Owner-breeder Godolphin, trainer Anthony Freedman and jockey Luke Currie may be poised to repeat the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) success they achieved last year with Lyre (Lonhro) after their Street Boss (Street Cry) colt Hanseatic was an

emphatic winner of yesterday's Blue Diamond Preview (C&G) (Listed, 1000m) at Caulfield.

However, the royal blue-adorned colt - one of only three Godolphin youngsters entrusted to Freedman this season - was not the only juvenile to stake a claim for next month's Blue Diamond on an afternoon which had no shortage of juvenile news plus highlights aplenty from Ellerslie in New Zealand. *Continued on page 2>>*

Starting with a bang: the star attractions on day one at Karaka

Buyers will have precious little time to assess the tone of the day, and the sale overall, as the first half-hour sees the current king of Karaka, Savabeel (Zabeel), represented by Lots 8 and 11.

Lot 8 is from six times winner Kaleidoscope (Pins), a half-sister to the dam of the brilliant Xtravagant (Pentire).

Lot 11 is from an O'Reilly (Last Tycoon) half-sister to three Group winners, including Avondale Cup (Gr1, 2200m) scorer Sharvasti (Montjeu). *Sales News page 12>>*

The juvenile competition began with the opening race at Randwick, the \$2m Inglis Millennium in 14 days Handicap (1000m).

Peter and Paul Snowden landed the spoils with Rulership, a son of I Am Invincible (Invincible Spirit) who realised \$900,000 at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale last year. The training duo also saddled Mount Fuji (Snitzel) - who topped the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale when being knocked down for \$2.8 million - to finish an inauspicious last of nine, trailing home 13.4 lengths in arrears.

The two-year-old action continued with Hanseatic's outstanding win from the outside barrier before A Beautiful Night, who is also by a Darley stallion in former shuttler Night Of Thunder (Dubawi), enhanced Ciaron Maher and David Eustace's stellar two-year-old season when she denied the Snowdens' Fresh (Fastnet Rock) in the Blue Diamond Preview (F) (Gr 3, 1000m).

The Caulfield training partnership won the Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) with Away Game (Snitzel) two weeks ago and last Saturday produced the now Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) favourite Cellsabeel (Hinchinbrook) for an impressive win at Rosehill.

Yesterday's three winners, along with runner-up Fresh, each garnered a positive market reaction in Victoria's premier two-year-old race. Hanseatic is now a pronounced \$4 favourite, firming from \$9 yesterday morning, ahead of Fresh (\$15 into \$8), while A Beautiful Night was cut from \$51 into \$11 and Rulership \$15 into \$11.

A Beautiful Night ran a marginally quicker time than Hanseatic, but it was the Freedman-trained colt who was visually more impressive at Caulfield.

Rawiller purrs over Rulership

Meanwhile in Sydney, jockey Nash Rawiller's enthusiasm for Rulership suggests the visitor should not be underestimated.

"You could tell going to the gates that he's a lovely colt," Rawiller said.

"One (horse) went past me out of control and he never turned a hair - he just stayed in a slow canter.

"He was electric out of the gates, got across comfortably and then saved himself for the business end. It's early days, but you can only go on what you feel, and it's been a while since one had excited me like that."



Rulership

Co-trainer Paul Snowden described Rulership as a "professional" while lamenting that Mount Fuji simply pulled too hard.

"He's savvy - he knows what he's doing," Snowden said of Rulership.

"But the other horse (Mount Fuji) pulled himself into the ground the whole race and showed the effect of not relaxing well enough to finish off, which was totally opposite to what he's been doing in his trials."

Yarraman Park sold Rulership (2 c I Am Invincible - Devoirs by Dehere) on the Gold Coast and he was knocked down to Newgate Farm, Stonestreet Stables and China Horse Club.

He is one of five named foals, all of whom have raced and three of whom have won out of the Listed winner Devoirs (Dehere). His second dam is the Group 2 winner Velasco (Flying Spur).

Currie also sweet on Hanseatic

Luke Currie, like Rawiller, was taken with the performance of Hanseatic as the talented juvenile scored his second win from as many starts.

"He's pretty smart. He didn't have the best of the runs, I had to drag back to find some cover and never really found it," Currie said.

