Agents take to Newmarket as UK bloodstock sales ready for return

Strict protocols in place in new Covid-19-influenced pandemic world

Buyers will be allowed back into the sales rings of Europe for the first time since the Covid-19 pandemic hit when the combined Tattersalls Craven and Tattersalls Ascot Breeze Up Sales take place in Newmarket later this week, with the auction potentially providing a guide to the northern hemisphere buyers' appetites to

invest in new stock in light of the health and economic crisis.

Socially distanced breeze-ups were held at Newmarket on Monday as agents started their inspections and assessed the merits of the respective lots ahead of tomorrow's first lot going through the ring.

This sale, and next month's Tattersalls July Sale that is regularly attended by Australasian agents seeking racing *Continued on page 2>>*

<< *Continued from page 1* and commercial breeding prospects to bring to the southern hemisphere, may also indicate the willingness of the international market to participate in next month's Inglis and Magic Millions sales in Australia, even from afar.

At Monday's breeze-ups, despite an easing of lockdown measures across Britain where some shops have reopened and people being allowed to meet in groups of six in outdoor spaces, Tattersalls implemented strict protocols to allow the breeze to be conducted in as safe a manner as possible.

Richard Brown of Blandford Bloodstock was among the agents in attendance on the Rowley Mile, and said of his experience: "I had my temperature taken at the entrance to the sales ground, the entrance to the racecourse and again when I got back to Tattersalls.

"I've never had my temperature taken so many times. Tattersalls have put in very strict protocols, and rightly so."

Bloodstock industry

professionals are generally a tight-knit bunch, but Brown reported that the social distancing measures were being adhered to, with buyers and sellers alike acutely aware of how fortunate they are that sales are going ahead at all.

"There's social distancing measures everywhere and from what I could see everyone was taking it very seriously," he said.

"At one stage it looked like a very real possibility that there wouldn't be breeze-up sales, so to be here and having them happening is great. We get this chance now and everybody understands that they've got to be very responsible."

Those sentiments were echoed by leading consignor Brendan Holland of Grove Stud, who is set to offer three lots at this year's Craven Sale.

He said: "It's a huge relief that the sales are on. At the start of lockdown I don't think we realised how bad it was going to get, no one did, but once we got into it it was horrendous. It's been an extremely anxious time for everybody."

Although those within the breeze-up sector have endured a tough time of it during a sales season ravaged by uncertainty, Holland stressed that he and his fellow vendors had not lost sight of the bigger picture during a global health crisis.

"There's no doubt it's going to cost us money but it'll be tough on a lot of people, and not just financially," he said reflecting on the last three months of disruption.

"We were lucky that it was easy for us to self isolate on our farms and we were in a healthier situation than a lot of people in Britain and Ireland.

"We were thankful for that and appreciated our rural life more than ever before. As far as I know, we've all come through this healthy, and at the end of the day that's the main thing."

Holland added that the increased safety protocols had not presented any issues for vendors, either in terms of showing horses or accessing the Park Paddocks site.

He said: "You have to be on the pre-authorised list to come in, but that's not a big deal because it's being run efficiently and is well organised so there's no aggravation.

"It's a very big complex here so it's very easy to maintain social distancing. That was never going to be an issue with viewing horses."

While some semblance of normality has resumed in Newmarket, what impact the coronavirus pandemic will have on the bloodstock market remains to be seen.

Brown, whose past breeze-up buys include Group 1 winners Dream Ahead (Diktat) and Teppal (Camacho), offered a pragmatic prediction as to the state of trade at the Craven and Ascot sales, but highlighted the ongoing success of breeze-up graduates as a reason to be optimistic.

He said: "It's highly unlikely the market will be up, I don't think anyone

is expecting that. I think the top will be relatively unaffected but that we might see very polarised trade.

"But trying to predict bloodstock markets is notoriously difficult; they've been amazingly resilient over time. And we're not dealing with a huge number of horses this year and the breeze-ups have been extremely successful over the last three years."

Holland said the buying bench already on the sales ground was a source of hope rather than confidence, and added that he would be taking a watching brief as to how that translated into prices in the ring.

