Racing on tenterhooks as government heightens coronavirus measures

Decision on whether crowd-free meetings can continue expected to be made today



Sports across Australia are being restricted as a result of COVID-19

he Australian racing industry could be halted immediately and upcoming thoroughbred sales are in extreme doubt after federal and state governments introduced stringent new measures yesterday to try and slow the rapid spread of coronavirus, a disaster that makes the global

 $financial\ crisis\ (GFC)\ look\ like\ "a\ stroll\ in\ the\ park".$

The Premiers of NSW and Victoria, prior to last night's National Cabinet meeting, moved to a "more comprehensive shutdown" of non-essential services in response to the worsening COVID-19 pandemic, which is likely to force national sporting bodies and the state's racing industries into hibernation.

Golden glory for Ho and Lui in Hong Kong Derby

Golden Sixty (Medaglia d'Oro) triumphed in an epic HK\$20 million Hong Kong Derby (Listed, 2000m) at Sha Tin yesterday to complete a brilliant whitewash of the Four-Year-Old Classic Series.

The victory was a first in the race for jockey Vincent Ho, who ended a run of outs for local riders in the blue riband going back to 1995. This was also a first Derby for trainer Francis Lui and owner Stanley Chan, and the first time in the professional era – since 1971 – that a native Hong Kong trainer, jockey and owner combined for victory.

<< Continued from page 1 However, Prime Minister Scott Morrison, who had earlier announced a ban on non-essential travel within Australia, left the door ajar for sports such as racing to potentially continue when he listed only "indoor sporting venues" among the facilities and businesses that will be forced to close while the fight against coronavirus is ongoing.</p>

Pubs, clubs, cinemas, casinos, places of worship, nightclubs, entertainment venues, gyms and cafes and restaurants (excluding takeaway) will also be obliged to close, the PM said, with the measures to be reviewed monthly. However, he warned that he expected them to be in place for at least six months.

Racing Victoria chief executive Giles Thompson last night said the organisation would be briefed this morning to better understand state and federal government directives following the National Cabinet meeting.

He did not indicate whether he believed racing and horse training in the state could continue, which has been conducted without crowds for the past week.

"Once we are armed with all of the appropriate information and have had time to discuss it with the relevant authorities, we will then be in a position to consider it with all of our stakeholder representative groups," Thompson said in a statement.

"It is our intention to provide a comprehensive update when we have greater clarity on the immediate requirements and necessary actions of our industry. Given the unprecedented and evolving nature of this situation, we are not in a position at present to confirm an exact time as to when that update will be provided."

There is no race meeting scheduled in Victoria today but Goulburn and Murwillumbah are programmed in NSW. It was unclear last night whether they would go ahead.

While racing participants face an anxious wait, the fate of the Easter sale also hangs in the balance. Last year's sale had a turnover of more than \$123 million and played a critical role in the cash flow of the country's major stud farms and breeders.

Inglis management is expected to meet today to confirm how its Australian Easter Yearling Sale would be held, if it is at all, and what protocols are put in place if it proceeds as planned.

It is believed that the company had been considering bringing forward the auction from its scheduled April 7 and 8 dates prior to yesterday's

g o v e r n m e n t intervention, which causes further headaches for the auction house and stakeholders.



states or territories forced into 14 days of self-isolation.

The ramped up travel restrictions could impact interstate Easter sale vendors such as South Australia's Mill Park as well as New Zealand sellers Henley Park, Highden Park, Jamieson Park and Little Avondale Stud.

Fellow New Zealand vendors Lyndhurst Farm, Trelawney Stud and Waikato Stud also have drafts set to sell at Easter.

<< Continued from page 3 Inglis had already announced that the make-up of its buying bench in attendance at the Sydney sale would be by invitation only, so that the company could comply with the 500-person limit for outdoor gatherings that was brought in earlier this month.</p>

Last week's introduction of a 100-person limit for indoor events, with four square metres of space for every person in attendance, would also put more pressure on Inglis's ability to run a viable sale as Australian officials attempt to "flatten the curve" of the deadly virus.