"I was worried he might not come off the bend and quicken as he's showed me a couple of times he can take a little time to pick up, but I picked up the bridle in his mouth and he put them away in ten strides. *Continued on page 4>>*

<< *Continued from page 2* "He's definitely a Diamond colt. My only concern was that he played up a bit at the gates and got a bit hot, but now he's had this run under his belt now and Anthony (Freedman) knows what to do with them."

Freedman indicated he would look for further experience with Hanseatic.

"Obviously going forward you want to see a performance like that, to win in that empathic away," Freedman said.

"He'll improve off today as he was a bit fresh and I'll probably run him again in two weeks time. I think this colt might need the racing and getting used to the raceday routine."

Both Blue Diamond Preludes are run on February 8.

Hanseatic (2 c Street Boss - Itameri by Exceed and Excel) is the third foal and second winner out of Itameri (Exceed And Excel), who was purchased by Darley for \$300,000 as a yearling in 2012.

Itameri is out of the Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr Prospector) mare Baltics, who is a half-sister to Magnus (Flying Spur) and Helsing (Desert Sun), the dam of Black Caviar (Bel Esprit) and All Too Hard (Casino Prince).

Night to trial again before Blue Diamond



A Beautiful Night

A Beautiful Night was bred by part-owners the Mustafa family and the Diamond-bound filly was the first Australian winner for Night Of Thunder when she won at Flemington on New Year's day.

Winning jockey John Allen said: "It wasn't the plan to lead but she began well and got to the fence easily enough.

"She's improved every run and hopefully can keep doing that over the next few weeks.

"She's honest, she tries hard and you'd imagine she'd be better over further. I thought the 1000 (metres) might be a little sharp for her."

Co-trainer David Eustace said: "We were quite confident, we thought she'd been underestimated.

"We wanted her to be midfield but she pinged the lids and John (Allen) rated her beautifully.

"She'll have another run, she handles her racing very well...and I'm really pleased for the owners who bred her."

A Beautiful Night (2 f Night of Thunder - Lindyhop by Gonski) finished runner-up on her debut at Bendigo and has won her last two starts, accruing prize-money of \$212,450.

She is from the family of Group 2 winner Classy Fella (Kenmare) and Group 1 scorer Bonaria (Redoute's Choice), with her third dam being the Group 2 winner Twirled (Turf Ruler).

Australia-bound Catalyst back with a bang

Meanwhile at Ellerslie, exciting Australia-bound three-year-old Catalyst (Darci Brahma) stole the show with a last-to-first win in the \$70,000 Mr Tiz Trophy (Gr 3, 1200m).

His performance arguably upstaged the much richer \$1 million Karaka Million contests, although not in the eyes of trainer Jamie Richards and jockey Opie Bosson, who combined to win both.

Jockey Troy Harris was happy to bide his time on Catalyst, who began slowly before claiming his sixth win from seven starts. The son of Darci Brahma (Danehill), whose only defeat was on debut, is nominated for the Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and the All-Star Mile (1600m).

"He makes it easy riding a horse like this," Harris said.

"It's an unreal feeling - you can put him anywhere and he just wins. I didn't panic, they were licking along all the way and I was confident he'd pick them up.

"He had a decent blow and I'd say there's a couple of lengths improvement in him."

<< *Continued from page 4* Looking ahead, Harris added: "It's more excitement than pressure riding him and now we go to Aussie and take them on and everyone should vote for him in the All-Star Mile."

Trainer Clayton Chipperfield was less confident in the run than the winning rider.

"It was heart stopping," Chipperfield said. "At the 600-metre mark he was last and the amount of ground he made up in such a short amount of time is unbelievable.

"He'll take plenty of improvement from this - he needed this run today."

Regarding future plans, Chipperfield added: "We'll put the hood back on because he can't be falling out of the gates in Australia if he's going to be competitive over there. We'll give them a fright!"

Owner-breeder Dick Karreman echoed Chipperfield's thoughts.

"I was a bit worried for quite some time until the home straight," he said.

"He is a serious, serious horse, but you can't afford to miss the start in better races.

"This is like the Seachange days," Karreman added in reference to his multiple Group 1-winning Cape Cross (Green Desert) mare.

Catalyst (3 c Darci Brahma - Evana by Entrepreneur) is one of eight named foals, all of whom have raced and six of whom have won out of the three-time winner Evana (Entrepreneur). He has now won NZ\$476,350 in prize-money.

