# Hong Kong buyers to play key role in two-year-old sales

Strong turnout for champagne parade as Inglis prepares to launch 2020 Ready2Race Sale

ong Kong buyers, deemed pivotal to the success of two-year-old auctions in Australasia, are expected to remain active in the market, starting at tomorrow's Inglis Ready2Race Sale, despite prominent agents from Asia unable to be in Sydney to inspect the horses.

Hong Kong-based George Moore is normally on the ground for the two-year-old sales and last

year he purchased the highest-priced lot at the Inglis sale when going to \$340,000 for a Deep Field (Northern Meteor) gelding but this year will be relying on the assistance of family to help compile a short list.

Due to the restriction on international travel in Australia, Moore remains in Hong Kong and so he has called on the help of his uncle, Rosehill trainer Gary, to cast his eye over the 226-lot catalogue of horses at Riverside Stables.

"I'm the bloodstock agent for Team Moore

<< Continued from page 1 Magus Equine's Willie Leung is also a regular visitor to Australia and New Zealand's yearling and two-yearold sales and he is optimistic that he will again be able to make his mark despite being grounded in Hong Kong.

"There's still plenty of demand for two-year-olds, so it all depends on whether they are happy to try and buy them online ... and we will see what happens in the next couple of days," Leung told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"I have people over there (in Sydney) completing inspections and providing me with some extra videos."

The emergence of Sky Field and Winning Dreamer in Hong Kong is certain to see agents servicing the jurisdiction keeping a close eye on the progeny of Deep Field.

There are six two-year-olds on offer at the Inglis sale by the Newgate Farm stallion while Leung also singled out Headwater (Exceed And Excel), who has three lots to go under the hammer, as a stallion the Hong Kong market could warm to.

"It is so far, so good because we need 500 horses (in Hong Kong) every year, so the demand is still there and it just depends on whether we can secure the right one (at the sale)," Leung said when asked about his and his fellow Hong Kong agents' clients willingness to buy horses during the Covid-19 pandemic..

Meanwhile, a champagne brunch and a selection of Ready2Race horses were paraded at Riverside Stables yesterday, attracting a significant number of trainers, bloodstock agents and syndicators.

Trainers including Paul Snowden, John O'Shea, Gerald Ryan, Gary Moore, Greg Hickman, Kim Waugh, John Sargent, Annabel Neasham, Peter Robl, Danny Williams, Rod Northam and Mitchell Beer were in attendance as were agents Andrew Williams, Bill and James Mitchell, John Hutchinson, Bevan Smith, Johnny McKeever and Olly and Anton Koolman.

Adelaide-based Gordon Richards, the trainer of Inglis' Everest (1200m) third placegetter Gytrash (Lope De Vega), was also a keen onlooker at yesterday's parade and plans to be active in tomorrow's sale. *Continued on page 4>>* 



<< Continued from page 3 The Group 1-winning trainer paid \$40,000 for Gytrash at the Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale while he also paid just \$18,000 for Listed-winning sprinter Bold Star (Needs Further) from the Magic Millions Tasmanian Yearling Sale and he won't be changing his approach to seeking value at the Ready2Race Sale.

"They are cheap horses and I wouldn't want to break the mould. You are going to get a dud every now and then, but you don't lose a lot of money that way, so I will be here putting my hand up and probably spend a little bit more than I normally do and hopefully get the right one," Richards said.

He does, however, hope to have more luck than he did the last time he bought a horse at a two-year-old sale.

"I bought one by Lope De Vega just after I bought Gytrash (as a yearling) and I paid \$50,000 I think for him at a Melbourne ready to run and when they were working together as two-year-olds there wasn't much between them," he said.

"But the other one is still trying to win a maiden I think, so I'd shied away from the ready to runs a little bit after that, but I will buy one here on Tuesday.

"It's a good sale and the best part about it, anyone who buys should be racing in a couple of months."

Inglis general manager of bloodstock sales and marketing Sebastian Hutch is in no doubt about the quality of horses available at this week's sale.

"We've been very pleased with the response to the catalogue and we can say with real sincerity that it is the best breeze-up sale catalogue that there's been in Australia, so when we talk about there being genuine quality in the catalogue we mean it," Hutch said yesterday.

"People who come out to the complex will see that and the people who watch the breezes on the website will see it.

"It feels like there's going to be solid demand for horses who tick all the right boxes: horses who breezed well, look the part physically and have the right profile.

"Just beneath the top level I also think there could be some really fantastic buying. The record of the sale for producing good racehorses and winners - every owner wants to win a race and the sale has an excellent record of producing winners."

Inspections for the Inglis Ready2Race Sale continue today while the auction will start at 10am local time tomorrow.

