Glenlogan Park enjoying Time at the top as change in direction pays off

Half-brother to She Will Reign ready to add to credentials for suite of stud-bound colts



Time To Reign

Steve Morley has little doubt that Time To Reign (Time For War), the half-brother to Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner She Will Reign (Manhattan Rain), is among the top echelon of three-year-old colts in the country.

And the Glenlogan Park manager should know - he and stud owner Jon Haussler also

race Coolmore Stud Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Exceedance (Exceed And Excel) and Group 1-placed colt Reloaded (Snitzel).

Time To Reign, who won the Silver Slipper Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) last February before having his spring campaign abandoned by trainer Gary Portelli after contracting a virus, will make his long-awaited return in today's Kensington Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at Flemington. *Continued on page 2>>*

"I have got no question that he is a horse who, ability wise, is right at the top of what is a terrific three-year-old year," Morley told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday.

"He was pretty dominant in winning the Silver Slipper and there was only one colt who beat him home in the Golden Slipper and that was Microphone who ran second.

"He ran fifth in a Slipper on a track where he didn't love the going on that day. He has shown that he has got the raw talent of any of the colts in that age group, so we are very excited to get him back and hopefully he can produce his best."

Time To Reign, who will be ridden by Damien Oliver against older horses, caught the attention of onlookers when winning a Warwick Farm 804-metre barrier trial on January 2 by nine and a half lengths.

The Kensington Stakes will prove decisive for Time To Reign, with connections waiting to see how he performs before determining what races the Time For War (Snitzel) colt targets as they attempt to increase his value as a stallion prospect.

"What we've said as an ownership group and what Gary has also said is, there are so many races available for this guy if he is at the top of his game, so let's just get through Saturday and hope that he does what we think he can do and then sit down and map out a plan," he said.

"He's got a stallion's pedigree and plenty of good stallions have won a Silver Slipper. He's got that raw two-year-old speed and he's a magnificent horse to look at.

"It's a pretty dominant female family there now as well and that mare (Courgette) is going terrifically, he is a half to a Golden Slipper winner and is a Silver Slipper winner himself"

Glenogan Park, owned by Jon Haseler and Morley, decided to stop standing stallions at the Queensland farm in early 2017 and instead focus on strengthening its broodmare band and acquiring shares in young sire prospects that could go to stud predominantly in the Hunter Valley.

They subsequently bought shares in the Hawkes Racing-trained Exceedance, the Chris Waller-trained Reloaded, Group-placed colt Born A Warrior (I Am Invincible) as yearlings and last year joined forces with the China Horse Club-Newgate Bloodstock colts syndicate.

Among those to already fly the flag for that partnership is Inglis Nursery (RL, 1000m) winner Wild Ruler (Snitzel) and Aim (Star Witness) who was caught on the wrong part of the track at the Gold Coast in last Saturday's Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m).

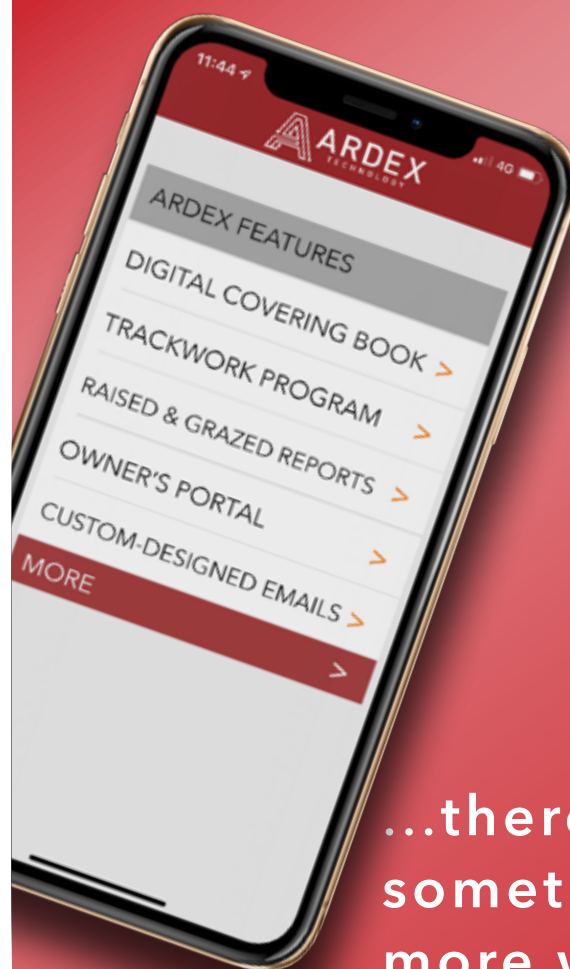
Glenogan Park, along with the likes of Kitchwin Hills, Neil Werrett and Max Whitby, bought into Time To Reign who confirmed his talent by winning his first start at Rosehill in November 2018.