He said: "I've never had less expectations because I've never had less of a handle on what trade is going to be like.

"There are people here looking and with orders to fill so there will be trade, I'm just not sure at what level.

"We're just glad and grateful that the sale is taking place and we hope it comes to a successful conclusion."

Two for Exosphere

Former Darley shuttler Exosphere (Lonhro) sired his second first-crop winner yesterday when No Laughing Matter (2 f ex Laughing by Distorted Humor) took out a 1206-metre open maiden at Port Macquarie. The Kris Lees-trained filly defeated Whatisin (Epaulette) by a length and three-quarters with Another Option (Master Of Design) another neck away in third. Purchased by Australian Bloodstock for \$38,000 from the draft of Moobi Farm at the Inglis Classic Sale, No Laughing Matter is the second foal out of winning mare Laughing (Distorted Humour), who herself is a half-sister to Listed scorer Outskirt Lady (Purge). Further back, this is the family of dual Grade 1 victor Better Lucky (Ghostzapper). Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Exosphere will stand at Darley's Kelvinside property for a fee of \$16,500 (inc GST) in 2020.

Talented Time To Reign set to resume

Group 2-winning colt Time To Reign (Time For War) is set to make his return to racing at Randwick on Saturday with trainer Gary Portelli eyeing a Benchmark 94 handicap over 1100 metres as the starting point for last year's Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) fifth. The three-year-old missed last spring and his only start this year was a fourth placing in the Kensington Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at Flemington in January. "It's been a long time getting him back to where we want him and I think he's 110 per cent ready to go this weekend after two trials," Portelli said. "He had a good workout this morning and we've got him as good as you can get him going into his first run

back from a spell. I'm looking forward to the weekend. Hopefully he runs well."

Twitchy Frank likely for Spear Chief

Stakes-winning former Tasmanian mare Twitchy Frank (Choisir) is likely to back up in the Spear Chief Handicap (Listed, 1350m) at Doomben on Saturday after a solid fourth in a Deagon barrier trial yesterday. Twitchy Frank was deep from the 600 metres before being given an easy time to the line in the 1050-metre heat. Formerly trained by Adam Trinder in Tasmania, Twitchy Frank won in Group 3 company at Hobart and counts a Flemington victory among her seven wins. The mare is now with Tony Gollan and is chasing more stakes success before going under the hammer at the Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale next month. "I will see how she comes through the trial but she will probably run in the Spear Chief and then maybe the Gai Waterhouse (at Ipswich on July 18) but it is right on top of the sales," Gollan said.

Ramornie aim for Graff

Kris Lees is eyeing next month's \$200,000 Ramornie Handicap (Listed, 1200m) at Grafton with Graff (Star Witness) after an impressive barrier trial yesterday. A multiple stakes winner with more than \$1 million in prize-money, Graff has been at the Newcastle trainer's Gold Coast base for the past month. He ran tenth in the Stradbroke Handicap (Gr 1, 1400m) on June 6, with Lees deciding to press on into the winter. In a Deagon trial over 1050 metres, Graff settled last before running on strongly in the final 200 metres to be beaten one and a half lengths into second place by speedy mare Jami Lady (Spirit Of Boom). "(The Ramornie) is the way Kris will probably go but we also have the option of the Eye Liner

Handicap at Ipswich two weeks later," Lees' Gold Coast representative Mel Eggleston said.

Wet track to suit Sully

Dual Group 1 placegetter Sully (Reliable Man) will be vying to nab an elusive stakes victory when he contests the WJ McKell Cup (Listed, 2000m) at Rosehill on Saturday. The gelding has been hampered by a few issues, but trainers Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young are excited to send their horse north to Sydney to contest the 2000-metre race on what is currently rated a Heavy 9 track. "Sully will be going up to Sydney, unless something untoward happens," Busuttin told Sky Sport Radio. "He is at a stage where he has been through the wars as a horse. His knees aren't the best and he is crying out for a wet track. A wet track is what we will get in Sydney I would presume on Saturday and based on his work this morning I think he will be right in amongst it."

