James Price to depart Woodside Park following restructure

*Leading Victorian farm to retain ownership
of stallions as they vacate Tylden property*

James Price will leave his role as CEO of Woodside Park Stud at the end of the financial year after the leading Victorian farm, owner of star stallion Written Tycoon (Iglesia), announced a restructure which will see them vacate their leased Tylden property, home to stallions Tosen Stardom (Deep Impact),

Foxwedge (Fastnet Rock), Rich Enuff (Written Tycoon) and Cable Bay (Invincible Spirit).

In a statement released yesterday evening, Woodside Park principal Mark Rowsthorn outlined plans to consolidate their operation at their Morningside property in Nagambie, which they acquired in May 2019, with a focus on breeding elite yearlings to sell at auction.

Magic Millions release Gold Coast March Yearling Sale catalogue

Magic Millions yesterday released the catalogue for their Gold Coast March Yearling Sale, with 419 lots set to go under the hammer on March 15 and 16. *Morning Briefing page 6>>*

"We are looking to simplify our family's interests and direct our investment to a smaller operation that is focused on breeding yearlings at the elite end of the market," said Rowsthorn.

"Morningside lends itself to this change in direction and also complements our growing cattle and cropping operations."

Written Tycoon, the sire of three Group 1 winners last year, including Golden Rose (Gr 1, 1400m) and Caulfield Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Ole Kirk and Moir Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) winner Pippie, stood the 2020 breeding season at Arrowfield Stud in the Hunter Valley.

While the statement added that Woodside Park would be retaining ownership in its stallions, when contacted by ANZ Bloodstock News yesterday evening, Price would not be drawn on the future location of Woodside's stallion roster, although he indicated that the restructuring had been considered at length.

"It's something that we've discussed at board level for some time," said Price. "It's something Mark Rowsthorn has been thinking about, certainly since the latter part of last year, and saw it as a prime opportunity to downsize into a smaller, boutique operation."

"Morningside is a fantastic property for whatever the Rowsthorn family wish to use it for. They've certainly got interest in breeding to their broodmares and have a keen interest to breed cattle there. It's a great piece of land on the Goulburn river, so whatever the Rowsthorn family decide to do with it, I'm sure it will be a success."

<< *Continued from page 2* into the top five leading vendors, selling four yearlings at an average of \$395,000, an achievement Price says sought to consolidate this new strategy.

"This is the focus where the Rowsthorn family want to take it," said Price. "Particularly on the back of our results that we've seen this year, and will hopefully continue to see this year.

"Our achievement of being a top-five vendor at the Magic Millions last month was a fantastic feat, selling our highest-priced yearling. I hold that pretty high in our achievements."

The move follows a notable trend of stud operations concentrating resources on breeding high-end yearlings for commercial sale, with fellow Victoria-based operation Sun Stud last month announcing plans to downsize, focusing on an elite broodmare band.

"What a lot of studs have done is acquire a high level of mare, which has produced great results in the sale ring," Price added.

"There's no doubt that with a higher quality of mare, it brings a greater return. It's a simple equation in that it costs just as much to raise and host the bad ones as it does the good ones, so why not focus on having as many of the good ones as possible, and fewer of the less paying ones as possible? It's not rocket science, and it's the way many principals are aiming.

"If it was my business, I'd be doing the same too."

Price has yet to determine his next destination in the thoroughbred industry, but is proud of his contribution in the development of Woodside Park in the three years he oversaw operations as CEO.

"I'm keeping my options open and have really enjoyed and am very proud of what I've achieved at Woodside Park Stud.

"Being a part of the continued success of Written Tycoon, as well as the other stallions here. Rich Enuff has made a good start to his career and Foxwedge recently recorded his fourth Group 1 winner and, if we think about how many stallions have one Group 1 winner, let alone four of them, Foxwedge is a brilliant stallion.

"Where to next? I'm not sure. I've had a few conversations with a few people. There's nothing set in stone, but I'm looking forward to my next challenge."

Magic Millions release Gold Coast March Yearling Sale catalogue

Magic Millions yesterday released the catalogue for their Gold Coast March Yearling Sale, with 419 lots set to go under the hammer on March 15 and 16. All of the catalogued lots have been subject to the first payment for QTIS, while 137 of the youngsters are BOBS eligible. Buyers at the auction will have the added incentive of a discounted nomination fee for the Magic Millions race series. Graduates of this sale include Buffering (Mossman), Spirit Of Boom (Sequalo), his Group 3-winning son Boomsara, Winning Rupert (Written Tycoon) and Hong Kong sensation Wishful Thinker (I Am Invincible), while the progeny of 92 individual sires have been listed for the two-day run. The auction will begin after the \$2 million Jewel raceday at the Gold Coast on March 13 and the online catalogue can be found [here](#).