"It was only a couple of years ago when Glenogan changed direction from standing stallions to become a boutique broodmare farm," Morley recalled.

"Glenogan and Jon Hausler always loved the bulls, so when we decided to stop standing them what we wanted to do was to still be involved in them.

"So, I went to those (2018) yearling sales for that group that are now three-year-olds and the plan was to try and buy into some colts as yearlings who could hopefully develop. *Continued on page 3>>*

“Luckily enough, we had Exceedance, who is the flag bearer in a small group of seven or eight colts we have and, right at this second, four of them are genuine chances of going to stud.”

Among the potential stud-bound quartet are Exceedance, who could be aimed towards Royal Ascot in June, the J J Atkins (Gr 1, 1600m)-placed Reloaded who is being aimed at the Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m), the twice stakes-placed two-year-old Born A Warrior and Time To Reign.

“In the second year we went out and we were invited into the Newgate-China Horse Club group and I enjoyed going around with Henry (Field, Newgate founder),” he said.

“I think there’s some really exciting horses there as well. Aim was stuck in the wrong part of the track on the weekend, Wild Ruler is an exciting horse, Barbaric and Rulership and Bartley are all coming back with a Golden Slipper campaign in mind, so it’s pretty exciting for Glenlogan on the racing side at the moment.”

The on-track success coincides with Glenlogan Park enjoying a profitable Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale where the stud sold ten yearlings at an average of \$311,500.

It’s top lot was an \$800,000 Written Tycoon (Iglesia) filly and a colt by Star Turn (Star Witness) bred and sold by Morley to Hawkes Racing for \$550,000.

Morley said: “The success of the last sale and the success on the track are giving us plenty of confidence going forward that we’re happy with the decision we’ve made.”

Glenlogan Park also bought into about 15 yearlings at the Magic Millions while they also acquired a Not A Single Doubt (Redoute’s Choice) filly out of US stakes winner A Brilliant Idea (Afleet Alex) for \$220,000.

The Highgrove Stud-consigned filly was signed for by trainers Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott on day one.

My Pendant to return in Kensington

Danny O'Brien admits he has some concerns over the distance for My Pendant (Pins) when she drops back in trip for today's Kensington Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at Flemington. "She has come back in really good shape," O'Brien said. "The 1000 metres might be a bit sharp for her but we thought this would be a good kick-off on her home track to get her going for the autumn. It's a small field and she's going to be the one out the back and sometimes it can set up for the closer to be the finisher. If she is close enough she will run as good a last 200 metres as anything else in the race."

Wet-track query for Bobby Dee

Bjorn Baker is not convinced the return to a rain-affected track will benefit Bobby Dee (Zed) when the four-year-old lines up in today's Bookmaker Recognition Raceday Trophy (2000m) at Rosehill. "I guess a soft track is a bit of a question mark," Baker said. "He has run on soft tracks in New Zealand with mixed levels of success but he is well and I think he should be pretty competitive. His work has been excellent and he ran a super race in The Wave."

Payne banking on Fasano

Trainer David Payne is hoping he has another nice horse on his hands for owner/breeder John Camilleri in lightly-raced three-year-old Fasano (Lonhro) who resumes in today's Jack Ashman Handicap (1300m) at Rosehill. Payne, who trained the dam Florentina (Redoute's Choice) to Group 3 success, said: "It was nice of him to give me this horse. If he performs, I'd like to try to win a black-type race somewhere. Saturday will tell us - he's got to step up."

Belated return for Just Hifalutin

Trainer Enver Jusufovic believes Just Hifalutin can run a big race when she returns from a ten-month absence at Flemington today. "It's been a long preparation but a preparation in halves," Jusufovic told Racing.com. "I had her pretty right and she was almost ready to race but she got a little bit cantankerous in the box next to another one and opened up an old wound in her hock so we pretty much had to start again with her. Fitness-wise, she's pretty right to go although certainly whatever she does first-up she will improve on."

