year-old winners this season, including six stakes winners, while the Yarraman Park stallion is on the cusp of breaking the record for most stakes winners in a season, with his current haul of 26 placing him level with Danehill (Danzig) and Snitzel's (Redoute's Choice) record.

Spright's eye-catching finishing burst was also spectacular on the clock

fter finishing close-up in five previous Group 1 features, Spright (Hinchinbrook) produced a visually-stunning finishing burst to take out Saturday's TAB Classic (registered as Robert Sangster Stakes) (Gr 1, 1200m) at Morphettville - a performance that was also spectacular on the watch.

Ridden patiently by Damien Oliver, Spright remained in second last place in the 13-horse field until taken to the centre of the track on turning for home, before producing a dazzling

turn of foot to grab the lead nearing the post.

Such was the speed of her finishing run, Spright actually went on to take out her first Group 1 victory by a length and a half, with Cool Passion (Not A Single Doubt) second and Bella Martini (Stratum) a short head away in third.

The time for the 1200 metre journey was a smart 1:09.28 in a race that was solidly run throughout, with the leaders clocking 34.85 for the first 600 metres and 34.43 for the last 600

But the feature was undoubtedly the :

outstanding sectional times recorded by Spright.

The Gary Frazer-trained mare clocked a very fast 54.84 for her final 1000 metres, 44.02 for her last 800 metres, 33.19 for her last 600 metres, 22.33 for her last 400 metres and 11.44 for her final 200 metres - exceptional closing sectionals.

It was Spright's sixth win, with nine placings, from 29 starts and her victory took her prize money earnings to \$1,268,095 - she now heads to The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) at Morphettville on Saturday week with strong credentials.

Earlier in the programme, the Tony McEvoytrained four-year-old gelding Despatch (Written Tycoon) staged a very good effort on the watch in winning the D C McKay Stakes (Gr

Despatch is now the winner of six of ten starts, all three this preparation, with Saturday being his second victory at stakes level.

After a smart beginning from his outside barrier (8), Despatch was caught wide without cover in fourth place. He then moved up to take the lead in the straight, despite a difficult trip, and then lifted gamely for Barend Vorster to hold off a late bid and score in a time of 1:03.64.

Despatch's early sectional times were impressive, his 200 metre breakdown (from the 1000m) was: 10.73, 10.70 (400m in 21.43), 11.01 (600m in 32.47), 11.09 (800m in 43.56) with his final 200 metres in 11.66 to give him a fast final 1000 metre time of 55.22.

Judging by Saturday's performance, Despatch has the potential to reach higher levels.



The opening race, the Queen Adelaide Stakes (Listed, 1050m) for two-year-old fillies, was taken out by the attractive chestnut filly **Absolute Flirt** (Stratum) from the Danny O'Brien stable, her second win in four starts and her first at stakes level.

She began well and then settled for Damien Oliver in third place before improving approaching the home turn. She hit the front at the 200 metres and then fought back gamely to defeat the Tony McEvoy-trained filly Balaabel (Not A Single Doubt) by a half-length.

The time for the 1050 metre journey was 1:01.67 (11.67 200m rate), equivalent to 1000 metres in 58.35.

Absolute Flirt returned quick closing sectionals with her final 600 metres in 34.15, last 400 metres 22.76 and last 200 metres in 11.68.

However, the fastest sectionals were recorded by the runner-up Balaabel, who staged an excellent debut performance in coming from second last in the six-horse field, with her final 600 metres in 34.07, last 400 metres in 22.65 and last 200 metres in 11.47.

Franking the form was the fact that third was taken by the consistent locally-trained Li'l Kontra (Krupt), winner of the Dequetteville Stakes (Listed, 1050m) at Morphettville on her previous start and a filly that is yet to miss a placing in eight starts.

Another noteworthy effort on the watch was the victory of the promising young stayer **Ridgewood Drive** (Sebring) who recorded his second win in seven starts with an impressive victory in the Zipping Handicap (2000m) at Saturday's Flemington meeting.

The Anthony Freedman-trained gelding

raced back in 12th place, tracking a strong tempo, before displaying his stamina with a very decisive four-length victory in the quick time of 2:01.81.

Demonstration of the solid, even tempo was that the leader ran the first 1400 metres in 1:25.27 (12.18 200m rate) with the final 600 metres in 36.54, which was exactly the same strong 200 metre rate of 12.18 for the 2000 metre journey.

Ridgewood Drive, in running on from back in the field to score, returned an impressive final 1000 metre time of 59.81 and he now advances in class and distance tomorrow in the South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m), a task he may well be capable of judging by Saturday's win.

The last word this week goes to the Chris

Waller-trained three-year-old **Kolding** (Ocean Park) who is now unbeaten in two starts since being gelded and he was most impressive in winning a Benchmark 74 (1250m) at Canterbury on Wednesday.

Kolding was given a good trip by James McDonald in fourth place on the rails before sprinting clear in the straight to score easily – his closing times really taking the eye with his last 600 metres in 34.39, last 400 metres in 22.32 and last 200 metres in 10.97.

That latter sectional is especially noteworthy as it is quite rare to see the final section run in sub-11 seconds - Kolding now heads north for three-year-old targets over the Queensland Winter Carnival and he is a horse to watch.