Using the company's online bidding technology had also been flagged as one instrument that could assist in as many buyers as possible participating in the Easter sale, even if they were not on site.

The Australian Football League reacted to the news by postponing its 2020 season until at least May after completing round one yesterday but the National Rugby League, whose chairman is Racing NSW chief executive Peter V'landys, had committed to pressing on with its competition.

NSW Trainers Association secretary Glenn Burge was blunt in his assessment of the severity of COVID-19, but he believes Racing NSW has the financial capacity to support participants through a potential shutdown of the industry.

"I will stress my personal opinion - and I am not speaking on behalf of my board - is that racing should continue as long as possible. Realistically, there's a lot of things you've got to look at before shutting it down because the economic impact of what is occurring is so much worse than what I think people realise," former Australian Financial Review editor Burge

GLENN BURGE, NSW TRAINERS ASSOCIATION SECRETARY told ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday.

"I was pretty close to the GFC (when at the AFR) and this is nothing to the GFC. The GFC was a stroll in the park compared to this. The GFC did not have mass shutting down of economic activity,

you could still go to a pub, a club or a beach.

"I saw what the government did back then and I've seen what Morrison is doing now and he is doing his best, but we've never had a shutting of economic activity like you're getting in Australia since World War II, but a better analogy is probably the Depression."

Burge, who said he had received numerous calls from anxious trainers and stable staff, added that Racing NSW's experience with the devastating equine influenza outbreak in 2007 that left the industry on its knees had the organisation well-placed to react to the latest setback.

"The wins that Peter V'landys had with the race fields legislation, the point of consumption tax ... they are actually in a good position and have built up great (cash) reserves," he said.

"Racing is in a much better financial position than what it was in 2008. I think a mixture of what they have got in the bank and, secondly, any government assistance racing can get - and it won't be high up the queue, unfortunately - is going to allow us to do things (to help the state's racing participants).

AUSTRALIA

Farnan's season over

Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Farnan (Not A Single Doubt) will not press on this campaign for a tilt at the two-year-old triple crown in Sydney, with co-trainer Adrian Bott confirming yesterday that the colt would be spelled. Owned by Aquis Farm and Phoenix Thoroughbreds, Farnan has won five of his six starts, including four at stakes level, and will enjoy a break as the most valuable juvenile in the country.

Tagaloa likely to be spelled

Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Tagaloa (Lord Kanaloa) is likely to head to the paddock after his fourth-placed effort in Saturday's Golden Slipper. Co-trainer Trent Busuttin yesterday indicated that the colt, who was secured for stud duties by Yulong after his Group 1 success last month, would not race again this season. "He definitely felt the run. He's pulled up with no issues, no problems, but it's noticeable that he walked out of the box a bit more jaded than usual," Busuttin told Racing.com. "We thought we had him in peak condition for the race, he gave us no indication otherwise, and it's easy to say that he raced like a horse who wanted further, but I think he raced like a horse that had had enough, to be honest. It's disappointing, but I'm not disappointed in the horse."

Thompson celebrates training success

If the rest of the autumn carnival is scuppered by the coronavirus, trainer John Thompson has already celebrated his biggest day on a racecourse. Thompson arrived at Rosehill for Saturday's closed door meeting with two Group 1 chances and left with a George Ryder Stakes (Gr 1, 1500m) winner in the shape of Dreamforce (Fastnet Rock) and a Golden Slipper placegetter courtesy of Mamaragan (Wandjina). The Randwick trainer, who has a relatively small team compared to the major stables, rated Saturday afternoon as his greatest day on a racetrack. "You'd have to say yes," Thompson said. "It's pretty good."