#### First for Odyssey Moon

TWIN HILLS STUD

Twin Hills Stud's first season sire Odyssey Moon (Snitzel) has sired his first winner with his first runner after the Chris Munce-trained Berdini's Girl (2 f ex Berdini by Bernardini) won at the Sunshine Coast yesterday. Ridden by Micheal Hellyer, Berdini's Girl finished strongly from off the pace to score by a long neck over Vienna Empress (Holy Roman Emperor) and Rhapsody Rose (Star Witness) who was another three quarters of a length away in third place in the QTIS 2YO Handicap (1000m). Bred by Woodpark Stud, the Sledmere Stud-consigned Berdini's Girl made \$35,000 at this year's Inglis Classic Yearling Sale when selected by Munce and agent Arthur Hoyeau. Odyssey Moon, who stands for a fee of \$6,600 (inc GST) at Olly and Amber Tait's Cootamundra Stud, continues a good start for freshman season sires, with Capitalist (Written Tycoon), Shalaa (Invincible Spirit), Flying Artie (Artie Schiller) and Frosted (Tapit) all siring twoyear-old winners this season.

## Second Listed win for Huiying

Almost three years after landing his first Listed success in the 2017 Connoisseur Stakes (Listed,

1800m), All Too Huiying (6 h All Too Hard - Madame Flurry by Perugino) brought up his second win at Listed level when landing the \$200,000 Seymour Cup (Listed, 1600m) at Kilmore yesterday. The Phillip Stokes-trained six-year-old dueled with \$2.60 favourite Gold Fields (Churchill Downs) all the way down the straight but All Too Huiying just got up in a photo, with with ever-closing Romancer (Redwood) half a length behind in third. The son of All Too Hard (Casino Prince) was making his 40th start yesterday and has racked up over \$600,000 of prize money since making his debut in 2016.

#### Kah on Buckhurst in Plate

Jamie Kah has secured her first Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) ride on Buckhurst (Australia), who is set to back-up this Saturday following his seventh-placed finish in the Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m). The Joseph O'Brien-trained import, who has an international rating of 114, ran a solid race on Saturday but was outpaced in the final 200m, suggesting a drop in trip may prove beneficial. Kah has had previous success with Buckhurst's owner Lloyd Williams, partnering his Midterm (Galileo) to success in the Manion Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) in 2019. Kah currently leads the Melbourne jockey's championship with 20 winners, four ahead of Damien Oliver and Ben Melham.

## Cox Plate pinnacle for Peters' Queen

Arcadia Queen (Pierro) will provide owner Bob Peters with his biggest day in racing when lining up in the Cox Plate on Saturday. Arcadia Queen, who took out the Caulfield Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) on October 10, will be Peters' first runner in the Moonee Valley feature. "Every racing person aspires to having a runner in the race so it's something of a win just to have a horse get there," Peters told Racing.com. "She's come through some tough times over the last year and again when she had that little setback when we got to Victoria, but she's going to Saturday's race fit and well and ready to do her best we hope. She's trained on well and going into the race probably as well as she can be, so we're hoping."

#### Waller ponders Elleegant's Cup weight

Connections of Verry Elleegant (Zed) are contemplating whether to run in the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200) due to an expected weight increase following her impressive Caulfield Cup win on Saturday. Prior to Saturday's win, Chris Waller had expressed concern over Verry Ellleegant's Melbourne Cup weight of 55 kilograms and a revised mark would only make matters worse. "I haven't spoken to the owners yet but obviously they are concerned about what weight she will be carrying and what cost running in the Melbourne Cup has on her career, so that will be discussed," he told RSN 927. "Hopefully it's onward and upward to a Melbourne Cup but we have to respect the owners, the weights and of course, the horse." Verry Ellegant currently has two jockeys for the Melbourne Cup, after Mark Zahra replaced regular rider James McDonald in the Turnbull Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) and Caulfield Cup, causing a further issue for connections. "That's a tricky one," he said. "It will be one that comes down to a collective discussion with the owners. Obviously, she is James' horse but this is a very strange year. Mark has won a Caulfield Cup and a Turnbull, I can't see how we can take him off either. At this stage, she has two riders."

#### Melbourne Cup target for The Chosen One

A gallant run for third in Saturday's Caulfield Cup has connections of the New Zealand-bred and trained The Chosen One (Savabeel) excited about his prospects for the Melbourne Cup. The five-year-old entire cast off some indifferent lead-up form for Saturday's Caulfield feature to put his best foot forward in a race won by Verry Elleegant. Co-trainer Andrew Forsman credited the addition of blinkers for the race and a good barrier draw as the key elements for the improved performance after the horse had disappointed when finishing near last a week ago in the Herbert Power Stakes (Gr 2, 2400m). "It was a massive buzz to see him do that against such a quality field," Forsman said. "It was very exciting and good to see him get his chance like that. He had had his excuses in his lead-up runs after winning first up, in that going against the weight-for-age specialists second-up in the Underwood was always going to be tough for him." The Chosen One will head straight to the Melbourne Cup without another start.