New tactics for Prioritise

Toowoomba trainer Steve Tregua is hoping his decision to drop Prioritise (Rothestay) in trip and grade will reap dividends when the gelding lines up in today's Mount Franklin Handicap (1200m) at Eagle Farm. "He races well on the fresh side and we haven't done much with him," Tregua said. "So we have dropped him back in class and in distance. He is a horse that does go well for apprentices so I will take three kilograms off his back with apprentice Adin Thompson. It

might seem a strange move at this time in his campaign but he is a horse you can do different things with."

Sears team chasing QTIS cash

Trainers Tony and Maddy Sears will attempt to continue their domination of QTIS bonus races with two key runners at Eagle Farm today in the shape of Dark Son (Better Than Ready) in the Makers Mark QTIS Two-Year-Old Handicap (1000m) and Raging Pole (Better Than Ready) in the TAB QTIS Three-Year-Old Handicap (1200m). "Raging Pole had no luck in a couple of runs earlier in his preparation but things went right last time," Tony Sears said.

"He needs the pace on early, and cover, so he can get home hard. He should get that again on Saturday." Dark Son finished fourth in a QTIS race at the Gold Coast two weeks ago and that form has held up well. "He finished about a length from the winner, Wisdom Of Water, and not far from the runner-up Conceited in that race," Sears continued. "Those horses finished fourth and third in the Magic Millions Classic last week so it is a good guide."

Kalik defies his pedigree

In-form Kalik (Champions Gallery) may be bred to be a stayer, but the gelding heads to Eagle Farm today attempting to make it four wins from his past five starts over sprint distances in the TAB Three-Year-Old QTIS Handicap. "It goes to show that sometimes bloodlines aren't always a guide to what distances a horse will handle," owner/breeder Neville Bell said. "He is perfectly drawn in barrier two so there should be no excuses. Kalik is still maturing so the winter stakes races might not be a total daydream."

Button hoping for change of luck

Trainer Tom Button is hoping for a change of luck at Eagle Farm today where Miss Lot Won (Sidereus) chases her first city win in the QTIS Two-Year-Old Handicap (1000m). Button claimed his first metropolitan winner with The Tax Accountant (Love Conquers All) at Doomben in August. The former leading trainer in central Queensland, who is now based at Caloundra, has trained 11 winners this season but another Saturday metropolitan victory has eluded him. Miss Lot Won has been typical of Button's luck as she has raced well against some of the best two-year-olds without winning. At her last start Miss Lot Won was third to eventual Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) winner Away Game (Snitzel) in the Calaway Gal Stakes (Listed, 1110m) at Doomben on December 18. "She also has form around Dusty Tycoon who has been one of the best early season two-year-olds in Brisbane," Button said.

Orman to ride Niccanova in cup

In-form jockey James Orman is clear to maintain his association with Niccanova (Nicconi) in the Sunshine Coast Cup (Listed, 1400m) next Saturday, despite being suspended for six days at Doomben on Thursday, after pleading guilty to causing interference on Mountbatten (Manhattan Rain) near the line. The stewards agreed to defer the suspension until midnight on Saturday week meaning Orman can ride at the Sunshine Coast Cup meeting that day.

Aquis Jewel aim for Master Jamie

Trainer Graeme Green is hopeful his talented three-year-old Master Jamie (Poet's Voice) can overcome his barrier woes in the QTIS Three-Year-Old Handicap (1200m) at Eagle Farm today and earn himself a shot at the \$300,000 QTIS Jewel (1200m) at the Gold Coast in March. "If he doesn't miss the start, he'll be very competitive," Green said. "He missed the start a few times in his nine wins back home but he can't afford to do that in Brisbane. We think we found the key to him when we had a barrier attendant hold his tail when he won his last two races in Rockhampton and I'll have his tail held again."

Winning debut for \$1.6 million colt

Ciaran Maher and David Eustace's incredible record with two-year-olds this season continued at Canterbury last night when Prague (Redoute's Choice) won the Canterbury League Club Maiden Handicap (1200m) by a comfortable margin of two lengths. By champion sire Redoute's Choice (Danehill) out of Purely Spectacular (Pins), the colt was purchased for \$1.6 million from the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. He is a half-brother to dual-Group 1 winner Stratum Star (Stratum) and is from the family of Karaka Million (RL, 1200m) placegetter Raid (Pins).