Sires next for Mamaragan

John Thompson's Golden Slipper third Mamaragan will now press on to the ATC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m). "He's done super against some more seasoned two-year-olds," Thompson said. "To run like that in your second start in a race, in Nash's words, we might have lost the battle but I reckon we will win the war. We've got a nice horse on our hands. If he pulls up good and well he will go to the Sires'."

The Bostonian onto All Aged

Tony Pike believes The Bostonian (Jimmy Choux) was unlucky not to take out Saturday's George Ryder Stakes (Gr 1, 1500m) but the horse will get his chance to make amends in another Group 1 next month. The Canterbury Stakes (Gr 1, 1300m) winner was runner-up to Dreamforce at Rosehill and now Pike plans to target the Randwick carnival with the in-form five-year-old. "(The Bostonian) was super and it was just unfortunate he had Spend over-racing inside of him early on which didn't allow us to sit outside Dreamforce like we wanted to," Pike said. "I think that made all the difference as they walked in the mid stages and Dreamforce got that bit of a break on him. He was very strong late and just missed so if he could have landed outside the speed, which was the plan, then he probably wins the race. He's flying though and couldn't be going any better so now we will hunker down and head to the All Aged Stakes in three weeks."

Tancred possible for Verry Ellegant

Provided she pulls up well from her gallant second in Saturday's Ranvet Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m), Chris Waller's Verry Elleegant (Zed) could be headed for the Tancred Stakes (Gr 1, 2400m) on Saturday. "I'd love to try her over 2400 metres at weight-for-age," Waller said. "She had a very tough run in the Ranvet and I think Tommy Marquand did a fantastic job, as simple as that. "He took off knowing we'd be vulnerable late and he was right. I knew if it was a sit and sprint from the turn we wouldn't be beaten, and I was almost right. They took off from the 600 (metres)."

Carters happy with Elleegant

New Zealand owners John, Mark and Rachael Carter, who race under the Jomara Bloodstock banner, were delighted with the performance of their mare Verry Elleegant. "It was a very good run and probably not ideal that she had to make her run so early," John Carter said. "It was a gutsy effort and after her previous start, where she just got beaten by Te Akau Shark over 1600 metres, the writing was probably on the wall that she was nearing her best. The stable was quite confident as she has come back in good fashion and the further she goes the better she will be. I think 2400 metres will be where she is strongest, especially as there isn't a lot of depth in the staying ranks over there at the moment. We will wait and see how she pulls up but she could line up again next week if Chris is happy with her."

Pike happy with Sherwood Forest

The Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) remains on the cards for New Zealand three-yearold Sherwood Forest (Fastnet Rock) after his satisfactory seventh in Saturday's Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m). The Tony Pike-trained gelding won the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) in February. "We were using the race as a lead up to the Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) so we may have been a little soft on him since his last run," Pike said. "To be fair, though, two or three of those more brilliant three-year-olds just sprinted and left him standing but he kept grinding away and Michael was quite happy with him. He said that would just tighten him up nicely and that the mile and a half was going to suit him a lot better. He has taken all the travel in his stride so hopefully he improves a couple of lengths after the run and he can bring that to the Derby in a fortnight."

Scorpz suffers injury

After finishing last in the Rosehill Guineas, connections believe New Zealand placegetter Scorpz (Charm Spirit) has suffered an injury. "From what we have heard he may have done a suspensory ligament so he is all wrapped up at the moment," co-owner John Carter said. "It's very disappointing but we are still waiting to hear the final prognosis once the swelling has subsided. It's definitely not what you want to see and is made a little more frustrating as you can't be over there with them due to all the travel restrictions at present. Todd (Pollard) from Stephen Marsh's stable is looking after him and the horse is not in any pain so we just have to wait and see."