#### Skyward on song for Geelong Cup raid

Trent Busuttin is impressed with the early indications of French-import Skyward (Camelot), who will line up in Wednesday's Geelong Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) with the aim of securing a place in the Melbourne Cup. The five-year-old entire arrived at Busuttin's yard on Friday following two weeks of quarantine at Werribee's International Horse Centre and began his preparation to win Busuttin a first Melbourne Cup. "He looks a very straightforward and laid-back sort of horse that really suggests he's a real mile and a half (2400 metres) plus horse," Busuttin told Racing.com. Skyward is currently 41st in order with 52.5 kilograms, so he lines up in the Geelong Cup seeking a victory and a subsequent penalty that will boost him up the order for the feature on November 3.

## Gytrash likely to stay in Sydney

Everest (1200m) third placegetter Gytrash (Lope De Vega) is set to extend his Sydney campaign and chase a lucrative bonus in the Yes Yes (1300m) at Rosehill on Saturday week. The Gordon Richards-trained gelding, who represented auction house Inglis in the \$15 million race, is eligible for a \$750,000 bonus on top of the \$580,000 first prize should he win the Yes Yes. "If things do go pear-shaped, then the (VRC Sprint Classic) is a week later at Flemington, but I am thinking of keeping him here, but not running both," Richards said. "He ate up (on Saturday night) and he is as bright as a button. The Yes Yes Yes is 1300 metres and they way he finished off yesterday, it shouldn't worry him." Reflecting on Gytrash's Everest performance yesterday, Richards told ANZ Bloodstock News: "He delivered in spades, but our plan was to win it and he didn't. After you think about it for a while, running third in that race is a fantastic effort."

## \$6.7 million to be spent on NSW racecourse upgrades

The NSW Government will invest \$6.7 million in country racecourses, with Bathurst, Taree, Grafton and Dubbo all set to receive upgrades. This follows a \$3.7 million grant to improve facilities at Bathurst Thoroughbred Racing's Tyers Park. "The NSW Government is providing significant funding to upgrade five country tracks and we are appreciative of this initiative and for the government's constant support," said Racing NSW's Chairman, Mr Russell Balding AO. "We are grateful that our State government recognises the importance of thoroughbred racing in the country regions and these grants will improve infrastructure and stimulate local communities." The Bathurst project includes the construction of additional stabling, course proper reconfiguration, horse walkers and treadmills. Taree will receive \$1.2 million for day stalls, Grafton \$1 million for a water harvesting project and Dubbo \$318,000 on stabling.

who still had a number
of horses in training, was
a stalwart of the Cranbourne

racing community. One of his most memorable successes came with Lord Scotia (Lord Seymour), who won seven races in Melbourne including the Caulfield Sprint in 1987. Robbie Griffiths knew the trainer well and said he will be a big loss to the Cranbourne training ranks. "He was much-loved especially by the people here at Cranbourne." Griffiths said. "He was always a highly-skilled horseman and very resilient, having had to change to training from being a jockey when getting too heavy and then again when losing his leg up to his knee almost a decade ago. It didn't slow him down or stop him riding. We'll really miss him here and our thoughts are with his long-term partner Leanne Doyle."

#### **NEW ZEALAND**

## Cornflower Blue back in Guineas contention

Matamata filly Cornflower Blue (Savabeel) reinvigorated her challenge for next month's Barneswood Farm New Zealand 1000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) with a determined win at Ashburton. The Jamie Richards-trained three-year-old ran fourth in the Canterbury Belle Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Riccarton at her last start but made no mistake yesterday when she produced a determined home straight burst to down fellow northern raider Embers (Darci Brahma) in the Barneswood Farm Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m). "I watched the race with the trainer and I'm absolutely rapt," Cornflower Blue's breeder and owner Mark Chittick of Waikato Stud said. "Jamie and the team, his father Paul, have done an incredible job with her after she felt the ground in the Canterbury Belle Stakes. We're looking forward to her contesting the 1000 Guineas, if she goes the right way, but we'd like to see a touch more give in the ground if possible."