Acrobat sidelined

One-time Inglis Millennium (RL, 1100m) favourite Acrobat (Fastnet Rock) will not race again this autumn, co-trainer Ciaran Maher revealed yesterday. The Coolmore-owned Acrobat was second favourite yesterday for the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) before Maher's announcement, but he will not be seen again until the spring. "Unfortunately, Acrobat has sustained a superficial cut to the back of his hock," Maher said in a statement. "Although only a minor injury, it has required some rest and has forced us to halt his preparation. With his Golden Slipper lead-up rapidly approaching, we have simply run out of time and, together with Coolmore and his

connections, we have made the tough decision to spell him with a view to a spring campaign. He is a colt with enormous potential, one of the most naturally gifted two-year-old colts we have trained and we have always considered him to be a leading Golden Slipper contender. Although it is disappointing for all involved, we are not taking any risks and believe a spell is in the best interests of the horse." Acrobat won the primary lead-up to the \$2 million Inglis Millennium, the \$500,000 Inglis Nursery (RL, 1000m), at his first - and, to date, only - start in December.

Vasil under investigation

Disqualified Victorian trainer Tony Vasil, who is currently serving an 18-month suspension for his role in the Aquanita scandal, has been named by a Sydney radio station as the racing identity that was allegedly involved in an incident with two women on the Gold Coast last month. The Ray Hadley Morning Show yesterday revealed CCTV footage of the incident, which has been referred to Queensland Police for investigation. Hadley said the footage shows Vasil touching a 73-year-old woman, who then appears to slap his face. The incident then escalated, with the woman's daughter confronting Vasil before she went to the venue's management, with a report later made to police according to Hadley. The alleged incidents occurred during the Magic Millions carnival.

Two jockeys, four trainers in Covid-19 scare

Six licensed personnel, including jockeys Damien Oliver and Jye McNeil and trainers Denis Pagan and Robbie Griffiths, will not be allowed to attend a licensed racing premises until further advised by Racing Victoria

after being caught up in a Covid-19 scare. The quartet, alongside two other unnamed trainers, attended a Victorian Racing Media Association lunch on Monday, after which a fellow attendee was identified as having been to one of the exposure sites listed by the Victorian state government on Thursday, initiated after a hotel quarantine worker tested positive to the virus. In a statement made to Racing.com, RV confirmed the attendee of the event was awaiting a Covid-19 test result, but had not shown any symptoms. The statement read: "RV has directed two jockeys and four trainers who were in attendance at the luncheon not to attend a licensed racing premises until further advised by RV. It has also requested, directly and/or via the VRMA, that all other attendees refrain from attending a licensed racing premises pending further advice. An update will be provided once the test result has been received." As such, McNeil did not ride at Pakenham yesterday, while he will be unable to partner Swats That (Shamus Award) in his intended jump-out this morning. Oliver has three rides at Pakenham today and he had not been stood down as of yesterday evening. Both McNeil and Oliver rode at Sandown on Wednesday.

Change of plan results in Orr for Dragonet

Wet weather, the opposition, and a chance to increase his subsequent stud value means connections of Sir Dragonet (Camelot) will allow the four-year-old to begin his autumn campaign in the C F Orr Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield tomorrow. The Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) winner had originally been slated to run first-up in the All-Star Mile (1600m) on

March 13, but after impressing at the Geelong trials last Thursday and with track conditions deemed to be suitable by trainers Ciaran Maher and David Eustace, Sir Dragonet will take his chance in the \$500,000 feature. "Winning a race like that over that trip is going to add a huge amount of value to him, much more than he would currently stand at now," Eustace told Racing.com. Sir Dragonet has yet to race at a trip short of 2000 metres, but Eustace added: "You see it time and time again, those European staying horses, if they really take to the training, then you get that bit extra out of them fresh, that extra turn of foot that they haven't shown before. We thought we would keep that (freshness) up our sleeve for the All-Star Mile but, looking at the fields and looking at the weather, it seemed a good opportunity to win a Group 1 over this trip." Sir Dragonet has drawn gate three under Glen Boss as nine runners are set to go to post in the Orr Stakes.

Fifty Stars out of Orr

The Orr Stakes field was reduced from ten yesterday after Lindsay Park scratched last year's Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) winner Fifty Stars (Sea The Stars) following a dirty scope. "After work he coughed and scoped with some mucus, so the vet's advice is to just wait," Tom Dabernig, who trains the six-year-old in partnership with Ben Hayes, told RSN927. "Although it's not ideal missing the Group 1, he is being set to run in the Blamey and then back up in the Australian Cup. We'll likely head to Sydney and kick off in the Apollo Stakes but that will all be subject to the clean scope on Monday. If we show a little patience, he'll have a good autumn." Lindsay Park will be represented in the Orr Stakes by improving three-year-old Crosshaven (Smart Missile) and Dabernig said of his chances: "Crosshaven is in really good shape. He is taking on the older horses but his 1400-metre record is excellent and if the rain does come and the track is a little soft, he's had three goes on the soft for three wins. He's drawn a good gate and he put himself handy to the speed." Crosshaven will break from barrier four under Daniel Stackhouse.

