Racing NSW puts foot down on eve of Inglis sales inspections

Victorians banned from Riverside Stables auctions as Queensland border set to reopen

have been locked out of next week's Inglis sales series in Sydney, forcing the already rescheduled Great Southern to be pushed back to August, while the southern state's stakeholders face 14 days of isolation before being allowed to attend the Magic Millions Gold Coast National Sale later this month.

The reinforcement of a Racing NSW directive preventing licensees from

interacting with their interstate counterparts has forced Inglis to effectively ban Victorians from attending Riverside Stables for Sunday's Easter Round 2 and Scone Yearling Sales and the Australian Weanling Sale next Wednesday.

"As a result of advice from the NSW state government and Racing NSW resulting from the increasing Covid-19 situation in Victoria, all Victorian-domiciled persons will be unable to attend Riverside Stables at the upcoming Inglis July Sales Series auctions," Inglis said in a statement last night. *Continued on page 2>>*

Inspections for Sunday's yearling sales begin at Riverside Stables today with arrangements having already been made to ensure Victorian vendors Yulong, A List Stud and Daisy Hill are able to have their horses on site.

The Great Southern Sale, which had been moved from Victoria to Sydney in a bid to counter the coronavirus issue engulfing Melbourne in recent weeks, has once again been rescheduled as a live auction at Oaklands Junction on August 9.

A back-up plan of an Inglis Digital sale being conducted if strict Covid-19 protocols make it impossible for buyers and vendors to be on site has been put in place.

"We've been working with Inglis in relation to an upcoming weanling sale that was transferred from Melbourne (Great Southern) and as I understand it, it seems that the sale is no longer taking place (in Sydney)," Racing NSW chief steward Marc Van Gestel told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"In terms of the yearling sales this weekend, Inglis has agreed to Racing NSW's request that there is the non-attendance of persons based in Victoria on the basis of the outbreak of Covid in that state."

The last-minute Racing NSW intervention on who could attend the Inglis sales, which had already been moved back from April and June because of the government-imposed restrictions, will also impact the buying bench at the Magic Millions National Sale on the Gold Coast later in July.

"Our current protocols in place for NSW participants is that if they do attend another state then they have to quarantine in NSW for 14 days when they return back from that state and they can't attend a racecourse or licensed premises during that period," Van Gestel said.

"That's the current protocols we have in place for all our participants."

The action taken by Racing NSW emerged at the same time as Queensland premier Annastacia Palaszczuk announced a reopening of the state's borders to residents of all states and territories except Victoria on July 10.

<< Continued from page 2 Palaszczuk said Victorians or travellers who had spent time in Victoria in the preceding 14 days leading up to entering Queensland would be required to undertake two weeks of quarantine at their own expense.

It was unclear last night whether Victorians would have to undertake hotel quarantine or if they had the option to spend 14 days isolating outside their home state before heading to Queensland.

Magic Millions managing director Barry Bowditch said: "Our understanding is they can, but I want to reiterate that we haven't got confirmation on that. The other option is that they could get to the Coast early and quarantine there.

"If Victorians are eager and keen there is a means and a way for them (to attend the National Sale)."

Yesterday's border announcement by the Queensland government has prompted Victorian agent Suman Hedge to pack up and head north to complete his isolation so he can attend the Magic Millions sales.

However, the Racing NSW order will prevent Hedge, a prominent weanling buyer, and his Victorian peers including Sheamus Mills, from attending the Sydney sales.

"I've just been telling my wife that I'll probably need to leave (this) morning," Hedge said.

"That's the part that is so hard to reconcile for families. I don't have children, but some of the other agents and participants have got young families, so it's going to be a bit tricky to deal with for them. But there's no other options for us at the moment."

Hedge added: "It's a big blow for Victorian participants because they already had the Great Southern Sale cancelled and moved up to Sydney, so they've had to adjust for that.

"Now, they've been allowed to send their horses up, but they won't be able to send any staff up and they will have to be managed by other people.