#### Bosson weaves magic on Swords Drawn

Swords Drawn (Camelot) threw his hat into the ring for some of the upcoming summer staying features when he stormed home from near last to score impressively over 1600 metres to close out this year's Hawke's Bay Spring carnival on Saturday. Placed twice in stakes company as a three-year-old, the now five-year-old gelding has always looked to have the makings of a quality stayer with more experience and maturity on his side. Second up on Saturday, the Shaune Ritchie and Colm Murray-trained galloper looked a forlorn winning prospect at the 600m mark when last on the inner for rider Opie Bosson. The champion jockey did not panic as he hugged the rail in the home straight with Swords Drawn, who burst to the front at the 200 metres before easing down to win by just under two lengths at the line. "That was an awesome run," Murray said. "His turn of foot was very good and he relaxes so well in his races now. It was a super ride from Opie as well as he just picked a path up the fence and when he gave him his head, he really let down nicely. He's a far stronger and more mature horse for this campaign where we would like to get him into those good cup races on a light weight."

#### Paisley Park back in winning form

Progressive stayer Paisley Park (Azamour) bounced back to winning form when taking out a 1600-metre race at Ellerslie on Saturday. The Dunstan Feeds Stayers Championship Final (2400m) winner earlier in the year, he was having his third start in a new campaign and looked ready for a big performance based on his first two efforts. Trainer Graeme Richardson, who prepares Paisley Park in partnership with Rogan Norvall, was thrilled to see their charge back on top as he looks ahead to several of the major summer staying races. "He's gone two very good races this time in off some bad draws and unlucky circumstances, so to see him win was very pleasing," Richardson said. "I was a little worried that he was looking for more ground and the mile may have been too short. I think the way he finished off franks that opinion but he was strong to the line and it was a lovely ride by Darren (Danis)."

#### **ASIA**

#### 161 for Deep Impact

Salacia (5 m ex Salomina by Lomitas) provided Deep Impact (Sunday Silence) with his 161st individual stakes winner when taking out the Fuchu Himba Stakes (Gr 2, 1800m) at Tokyo yesterday. The Manabu Ikezoe-trained mare impressively defeated Shadow Diva (Heart's Cry) by three lengths, with Something Just (Victoire Pisa) a further one and a quarter lengths behind in third. Deep Impact, a seven time Grade 1 winner in Japan during his career and subsequently multiple champion Japanese sire, sadly died last year having stood at Shadai Stallion Station.

## JPN: Tact first undefeated Triple Tiara winner

Daring Tact (3 f Epiphaneia - Daring Bird by King Kamehameha) became the first undefeated winner of the Japanese Fillies' Triple Crown when landing the Shuka Sho (Gr 1, 2000m) at Kyoto yesterday. The Haruki Sugiyama-trained three-year-old extended her record to five from five to achieve the feat, with other recent Fillies' Triple Crown winners including Almond Eye (Lord Kanaloa) and Gentildonna (Deep Impact). Daring Tact followed up victories in the Oka Sho (Japanese 1,000 Guineas) (Gr 1, 1600m) and Yushun Himba (Japanese Oaks) (Gr 1, 2400m) and stayed on best to defeat Magic Castle (Deep Impact) under Kohei Matsuyama by a length and a quarter. Matsuyama said: "There was some pressure as we were aiming for her to become the first undefeated Triple Crown filly in Japanese racing history but I'm delighted to be able to accomplish this remarkable feat. She seemed a bit nervous in the paddock but she broke well and we were able to race in a good position and in good rhythm. She has developed into a bold filly and I hope she will remain undefeated."

#### **INTERNATIONAL**

#### First for Territories

Fulgentia (2 f ex India Spirit by Dr Fong) provided Darley's Territories (Invincible Spirit) with his first stakes winner when taking out the Premio Ubaldo Pandolfi (Listed, 1200m) at Rome yesterday. The Davide Livermoreowned filly finished runner-up in a Listed contest in June but went one better this time with a convincing two and a quarter length win over Virgin Isla (Mehmas), with Sunshine Day (Arcano) a further two and a half lengths back in third. Territories, whose career highlight came when winning the Prix Jean Prat (Gr 1, 1600m) at Chantilly in 2015, has 15 individual winners to his name from 54 runners. The Darley shuttler stands at Kelvinside for a fee of \$11,000 in 2020.

#### 17 for Shalaa

Noman (2 c ex Mathool by Alhaarth) brought up a 17th individual winner for first season sire Shalaa (Invincible Spirit) [right] by landing a novi

[right] by landing a novice stakes (1m1/2f) on the all-weather a t Wolverhampton on Saturday evening. The Hugo Palmer-trained colt finished third on his first appearance at Newmarket over 1m in September but made no mistake second time out. Noman won going away from the Richard Hannon-trained Mickydee (Twilight Son), who finished one and three-quarter lengths off the winner, with Folk Magic (Dubawi) finishing a further one and a quarter lengths behind in third. Arrowfield Stud shuttler Shalaa had his first Group winner when Shaquero (2 c ex Fimatino by Not A Single Doubt) took out the Breeders' Plate (Gr 3, 1000m) at Randwick on

October 3. He stands at Arrowfield for \$33,000

(Inc. GST) this Spring.