Boasting a high-class female line, Catalyst's second dam, Miss Trump (Last Tycoon), is a half-sister to Australian Horse of the Year, champion three-year-old and champion sire Lonhro (Octagonal) as well as his Group 1-winning brother Niello.

Te Akau continue Millions dominance

Te Akau Racing, trainer Richards and jockey Bosson claimed the Karaka Million 2YO (RL, 1200m) for the fourth year running when Savabeel (Zabeel) colt Cool Aza Beel scored by a decisive length and a half.

He proved too strong for red-hot \$1.60 favourite Play That Song (Showcasing), who was ridden by James McDonald, while Taroni (Showcasing) finished a further neck away in third, with the front three pulling well clear.

The colt was purchased by Te Akau principal David Ellis for NZ\$150,000 from the Fairdale Stud draft at last year's New Zealand Bloodstock National Yearling Sale.

The team previously won the race with Melody Belle (Commands) in 2017, Avantage (Fastnet Rock) in 2018 and Probabeel (Savabeel) last year (Richards in partnership with Stephen Autridge for the first two).

"It's awesome. It's a really great way to start the biggest week of the year for us," Richards said in relation to the NZB National Yearling Sale, which gets underway at Karaka today.



Cool Aza Beel

"Whether we can make it five in a row I'm not sure, but I'd like to think so. We're definitely going to be out there in force at Karaka over the next few days, looking for more horses like this."

Cool Aza Beel (2 c Savabeel - Cool 'N' Sassy by Testa Rossa) has won three of his four starts for prize-money of NZ\$573,560.

He is the only named foal out of three-time winner Cool 'N' Sassy (Testa Rossa), while this is the family of Group 1 winners Malaguerra (Magnus), Aloha (Encosta De Lago) and Seabrook (Hinchinbrook).

Later on the card, Probabeel returned to contest the Karaka Million 3YO Classic (RL, 1600m) and became the first horse to win both races in successive years.

Returning the \$1.60 favourite, she got the better of another McDonald-ridden runner-up in Conqueror (Fastnet Rock) by a length and a half, while Hasstobegood (Per Incanto) was a further two and a half lengths back in third.

Probabeel was sold to Ellis for NZ\$380,000 at the Karaka sale in 2018 and later bought outright by Cambridge Stud owners Brendan and Jo Lindsay.

"There was a bit of pressure coming into today, and I was pretty keen just to get through it," Richards said.

"But full credit to everyone - it was a big team effort and a great result. Now we're really looking forward to getting her back over to Australia, more than likely for the Surround Stakes."

"What a day, what a horse," Brendan Lindsay added. "She's the first horse to ever do this, and I think it'll be a long time before anyone else does it again."

Probabeel (3 f Savabeel - Far Fetched, by Pins) has won five of her 11 starts, running second on a further three occasions, for prize-money of \$1,237,256.

The first foal out of stakes performer Far Fetched (Pins), Probabeel is from the same family as Group 2 scorer Ocean Emperor (Zabeel) and dual Group 1 winner Savvy Coup (Savabeel), who was crowned New Zealand's champion three-year-old in 2017-18.

Nine for Night Of Thunder



Night Of Thunder

Former Darley shuttler Night Of Thunder (Dubawi) sired his ninth stakes winner - and first in Australia - when A Beautiful Night (2 f ex Lindyhop by Gonski) secured the Blue Diamond Preview (F) (Gr 3, 1000m) at Caulfield yesterday. The Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained juvenile proved half a length to strong for the Peter and Paul Snowden-trained Fresh (Fastnet Rock), with Unstoppabelle (I Am Invincible), who is a stable companion of the winner, finishing a further length and a half back in third. Night Of Thunder shuttled to Australia

for one season, covering 96 mares in 2016, and he made an explosive impact with his first crop of European juveniles in 2019, including Italian Group 2 winner Night Colours.