Sydney likely for Eric The Eel

Trainer Stuart Kendrick has confirmed a Sydney campaign for Eric The Eel (Olympic Glory) - if he can travel to Sydney. The three-year-old gelding was a Doomben winner two starts ago and then a close-up third in an Open Handicap (1800m) at the Gold Coast two weeks ago. Kendrick said Eric The Eel was headed to the Tulloch Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) at Rosehill on Saturday as a lead-up to the Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) on April 4. "It of course is all dependent on the coronavirus and that we are allowed to travel," Kendrick said. "He pulled

up well from the Gold Coast and I think the further the races the better he will be. Eric The Eel deserves his crack at Sydney. I just hope we get there."

Spiritual Warrior too good in Tavern Cup

The Justin Warwick-trained Spiritual Warrior (5 g Blackfriars - Angelic Heart by Show a Heart) was too good for his rivals when taking out the Tavern Cup (Listed, 2200m) at Bunbury yesterday. The five-year-old gelding defeated Superior Smile (Patronize) by a nose with He's A Parker (He's A Decoy) a further three-quarters of a length back in third. Spiritual Warrior is out of the four-time winning mare Angelic Heart (Show A Heart), who herself is out of dual stakes winner Paris Heartbeat (Marooned).

Waller hopes racing can continue

Chris Waller hopes racing can continue under the biosecurity measures employed on Golden Slipper day, which featured five Group 1s but no spectators because of the coronavirus pandemic protocols. "There's a lot of ways of looking at it. I think continuing on racing and racing sensibly is brilliant," Waller said. "We put on a good show for people watching from outside here and we were very responsible. People were there with the sole reason of making sure racing ran and didn't take any silly risks. It's not going to be easy to suggest we can continue to maintain it at the levels they suggest and I'm sure we can even tighten up more."

Queensland race clubs to seek assistance

Queensland race clubs are preparing a submission to seek federal and state government financial help as the coronavirus crisis causes huge financial losses. As is the case throughout Australia, race meetings are being conducted without public attendance. If the situation continues into the winter carnival it will cost the south east Queensland clubs at least \$5 million. The figure will be three to four times that figure if the industry is to close down completely. RQ chief executive Brendan Parnell said the main aim was to keep racing continuing to maintain an income flow and

protect as many jobs as possible. "We will follow federal government guidelines no matter which way they go, we are obliged to do that," Parnell said. "By racing without crowds it means the industry is still producing revenue for gambling businesses and treasury. Compensation in some form is paramount and we will be working with clubs this week on the issue."

NEW ZEALAND

London Banker gets the money

London Banker (Tavistock) continued in his rich vein of form and completed a hat-trick of recent successes when taking out the Bay Of Plenty Cup (2100m) yesterday. Prevailing by the minimum of margins in a thrilling finish to the middledistance feature, the Roger James and Robert Wellwood-trained four-year-old fended off the challenge of Bully Boy (Rock 'N' Pop) to build on his earlier wins at Te Teko and Ellerslie. "I think it was only at the post that he got his nose in front," Wellwood said. "He's still immature, quite babyish and doing a bit wrong but he's strung three together now and is a horse on the way up." Looking ahead, Wellwood added: "We think he will have one more start in this campaign which will be in the Hawke's Bay Cup next month. He will go for a spell after that but on what he has shown us so far he could be a very exciting horse if he can keep improving like he has."

ASIA

Seven for Kinshasa No Kiseki

Kinshasa No Kiseki (Fuji Kiseki) sired his seventh stakes winner yesterday when Galore Creek (3 c ex Gold Relic by Kingmambo) took out the Sho Spring Stakes (Japanese 2,000 Guineas Trial) (Gr 2, 1800m) at Nakayama. Racing for the fourth time having been tried in top-tier company at the same track in December, the Hiroyuki Ueharatrained Galore Creek quickened a length and a quarter clear of Weltreisende (Dream Journey) in second, with a further length and three-quarters back to Succession (King Kamehameha) in third. Shadai Stallion Station resident Kinshasa No Kiseki, who twice won the Takamatsunomiya Kinen Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) on the track, is also the sire of fellow Grade 2 winners Shuji and Monde Can Know.