#### 27 for Kingman

Fresh from his Group 1 win in the Champion Sprint (Gr 1, 6f) at Ascot on Saturday, trainer Archie Watson sent Parent's Prayer (3 f ex Pure Excellence by Exceed And Excel) over to Naas yesterday and collected the feature race with the daughter of Kingman (Invincible Spirit) taking the Garnet Stakes (Listed, 1m) and becoming the sire's 27th individual stakes winner. Ridden by Ben Coen, Parent's Prayer was sent off at 12-1 and she scooted clear in the closing stages to win impressively by three lengths from Best On Stage (Pastorius) and Stormy Belle (Dandy Man) who deadheated for second. Parent's Prayer was a €165,000 Goresbridge Breeze-Up purchase by BBA Ireland and the lightly-raced three-yearold broke her maiden on her third start this year before running third to Champers Elysees (Elzaam) in the Fairy Bridge Stakes (Gr 3, 7.5f) last month. Kingman, the sire of Group 1 winners Palace Pier and Persian King, as well as Coolmore sire Calyx has been announced as the first cover for superstar Enable (Nathaniel) next year and stands at Juddmonte's Banstead Manor Stud in Newmarket where his 2020 fee was £150,000.

#### 13 for Intello

Noble Heidi (2 f ex Noble Pensee by Orpen) provided Intello (Galileo) with his 13th individual stakes winner when taking out the Preis der Winterkonigin (Gr 3, 1600m) at Baden-Baden yesterday. The Henk Grewetrained filly got off the mark at the second time of asking when landing a conditions contest over 1600 metres at Chantilly last time out and followed up nicely at Baden-Baden. Sent off the favourite under Andrasch Starke, Noble Heidi

defeated Novemba (Gleneagles) three quarters of a length, with Amazing Grace (Protectionist) a further one and three quarter lengths behind in third. Intello stood at Haras du Quesnay for a fee of €12,500 (approx. AUD\$20,700) in 2020.

#### 19 for Lord Of England

Lord Of England (Dashing Blade) had his 19th individual stakes winner yesterday when Queen Rouge (4 f ex Tolerate by Dubawi) took out the Stockholm Fillies and Mares Stakes (Listed, 2100m) in impressive fashion at Bro Park. The Marc Stott-trained filly was sent off favourite and rewarded her supporters by defeating Silverstone (Pistachio), with Zahara (Nayef) back in third. Lord Of England stood at Gestut Etzean in Germany for €6,500 (approx. AUD\$10,750) in 2020.

#### Three for Gutaifan

Sopran Poseidone (2 c ex Ms Sasha Malia by Verglas) brought up the third individual stakes winner for Gutaifan (Dark Angel) when taking out the Premio Campobello (Listed, 1800m) at Milan yesterday. The unbeaten colt made it three wins from as many runs when impressively pulling away from Bell'imbusto (Helmet) in the final 200 metres to win by three and a quarter lengths, with Sens Of Emperor (Holy Roman Emperor) finishing a further four lengths back in third. Gutaifan stood at Yeomanstown Stud in Ireland for €6,000 (approx. AUD\$9,900) in 2020.

#### 74 for Mastercraftsman

Six-year-old Barrington Court (6 m ex Arabian Hideway by Desert Prince) who switched from hurdling to the flat three starts ago, winning a

maiden and placing twice in stakes company, gained a deserved black type success in the Bluebell Stakes (Listed, 1m4f) at Naas yesterday. The Jessica Harrington-trained

mare, who was ridden by Shane Foley in the colours of JP McManus, took up the running a furlong and a half from home and saw off the challenge of Snapraeceps (Canford Cliffs) to win by a length and a half, while Yaxeni (Maxios) was a further three lengths back in third. Barrington Court was also the winner of a Listed bumper two years ago under National Hunt rules, however became the 74th individual stakes winner for her sire Mastercraftsman (Danehill Dancer) [above] who stands at Coolmore in Fethard where his 2020 fee was €25,000 (approx. AUD\$41,360).