Marnix impresses at Geelong

The James Cummings-trained Marnix (Written Tycoon) produced an impressive performance on debut to win the Connect Tel Maiden 2YO Plate (1250m) by a length and a half at Geelong yesterday. "He has a great attitude," winning jockey Brad Rawiller told Racing.com. "It's always a concern when you draw the outside on these babies, especially with this wind. James (Cummings) was terrific and pretty much gave me an open book to ride him how the race turned out. He travelled up nicely and gave me a strong feel before the turn but with his turn of foot he put them away a little too soon. He's got a lot of upside. He was a little bit stubborn loading into the gates, but he has a great attitude for a bull and he is only going to improve."

Flemington set to proceed

The Kensington Stakes meeting at Flemington looks set to go ahead today after racing officials received a positive update regarding the forecast smoke haze and air quality levels in Victoria. Three race meetings in the state were abandoned earlier this week, Werribee on Tuesday and Yarra Valley and Caulfield on Wednesday, because of smoke haze and a forecast for hazardous air quality as a result of bushfires affecting parts of Victoria and NSW. Smoke haze had again been predicted for Melbourne on Saturday, putting the Flemington meeting in doubt. Following the release on Friday of an improved forecast, Racing Victoria officials said the meeting would

proceed. Saturday's other Victorian programs at Camperdown and Woolamai have also been given the all-clear.

Heavy track likely for Rosehill

Australian Turf Club track manager Nevesh Ramdhani is predicting the Rosehill surface to tip into the heavy range with continuing rain forecast for Sydney. Rosehill was rated a slow seven yesterday morning but Ramdhani expected it to be even wetter come race day. "I think that's going to change given the way the rain has set in in Sydney," Ramdhani said. "The Bureau (of Meteorology) is forecasting anything between 20 and 45 mils of rain. It's a little bit hard to determine exactly where we will be rated but I can tell you for sure it will be a heavy track tomorrow."

Spend back to make presence felt

Team Hawkes may have unearthed their next stable star after an impressive jump-out performance by the \$1.55 million Spend (Snitzel) at Flemington yesterday. "With a bit of luck, the normal Joe-blow punter will know who Spend is come the end of the autumn," Wayne Hawkes told Racing.com. "He just had an easy look around just to get him on his Melbourne leg. He's been here before but he's never raced (in Melbourne) before so he had an easy jump-out and he strolled up quite nicely." Spend had one start for one win in July and Hawkes believes he has come back a better horse "He's a full matured horse now. Even though he's only had the one start, he's not race mature but he's mature in the head and body-wise, he's a great looking colt as all expensive colts generally are. He's just furnished into a lovely horse."

Two racehorses dead, investigators find

The Queensland Racing Integrity Commission (QRIC) has confirmed a registered racehorse has died and another has been euthanised after investigations at a property near Brisbane. QRIC boss Ross Barnett said another two horses were found to be in a serious condition after a visit by Integrity officers to the property at Pimpama between Brisbane and the Gold Coast. Barnett said QRIC had also issued an animal welfare direction to the owners of two currently registered thoroughbred racehorses found in various stages of neglect at the property. He said officers attended the property earlier this week after the case was referred from the RSPCA. "Two horses remain in a serious condition and arrangements are in place for their care," Barnett said. "Whenever the commission receives an animal welfare report, the response is swift and in this case it was immediate."

Zechner to make Australia home

South African jockey Karl Zechner is set to try his luck in Australian racing as he begins riding trackwork in South Australia from next week. "We had been contemplating moving to Australia with our young family for some time," Zechner told Racing.com. "The decision was completed after my wife, with my young son, were held up at gunpoint on a highway at home around Christmas time. After such a traumatic event I immediately got the ball rolling for my PR Visa and part of the criteria with that will see me based here in South Australia for at least two years." Chairman of Stewards in South Australia, Johann Petzer, said Zechner had completed the necessary paperwork and was right to start riding in races immediately once opportunities presented themselves.

NEW ZEALAND

Cambridge quartet after Trentham features

Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman head to Wellington today with good chances in three feature races at Trentham. Mongolian Marshal (High Chaparral) heads their team when he contests the Thorndon Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) off

the back of a fourth place in the Zabeel Classic (Gr 1, 2000m) and Forsman said: "He takes a good formline into the race, albeit he has been racing in very good company and hasn't won for a little while, but I think the conditions of the race suit, it's just the niggly barrier draw (12)." Stablemate Artiste (Mastercraftsman) contests the Wellington Cup (Gr 3, 3200m) and Forsman said of her chance: "She is in very good form, but whether she can relax and run the two miles out, that will be the query with her. She is well-weighted and on ability, I think she is up to beating most of those horses." The stable will also have two representatives in the Desert Gold Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) in the shape of Showbeel (Savabeel) and Selenelion (Charm Spirit).