Award out to reign against males

In other Orr Stakes news, Danny O'Brien is using the race as a means of gauging Sovereign Award's (Shamus Award) Group 1 credentials heading into the autumn. "She finished her spring campaign with three wins, including two Group 3 wins, so she deserves her chance at something better," O'Brien said of the Ladies' Day Vase (Gr 3, 1600m) and Tesio Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) winner. "She's won her way into a race like this. She went out in great form and she's returned in the same manner. She looks great. She's been a slow maturer. She's always been wanting to run hard but she's learning to settle better with age." Looking ahead with the five-year-old, O'Brien added: "If she runs really well I'll look at the Futurity Stakes with her but we're trying to find out whether she's up to the All-Star Mile. We've got to get the voters to get behind her." Sovereign Award has won eight of her 16 starts, the last three of those coming under Jamie Kah, who will be back aboard tomorrow. The duo will break from barrier five and O'Brien believes they should enjoy a pleasing run on the speed behind the other on-pace runners, Streets Of Avalon (Magnus) and Crosshaven.

Waller's Conexy his only juvenile runner

Chris Waller is represented by just one two-year-old in his 13-strong team of horses heading to Randwick tomorrow. The champion trainer, who does not have a runner in either of the Blue Diamond Preludes or the Inglis Millennium, will saddle Conexy (Nicconi) in the Lonhro Plate (Listed, 1000m). A winner at Doomben back in November, Conexy was scratched from his intended assignment at Rosehill last week due to a weight penalty. "He had a three kilogram penalty. I didn't think it was fair running him," Waller said. "It was done on prize-money, which I haven't seen before. He will run (on Saturday) and it is a more suitable race." Hugh Bowman will take the ride from barrier one. Reflecting the patient approach he adopts with juveniles overall, Waller added: "We haven't changed anything, they're not wound up. They are just going through their well-educated systems and they will keep improving."

MRC expect crowds at Caulfield despite new rules

A crowd is still expected to be in attendance at Caulfield tomorrow despite the imposition of new Covid-19 restrictions on Wednesday night. Victorian premier Daniel Andrews announced that a new, community based Covid-19 case had been detected, which is believed to have originated at a hotel used to quarantine Australian Open players and staff. Experts fear further community transmissions and new safety measures now include the mandatory wearing of face masks in public and caps on the number of people in private homes. The Melbourne Racing Club announced this week it had been given government approval to have 15,000 people on course from tomorrow and Jake Norton, MRC general manager of racing, said punters will still be welcomed as things stand. "Obviously the major change as it stands relates to masks, so that will be a requirement," he told Racing.com. "We will be altering our questionnaire to include the new exposure sites that were announced on Wednesday night. Other than that, we have not received other specific directions that anything cannot proceed." The MRC is not expecting the crowd to nudge 15,000.

Reinvigorated Devine Grey to strike again

Trainer Matt Dunn is hopeful born-again stayer Devine Grey (The Factor) can continue on her upward curve when she tackles Saturday city company for the first time in the Hellbent First Crop at Inglis Classic Handicap (2212m) at Eagle Farm tomorrow. Stepped up to a mile at Grafton in early November, Devine Grey rectified a slump in form by coming from second last in the ten-horse field to cruise to a two and a half-length win. The four-year-old has not finished outside of the first two in five subsequent starts, tackling trips up to 2200 metres, and she heads into tomorrow's assignment off the back of a last-start success on January 23. "At the start of this prep she was borderline looking for a new home, her first couple of runs were pretty disappointing," Dunn said. "We started trying her over further which wasn't the original plan that we had in place at the start of her prep. She's deep into

her campaign and still racing well, she's still holding weight and doing all the things that proper stayers do. Plus, she's learning to settle better which is important. She's a proper stayer who actually quickens at the end of long races."

Moody to train Invincible Caviar

Peter Moody's career will be forever linked to the deeds of unbeaten champion sprinter Black Caviar (Bel Esprit), but his return to the training ranks has seen him given the reins with one of her foals for the first time. Black Caviar's fifth foal Invincible Caviar (I Am Invincible) is likely to step out in the next month for Moody, having had a jump out on Wednesday. "I've seen all her progeny and this is the first one that has looked like her," Moody told Racing.com. "I am not going to dare to dream that she's going to have mum's ability, but when I walked down the barn and saw this head hanging over the door, you could dead-set think mum was in the stable. This filly is a dead ringer of her: the head, physique, colour, it's unbelievable, it's uncanny." Black Caviar's first two foals, Oscieta (Exceed And Excel) and Prince Of Caviar (Sebring), both managed to win before retirement while her third foal, Out Of Caviar (Snitzel), was retired unraced. Fourth foal Ready For Caviar (More Than Ready), a three-year-old filly, has had two starts and remains in training with Tom Dabernig and Ben Hayes.