## ITA: Group success for Elisa Again

Elisa Again (4 f Champs Elysees - Sunny Again by Shirocco) collected a third stakes prize of her career when taking the Premio Verziere (Gr 3, 2000m) at Milan yesterday for Roberto Biondi. The four-year-old, who now has six wins from 15 starts, won twice at Listed level last year and this was her first Group success, although she was placed in the Premio Lydia Tesio (Gr 2, 2000m) and two Group 3s while she also ran fifth in the Oaks d'Italia (Gr 2, 2200m). She got the better of the French raider Amica Nostra (Epaulette) in a tight finish, while Santa Rita (Jukebox Jury) was six lengths back in third.



### US: Raven Run to Venetian Harbor

A solid performance in the Raven Run Stakes (Gr 2, 7f) for three-year-old fillies on October 17 at Keeneland earned Venetian Harbor (3 f Munnings - Sounds Of The City by Street Cry) a trip to the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint (Gr 1, 7f) back at the Lexington track. The Richard Baltas-trained Venetian Harbor, a Grade 2 winner with form around some of the best three-yearold fillies like Gamine (Into Mischief) and Swiss Skydiver (Daredevil), set an uncontested pace and had enough left to hold off a late bid from Finite (Munnings) by a neck. "Our intention was to go to the Breeders' Cup, but we felt this would be a good opportunity to get a race in her," co-owner Joseph Ciaglia said. "I couldn't be any happier today. She's great out of the gate. She's tenacious, and that's what you need to win some races. Gotta be quick out of the gate. Manny (Franco) did a great job getting out of the gate, and that was the key to the win."

## US: Warren's Showtime takes Autumn Miss

Warren's Showtime (3 f Clubhouse Ride - Warren's Veneda by Affirmative) surged home to take the Autumn Miss Stakes (Gr 3, 1m) at Santa Anita, marking the 1,000th victory for her trainer, Craig Lewis, Lewis finished second with his two earlier entries, including Warren's Showtime's twoyear-old brother, Warrens Candy Man. But in the Autumn Miss for sophomore fillies, Warren's Showtime rallied from fifth and got up to score by a neck under jockey Flavien Prat. "I've been very fortunate," Lewis said. "I've had a lot of great horses in my career: Cutlass Reality, who beat back-to-back (Kentucky) Derby winners Alysheba and Ferdinand in the Hollywood Gold Cup; Music Merci, who won the Del Mar Futurity, Illinois Derby and many other big races; and then of course Larry The Legend. I've had multiple other good horses and a lot of great owners. I'm very thankful and feel very fortunate, very grateful to be in this situation.

Fillies like her (Warren's Showtime) bring me back. There are a lot of bumps in the road. A trainer's life is not all pie and ice cream, but when things like this happen, it makes it all worthwhile. The early mornings, the things that go wrong, the difficult situations, but situations like this overcome all the negatives involved."

#### UK: Kameko to retire to Tweenhills in 2021

Qatar Racing's 2,000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m) winner Kameko (Kitten's Joy) will be retired to stand at Tweenhills Stud in Gloucestershire at the end of 2020. Connections intend to give the colt a final start in the Breeders' Cup, having opted out of a run at Ascot last weekend. Also an impressive winner of last year's Vertem Futurity Trophy Stakes (Gr 1, 1m) and fourth in the Derby (Gr 1, 1m4f), Kameko was most recently seen giving weight away to some very smart rivals in the Joel Stakes (Gr 2, 1m) at Newmarket. Bought by Qatar Racing advisor David Redvers for \$90,000 as a yearling at Keeneland, he is the obvious replacement to the late Roaring Lion, another outstanding son of Kitten's Joy (El Prado) for the same connections. Sheikh Fahad Al-Thani, chairman of Qatar Racing, said: "My brothers and I are delighted to own another superstar in Kameko, whose record-breaking two and three-year-old campaigns will live long in our memory. We cannot wait to unveil him to breeders." Trainer Andrew Balding added: "Kameko is without doubt the best horse I've trained. He has all the attributes of a top-class miler and is a striking horse to look at. I feel very honoured to have had the opportunity to train a horse of such class." His 2021 stud fee and syndication plans will be announced in due course.

## US: Mike Smith: 'New whip rules are putting jockeys' lives at risk'

US Hall of Fame jockey Mike Smith believes riders are at risk of "serious injury or even possibly death" as a result of the new whip rules implemented in California and has called for them to be urgently reviewed by policymakers. Smith, rider of US legends such as Zenyatta (Street Cry), Arrogate (Unbridled's Song) and Justify (Scat Daddy), also expressed concern about the integrity of races and the livelihoods of riders in a letter written to the California Horse Racing Board (CHRB) in his role as co-chair of the Jockeys' Guild. CHRB introduced changes to the whip rules on October 1, limiting the number of strikes to six - with no more than two in succession - and with it to only be used in the underhand position. Contravening the rules can lead to a maximum fine of US\$1,000 and a minimum ban of three days. However, Smith argued the rules are likely to lead to more dangerous riding conditions, having participated under the changes last weekend, and feels the views of riders' are not being adequately considered by those making the laws. "After the jockeys have attempted to comply with [the rules] this weekend, our concerns have been reiterated and we strongly believe that more than one of us will suffer a serious injury, or even possibly death, from your new rule," he wrote. "The reality is we are very alarmed about the lack of concern for our safety and wellbeing. Furthermore, not only do we have a concern for our own welfare, but also have grave concerns about the risks being created for the horses. We strongly believe that regulation is extremely hazardous and has added an even greater risk and uncertainty to our profession."