Elliot hoping right run for Wood

Trainer Leanne Elliot is looking forward to seeing the consistent Rock On Wood (Redwood) take his chance in the Thorndon Mile. The five-year-old has six wins and two placings from 11 starts, including victory in the Anzac Mile (Listed, 1600m) and a last-start runner-up performance in the Manawatu Challenge Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m). "There are good horses in the race and they all deserve to be there, I think it is just going to come down to the run on the day and hopefully he gets the gaps and he can run on," said Elliot whose son Ryan will be on board. "Family is a big thing and I am glad to have Ryan there, I am so pleased for him to want to ride him. He loves it."

Loire right for Desert Gold

Group 1-winning filly Loire (Redoute's Choice) will attempt to add further black-type to her record when she lines-up in the Desert Gold Stakes at Trentham. The New Zealand 1000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner impressed her trainer Tony Pike with her recent 1200 metre trial victory at Cambridge. "You can't fault her trial at Cambridge last week, it was superb," he said. "Not many make up that much ground in the last furlong on the bridle at Cambridge. She is in great shape and I am looking forward to getting her back to the races. It should be a very good race. Jennifer Eccles won very well at Ellerslie and it's a nice group of three-year-old fillies this year."

Beel secures Millions berth

Te Akau Racing's quest to win next week's Karaka 2YO Million (RL, 1200m) for the fourth successive year was bolstered considerably yesterday when Cool Aza Beel (Savabeel) ensured his place in the field with a dominant victory at Tauranga. The Jamie Richards-trained colt had no problems in defeating his rivals in the Matamata Veterinary Services 2YO (1200m) coming home three lengths clear. "We're on track," a relieved Richards said. "He's a pretty important horse for us so it was good to see him do that. I thought he did it nicely and physically he has still got a bit of improvement in him for eight days' time. We think he is good enough to be competitive so the next eight days are going to be very important, but he is the sort of horse that can handle what we need to give to him to get him there."

Jennings to stick with Luvaluva

Koby Jennings will attempt to make it three wins from as many rides on Luvaluva (Mastercraftsman) after it was decided he would keep the ride on the in-form mare when she travels to Te Rapa to contest the Herbie Dyke Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) on February 8. Jennings rode his first Group winner when partnering the John Sargent-trained filly to a near three-length success in the Summer Cup (Gr 3, 2000m) at Randwick on Boxing Day and the pair were victorious at the same track in last week's January Cup (Listed, 2000m).

Asano to stay loyal to the South

In-form apprentice Kozzi Asano will be looking to add to his tally today after deciding to shun Trentham's premier meeting in favour of taking a book of eight rides at Gore including Kilowatt (Shocking) in the Gore Cup (2000m) and Lightning Jack (Per Incanto) in the Gore Guineas (Listed, 1335m). "I decided to ride at Gore and stick to the trainers who put me on a lot," he said. "Kilowatt has got a nice draw (4) but I think he is better with a bit of cover, so I don't want to rush him. We will see how the race is going. Lightning Jack is a genuine horse with really good strength. The trainers (Kelvin and Aimee Tyler) have told me he has been working well, so I am looking forward to it."

Kolding's breeders to have strong Karaka draft

Wentwood Grange are set to once again send a strong draft to the 2020 New Zealand Bloodstock National Yearling Sale with their 35 yearlings at Karaka 2020 in the Book 1 session featuring a colt from the final Australian crop of former Darley shuttler Teofilo (Galileo). Catalogued as **Lot 658**, the Teofilo colt out of Hy Fuji (Fuji Kyseki) is a full-brother to the Doncaster Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Kermadec. "This colt is from the last Australian crop of Teofilo, and he's a colt we're very excited to be selling," Wentwood Grange co-owner Dean Hawkins said. "He's a very nice-moving colt and there's a lot to like about him." Other stallions featuring in the draft include proven stars such as Savabeel (Zabeel), Iffraaj (Zafonic) and Dundee (High Chaparral) as well as Tavistock (Montjeu), Per Incanto (Street Cry), and Darci Brahma (Danehill).