Stutt winner unlikely to race again

Bill Stutt Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) winner Glenfiddich (Fastnet Rock) is unlikely to step foot onto a racetrack again and is instead likely to retire to stud after injuring a tendon. Glenfiddich, sporting the Edinburgh Park Stud colours, began his career with Robbie Griffiths, finishing second in the Champagne Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) among nine starts at two. At three, he ran third behind Behemoth (All Too Hard) at weight-for-age in the Memsie Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) before his Bill Stutt Stakes success. "I respect the fact that he's a very nice horse, he's got a very good pedigree and whilst he's not a Group 1 winner, he's a Group 2 winner and he's multiple Group 1-placed, so efforts are being made to find him a breeding farm,"

Moody said on his podcast, Moody On The Mic. "It's not that easy, I've got to say, because people want Group 1 winners and big, high profile horses and I think this horse's profile was all ahead of him. He was down to run in the Orr Stakes this Saturday and I was very much looking forward to having him there because he ran so well at weight-for-age in the spring. I thought he could have been my sixth Orr Stakes winner this Saturday but, unfortunately, he's on the sidelines. I think his future will lie in the breeding barn but, just in case that doesn't come off, we have commenced a rehab program which would see him return, I wouldn't believe before next autumn."

Group 1 trophies evacuated from Perth Hills fire

The base of Grand Syndicates has been caught up in the bushfire blazes of Western Australia, with the town of Bullsbrook told to evacuate on Wednesday. Bushfires in the area have destroyed more than 70 homes and Sam Lyons of Grand Syndicates said syndication owner Peter Morley and family acted quickly to the developments, but not without taking some special cargo. "When it was declared a red zone Peter and his family and horses got out of there, but I think they are pretty safe now hopefully," Lyons told Racing.com. "He took out the computers, but I think the first two things he took were the two Group 1 trophies. I don't think he has got them under the house insurance policy yet." Grand Syndicates' flag-bearer Behemoth returned with a dominant win in the Durbridge Stakes (Listed, 1100m) at Morphettville last Saturday and he is being set for the Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield on February 20 prior to a tilt at the All-Star Mile. "He pulled up enormous and has lots of improvement to come," Lyons said. "David Jolly told everyone he was as fat as a pig before the race and that was probably a nice way of saying it. He has come back bigger and stronger, which is a scary thought."

Terminally-ill Ryan hopes to line up Star in Mile

In other All-Star Mile news, Hall of Fame trainer Bill Ryan - who is suffering from the incurable lung disease idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis - is hoping talented mare Still A Star (Toronado) can provide him with the perfect swansong by gaining a place

in the \$5 million feature. The four-year-old, who has won seven of her 12 career starts, is currently ninth on the All-Star Mile voting leaderboard, with Ryan hopeful she can attract enough votes to make the final field. "I'm getting towards the end of my training career and this would be my last chance to roll the dice in a decent race. It's the All-Star Mile, the richest mile race on turf in the world, and it would be a real hoot to get in there," the Tasmania-based Ryan told Racing.com. "Even just to take a place in the race would be quite an achievement." Given his illness, Covid-19 has made life tricky for Ryan and if Still A Star makes the field at Moonee Valley on March 13, his initial thoughts were that it would be too risky to travel. "Then I thought, 'What the ****, I'm going to die anyway (so why wouldn't I go?)'" he said. "I may as well die happy. It won't be much fun sitting at home watching it in the lounge, would it?"

Replacement meetings added, trials moved in WA

Racing and Wagering Western Australia has announced a number of changes for upcoming meetings in light of the five-day lockdown imposed within the Perth metropolitan, Peel and south west regions. There is no opportunity to replace the lost Esperance meeting and additional races will be added, if required, to the meeting scheduled for next Saturday. Additional races will also be scheduled at next week's midweek fixtures at Ascot and Bunbury to replace races lost at Bunbury last Sunday.

Four-month ban for Morrow

Apprentice jockey Joshua Morrow has received a four-month suspension after betting illegally last year. The Queensland Racing Integrity Commission discovered Morrow placed 65 bets totalling \$8,807 on thoroughbred racing between April 26, 2020 and June 24, 2020. Morrow did not place any bets on races he was involved in. The 23-year-old, who has not ridden since June last year, pleaded guilty and cannot return to riding until April 25.