Smile lands first Grade 2

You Can Smile (5 h King Kamehameha - Mood Indigo by Dance in the Dark) added a maiden Grade 2 success to his career record when the five-year-old landed the Hanshin Daishoten (Gr 2, 3000m) at Hanshin yesterday. Trained by Yasuo Tomomichi, You Can Smile supplemented his previous two victories at Grade 3 level, achieved at Tokyo last February and Niigata in September, when coming home a length and three-quarters too strong for Tosen Cambina (Deep Impact), with a further half-length back to Meisho Tengen (Deep Impact) in third. You Can Smile has now won six of his

Dubai World Cup cancelled

Dubai World Cup night at Meydan on Saturday has been cancelled with the organising committee citing safeguarding the health of all participants during the ongoing coronavirus pandemic. The fixture, which holds six Group 1s and two Group 2 contests including the Dubai World Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) and Dubai Sheema Classic (Gr 1, 2400m), is the latest global sporting event to be cancelled with the pandemic continuing to escalate. Having announced that the meeting, which has a total prize fund of US\$35million, would be held behind closed doors earlier in the month, the Dubai Media Authority confirmed in a tweet that the bonanza had been cancelled. "To safeguard the health of all participants, the higher organising committee of the Dubai World Cup 2020 has decided to postpone the 25th edition of the global tournament to next year."

54 for Lookin At Lucky

The Brad Cox-trained Wells Bayou (3 c ex Whispering Angel by Hard Spun) continued on his upward curve and posted a clear career best when he captured the Louisiana Derby (Gr 2, 9.5) on the dirt at Fair Grounds on Saturday. Runner-up in the Southwest Stakes (Gr 3, 8.5f) at Oaklawn Park at his last start, Wells Bayou improved for the step up in trip, seeing off the challenge of Ny Traffic (Cross Traffic) by a length and a half. Modernist (Uncle Mo) finished a further two and three-quarter lengths adrift in

third. In winning for the third time in five starts, Wells Bayou became the 54th stakes scorer for Ashford Stud resident Lookin At Lucky (Smart Strike), who is currently standing for a fee of US\$20,000 (inc GST).

The win, a third in four starts for Bonny South, formed part of a red-letter card for trainer Brad Cox, while the victory was also the 39th individual stakes success for Munnings (Speightstown), who is currently standing at Ashford Stud for a fee of US\$30,000 (inc GST).

Standards takes out New Orleans Classic

By My Standards (4 c Goldencents - A Jealous Woman by Muqtarib), who landed last year's Louisiana Derby and subsequently finished down the field in the Kentucky Derby (Gr 1, 10f), scored his second win in Grade 2 company when taking out the New Orleans Classic (Gr 2, 9f) at Fair Grounds on Saturday. A winner at the track on his return last month, By My Standards turned in an authoritative display at the weekend, quickening three lengths clear of Captivating Moon (Malibu Moon) in second, who in turn finished half a length clear of Tenfold (Curlin) in third. By My Standards has now won four of his eight starts.

Muniz Memorial to Factor This

The only Graded action on the turf at Fair Grounds on Saturday, the Muniz Memorial Classic (Gr 2, 9f), went the way of Factor This (5 h The Factor - Capricious Miss by Singspiel), who built on last month's track and distance victory in the Fair Grounds Stakes (Gr 3, 9f) when taking out this Grade 2 prize by three lengths. Providing trainer Brad Cox with his third Graded success on the card, Factor This saw off the claims of Dontblamerocket (Blame), while Rockemperor (Holy Roman Emperor) was a further three-quarters of a length adrift in third. The consistent Factor This has now won nine of his 28 starts, with this being his maiden success in Grade 2 company on his first outing at the level.