Bridson leaves Cambridge Stud

Angelique Bridson, Cambridge Stud's marketing manager for the past two years, has resigned. Bridson confirmed yesterday that she was leaving the Brendan and Jo Lindsay-owned operation, with head of sales and operations Scott Calder filling the void for the immediate future. "After two years as head of marketing, Angelique Bridson is leaving Cambridge Stud to pursue other options," Cambridge Stud chief executive Henry Plumptre said. "Ange has overseen the transition of Cambridge from January 2018 to the entity it is today, changing its handwriting to reflect a new era but preserving the great tradition of the property.

We wish her the very best in her new venture and thank her for the dedication and expertise that she brought to her role at Cambridge."

Tough field for Clock to Beat in Centenary Cup

Hong Kong Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Beat The Clock (Hinchinbrook) will face tough opposition when he attempts to win tomorrow's Centenary Sprint Cup (Gr 1, 1200m) at Sha Tin for the second consecutive year with Joao Moreira believing the John Size-trained speedster's biggest threat could be his stablemate Full Of Beauty (Darci Brahma). "Full Of Beauty was a bit unlucky last time," Moreira said. "It looks like something happened in the gate, he's done that before and he finished very close. So if he's able to do things a little bit more proper he might be the one to beat."

Moreira confident in Waikuku in Stewards' Cup

Joao Moreira also takes the ride on up-and-coming miler Waikuku (Harbour Watch) in the Stewards' Cup (Gr 1, 1600m) who he believes has a great chance of getting the better of local star Beauty Generation (Road To Rock). "Form-wise, Waikuku is probably at the top of the board," Moreira said. "Beauty Generation, for the last two seasons, has been the best horse in town and he deserves that reputation for what he's done and we've still got to show him some respect, but I'm happy to stick with my bloke. He deserves a Group 1. He's done enough to have that reputation and I really believe it's just a matter of time and it's likely to be this time. If it's not, I have no doubt that he's going to win a

Group 1 because he seems to be classy enough to be winning those types of races."

Magic Lily win brings up New Approach's Fifty

Darley sire New Approach (Galileo) reached his half century of stakes winners when the Charlie Appleby-trained Magic Lily (5 m ex Dancing Rain by Danehill Dancer) came out on top in a thrilling finish to the Cape Verdi (Gr 2, 1600m) at Meydan on Thursday. The lightly-raced mare edged out the promising Nisreen (Raven's Pass) by a short head with a further two and a half lengths back to the winner's stablemate Beyond Reason (Australia) in third. Magic Lily, who finished third in the Fillies' Mile (Gr 1, 1m) having won by eight lengths on debut, is out of Oaks (Gr 1, 1m 4f) winner Dancing Rain (Danehill Dancer). Her full-brother Jalmoud was third in last year's Grand Prix de Paris (Gr 1, 2400m), New Approach stands at Dalham Hall Stud in Newmarket for £30,000 (inc GST).


Certain Lad posts surprise win


Certain Lad (4 g Clodovil ex Chelsey Jane by Galileo) belied his 33-1 odds when he ran out a comfortable winner of the Zabeel Turf (Listed, 2000m) at Meydan on Thursday. After breaking slowly, the Mick Channon-trained four-year-old made smooth progress to get the better of runner-up Simsir (Zoffany) by three-quarters of a length with the same distance back to the third home, Desert Fire (Cape Cross). The win was a second at stakes level for the son of Clodovil (Danehill), and a sixth in total from 18 starts.

Bjorn Nielsen takes interest in headline-making colt at Cape Premier Sale

A recognisable buying combination returned to a familiar theme at the Cape Premier Yearling Sale as Nic Jonsson and Stradivarius's (Sea The Stars) owner Bjorn Nielsen were responsible for the R3 million (A\$302,000) top lot of the one-day event.

The Silvano (Lomitas) colt, provisionally named I Want It All, was seemingly held in high regard by his breeders at Drakenstein Stud, and such high-rolling will surely fuel the interest whenever his two-year-old half-sister, now rechristened Orange Bowl (Duke Of Marmalade), makes her debut for the Justin Snaith stable. She was picked up for R3.2m here 12 months ago.

The pair are the first and second foals of Giant's Causeway's (Storm Cat) Song Of Happiness, a minor winner in South Africa who is out of the Group 1-winning mare Captain's Lover (Captain Al).