"Obviously for myself it's difficult because (pinhooking weanlings) is a big part of my business but for the farms, some of those farms they aim to sell all of their horses as weanlings like Cathy Hains (at Burnewang North it is even harder)."

It could lead to some vendors electing to make a last-ditch bid to get their weanlings to Queensland as supplementary entries for the Magic Millions Sale or, alternatively, attempt to sell them privately.

Lauriston Thoroughbred Farm's James O'Brien, who is also the president of Thoroughbred Breeders Victoria, is weighing up his options after yesterday's developments.

The Victorian breeder has his entire 2019 foal crop, who are by stallions such as Deep Field (Northern Meteor), Not A Single Doubt (Redoute's Choice) and So You Think (High Chaparral), catalogued in the Great Southern Sale.

"Wearing a Lauriston Thoroughbred Farm cap, I've got ten in the Great Southern Sale, and we are presenting all our weanlings to sale, so we're all-in. I've got none going to the yearling sales. I've put all my eggs in one basket and the basket's getting a bit shaky," O'Brien said.

"I have got some really nice horses there and I want them to be presented well. These are the times we are in."

Late entries for the Magic Millions National Sale, which has already received some high-profile entries including Group 1-winning mares Sunlight (Zoustar) and Viddora (I Am Invincible), remain open until July 6.

"I am in the Hunter Valley at the moment and we've got some unbelievable stock to offer," Bowditch said.

"We are genuinely excited that we can host this sale in a live format - the best format to host a sale - and we're looking forward to having our clientele back on the Gold Coast."

Corona scare for Sydney jockeys

Today's Sydney meeting on Randwick's Kensington track will go ahead as planned after an unnamed NSW metropolitan jockey returned a negative test for Covid-19 yesterday. Nine jockeys who rode at Rosehill on Saturday were stood down from their mounts at Gosford yesterday and all riders who rode in the city last weekend were asked to undergo coronavirus tests after one member of the jockeys' room displayed flulike symptoms yesterday morning. "We had a test performed on the jockey with the flu like symptoms and that has come back negative to COVID," Racing NSW chief steward Marc Van Gestel said. "So all the protocols that were in place previously are back in place and apart from the jockey changes at Gosford today, there's no other change."

Sircconi to back up

A week after tackling 2000 metres for the first time, Sircconi (Nicconi) will drop back to 1600 metres when he lines up in the Winter Championship Final (Listed, 1600m) at Flemington on Saturday. Sircconi, whose career highlight came at Flemington in the VRC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) in 2017, pleased Nick Ryan with his first attempt at a middle distance. "He was very brave the other day at his first try at the trip, but he did have a bit in his favour," Ryan said. "He got a nice run in front, the rail was out 12 metres and the track was favouring on-pace runners, but in saying that, he was terrific. They say coming back in trip, being rock hard fit and racing on speed, it's a good recipe. Hopefully they're right."

Prize-money for major Victorian races unchanged

The flagship races of Melbourne's Spring Racing Carnival will retain their prize-money levels in 2020, Racing Victoria announced yesterday. Minimum prize-money levels will also be restored to pre-Covid levels and all Vobis bonuses will return from August 1, but 12 stakes races will have their purses lowered. These include the Cantala Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) and the VRC Sprint Classic (Gr 1, 1200m) both reduced from \$2 million to \$1.5 million - and the Memsie Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m), down to \$750,000 from \$1 million. The Lexus Stakes (registered as Hotham Handicap) (Gr 3, 2500m) will also be reduced from \$300,000 to \$200,000, but the winner will still earn ballot exemption for the \$8 million Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) three days later.

Prize-money to shape Tofane's spring

Before yesterday's prize-money announcement, Mike Moroney was weighing up options with All Aged Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Tofane (Ocean Park) with his decisions to be guided by her earning potential. Moroney has his eyes on the \$15 million The Everest (1200m) with the mare and he said that, with a Group 1 on the board, now is the time to try and boost her bank balance. "She's won a Group 1, so it's down to prize-money now with her," Moroney told Racing.com. "She might start off here in Melbourne, but it really just depends on the programming and the money here, otherwise we'll just get her to Sydney straight away. I think she's bigger and stronger. For the first time I look at her and see why she has made a sprinter, because she's got real strength now, something she's lacked all the way through."