Nolen cops eight-meeting suspension

Luke Nolen has been handed an eight-meeting suspension after being found guilty of careless riding at Sandown on Wednesday. Nolen was aboard the impressive Lightsaber (Zoustar) in the opening 1300-metre maiden and was judged to have shifted in when not clear of subsequent fourth Cheerful Legend (Shalaa), forcing the colt to check under Jack Hill. Lightsaber went on to win the contest by three-quarters of a length, two lengths ahead of Cheerful Legend. Nolen pleaded guilty to the charge and his suspension will run from midnight, February 13 to midnight, February 19.

Aitken banned for three weeks

Mitch Aitken has been handed a three-week suspension for his ride on Heavenly Emperor (Echoes Of Heaven) at Flemington in December. Heavenly Emperor finished sixth of eight in the 1600-metre Benchmark 84 on December 19 and Aitken was charged with failing to take all reasonable measures to give the five-year-old the best possible placing. The Victorian Racing Tribunal handed Aitken his penalty at a hearing earlier this week.

Lloyd hospitalised

Victorian apprentice premierships leader Madison Lloyd was taken to hospital yesterday following a fall at Kilmore. Lloyd was suspected to have suffered a broken hand after falling from Rokatta (Kuroshio) in the third of eight races, but was later cleared of any fractures and was found to have soft tissue damage. Lloyd was quickly up to her feet after the incident, but was nursing her hand as she headed to the

ambulance. She currently leads the apprentice premierships on 43 winners, with Will Price one behind on 42.

Beaumont Newcastle moved to Newcastle course proper

The race meeting scheduled for the Beaumont Newcastle on Monday has been transferred to the Newcastle course proper. As a consequence, five races have increased in distance. The opening two Benchmark 58 races will be run over 1200 metres instead of 1150 metres, while race four has been increased from 1250 metres (from 1150 metres), race five to 2300 metres (from 2100 metres) and race six to 1200 metres (1150 metres).

NEW ZEALAND

Vale Silent Achiever


Kevin and Joanna Hickman yesterday announced the death of their four-time Group 1-winning mare Silent Achiever (O'Reilly), who passed at their Valachi Downs property aged 12. Champion New Zealand three-year-old in 2011-12 and champion New Zealand stayer in 2013-14, Silent Achiever's first top-level victory came in the New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) and she followed that up with wins in the New Zealand Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m), Ranvet Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) and the BMW Stakes (Gr 1, 2400m). "We are saddened to share the news of the loss of our champion mare Silent Achiever, who delivered us so many memorable performances during her exceptional racing career," said owner-breeder Kevin Hickman. "She was a special mare who raced with heart and gave her all to every race." Out of Winning Spree (Zabeel), Silent Achiever was trained by Roger James during her 36-race career and upon her retirement, James described her as the ultimate fighter. "She's the kind of mare that will bust her guts for you every time. She would run her heart out. I was privileged to train her," he said. Silent Achiever was sent to Britain in 2015 to be covered by Frankel (Galileo) in her first year, delivering a filly (Lady Faustina) who is now at stud as a broodmare. She later foaled another Frankel colt alongside sons of Galileo (Sadler's Wells) and Kingman (Invincible Spirit).

Vale Te Akau Shark

In a sad day for the industry in New Zealand, Te Akau Racing also announced the death of their dual Group 1 winner Te Akau Shark (Rip Van Winkle) yesterday after he succumbed to a series of health complications. The six-year-old gelding developed a degenerative eye condition during the 2020 Sydney autumn carnival and underwent surgery for the issue last year. He failed to recover completely and was retired from racing in December. "It is with immense pain and sadness that we announce that our beloved Te Akau Shark has lost his brave health battle," a Te Akau Racing statement read. "We are shattered by your loss and will be eternally grateful to have had you, our great red giant, in our lives." The horse with the cult following won seven of his 14 starts including the BCD Group Sprint (Gr 1, 1400m) at home and the Chipping Norton Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) across the Tasman. Trained by Jamie Richards, Te Akau Shark also finished third to Lys Gracieux (Heart's Cry) in the 2019 Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m). Part-owned by rugby league great Paul Gallen, the chestnut amassed almost A\$1.5 million in prize-money. Te Akau Shark has been laid to rest at Te Akau Stud.