Ablaze set for Stayer's Cup

It's not too often you hear two miles is short of a horse's best distance, but that will be the case for quality New Zealand-bred stayer Ablaze (Raise The Flag) when he contests the Stayer's Cup (3200m) at Rosehill on Saturday. The eight-year-old gelding has been in hot form for Ciaran Maher and David Eustace, winning his last five races, including The Jericho Cup (4600m) and Grand Annual Steeplechase (5500m). The Stayer's Cup will be his first run since his winning effort in the Warrnambool feature and the stable's assistant trainer Annabel Neasham believes he can continue his picket fence form line. "He is probably our best (chance) for the week," she said. "He won the Jericho Cup and he won the Grand Annual over 5500 metres, so the 3200 metres is probably short of his best, but if it is a wet slog then that will be to his liking."

Sansom on the improve

Phillip Stokes expects a slight step up in distance will suit stakes-placed sprinter Sansom (Charm Spirit) when he runs second-up at Caulfield with added fitness on his side. Stokes has runners nominated in five of the nine Caulfield races on Saturday with Sansom aiming to go one better in the 1100-metre Benchmark 84 handicap after finishing second to Iconic Star (Brazen Beau) over 1000 metres at Moonee Valley first-up on June 13. "I was very happy with his return under a big weight (60 kilograms)," Stokes said. "He just found it a bit sharp so that little bit further will suit and he has run well at Caulfield before. He's a very consistent horse and I'm very happy with him. He only had the one jump-out going into his first-up run and was always going to take good benefit out of it."

Rose on radar for Prompt Prodigy

Hawkesbury trainer Edward Cummings is hopeful that Prompt Prodigy (More Than Ready) can justify connections paying the nomination fee for next season's Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) with a victory at Canterbury today. The two-year-old colt, who is a son of Cummings' grandfather's Group 1-winning mare Allez Wonder (Redoute's Choice), ran third at Warwick Farm on June 8 and will step out for the second time in the All Too Hard at Vinery Handicap (1250m). "We paid up (for the Golden Rose) off the back of what was a fairly promising run, he earned five grand that day, so the thinking was he earned the nomination fee," Cummings told Racing NSW. "If he was to win he'd end up in the paddock fairly promptly and we'd be looking to get him back in time to trial and have a decent hit out before he went into some nice races in the spring."

Schweida cautious of Expert Eye's chances

Kelly Schweida has cautioned punters expecting promising filly Expert Eye (Better Than Ready) to improve her winning strike-rate at Ipswich today. The filly is chasing a hat-trick of wins in the QTIS Three-Year-Old

Handicap (1690m) after breaking through for her first win in a maiden handicap (1350m) at Doomben on May 13 before scoring a commanding victory over the same distance in a Class 1 at Doomben on June 3. "She's a nice filly but I wanted to run her over 1400 metres at the Gold Coast last Friday but the meeting was washed out," Schweida said. "She's done a good job to win twice in her five starts which have all been in one preparation. She'll race well again but I would have preferred this to be over 1400 metres. Instead, she's had to step up in distance to 1690 metres which isn't ideal."

Offers rejected for Front Page

Impressive Flemington winner Front Page (Magnus) will remain in Australia after connections declined some sizeable offers from Hong Kong for Saturday's AR Creswick Stakes (Listed, 1200m) winner. Part-owner Paul Duryea, son of the gelding's trainer Geoff, would not disclose the highest bid but said offers ranged between \$1 million and \$1.5 million. "We bred the horse, we don't want to sell him, we don't need to sell," Duryea told RSN927. Duryea said the first offers for Front Page started minutes after the gelding's win on Saturday and had continued through until yesterday morning. Front Page is heading off for a spell after winning Saturday's target race which Duryea said was more about giving connections an idea of the gelding's potential. "It's fine to have ability at home, but you've got to go and do it in the city and it was there for everyone to see on Saturday," he added.

Jolly Sailor sold to Hong Kong

A future in Hong Kong does however beckon for the three-time winner Jolly Sailor (Canford Cliffs) after connections elected to accept an offer for the Henry Dwyer-trained gelding following his latest all-the-way win at Flemington on June 6. Dwyer said he was disappointed to lose a horse of Jolly Sailor's potential, but is hopeful of getting the yearling and weanling siblings of the gelding to train. Jolly Sailor is entered for a couple of races at Caulfield on Saturday, but Dwyer said the three-year-old had run his last race in Australia. "He's been sold and he's off to Hong Kong," Dwyer said. "Unfortunately it's part of the game. Everyone needs to replenish their finances to get more horses and you've got to sell them when the offer comes."