Successful return for Cistron

The John Sadler-trained Cistron (6 h The Factor - Major Allie by Officer), who was last seen landing the Bing Crosby Stakes (Gr 1, 6f) at Del Mar in July, made a successful return to action when taking out the San Simeon Stakes (Gr 3, 5.5f) at Santa Anita on Saturday. Showing a fine attitude under Victor Espinoza, Cistron fended off the challenge of Bound For Nowhere (The Factor) by a head, completing a quinella for Lane's End Farm stallion The Factor (War Front). Murad Khan (Raven's Pass) was a further length and a quarter adrift in third. The result was a compensatory one for Cistron, who finished runner-up in the corresponding race last year.

12 for Lucky Pulpit

Ward 'N Jerry (7 g ex Tamarack Bay by Dehere) gained an overdue victory in stakes company when he landed the San Luis Rey Stakes (Gr 3, 12f) at Santa Anita on Saturday. Laden with stamina but tackling this marathon trip for the first time, Ward 'N Jerry outstayed his six rivals in the home stretch, landing the spoils by a length and a quarter to become the twelfth individual stakes winner for late Harris Farms resident Lucky Pulpit (Pulpit). Camino Del Paraiso (Suances) ran second, while Oscar Dominguez (Zoffany) was a further length and a quarter adrift in third. Lucky Pulpit, who died as a 16-year-old in 2017, is best known as the sire of seven-time top-tier winner California Chrome.

olden Sixty (Medaglia d'Oro) triumphed in an epic HK\$20 million Hong Kong Derby (Listed, 2000m) at Sha Tin yesterday to complete a brilliant whitewash of the Four-Year-Old Classic Series.

The victory was a first in the race for jockey Vincent Ho, who ended a run of outs for local riders in the blue riband going back to 1995. This was also a first Derby for trainer Francis Lui and owner Stanley Chan, and the first time in the professional era – since 1971 – that a native Hong Kong trainer, jockey and owner combined for victory.

"I think I can sleep well tonight, all the pressure on my shoulders has just gone," Ho said after he had driven the \$1.70 favourite to a flashing neck win over the 289/1 shot Playa Del Puente (Elzaam).

The jockey deserves his night of peace, as does Golden Sixty. The brown gelding quickened from eleventh at the top of the straight through a run that was, in equal measure, brilliant dash and depth-mining resolution.

His closing 400-metre split was completed in a lung-taxing 21.83 seconds, the fastest at the course and distance since Designs On Rome (Holy Roman Emperor) clocked 21.82 seconds in the 2014 Jockey Club Cup (Gr 2, 2000m). Golden Sixty's final sprint ensured a race record time of 2.00.15 – but anything less would have brought nothing but a gallant defeat.

Lui admitted to being "excited and panicked" when Ho angled Golden Sixty from behind horses into a wide alley, at least six lengths behind Playa Del Puente. The runner-up had made an audacious burst clear of the pack under Blake Shinn.

"Round the bend, they slowed down the pace and that's why the other horse was able to run away but Golden Sixty showed excellent

acceleration. I was worried but I could see Golden Sixty was trying very hard," Lui explained.

Much had been said and written pre-race about Ho's rapid ascent in the past two seasons and when the chips were down, the burgeoning rider did not disappoint.

Ho could do nothing but sit and wait when Shinn opted to roll Playa Del Puente from last to first, between the 900-metre mark and the 700-metre point. That move saw Golden Sixty shuffled back to the rear behind a tempo that had steadied for a sprint home.

Shinn's exquisite move gave him the edge, but Ho kept his cool.

"I wasn't too worried," Ho said. "I know my horse can produce a really good turn-offoot and he relaxed really well for me through the race. When I saw the winning post, I knew I should be able to get him, as long as the other horse didn't accelerate again.

"I didn't mind the tempo – fast or slow – as long as my horse was relaxed and I knew I had to wait until the last bit to ask my horse to pick up. He's got the best turn-of-foot in the field and I just had to be patient."