Jonsson, whose family has established a global company producing uniforms and workwear, is continuing a dynasty of ownership by his forefathers which stretches back well over a century. He is a partner in Snaith's Do It Again (Twice Over), last year's South African champion who landed the Durban July (Gr 1, 2200m) among a slew of big-race wins but has not looked on his A-game so far this term.

Nielsen, meanwhile, is a more recent arrival within the Snaith yard and had a first runner in his black and yellow silks at Kenilworth last Friday.

"I've bought him with my friend Bjorn Nielsen, we bought the sister by Duke Of Marmalade here last year and she looks as if she might be quite special," Jonsson said.

"We thought we might have to pay more for him, so we're quite happy. It's not a pedigree we see very often in South Africa, that Giant's Causeway-Storm Cat cross, and I did think he was the best of the sale."

Skiffington backs new boy Rafeef

Amanda Skiffington and her client Fiona Carmichael have been regular visitors to this sale and they paid enormous faith in the progeny of Rafeef (Redoute's Choice), a Group 1-winning sprinter for Mike De Kock, whose first crop from Ridgemont Highlands were being offered.

A colt out of the Encosta De Lago (Fairy King) mare Aneefa was substantially the most

expensive of a trio that Skiffington had signed for when bidding concluded at R2.2 million (A\$221,700).

"We've had some luck with first-crop sires before and after going through a lot of horses, we thought he was the best colt. He wasn't cheap, though!" said the agent, who confirmed that the youngster would be going into training with Cape Town-based Brett Crawford.

That price was equalled later in the session by the Gimmethgreenlight (More Than Ready) half-brother to last weekend's Queen's Plate (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Vardy (Var), offered by Klawervlei Stud.

It only became apparent afterwards that a bidding war was developing between two different partners in Adam Marcus's new star colt, with the stakes being raised by a table containing Bernard Kantor, and another with agent Christopher Santos, who was bidding on behalf of Jimmy Sarkis.

Santos, who appeared rather overwhelmed to have won the tussle, said: "I only got a late call about him, as Jimmy Sarkis owns some of

Vardy and, I believe, some of the mare. He was a strong colt and after Vardy did what he did, I knew that he would be popular."

It seems most likely that Marcus will receive the young sibling.

There was also some international interest from another jurisdiction through sustained bidding for Avontuur Thoroughbreds' Trippi (End Sweep) filly, who is a half-sister to Miss Frankel (Frankel), the first of the Juddmonte superstar's progeny to appear - and win - in this country.

She was picked up for R1.65m (A\$166,200) by New Zealand-based Ric Wylie, along with an earlier R600,000 (A\$60,200) for a Visionaire (Grand Slam) filly who traced back to wonderful Australian producer Barkada (Spectrum).

"They've been bought for Australia but they'll be going the long way, with a quiet summer in England being broken in," Wylie said. "It was my client's idea to try to buy some fillies here, and they were two of our best five."

Slow progress

That the session-topping colt cost less than his female half-sister was a fair indication at the half-way stage that trade was fairly slow.

It had taken until lot 37 for the seven-figure barrier to be broken with the offering of Avontuur's Live My Life, a daughter of Gimmethegreenlight

whose third dam is Susurrattion (Erins Isle), a smart miler for John Gosden. She finished second to Selkirk (Sharpen Up) in Listed company at Kempton and won the Prix Perth (Gr 3, 1600m) back in 1991.

After reaching a figure of R1.1m (A\$110,300) the filly was knocked down to Derek Brugman, who signed the docket under Silver Ripples (Pty) Ltd for an undisclosed client and trainer.

"I thought she was one of the best three or fillies in the sale, a bit of a standout," Brugman said. "Gimmethegreenlight is now stepping up behind some of our captains of industry, like Dynasty and Silvano, and hopefully she has a nice future."

The final figures would make sombre reading for most vendors, particularly as they had spiralled downwards in the preceding year. There were only five seven-figure lots and turnover was recorded at R56,490,000 (A\$5,673,300) which was down 32 per cent year-on-year.

The average slipped to R326,531 (A\$32,700), a decrease by 25 per cent. The median dropped 16.66 per cent to R250,000 (A\$25,100) while 173 of the 216 lots sold at a clearance rate of 80 per cent.

CTS chief executive Wehann Smith said: "The figures are obviously disappointing but we knew we were operating in a tough economic environment at the moment.

"It's a huge positive that there was some new international money and there was still a R3m top lot. We'll just have to revisit our approach, and see what we have to do to make things work."