Second Listed success for Morvada

The Peter Jolly-trained Morvada (6 g Mossman - Carnegie Minstrel by Carnegie) reversed his last-start Flemington form with Yulong January (King Of Prussia) when bagging a second success at Listed level in yesterday's John Dillon Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Caulfield. Morvada finished a long neck behind Yulong January in their New Year's Day clash over 1400 metres, but he came home half a length to the good of his old rival yesterday, with Streets Of Avalon (Magnus) a further length away in third. "I just couldn't work out why he wasn't fancied more," Jolly said of his \$10 chance. "He led all the way last start and Yulong January beat him by a long head. It didn't worry me but I've been very confident. I've worked out how to train him now too. He needs a bit of time between runs and we keep him fresh." Jolly will consider upcoming options but said Morvada was likely

to head home for a break before turning his attention to the Adelaide carnival in May.

Stakes company beckons for Caulfield winner Score

A tilt at stakes company beckons for the John Sadler-trained Score (Written Tycoon) after she made it back-to-back successes with a one-length win in the Bass Strait Beef Handicap (1100m) at Caulfield. "You've got to remember that the top-rated horse in today's race was only rated 69, so it probably wasn't a genuine 78 race," Sadler said. "But with a filly like this obviously you're looking for black-type down the track. So we'll just head her in that direction and hopefully she can get it as a three-year-old." Sadler attributed the improvement shown by the filly to an upturn in her temperament. "In the latter half of her two-year-old career it looked like she might go the wrong way," Sadler said. "But she had a good spell and this time she's totally different. She has gone the right way and to just look at her out the back of the field today she was just flowing like a staying filly, not that I think she actually is. I just loved the way she quickened today."

12 for West Quest

Cradle Mountain (6 g ex From Japan by Jungle Pocket) landed yesterday's Carrington Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Randwick to provide West Quest (Gone West) with his 12th stakes winner. Cellarman (Mossman) finished second, beaten a length and a quarter, while Gaulois (Street Cry) was a further short-head back in third. The victory was a landmark one for trainer Clare Cunningham, who was gaining her first stakes winner. "It's my first black-type win. I wanted to achieve it last year but we didn't get to do it, so it's great to do it early this year anyway," Cunningham said. "We've always thought he had the ability to do this and was knocking on the door a couple of times last prep. It was a character building prep and last start was quite deflating. I thought I had him in really good order but he is just a horse that needs to be ridden the way he got ridden today and we got to see him win again." Cunningham will consider starting Cradle Mountain next in the Apollo Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) back at Randwick on February 15.

Pandemic impresses in first-up win

James Cummings could not hide his admiration for Pandemic (Sepoy) after the three-year-old made a successful return in the Mark Alt Bookmakers Handicap (1100m) at Randwick yesterday. Now the winner of three of his five starts, Pandemic was given an ice-cool ride by Tommy Berry when negotiating traffic prior to posting a half-length success. "Tommy had him in splendid isolation," Cummings said. "I love the fact he didn't panic and try to use the inside barrier on the horse that clearly enjoys being left alone early, and he's got the acceleration to put himself into that race so quickly. He's got a lot of ability this horse." Regarding future

plans, Cummings added: "He has just won a benchmark race in January so I don't want to put the cart before the horse. He is going to race through his grades really quickly if he keeps demonstrating that sort of x-factor, but they don't get any easier from here on in."

Successful Australian debut for import Mugatoo

Kris Lees and syndicators Australian Bloodstock appear to have unearthed another promising import in the shape of Mugatoo (Henrythenavigator), who made a successful debut in Australia when securing a neck success in the Coopers Hotel Newtown Handicap (1600m) at Randwick yesterday. The son of Henrythenavigator (Kingmambo) was previously trained in Britain by David Simcock, winning in minor company at Lingfield and Doncaster. "Australian Bloodstock have done it again, they've found another one," stable representative Cameron Swan said. "He came to us as a horse that got over a bit of ground, 2400 (metres) plus. In his track work, he has just been so sharp, and in his trial he looked really good, so Kris elected to start him over the 1600 (metres), which is a good starting point, and it all worked out."

Highways lead to Country Championships

The Stephen Jones-trained Mr Wong (Mossman) and Aiden St Vincent's Hellenism (Helmet), who landed the TAB Highway Handicap (1100m) and the Sky Racing Active Highway Handicap (1100m) respectively at Randwick yesterday, will both be pointed towards the Country Championships Final (1400m) back at the same track in April. Mr Wong will now head to the Country Championships qualifying heat at Tamworth on March 8, while Hellenism is set to step up to 1400 metres in another qualifying heat at Coffs Harbour on February 15. "He's always shown ability. We picked out the Country Championships but I've always thought he is a black-type horse at least," Jones said of Mr Wong. "I have always thought a lot of this horse and he is a gem to train."