Home track a help for Sharrock fillies

Allan Sharrock will use a home track feature as a potential launching pad to next month's New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) at Trentham. Sharrock had planned to use last week's Desert Gold Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) at Trentham to assess how promising fillies Sumi (Atlante) and Signora Nera (Sweynesse) were shaping as potential Oaks fillies. But through misfortune, neither started and Sharrock will default to producing both in tomorrow's Oaks Prelude (Listed, 1800m) at New Plymouth. "Sumi drew 14 out of 15 at Trentham and Signora Nera had pricked a hoof and had a bit of an abscess. She's 100 per cent now but having this race on our back doorstep a week later made my decision easy," Sharrock said. "Sumi is going really well and she's a real up-and-comer and Signora Nera is already black-type placed. They both have a little bit of X-factor. Sumi showed that when she ran home shin-sore on debut in 32.6 seconds. Not many horses can do that." TAB couldn't split the pair yesterday, rating both as \$5.50 chances in a market headed by last-start

"I expect both to be top-five hopes on Saturday and we'll see what's in store for them from there. Both of them, if they went well enough, would press on towards the Oaks," Sharrock said. "Signora Nera won't go around on the hard tracks so we'll just have to see how it goes with her, but Sumi doesn't mind a tarseal surface so she'll definitely press on."

Dunedin test for Auckland Cup aspirant

A tilt at the Auckland Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) at Ellerslie next month is on the line for City Slicker (Shocking) at Wingatui tomorrow. The five-year-old mare is slated for a late nomination for the feature two-mile race, although she will need to perform well in tomorrow's Dunedin Gold Cup (Listed, 2400m) to warrant the late payment. City Slicker has won two of her last three starts and Kelvin Tyler, who trains in partnership with his daughter Aimee, said the firm track conditions didn't suit his mare last start in the Waikouaiti Cup (2200m), where she finished 12th. "The track was way too hard, so hopefully they have put some water on this time because that's not acceptable to race on," he said. "I know it is summertime, but we want a little bit of give in the tracks. I have put concussion plates on this time, but hopefully there is a bit more give in the ground." City Slicker has drawn barrier eight and Tyler is happy with that marble. "It will be a good draw for us," he said. "She got on the fence last time which is a no go for her. This time we will be keeping away from the fence hopefully and giving her some clear air. She is a big striding horse and needs a bit of room to get going." The Auckland Cup is still in the plans for City Slicker, but Tyler is looking for a solid performance this weekend in order to carry on down that path. "It is still on the cards for her, but she has to perform this week," he said.

Dennis eyes Dunedin Guineas

Woodlands trainer Robert Dennis will venture to Wingatui tomorrow shouldering a degree of pressure. The 29-year-old will saddle three runners in the Dunedin Guineas (Listed, 1500m), headed by The Gift (Power) and Ocean Point (Ocean Park), who both come out of strong showings when second and fourth respectively in the Gore Guineas (Listed, 1335m), while one-win filly Choux In (Jimmy Choux) will step up to stakes company for the first time. "There is a little bit of pressure as they are three quality horses and I just want to do everything I can to make sure they get there in the best shape I can have them," Dennis said. "At the Gore Guineas there was something like 100 people connected to my two fillies there with owners and their friends, so I'd expect something similar at Wingatui this weekend. It's a big day for White Robe Lodge and a day to remember (late trainer) Steve Anderton as well." The Gift will start favourite after being narrowly trumped by Showemhowitsdone (Showcasing) in the Dunedin Guineas after enduring a wide passage throughout. "It was just bad luck that beat her last start," Dennis said. "The bigger track at Wingatui and the better draw (barrier three) is going to be right in her favour."

JPN: Gran Alegria set to clash with Contrail

Japan's champion sprinter and miler, Gran Alegria (Deep Impact), is set for a mouthwatering clash with last year's Triple Crown winner Contrail (Deep Impact) in April's Osaka Hai (Gr 1, 2000m). Gran Alegria, winner of the Sprinters Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) and Mile Championship (Gr 1, 1600m) on her last two starts, will be upped in trip on her return to action on April 4. The race is also on the agenda for Contrail, who was last

WA industries await McGowan announcements

Western Australia's racing and breeding industries will be praying for a glimmer of hope when premier Mark McGowan addresses the state's latest restrictions at a press conference in Perth today.

The five-day Covid-19 lockdown this week has come at a perilous time for many participants with bushfires causing devastation in rural areas north-east of the city.

Apart from wider ramifications, McGowan's speech will also determine whether the Magic Millions raceday at Pinjarra will go ahead tomorrow and whether a live auction is viable for the Magic Millions Perth Yearling Sale on February 15 and 16.

Pinjarra Race Club is bracing for its second financial hit in the last 12 months after they were forced to run last year's Cup meeting in front of essential personnel only because of Covid-19.

"It appears our best possible scenario is racing resuming on Saturday so we can go ahead without a crowd," club president Phil Ibbotson said yesterday. "We've already done our money cold making sure everything was ready for what would have been a big day out.

"We're in a strong financial position but last year's Cup cost us a minimum \$60,000. At best, it's going to be worse this weekend. Losing the meeting altogether would be disastrous."

Pinjarra and Magic Millions have developed the raceday into an iconic festival since it was transferred from Ascot. The fixture offers more prize-money than any non-city program on the Western Australian calendar and the sales-related feature races are a major drawcard, with stud marquees helping to host ladies' day crowds that top 6,000.