Untamed also heading to Asia

Hong Kong also emerged as the next destination for stakes winner Untamed (Pierro) after Lindsay Park Racing last night tweeted to confirm that the two-year-old had been sold in a deal brokered by Hong Kong Bloodstock. The Fernhill Handicap (Listed, 1600m) winner, who was last seen when finishing fifth in the Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick in April is set to be reunited with David Hayes who is in the process of relocating to Hong Kong.

Virus hiccup a hit to race club members

Racing Victoria CEO Giles Thompson is hoping patrons will still be allowed on-course by the end of July, but admits it's less likely because of the latest coronavirus spike in the state. Owners returned to the racetrack at Ballarat on Tuesday and it was hoped members and spectators would be back in July after restrictions in Victoria were relaxed. "We were hopeful at the back-end of last week that those guidelines would allow spectators at professional sports towards the back-end of July and that would allow us to really ramp up the numbers on track," Thompson told RSN927. "Unfortunately the hiccup on the weekend has meant that is less likely to be the end of July now, I wouldn't totally rule it out, but it's certainly less likely."

WA prize-money to return to pre-Covid levels

Prize-money in Western Australia is set to return to its full pre-Covid level on August 1.

Racing and Wagering Western Australia announced yesterday. RWWA made the decision to reduce prize-money and associated breeding bonuses by 20 per cent in early April to assist in mitigating the impact of declining income as a result of Covid-19. RWWA chairman Jeff Ovens said that the decision was a difficult, yet necessary one, to ensure the industry's future sustainability. "Racing has been fortunate to continue operating throughout the Covid-19 period, allowing RWWA to actively support the continuation of racing at 80 per cent of stakes levels at a time where our income was impacted by at least 50 per cent," Ovens said. "We recognise how difficult the situation has been for our racing participants. However, this decision was made to mitigate some of the impacts from Covid-19, to ensure the long-term survival of the WA racing industry."

Arrowfield backing young guns

Arrowfield principal John Messara is predicting big things of two of the young guns among the stud's battalion of established stallions including Castelveccchio (Dundeel) who is preparing for his first season this spring. "He's a homebred and we get a big thrill out of buying our horses back - often at a big multiple than what we sold them for, but nevertheless we know a lot about them and a lot about their families and it helps we bred them," Messara told Racing.com. "He was a Group 1 winner at two and three and has a lovely pedigree. He's a little bigger than his father. I am very hopeful about him." Castelveccchio will be taking his place at Arrowfield alongside The Autumn Sun (Redoute's Choice) who will be standing for his sophomore year. "He's the gun," Messara said. "The fact he is a son of Redoute's Choice, who is a proven sire maker. He's been the best sire maker since Danehill. He got a wonderful book of mares in his first season last year. We are personally sending him 47 mares ourselves. We are madly keen about him."

Allen on comeback trail

Ben Allen will return to the races at Moe

tomorrow for the first time since fracturing his wrist in a race fall in May. "Like many people this really hasn't been my year, I'm determined to turn around my luck of late and work hard and hopefully get back on a good roll," he told Racing.com. "My career has been really stop-start for the past 12 months with injuries and some suspensions and if I'm going to still make it to the top this is the time that I've got to turn it around and get some consistent form on my side. I've never been more determined to ride well and I can't wait to get back out there."

Logan McNeil still weeks away from returning

After being sidelined for almost a month with a foot injury, apprentice jockey Logan McNeil believes he is still weeks away from returning to the saddle. "It was hoped from surgery that it would be three months (out) as long as the rehab goes to plan and we're still looking towards that," McNeil told Racing.com on Monday. "I had an appointment a week ago to remove stitches and have an x-ray in four weeks. We'll know more after that." McNeil has not ridden since May 25 after suffering a serious foot injury in a freak trackwork accident in the following days. "I was riding a young one that got a fright and slipped over and crushed my leg underneath," he said. "I broke eight or nine bones in my foot and tore ligaments off the bone."