96 for Snitzel

Arrowfield Stud resident Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) sired his 96th stakes winner yesterday

when Scallopini (5 g ex Rose Of Mulan by More Than Ready) got up by a neck to land the Sunshine Coast Cup (Listed, 1400m) at the Sunshine Coast. Niccanova (Nicconi) ran second, while Persuader (Zoustar) finished the same margin adrift in third. The Steven O'Dea-trained winner, who has now won eight of his 20 starts, is finished for the time being. "He can go for a spell now and we will look at the winter carnival where hopefully he will take another step," stable foreman Matt Hoysted said. "Races like the BRC Sprint could suit him. But who knows, he might even get to something better." Meanwhile, Snitzel stood for a fee of \$220,000 (inc GST) in 2019.

Grey Missile breaks metropolitan maiden

Also at the Sunshine Coast, Grey Missile (Red Element) made a successful stable debut for Toby and Trent Edmonds when he scooted to an easy half-length success in the Coastline BMW X5 Handicap (1200m) - his first metropolitan success. The five-year-old won nine races under the care of Roy Chillemi, who suggested a move to the Edmonds' after Grey Missile was anchored by big weights in recent North Queensland starts. "We took the blinkers off him and he trialled well without them. He has won ten races now so we will have to see exactly where we can place him," Trent Edmonds said.

Just Orm win a family affair for Gollan

Just Orm (Falvelon) won yesterday's Coastline BMW X1 Handicap (1000m) at the Sunshine Coast to provide a popular result for Tony Gollan. "My wife Jane, sister Zoe and mother-in-law Helena are in the horse so I will be popular when I get home," the winning trainer said. "I have always liked Just Orm from the day I bought him for \$45,000 at the Magic Millions Sales and has now won about \$330,000 in prize-money. I thought enough of him to run him in the Magic Millions Classic as a two-year-old and we have tried him in some handy races. But the light weight made a big difference and the fast early pace suited him today." Gollan said Just Orm was best around distances of 1000 to 1100 metres on a big track. "There isn't much for him at the moment so I might give him a break and get him back for the Queensland Lightning in the winter," he added.

Kendrick has 50,000 extra reasons to smile

The Stuart Kendrick-trained Cosmic Gossip (Spill The Beans) came from last to beat favourite Queen Kay (Zoustar) in the \$125,000 Sunshine Coast 2YO Classic Plate (1200m) yesterday and in doing so secured a \$50,000 bonus awarded to any runner that had accepted for the Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m). Kendrick thought Cosmic Gossip had an outside chance of winning the \$2 million Gold Coast feature a fortnight ago, but she was only an emergency for the race. "We took her to the Gold Coast the week before the Millions in a last-ditch chance to make the Classic field," Kendrick said. "But she never travelled and was well beaten ironically by Queen Kay. But today on her home track I was confident she would race well." Reflecting on yesterday's victory, Kendrick added: "It (the bonus) makes it a very nice payday for her and there is more to come."

Promising Torrens keeps unbeaten record

In other Sunshine Coast news, the Ethan Ensby-trained Torrens (Adelaide) made it four wins from four starts when he raced away in the straight for an easy win in the Coastal BMW 1 Series Handicap (2200m). The three-year-old is now set to contest much loftier targets. "He will have a short break now and we might even look to the Australian Derby but it might be a bit rich," Ensby said. "The Queensland Derby looks a better option. But I have said all along I can win a black type race with this horse."

Vorster breaks collarbone in Valley fall

Barend Vorster has been confirmed to have suffered a broken collarbone in his fall from the ill-fated Manuel (Commands) in the Australia Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Moonee Valley on Friday night. Vorster and Manuel came crashing to the turf in the home straight during the feature sprint and six-year-old Manuel was subsequently euthanised. Vorster was expected to be discharged from hospital yesterday.

Currie pays tribute to Manuel

Meanwhile, Luke Currie - who rode Manuel to victory in last year's CF Orr Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m)

- has paid tribute to the popular gelding. "To all the connections and staff at home, I know they are all very upset," Currie said yesterday. "He's a lovely horse and he won a Group 1 for us last year. I won the Orr on him and I was pretty sad to see what happened last night. It's one of those things. Hopefully Barend is OK. I hear this morning he's got a broken collarbone so he'll be out for a little bit. It's just sad and commiserations to everyone."