Extra Time to follow Dalasan path

National Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) winner Extra Time (Shooting To Win) is set to be campaigned similarly as a spring three-year-old to highprofile stablemate Dalasan (Dalakhani) last year, starting in Adelaide before heading to Melbourne. Dalasan won the Spring Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) at Morphettville and the Danehill Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Flemington before finishing second to Alligator Blood (All Too Hard) in the Caulfield Guineas Prelude (Gr 3, 1400m) and fifth to Super Seth (Dundeel) in the Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and trainers Leon Macdonald and Andrew Gluyas are plotting a similar path for Extra Time. "He was fantastic at his most recent start before a break when we put the blinkers on and he bolted in. He has come back to the stables in terrific order," Macdonald told Racing.com. Dalasan is likely to be aimed at the Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) this spring.

First win in a generation for trainer

Terang-based trainer Noel Richards scored his first win in almost 24 years when Niamh Chinn Oir (Al Samer) scored at Ballarat yesterday. Richards was last in the winners' circle in November, 1996 when Captain Shillalae (Cavalry) won at Terang with Christine Puls in the saddle; Puls took the ride on Niamh Chinn Oir yesterday too. Richards told Racing.com that he gave training away in 1998 upon starting a new job, with the 73-yearold taking out his licence again in 2016. "I gave it away because I couldn't give the horses the time," Richards said. "Then I thought I'd better take it out again because I've retired. It gets me out of bed at five in the morning. I think the bottle of Glenfiddich, 12 years old, will be out tonight, or maybe the Chivas Regal that the other part-owner bought me for Christmas."

Victorian Covid-19 wave worries Browell

With the 100th running of the Cox Plate looming in October, Moonee Valley Racing Club chief Michael Browell is remaining hopeful but is cautious about the prospects of having crowds trackside for the feature's milestone. Browell told RSN927 that there were four options facing the MVRC. "The two that we are focused heavily on are the current restrictions of one person per four square metres - which, Moonee Valley with its configuration, we wouldn't be able to get anywhere near the 10,000 that was first proposed by the Prime Minister a couple of weeks ago - or it's more in our favour if it drops back to one person per two square metres and at this point in time you would think that is best case scenario," he said. "I don't really want to focus on the no-crowd option, that would be diabolical for all of us, and I don't think there is much point focusing too much time on crowds as per last year."

Perth trio in Everest reckoning

Leading Western Australian owner-breeder Bob Peters hopes to have a runner in this year's \$15 million The Everest (1200m) after having his first starter last year when Arcadia Queen (Pierro) finished near the rear as favourite. Peters told Racing.com yesterday that slotholders had shown interest in three of his horses: Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) and All-Star Mile (1600m) runner-up Superstorm (Sebring); promising three-year-old Windstorm (Redoute's Choice), who won twice at Belmont in June; and Showmanship (Showcasing), who will look to make it four from four this preparation when he steps out at Belmont on Saturday. "Everyone knows about Superstorm and have seen his credentials, there's interest around him," Peters told Racing.com. "I know

that a few people are watching Windstorm closely, so it's good that he won so well on the weekend. Showmanship needs to keep winning and running well and he could also put his hand up for a slot."

Ilovemyself sold to Hong Kong

Stakes-winning colt Ilovemyself (Ilovethiscity) has been sold to Hong Kong, Greg Eurell revealed to Racing.com yesterday. Ilovemyself, who won the Festival Of Racing Stakes (Listed, 1000m) at Flemington on debut, was back in the stables preparing for the spring before owner Neville Murdoch accepted an offer that Eurell said was "too good to refuse". "It's very disappointing because I thought he was a really promising horse," Eurell told Racing. com. "He'd been back in work for six and seven weeks and he was going terrific. He'd grown and developed and he was just an outstanding-looking individual."