Weir court case adjourned

Due to coronavirus restrictions, Darren Weir's court case has been adjourned and will now be heard at the Ballarat Magistrates Court on September 8. Weir, Jarrod McLean, Tyson Kermond and William Hernana were all set to face court this week for a committal hearing over a number of allegations, including animal cruelty and fraud conspiracy.

Tamworth transferred to Scone

Friday's meeting at Tamworth has been shifted to Scone after a track inspection yesterday. The decision was made after surface water was on the Tamworth circuit and it was deemed that the track would not dry sufficiently in time to allow the meeting to go ahead. The 1200-metre races will now be run over 1100 metres.

Gunnedah moved to Moree

Racing NSW yesterday also announced that the Gunnedah meeting set down for Monday, July 6, will now be held at Moree in the north west of the state. As a result of the venue change, the three 1000-metre races programmed for the meeting will now be held over 950 metres. All other race distances remain the same.

NEW ZEALAND

Karaka sales topper wins trial

New Zealand Bloodstock sales topping colt No Limits (Savabeel), purchased by Te Akau principal David Ellis for \$1.4 million at the 2019 Karaka Book 1 Sale, resumed with a solid trial win at Te Rapa yesterday. "I thought that he trialled well over a short trip (900 metres) and carried a bit of weight with Opie (Bosson) on," trainer Jamie Richards said. "The slow ground was not really to his liking, but I think the biggest thing with this horse is that he's going to want a mile fairly quickly - 1400 metres to a mile. So, I'm happy with him and I think we're going the right way. Opie said he's got a good attitude, good temperament, nice and relaxed when you're on top of him and that he felt good. It wasn't about exerting him to win, but rather just a nice day out and teaching him that he's got a job to do."

Out Of The Park heads to Australia

South Island Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) winner Out Of The Park (Ocean Park) has joined the Victorian stable of Henry Dwyer. The five-year-old mare was previously trained by Robert Dennis for good friends Mike Rennie and Jack Stewart and he was able to win four races from seven starts for connections. "I didn't have her for long and she arrived a well-tried horse with a few quirks and she took a couple of weeks to settle into farm training life, but once she did she never looked back," Dennis said. "A horse like that, with those quirks and characteristics, you get to know them and figure them out and it is pretty satisfying when you get them to turn their form around."

Personal best beckons for Teetan

There are seven meetings left in the 2019/20 Hong Kong racing season and while the talk of the town has been the race between Zac Purton and Joao Moreira to be champion jockey, t's the man dubbed the 'Mauritian Magician' who has stolen the spotlight of late with seven wins from the last two race meetings. Karis Teetan bagged a four-timer ten days ago at Sha Tin and again starred on Sunday with a treble, equalling his best ever season's tally of 84 wins in the process. "I wasn't focussing on breaking my personal best this season, I just try to ride as many winners as I can and things are going well," Teetan said. "We have a few more meetings left so hopefully things can keep on rolling and hopefully I can ride as many winners as I can before the end of the season."

Duric happy to stay put in Singapore

Three-time Singapore champion jockey Vlad Duric is looking forward to the resumption of racing as he continues to cut down on the calories and get back to his riding weight. With only limited opportunities to ride work during Singapore's lockdown, Duric's weight ballooned to 65 kilograms. However, as the restrictions have been eased, Duric has been back in the saddle more often ahead of the return on July 11. "As my fitness improved, I gradually picked up on the number of rides, and now I ride around nine horses every morning," he said. "If racing started today, I would be ready to go, even if I haven't quite reached my riding weight yet. It was a bit of a balancing act for me, as you don't want to lose too much weight and lower your immunity with the virus around us. It was hard, but I'm glad it's all worked out in the end."