Nikolic hoax quickly exposed

The Queensland Racing Integrity Commission has quickly dismissed a hoax regarding the licensing of former jockey Danny Nikolic. Nikolic has applied for a Queensland provincial licence to ride after being banned since 2012 after a long battle with Victorian authorities, particularly over his behaviour towards then chief steward Terry Bailey. Social media sites on Friday night carried an alleged QRIC media release stating Nikolic had been given a licence. QRIC Commissioner Ross Barnett said the commission was quickly aware of the hoax and was able to refute it. "The commission monitors social media and ensures anything regarding it is correct. The so-called media release was not on our official website where all information is carried," he said. "As the commission stated last week, Nikolic's application is under consideration and there will be a decision within a fortnight." The release was issued under a QRIC home page which is no longer used.

Moody aims for return

Despite early reports suggesting the contrary, Peter Moody intends ending his four-year hiatus from training with a return likely before the end of the season. It was reported by RSN927 yesterday morning that Moody confirmed he had decided to reapply for a trainer's licence following the final yearling sale for the season in April. Moody, who has not trained since being suspended for six months on a cobalt charge in 2016, intends training from his farm in Belgrave South with boxes also to be built at Pakenham.

Second for Vespa

Wellfield Lodge resident Vespa (Elusive City) sired his second winner yesterday when the

Mel and Warwick Coles-trained Chokito (2 f ex Pretty Woman by Pins) took out the NZB Insurance Pearl Series 2YO (800m) at Riccarton. Under Her Spell (Not A Single Doubt) finished second, beaten a length and a quarter, while Impecunious (Sacred Falls) finished a further three-quarters of a length adrift in third. A Group 1 winner and champion two-year-old on the track, Vespa stood for a fee of NZ\$5,000 (plus GST) in 2019. Chokito joins Piaggio as the sire's other winner.

17 for Alamosa

On a good day for Wellfield Lodge, Vespa's barn-mate Alamosa (O'Reilly) sired his 17th stakes winner when Windsor (5 g ex Shanro by Lonhro) took out the Timaru Stakes (Listed, 1400m) at Riccarton. Monza Circuito (Showcasing) was beaten half a length into second, while Belle Fascino (Per Incanto) was a further length and a half away in third. Trainer Terri Rae said he does not have any immediate plans for the winner. "I would say he is going to be pretty tired after that as it was a massive effort," she said. "He really did all the hard work out in front as we had the blinkers on and it fired him up. He was very brave to fight the way he did as sometimes you have to question him but today, he put his all into the race. I think he can have some time off before we work out what to do with him next." Meanwhile, Alamosa stood for a fee of NZ\$5,000 (plus GST) in 2019.

97 for Savabeel

Perennial champion sire Savabeel (Zabeel) was handed another boost to his already lofty reputation when Cool Aza Beel (2 c ex Cool 'N' Sassy by Testa Rossa) landed the Karaka Million 2YO (RL, 1200m) at Ellerslie yesterday, becoming his 97th stakes winner. The Jamie Richards-trained winner proved a length and a half too strong for red-hot \$1.60 favourite Play That Song (Showcasing), who was ridden by James McDonald, while Taroni (Showcasing) finished a further neck away in third, with the front three pulling well clear. The victory completed a four-peat in the NZ\$1 million contest for Te Akau Racing, Richards and jockey Opie Bosson following the successes of Melody Belle (Commands) (2017), Avantage (Fastnet Rock) (2018) and Probabeel (Savabeel) last year.

Ida lands hat-trick in Westbury

The John and Karen Parsons-trained Kiwi Ida (5 m Squamosa - Empress Ida by Blevic) made it a hat-trick of wins, and a brace at Group 2 level, when she landed the Westbury Classic (Gr 2, 1400m) on her first outing at Ellerslie yesterday. Volpe Veloce (Foxwedge) was beaten half a length into second, while there was a further neck back to Rondinella (Ocean Park) in third. Karen Parsons was still coming to terms with the mare's achievements post-race as she looked forward to the next challenge, which will include a shot at the New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Te Aroha in April. "Unbelievable really and I did think John was biting off more than he could chew shooting for three on end as it is hard to do," she said. "It's just unbelievable what she has done for us. We have to have a go now (at the Group 1)."