"We have been liaising with RWWA and Magic Millions," Ibbotson said. "There haven't been any locally-acquired Covid cases in the last four days so hopefully the news is positive on Friday."

Ibbotson and his wife Lindy own Westbury Park, near the heart of WA's breeding industry between Pinjarra and Coolup. They are

partners in Western Breeders' Alliance, which has catalogued a sale high of 32 yearlings for the Perth Yearling Sale.

"We're due to send our yearlings up to the Swan Valley next Wednesday," Ibbotson said. "But as of this morning, the Magic Millions complex was full of horses of all breeds sheltering from the bushfires."

The Magic Millions Perth Yearling Sale going ahead is also subject to a warning from McGowan that any potential easing of restrictions this morning "won't be as much as people might want".

Magic Millions expects most of the relocated horses to have left the complex by Saturday.

"We have a huge crew of volunteers working with our team and we have started getting the property ready where we can," Magic Millions WA manager David Houston said. "No one will be turned away. If there are some animals still on the property we will work closely with the owners and come up with a solution."

Houston also reported Magic Millions is committed to holding a live sale on behalf of WA breeders.

"We are working closely with RWWA on a Covid-safe plan to take to the state government which can be adapted to multiple scenarios to facilitate a live auction. This type of sale won't be online," he said.

Local and interstate buyers can access videos and photos of the yearlings on the Magic Millions online catalogue.

"There's plenty of information for most lots online," TBWA executive officer Ann Croucher said. "It's tough for vendors at the moment, but TBWA will be doing everything we can to support them in the lead up to the sale in the evolving circumstances."

Magic Millions Perth Yearling Sale graduates include Scenic Blast (Scenic), Black Heart Bart (Blackfriars), Moment Of Change (Barely A Moment), Scenic Shot (Scenic) and Boom Time (Flying Spur).

For the second time in three weeks, a youngster bred and raised on the famous Arrowfield pastures who was part of the stud's draft that was withdrawn from last year's Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale has earned the moniker of Maiden Of The Week.

Mallory (Not A Single Doubt) joined horses like Away Game (Snitzel), Mossfun (Mossman) and Overreach (Exceed And Excel) as a winner of the Widden Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m), scoring a length victory over leader Total Babe (I Am Invincible) thanks to a terrific Jason Collett ride.

The Gerald Ryan and Sterling Alexiou-trained Mallory was having her second start

on Saturday, having finished runner-up in the Gimcrack Stakes (Gr 3, 1000m) on debut behind the current star of the juvenile crop, Enthaar (Written Tycoon).

"She is well schooled," Alexiou said. "Jason got her into a nice rhythm. She held her spot on the fence and that big flashy white face looked good levelling out."

"They went along quick enough, they didn't go slow or overly fast. I was more impressed knowing how much improvement she has in her. She will derive great benefit fitness wise from that. When she steps up to 1200 or 1400 metres you will see the best of her."

Whether she targets the Golden Slipper Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m), the Percy Sykes Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) or the ATC Sires' Produce Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) remains to be seen with Alexiou waiting to see how she came out of that last run.

"We just have to get over the weekend first," he said. "We will speak to the ownership group and let her plot the best path. Whether we end up in a Slipper or Sires or sit back for the Percy Sykes, she will make a nice filly in time."

However, Arrowfield principal John Messara instead suggested that he wants the filly to be given her chance in the Golden Slipper.

"We won the Percy Sykes with Shoals a couple of years ago," he said. "If she is good enough I would like to aim her toward the Golden Slipper but it is up to my trainer."

"We will wait and see how she goes in her next couple of runs but that was a very, very professional performance today."

Mallory is the sixth foal to race, and the second stakes winner, out of American mare Panorama Ridge (Empire Maker), following Welcome Stakes (Listed, 1000m) winner Sassy 'n' Smart (Smart Missile).

Brought to Australia having been purchased by Jon Freyer for US\$160,000 at the 2010 Keeneland November Breeding Sale, Panorama Ridge is herself a daughter of two-time French Group 1 winner Nebraska Tornado (Storm Cat), while it is also the family of Anothertwistafate (Scat Daddy) - who this month became that rare commodity to win stakes races on turf, dirt and synthetic - and Lexus Stakes (Gr 3, 2500m) winner Excess Knowledge (Monsun).

Panorama Ridge has a yearling colt by Pariah (Redoute's Choice), who will be offered as **Lot 233** at the Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale, while she was served by Dundee (High Chaparral) in early September.

Dave Morissey's Cannon Hayes Stud are one of the vendors appearing on this year's Inglis Classic Yearling Sale catalogue for the first time, with four of their horses set to go through the ring at Riverside Stables.