Golden achievements

Golden Sixty became only the second horse since Rapper Dragon (Street Boss) in 2017 to win all three legs of the Four-Year-Old Classic Series. Yesterday's win followed his successes in the Hong Kong Classic Mile (Listed, 1600m) and Hong Kong Classic Cup (Listed, 1800m).

"It's an amazing feeling to win all the fouryear-old Classics and he's a superstar for sure. I think today, especially, it was very difficult to come from behind and sprint like that," Ho, 29, said.

The win meant that he took his place as one of only four Hong Kong-born jockeys to have won the Hong Kong Derby in the past 50 years, and the first since Tony Cruz scored on Makarpura Star (Native Kingdom) in 1995.

"It's such an amazing feeling, my first Derby on a horse that I love so much and he's such a good horse," he said.

Lui, 61, was delighted to have finally won the Derby after 25 years as a trainer.

"It's not easy," he said. "I'm very happy – I have to say thank you to my stable team."



Shinn's move foiled

Had Blake Shinn's field-rounding move worked out, he would have masterminded the biggest Hong Kong Derby upset since Holy Grail's (Zabeel) 183/1 shock in 1999 – if not the biggest ever.

Playa Del Puente had plenty in the tank when he led the 14 runners off the final turn and with 150 metres to go it still looked as though he had the march on Golden Sixty.

But the Danny Shum-trained Irish-bred began to falter as the winner surged home and Shinn could do no more.

"He ran his heart out," the Australian said.
"We left nothing to chance and put everything on the table when they slowed mid-race, we put it to the rest of the field.

"I knew my horse had a lot of stamina and I had confidence taking off that he would keep going – he did that, he was there for me, he just got beat by a superstar horse on the rise."

Playa Del Puente and third-placed More Than This (Dutch Art), also trained by Lui, both sported the silks of owner Huang Kai Wen. The latter horse boxed on for minor honours, three lengths behind his victorious stablemate.

"I thought his run was fair - he drew the right gate and had a lovely run," jockey Zac Purton said.

"It didn't help when Joao (Moreira on Champion's Way) backed the speed off and then the mid-race move happened and really shook the race's complexion up, but I was able to get through and I thought in the straight he should have been a bit braver than he was."

Purton keeps the pressure on

Earlier in the day, Purton drew level briefly with Moreira at the top of the jockeys' premiership when the Benno Yung-trained Tung Wah Glory (Hussonet) took the Class 4 Ping Hai Star Handicap (1400m), with Moreira an unfortunate loser on the slow-starting but fast-closing third Heza Beauty (Darci Brahma).

That completed a back-to-back double for Purton, who took the preceding race on the Ricky Yiu-trained Good Luck Friend (Swiss Ace).

Grant van Niekerk had already thwarted Moreira in the afternoon's first two races: the Peter Ho-trained Breeze Of Spring (Pins) arrived late to mug Moreira's mount Evan Almighty (Kuroshio) in the opener; the South African pulled off the same trick in the next, driving the Richard Gibson-trained Full Power (Frankel) to pip Moreira on Family Leader (Makfi).

Moreira hit the mark, and regained a one-

win advantage over Purton in the championship race, when another three-year-old, Ping Hai Bravo (Red Dazzler), landed race five, the Class 3 Designs On Rome Handicap (1200m).

Purton nailed a treble when he steered the Gibson-trained rising star Wellington (All Too Hard) to an impressive third win on the bounce in the Class 3 Luger Handicap (1200m), but Moreira struck back to edge a one win advantage at the end of play, with a success on another promising type, the Tony Millard-trained Seattle Choice (Sail From Seattle), in the Class 2 Rapper Dragon Handicap (1400m).

Neil Callan and Tony Cruz combined to win the Class 3 Collection Handicap (1400m) with All In Mind (Deep Field). Matthew Chadwick drove the David Hall-trained London Hall (He's Remarkable) to win the Class 3 Akeed Mofeed Handicap (2000m).