## More than Wishful Thinking in Premier Bowl

o horse was given less chance, at least according to the betting board, but that did not stop a rejuvenated seven-year-old Wishful Thinker (I Am Invincible) storming to victory in the Premier Bowl Handicap (Gr 2, 1200m) at Sha Tin yesterday.

The gelding, having just his third start for trainer Dennis Yip, was sent out at win odds of 44/1 but surged late to overhaul the Tony Cruzfavourite Computer Patch (Exceed And Excel) by a short head with Rattan (Savabeel), the second least fancied of the seven runners, two and a quarter lengths back in third for Richard Gibson who formerly prepared the winner.

Wishful Thinker was winless last season, after six wins in his first two terms post-import from Australia, but he ran with some credit; finishing a neck third, behind Seasons Bloom (Captai Sonador), in this race and being beaten just one and a half lengths when sixth to Beat The Clock (Hinchinbrook) in the Hong Kong International Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m).

And now, despite his age and the weight advantage he enjoyed yesterday, he may not be an unrealistic contender – at the very least among the locally trained horses – for this year's HK\$22 million Hong Kong Sprint showpiece. Aerovelocity (Pins), at eight in 2016, is the only HKIR Sprint winner older than six years.

Three horses have claimed the rich December Sprint prize after winning the Premier Bowl in the same season – Absolute Champion (2006), Aerovelocity (2014) and Mr Stunning (2017).

Winning jockey Derek Leung said Yip's decision to take the blinkers off the seven-yearold was one of the keys to his success along with the genuine pace at which the race was run.

"We took the blinkers off and kept him fresh for today. He was more relaxed today, tried hard and raced very good. Last time he was bumped at the beginning and then we tried to chase the

winner and he got a bit keen," Leung said of his distant fourth behind yesterday's runner-up in the National Day Cup Handicap (Gr 3, 1000m) on October 1.

"This time he raced much better with the blinkers off and last time he carried top weight and this time he carried the low weight. The weight helped him a lot and the pace was good which suited the horses coming from behind."

"I hope so," Leung said when asked whether the Hong Kong Sprint might be on his agenda, "I'm sure he will run there".

Karis Teetan, who rode the runner-up Computer Patch, was not discouraged by the performance of the lightly -raced four-year-old who may also be December bound.

"He got to the front without doing much work but he was very green in front in the straight. I think if a horse came next to him it would have encouraged him to go. He was by himself and got a bit lost to be honest. He never stopped. He did everything right. I just thought the way the race was run, I would have liked something to have gone with him earlier," Teetan said.

Last year's Hong Kong Sprint runner-up Hot King Prawn (Denman) stepped out for the first time this season and finished a creditable fourth, for John Size and Joao Moreira.

## Golden Sixty makes it nine in a row in Sha Tin Trophy

Golden Sixty (Medaglia d'Oro) took another important step toward December's Hong Kong International Races riches with victory in yesterday's Oriental Watch Sha Tin Trophy Handicap (Gr 2, 1600m) at Sha Tin, a result that all but confirmed a changing of the guard at the very top of Hong Kong's pecking order.

The Francis Lui-trained gelding scored his ninth straight win and his 12th from 13 starts as he comfortably despatched several of Hong Kong's best performers of recent seasons including dual Horse of the Year Beauty Generation (Road To Rock).

Last season's Four-Year-Old Classic Series champion, under Vincent Ho, quickened from the middle of the pack with a closing 400 metres clocked at 21.81s – his fastest closing 400 metres since a slick 21.65s recorded when he won in Class 2 at this fixture last year – beating Encouraging (Redoute's Choice), the 1400m Sha Tin track record holder.

Adding further merit to his time and performance, the Medaglia d'Oro (El Prado) gelding seemingly switched off once he hit the front as if the job was done, but a few reminders from Vincent Ho followed and he kicked on for a soft half-length win, with Ka Ying Star (Cityscape) in second, Southern Legend (Not A Single Doubt) in third, while Beauty Generation faded to sixth.