Five for Belardo

Haunui Farm shuttler Belardo (Lope De Vega) sired his fifth first-crop winner yesterday as Elysium (2 f ex Sonning Rose by Hawk Wing) took out the Irish EBF Auction Fillies Maiden (5.5f) at Navan. The Noel Meade-trained juvenile defeated Giselles Thunder (Night Of Thunder) by a length and three-quarters with Dense Star (Starspangledbanner) the same margin back in third. Purchased by her trainer for €15,000 at the Goffs Autumn Yearling Sale, Elysium is one of three winners out of Sonning Rose (Hawk Wing) who herself is a half-sister to stakes placegetters Universo Star (Excellent Art) and Vienna's Boy (Victory Note). Further back, this is the family of Grade 3 scorer Upper Noosh (Red Ransom). Dual Group 1 winner Belardo is the only son of Lope De Vega (Shamardal) at stud in the southern hemisphere and stands at Haunui Farm for a fee of NZ\$10,000 (plus GST) in 2020.

Dettori the half-century marvel in a sporting world dominated by youth

Frankie Dettori turns 50 on December 15 this year. He must surely be the world's best sportsman of that age.

Certainly the best in a sport which demands strength, balance, skill and bravery. A sport which is physically demanding.

Who could rival him? Kelly Slater perhaps? But Slater is almost two years younger and while still competing extremely well against all-comers, it is nine years since he won a World Surfing Title.

He's older than Bernard Hopkins, who at 48, is the oldest world champion in boxing history. Older than Arthur Wheeler, the Briton who was 46 years and 70 days old when he won a motorcycle major in Argentina in 1962.

Dettori is even older than the oldest major championship winner in the more genteel and less demanding pursuit of golf. Julius Boros won the 1968 PGA Championship at 48 years.

OK, he's not as old as Glen Boss (21-08-1969) who's had a remarkable racing year with four Group 1 wins plus a \$14 million Everest and a \$7.5 million Golden Eagle, but from a global perspective I fancy Dettori's six at Royal Ascot eclipses the Australian's stellar year (not that Boss would be swapping pay cheques).

And yes, he's a mere babe compared to Robert Thompson (13-05-1958) who is, of course, still competing and claimed the 2008 ATC Oaks just a month shy of his 50th birthday so he has the distinction of being older than Dettori when he won that Group 1 but, of

course, he doesn't have the international stature of the Italo/Anglo superstar.

Thompson has ridden a staggering 4443 winners - an Australian record bettering, long ago, the 3322 mark set by Jack Thompson (no relation) who was champion jockey in Ireland in 1950.

Dettori is not (yet) the oldest jockey to ride a major winner. Luminaries Lester Piggott won at Royal Ascot at 57 and Bill Shoemaker took out the Kentucky Derby at 54 but last week's star of the show is anything but in decline - his winning rides, in particular, aboard Alpine Spirit (Sea

The Moon) and Palace Pier (Kingman) were displays of great aplomb.

What a week he enjoyed. Dettori's first Royal Ascot winner came in the meeting's first race, the Queen Anne Stakes, in 1990. His 70th, Fanny Logan (Sea The Stars) in the Group 2 Hardwicke Stakes, came 30 years to the day later on (last) Friday.

Then a treble, on Saturday, took his tally to 73 which matches Pat Eddery's Royal meeting tally and trails only Piggott (116). The trio included the Group 1 Coronation Stakes which had previously eluded him. He's now won each of the meeting's major races.

Image is everything

Dettori is the recognisable face of world racing. If he's not, then we don't have one.

God bless reigning champion jockey Oisin Murphy (06-09-1995) for his well documented and positive social media engagement with fans and he may eventually be as warmly embraced as Dettori, but not yet.

From a racing perspective, Dettori's image is largely untarnished despite his six months ban - imposed in December 2012 - after being found guilty of taking a prohibited substance. The ardent punters rally to him, the casual fans love him and the wider public sure as hell knows who he is.

Dettori said he'd conquered Royal Ascot after the momentous week. He certainly 'owned it' after overhauling Jim Crowley (14-07-1978 for the record) in the race for most winners. (Crowley just might be the best judge, as far as I can tell from the other side of the world, of the British jockeys. When he jumps off one to ride another, the one seemingly never wins).

Dettori even overshadowed the third time Gold Cup winner Stradivarius (Sea The Stars) whom he rode. Noble beast he is Stradivarius but, in any given year, there's very few horses capable of sustaining a gallop for the 4000 metres of the Gold Cup. The competition is limited. This point was sagely made by ITV pundit and former jockey Jason Weaver.