Latest Australian shipment arrives in Hong Kong

Meanwhile, a shipment of 24 Australian horses arrived in Hong Kong early yesterday, featuring ten Private Purchases - those that have raced down under - and 14 Private Purchase Griffins. or those that are unraced. Among those who arrived at Sha Tin are Karrakatta Plate (Gr 2, 1200m) winner Ima Single Man (Gingerbread Man), South Pacific Classic (Listed, 1400m) conqueror Indy Car (Sebring), Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) fourth Chenier (Medaglia d'Oro) and stakes-performed juveniles Nitrous (Deep Field), while the unraced brigade includes a \$700,000 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale purchase, a colt by Snitzel (Redoute's Choice) out of Group 1 winner Go Indy Go (Bernardini), bound for the John Size stable.

Training partnership to open doors for Ritchie

Trainer Shaune Ritchie is soon to be joined in partnership by Colm Murray, a talented horseman who has been with the stable for more than two years and whose name will be in the formguide from August 1. "I think a lot of the bigger trainers are going to get training partners," Ritchie said. "It is cruel losing some of our better horses to Australia and you can understand why the owners want to take them over there for what is significantly better prize-money. But if I have a man on the base back here, such as the quality of Colm then it gives me the access and ability to go to Australia and campaign the right horses. Having a training partner back at home will be nice to cover that base and be able to travel to the carnivals as well."

Oaks winner set for August trial

Shaune Ritchie is pleased with the way his New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m)-winning filly Jennifer Eccles (Rip Van Winkle) has returned from a break. "She will go to Ruakaka with about eight to ten other horses for two-weeks and have a trial up there in August," he said. "The timing of that trial will be great for Jennifer Eccles because she will then come back to Cambridge and perhaps have an exhibition gallop before she goes to Melbourne or possibly Hastings first." Ritchie will have a strong raiding team including Wellington Cup (Gr 2, 2400m) runner-up The Good Fight (High Chaparral): "Swisswatch will go to Melbourne, as will The Good Fight who has come up exceptionally in my opinion, he has finally developed into a horse. He will be quite wellplaced if the Europeans don't invade. We will also have a horse like Rum, who is only lightly tried."



Bosson unsure of spring plans

After a stellar season on both sides of the Tasman, Opie Bosson is preparing to return to the saddle. However, Te Akau Racing's retained rider is unsure whether he will be able to head across the Tasman come the spring with Covid-19 cases rising in Victoria. "I will definitely be ready by the beginning of the new season, but depending on how things are going, it could be a little bit earlier," he said. "David (Ellis) wants me to focus on New Zealand, but it would still be nice to go to Australia

through the carnivals to ride in those big races. I made as much money in two months in Sydney as I did for the whole season in New Zealand, so it can be pretty lucrative. But David wants me to concentrate on the horses back home to start with and there are plenty of nice ones coming through."

Coleman injured at Rotorua trials

Veteran jockey Michael Coleman suffered a leg injury at the Rotorua trials yesterday. Coleman was aboard maiden Cerys (Tavistock) when she acted up upon leaving the birdcage. "The horse reared up and ended up rearing over, landing on Michael's leg," stipendiary steward Brady Jones said. "He was attended to immediately by paramedics and the injury is defined as a leg injury until X-rays are taken. It wasn't anything out of the ordinary. It was just unfortunate how it all happened. The horse just lost its balance and Michael ended up half underneath it." The popular rider is one of New Zealand's

most successful jockeys, with more than 2,100 domestic wins to his name.

Righteous Doctrine aims to keep rising at Sha Tin

Michael Chang remains the only Hong Kong trainer to have won a race in the United States a Grade 1 at that - and he is hoping his stable's current high-flyer Righteous Doctrine (Siyouni) may be able to begin a path towards Group company when the French import contests today's Class 2 Hong Kong Reunification Cup (1800m) at Sha Tin. "I think his rating can still go up, the horse has just continued to improve, and this race is a good test for him," Chang said. "That's why I asked Joao (Moreira) to ride him one more time, so I can see what we can do with him in the future. He's an improving horse, a very typical European horse; now he's getting more mature than last season and in his favour is that he can run well on both tracks."