"He does switch off, two maybe three strides after he hits the front, he always does – that's why he never wins by huge margins," Ho said.

The newly turned five-year-old, who swept aside his four-year-old peers last season, followed his first-up Celebration Cup Handicap (Gr 3, 1400m) success with another impressive display which confirms he is Hong Kong's new star.

"He's come on really well and today he settled a lot more, really well behind the gate and inside the gate, he was so relaxed and with each run his fitness is coming on," Ho said.

With December's Hong Kong Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) on the radar, Golden Sixty firmly set himself as Hong Kong's leading contender en route to December glory in the division which local horses have generally dominated.

"Before the race I was a bit nervous, but now I'm happy – the horse, his mind and fitness is improving, we'll keep him at the same distance," trainer Francis Lui said.

Vincent Ho and Golden Sixty broke evenly to settle midfield, fifth in the run before peeling out at the 300m mark to hit the front, holding on for a half-length score.

"He jumped well, we sat behind the pace and they went really slow, when the other horse accelerated a bit – I just gave him a reminder – he's a very smart horse.

"He always tends to lay in a little bit - Chad (Schofield) was on my inside and I think once Golden Sixty hit the front he thought the job was done, he sort of put his head up and started looking around and I had to remind him that there was someone coming back on the inside," Ho said.

Chad Schofield spoke of the willingness of his mount, Ka Ying Star who finished a close-up second: "Good run, he likes to control the race from the front like he did today, he kicked well and to my bloke's credit he fought hard to the line."

Karis Teetan, rode third placed Southern Legend, and was pleased with the effort of the dual Singapore Kranji Mile (Gr 1, 1600m) victor who is also on a Hong Kong Mile trail.

"If we had a draw he would have been more competitive. I had to face the breeze all-theway but he still ran very well," Teetan said.

## Winning Dreamer remains unbeaten

Frankie Lor's rising star Winning Dreamer (Deep Field) extended his unbeaten record to four with a smart Class 3 victory in the Pai Tau Handicap (1200m) under Vincent Ho, capping a brilliant day in the saddle for the 30-year-old.

"I can't ask for much more. I'm extremely lucky for the owners and trainers to be supporting me so well and as well, I'm so lucky to be on Golden Sixty and horses like Winning Dreamer – extremely lucky the owners have stuck with me," Ho said.

The talented son of Deep Field (Northern Meteor) was sent out a 2.3 favourite, against another unbeaten galloper, the John Size-trained Scores Of Fun (Reward For Effort) who finished second, while Chicken Dance (Hinchinbrook) grabbed third.

"He can be a sprinter but if he's behind horses he can switch off completely and when you ask him he can go again – he's quite fast, he's a good horse for sure," Ho said.

"He feels a bit easier than last time, he always tends to hang in but he didn't do that today – I'm extremely happy with that," Ho said.

The talented four-year-old arrived in Hong Kong as a 52-rater and has shot up to a figure of 79 since his debut in May, last season.

#### Teetan takes three

Karis Teetan secured a treble today capped with victory aboard Will Power (Power) in the Class 2 Fo Tan Handicap (1200m, dirt), moving the Mauritian to joint-second on the premiership with Zac Purton, locked on 16 wins behind only Joao Moreira in first with 21 wins.

"Great day, three winners – it's hard to have one but to have a treble is good," Teetan said.

The 30-year-old narrowly missed in both of today's Group 2 contests, finishing second and

third, but he ensured he did not go home empty handed with three wins of his own, sealed aboard the Douglas Whyte-trained Will Power.

"He's a lovely horse, since I first sat on him I knew and he's just improving each time and he's a better horse this season, mentally and physically," Teetan said.

"If I put him between horses like that last season he wouldn't have let down but he's learning and the good thing you can feel is he is getting better," Teetan said.

Teetan, earlier, took the first of the two dirt contests, securing the Class 4 Shing Mun River Channel Handicap (1200m) aboard Resolute (Per Incanto) for trainer Tony Millard and won the opening, the Class 5 Tin Sam Handicap (2000m) aboard the Peter Ho-trained Amazing Agility (King's Best) – a much needed win for the handler who is the last trainer to get off the mark this season.

"Precious moment – it's very hard to get a winner especially in Hong Kong, you need a good horse and a good jockey that is willing to help you ride the horse," Ho said.

Champion trainer Ricky Yiu got his seventh win as Bulletproof (Dissident) cruised to victory under Vagner Borges in the Class 4 Tai Wai Handicap (1600m).

Heza Beauty (Darci Brahma) and Neil Callan grabbed the finale, the Class 3 Sha Tin Hoi Handicap (1400m) for trainer John Size.