Weaver's contribution to the TV coverage of Royal Ascot was excellent. He was the only on-air pundit to "kick up" for the Karl Burke trained Dandalla (Dandy Man) in the Albany Stakes. She won by six lengths....at very backable odds of 17/2.

More importantly, he was the one person prepared to "call out" the Ballydoyle tactics in the St James's Palace Stakes which - regardless of intent and whether they were or were not - looked horrible. I'm not so concerned to judge this race in particular - I haven't seen the head on footage and nor do I know how the horses pulled up - but it didn't look good and it does raise a broader issue which centres on positive image.

Image is everything. Goodness me, we're living in a world where masses of people are prepared to jeopardise their own health and that of others by participating in demonstrations

against matters which are fuelled by the images broadcast around the world.

There was a lukewarm questioning, from what you can gather from the stewards report, of Tom Marquand after he rode the tailed off 50/1 Ballydoyle runner Royal Dornoch in the St James's Palace Stakes. But that's not the point.

The point is the BHA ought to be more stringent in their policing of "team tactics" from any stable and, as is the case in Australia, demand the notification of tactics changes.

Furthermore, if they want to promote transparency and a positive image for racing, they should demand that tactics are revealed from any stable with multiple runners in a race.

The change of tactics notifications in Australia are not always helpful and, sometimes, they just don't go as announced because of the vagaries of racing. But they are always transparent and, occasionally, incredibly helpful from a punter's point of view.

Whip has to be banned

While focusing on image, it is time for the whip to be banned which prominent owner Lloyd Williams again endorsed last week. Any rule based on a permissible number of strikes is simply nonsense and a time bomb waiting to

explode, one of these days, in a Melbourne Cup or an Everest.

There's been several controversial incidents, of late, in Australia including one rider transgressing aboard a dead-heater who should, logically you'd think, have lost the race if the whip has any bearing on the performance of a horse. If it has no bearing then there's simply no argument about banning it.

If the argument is that they respond to the sound given that the padded whips don't hurt, then that's just as silly. Mimic the sound.

There is no compelling argument, with the possible exception of rider safety, for its retention. If that's real then surely the answer is simple. A jockey may carry a whip but it may only be used in extreme circumstances to ensure the rider's safety and simply not, at any stage, for encouragement.

To argue that it has a bearing in that some horses won't try as hard or run as fast is as nonsensical as counting the strikes. They'll all be on the same playing field. Some horses don't run as fast if the ground is too soft or too firm, if they draw too low or too high, if the weather's too hot or too cold, if the pace is too slow or too fast, if the jockey is male or female, if the float trip is too long or too short.

Horse racing will not flounder without the whip but the sport and its image may flourish.

Very good ITV coverage

I thoroughly enjoyed ITV's coverage of Royal Ascot and if the Brits can learn from us about tactics notifications and some other issues, then Australian racing TV could take some heed from the very "cosy jumper" coverage of horse racing. It has to be about more than just the punt (as much as I love the punt).

I don't know Ed Chamberlin but he appears to be a likeable fellow. I do know he is a very genial host who hosts - just as he is paid to do. He doesn't dominate the coverage. Doesn't promote unnecessary gush. Francesca Cumani has appeal to a broad audience. Jason Weaver makes very good observations on occasions.

Vignettes from Oli Bell, Mick Fitzgerald, Luke Harvey and Kevin Blake are easily digested. It seems nobody's trying to appear

to be smarter than the next bloke or befuddle the audience with meaningless contemporary jargon.

Nobody's shouting at me. Well, with the exception of Matt Chapman from time to time. But even Dear Matt, aside from the forced affectation of delivery, seems to have pulled his head in a touch and - like him or not - his post-race interviews are excellent.

Perhaps there could be a touch more sophisticated analysis in terms of the form but not as much as we have here which appeals to such a minute part of the audience.

But what I loved most of all was the interview - which the ITV crew seemed to have forgotten - with Clive Cox who practically tipped Nando Parrado to win the Coventry. And he did win it and he was 150/1 and, yes, I did have a couple of dollars on him.