Established in March 2019, Cannon Hayes Stud is located just outside Scone in the sought-after Hunter Valley region of New South Wales and was the brainchild of Morissey, who has long desired to set up his own operation.

Born in Ireland, Morissey moved over to Australia on a scholarship and subsequently spent 18 years at Arrowfield Stud, operating as their stud manager for the final five years of his time at the world-renowned operation.

But a desire to have a crack at running his own operation with his wife Lucy, a veterinarian, led him to set up Cannon Hayes Stud, a boutique farm named after his mother's estate back in County Tipperary, Ireland.

"I moved over to Australia in 2000 and I worked for Arrowfield Stud for 18 years, managing the place for five years," says Morissey.

"There came a time in my life when I just

wanted to have a go on my own. Arrowfield were very good to me, but the next step was to buy our own family-run place.

"We bought a small boutique farm five minutes outside Scone and I'm here with my wife Lucy and our two sons, Teddy and James. We're a young family.

"The property is 105 acres and we're more reliant on quality than quantity, that's the business structure that we have. We don't want lots of numbers, we probably want 40, and we don't want to overrun the property.

"The business plan for us is to breed them, rear them and sell them.

"We're really happy with the business, the industry over here is unbelievable really."

Cannon Hayes Stud have quickly ramped up their operation to meet their maximise their facilities, with Morissey adding: "When we started off the business we had 10 foals, now we've got 20 foals and next year we'll be represented at all the major sales."

They have entered a five-strong draft for the Inglis Classic Sale, with one lot withdrawn, and the first horse of theirs to go through the ring is Lot 333, a Headwater (Exceed And Excel) colt out of Bernardini (A. P. Indy) mare Sozzini.

A maiden winner on the track, this colt is

Sozzini's second living foal, with her previous filly yet to race.

2015 Silver Slipper (Gr 2, 1100m) Headwater has proven himself to be an impressive young sire, with Ken Russell Memorial Classic (Gr 3, 1200m) winner Wisdom Of Water among his 33 winners from 81 runners at the time of writing.

"They're a quality bunch of horses, we've got three lovely colts and we're expecting them to sell well," says Morissey. "The Headwater colt is lovely, he's more your three-year-old type, a classy kind of horse. He's by a stallion that's doing a good job."

Ten lots later, Cannon Hayes will be represented by flying stallion Savabeel (Zabeel), whose colt out of Lovetessa (O'Reilly) was the second top-lot at Karaka 2021 last month at NZ\$720,000.

The sire of 21 top-level winners, Savabeel has four lots at the Inglis Classic sale and Morrissey seems particularly excited for his colt out of O'Reilly (Last Tycoon) mare Starry (Lot 343) to go through the ring.

"The Savabeel colt is a cracking type, lovely walker with a great temperament," he says.

"The Savabeel-O'Reilly cross is a cross that works, they've had 18 stakes winners and it's the best cross. If you look at Savabeel's stats, it's by far the best stakes-winning cross.

"There's probably no better time to be selling a Savabeel, he's had an outstanding year.

We'd be very disappointed if this horse didn't sell well."

However, the pick of their bunch according to Morrissey is Lot 562, a Deep Field (Northern Meteor) colt out of Flying Spur (Danehill) mare De Sea Eagle.

Deep Field, who stood at Newgate for \$55,000 (inc. GST) in 2020, recently had a colt out of Courageous Kitty (Fastnet Rock) sell for \$700,000 at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale and Morrissey is expecting this bay colt to be popular among buyers.

"The Deep Field colt is probably the pick of the bunch for us," he says.

"He's a really precocious colt, very attractive and a great walking horse.

"The stallion needs no introduction, he's hot at the moment, and being out of a Flying Spur mare, who is very good at producing broodmares, we'd expect that horse to sell extremely well.

"We'd like to think he would apply to the Asian market, these colts are sought after."

The other lot going through the ring for Cannon Hayes is a Dundee (High Chaparral) filly out of Stareign (Northern Meteor) (Lot 341), while a Pierro (Lonhro) filly included in their five-strong draft has been withdrawn.



The Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale and Karaka 2021 have both produced impressive numbers, despite there being a lack of internationals on the ground.

The Irishman believes, due to the impact of Covid-19, we are seeing a glimpse of what future sales might look like and that is not such a bad thing.

"It's a bit of a strange year but I think it will show that people don't have to travel internationally for these sales," he says.

"The photos, the footage, everybody is working extremely hard to promote these horses and even once Covid is gone, I think it's the way going forward.

"People love photos and videos and you can look at how successful Magic Millions was.

"We're very confident that the Classic will be a good sale and the international buying bench will be very strong."

On Cannon Hayes Stud's goals for the sale, Morissey added: "If we can sell all the horses and the clients are happy, that would be a good result for us. That's the number one aim."