Destiny fulfilled in Concord

Also at Ellerslie, the Bob and Jenny Vance-trained Its Destinys Child (6 m Castledale - It's My Destiny by Magic Ring) won the Concord Handicap (Gr

3, 1200m) to record her seventh win in 17 starts. Runner-up Molto Veloce (Pins) got within a neck, while Short Fuse (Per Incanto) finished a further half a length adrift in third. Bob Vance was delighted with the win, while he had been confident despite the mare running ninth in the Railway Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at her last start. "Her run in the Railway last time was great as she ran the third fastest last 600 metres," Vance said. "She was just too wide but she came home really well that day. Jenny rides her in all her work so I can't take any credit whatsoever for today. Like all good mares she has a little bit of a temperament but she is very good." Looking ahead, Vance added: "I'm not sure what to do next but there could be a race for her here over the Auckland Cup carnival, so we will freshen her up as she does go well fresh."

Special arrangement for Chinese New Year raceday

Following the outbreak of coronavirus, the Hong Kong Jockey Club has issued the

following statement in relation to its Chinese New Year raceday, which is scheduled for tomorrow. "The Club has decided that Chinese New Year raceday should go ahead, but with a reduced attendance and with measures in place to strengthen hygiene protection. On the day, apart from essential parties such as horse owners, trainers, jockeys, club officials and stewards etc., only those customers who already have a prior reservation at racecourse restaurants will be admitted. Patrons who wish to cancel their bookings will be given a full refund. Other racecourse facilities, such as betting halls, media halls and digital zone, will be closed. This means that approximately 8,000 customers will attend the race meeting, with these customers being distributed in 54 restaurants and boxes spread across two racecourses. According to medical experts, the level of health risk is not higher than visiting restaurants in shopping malls. All customers will receive temperature screening before entry and will be advised to wear medical masks."

Analysis: The Peter and Paul Snowden-trained colt **Rulership**, a \$900,000 purchase at the 2019 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sales, was highly impressive in winning here on debut. After beginning smartly, he went to the front and then travelled nicely at quite a good pace before dashing clear at the 200m. He then went on to score effortlessly, sprinting home his final 600m in a fast 33.61. The Gerald Ryan-trained colt **Mission River** was slowly away and after being second last early on, he recovered to race in sixth place, wide with cover and going a bit keenly. He moved up well

on straightening, went to second at the 200m and then fought on well to hold that position in a promising effort on debut. **Ticket To Ride** was ridden patiently after being caught deep and settled in second last place. She moved up deep rounding the home turn, improved well at the 200m and then kept battling on strongly for a good third in a sound first-up effort at her second race start. The Anthony Cummings-trained filly **Fayerra**, a \$81 outsider, was eased from a wide barrier, settled in last place in the ten-horse field, was widest of all at the home turn and then did very well in making good ground to finish (3.8 lengths) fourth, staging a smart effort at her second race start while **Mount Fuji**, a \$2.8m purchase at the 2019 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale, disappointed on debut. He began reasonably well, soon improved to race outside the leader, travelling too keenly, before tiring in the straight to finish last.

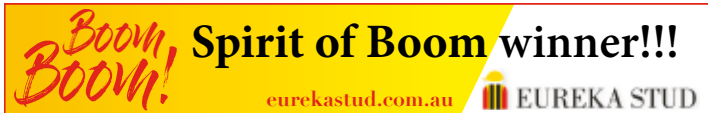

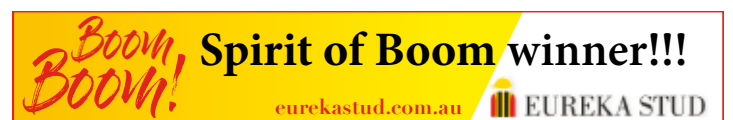

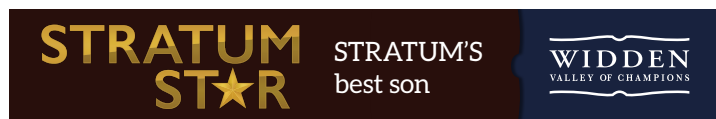
